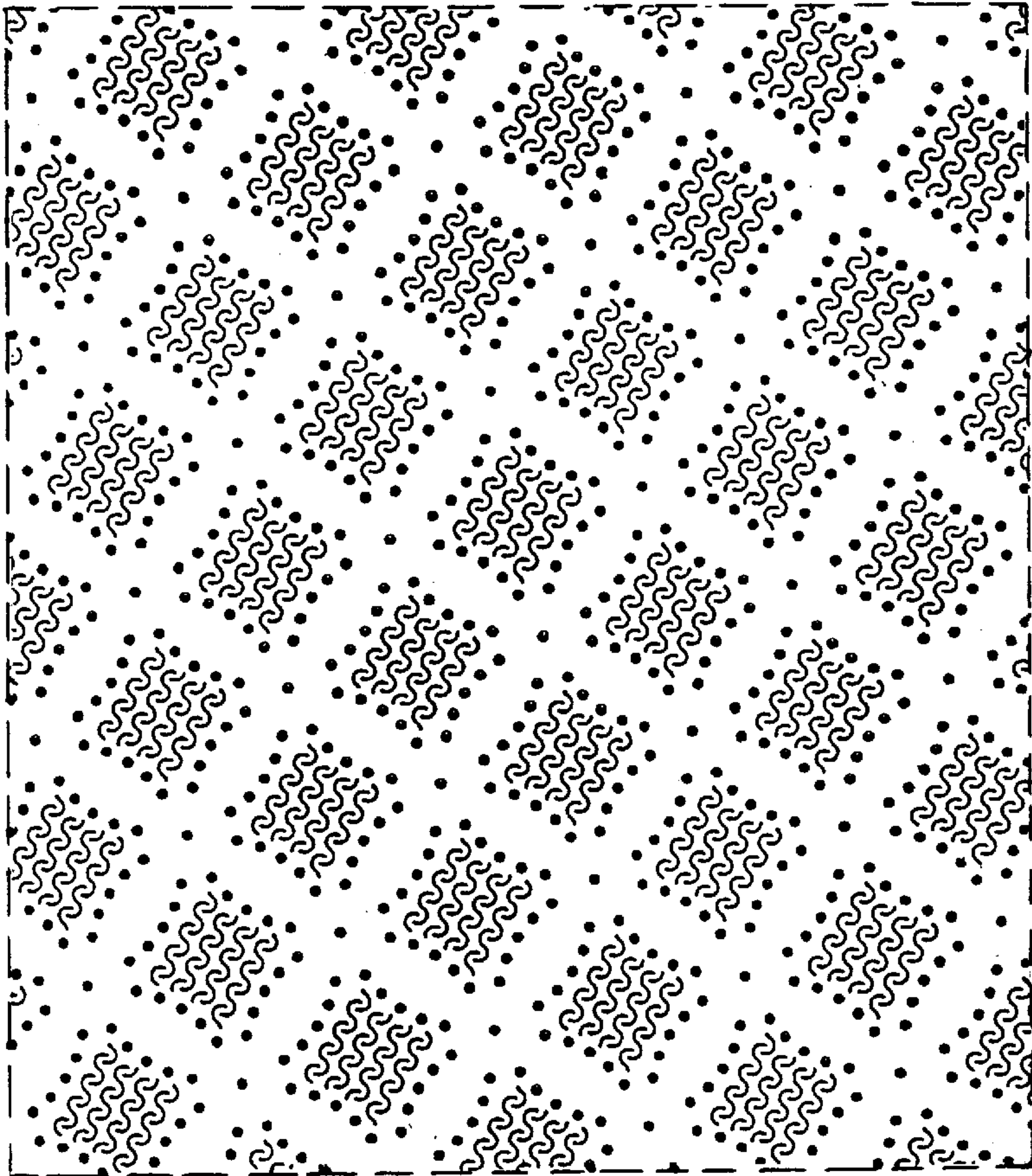
The ornamental design for an embossment pattern for a paper product, as shown and described.

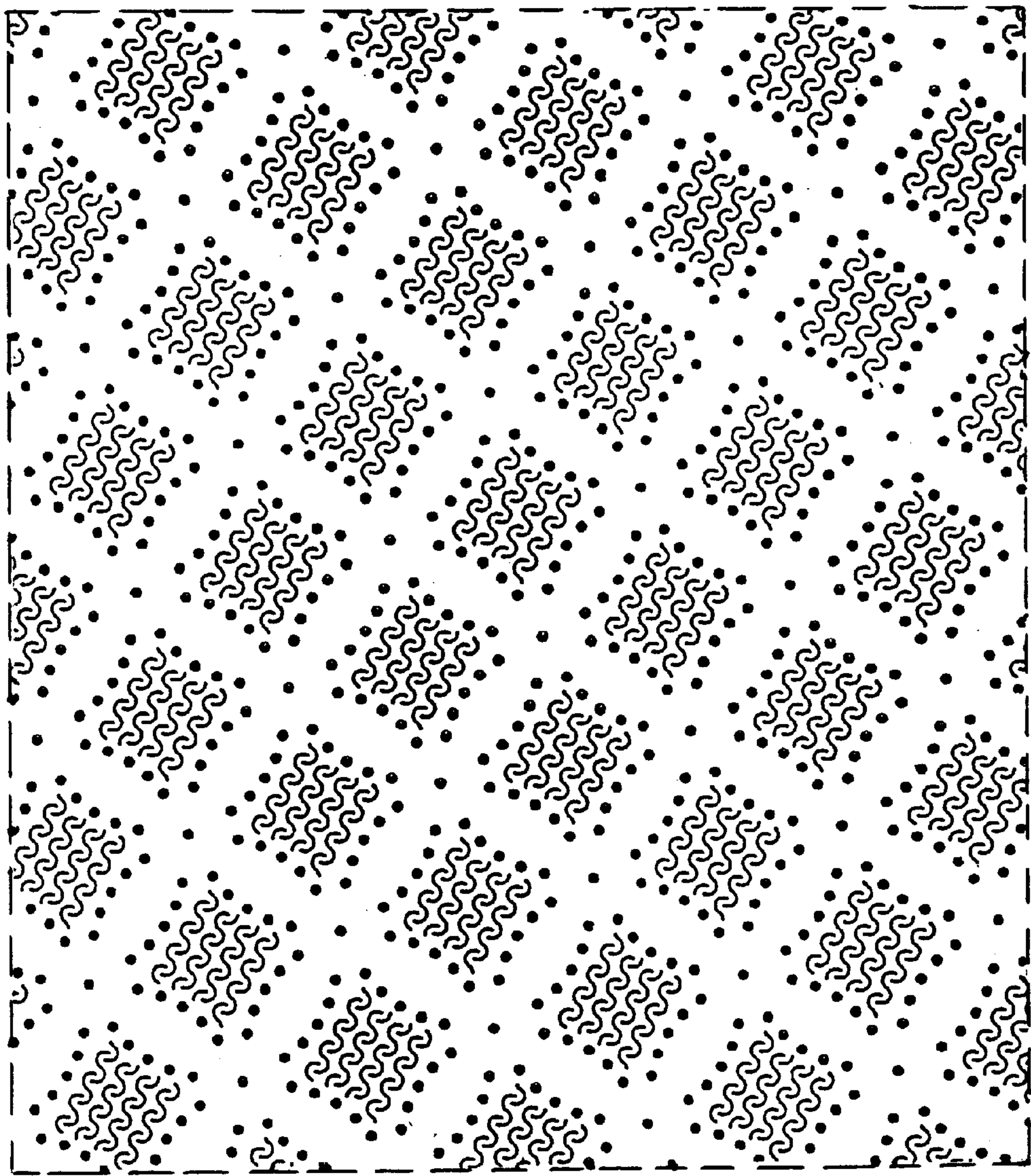
DESCRIPTION
