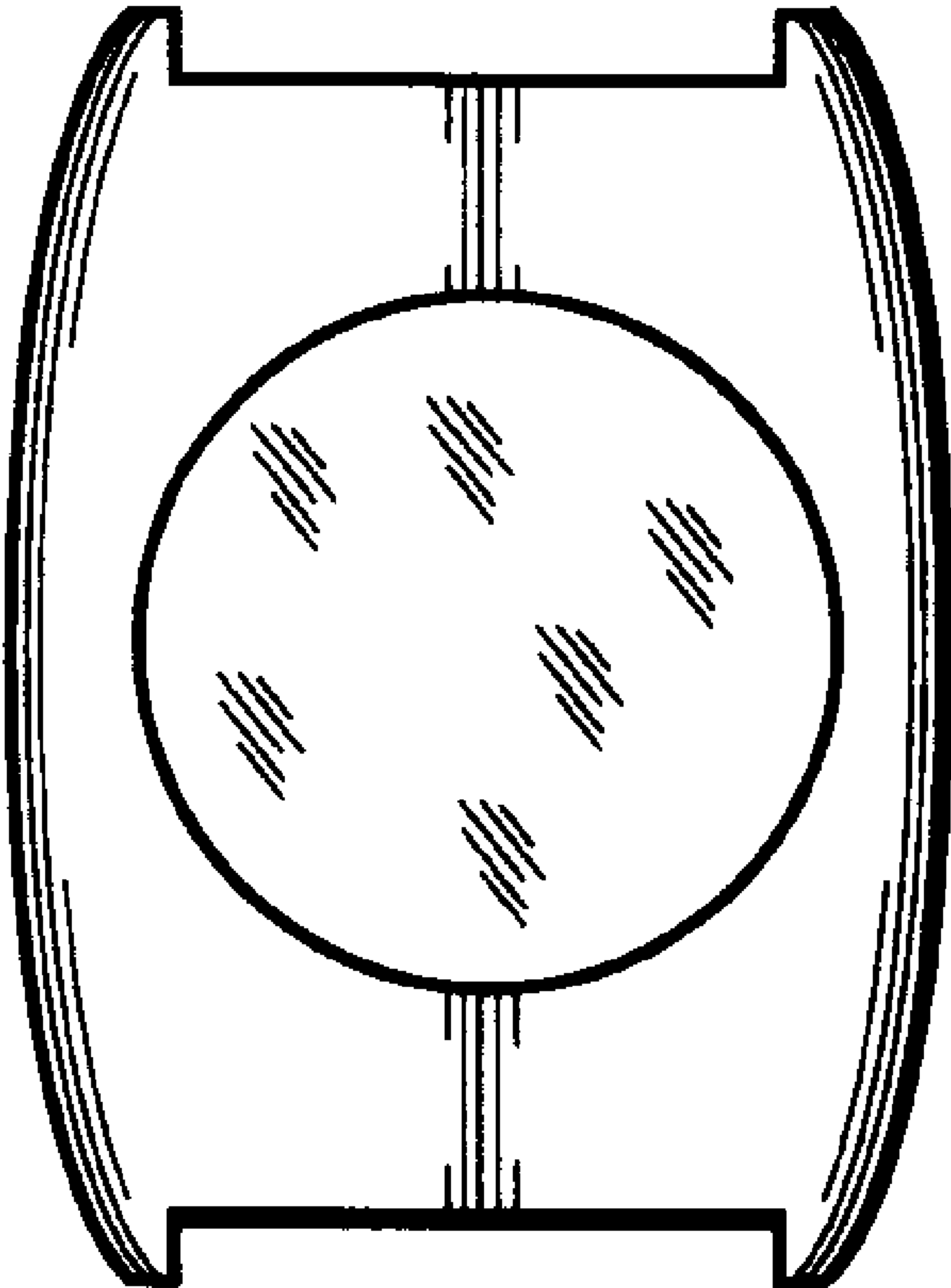
[57] **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a watch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the watch body, the rear being plain and unornamented and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view of the watch body, the right side being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the watch body, the top plan being a mirror image thereof.

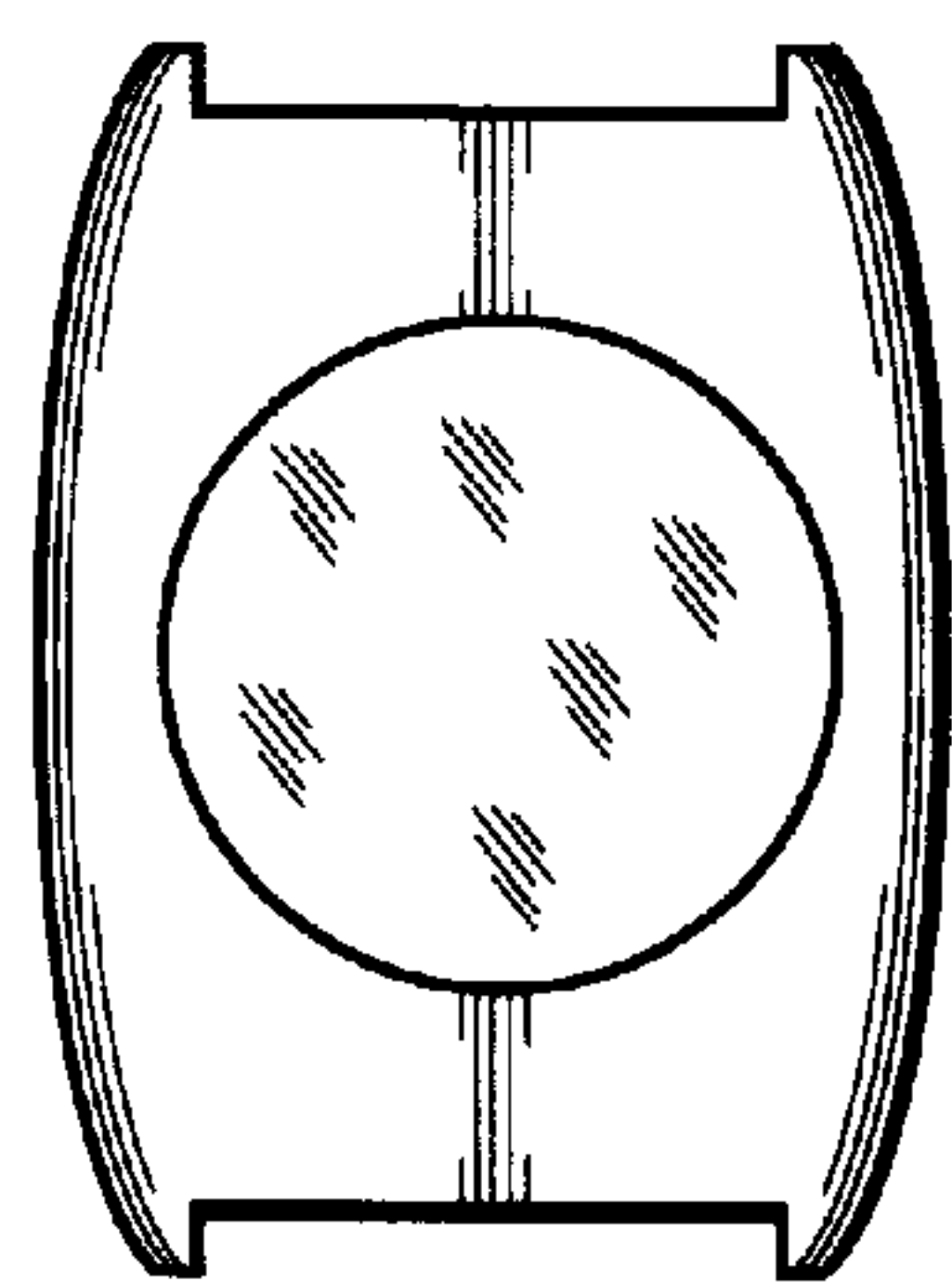

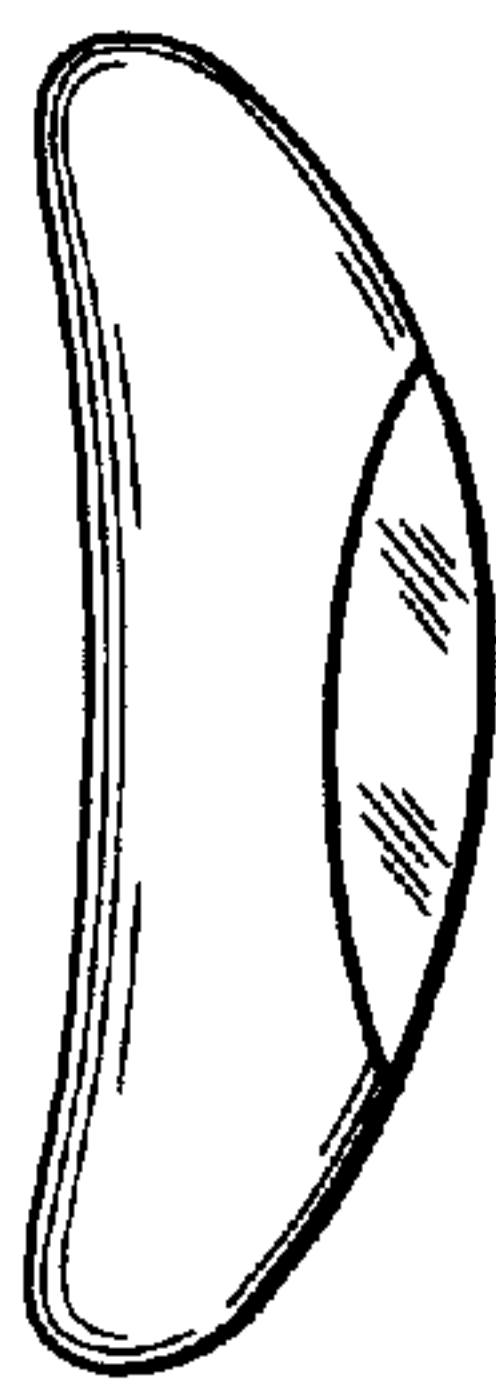

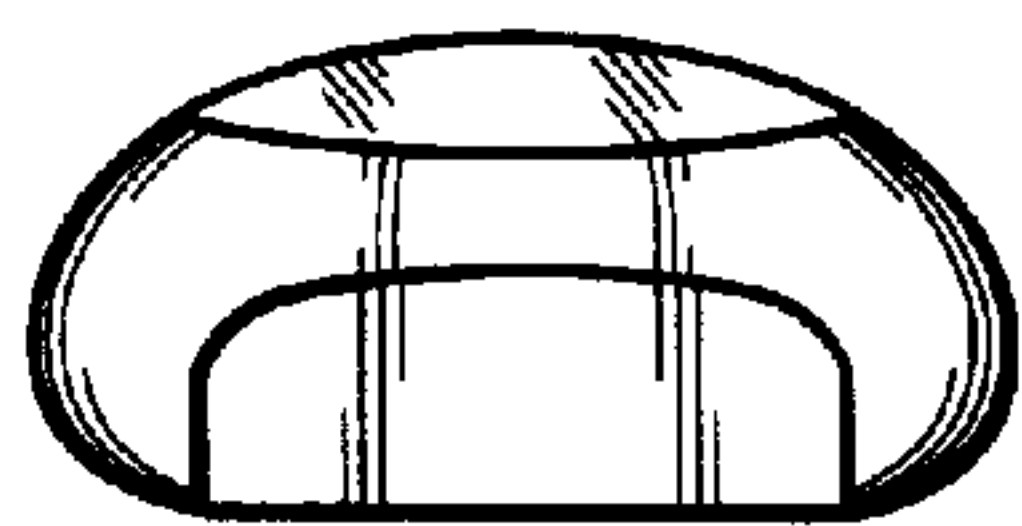
