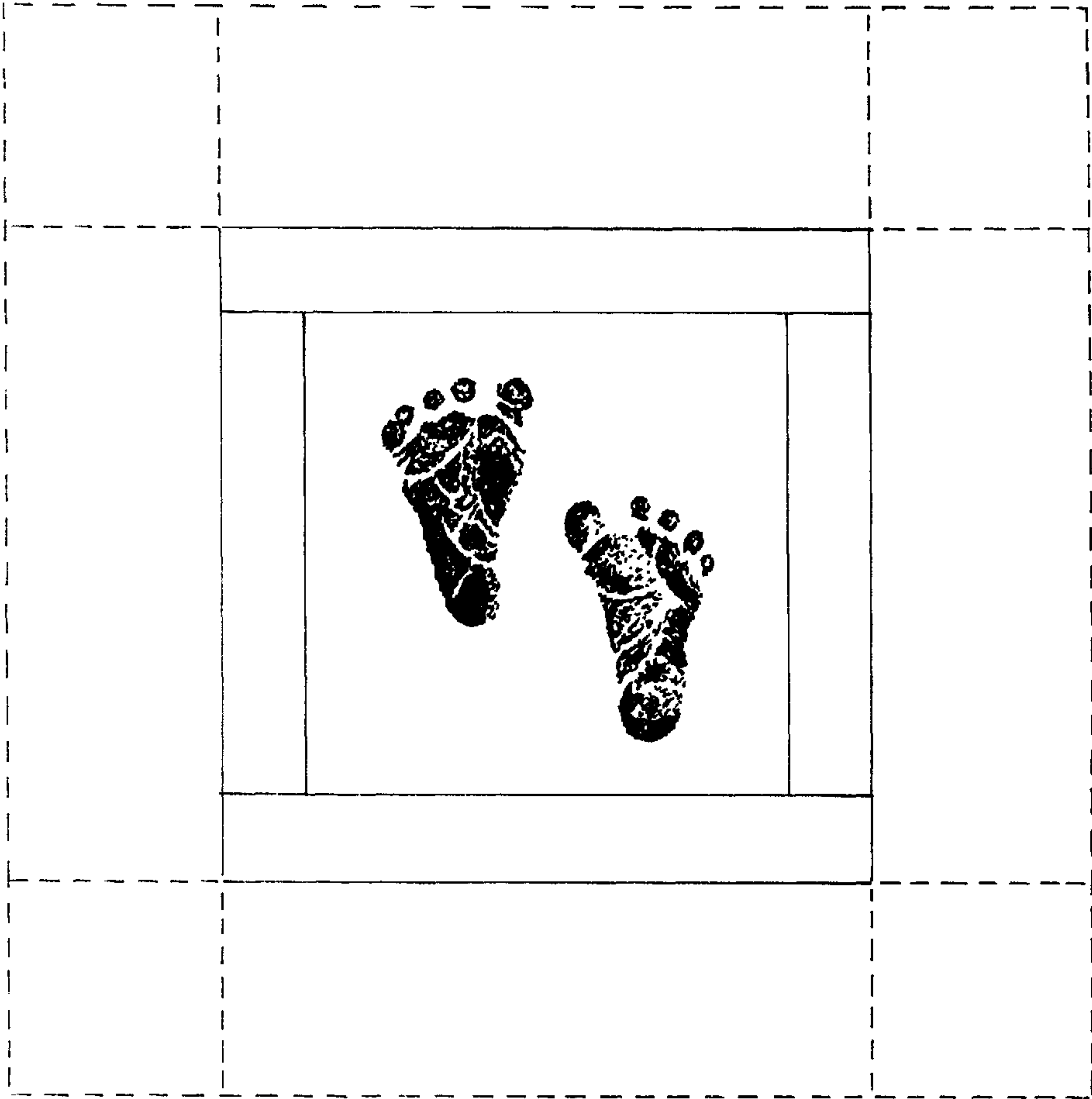

The ornamental design for a children’s pillow, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a children’s pillow showing our
new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of the pillow of the invention;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the pillow of the invention,
wherein the other side is a mirror image; and,
FIG. 4 is a top elevation view of the pillow of the invention,
wherein the bottom is a mirror image.

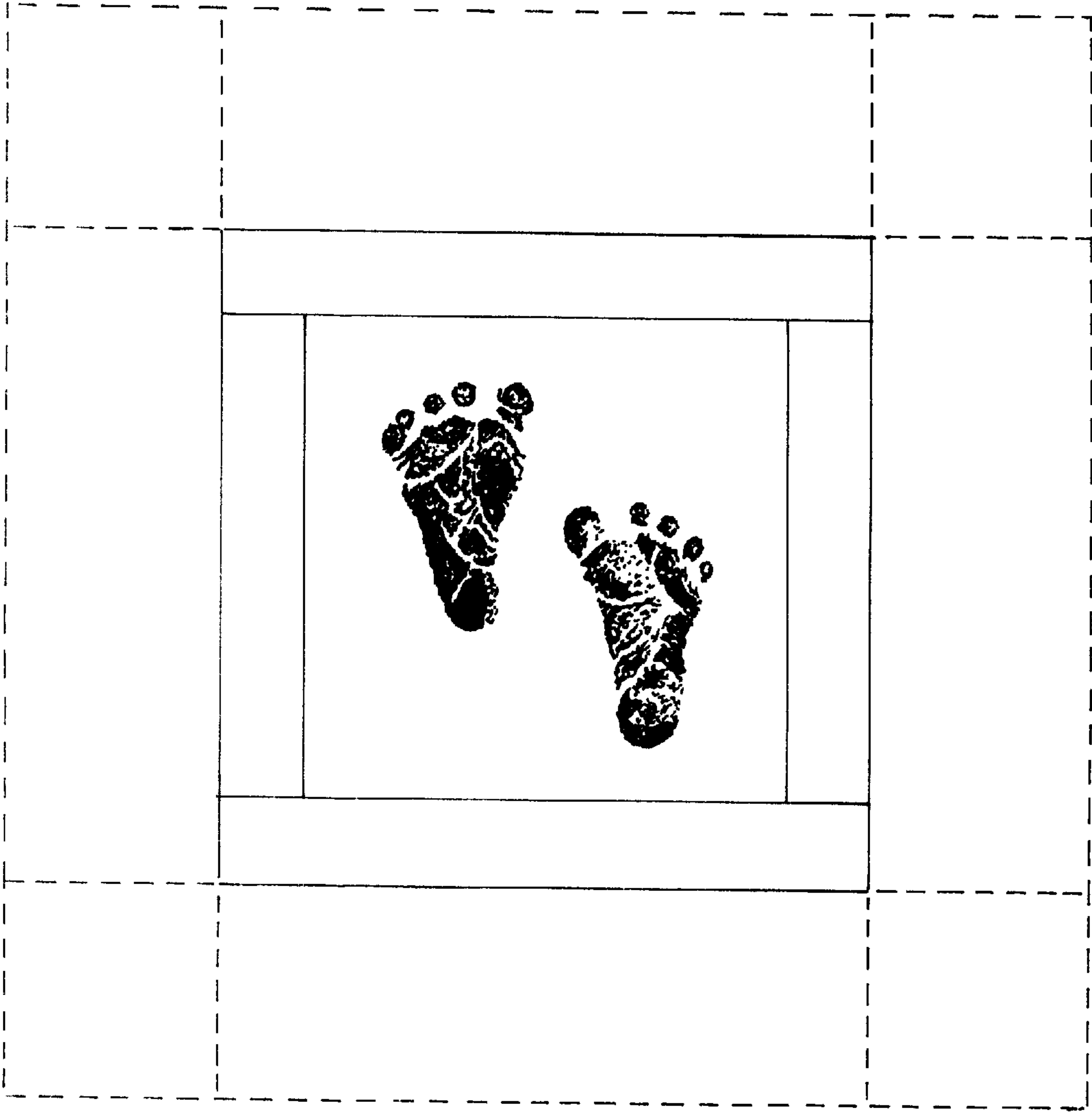

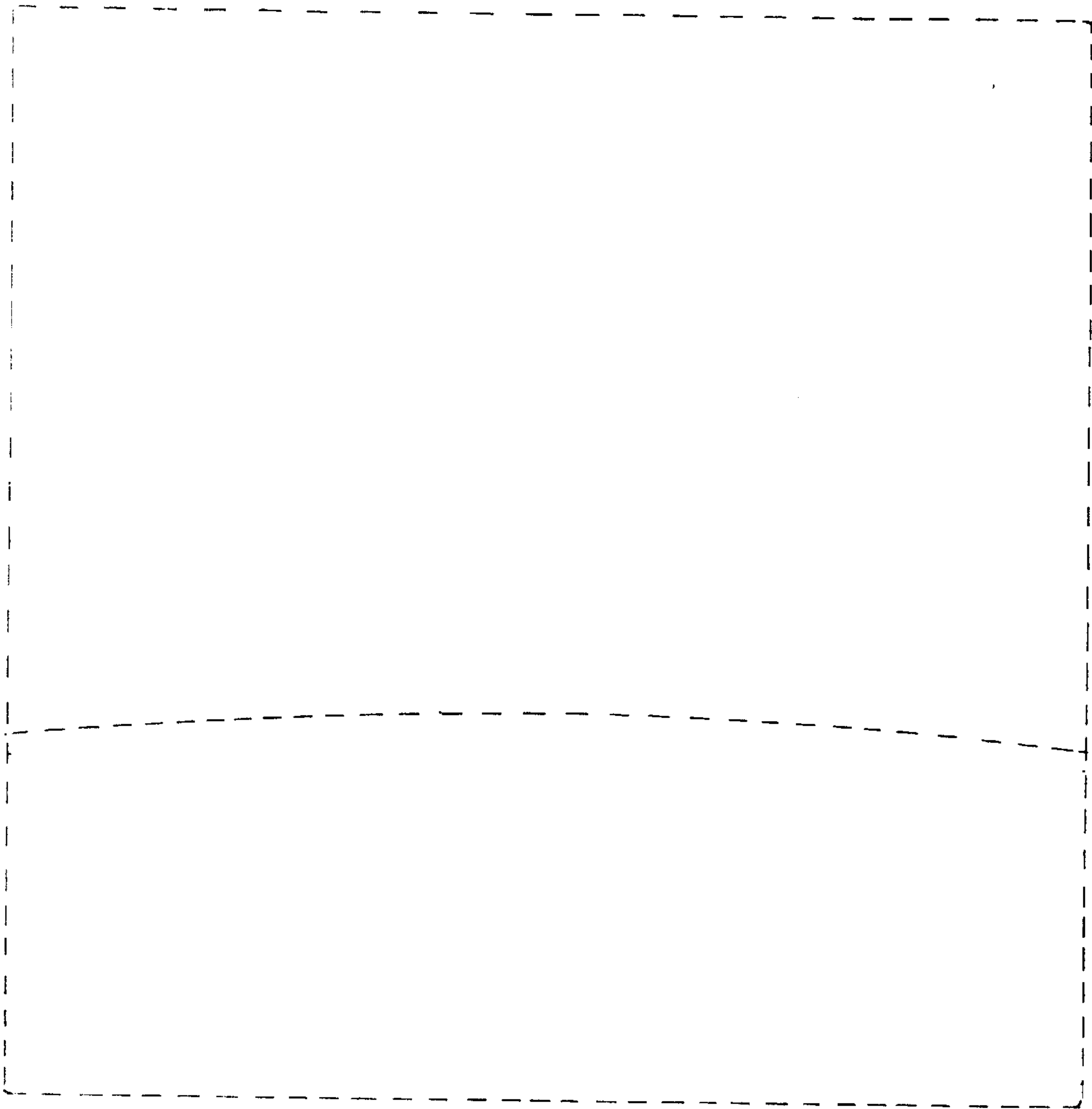

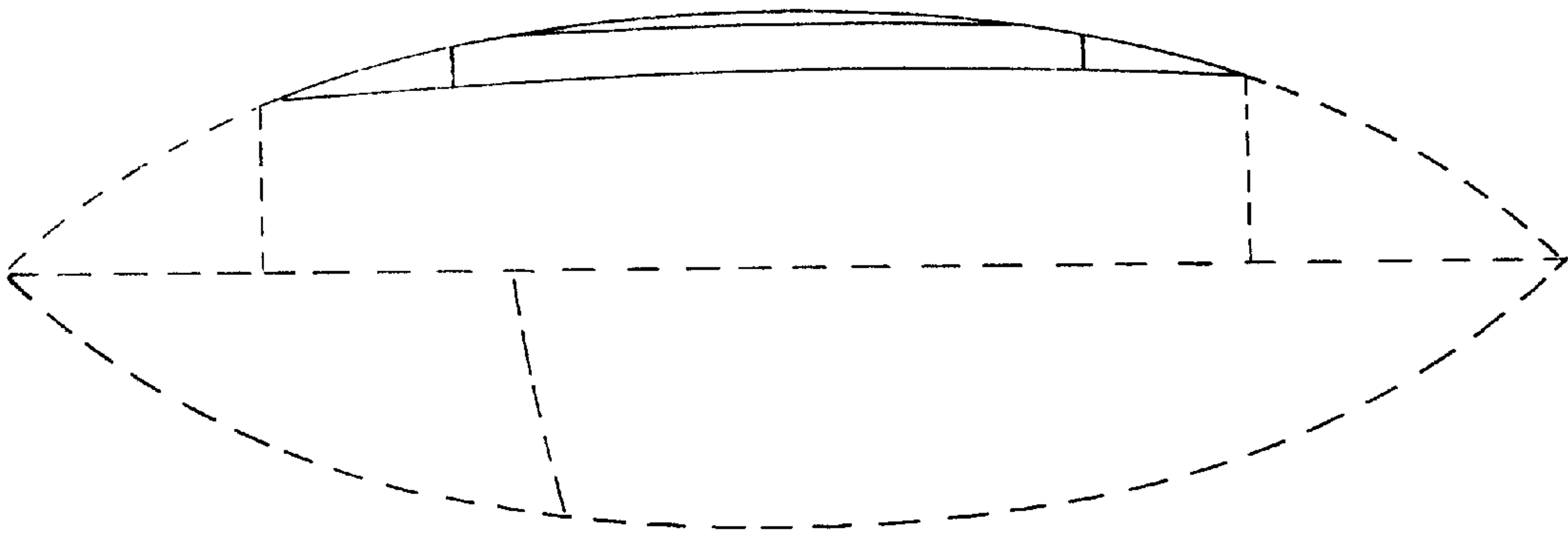

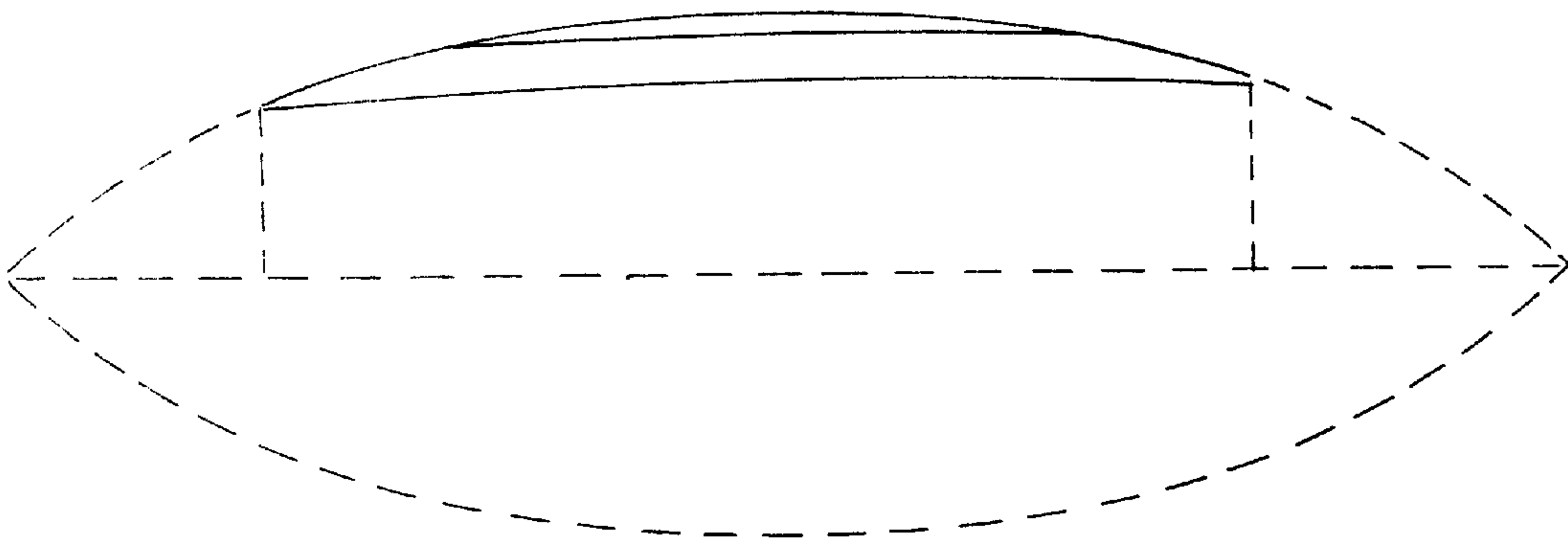
