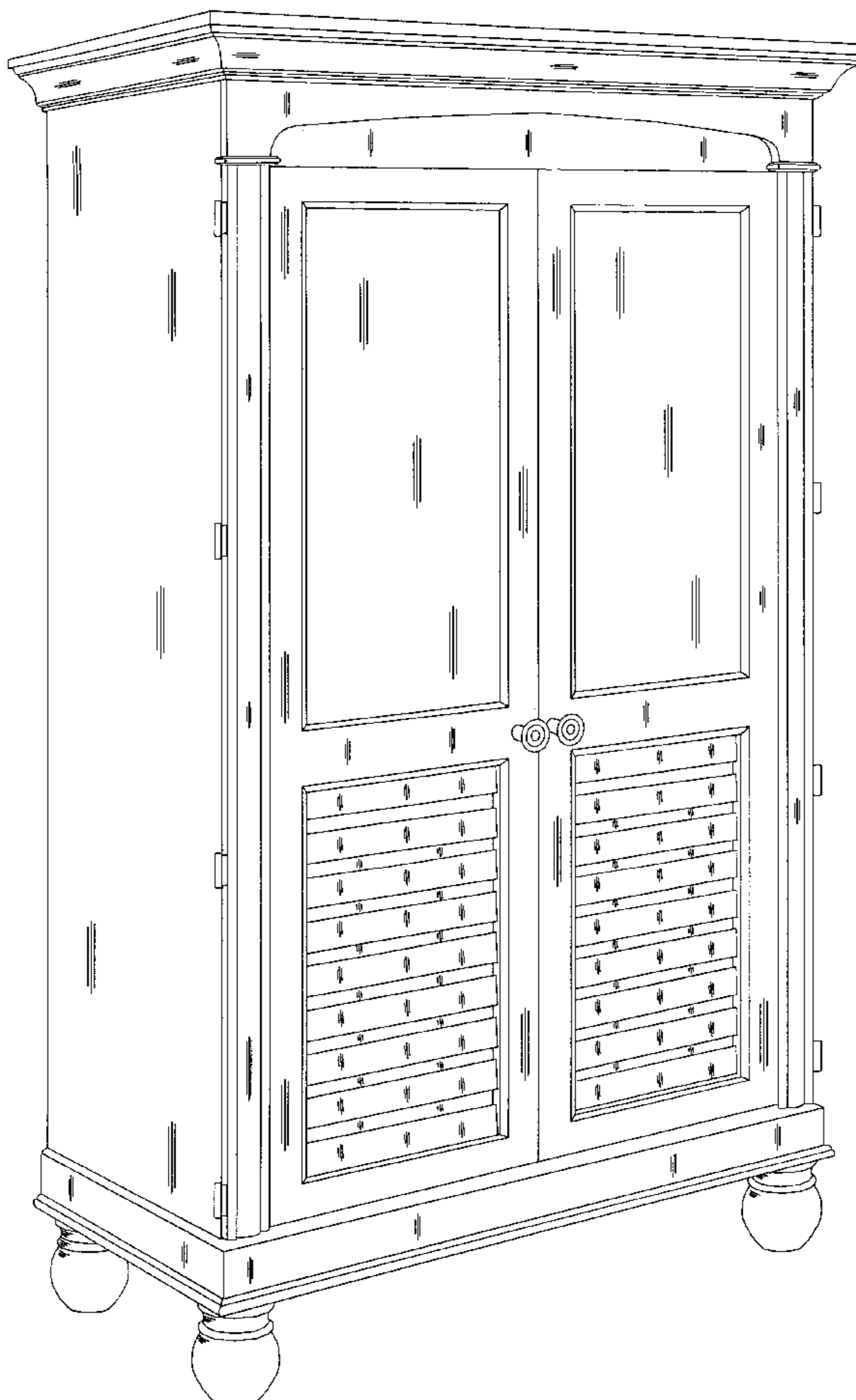
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the armoire of FIG. 1, the other side being a mirror image; and,

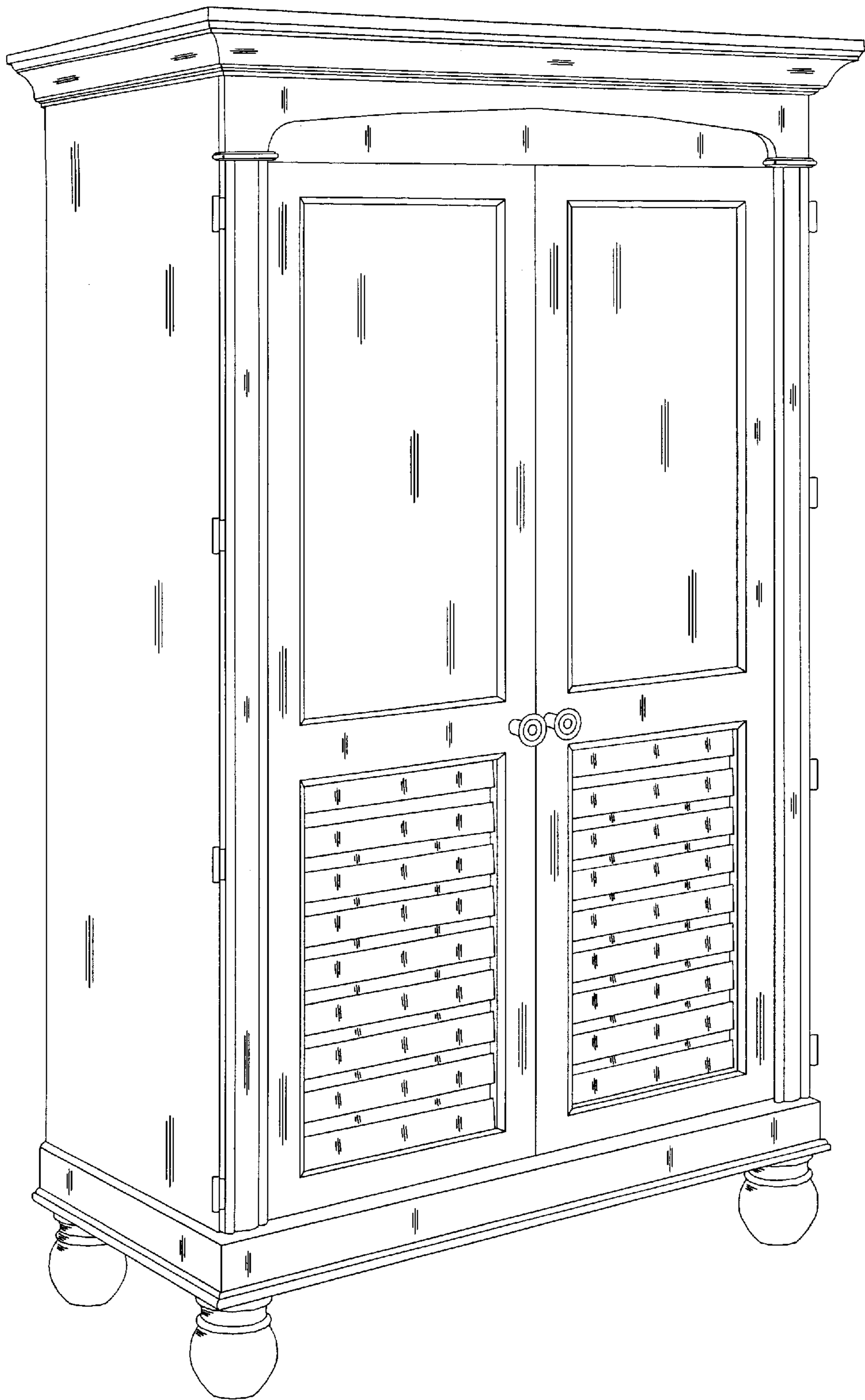

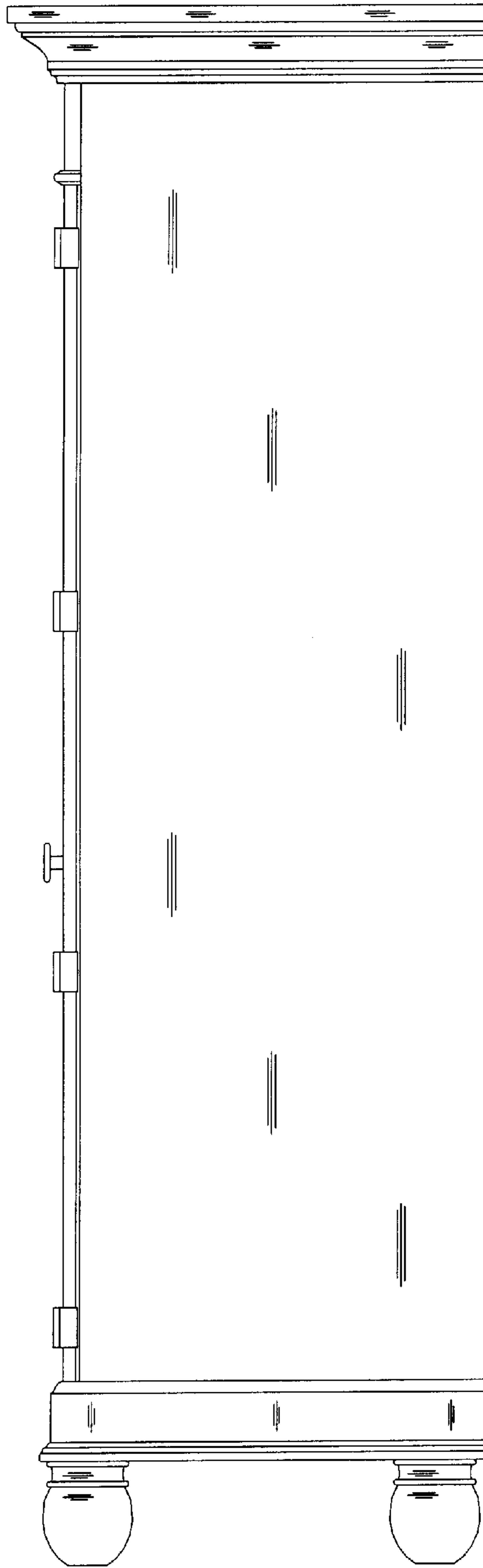

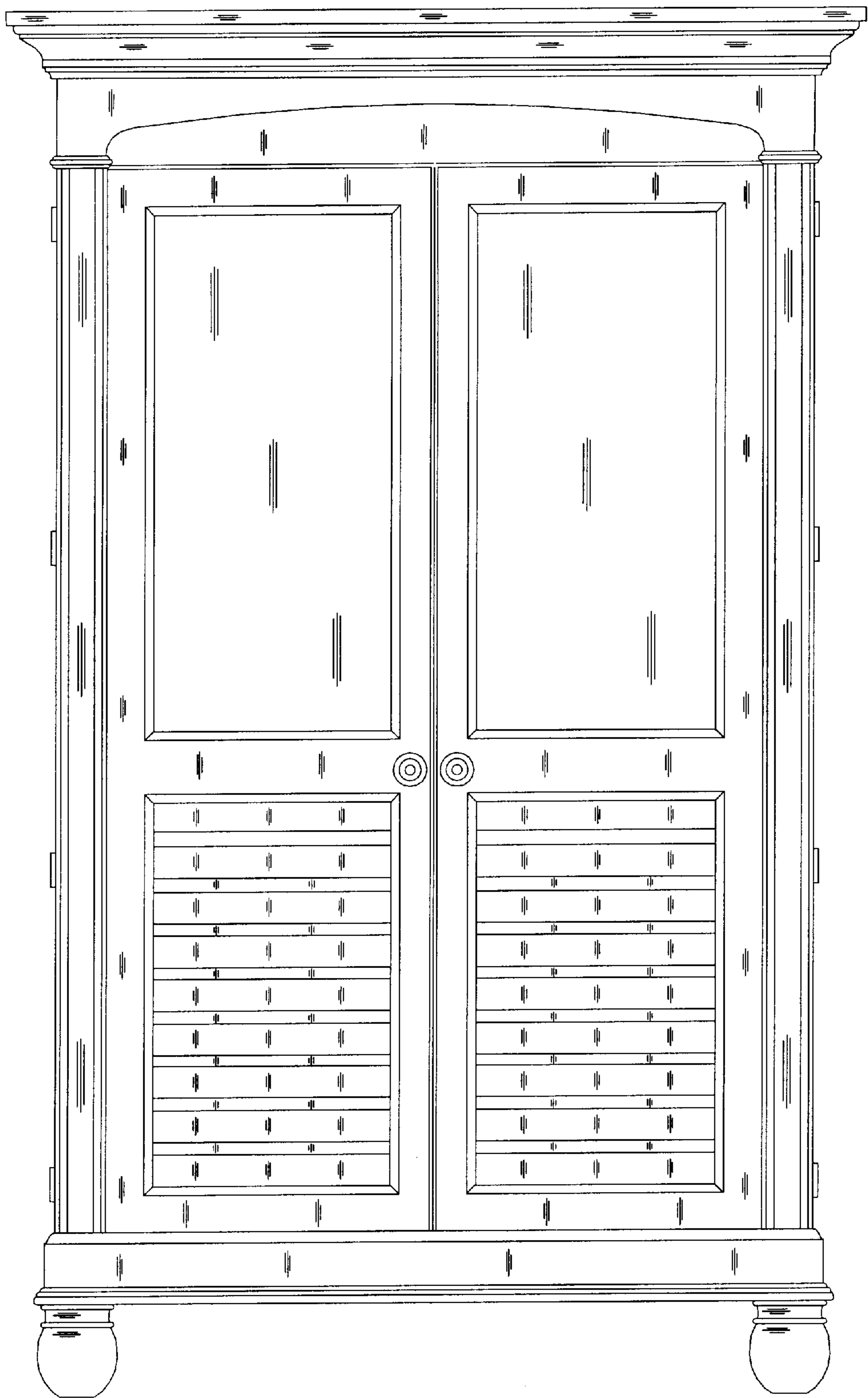
