FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the invention, facing top down.

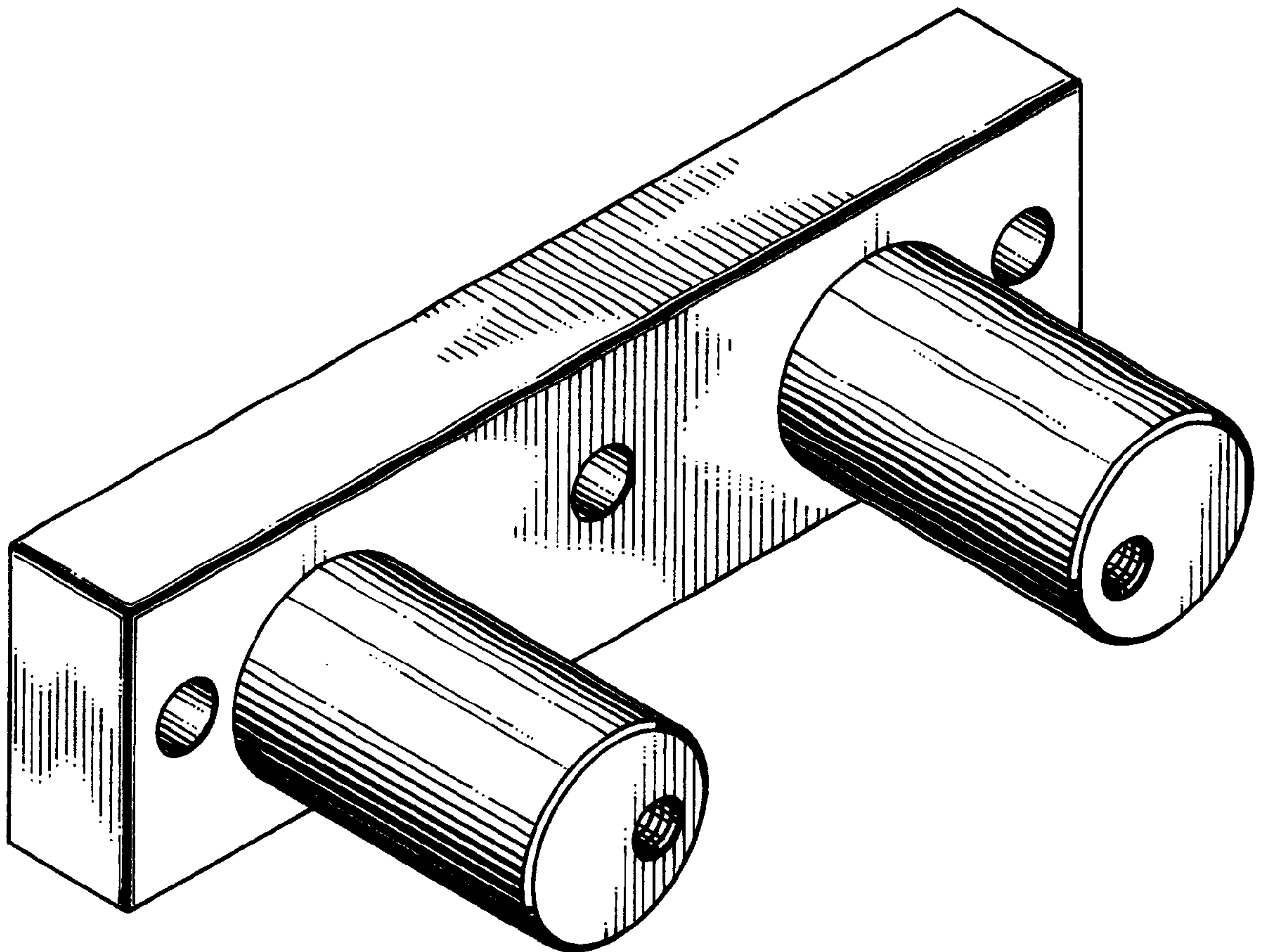
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the invention, facing bottom down.

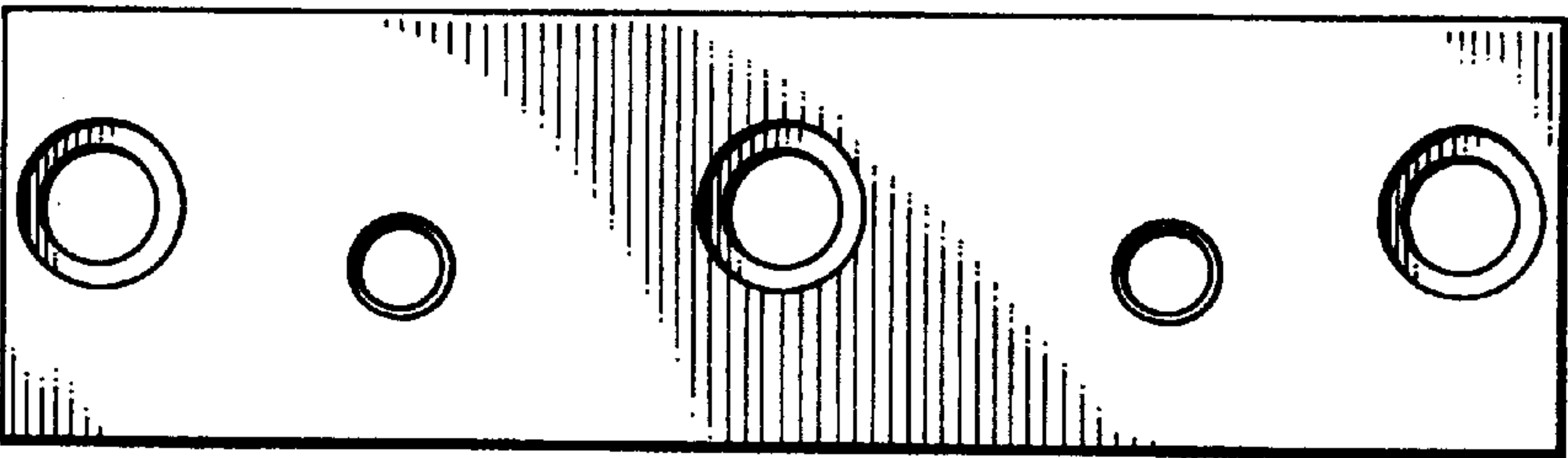
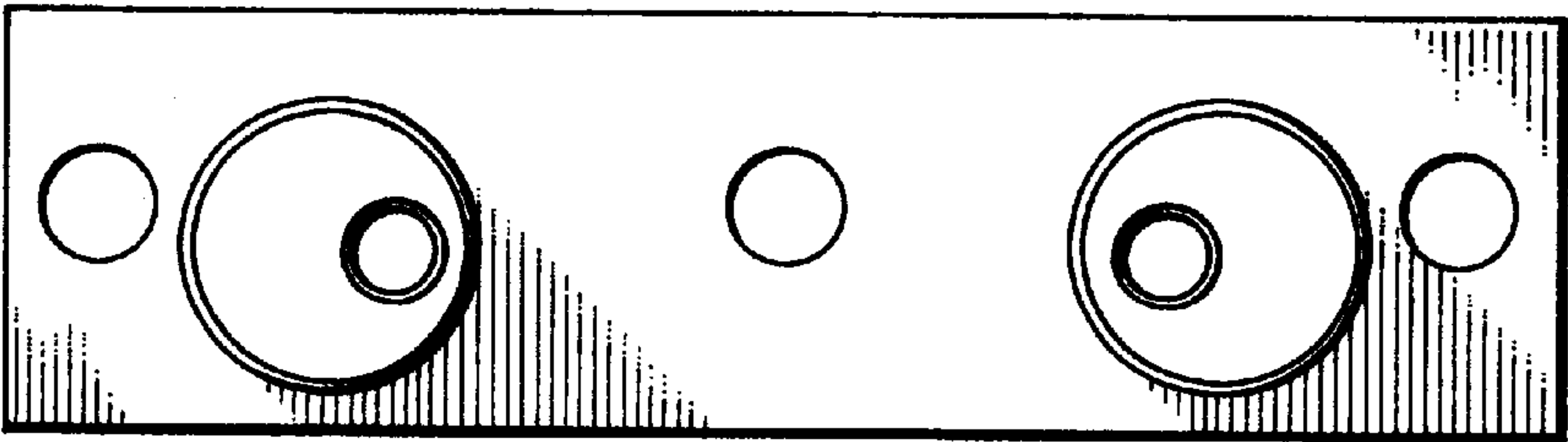
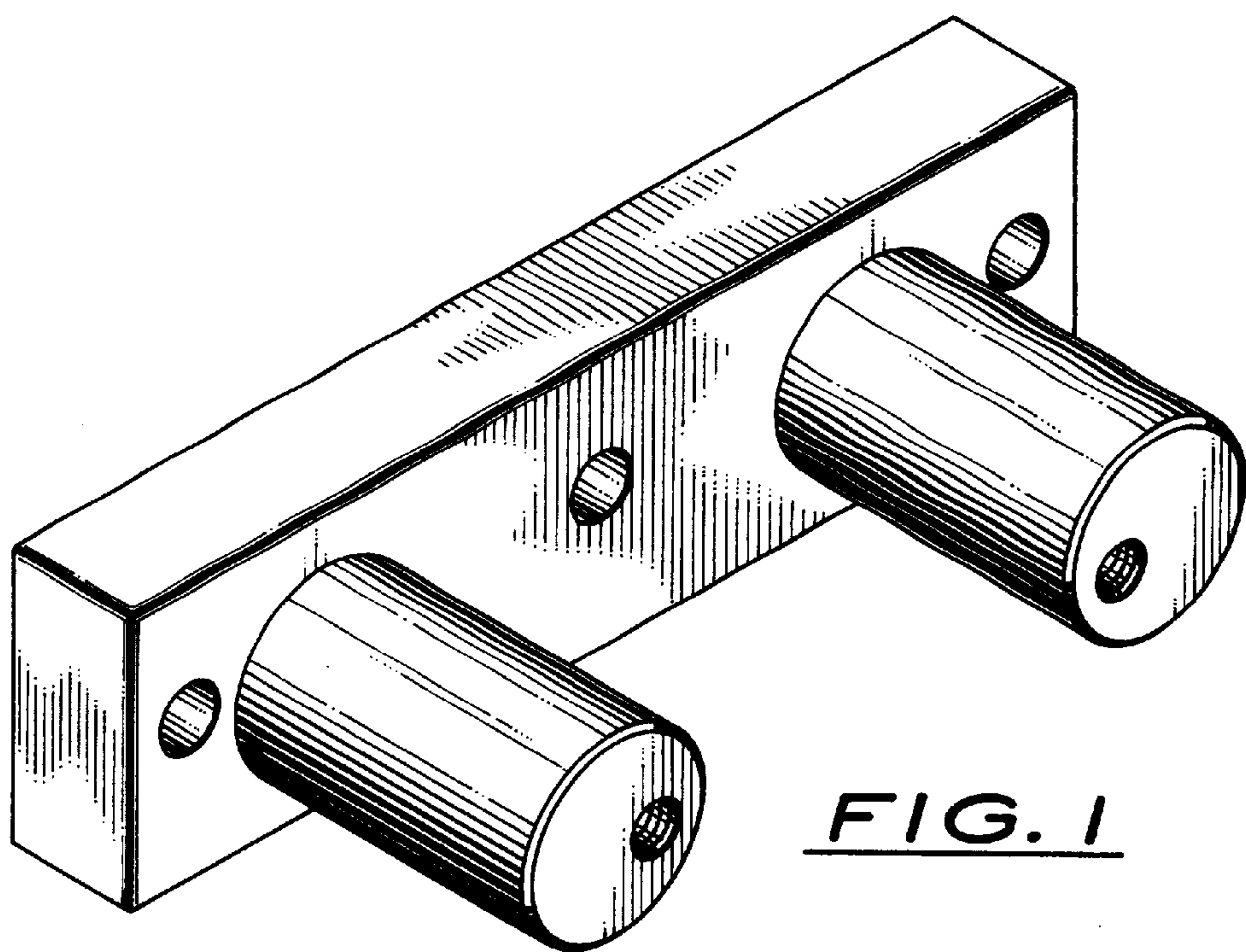
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the replaceable vice jaw lining.

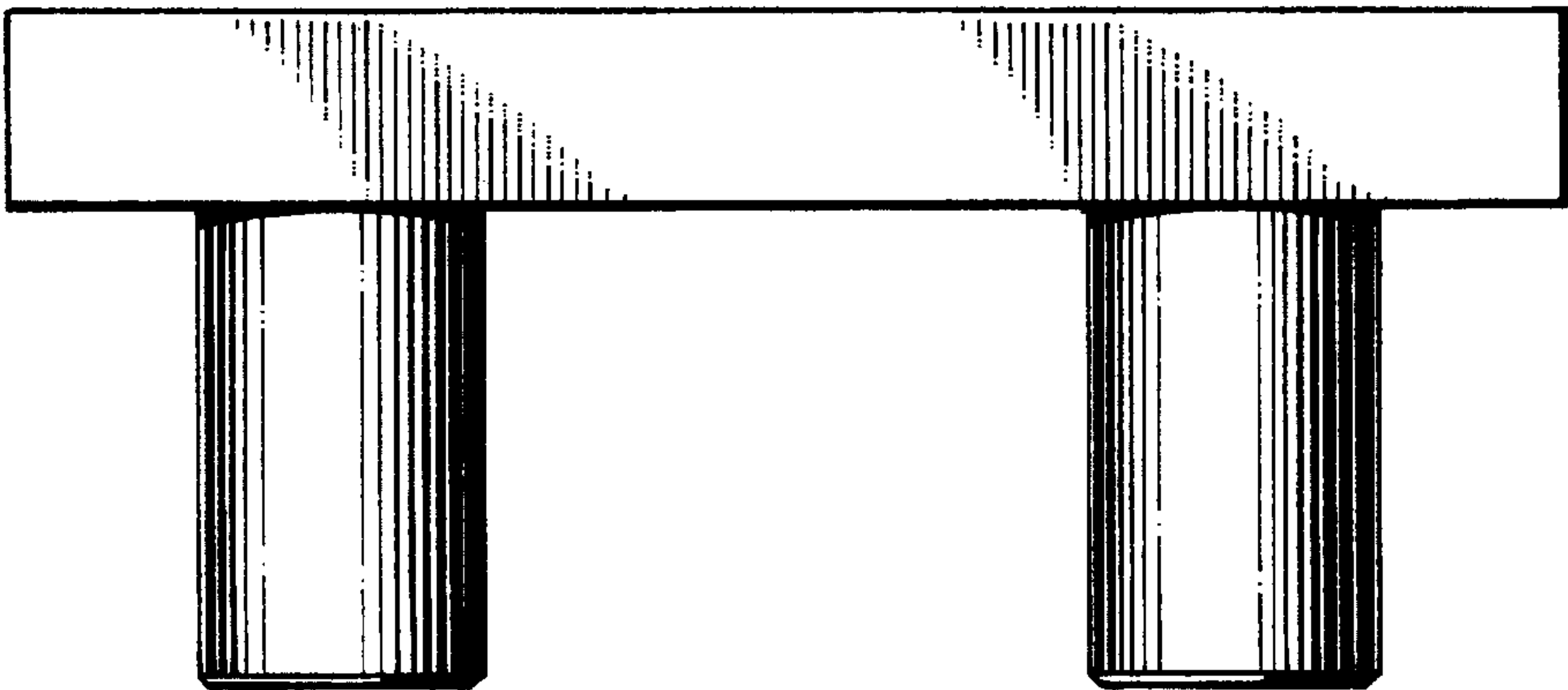

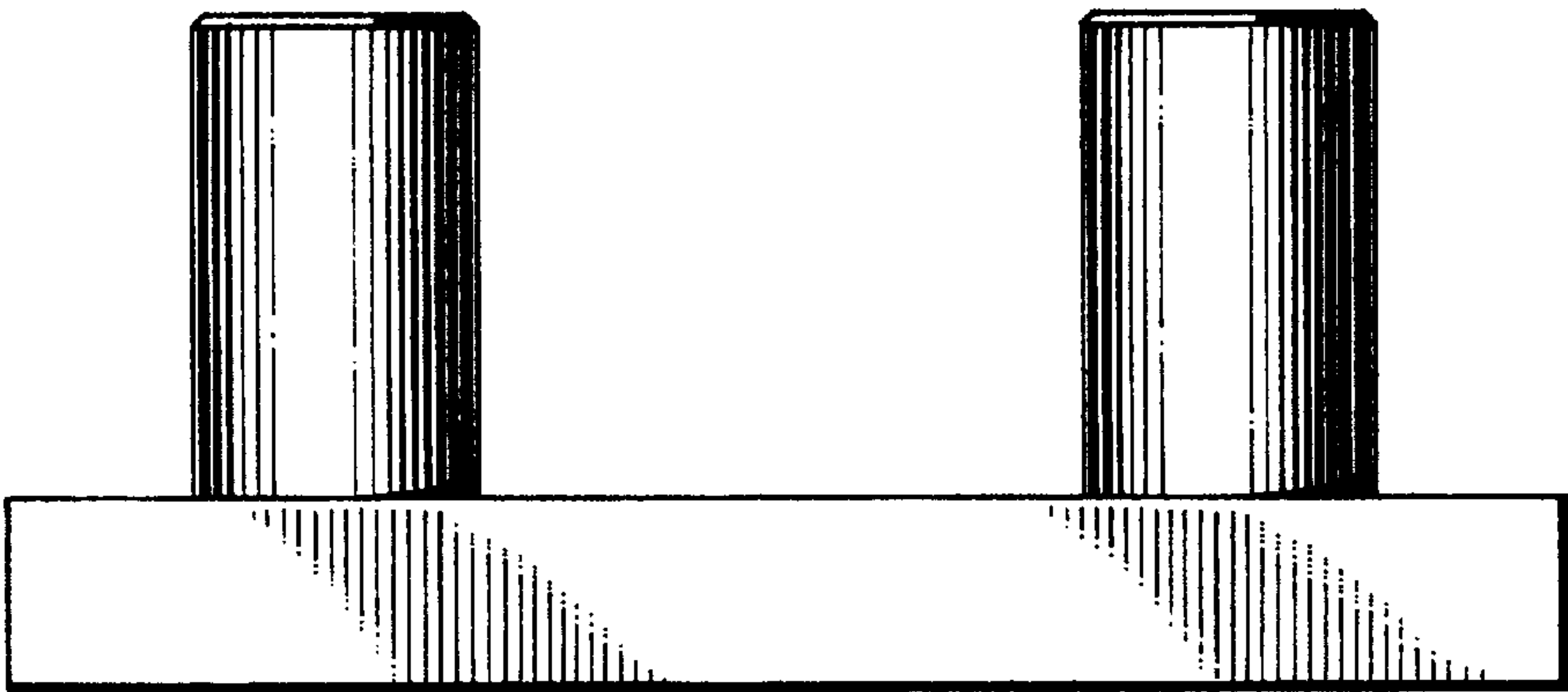

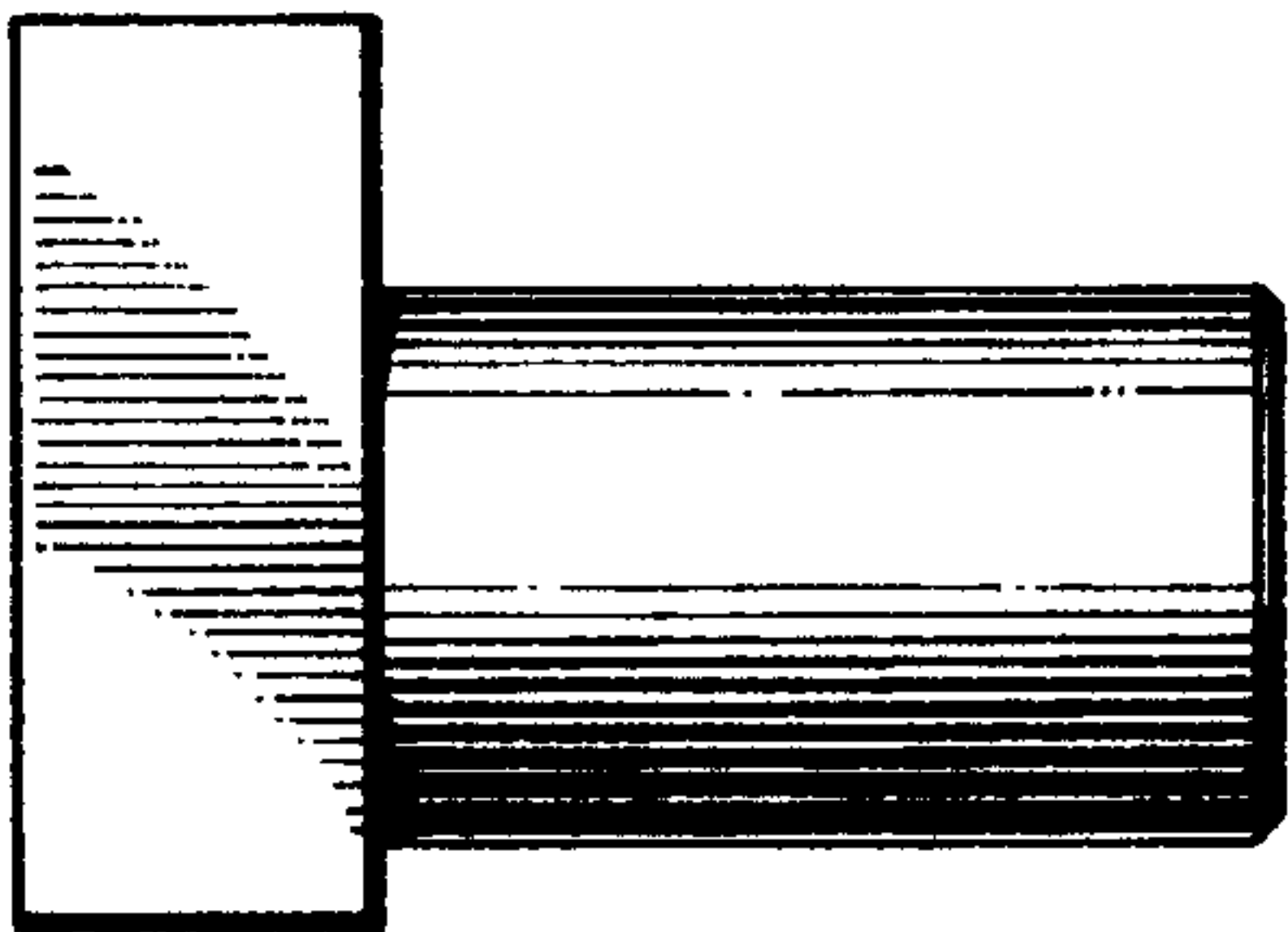

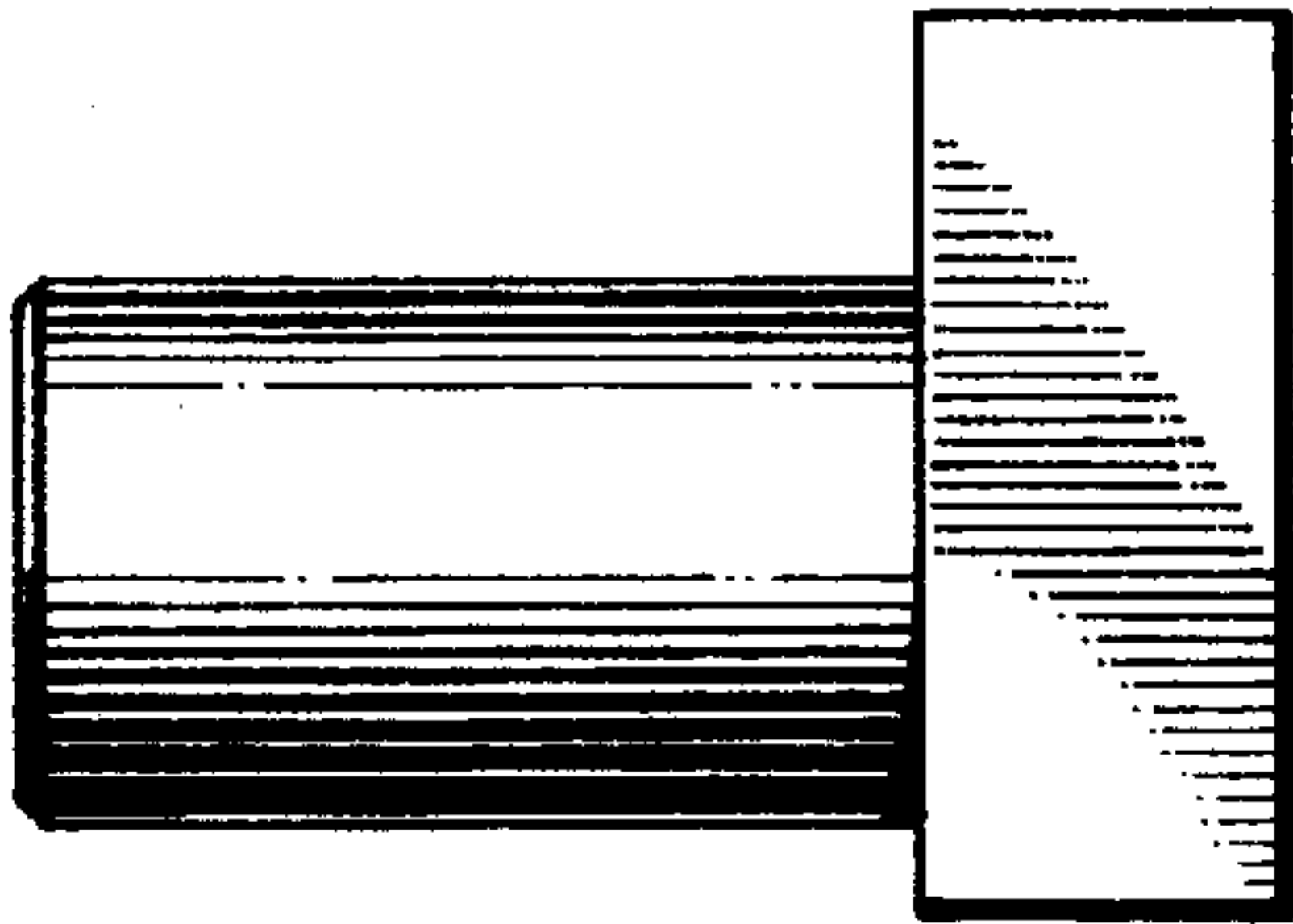
