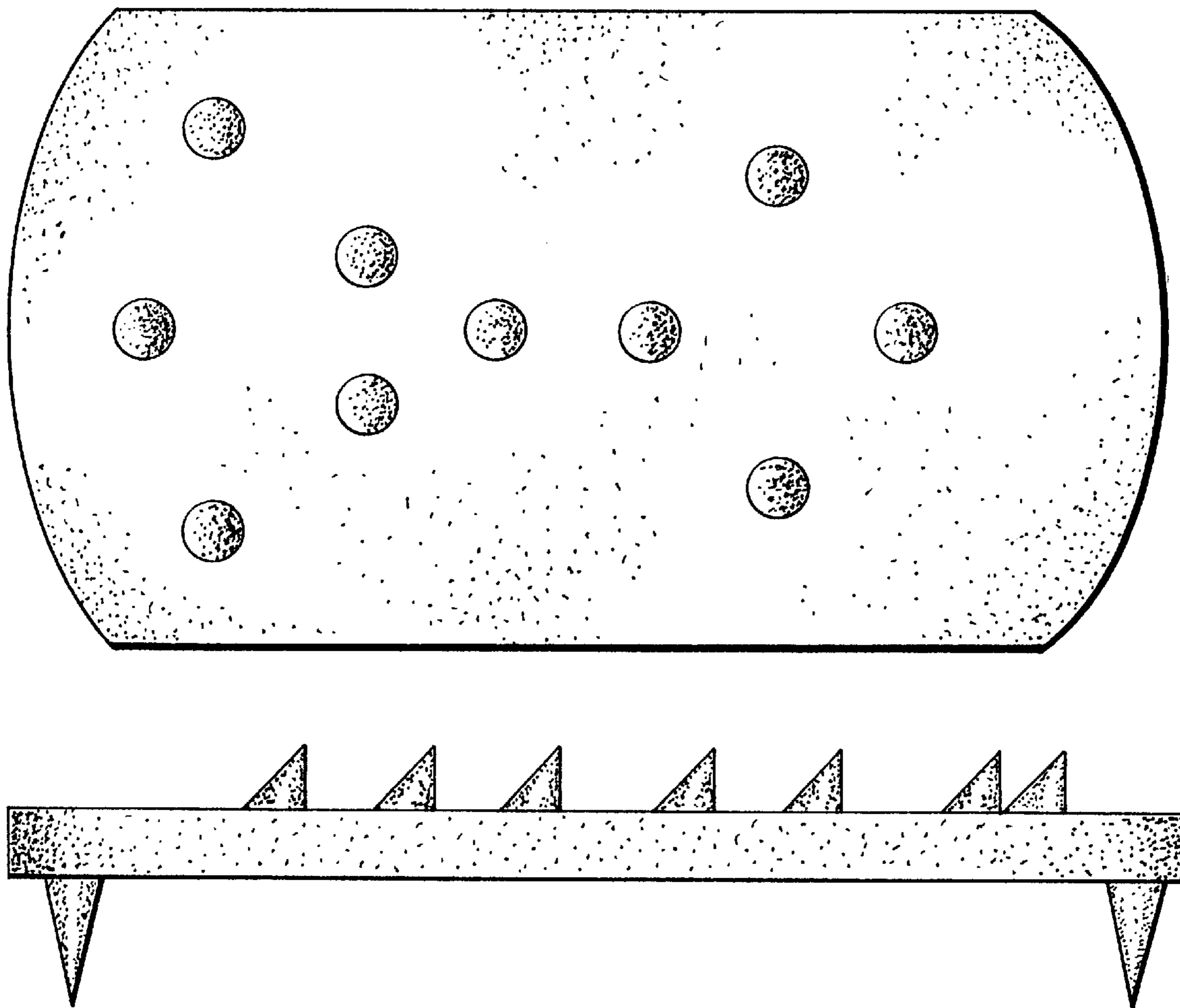
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an athletic shoe cleat cleaner, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an athletic shoe cleat cleaner showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof; and,  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof.

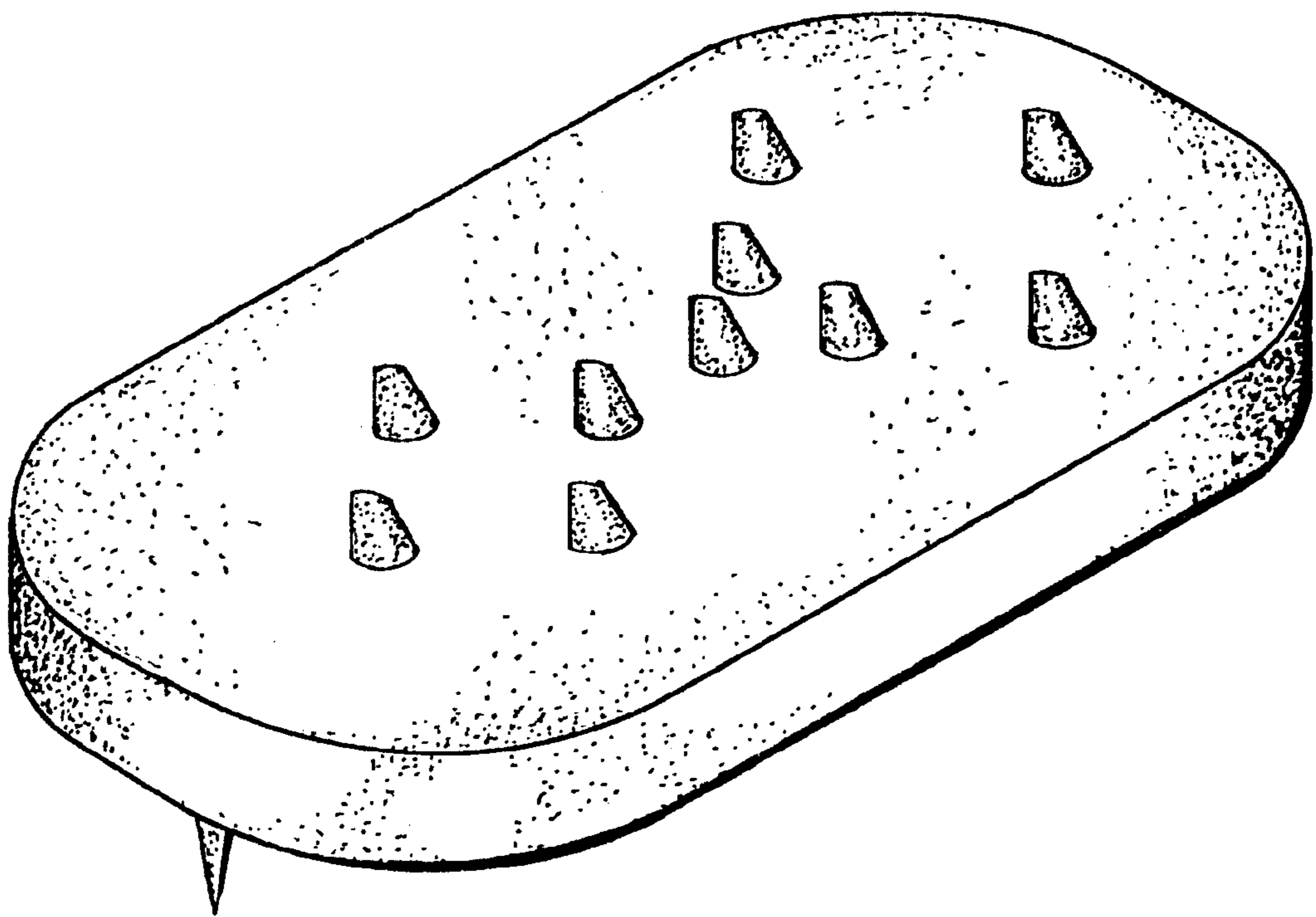

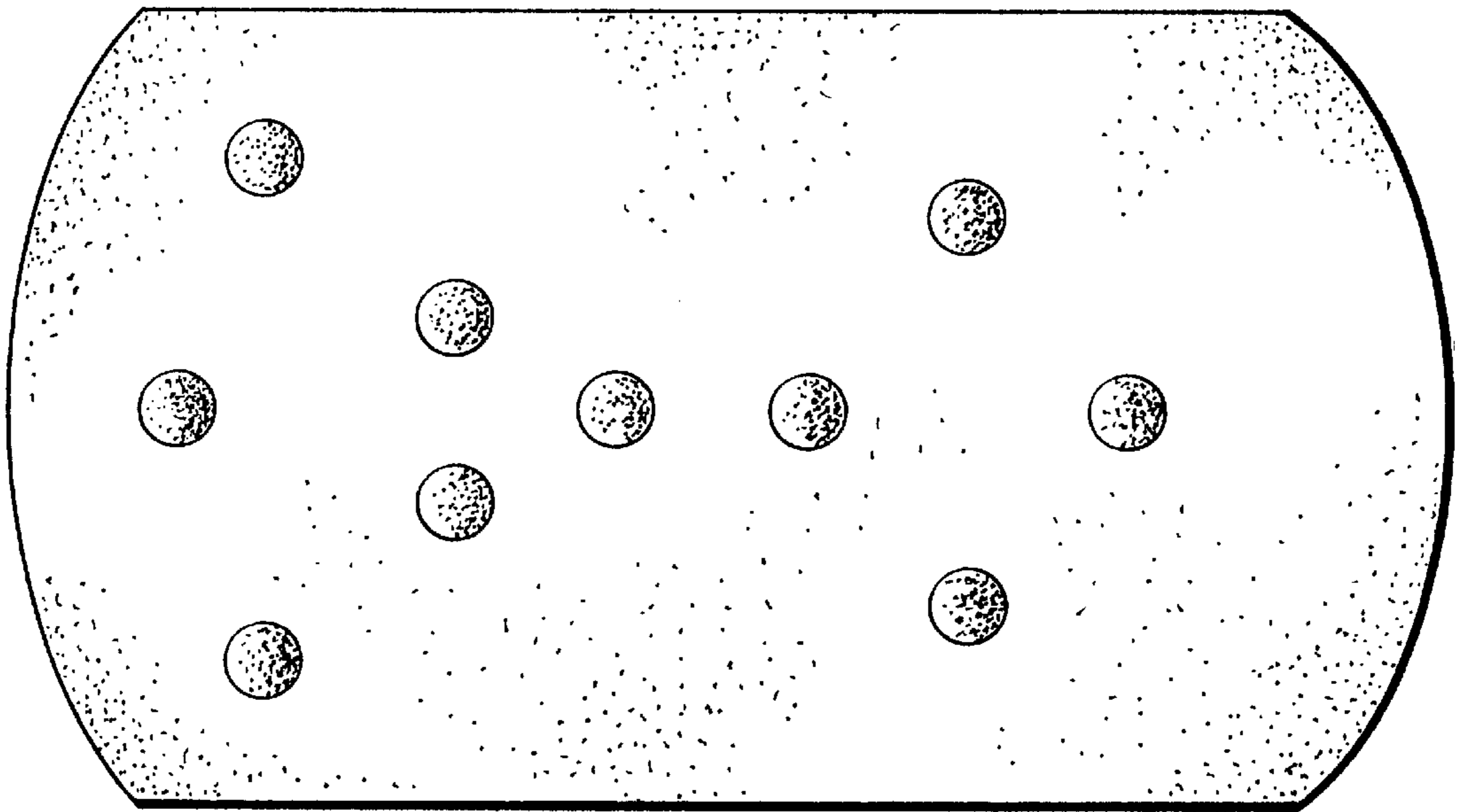

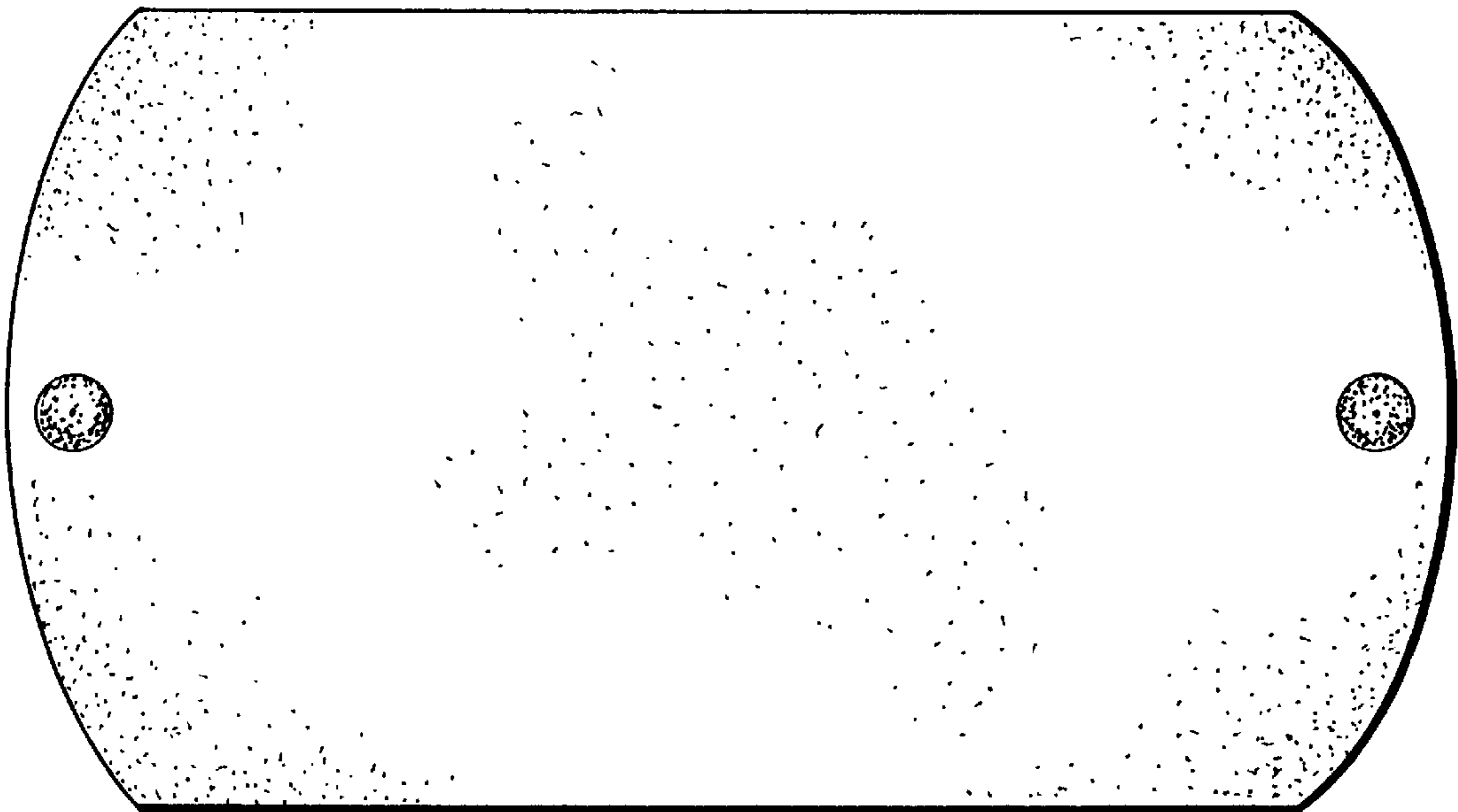

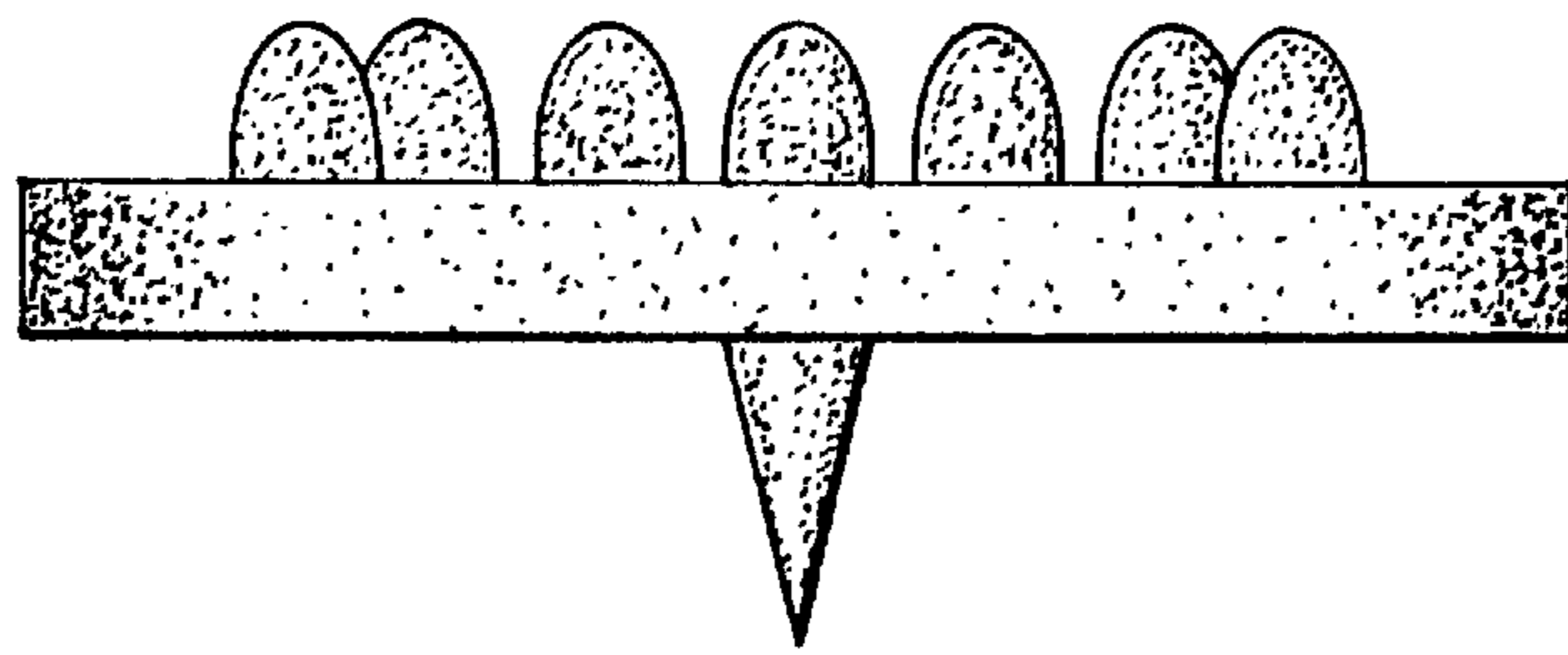

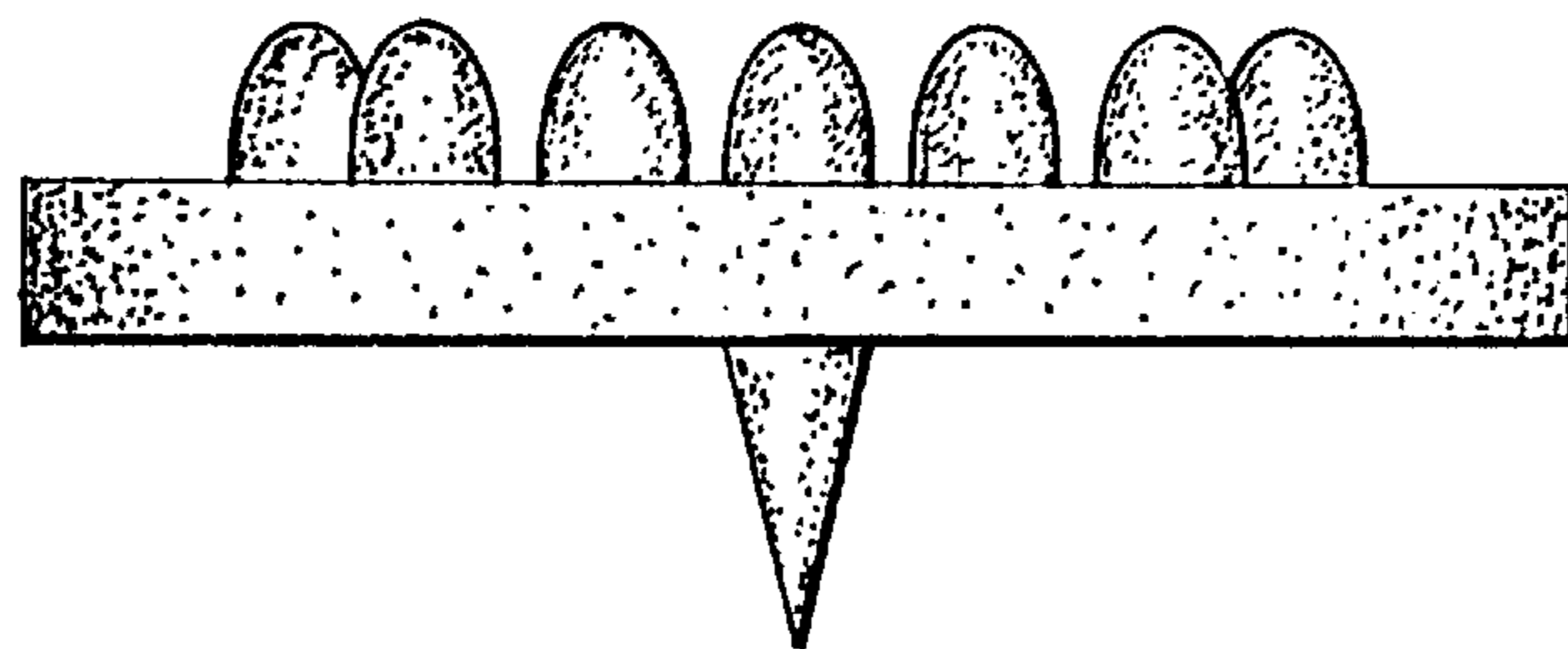

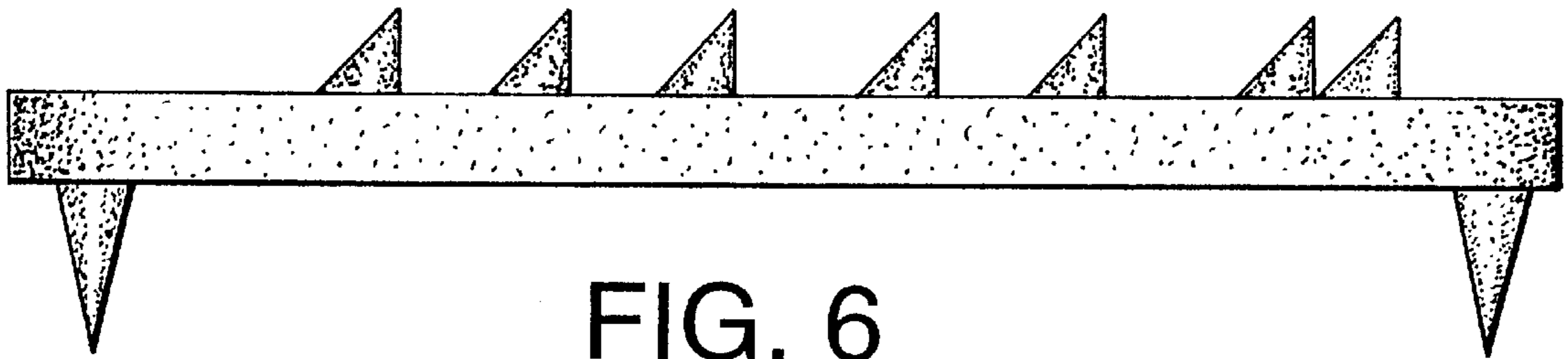

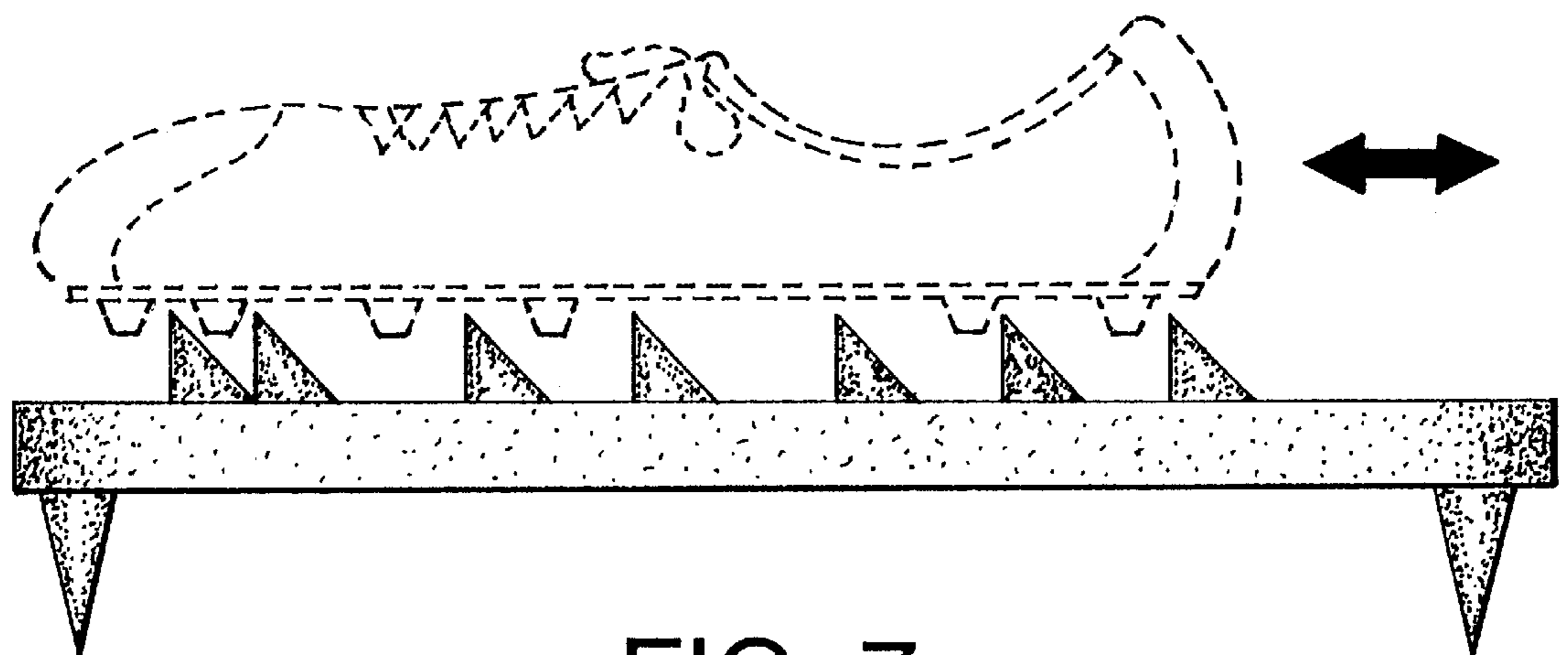
