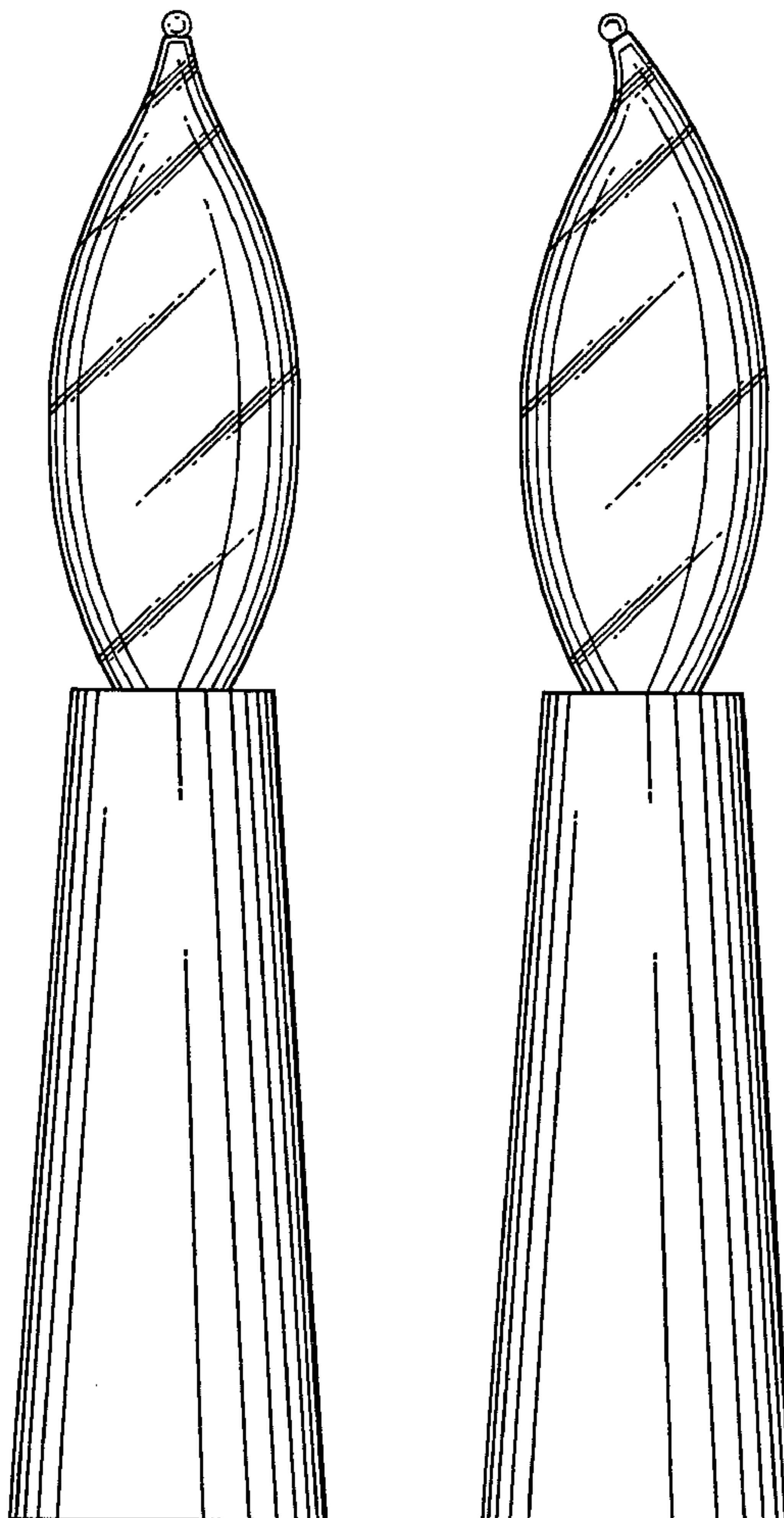
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture;
FIG. 2 is a front view of a first embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of a first embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture; and the right side view is a mirror image thereof.
FIG. 4 is a back view of a first embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of a first embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture;
FIG. 6 is a top view of a second embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture;
FIG. 7 is a side view of the second embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the second embodiment of a tapered lamp for a lighting fixture.

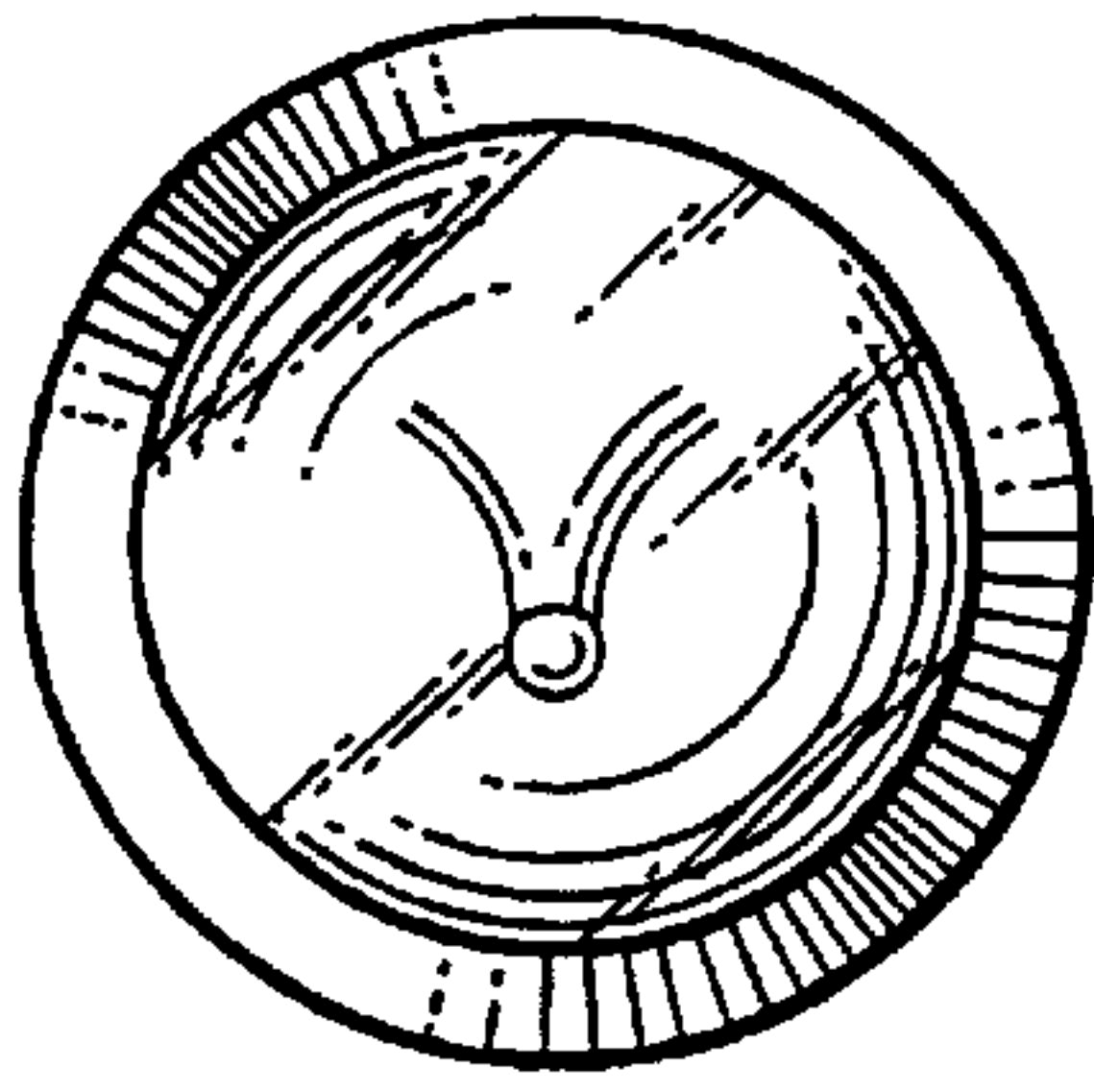

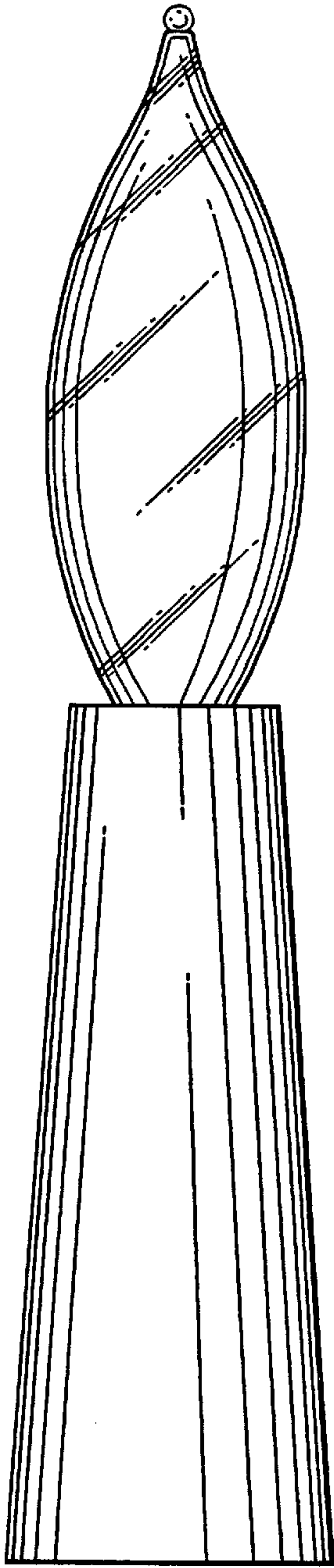
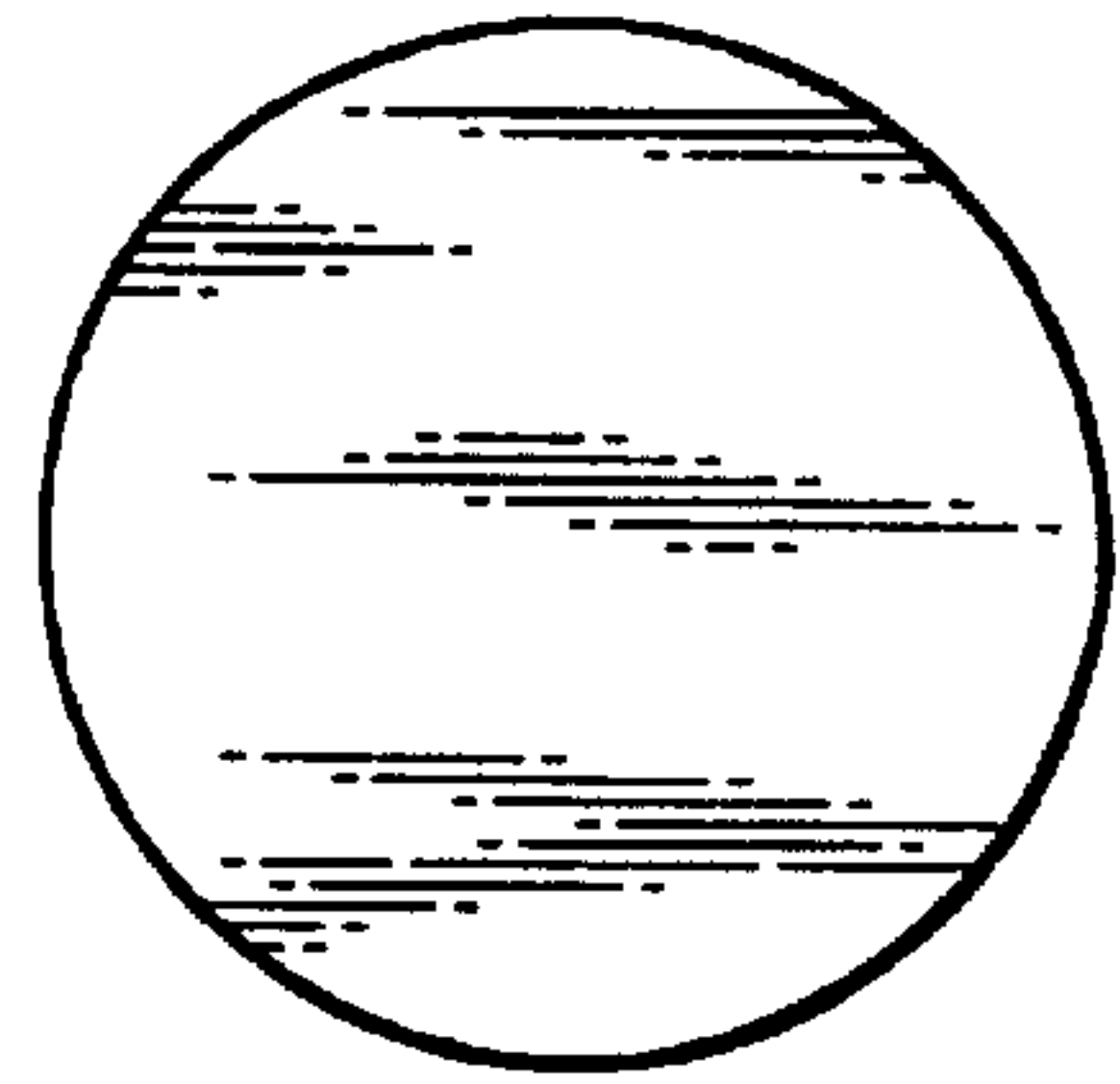

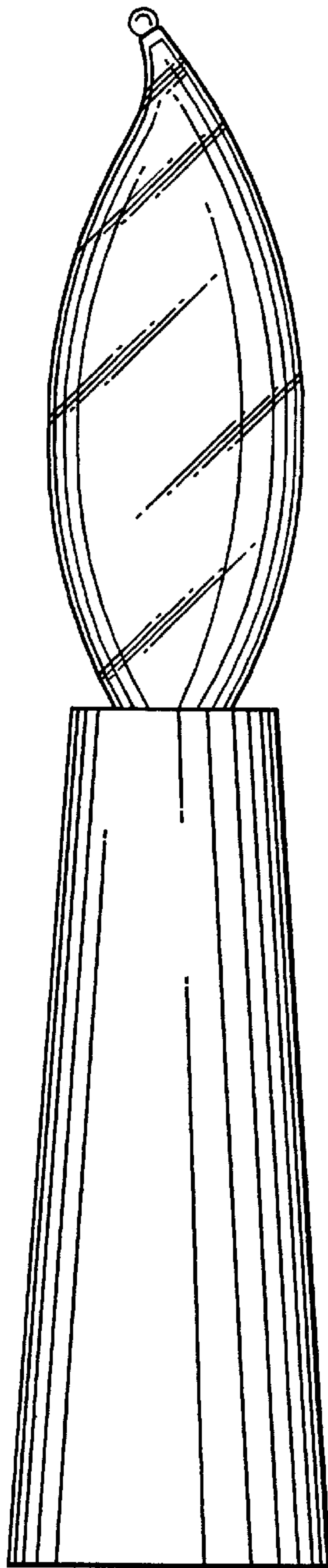

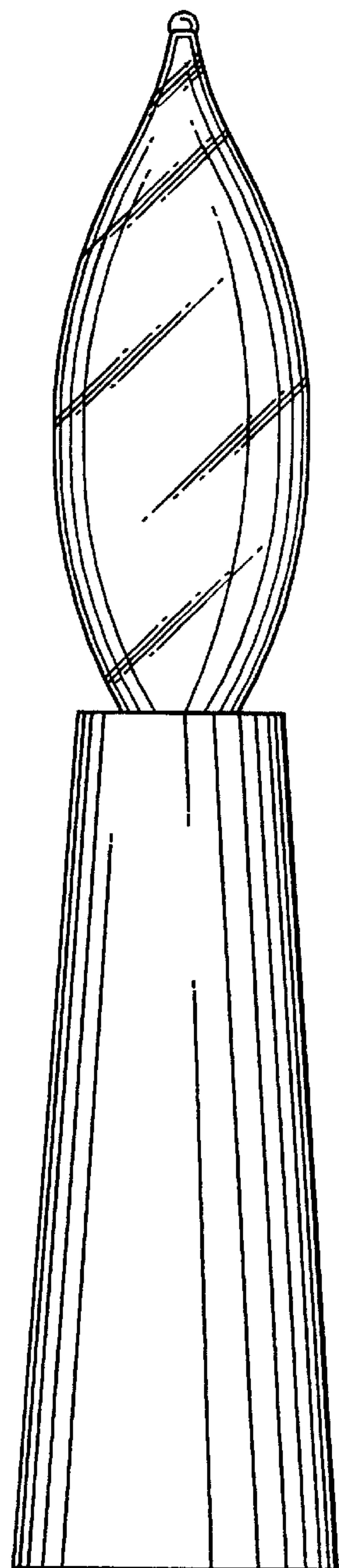

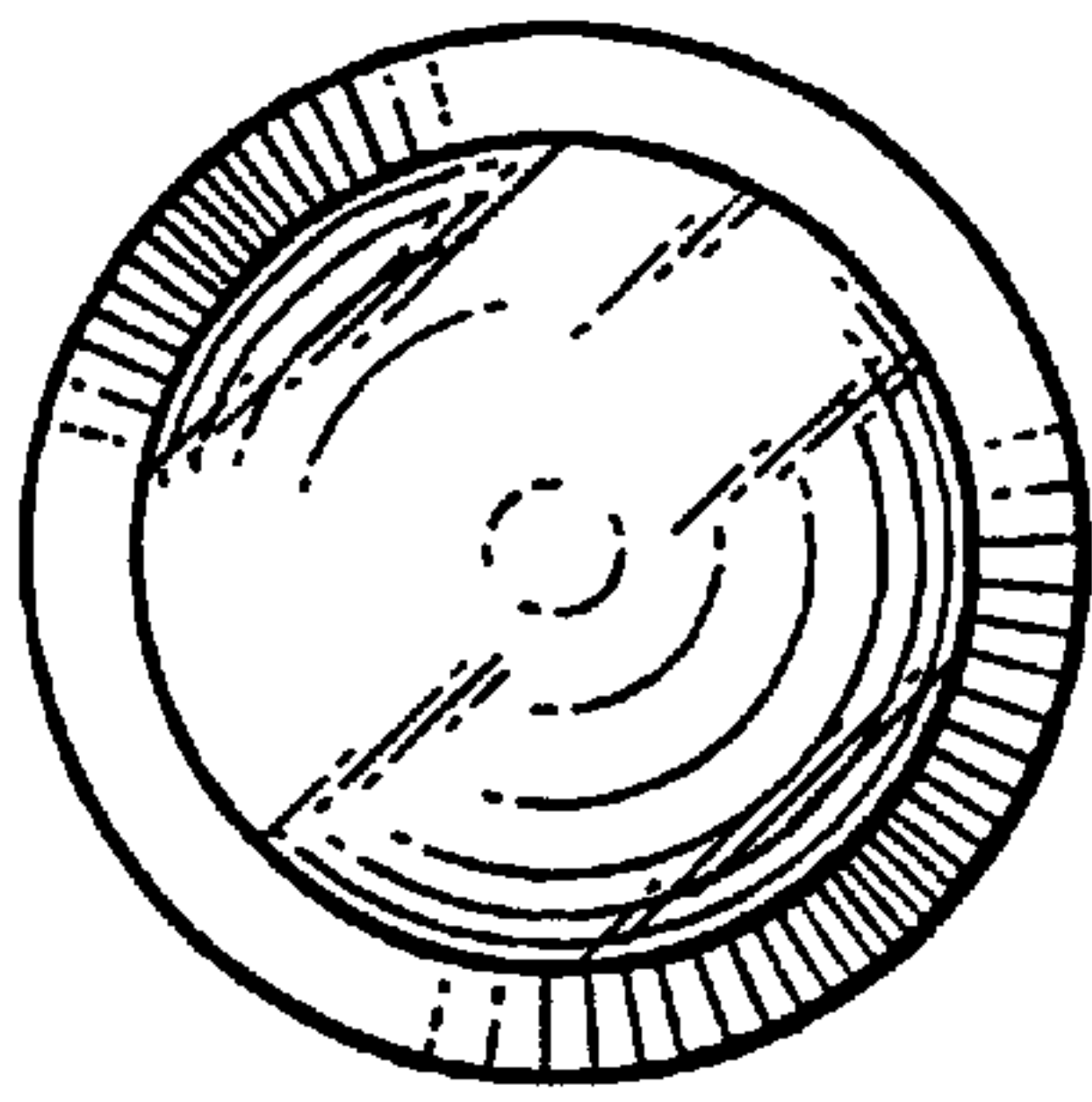

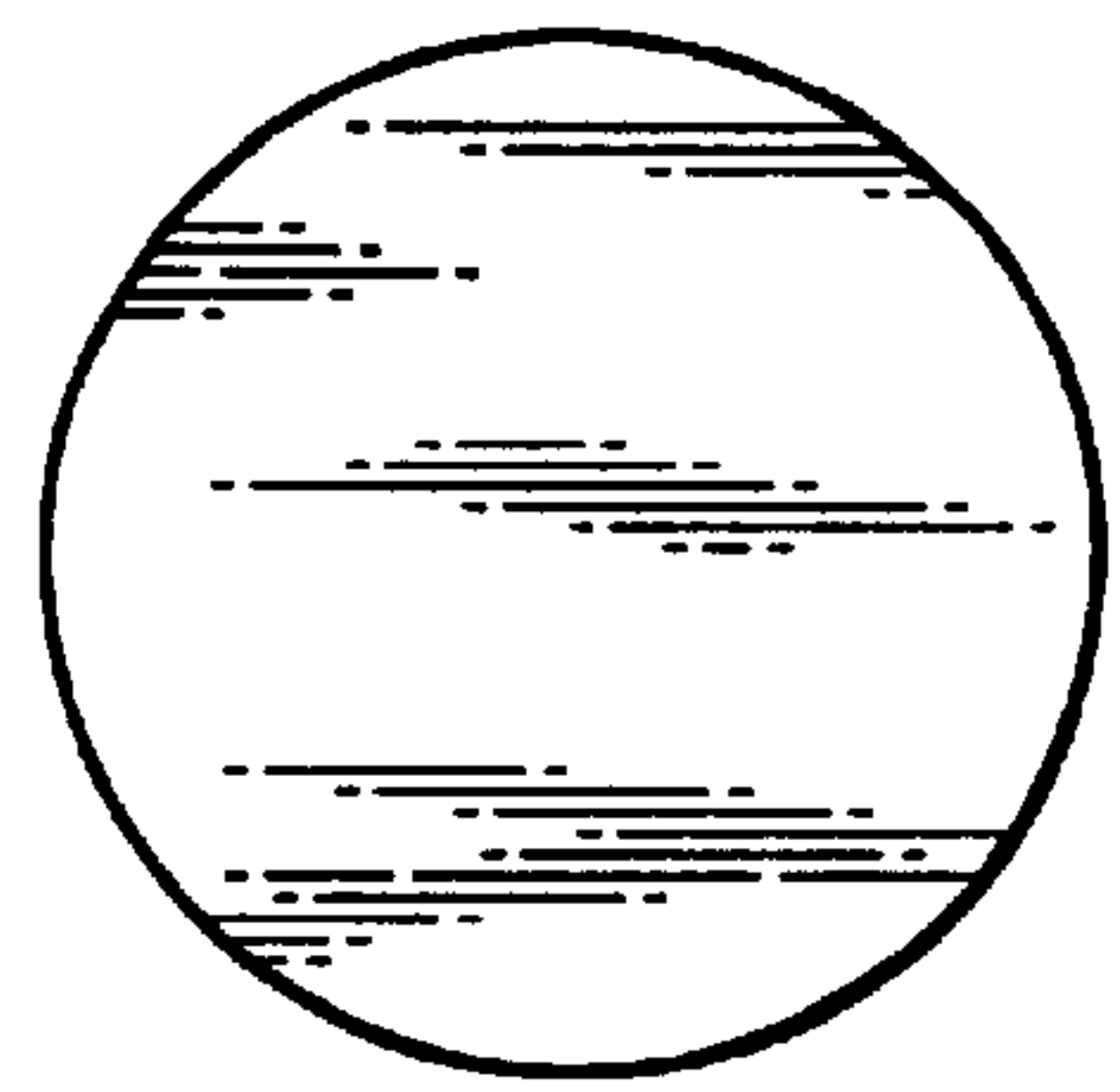

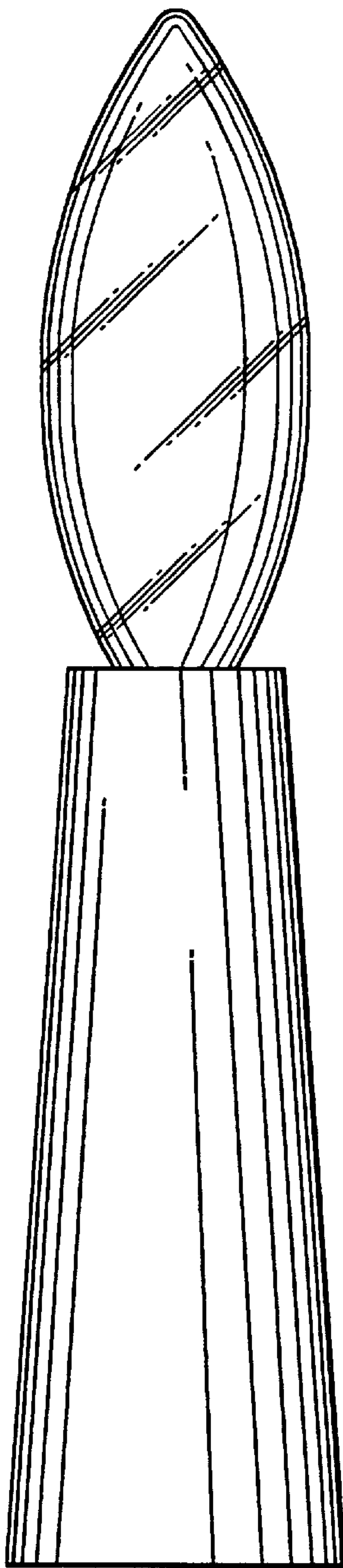
