[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a multiple head pet brush, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a multiple head pet brush showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof of the pet brush of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken on line IV—IV of FIG. 3;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken on line V—V of FIG. 3; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.
