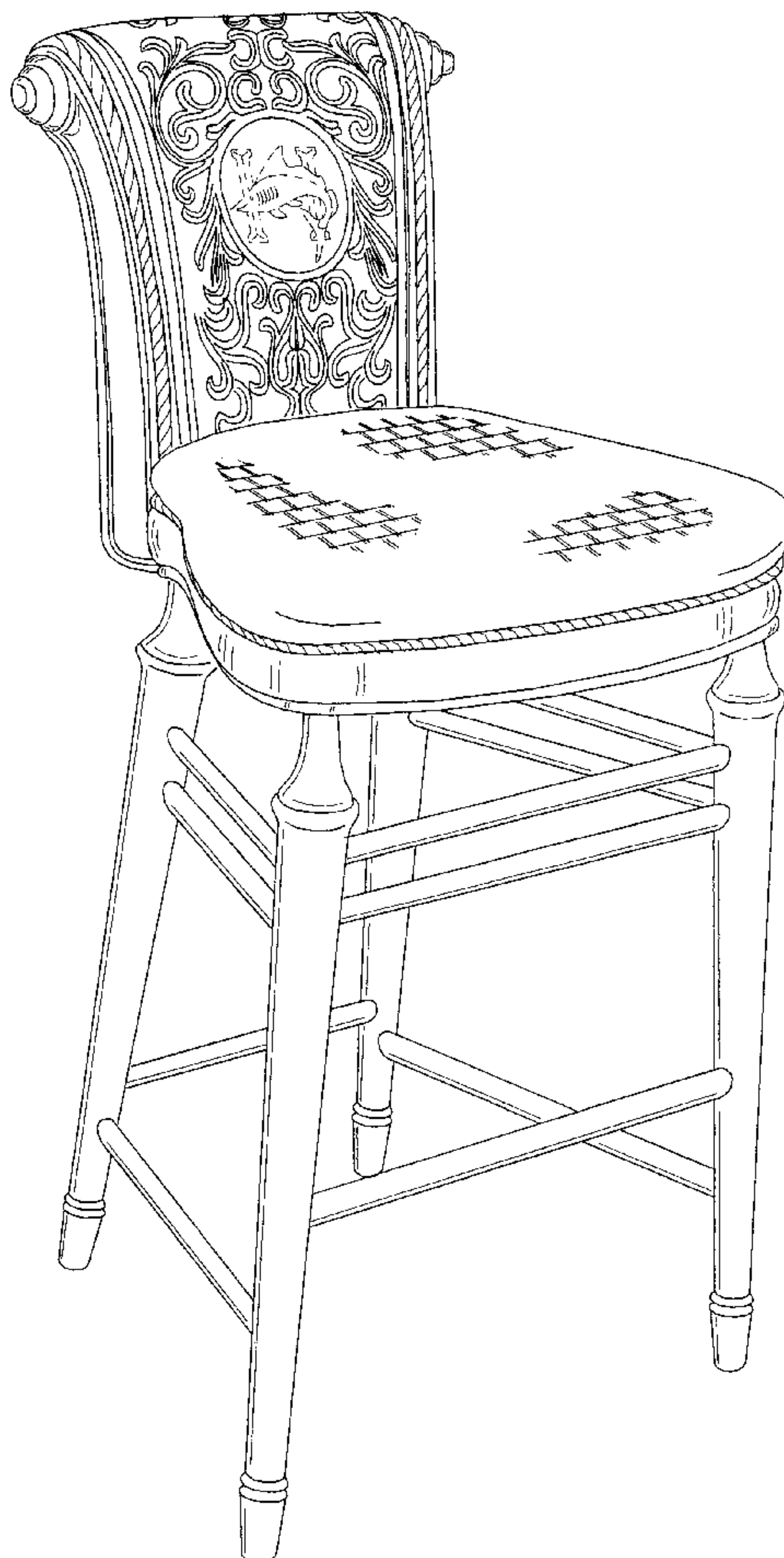
The fragmented pattern shown on the seat member is understood to repeat uniformly throughout the circumscribed area.

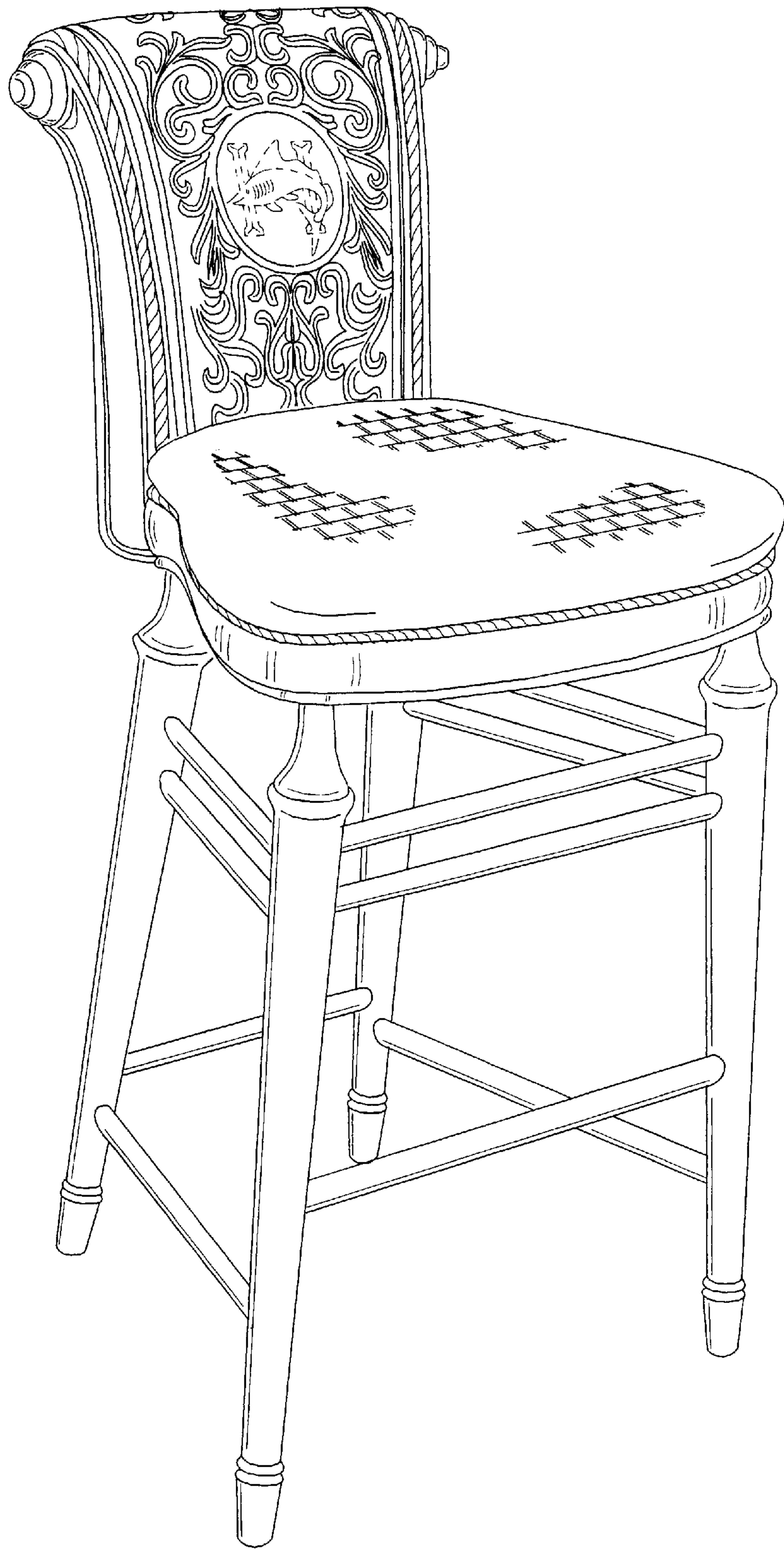

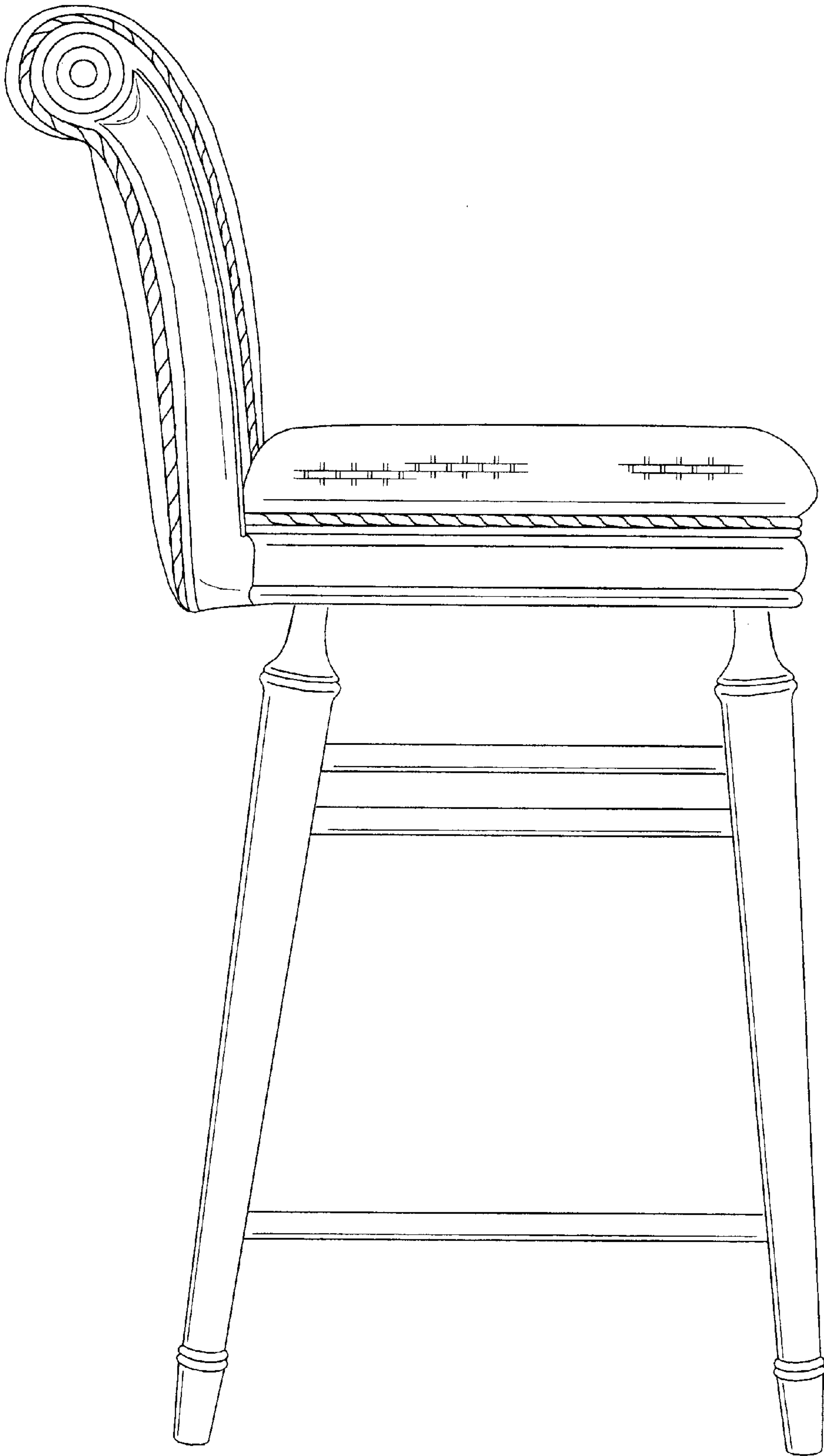

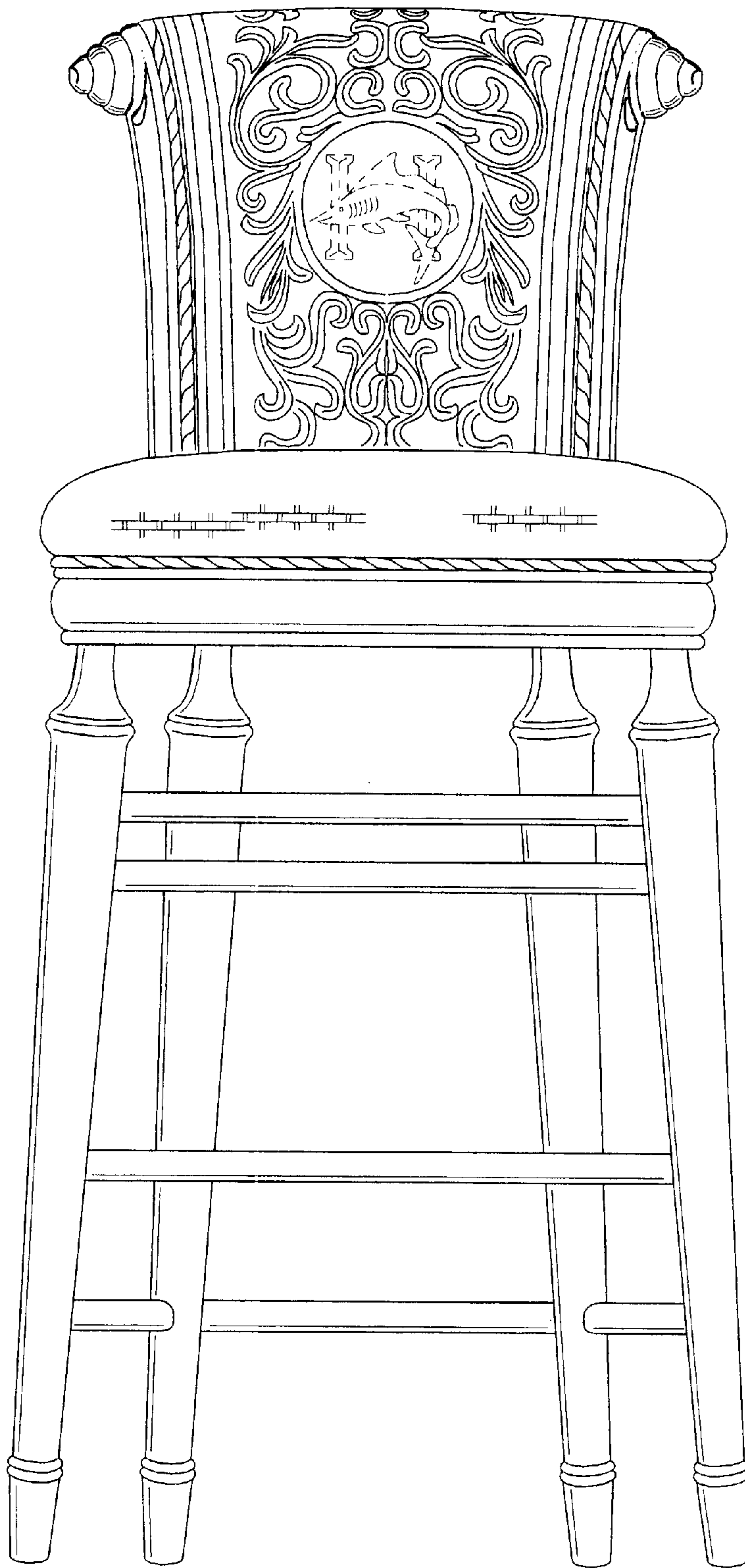

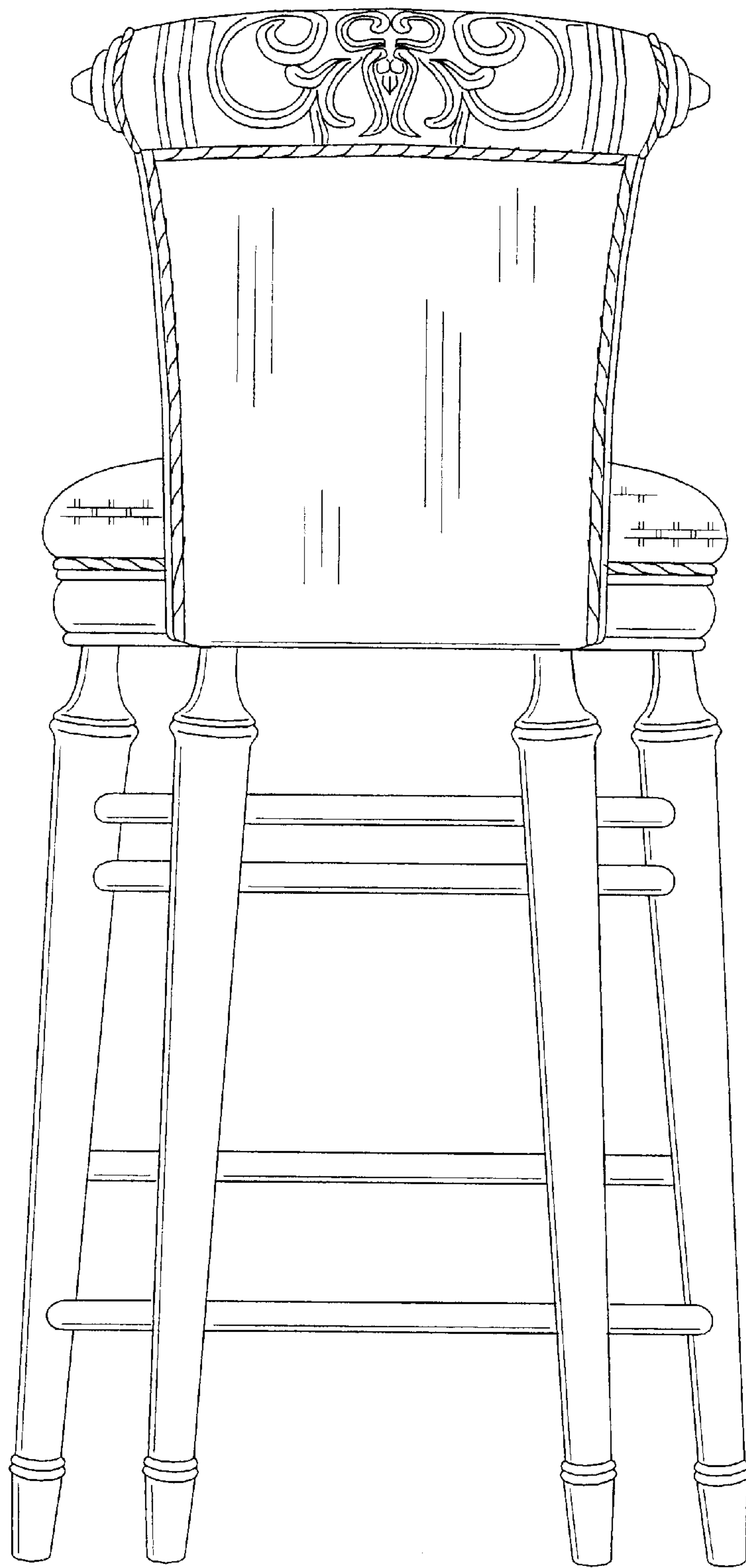

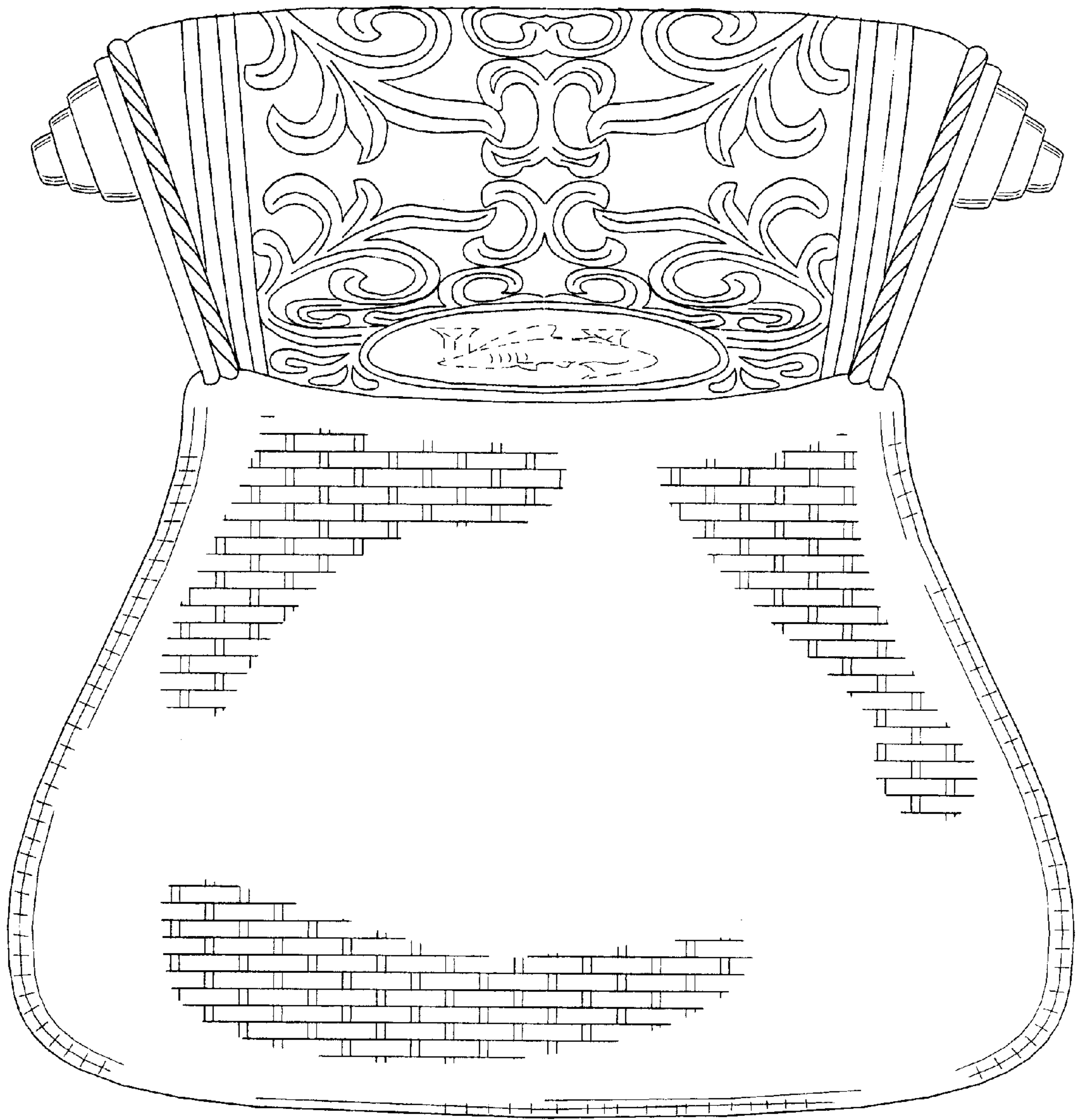
