[57] **CLAIM**

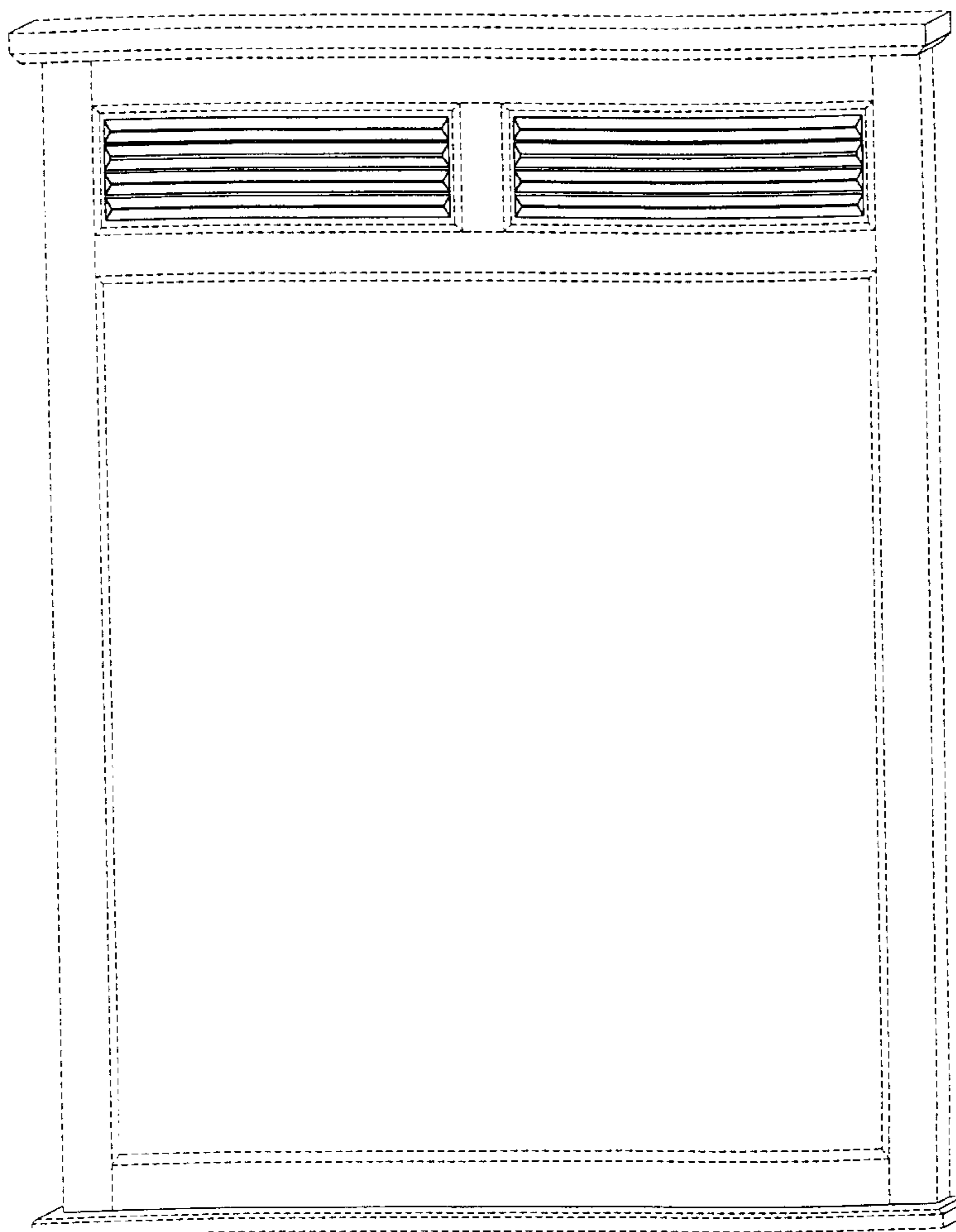
The ornamental design for a panel for a bedboard/mirror, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a panel for a bedboard/mirror, showing my new design embodied in a mirror; FIG. 2 is a front view of the mirror of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view at 3—3 in FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a panel for a bedboard/mirror, showing my new design embodied in a headboard; FIG. 5 is a front view of the headboard of FIG. 4; and, FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view at 6—6 in FIG. 5.

The rear and bottom views of the headboard and mirror form no part of the claimed design. The features shown in broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

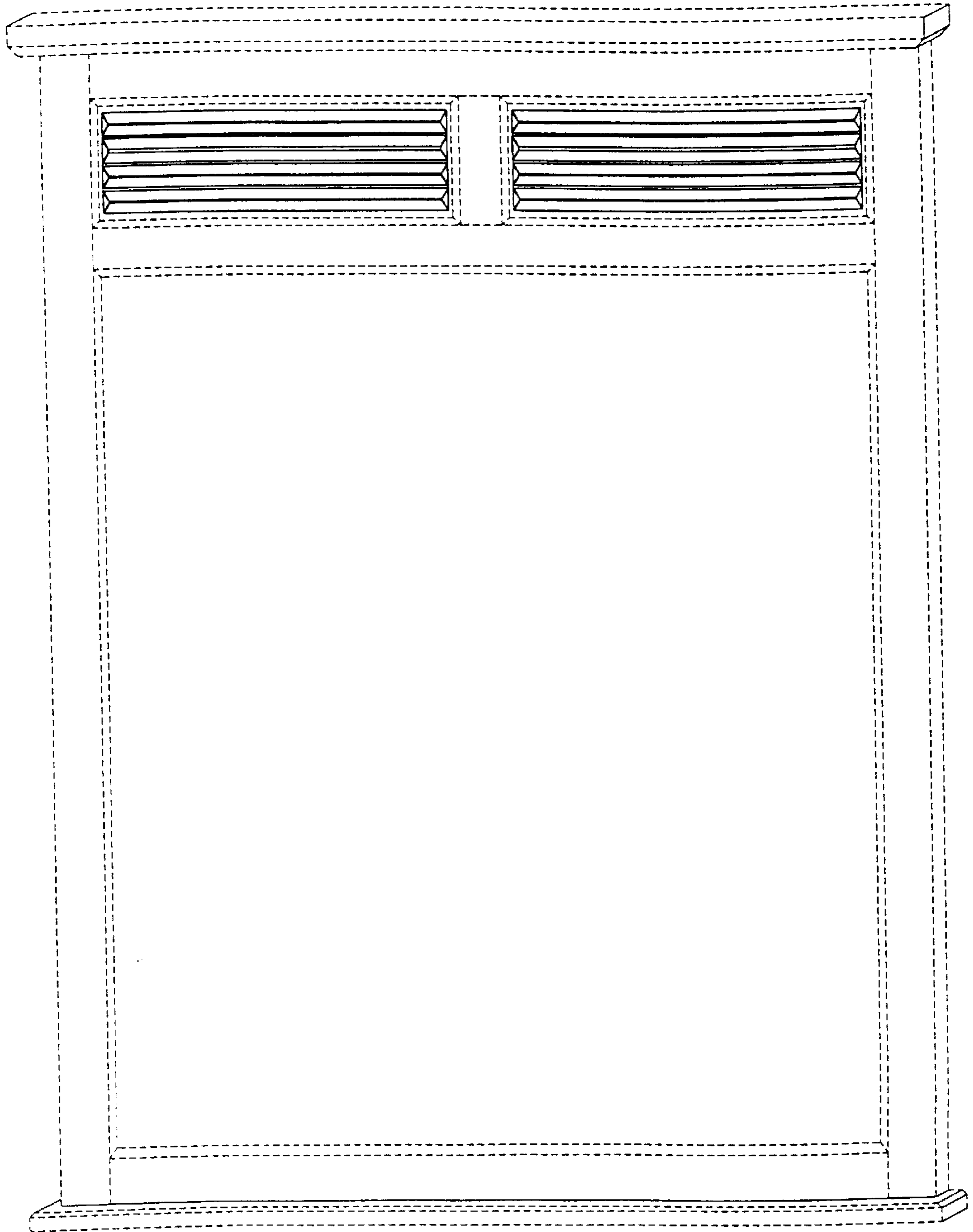

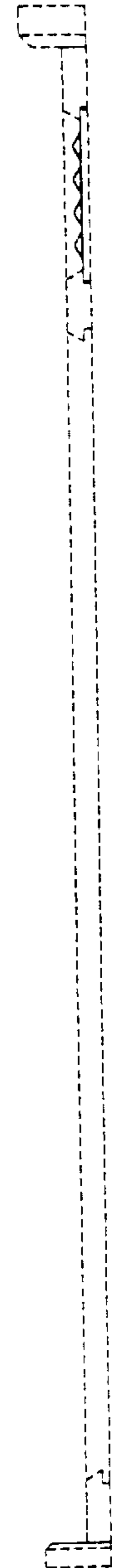
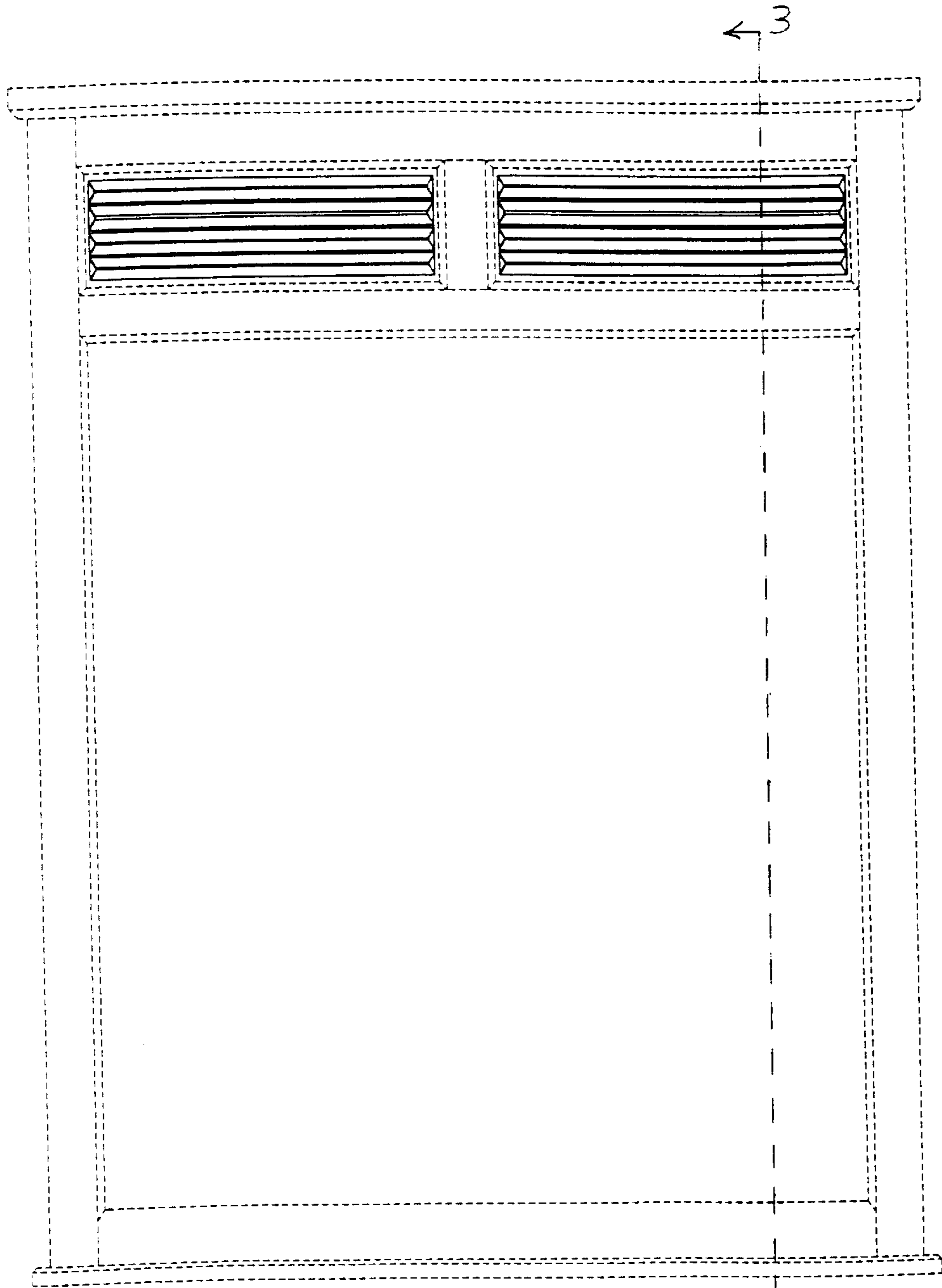

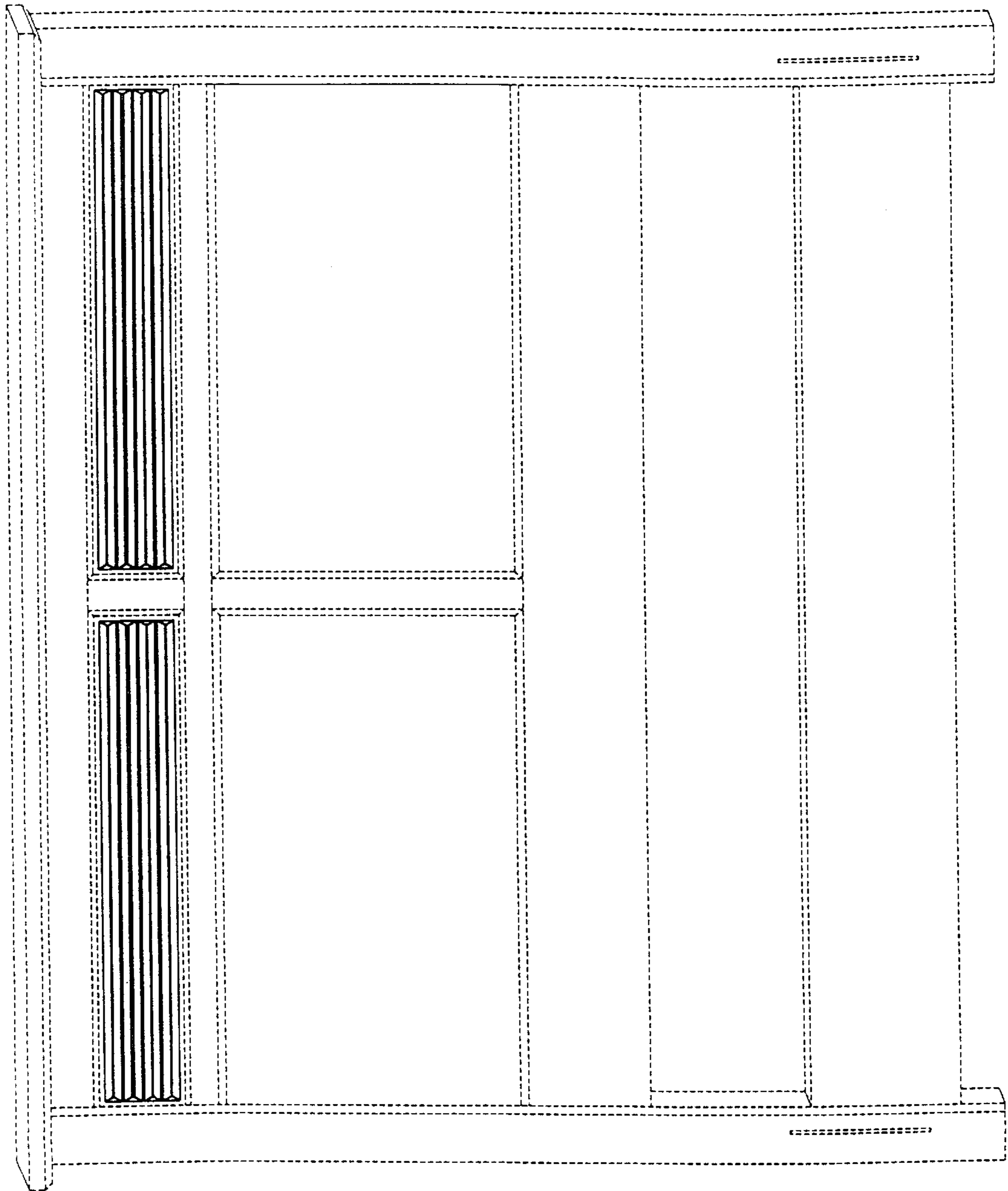

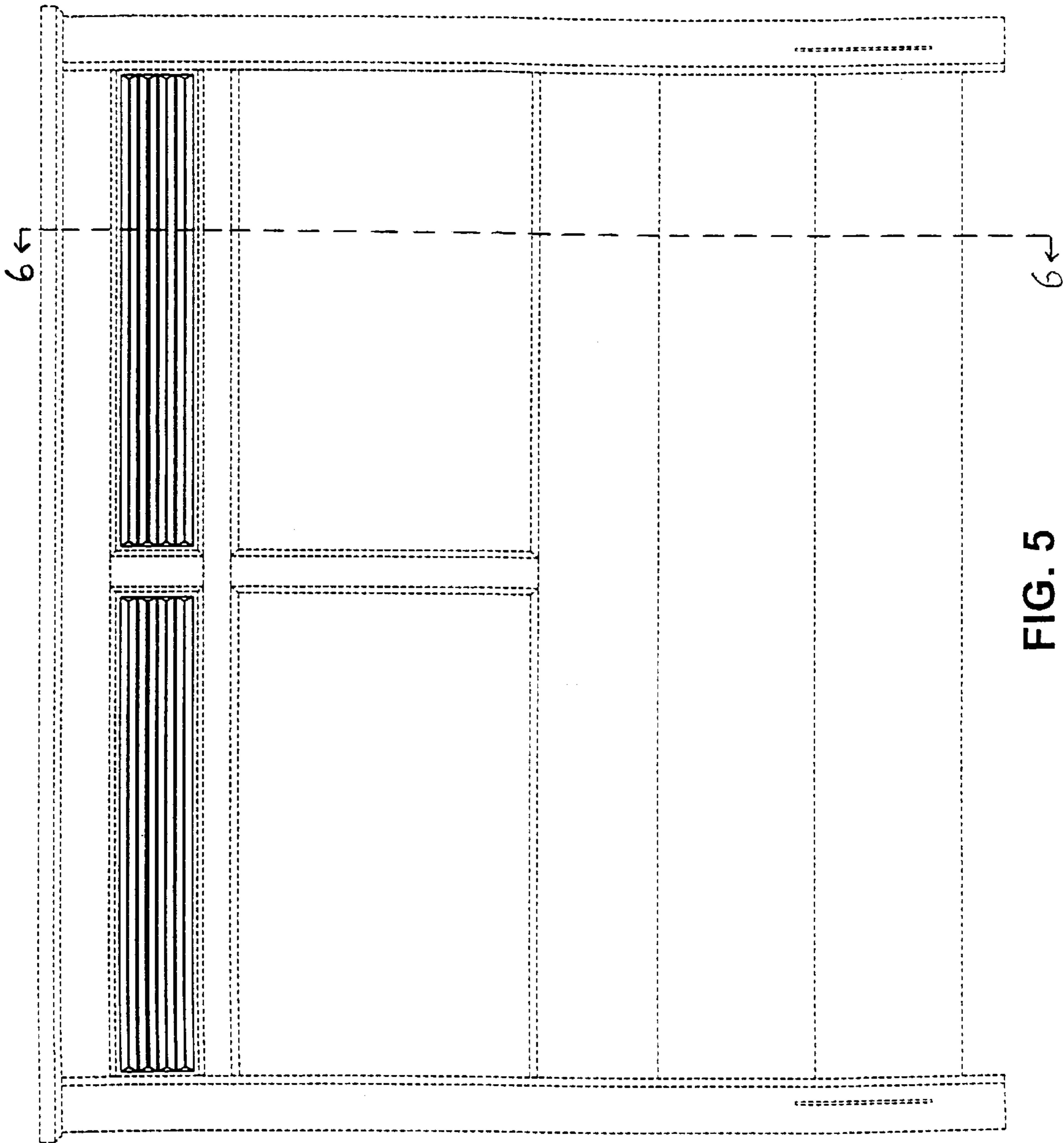

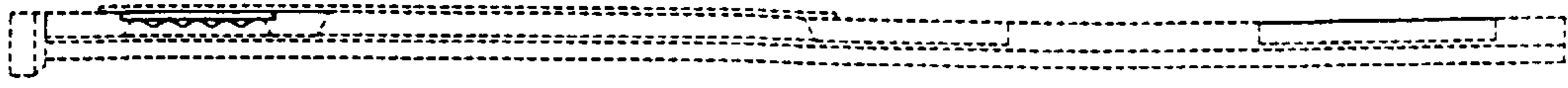
