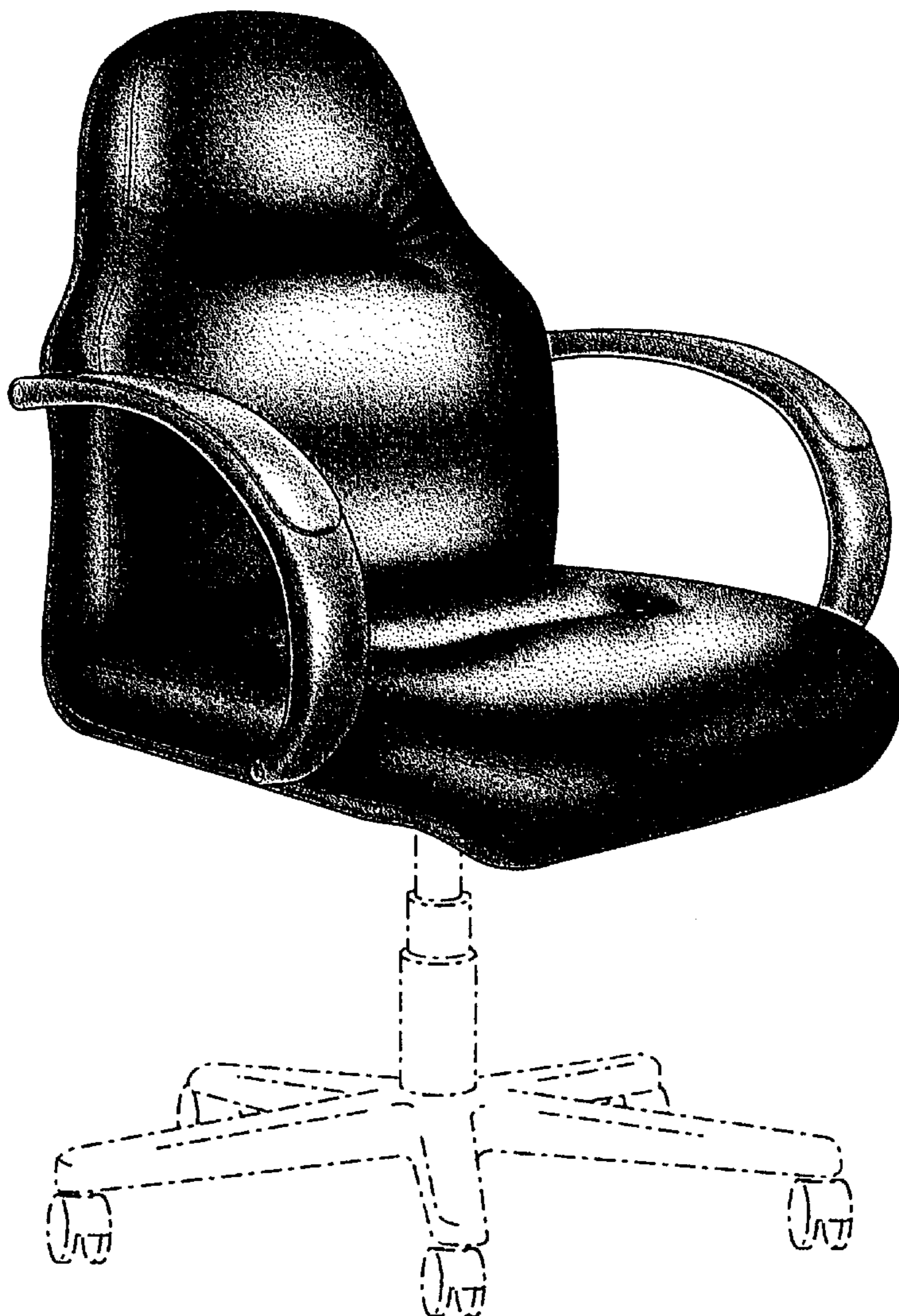

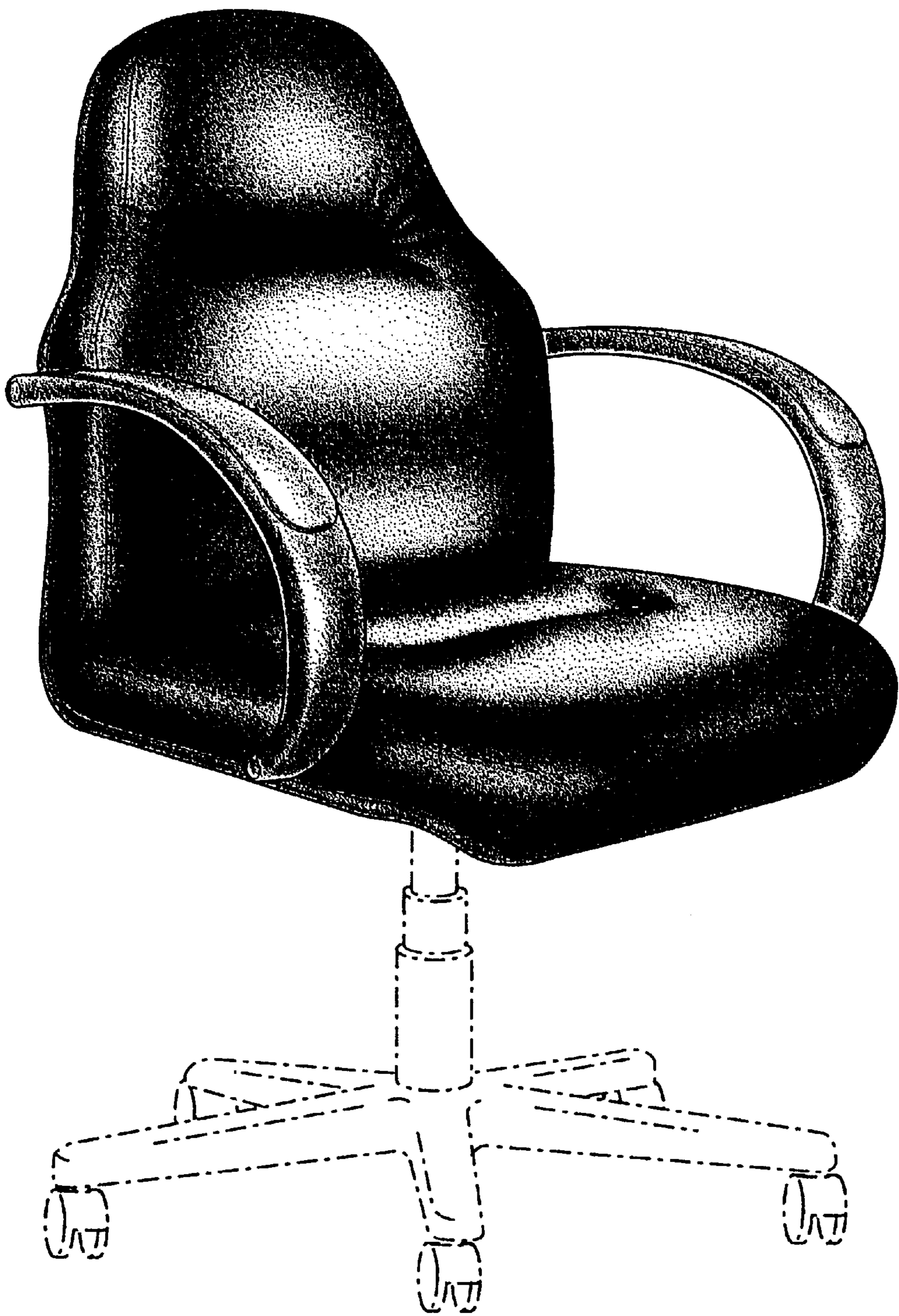
The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

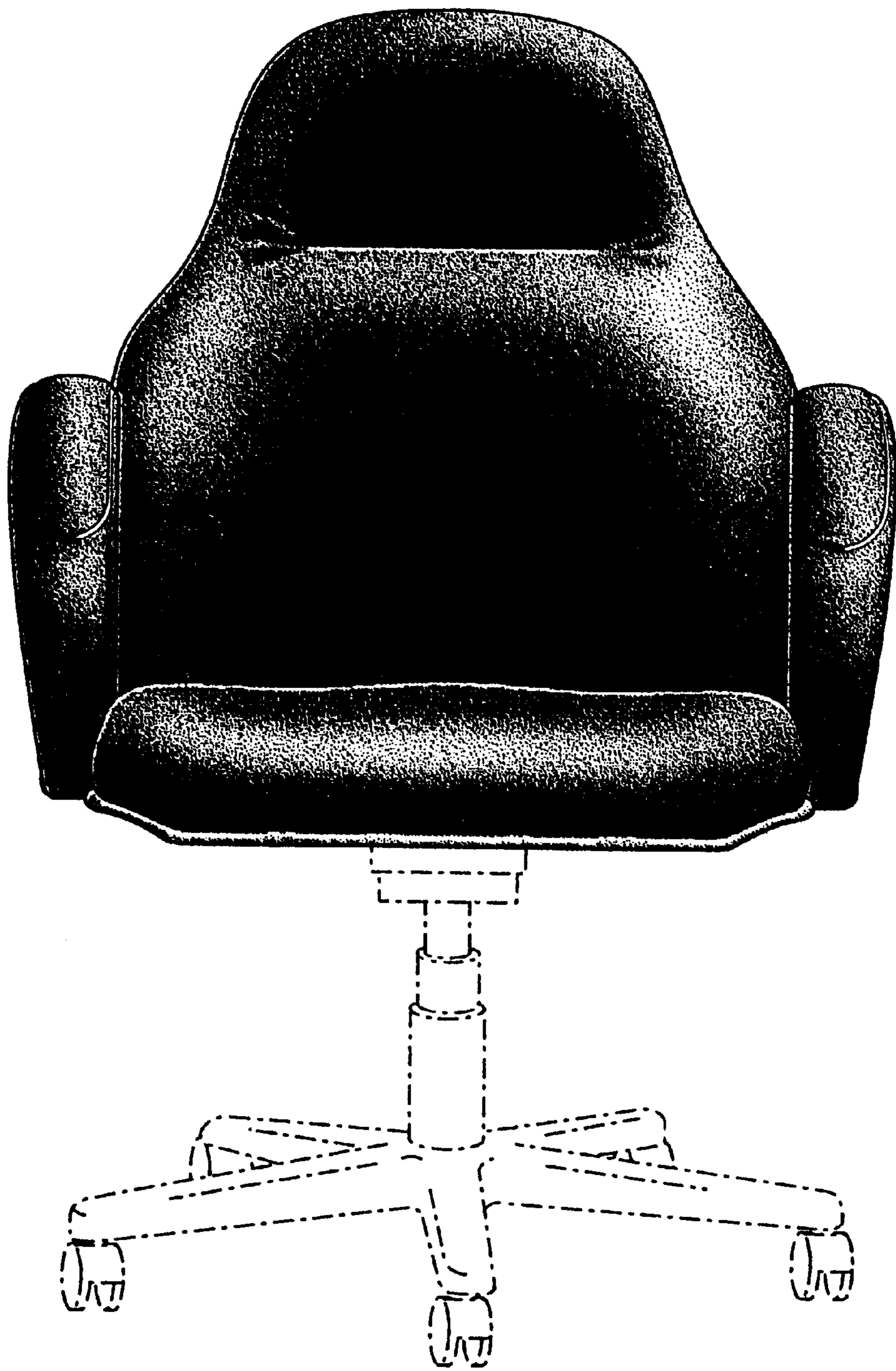
FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the front and one side showing my new design;

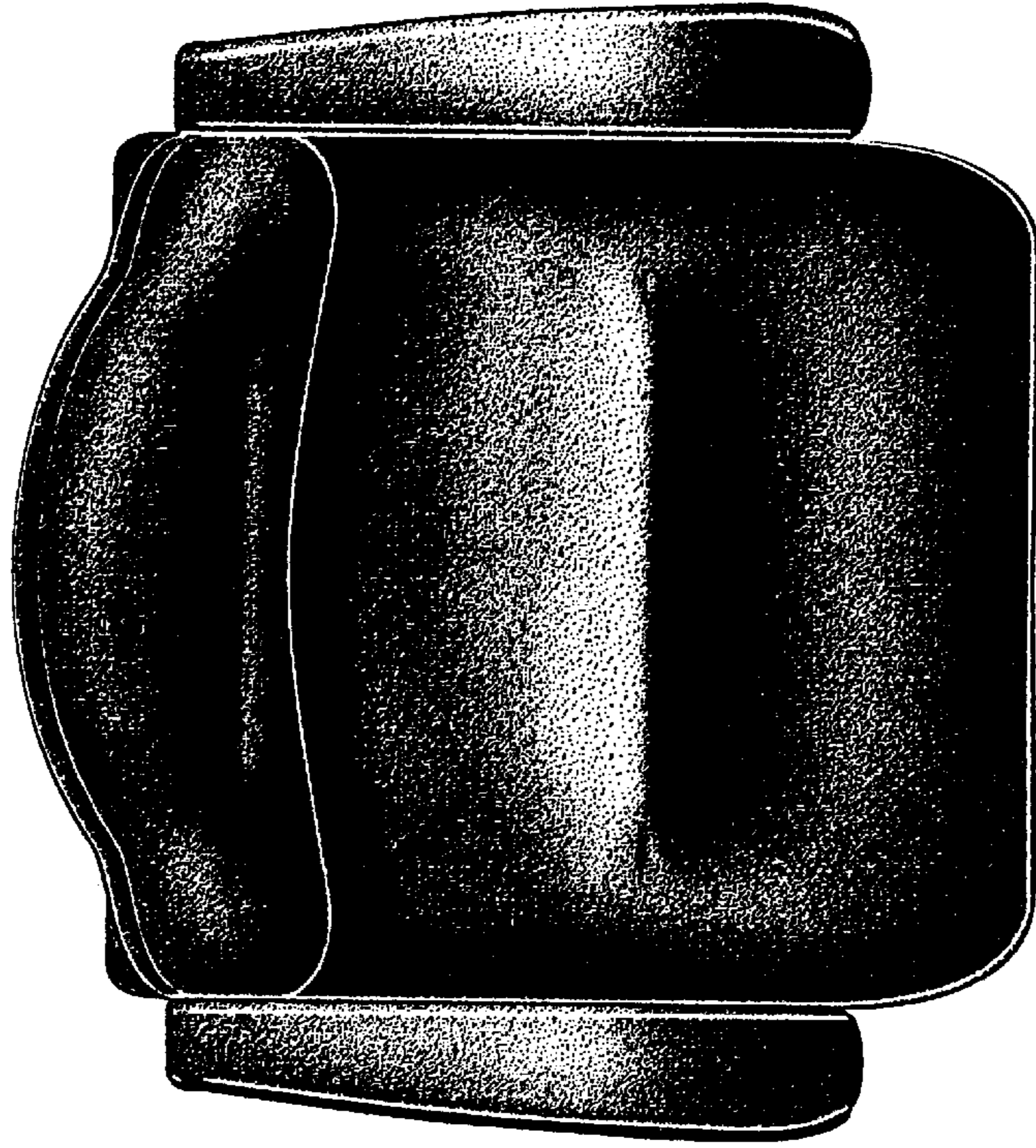

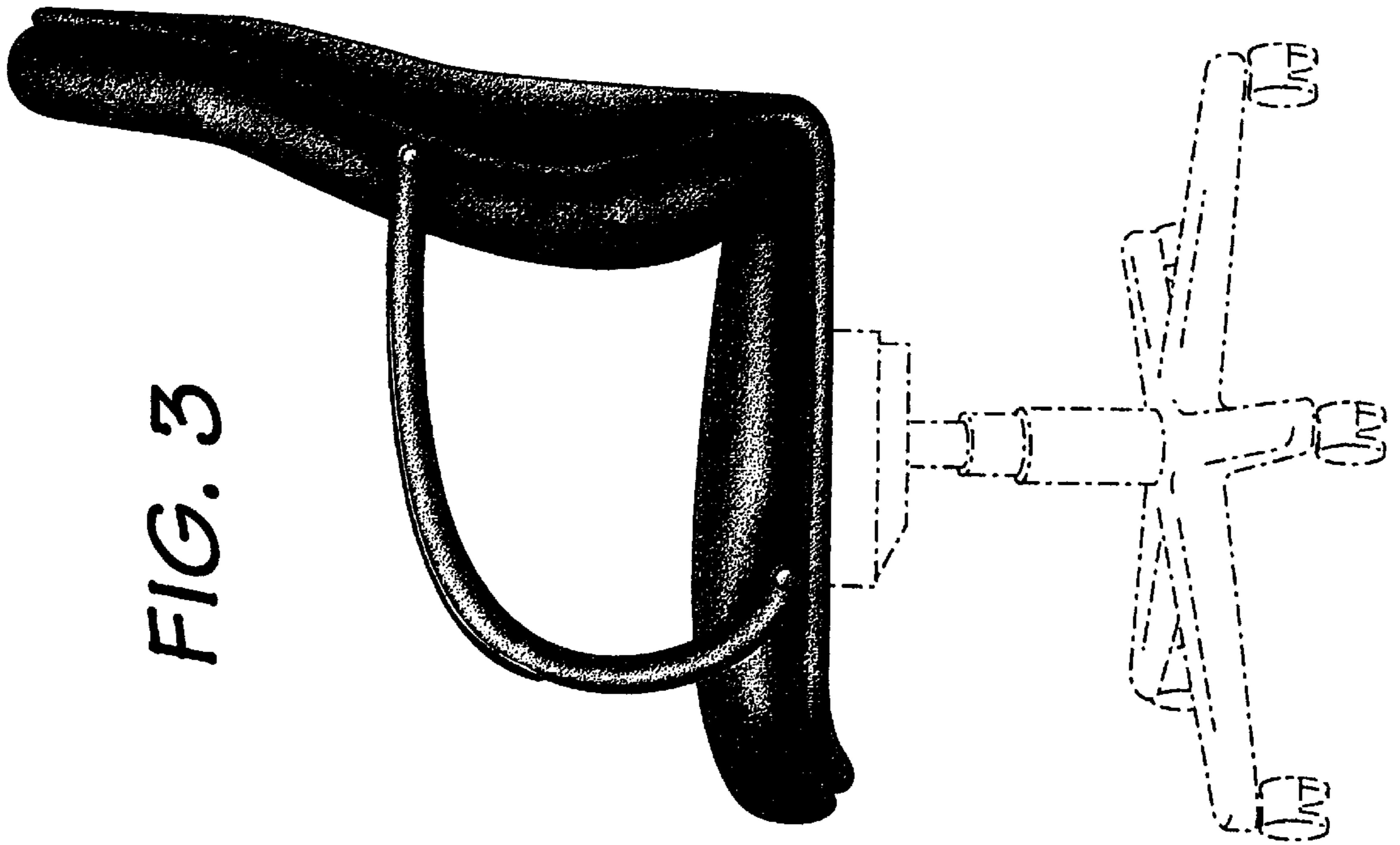
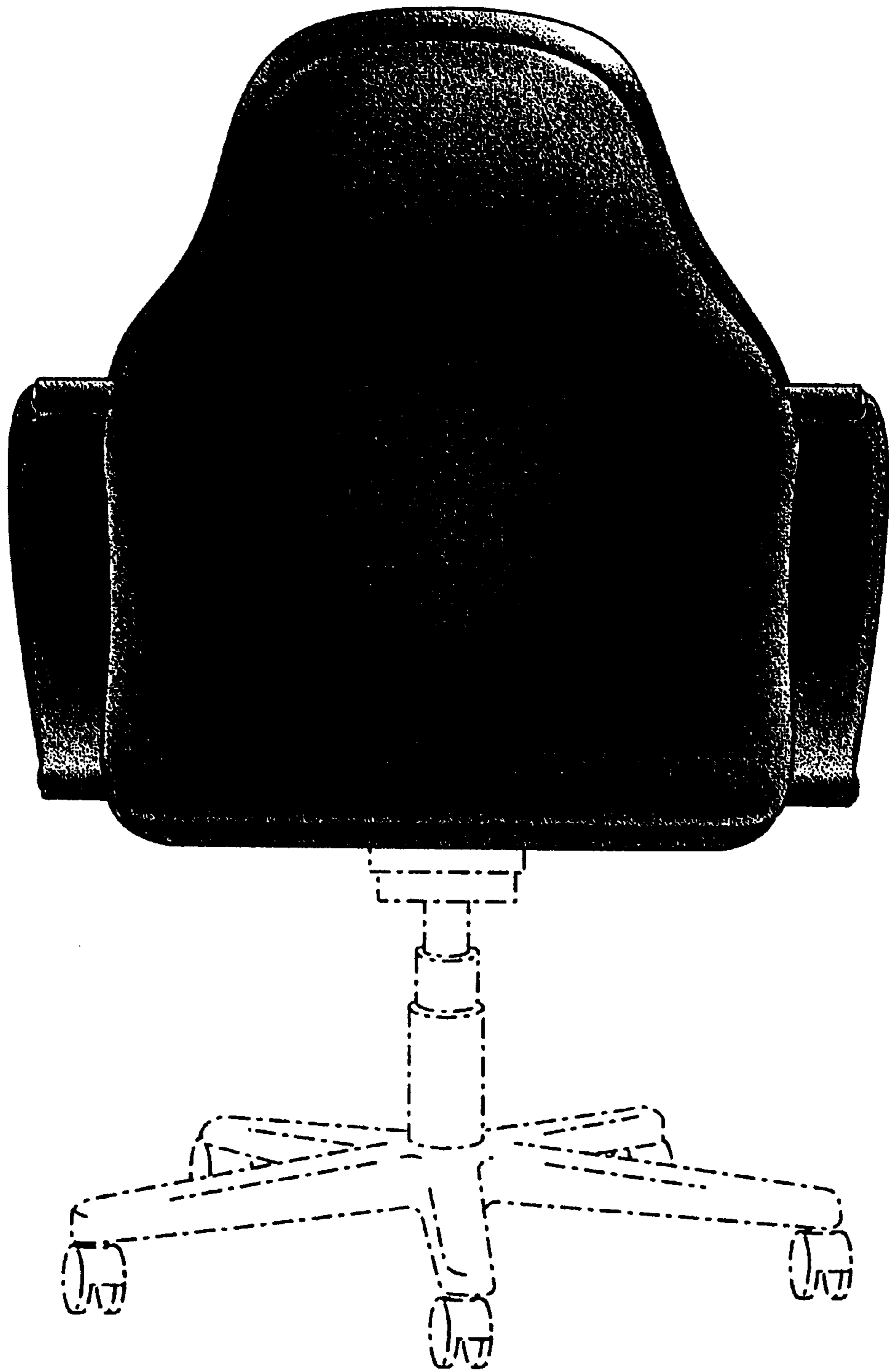
