FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; and,

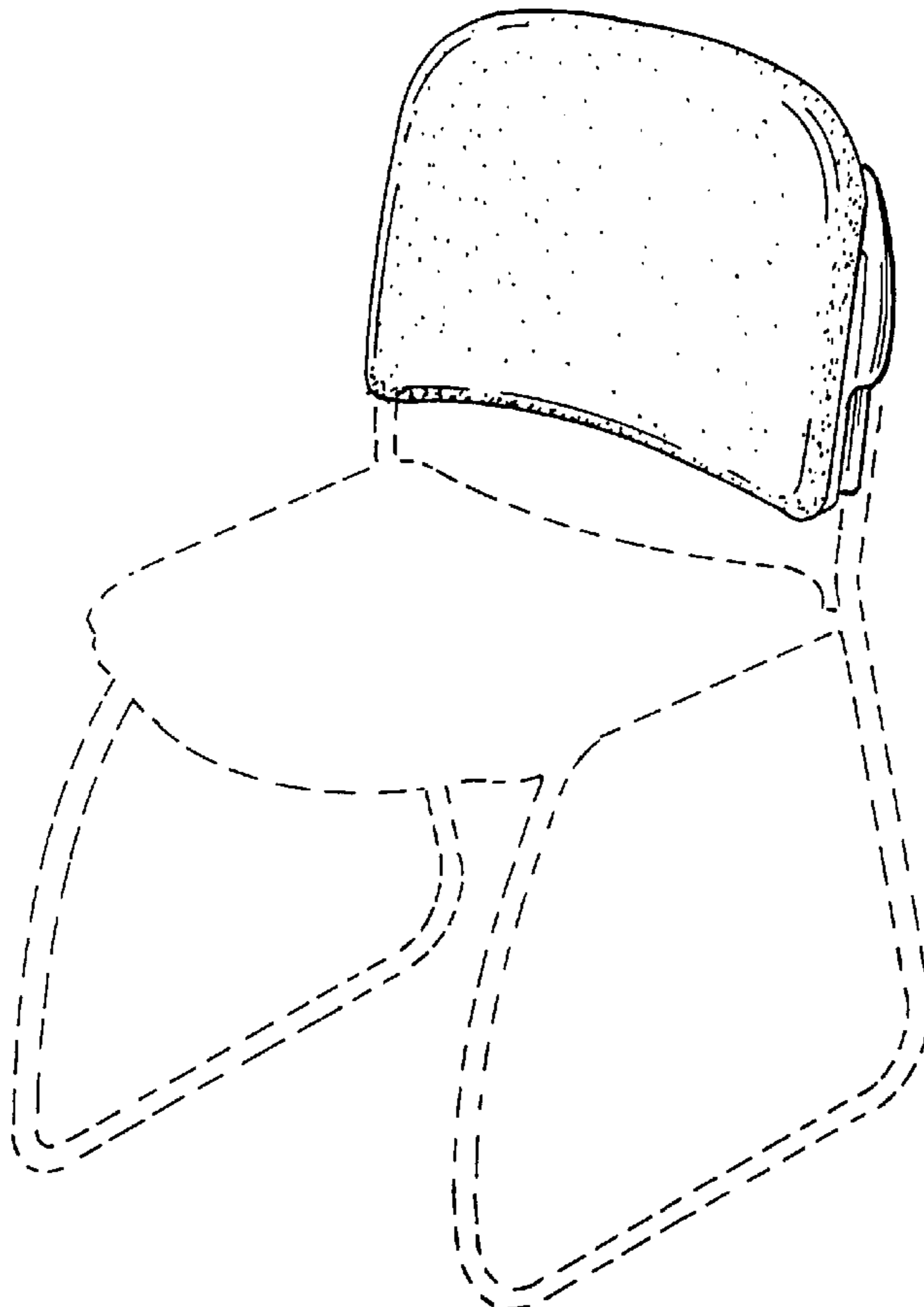
FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom view thereof.

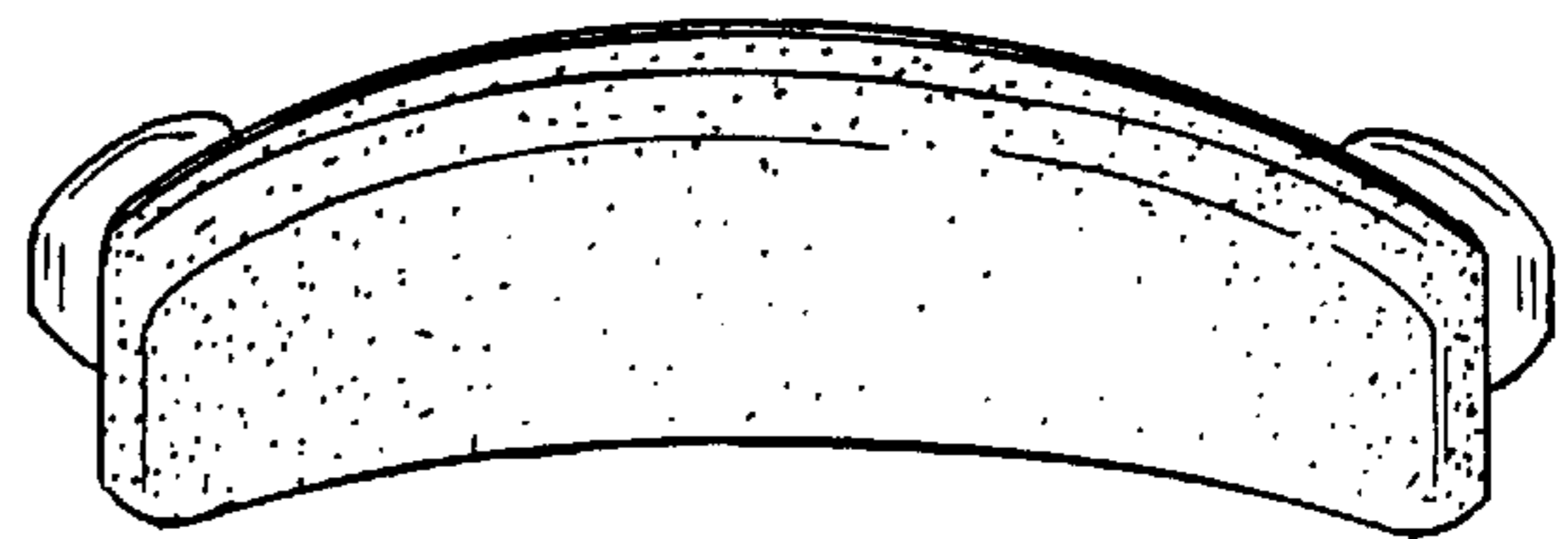
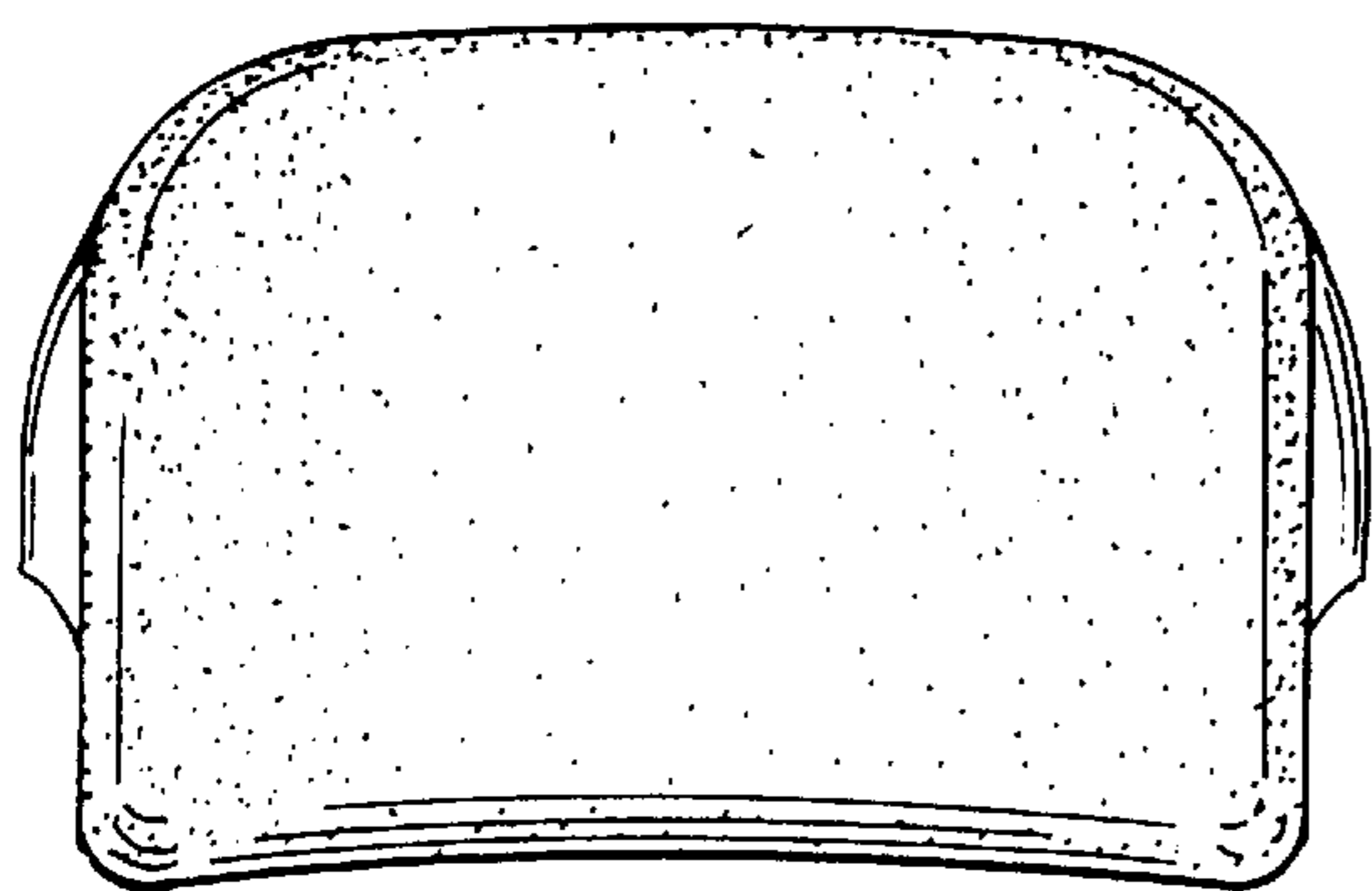
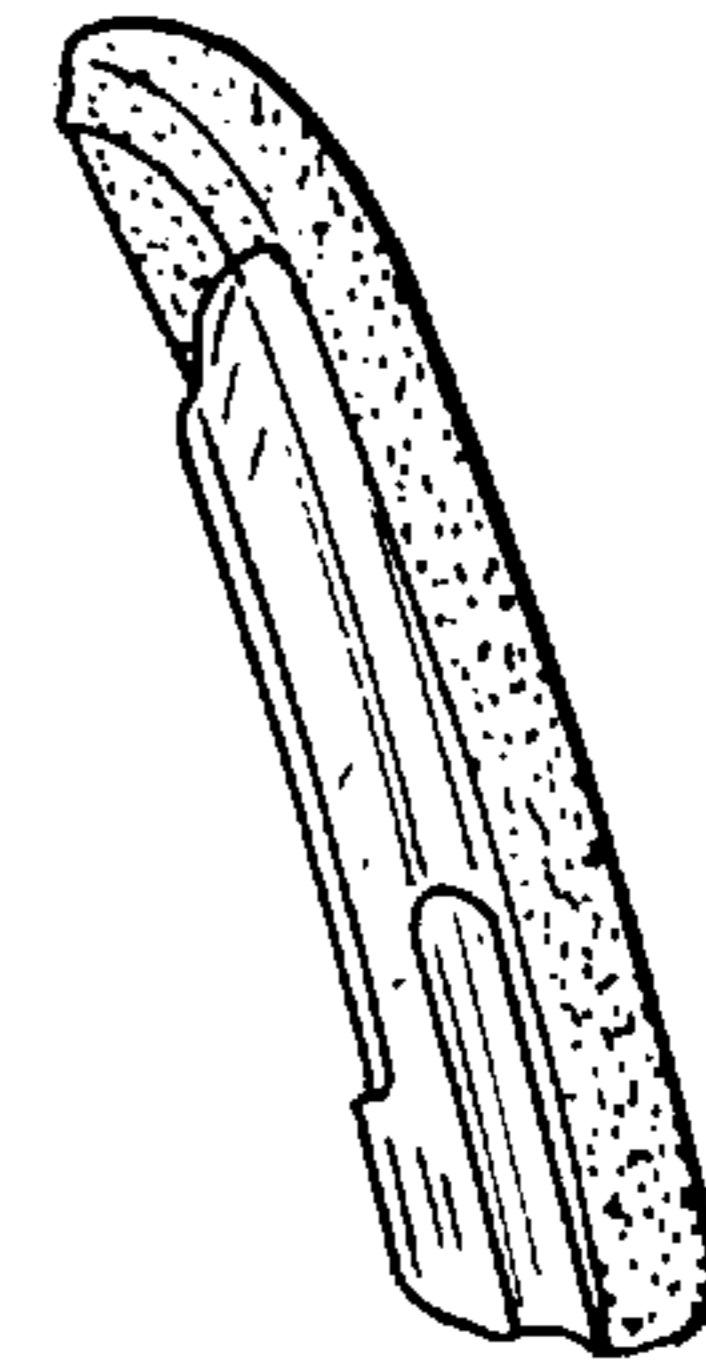
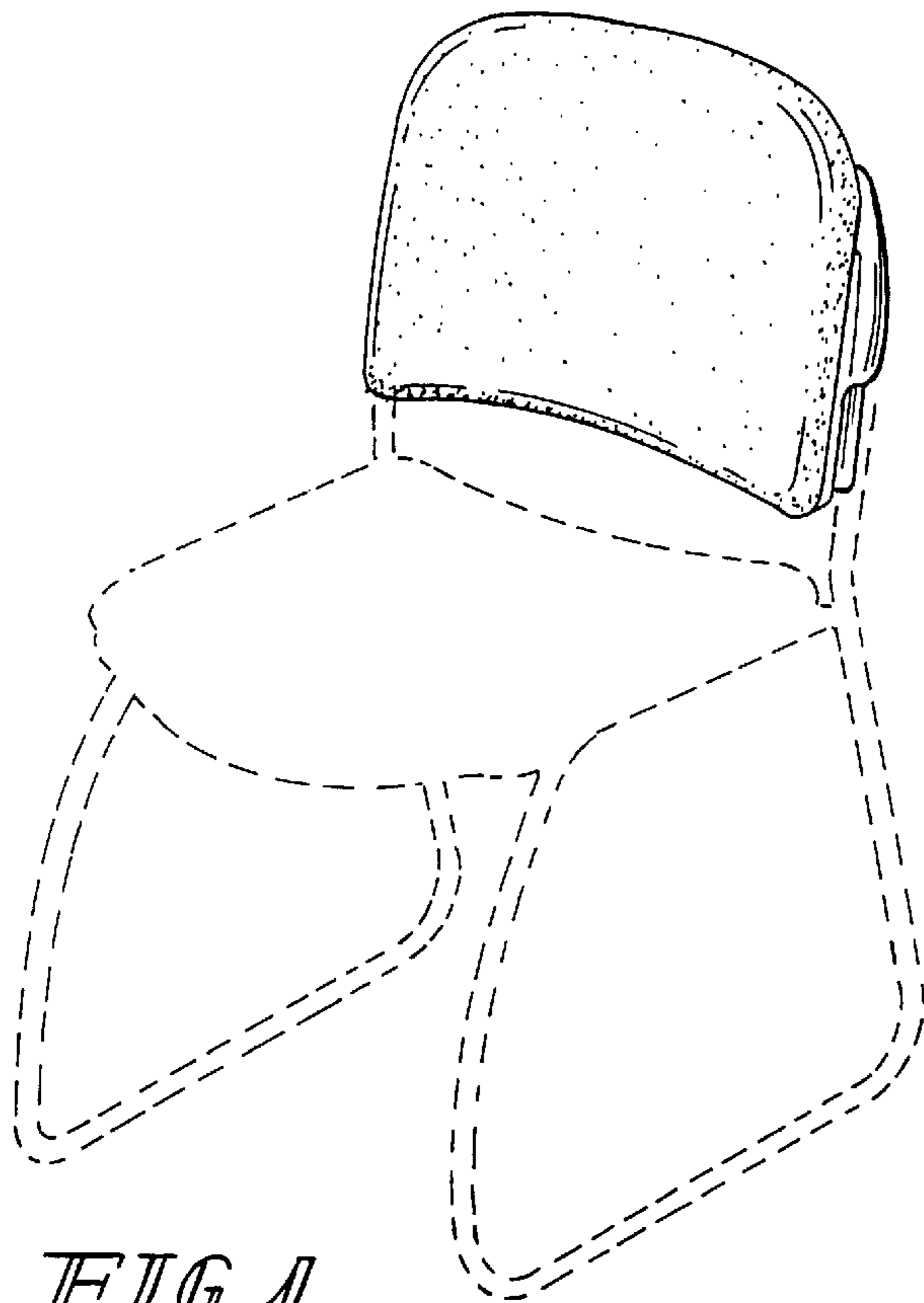

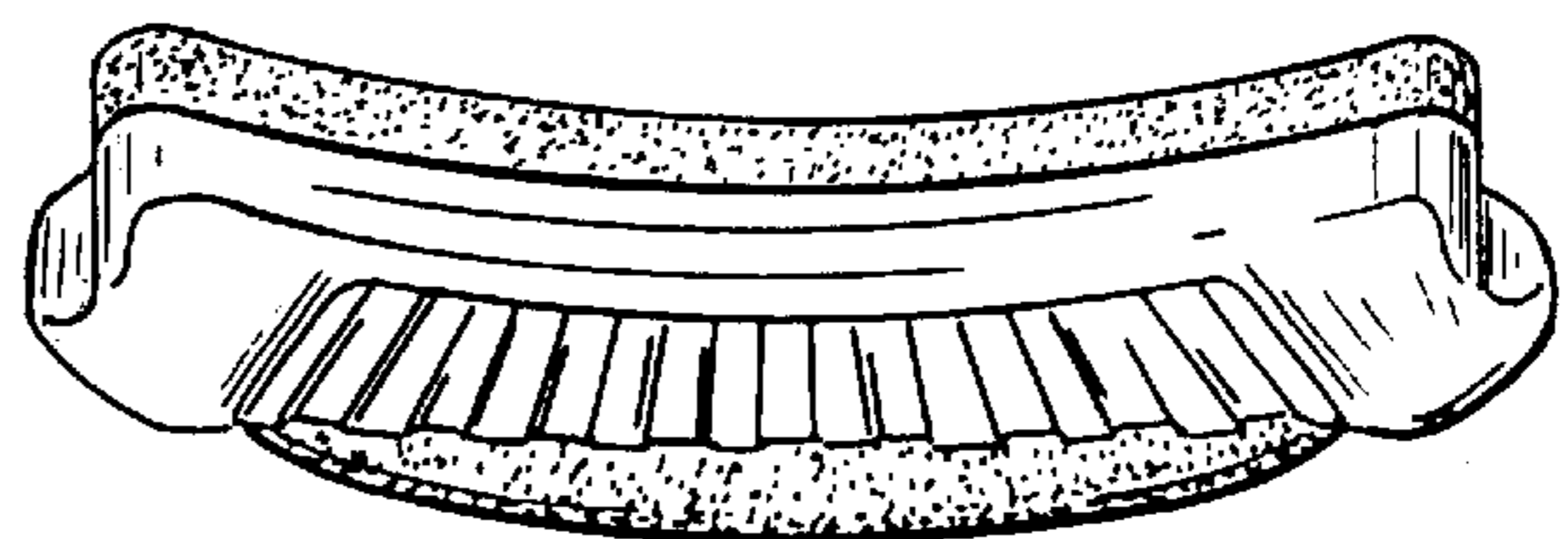
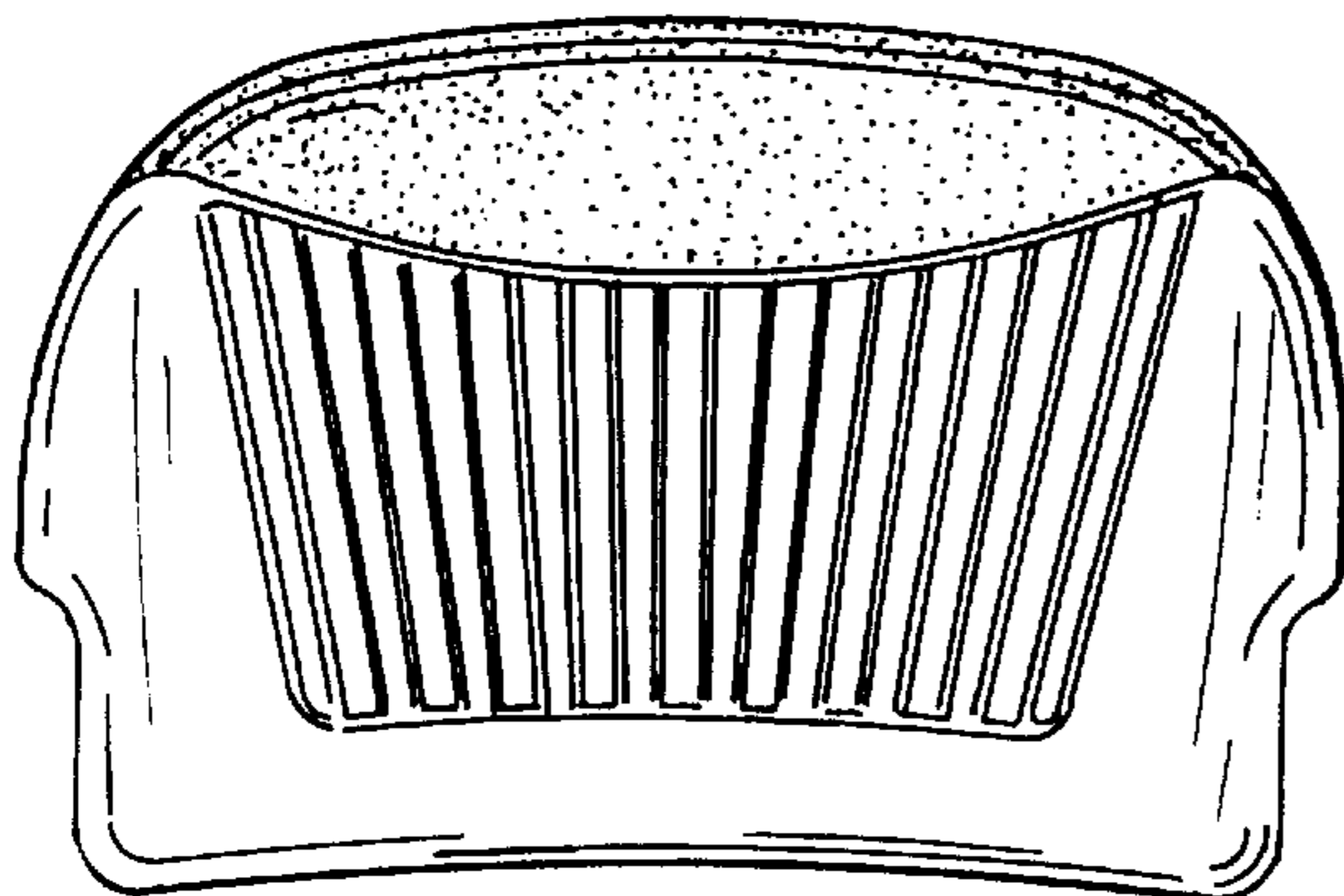
