[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a transaction card, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a transaction card showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof, the top plan view is identical;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a left elevational view thereof, the right side view is identical.

The drawings illustrate a transaction card characterized by having a transparent base and opaque areas.
The oblique line shading represents transparent surfaces.

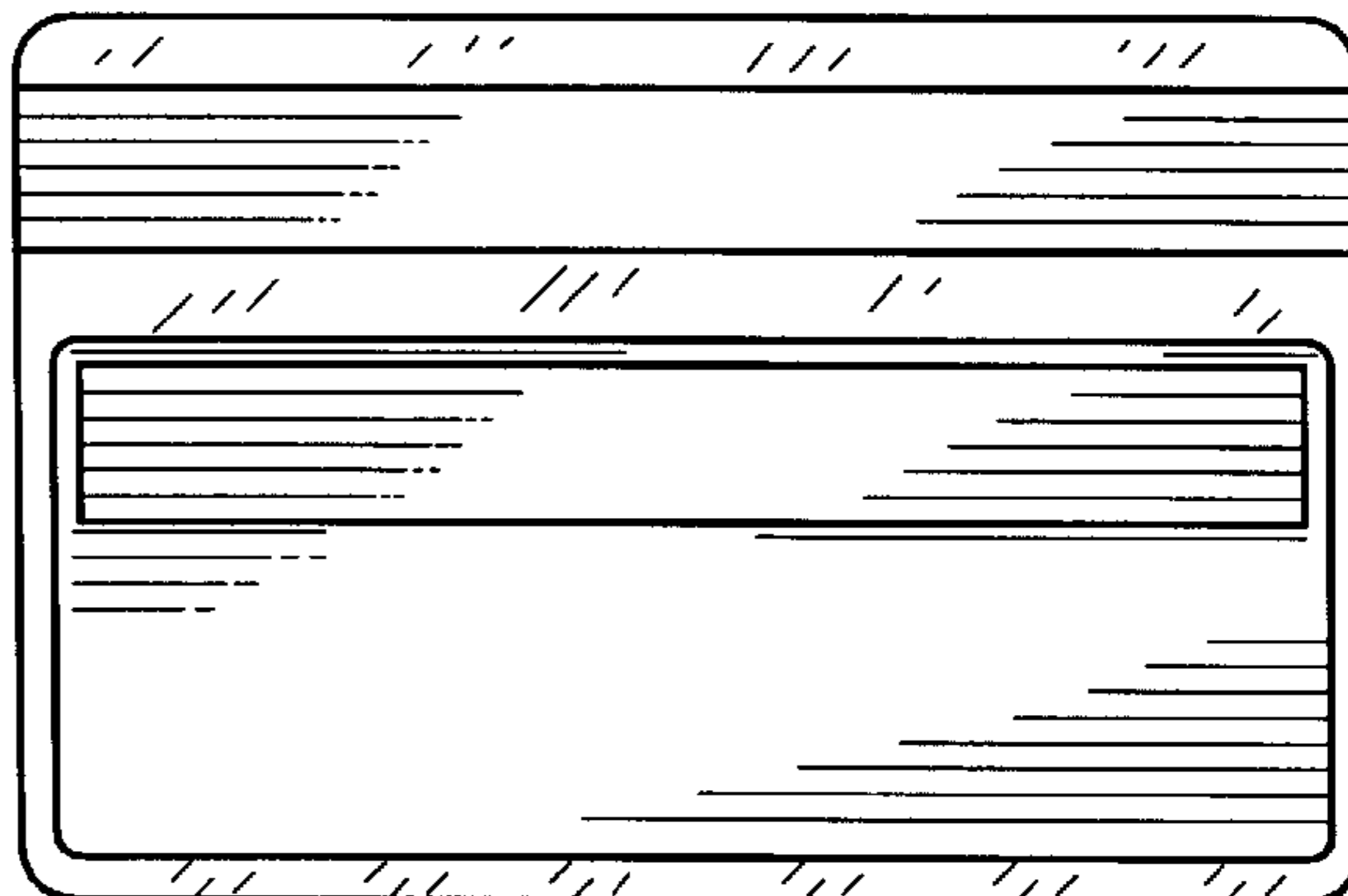
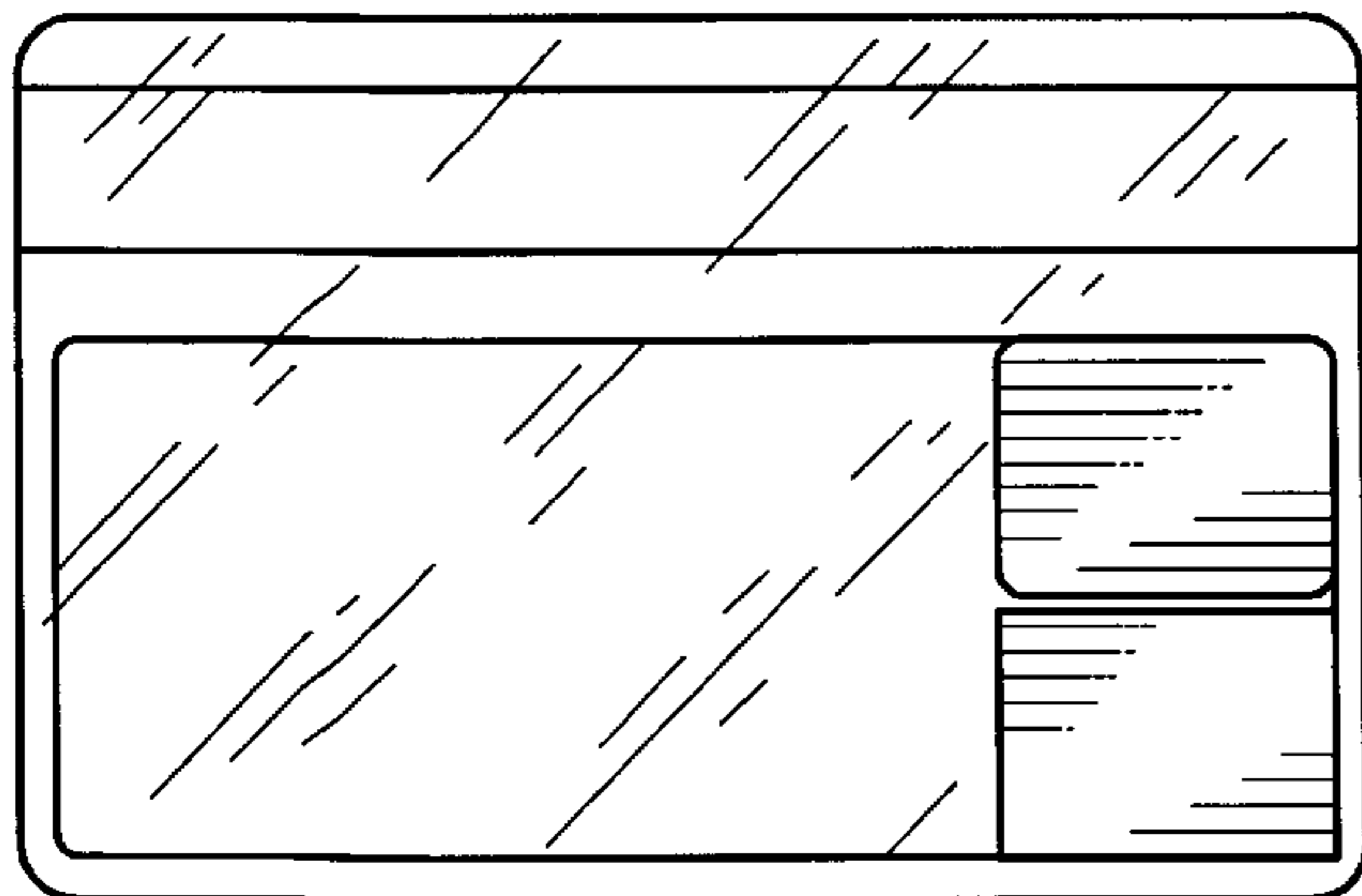

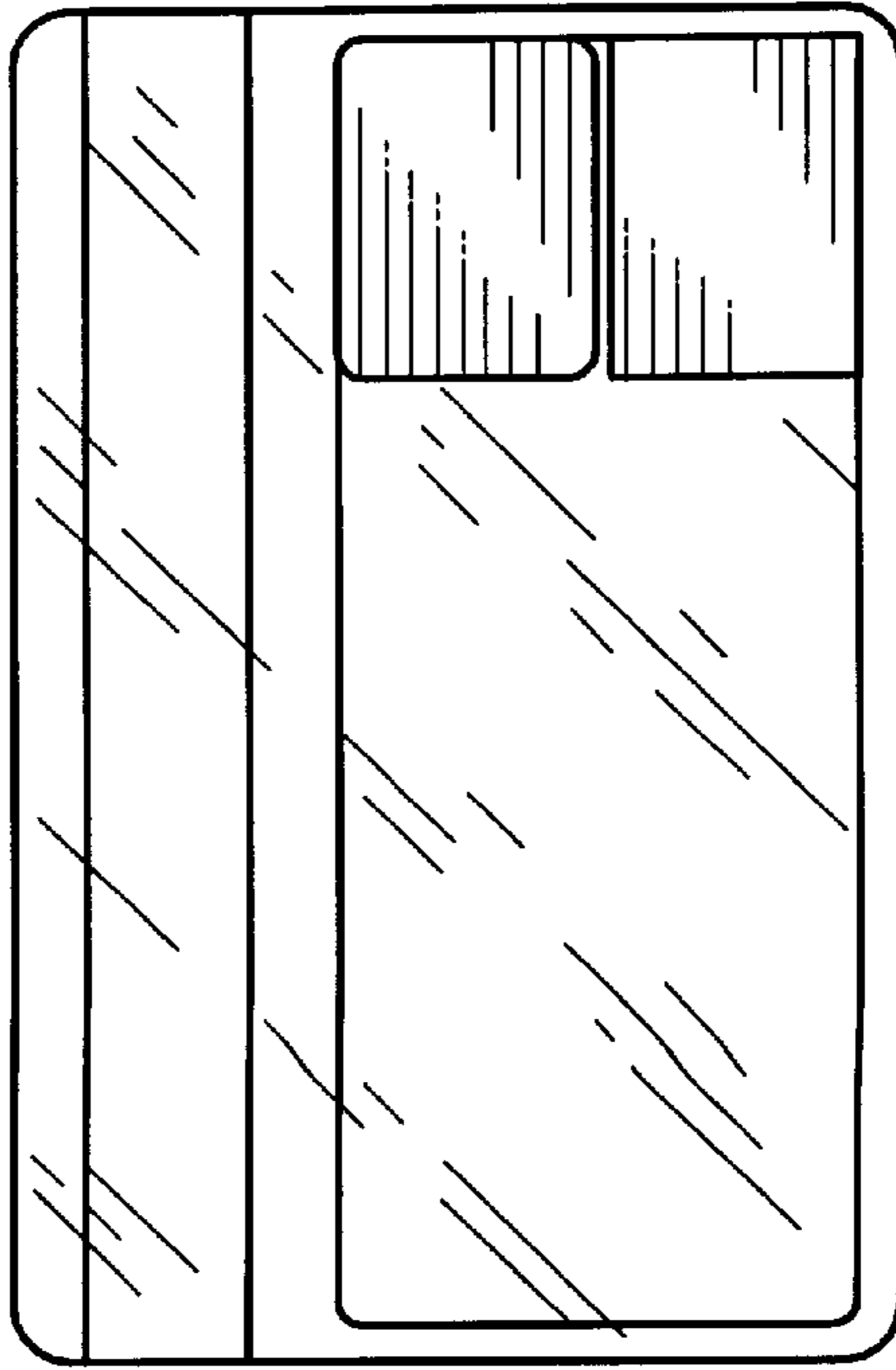

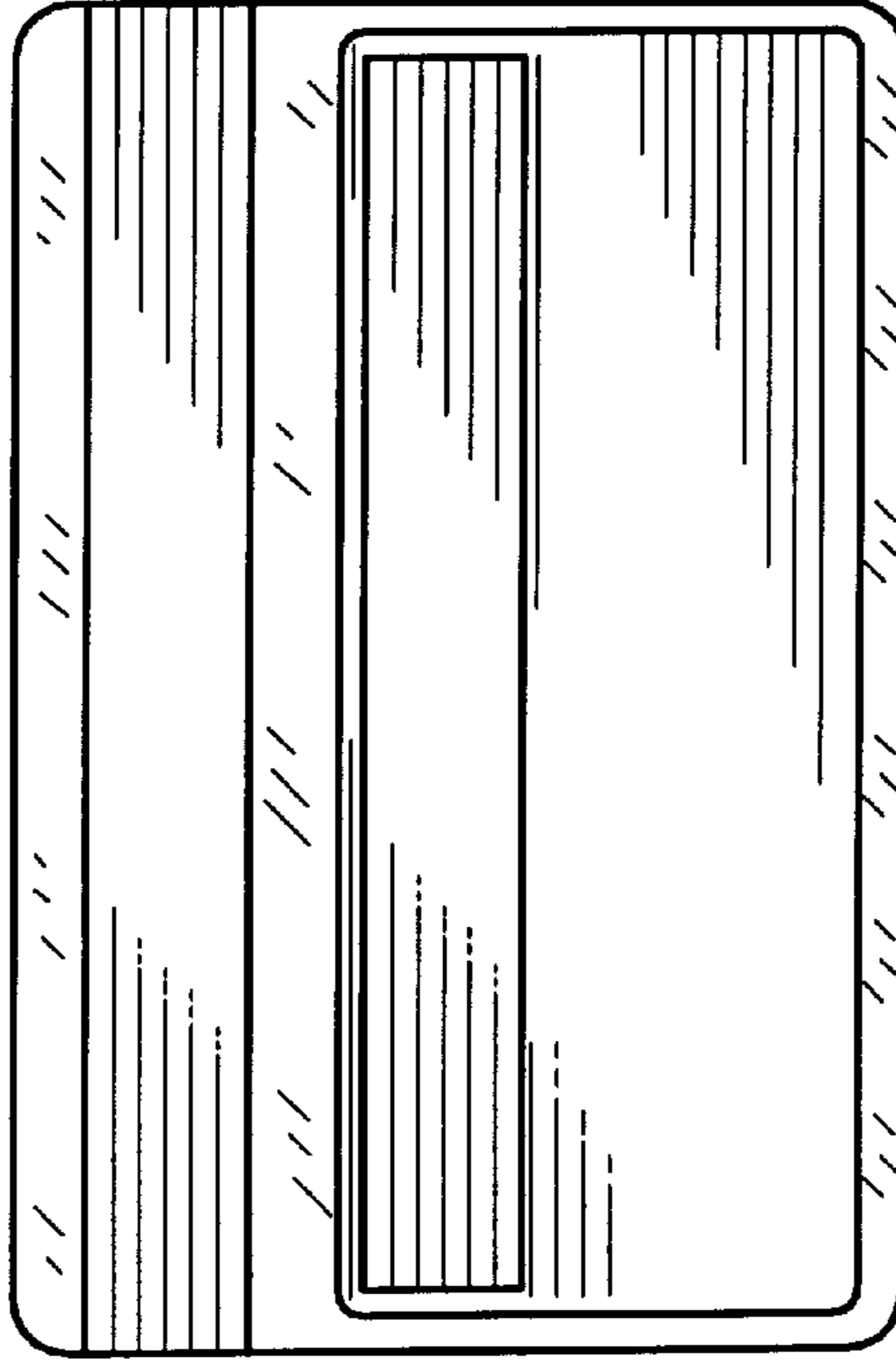
