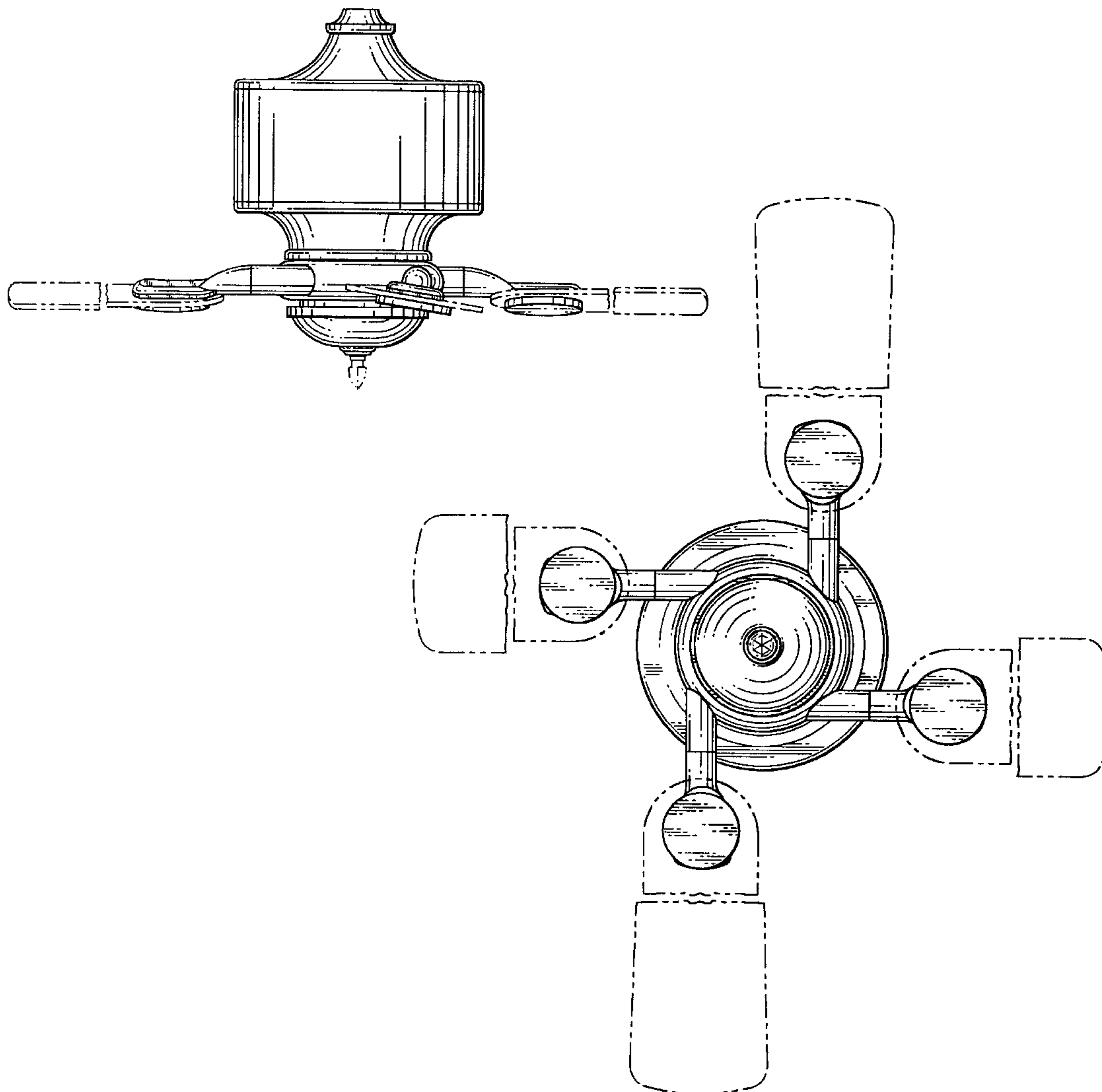
The ornamental design for a combined ceiling fan motor housing, support arms and blade irons unit, as shown and described.

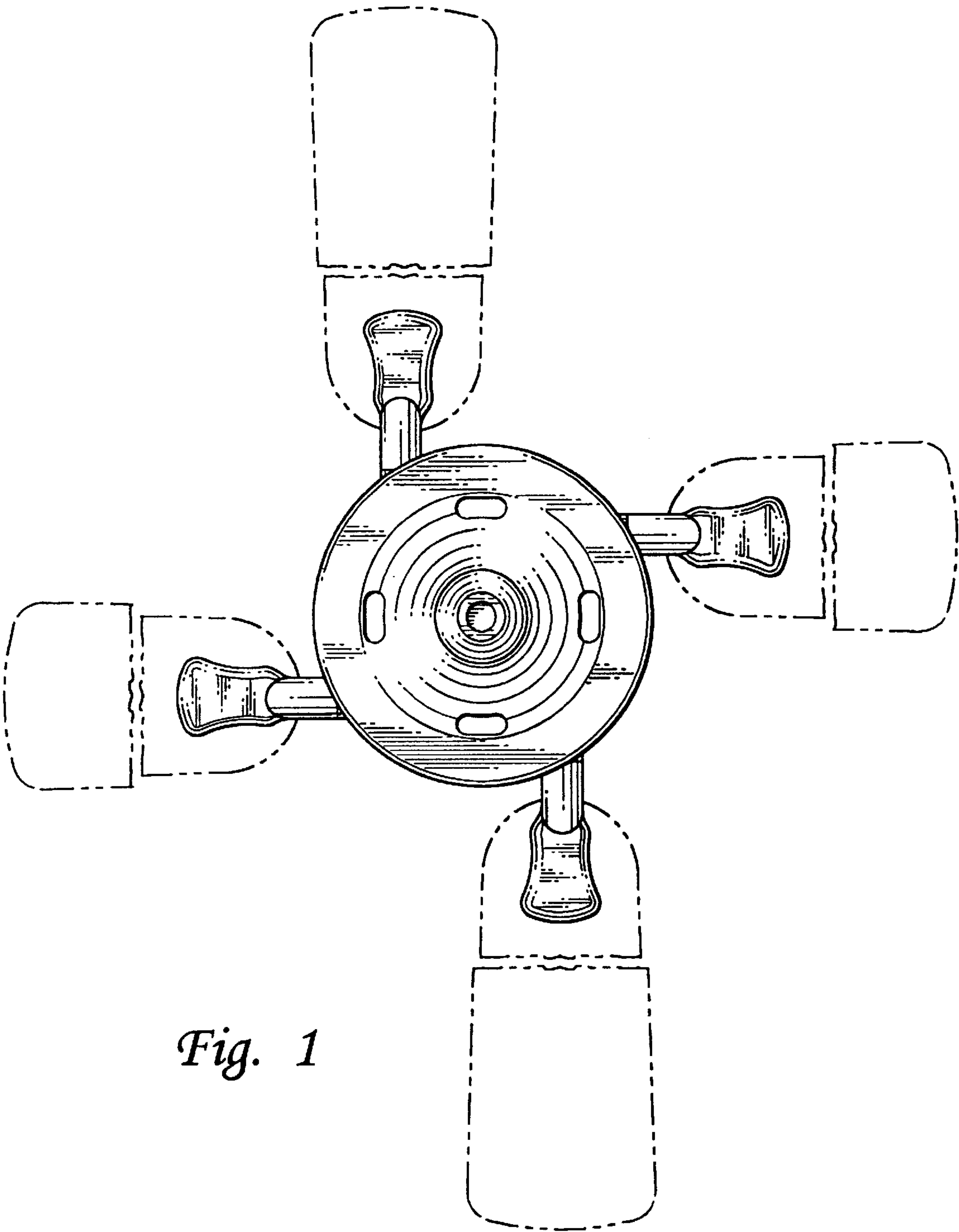

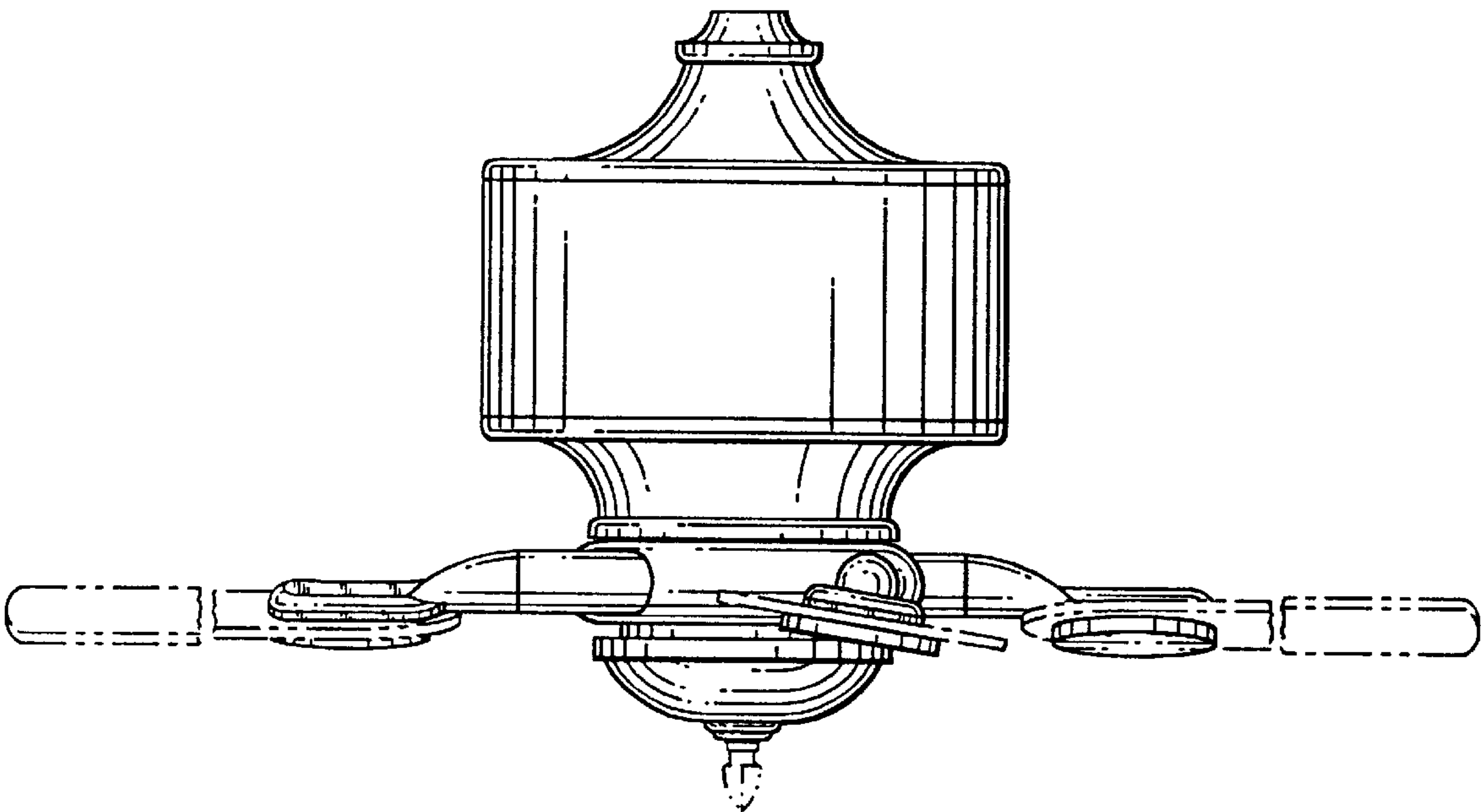

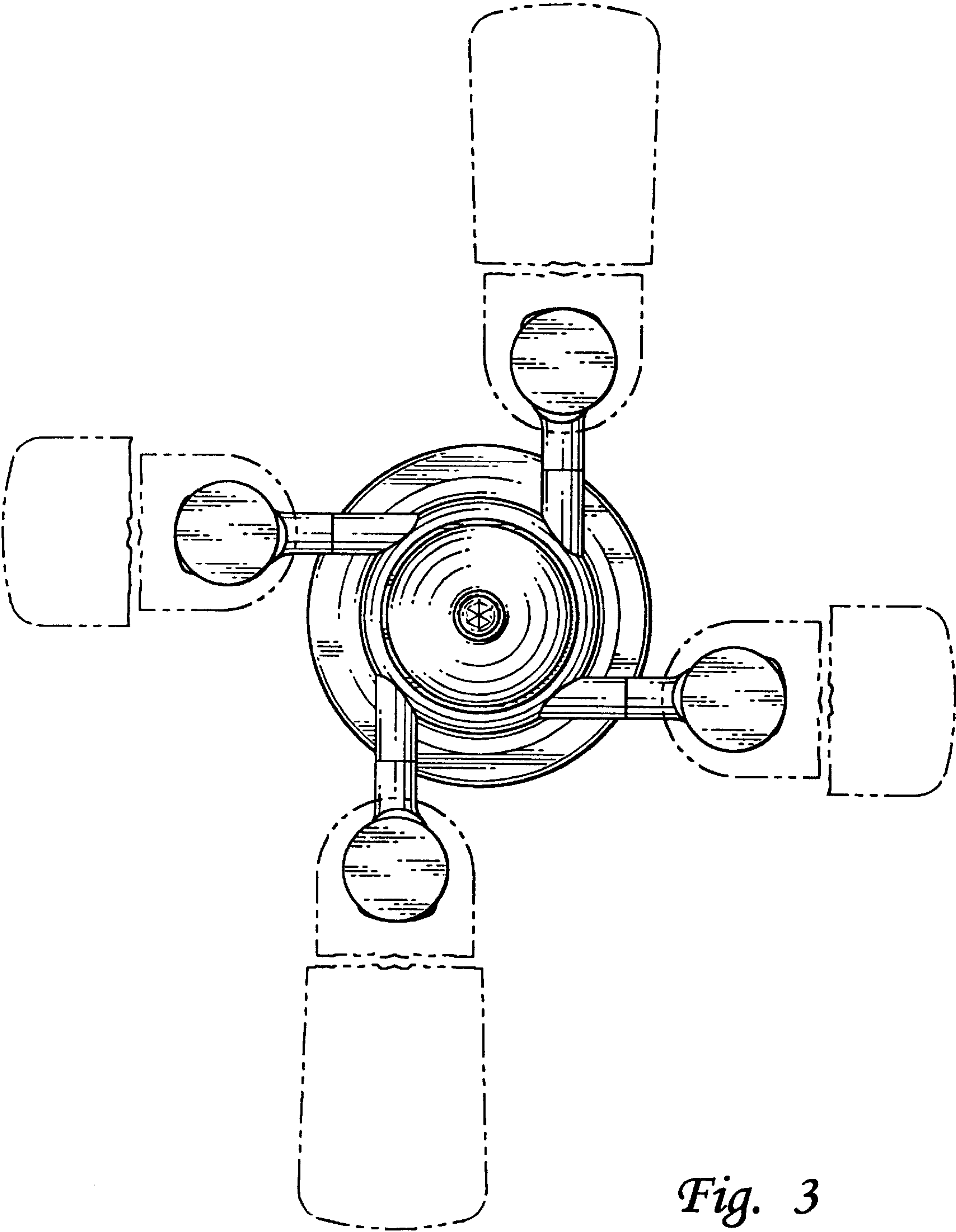
