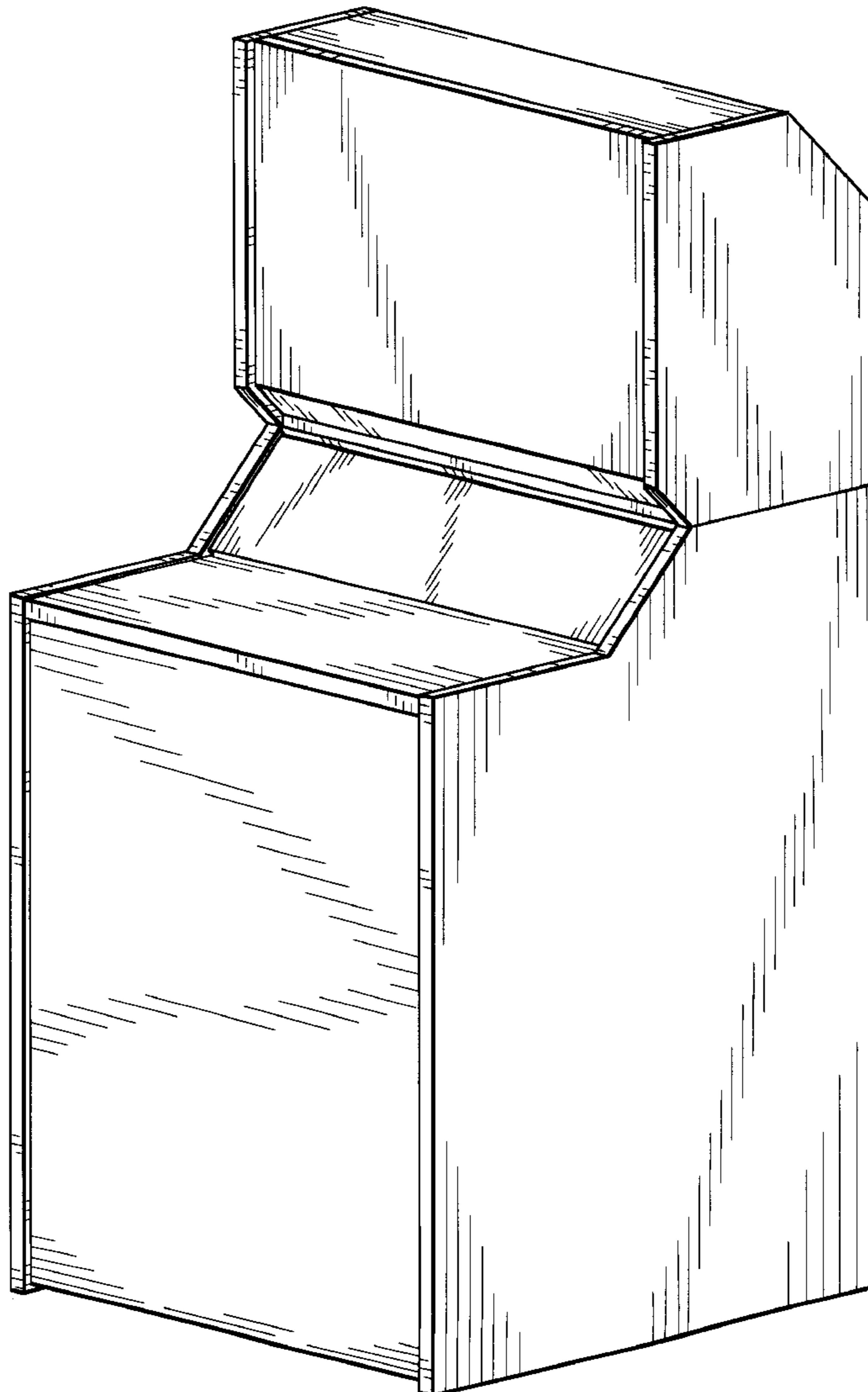
FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a coin redemption apparatus showing my design;

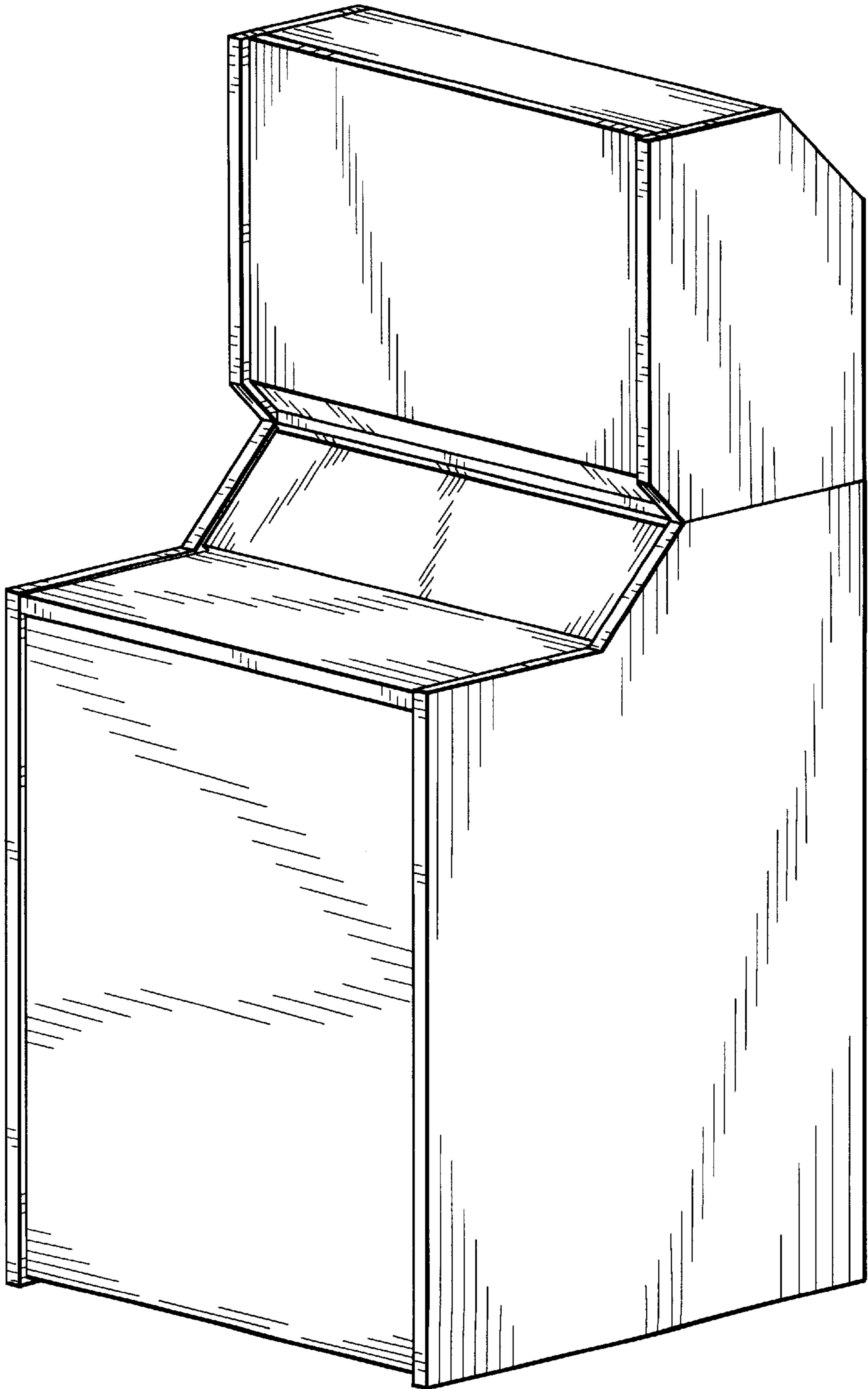

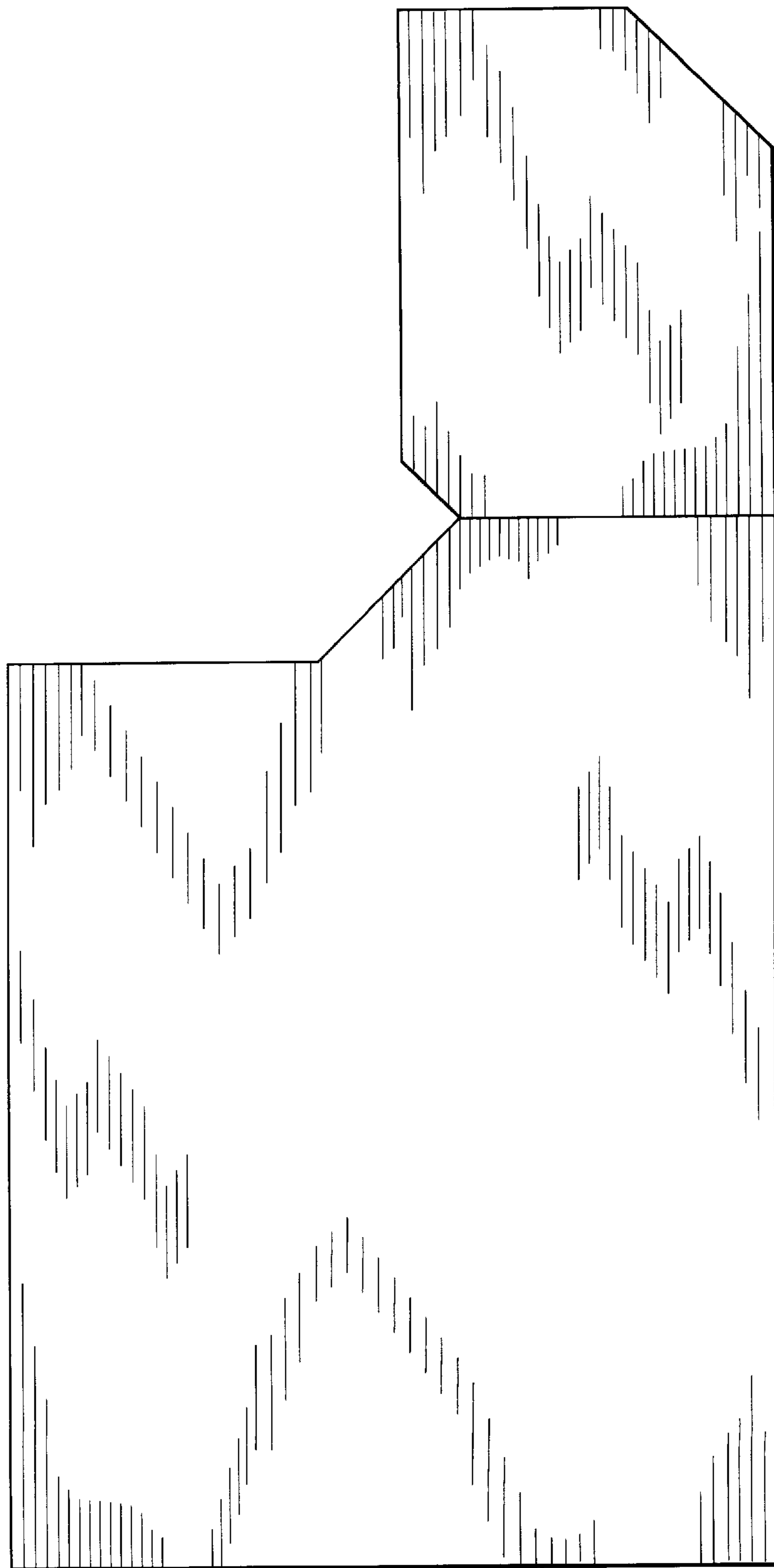

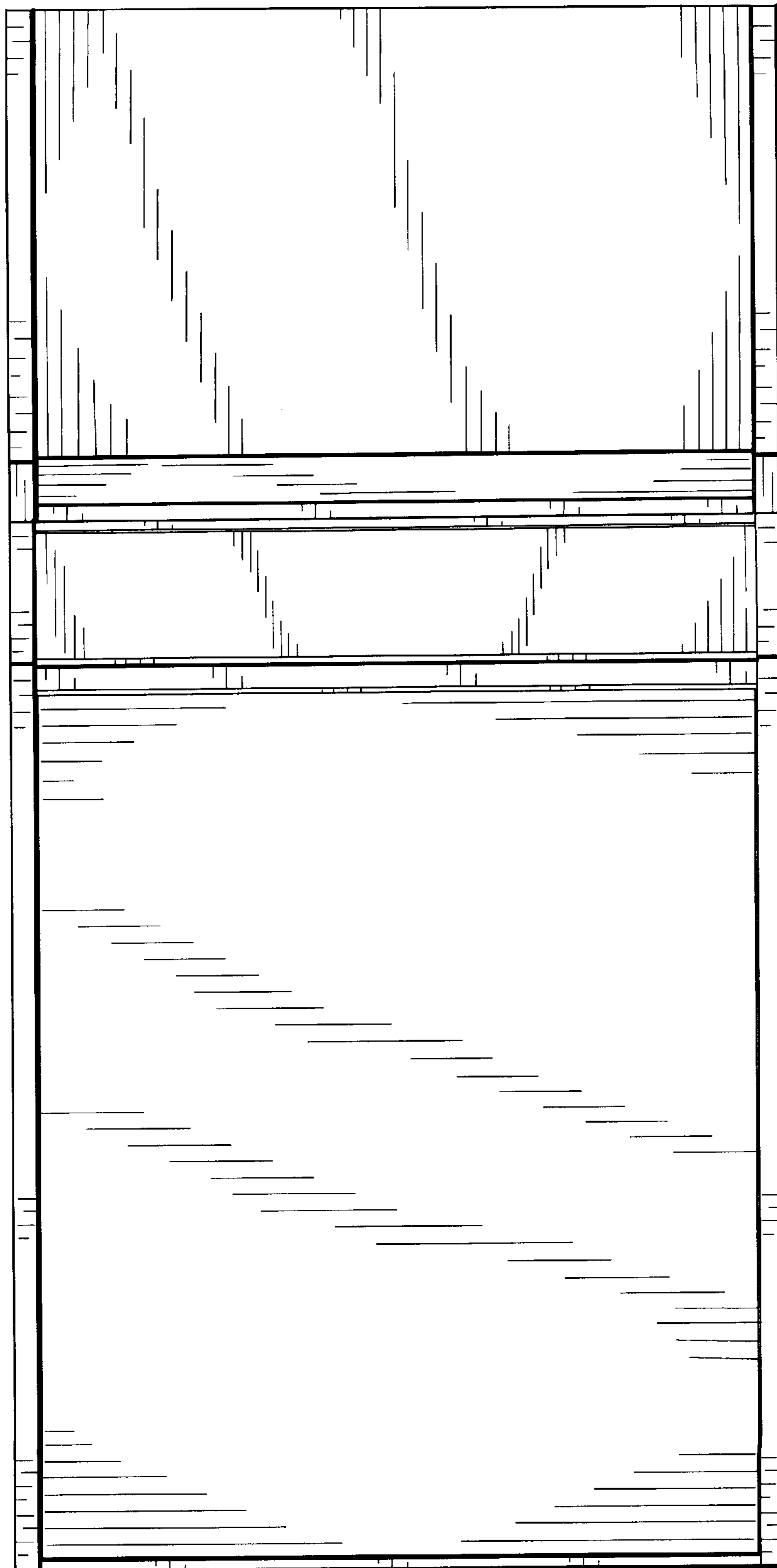

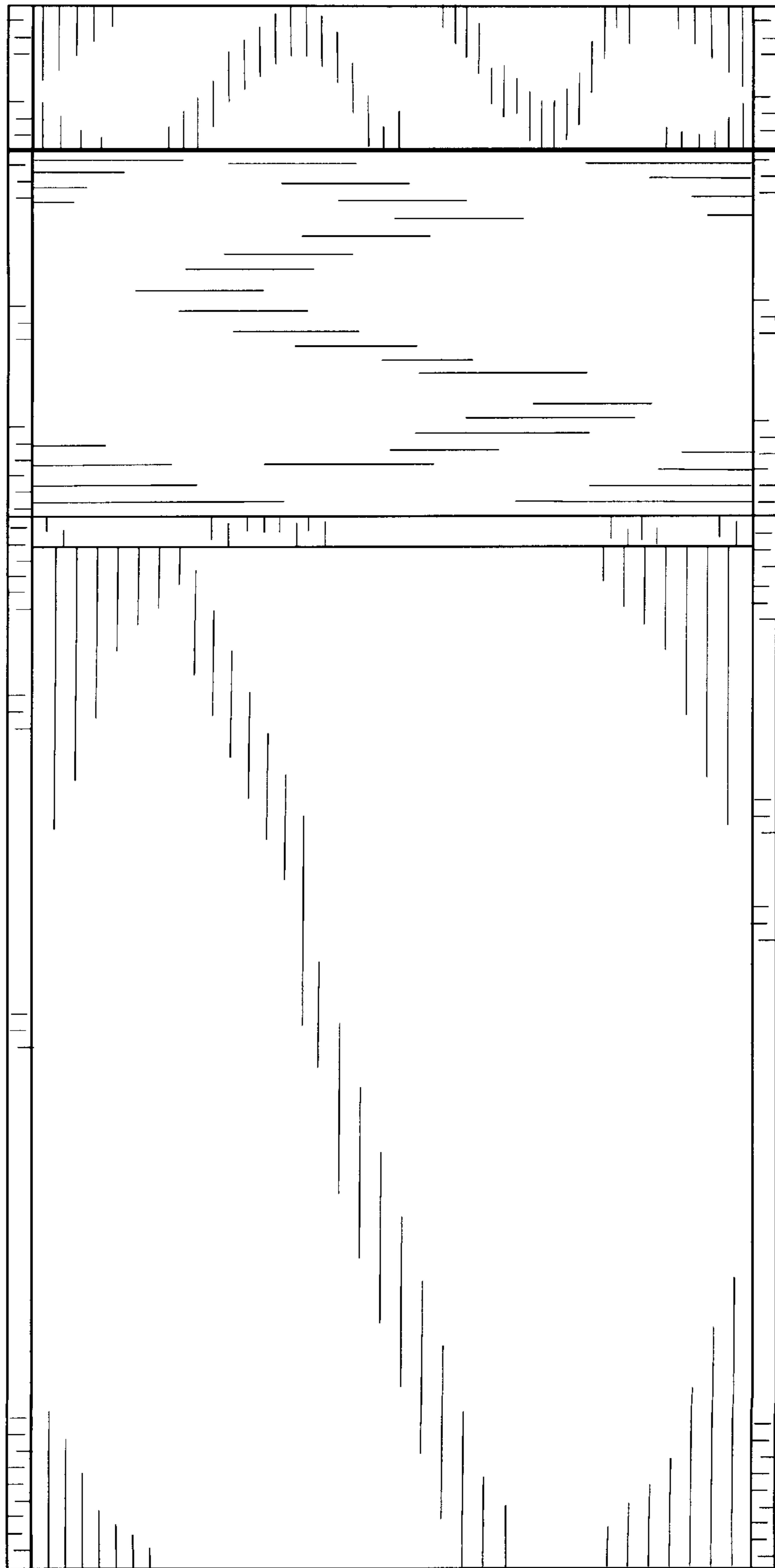

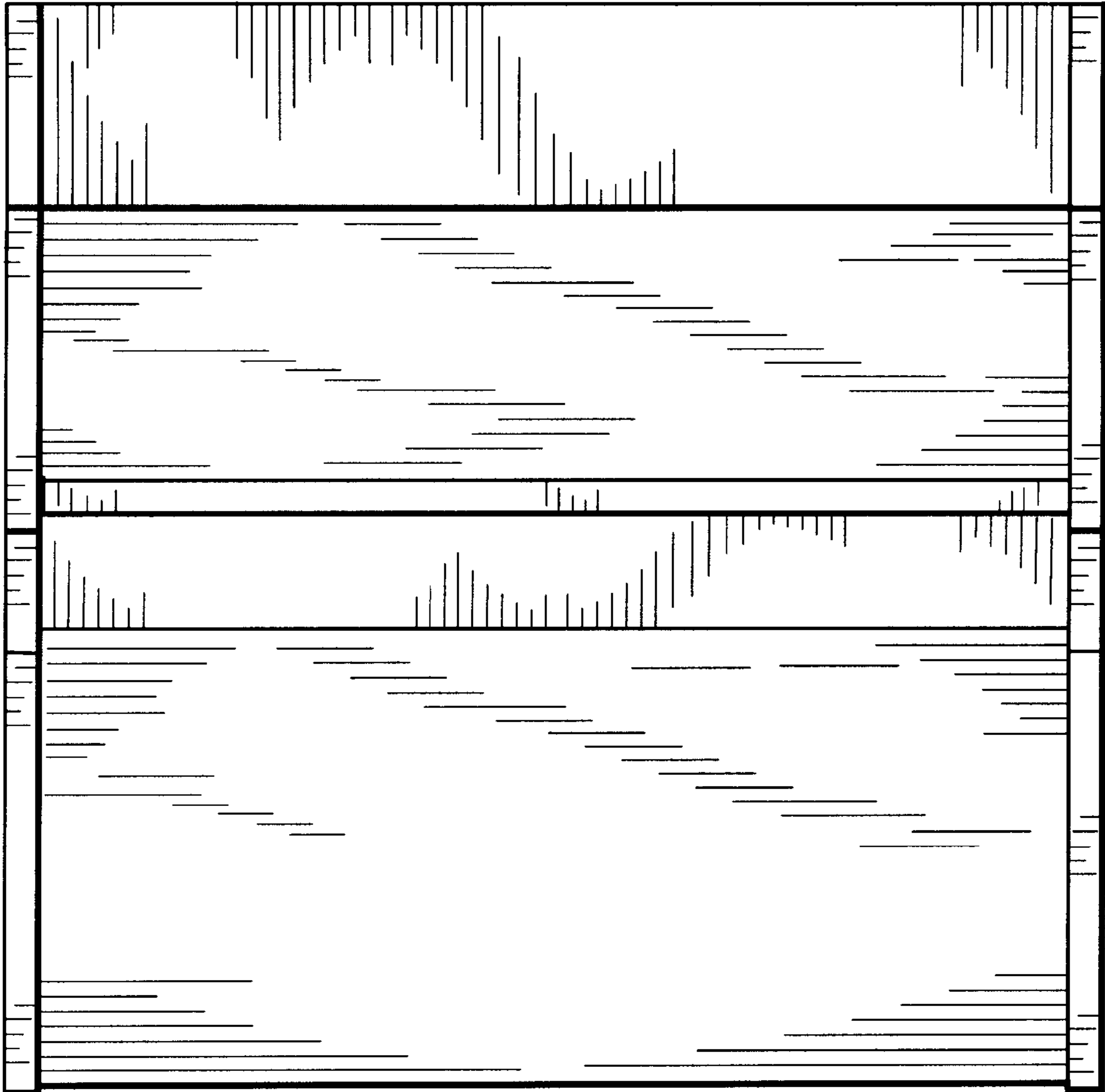

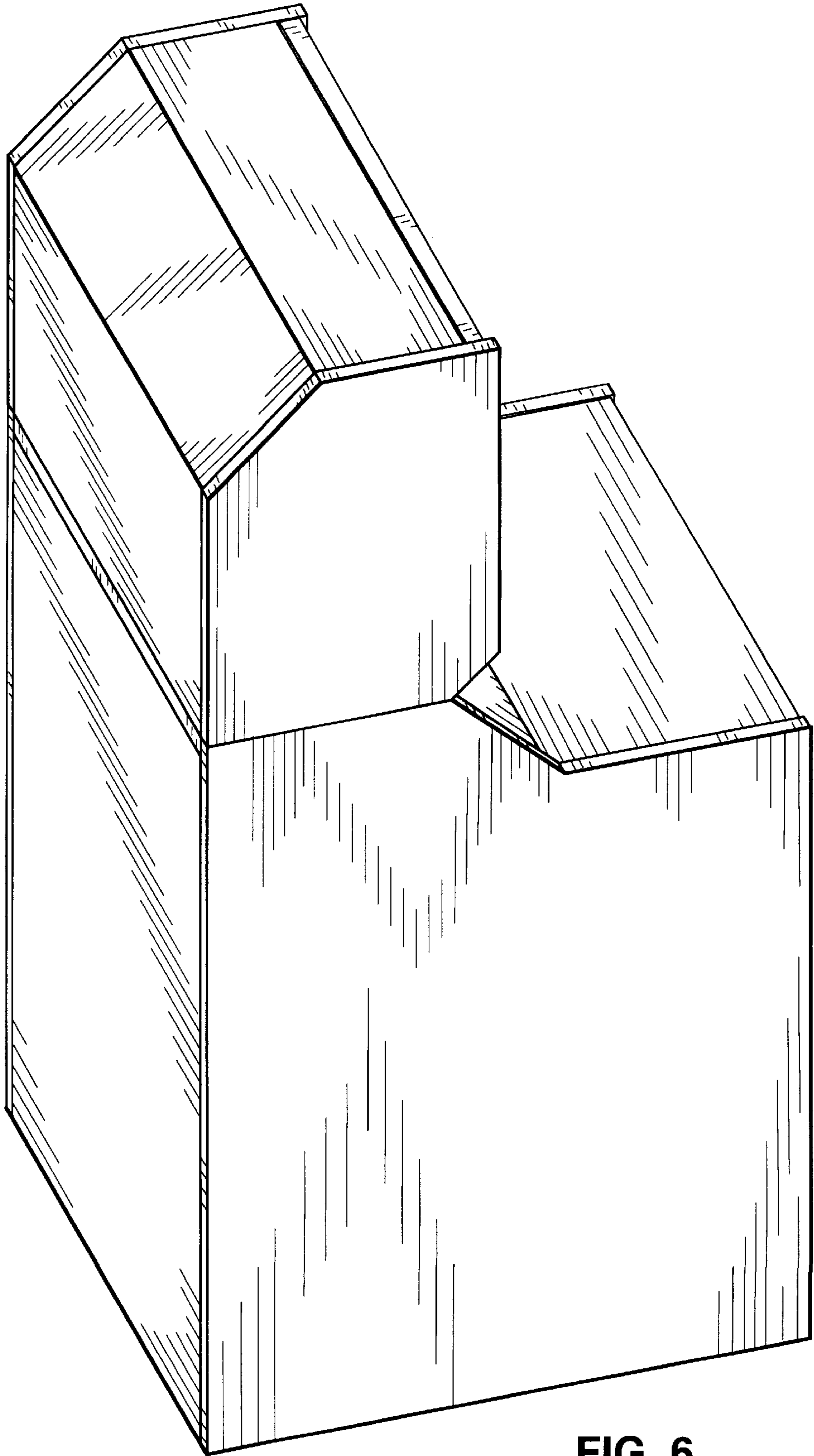
