FIG. 2: is a rear elevation view thereof;

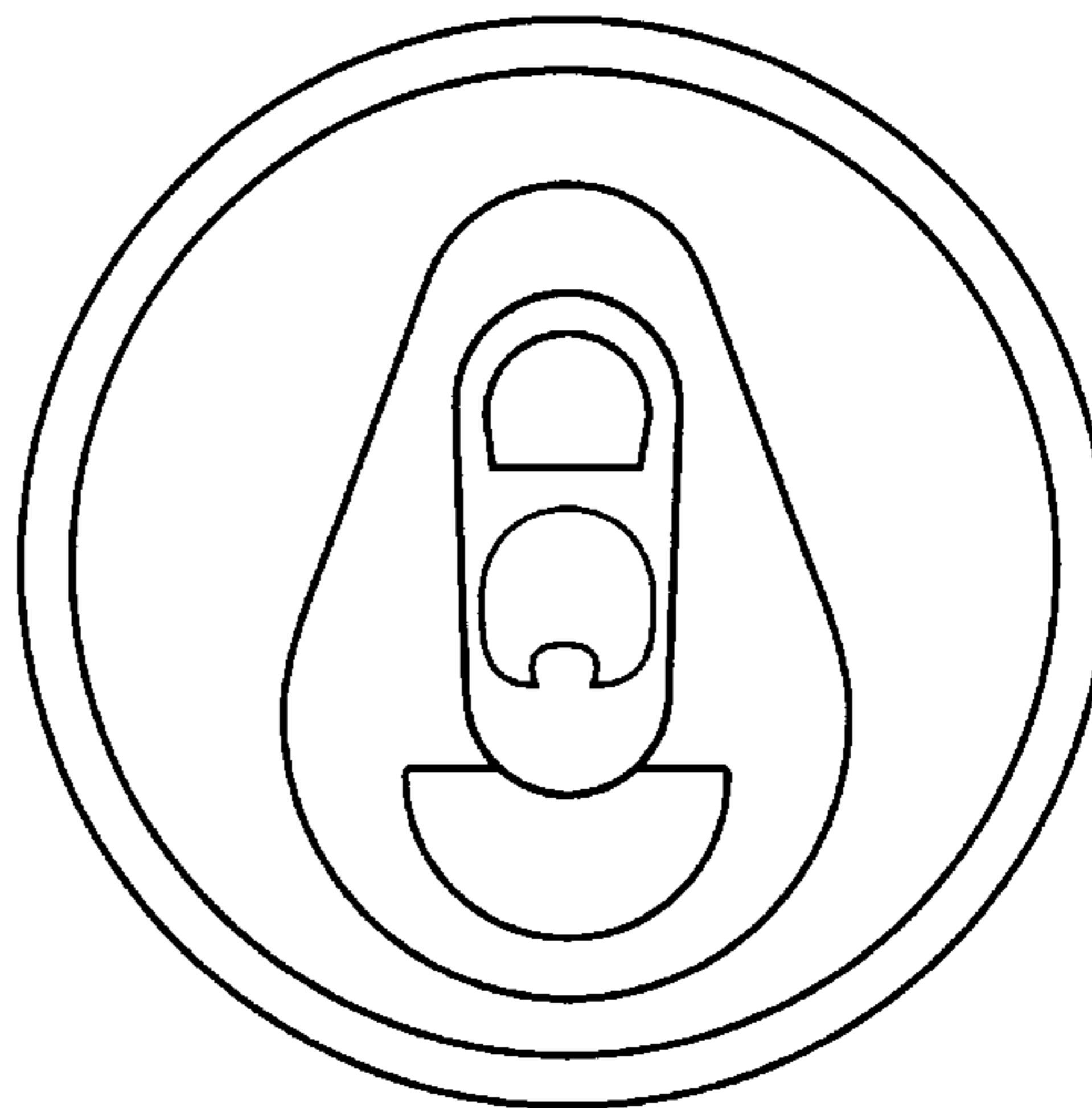
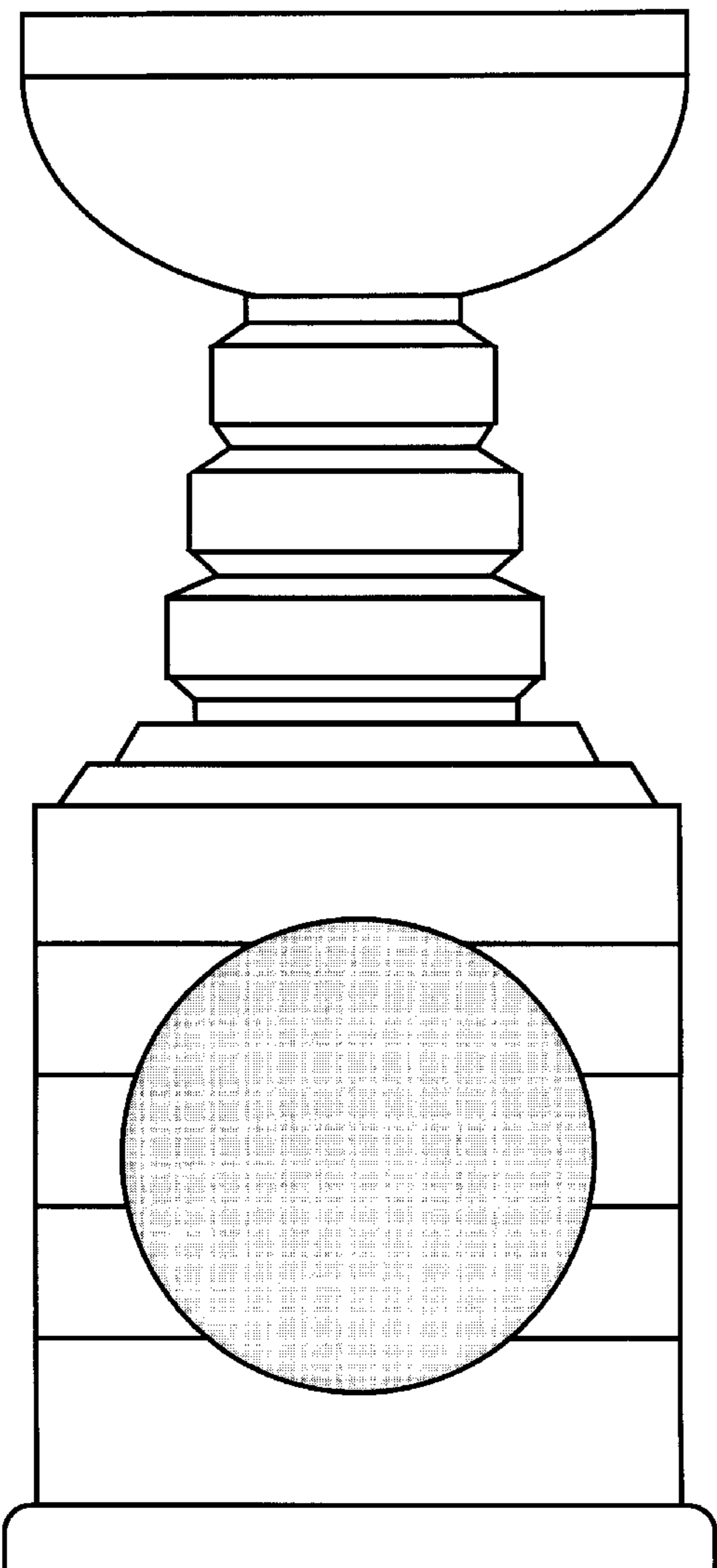
FIG. 3: is a left elevation view thereof;

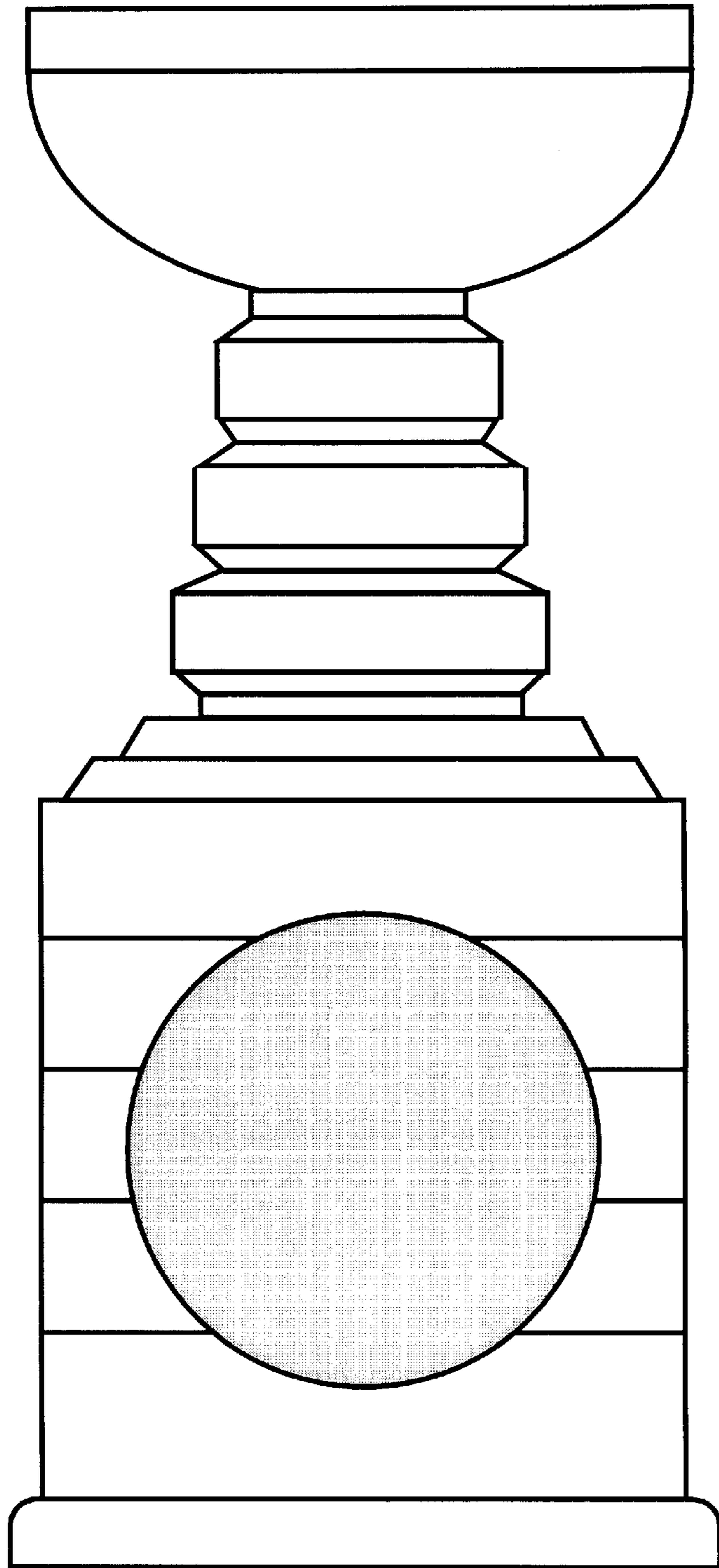

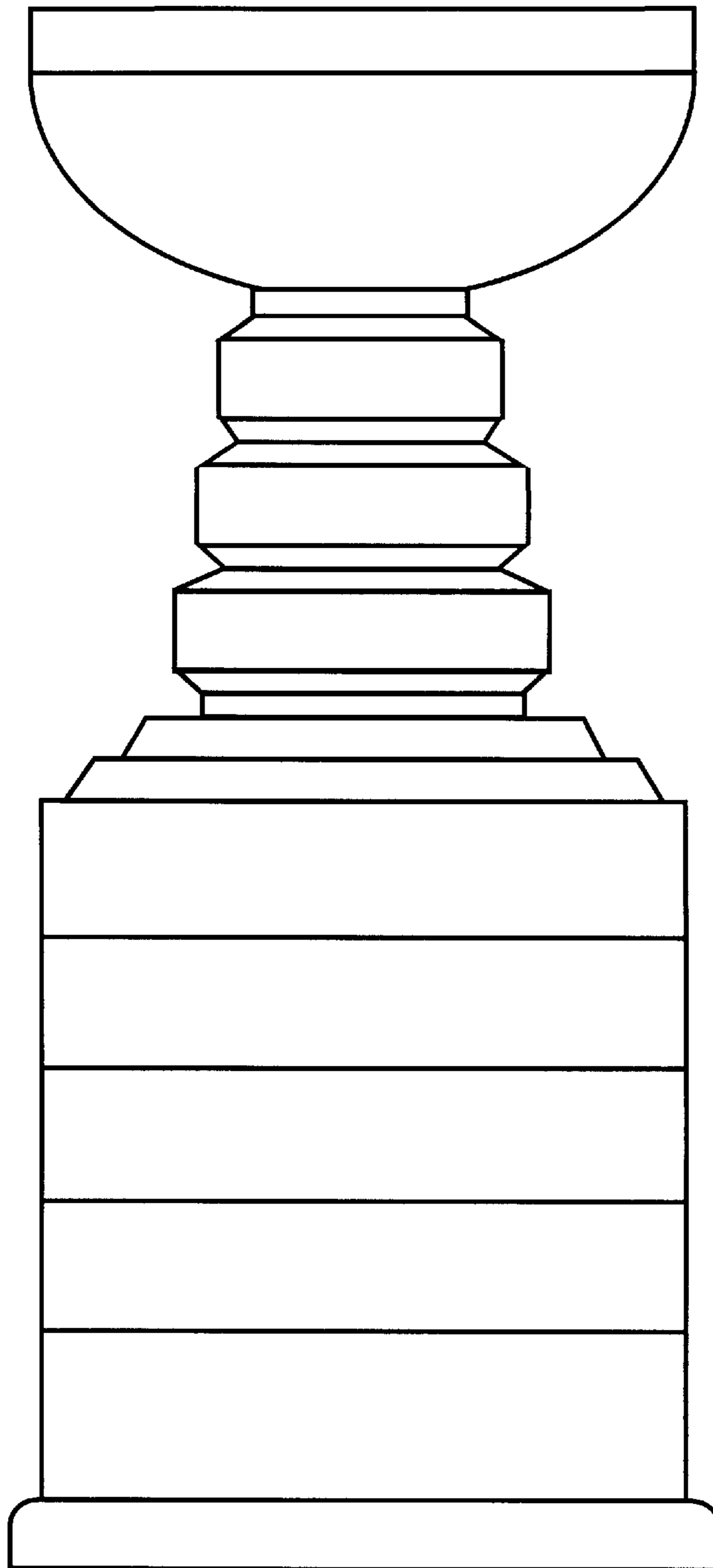

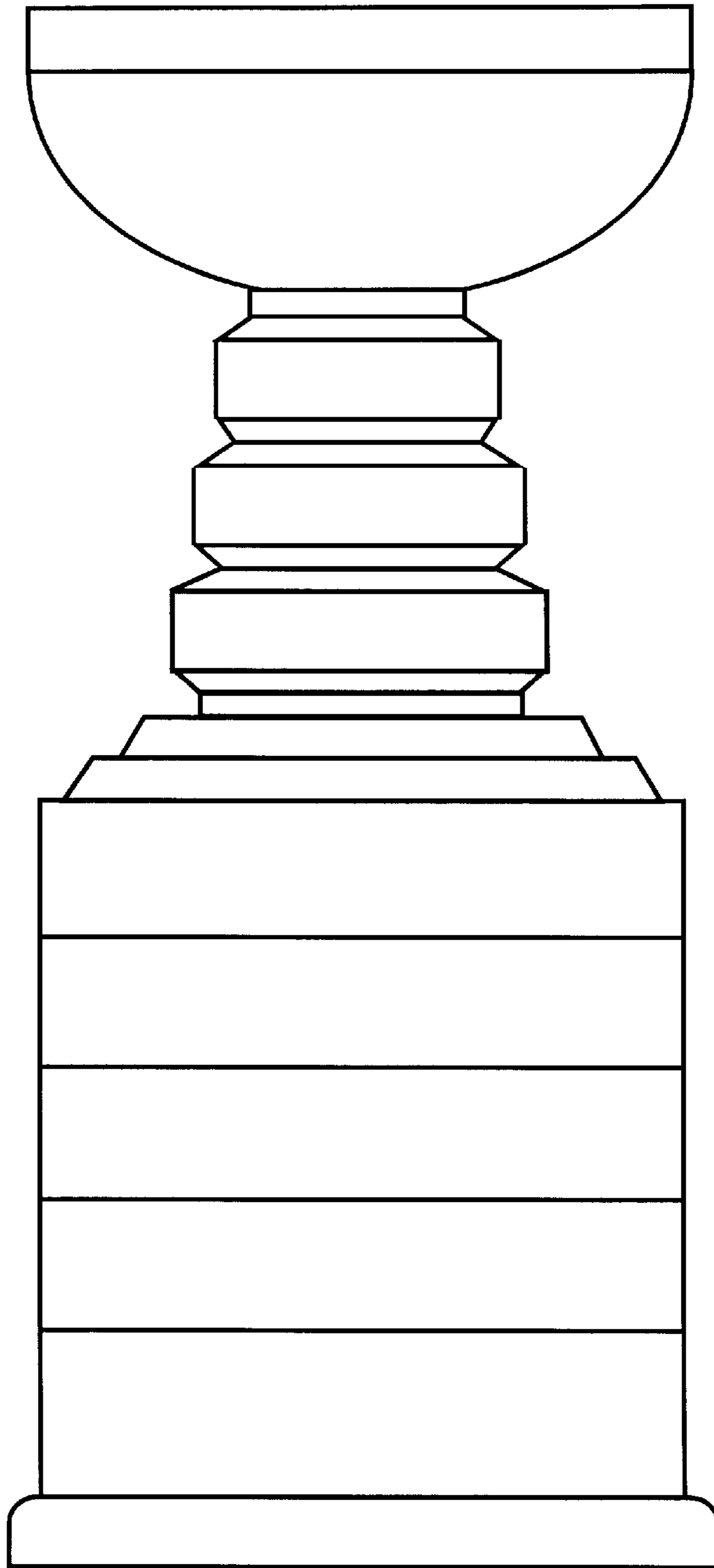

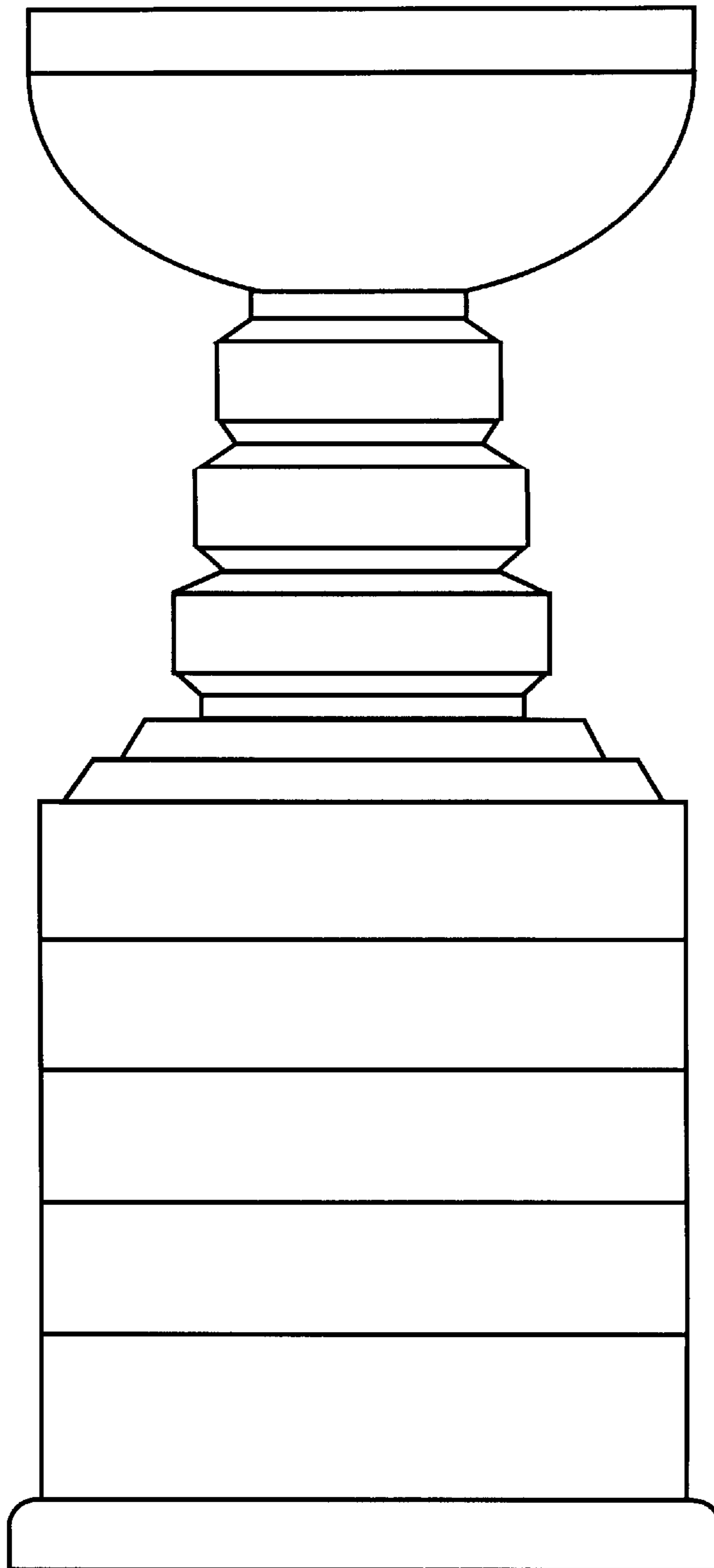

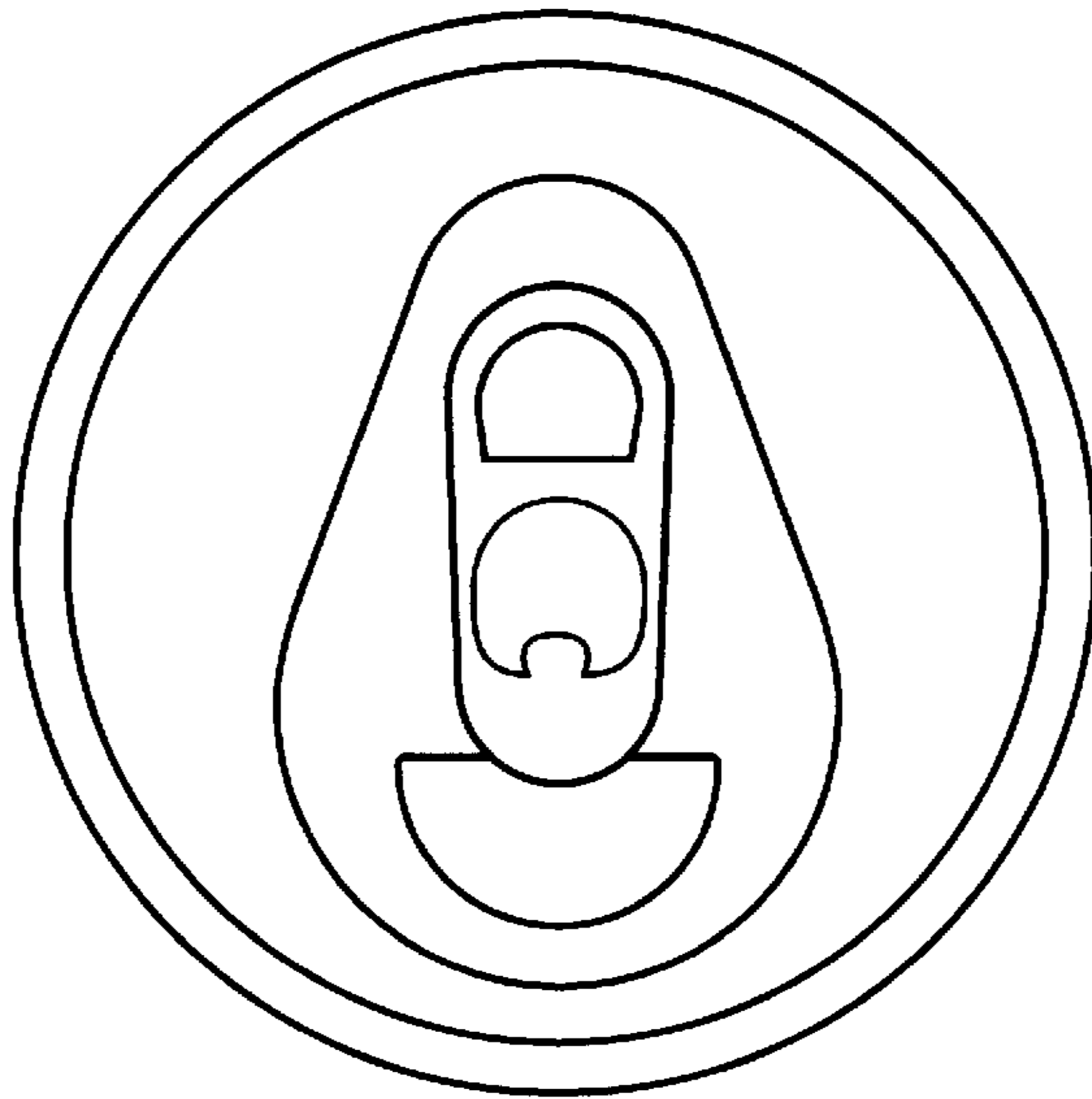

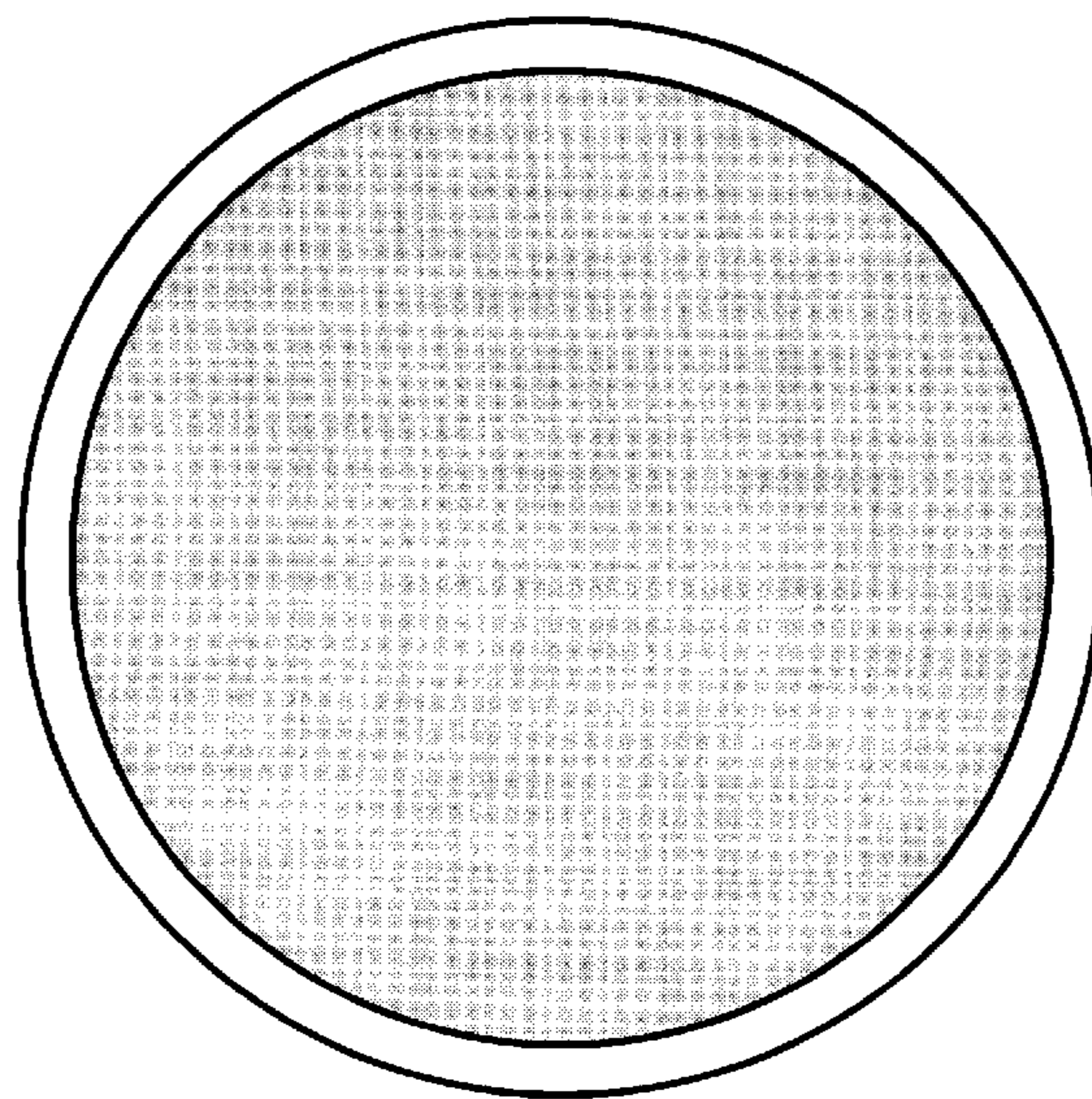
