DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the hitch mount bike rack and hitch cover showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

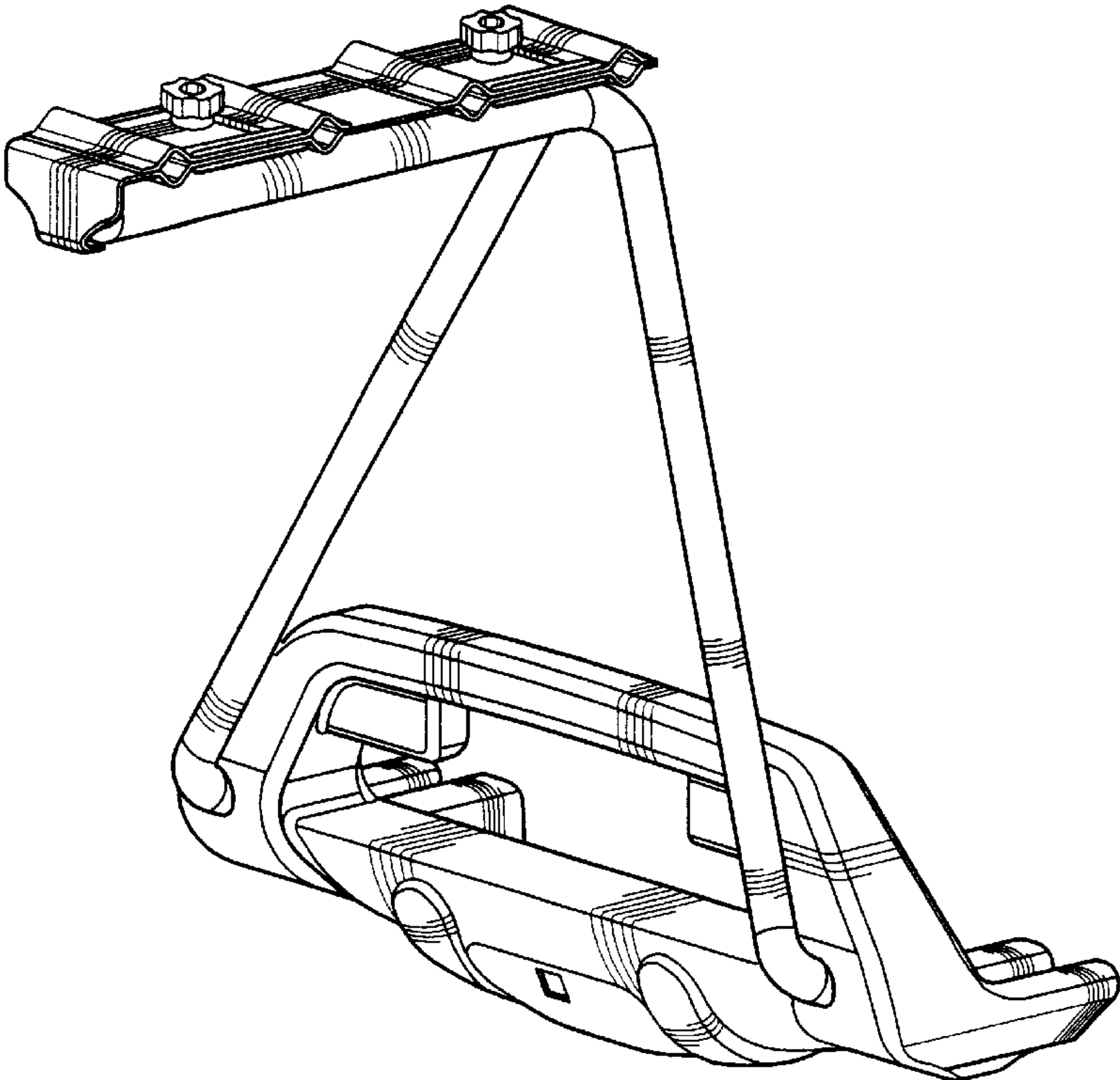

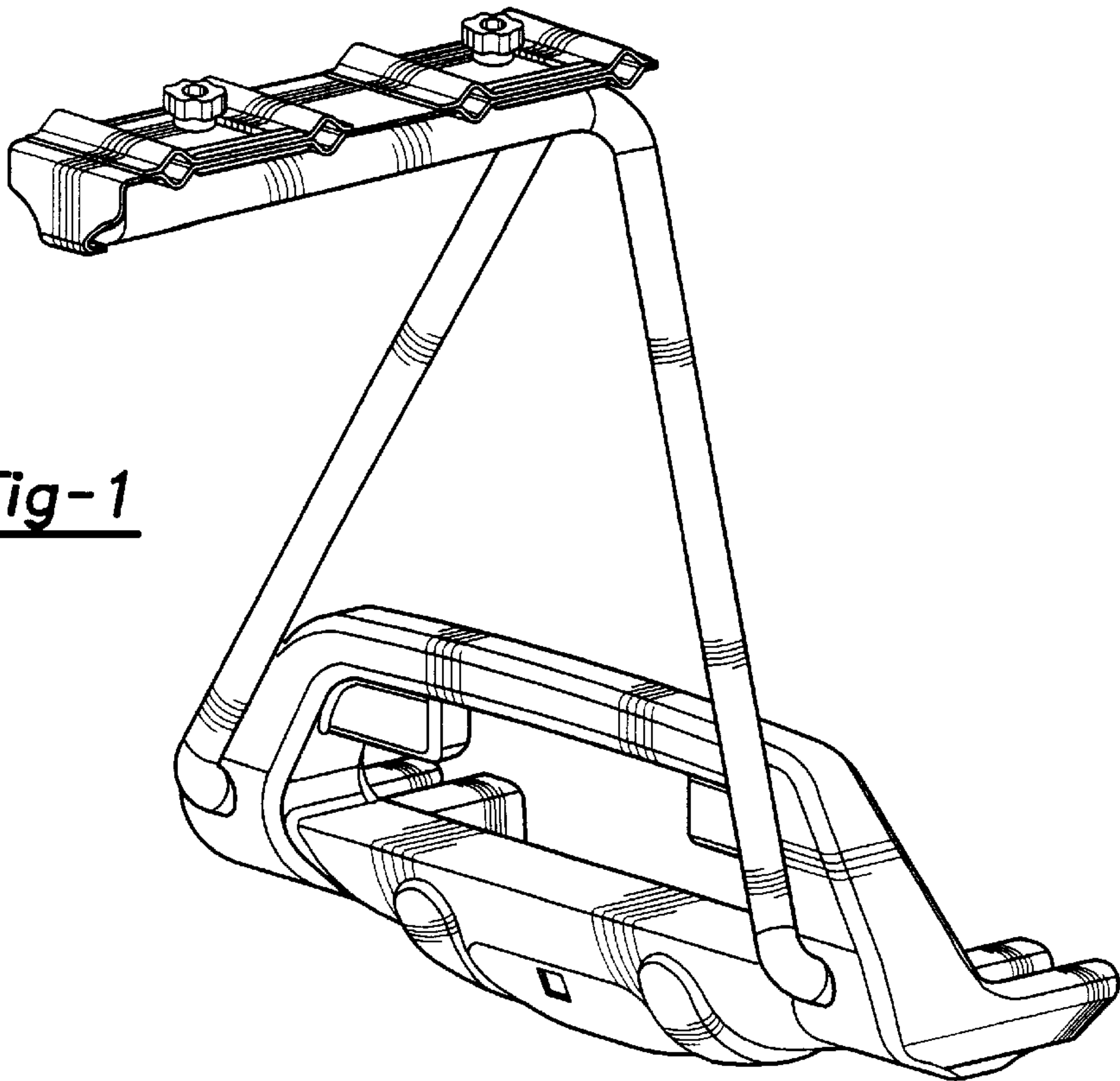
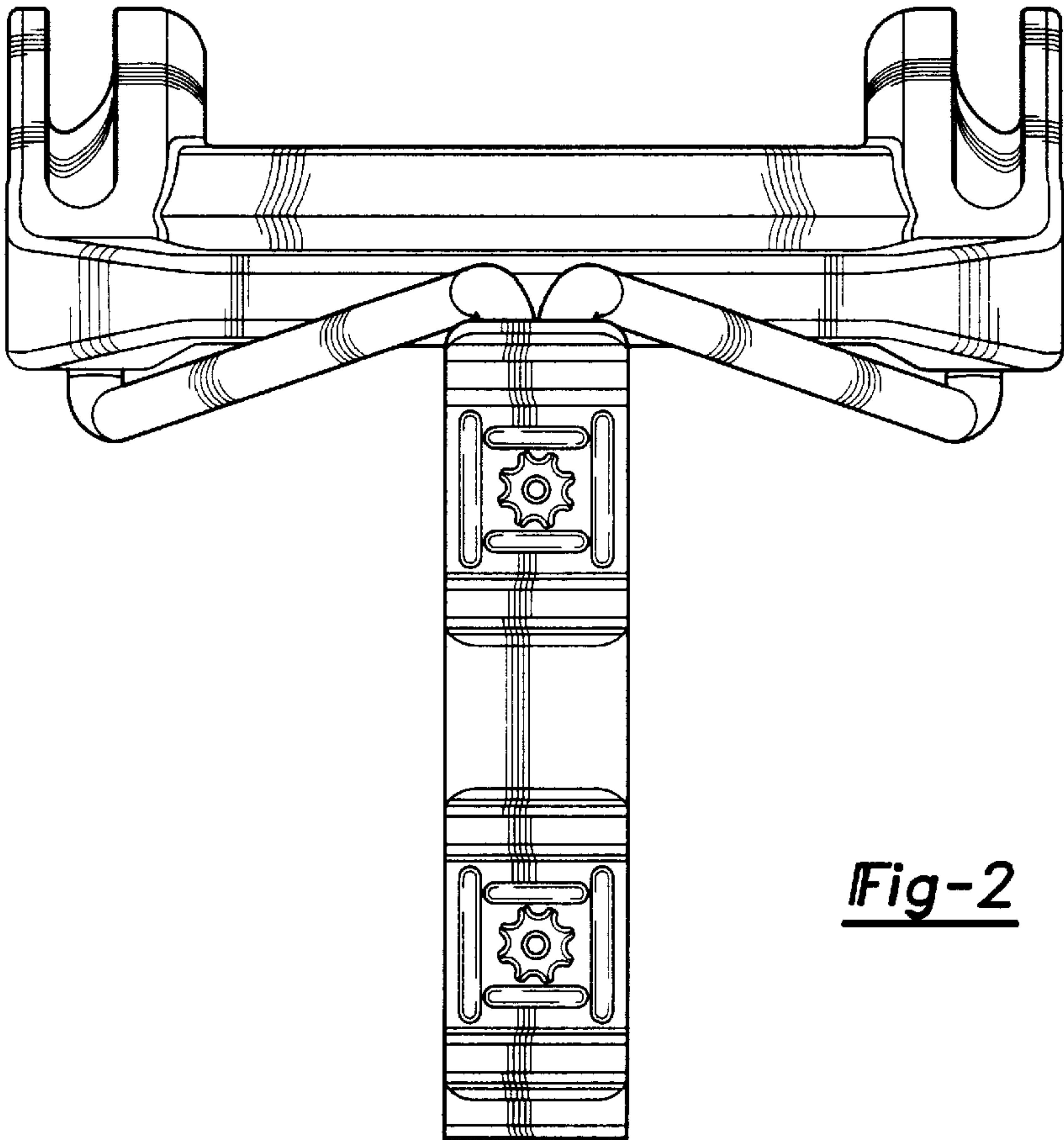

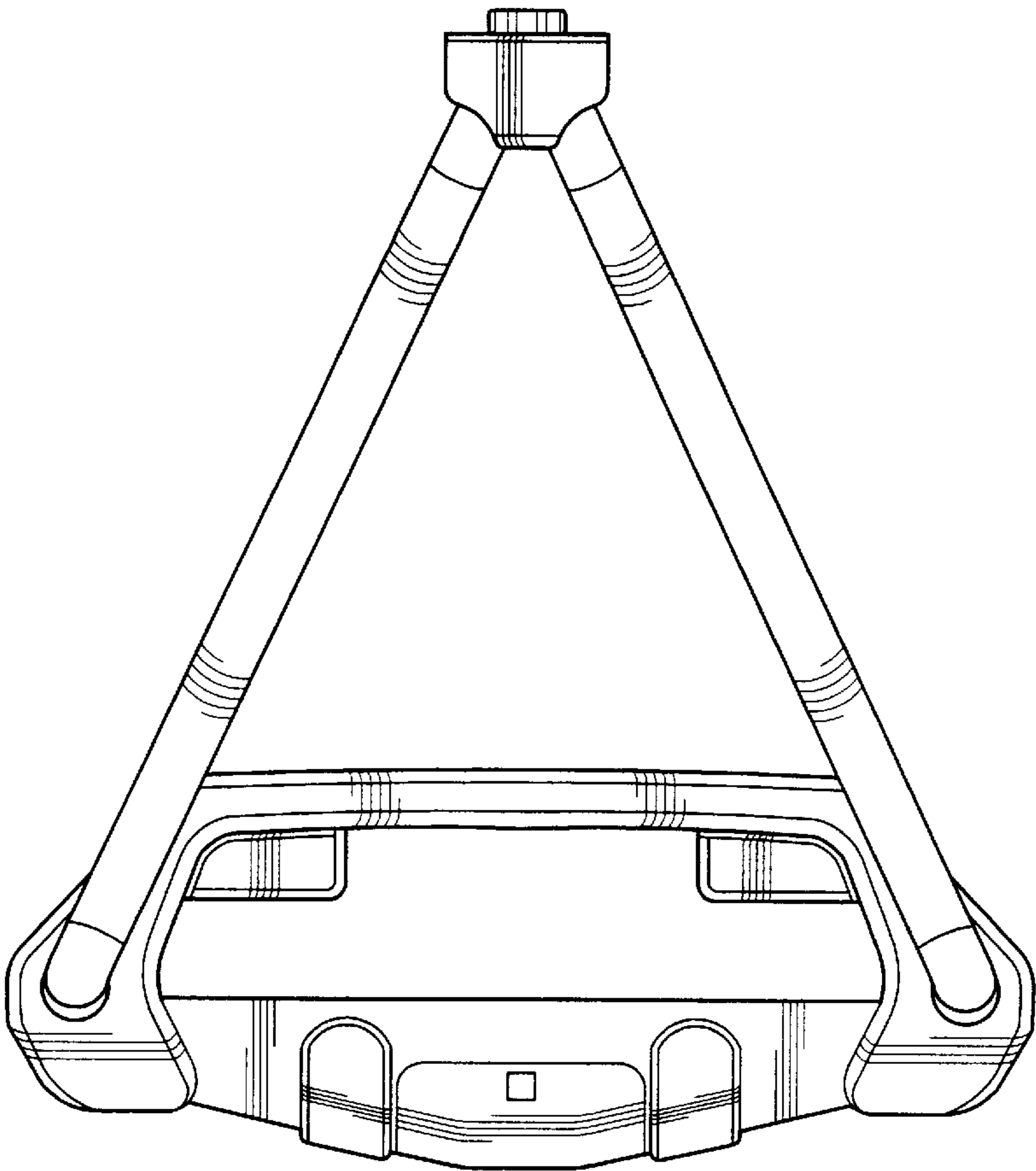

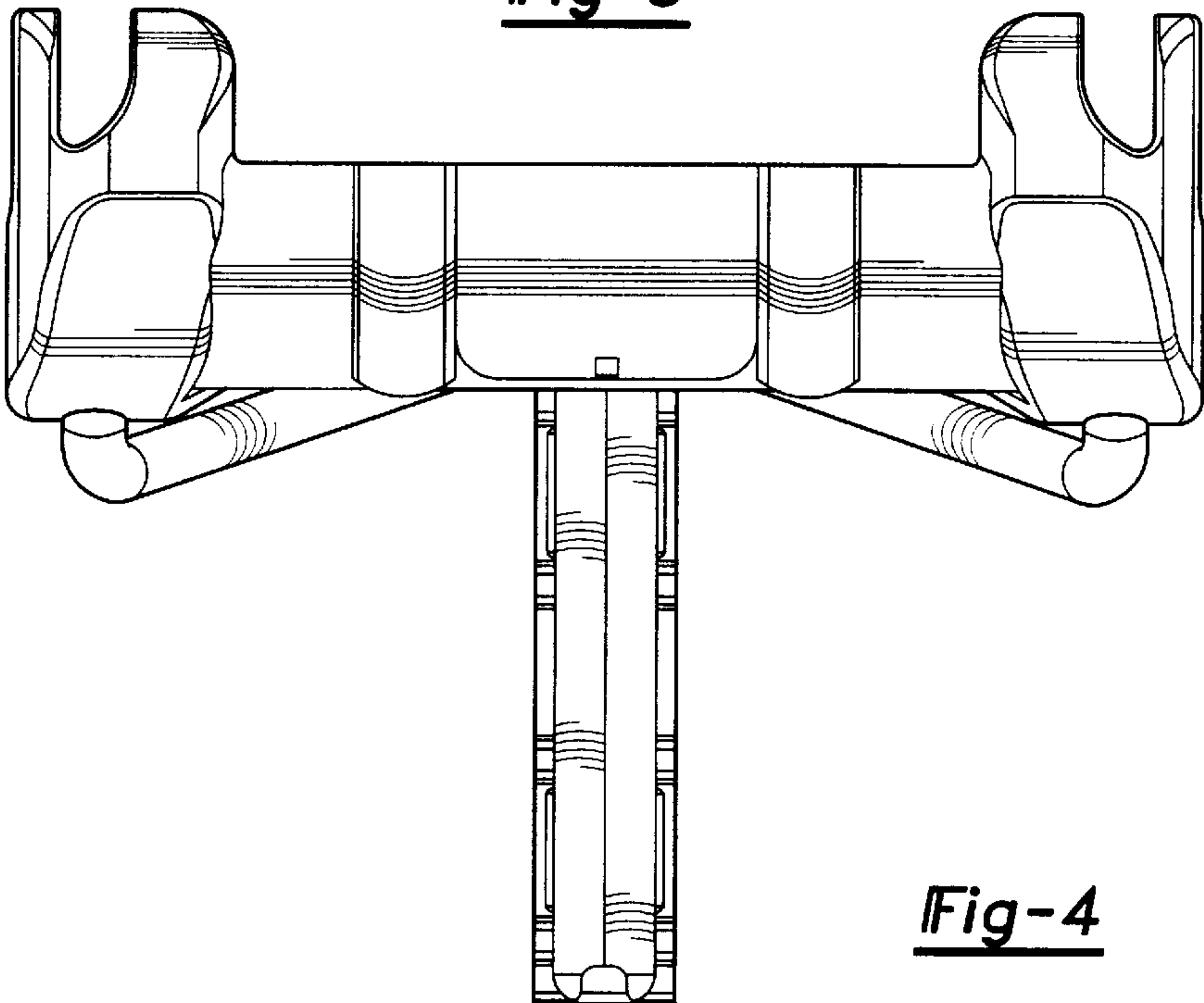

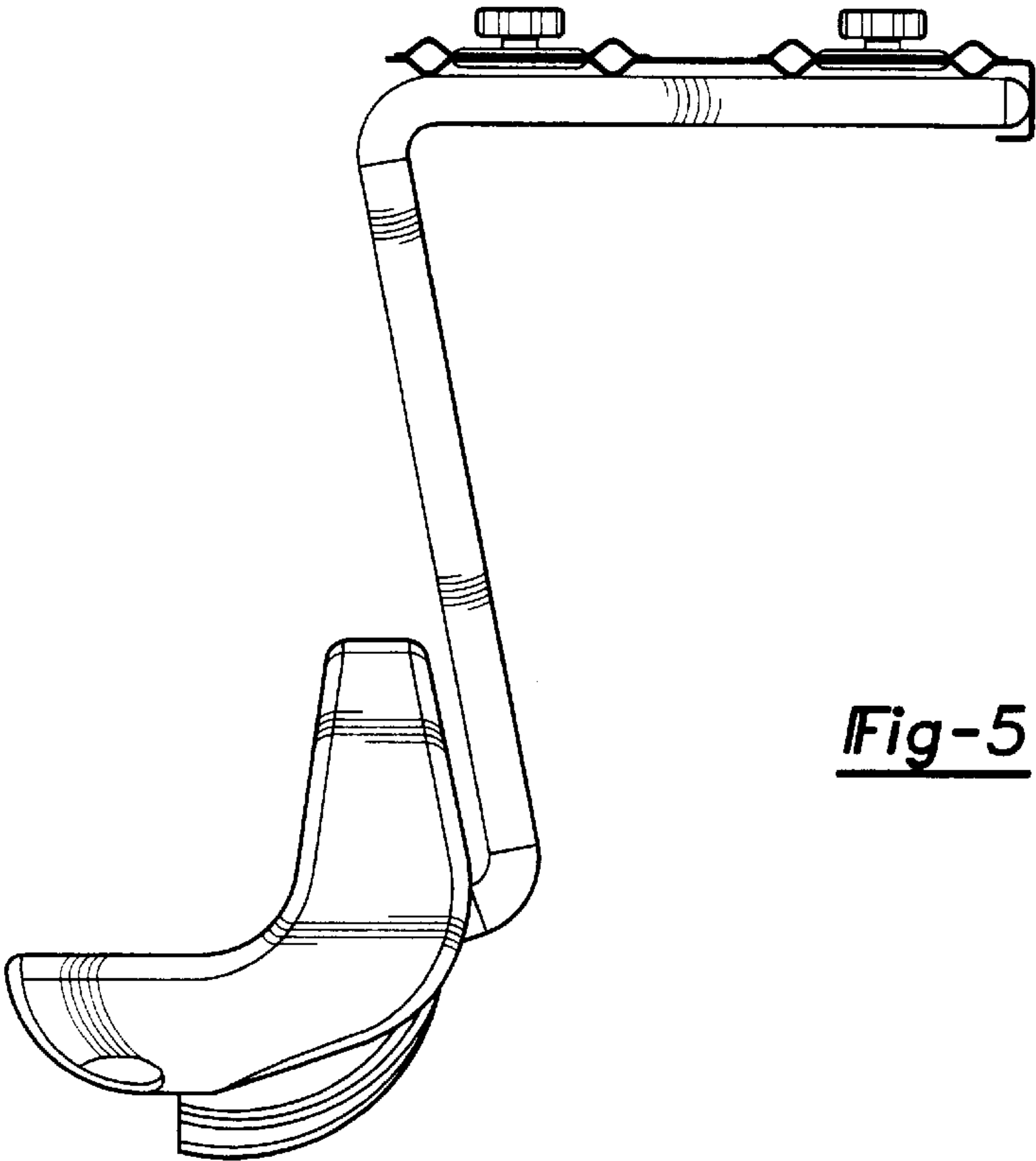

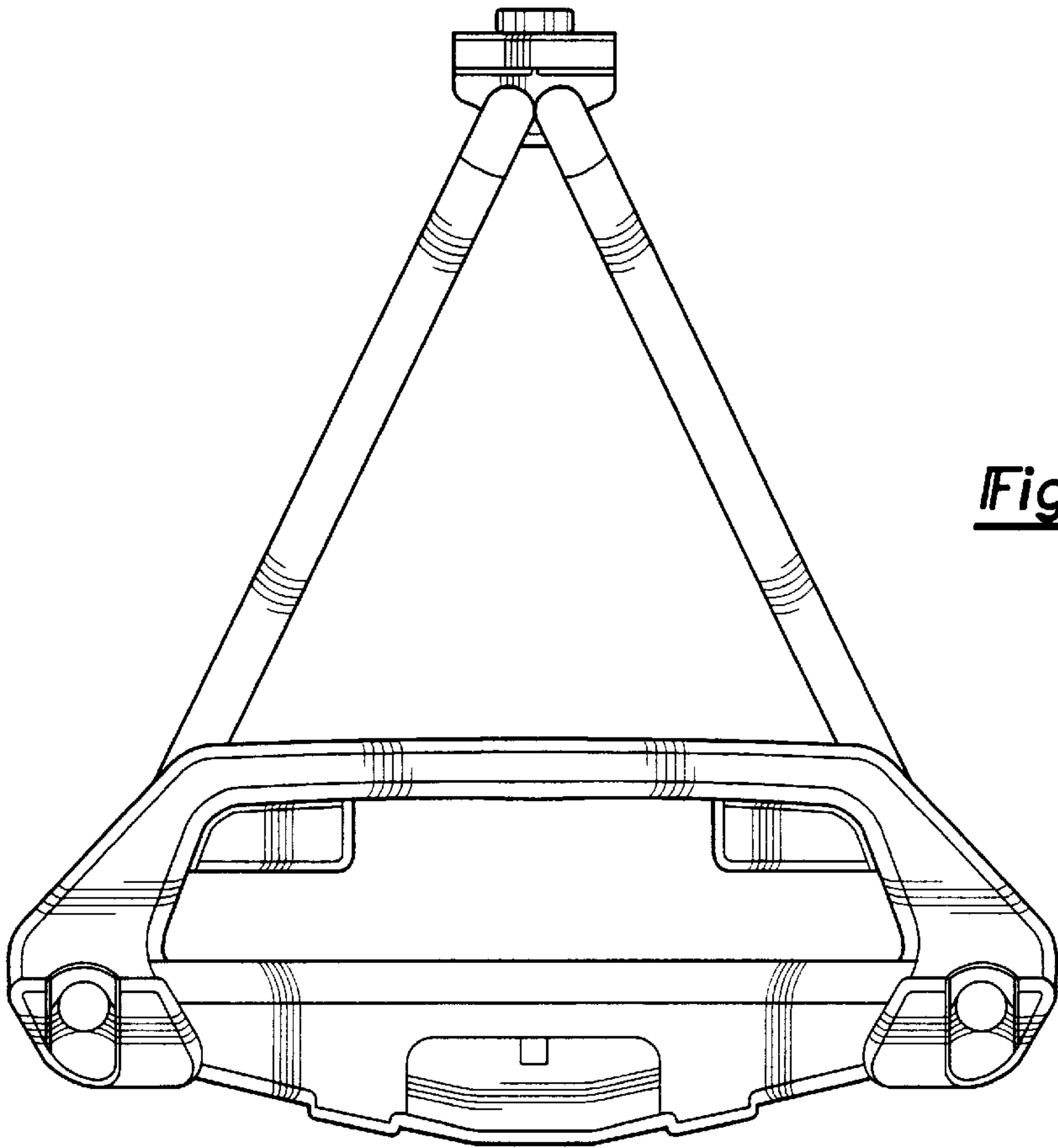
