The ornamental design for a deployable monitor, as shown and described.

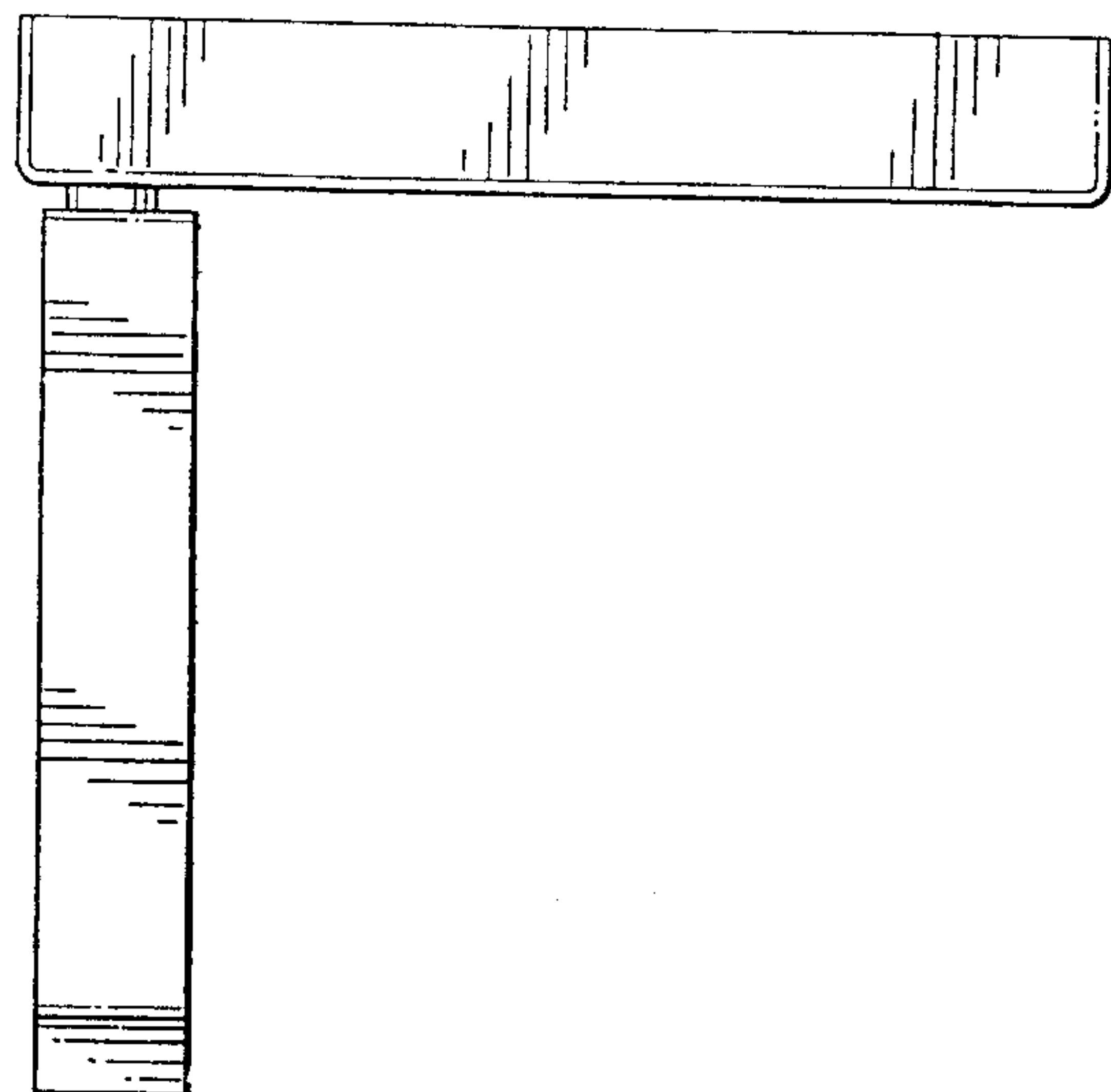
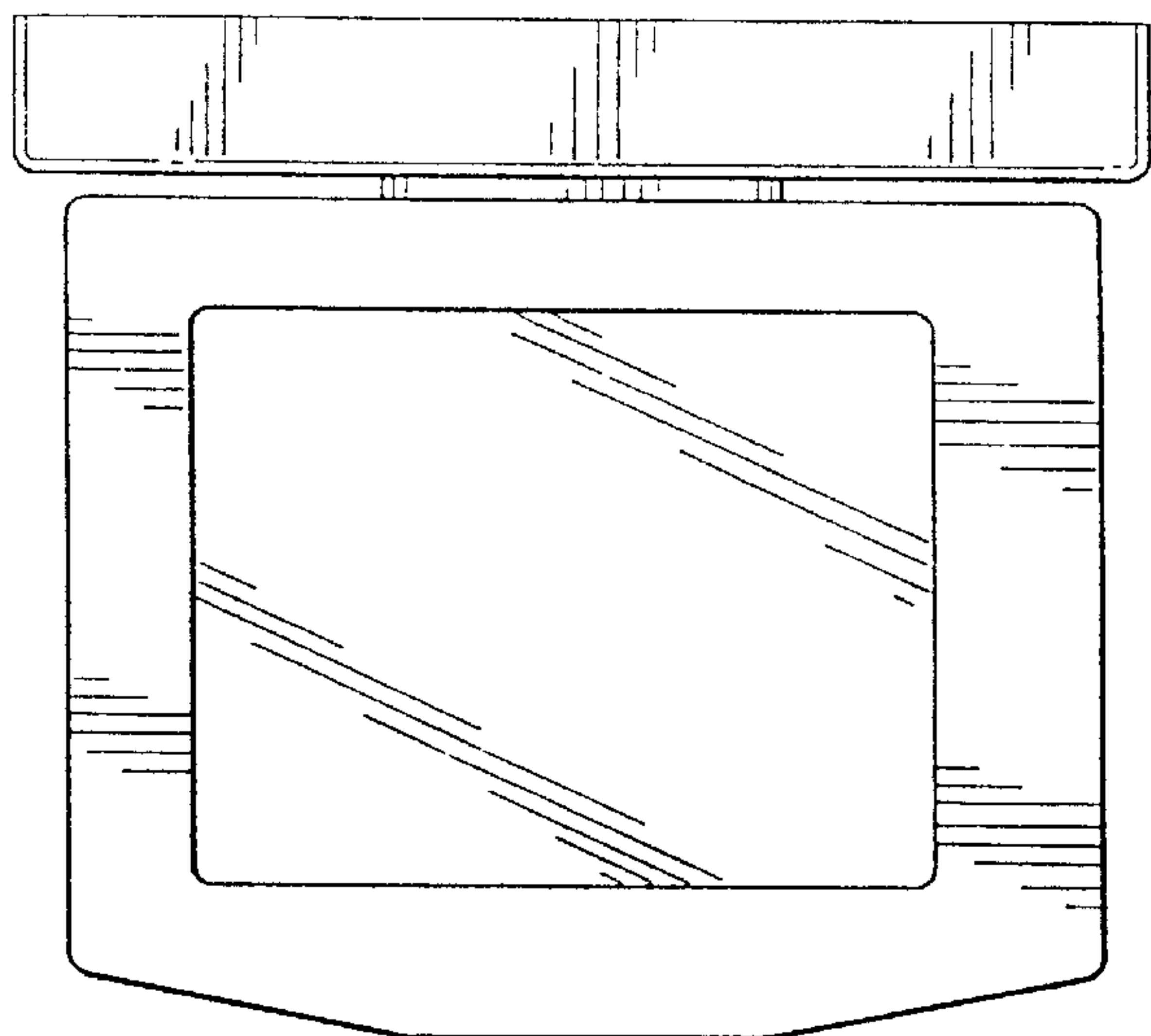
DESCRIPTION

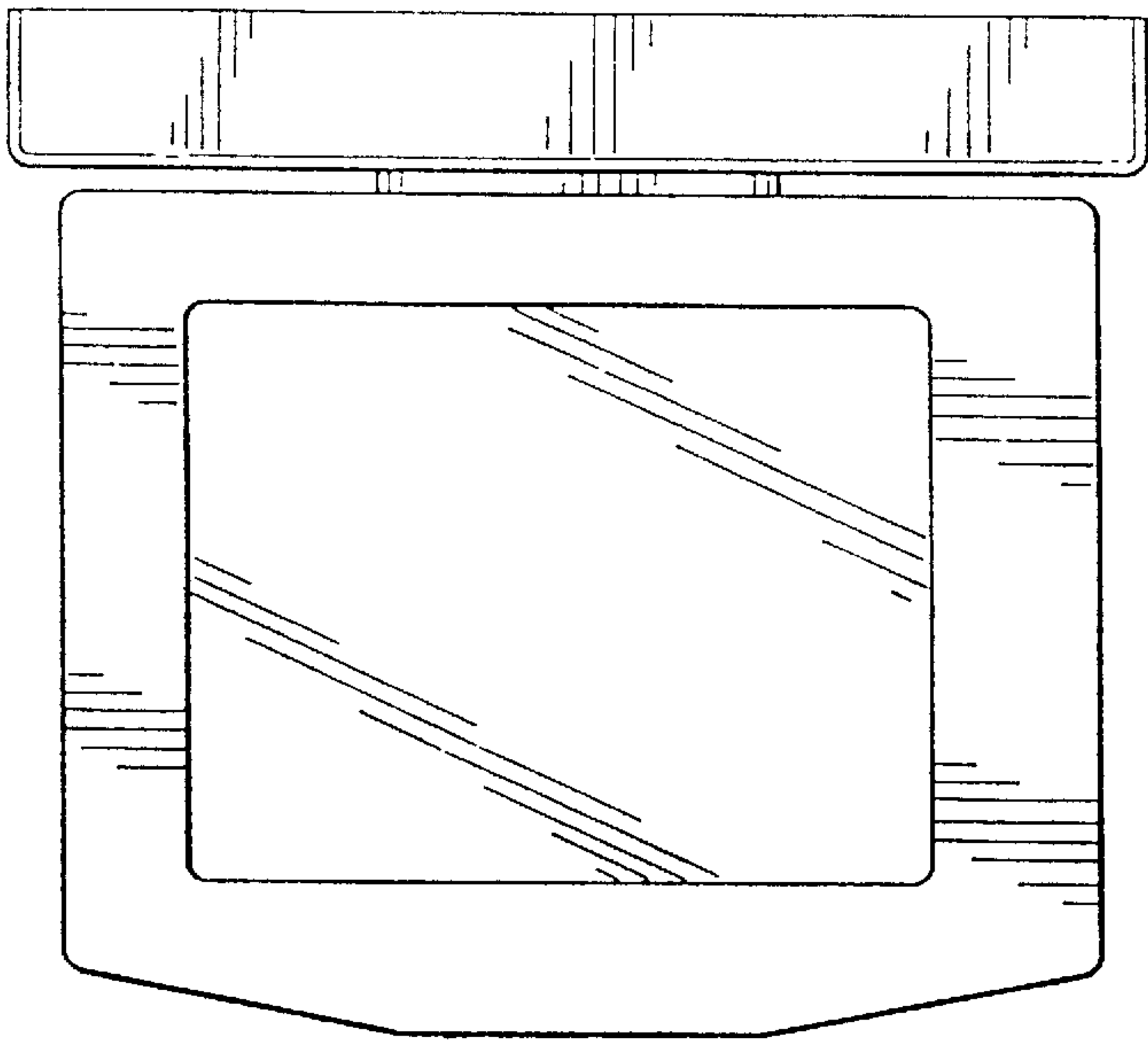

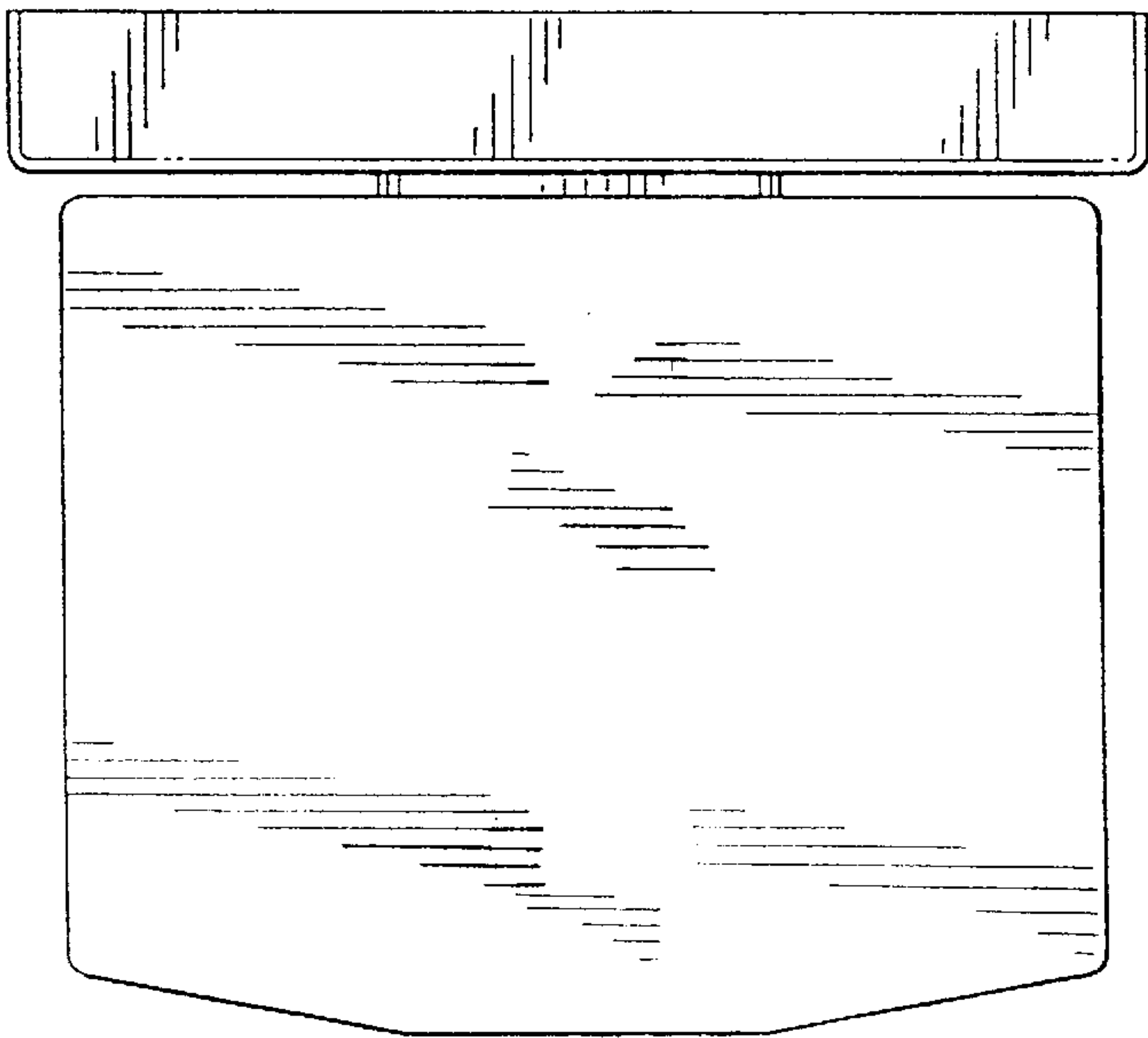

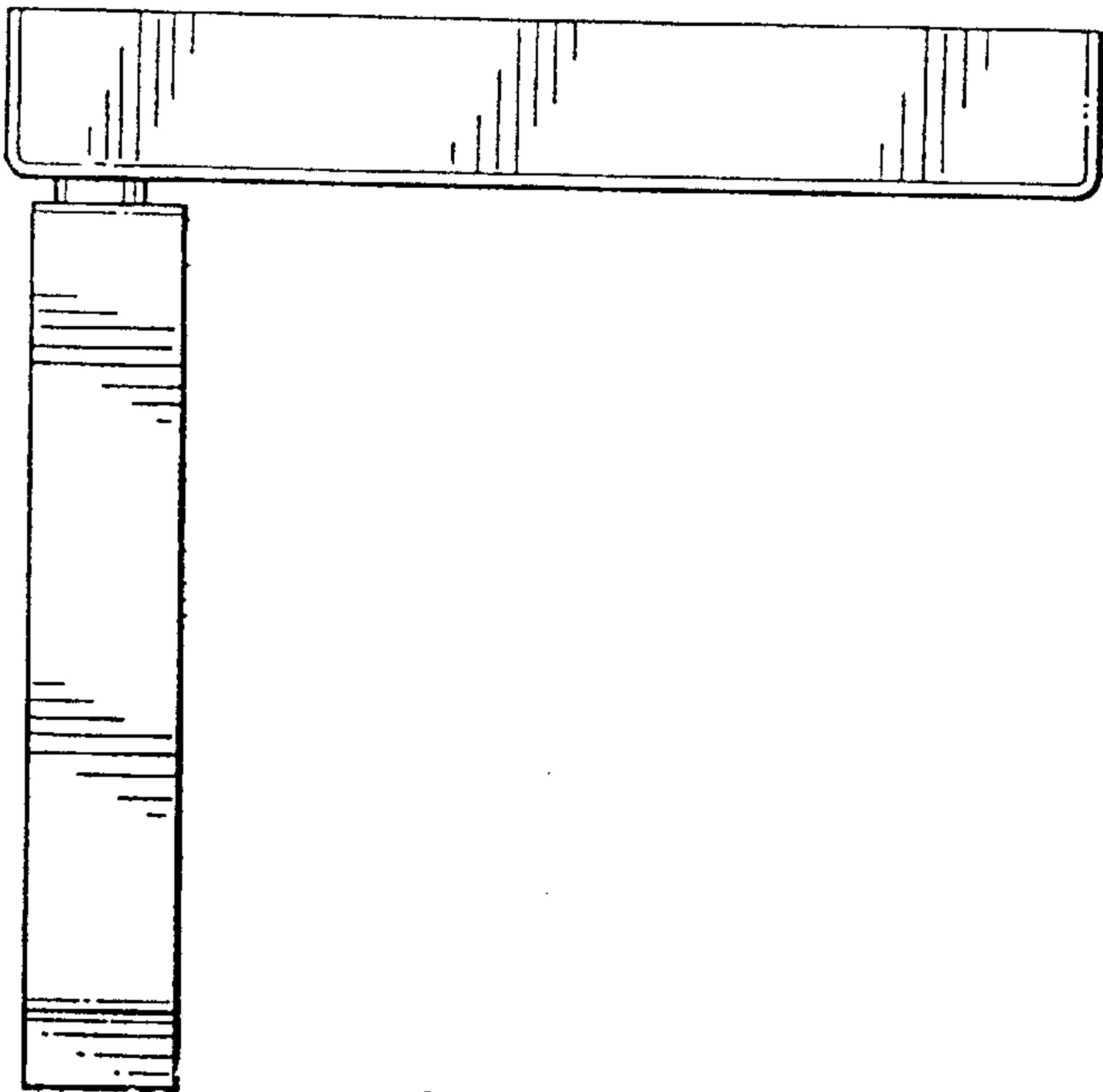

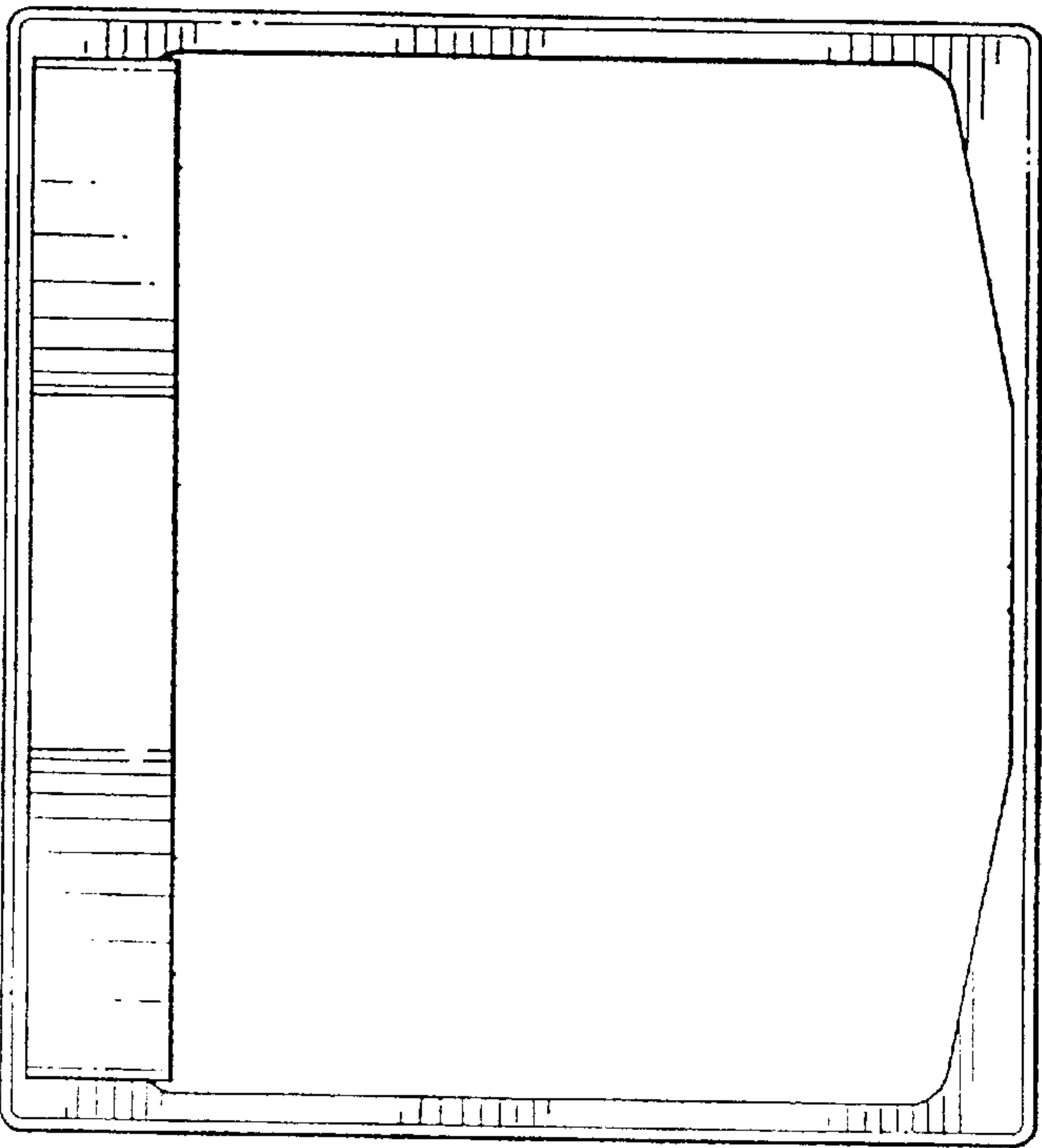
