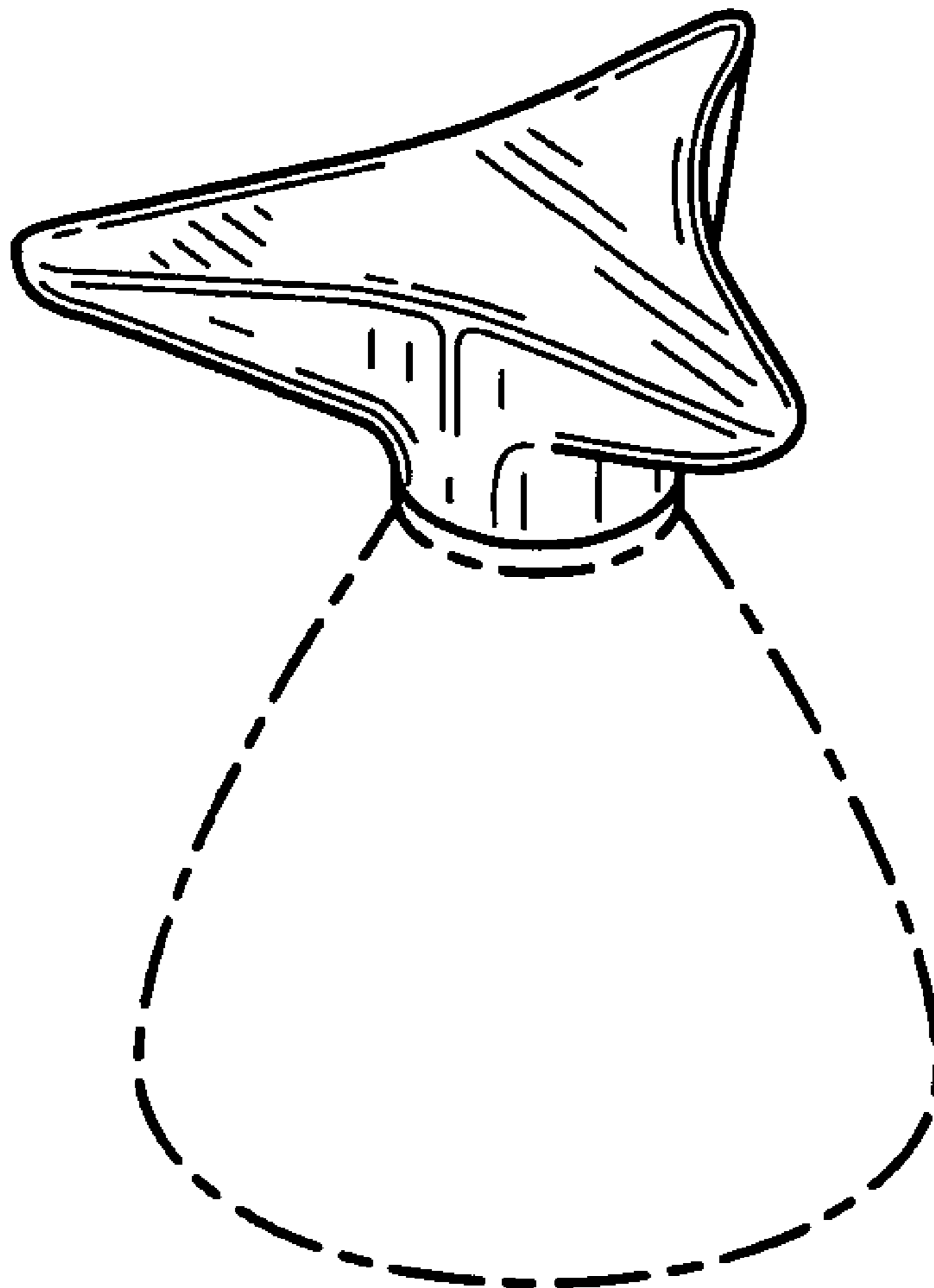
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a faucet handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a faucet handle showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a back elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image of the left side. The broken line showing is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

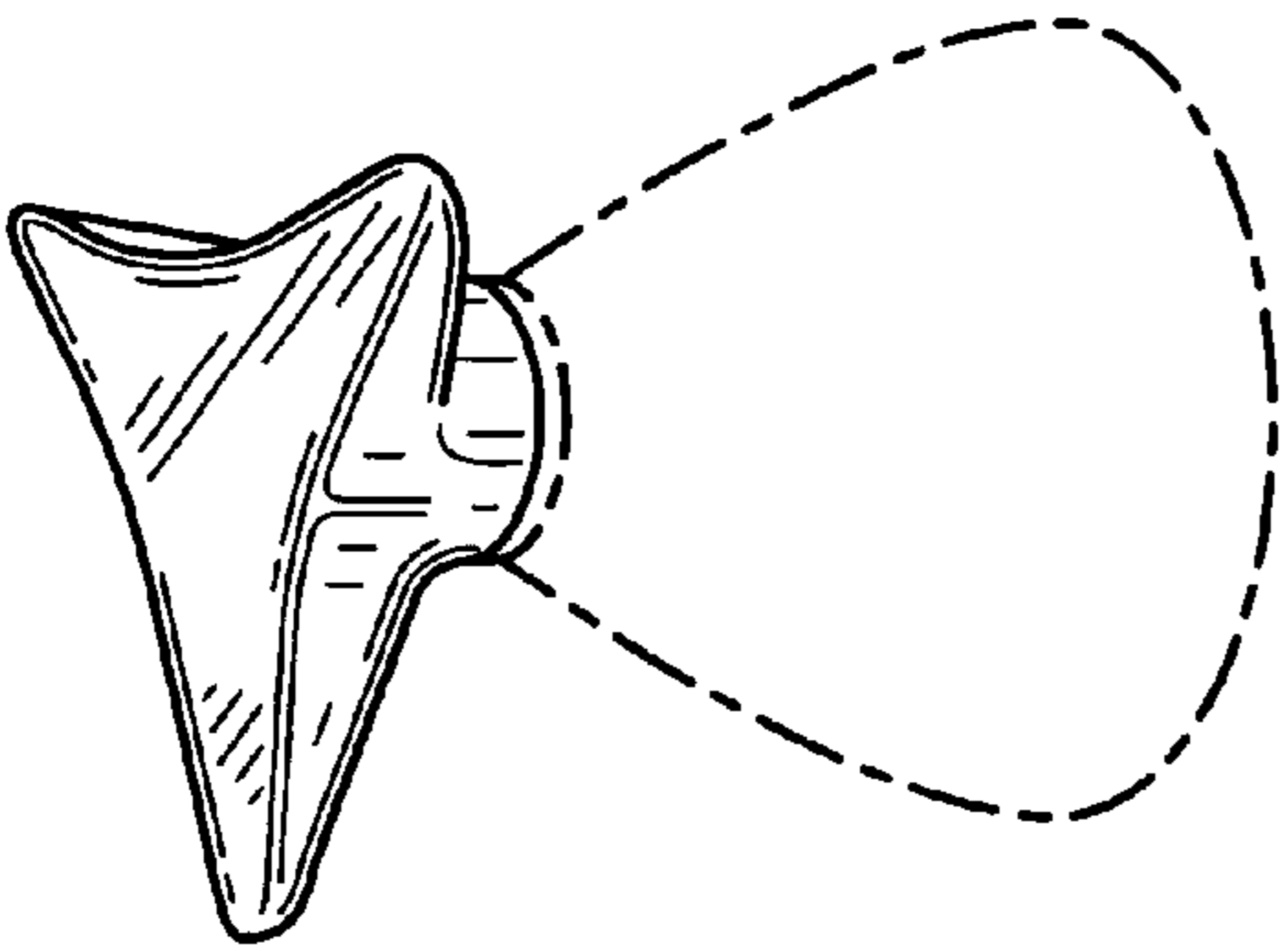

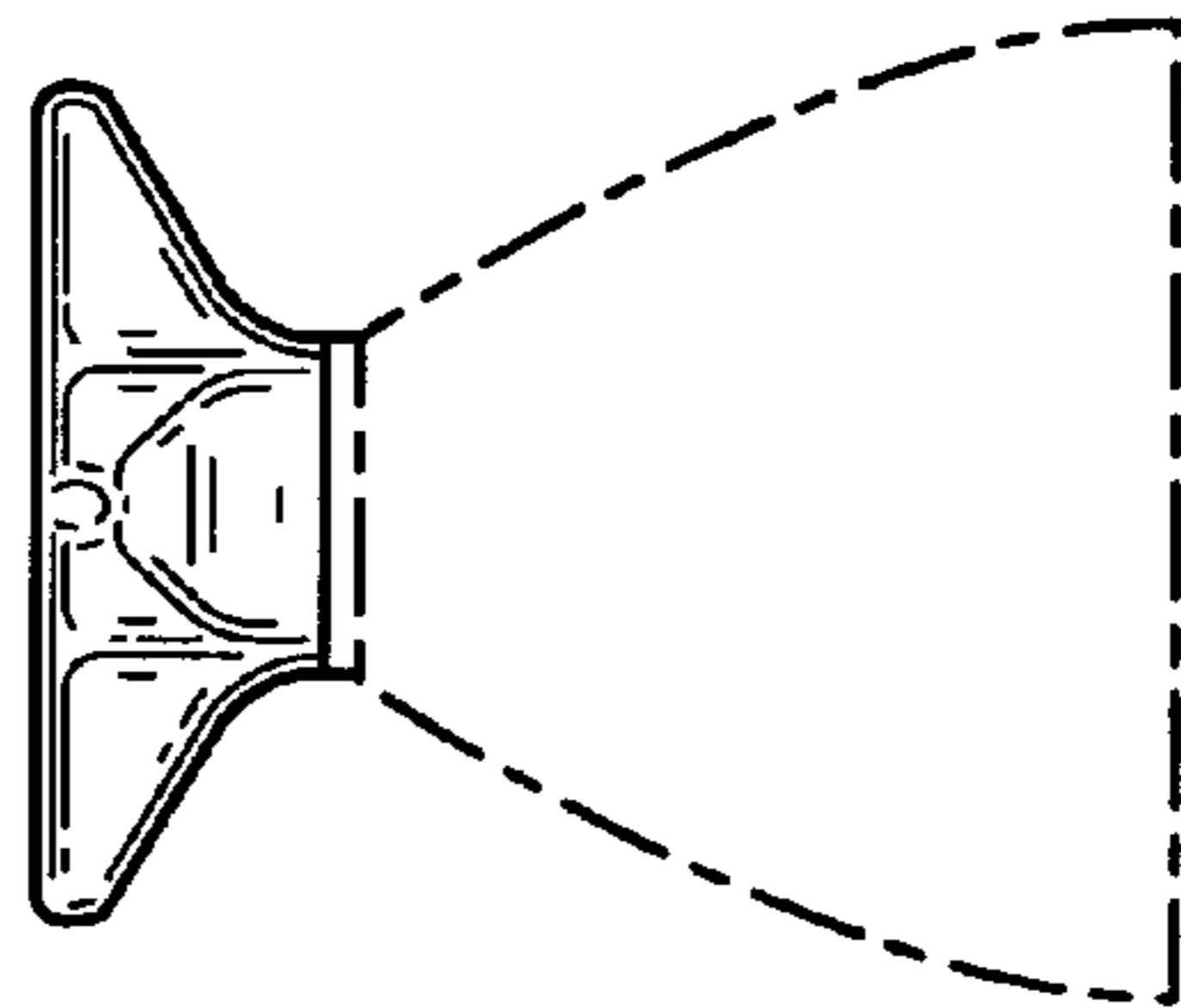

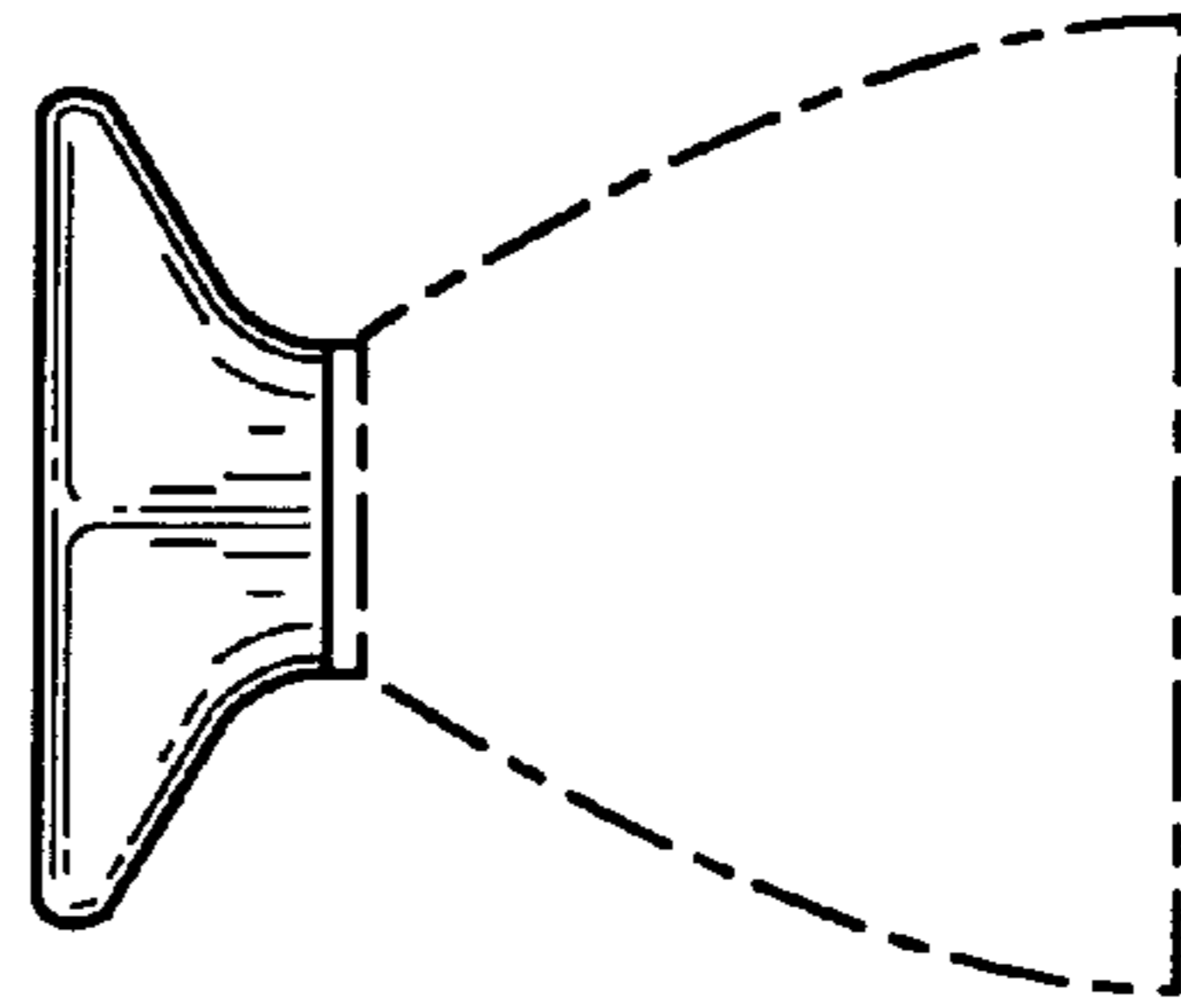

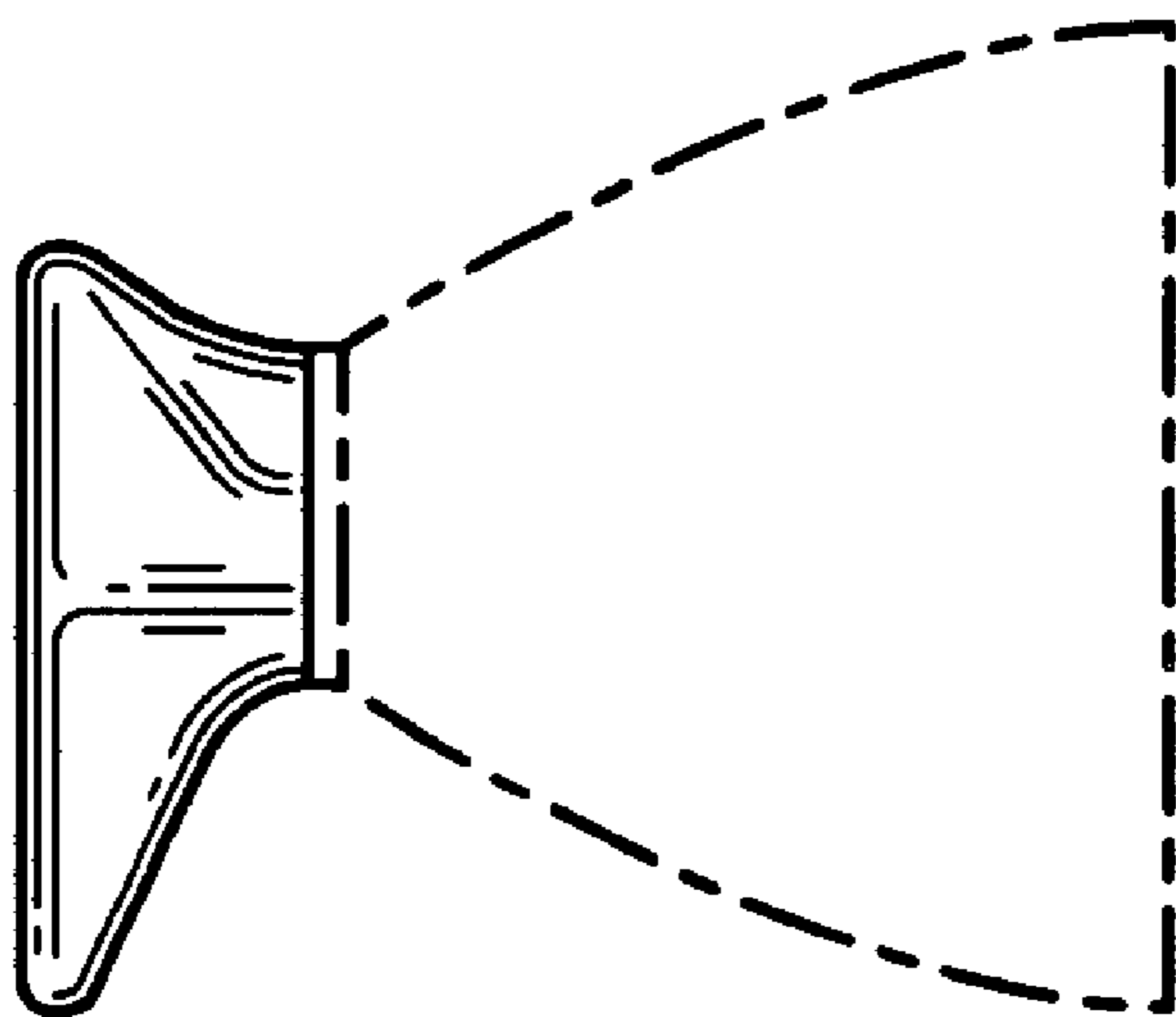

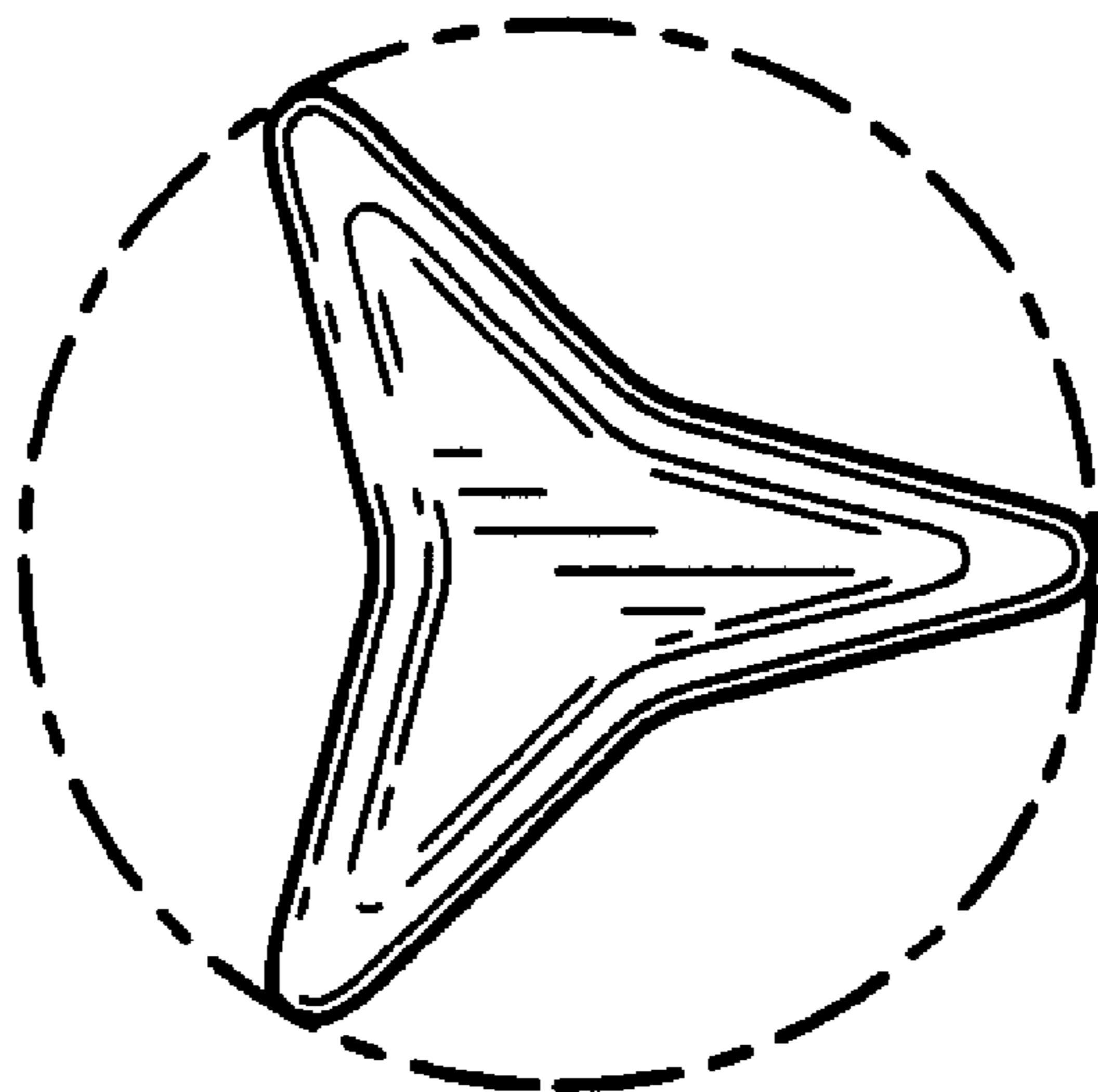
