FIG. 4 is a front in view of my design for a basketball shoe;

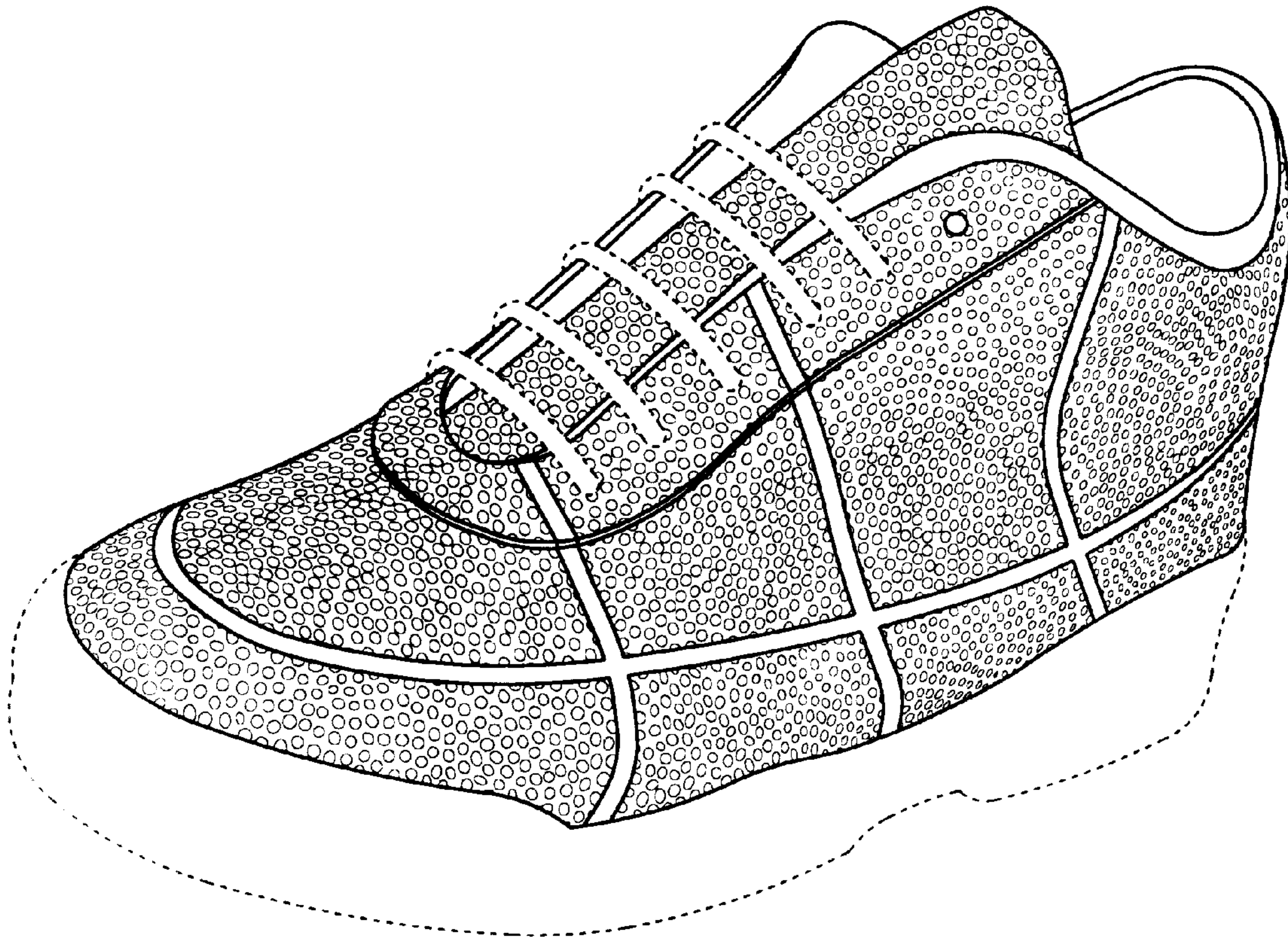
FIG. 5 is a back end view showing the heel portion of my design for a basketball shoe;

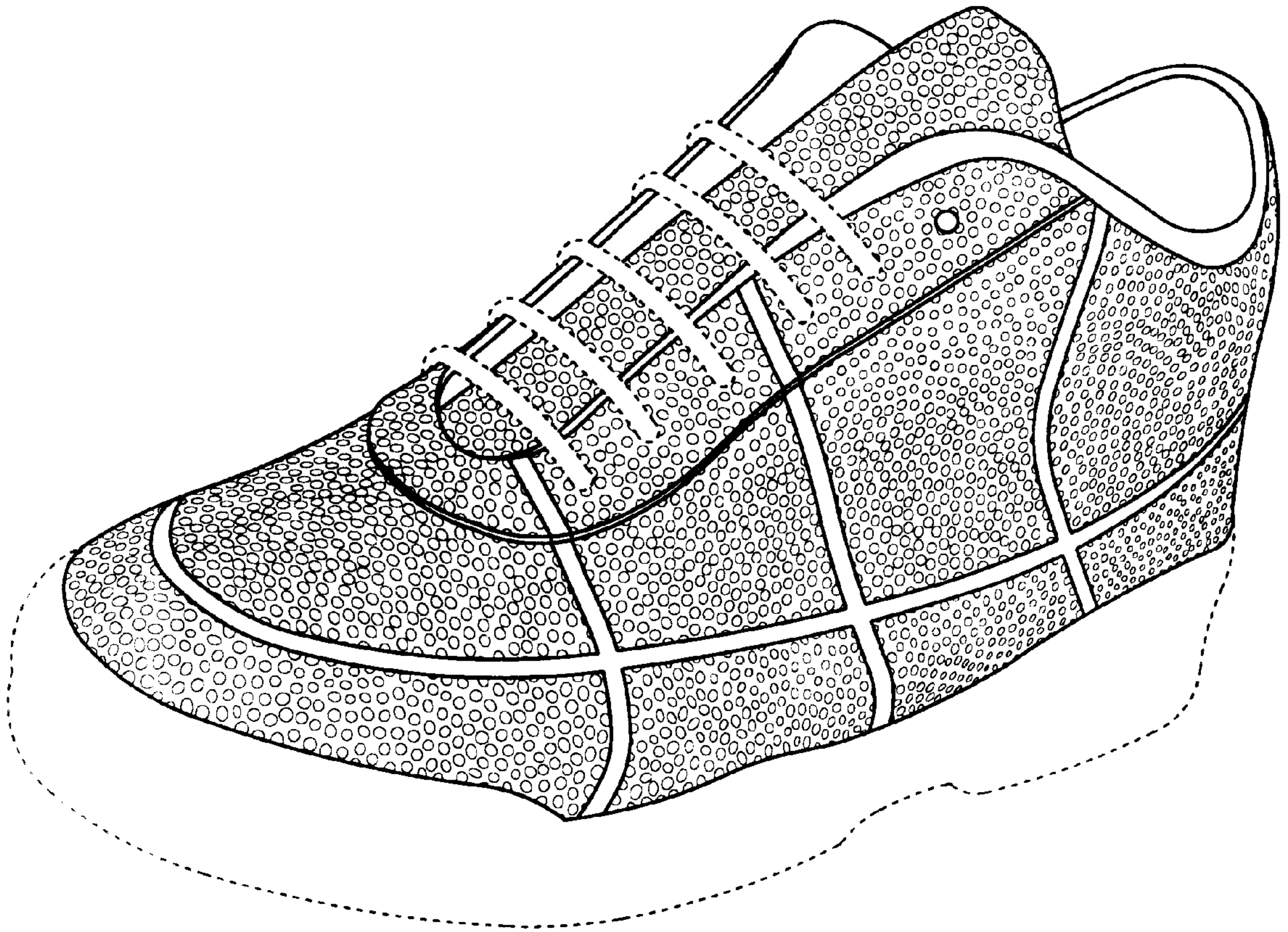

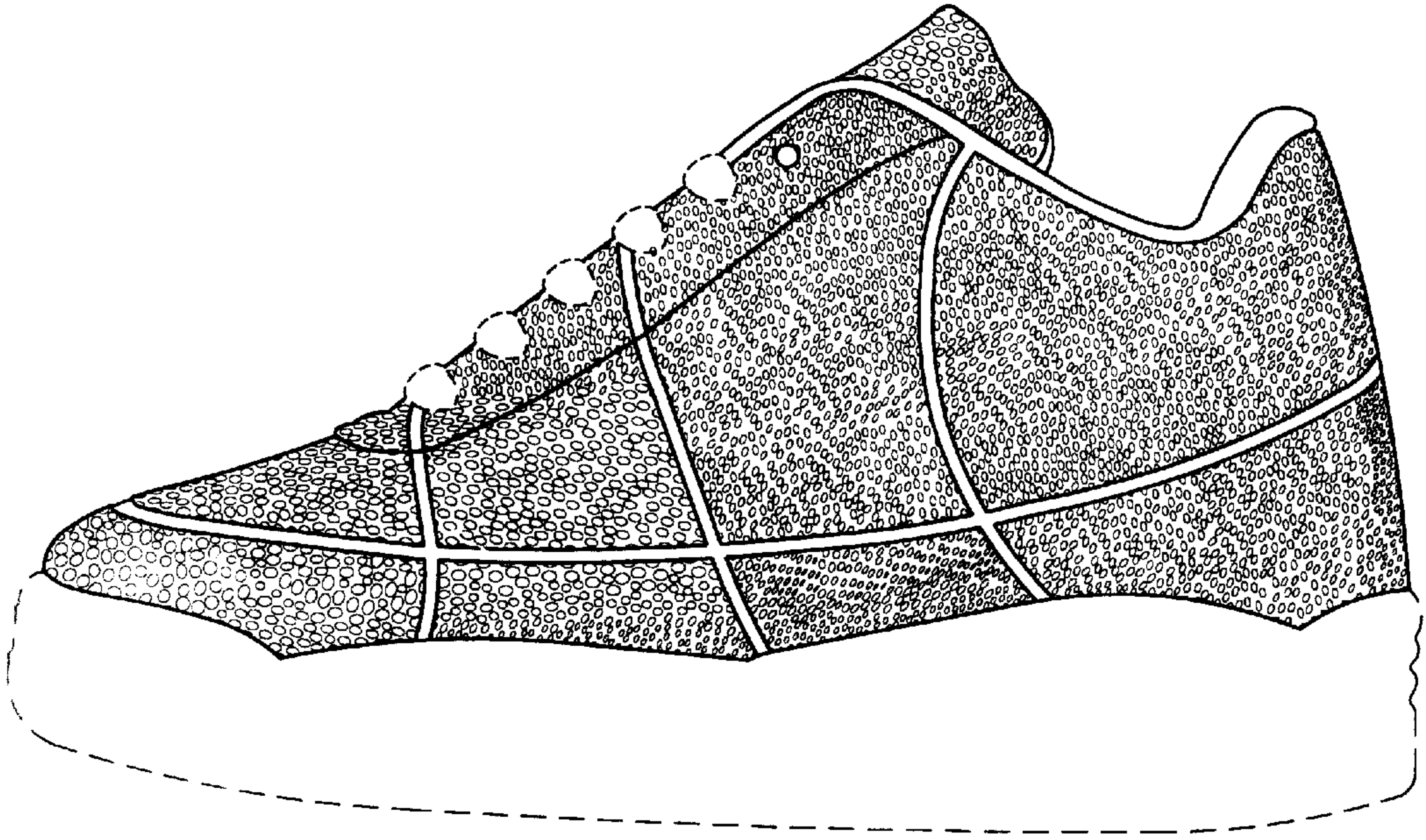

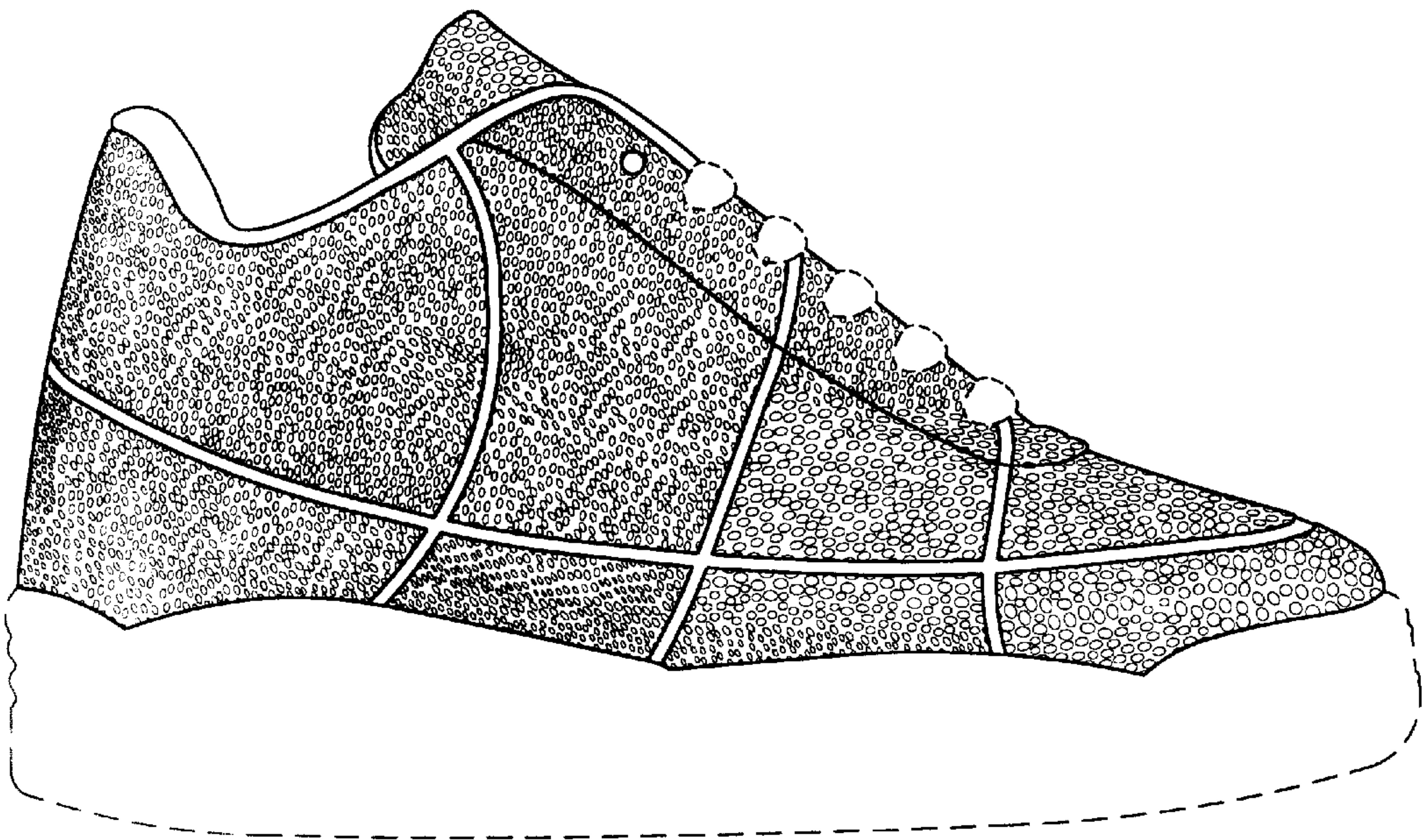

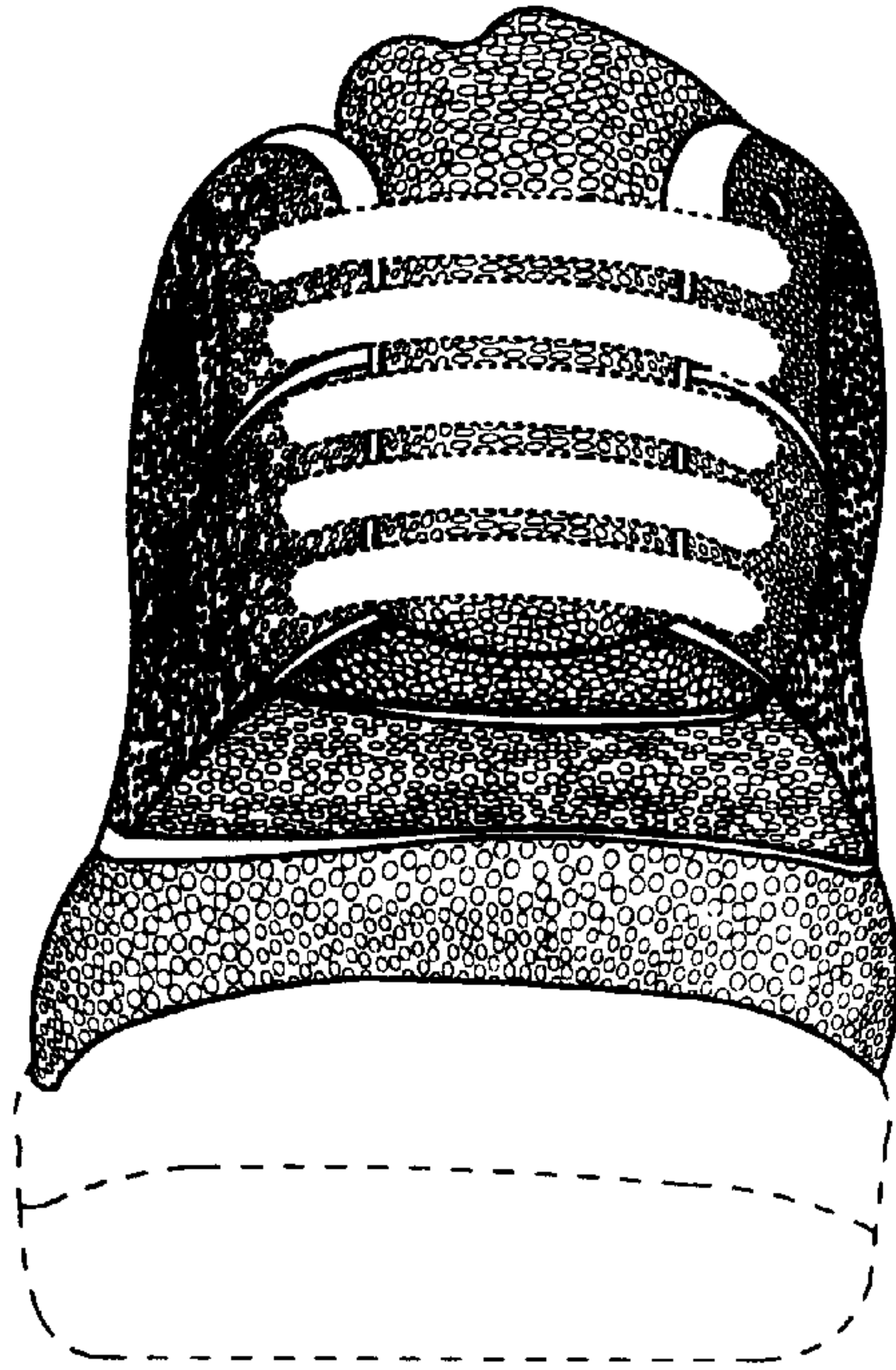

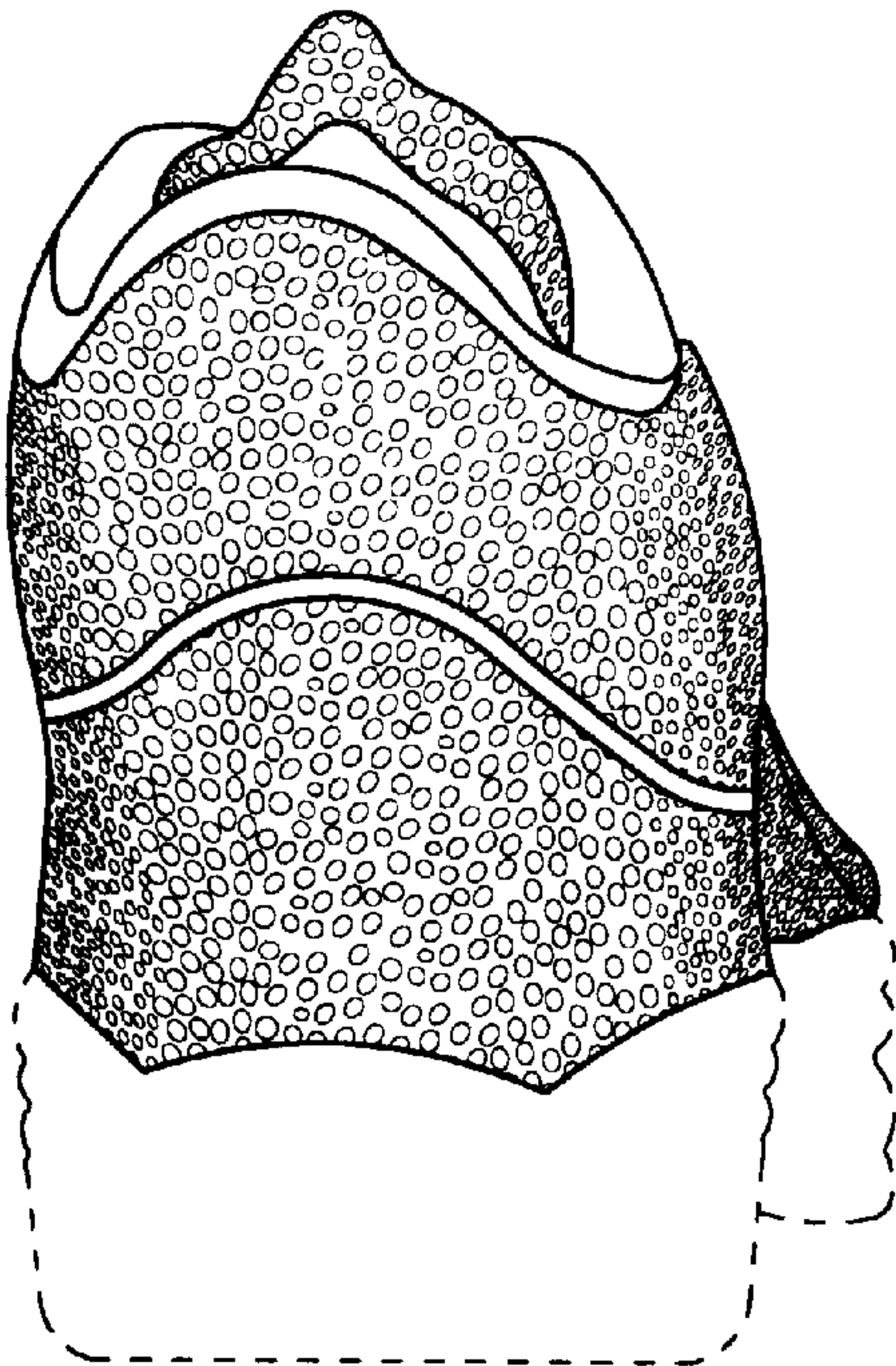

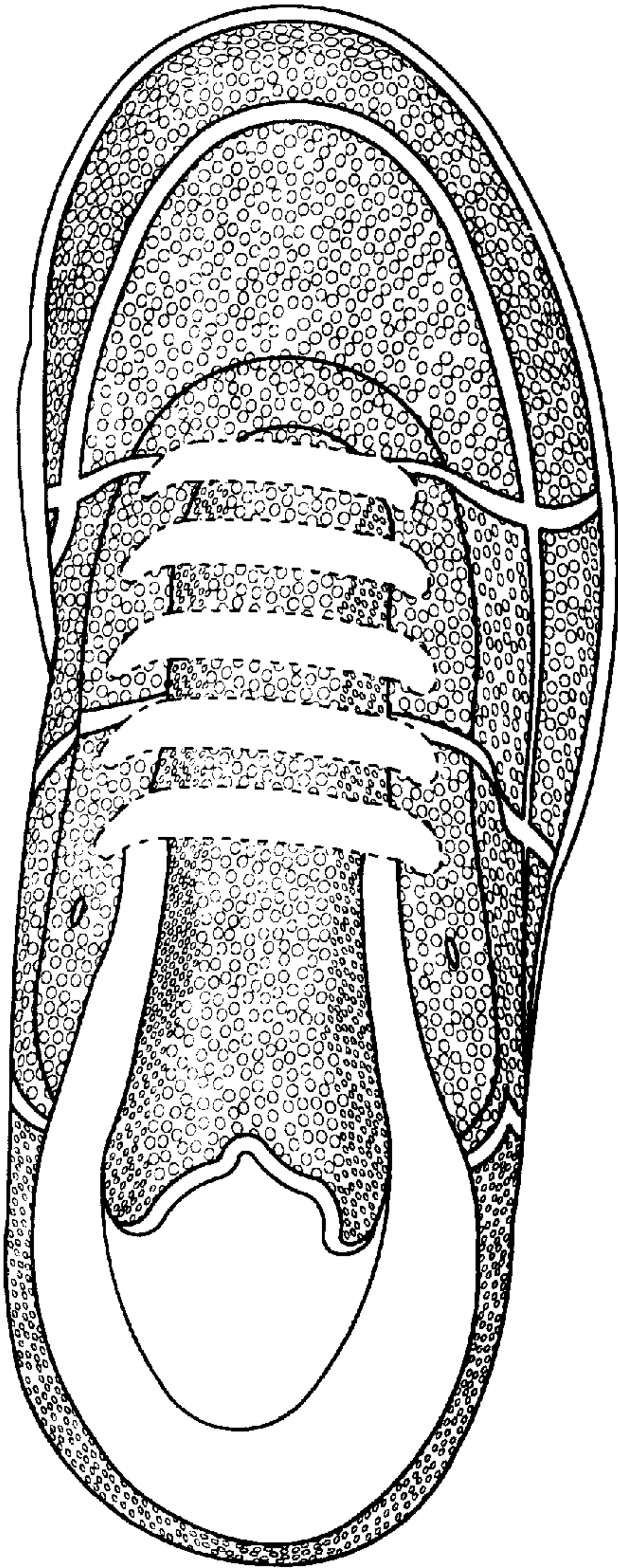

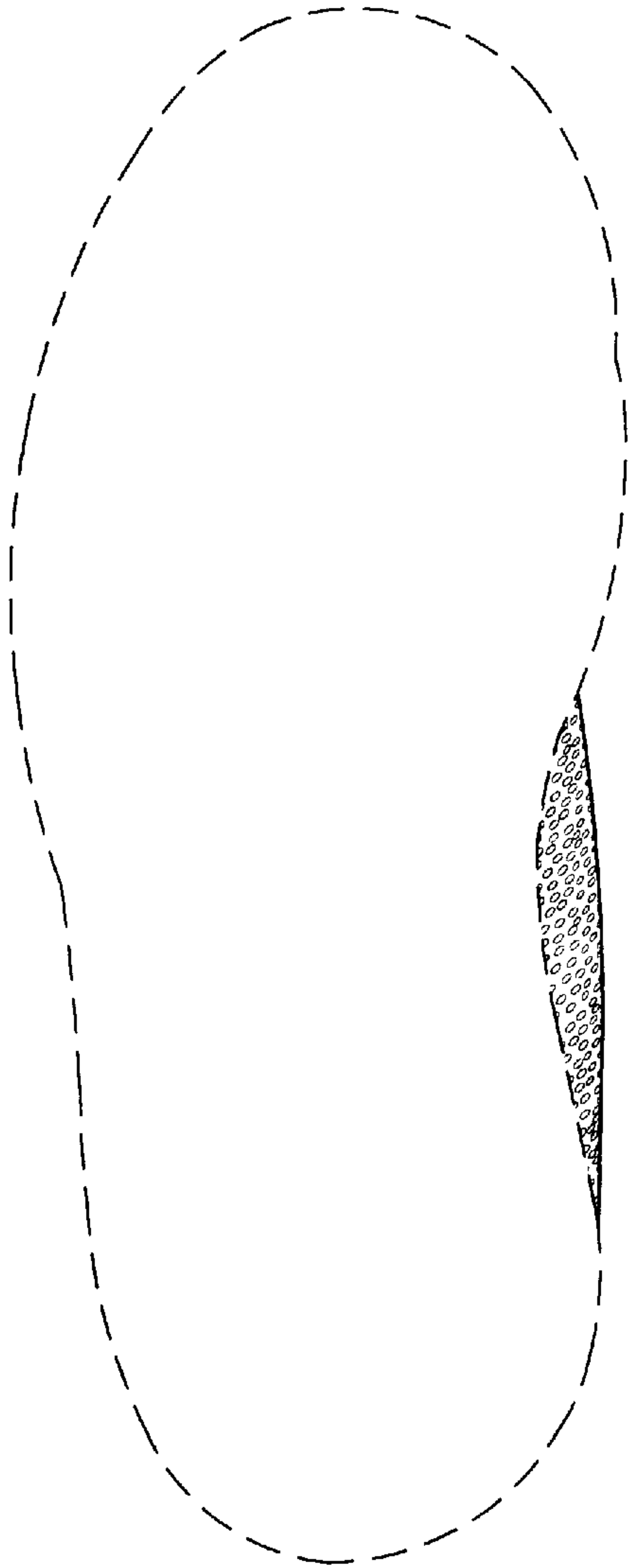
