[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the book jacket with handles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the book jacket with handles, with the panel gripping and closing fasteners being shown in open configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the design;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the design;

FIG. 4 is a top elevational view of the design, and with the panel gripping and closing fasteners being shown in open configuration;


FIG. 5 is a bottom elevational view of the design, with the panel gripping and closing fasteners being shown in open configuration;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the design, with the panel gripping fasteners being removed;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the opposite side of the design, with the panel gripping fasteners being removed; and,


FIG. 8 is a top elevational view of the design, with a retained book shown in phantom and forming no part of the claimed design, with the fasteners in closed configuration.











