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[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

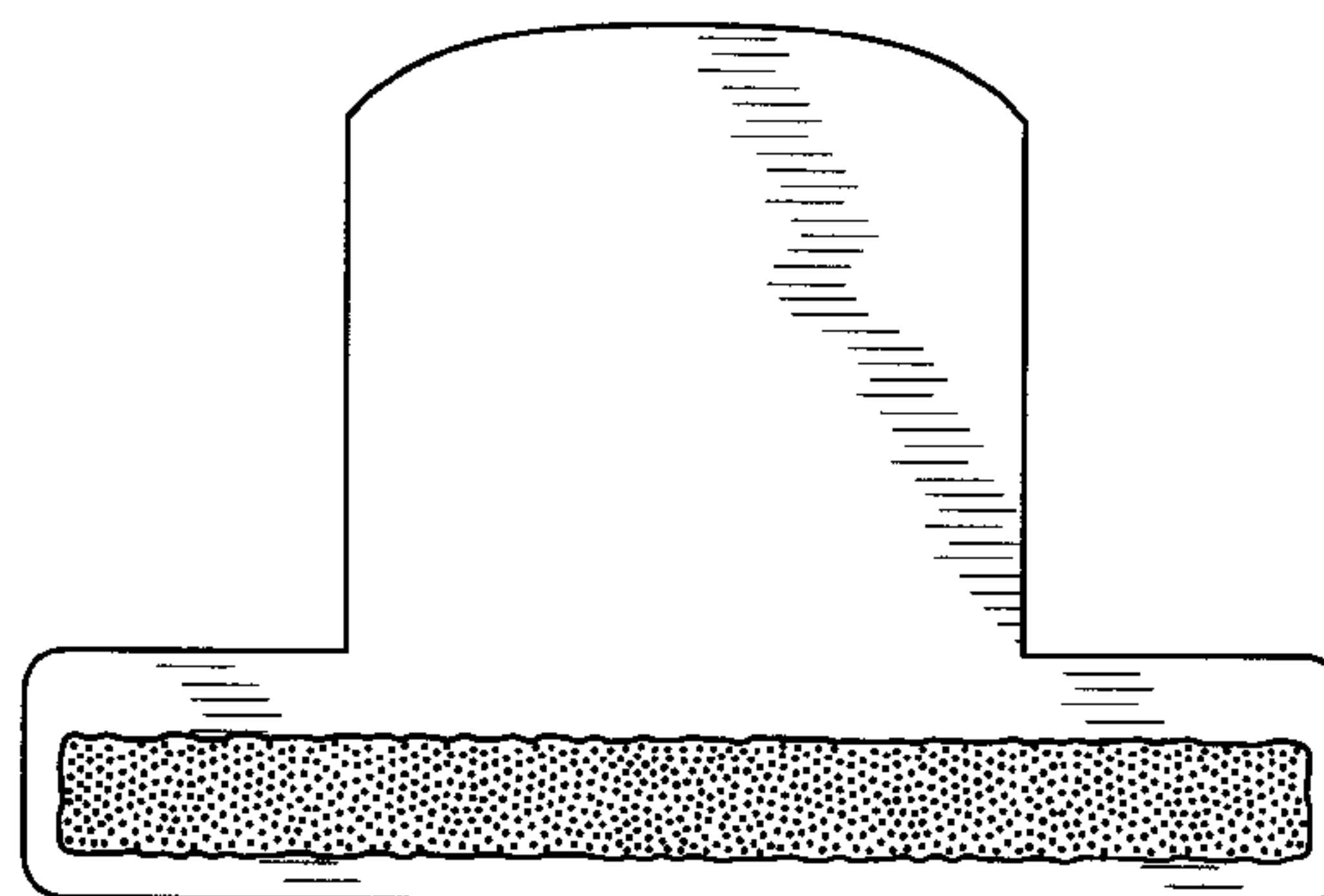
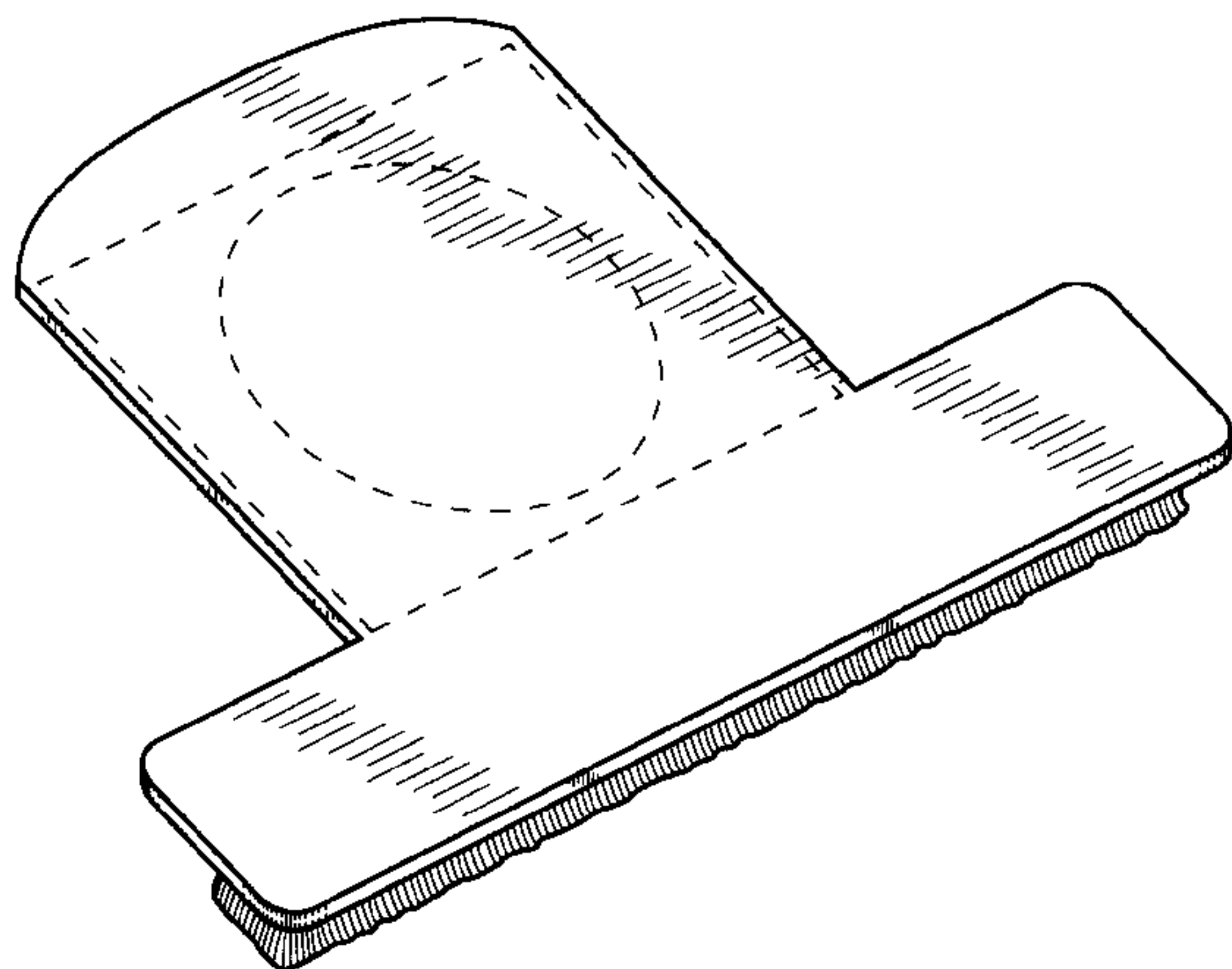
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view (the front end being the brush end);

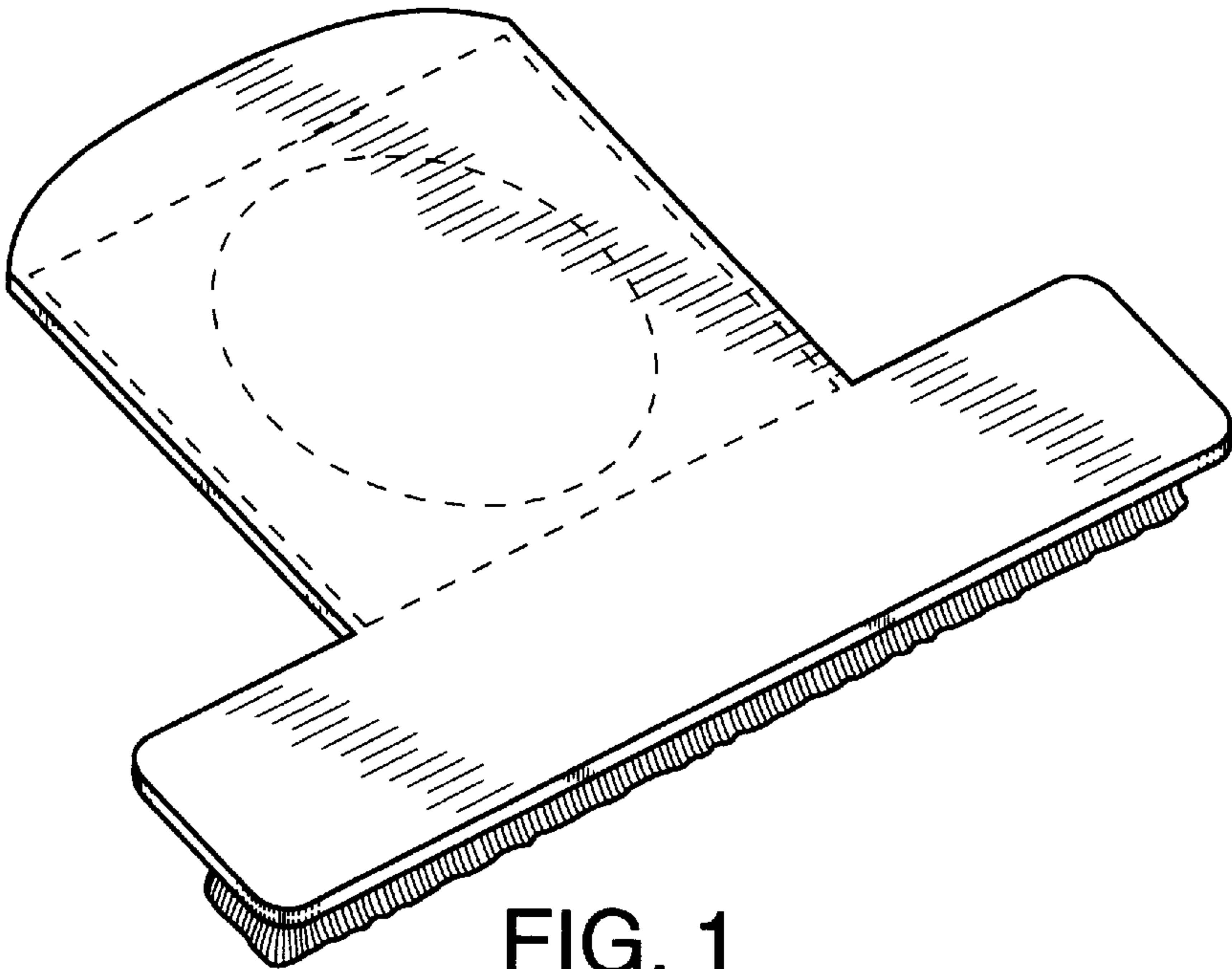

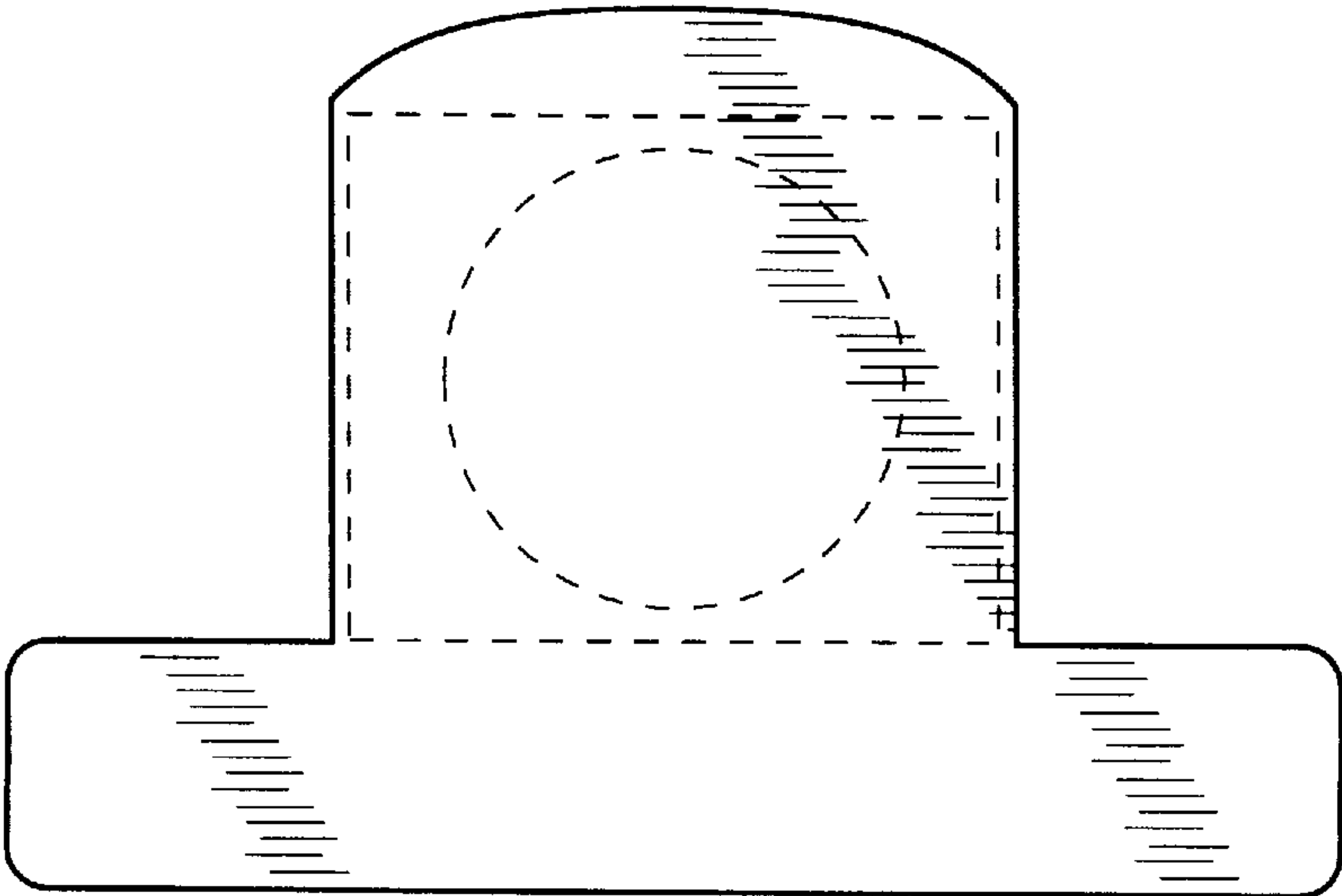

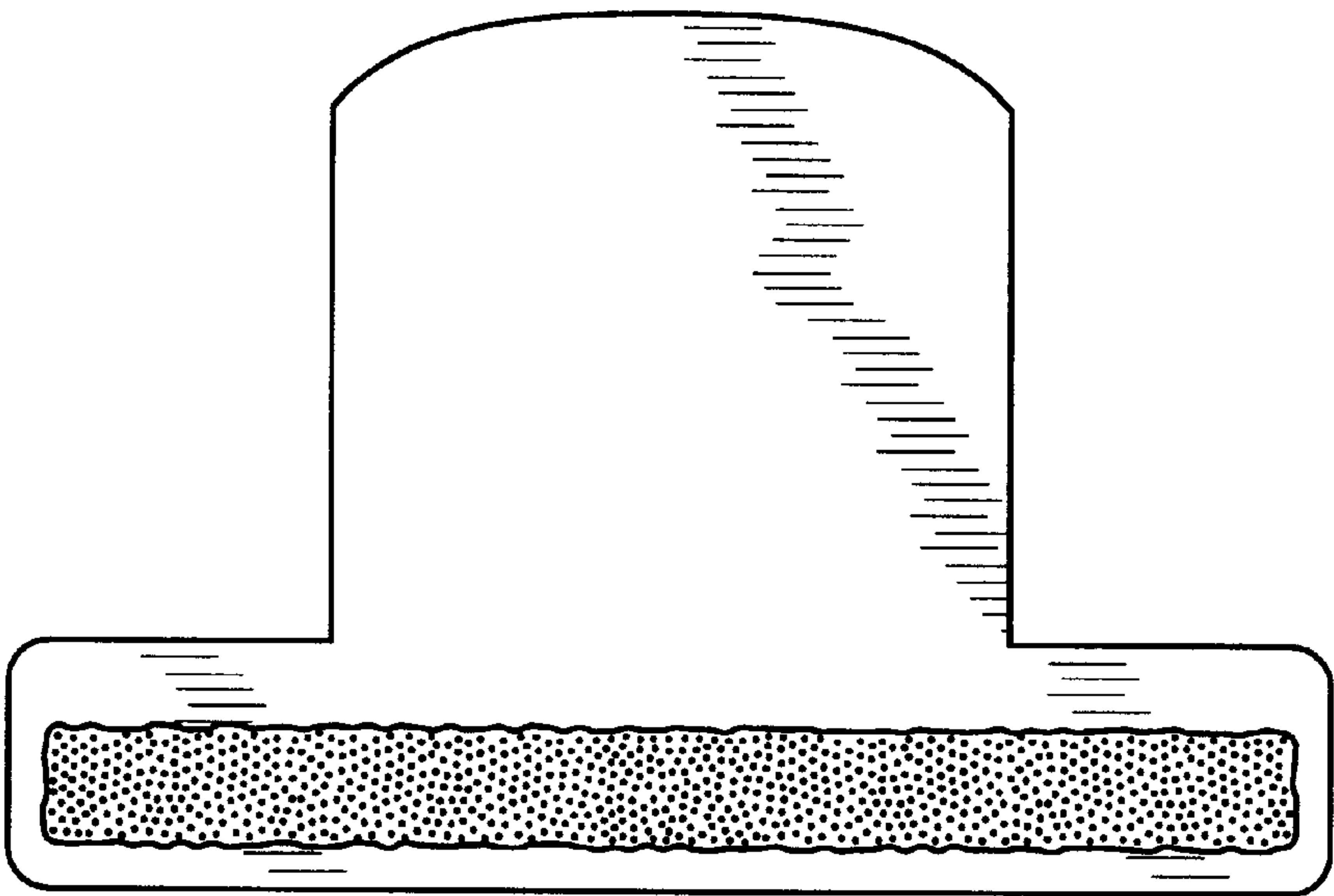

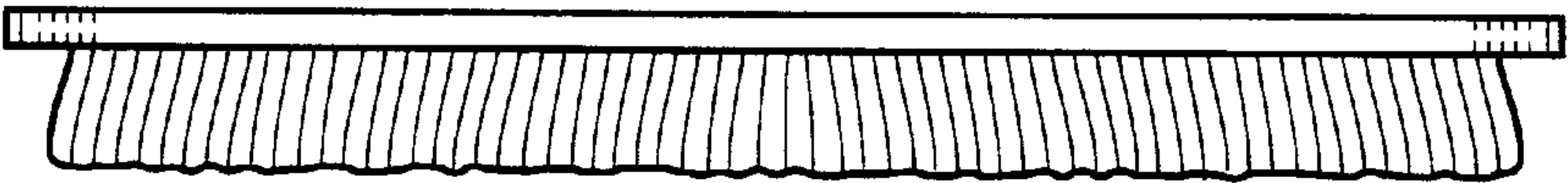

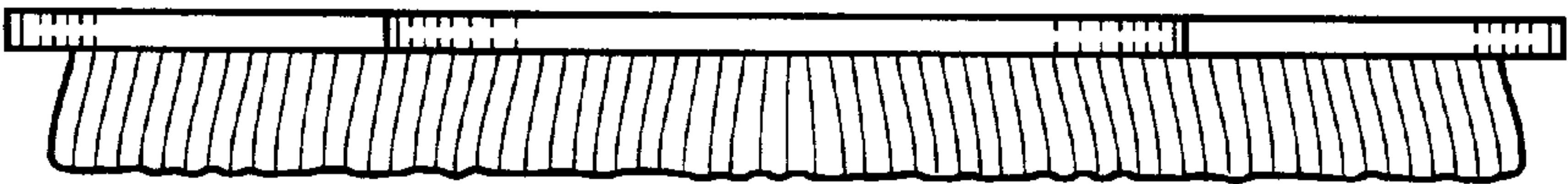
