DESCRIPTION

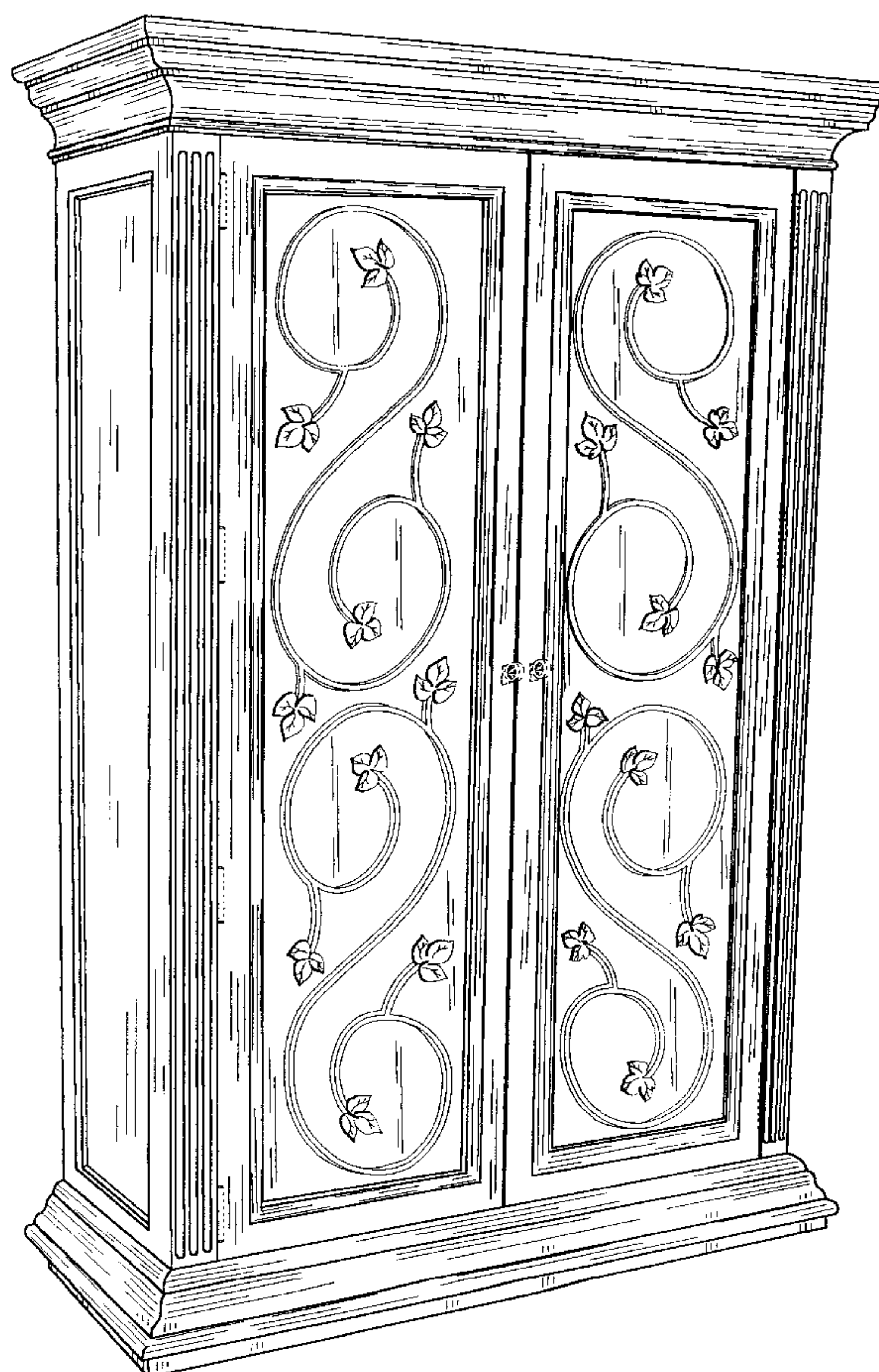
FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of an armoire showing
our new design;

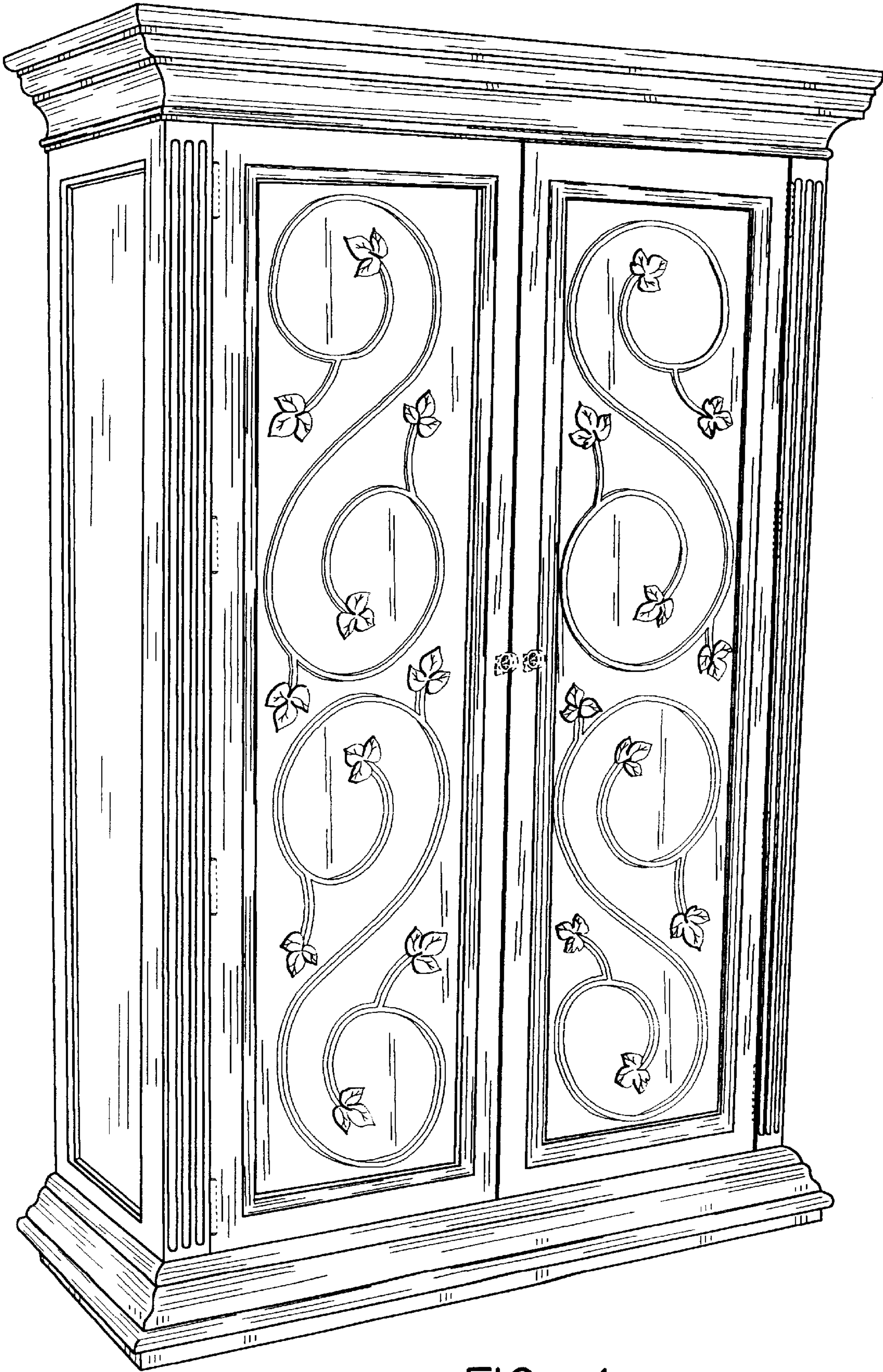

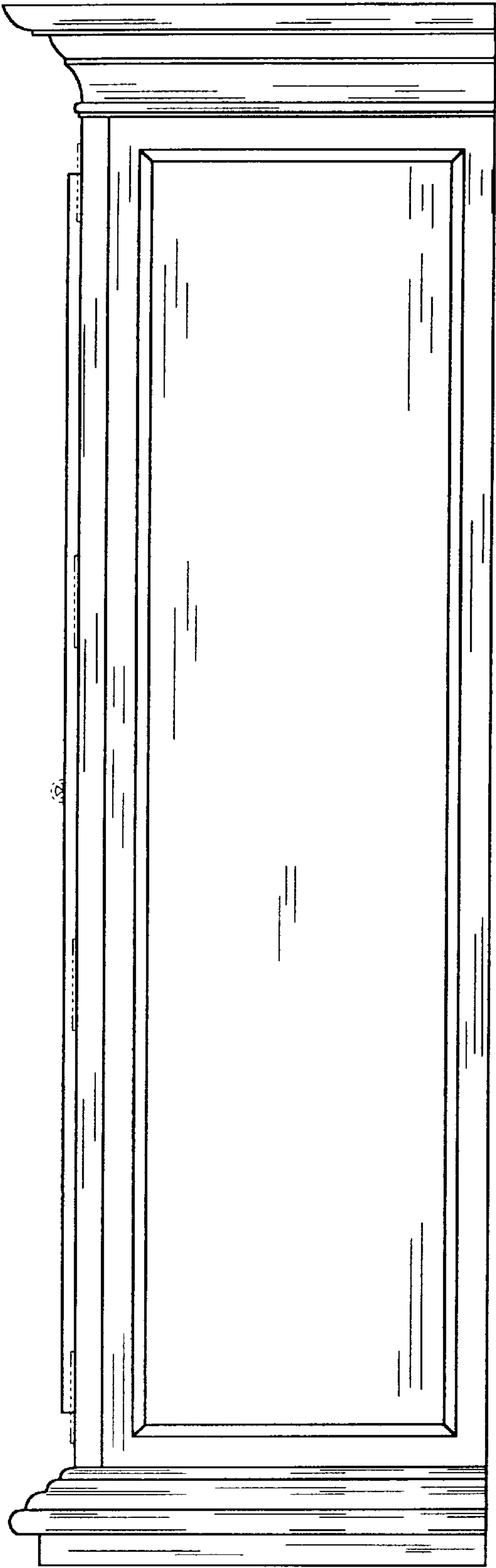

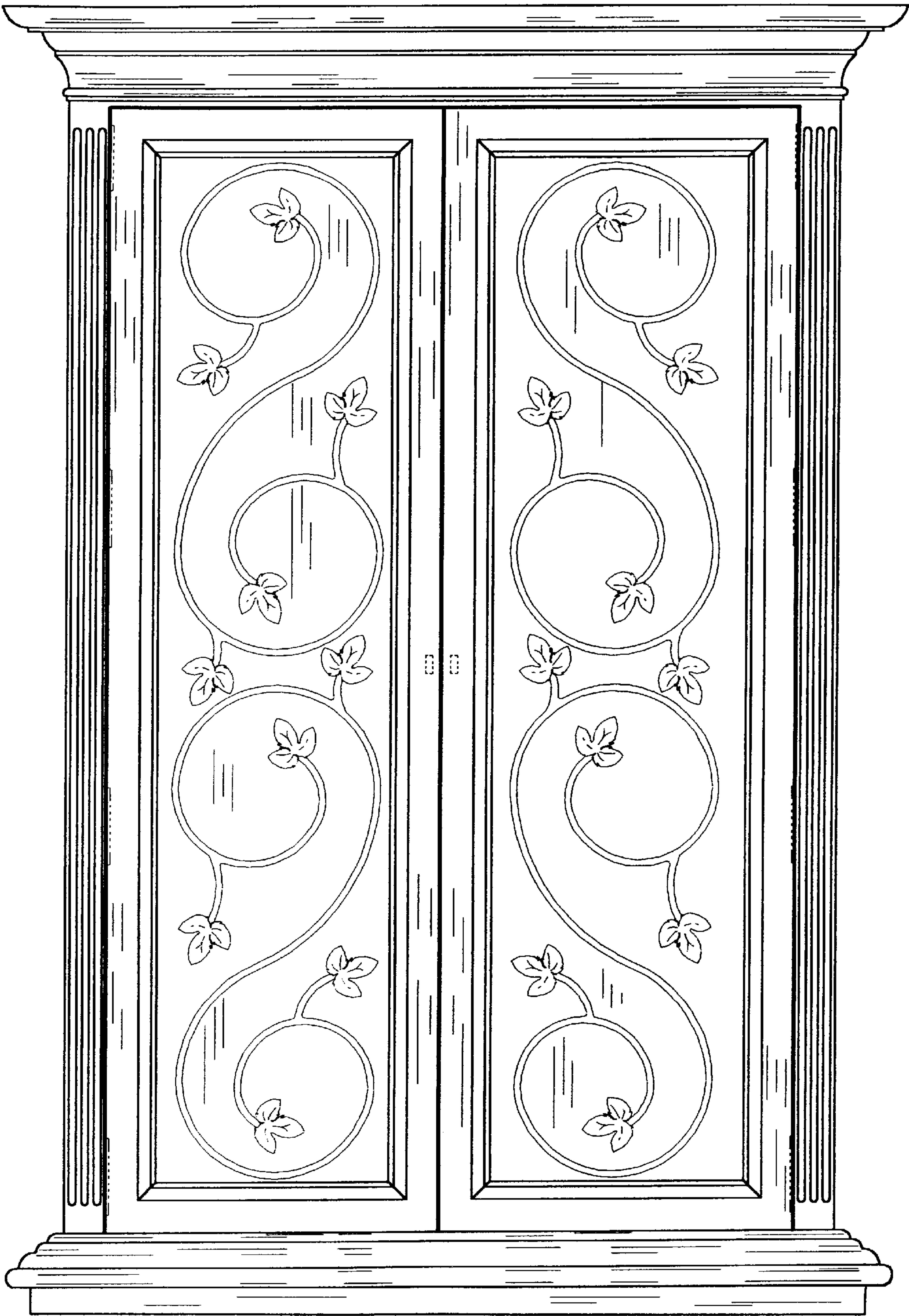
