FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

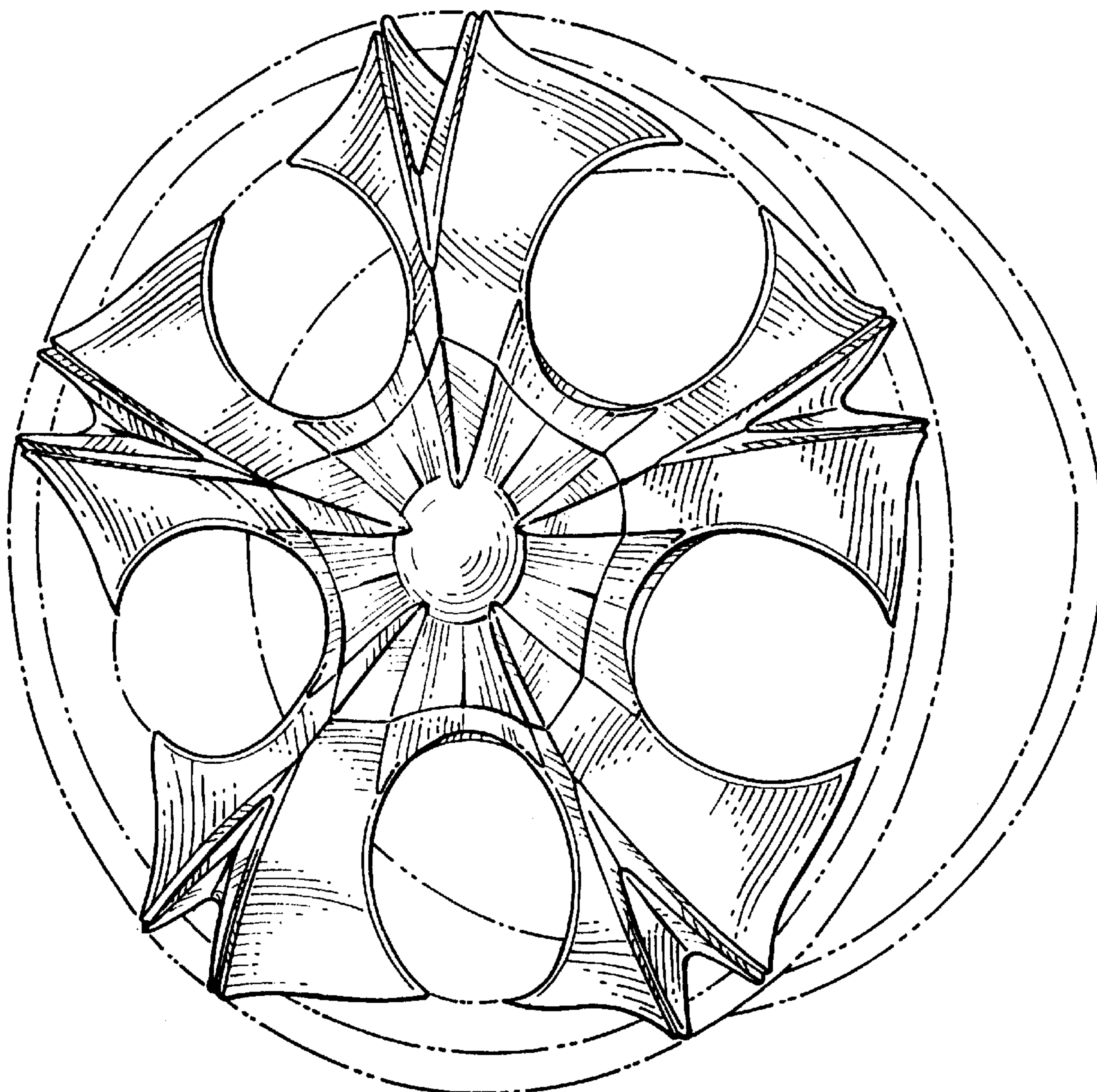
FIG. 3 is a left-side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side; and,

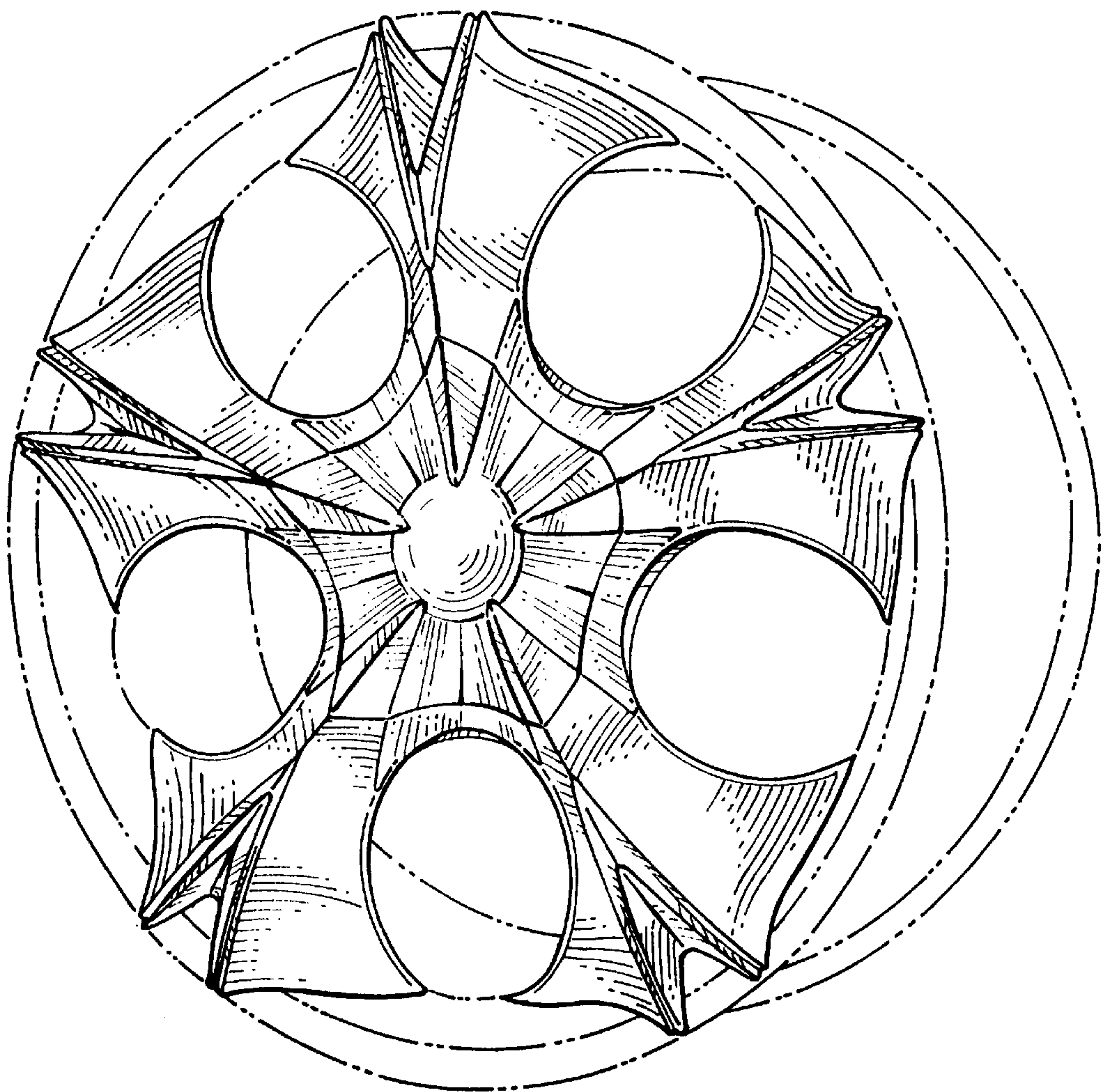

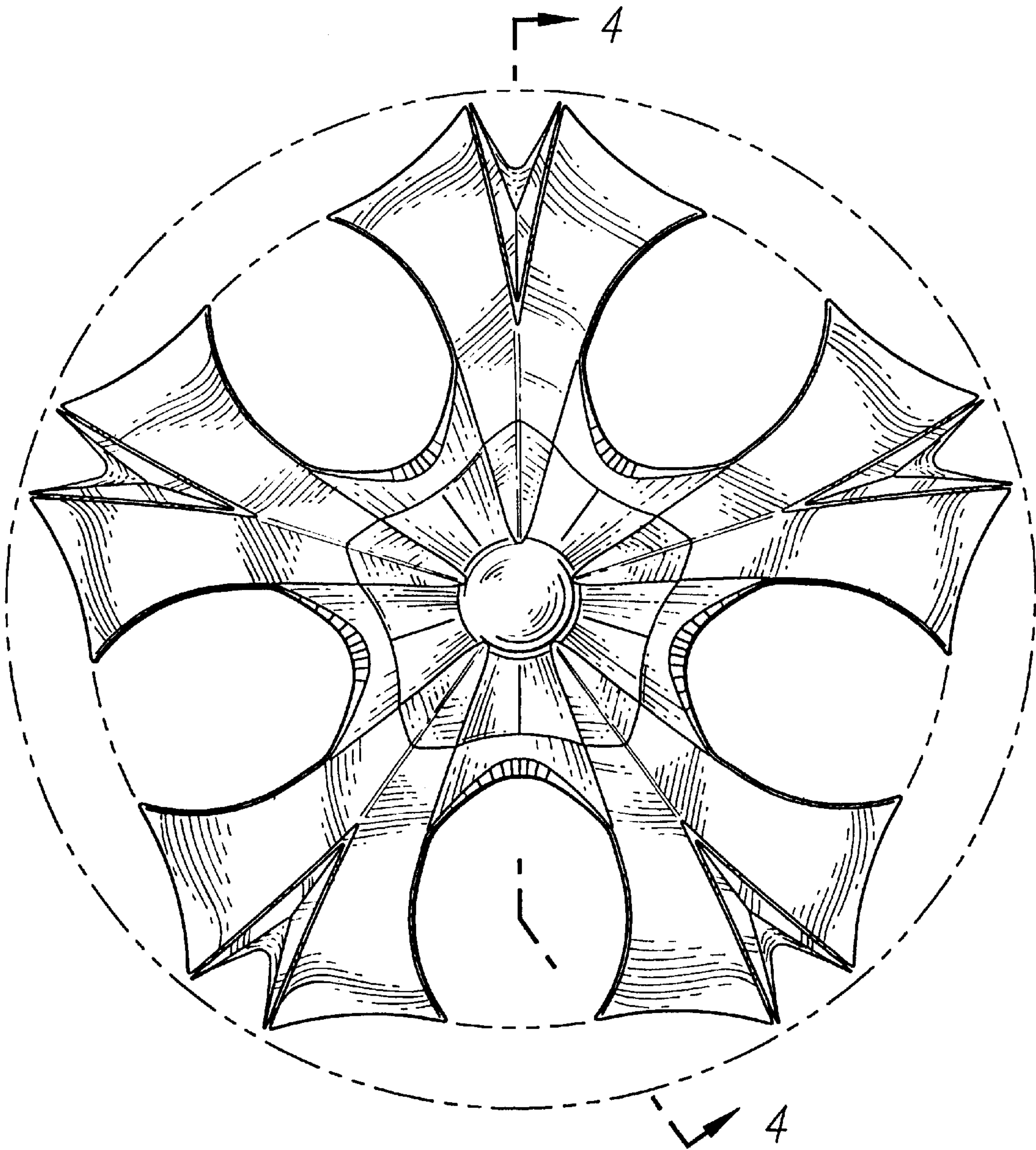

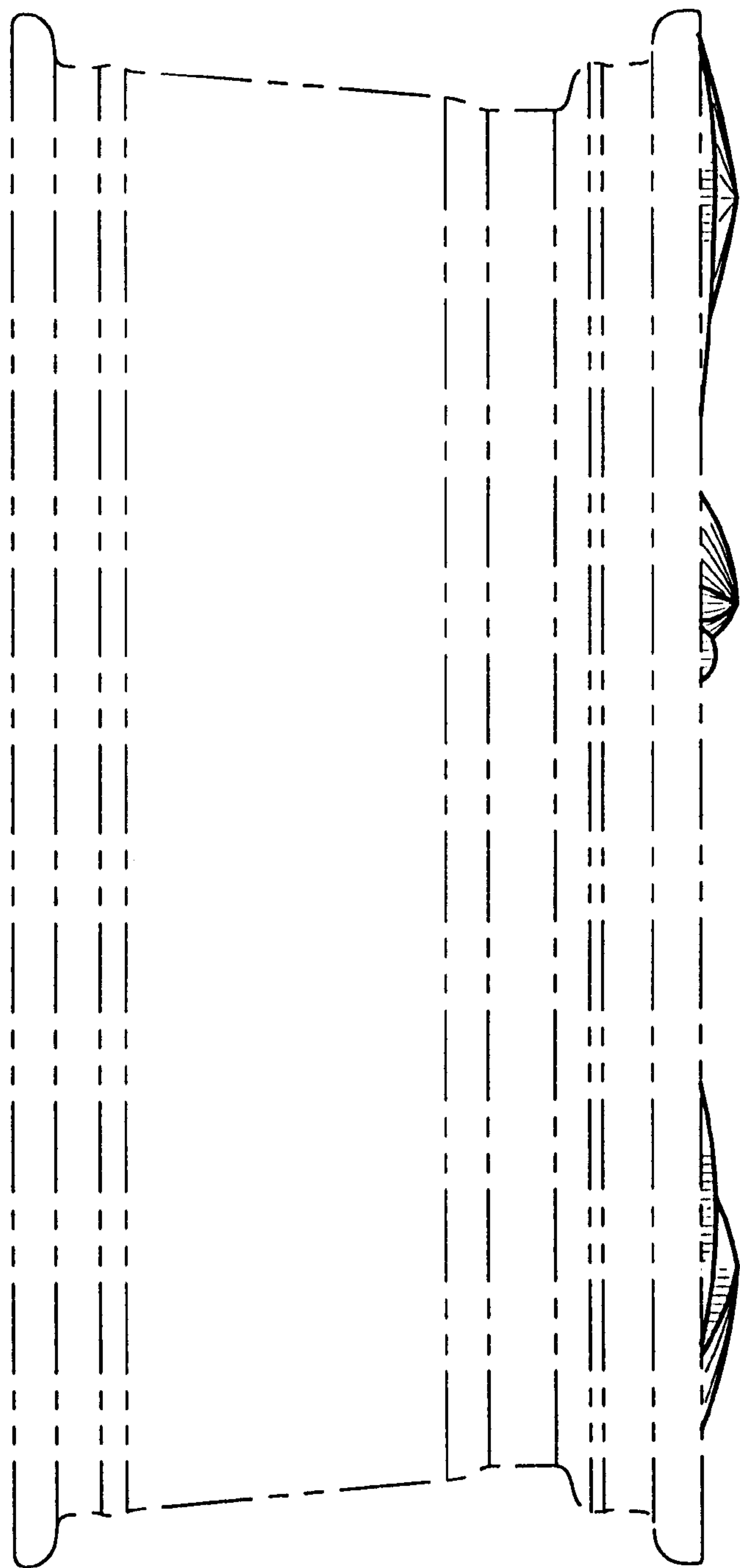

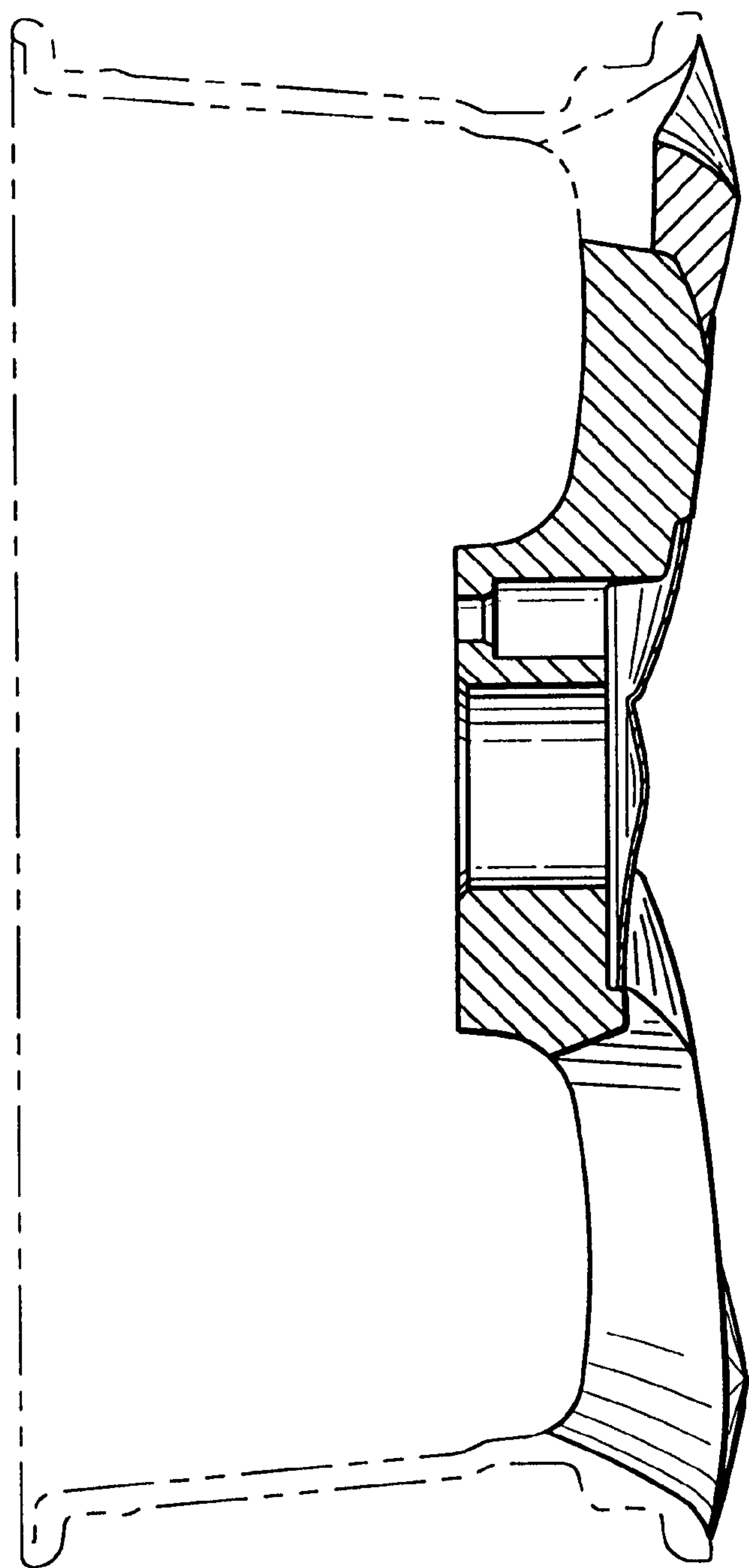
