[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a picture frame, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 shows a front perspective view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 2 shows a rear perspective view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 3 shows a front plan view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 4 shows a top plan view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 5 shows a rear plan view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 6 shows a side plan view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

FIG. 7 shows a bottom plan view of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention;

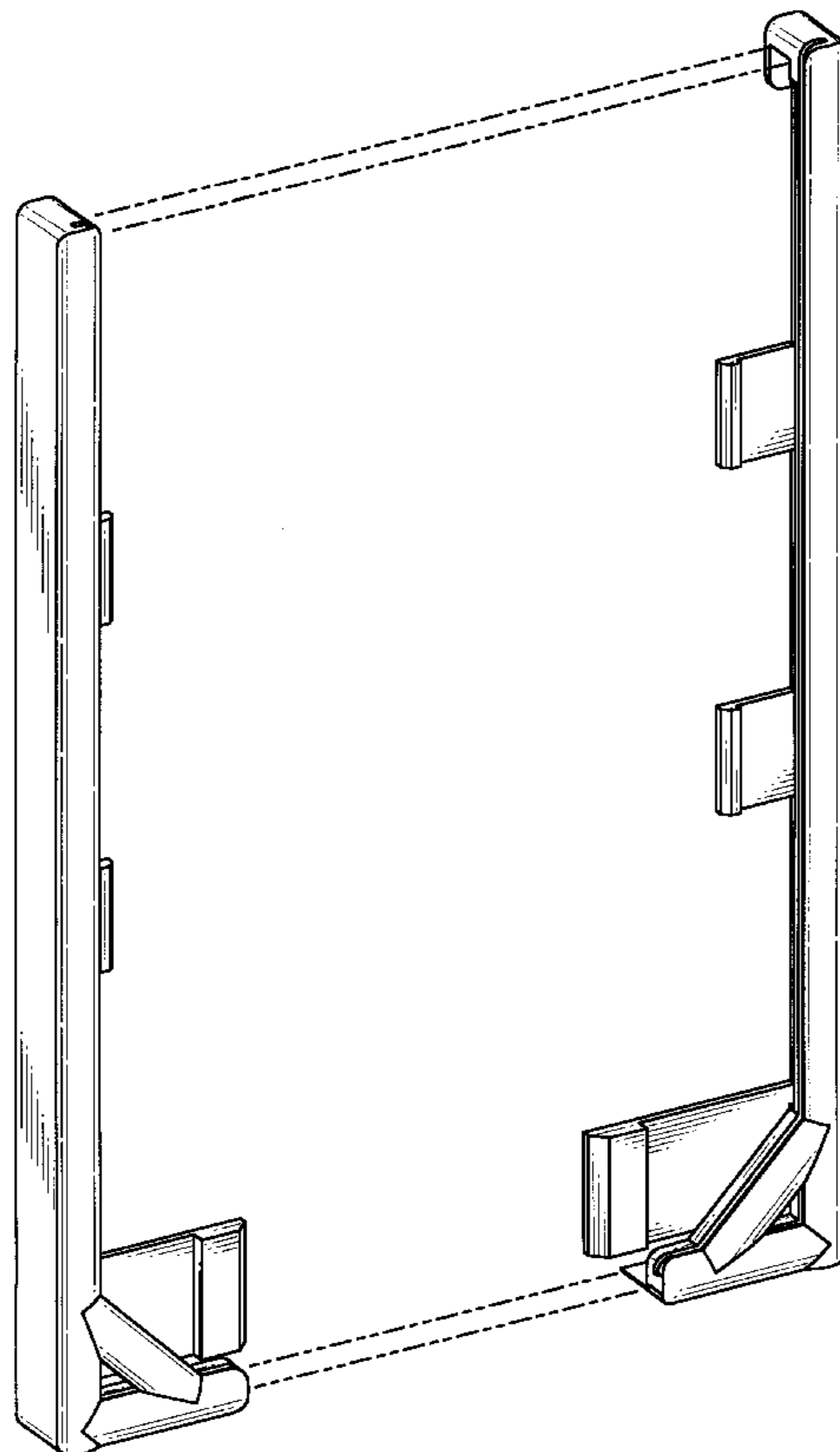
FIG. 8 shows a plan view of an inside portion of an ornamental design for a picture frame according to the invention taken from line 8—8 in FIG. 5;

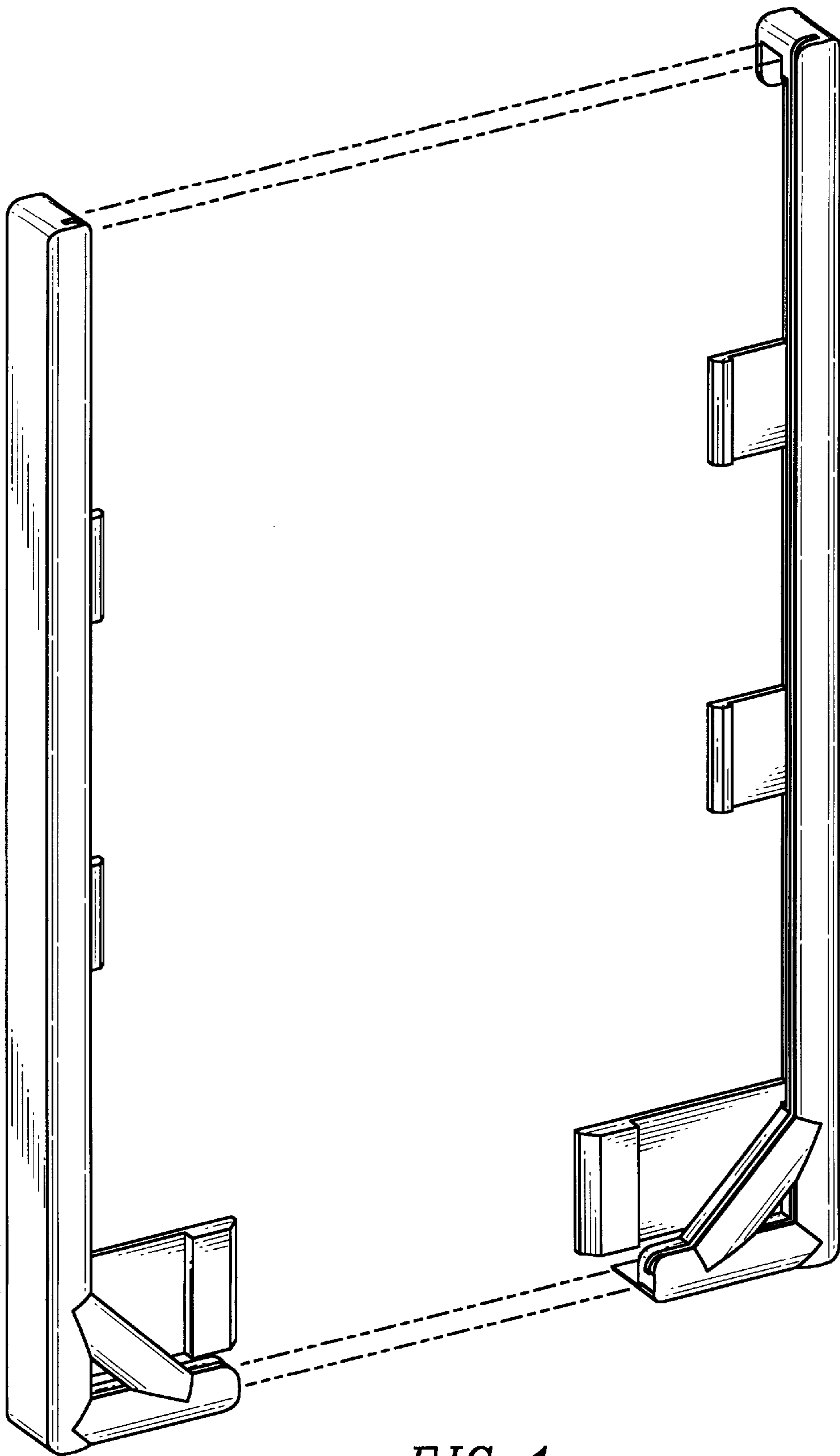

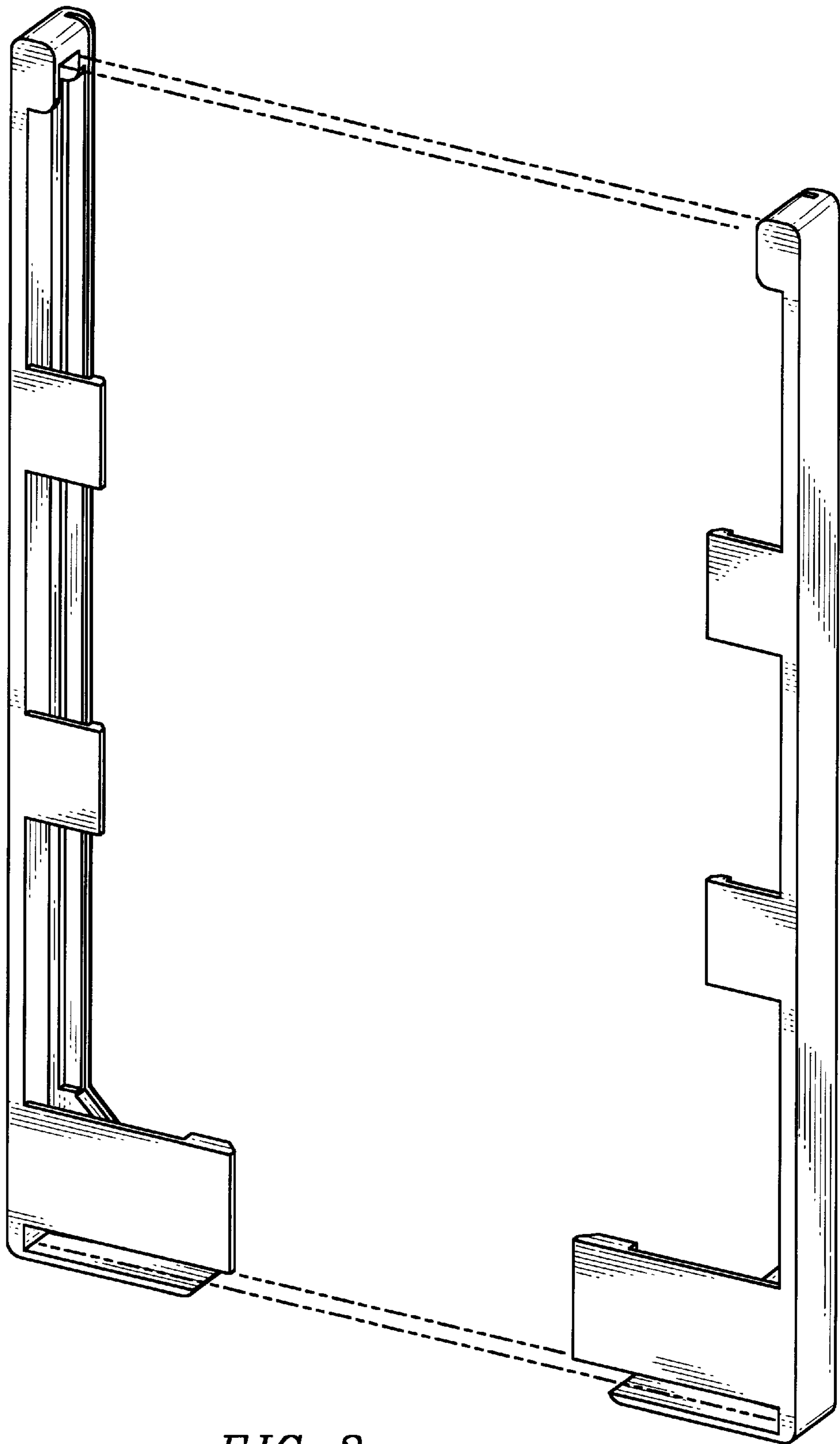

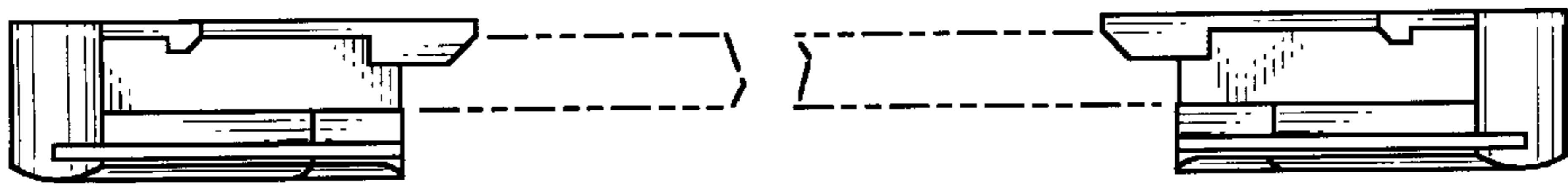

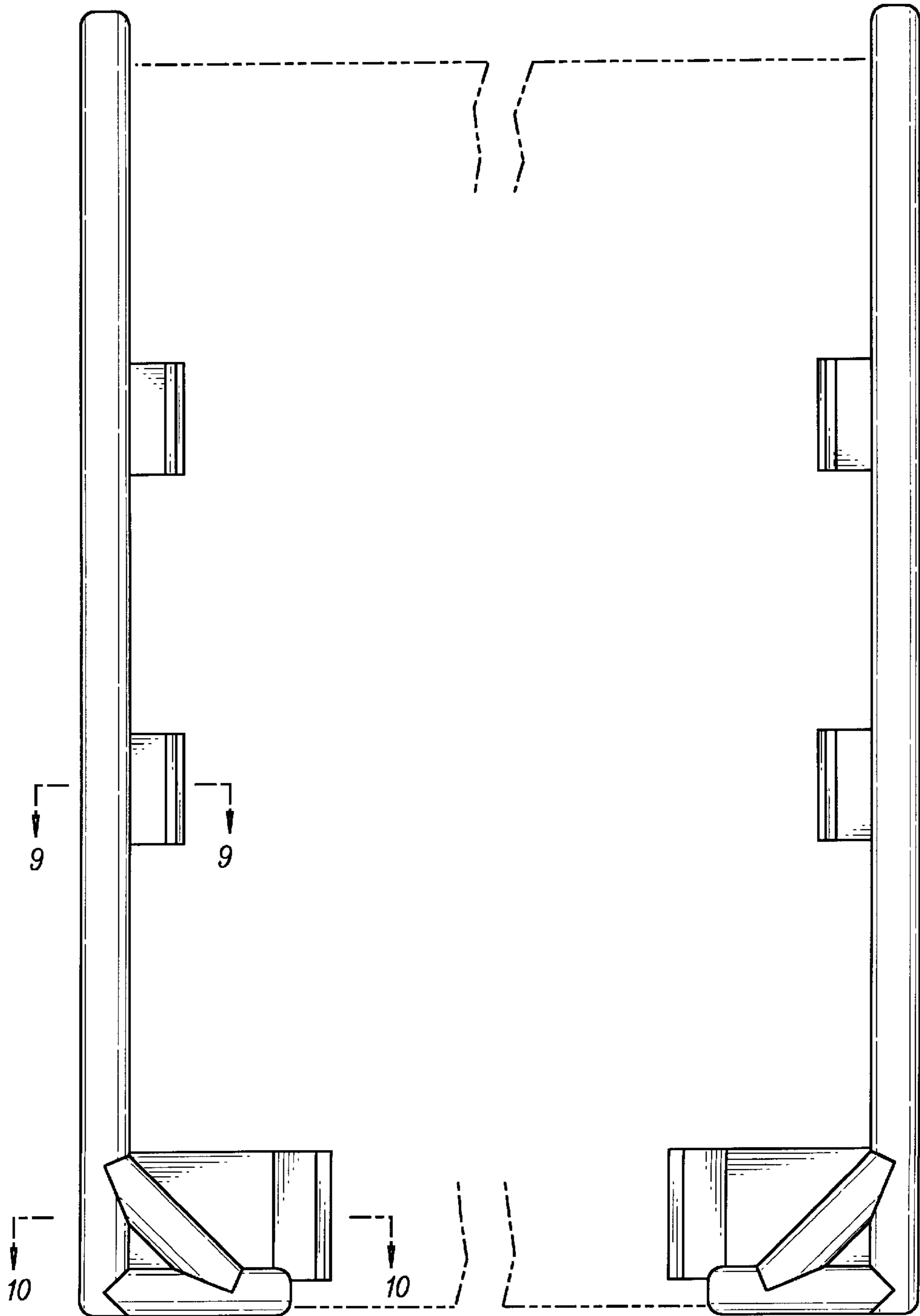

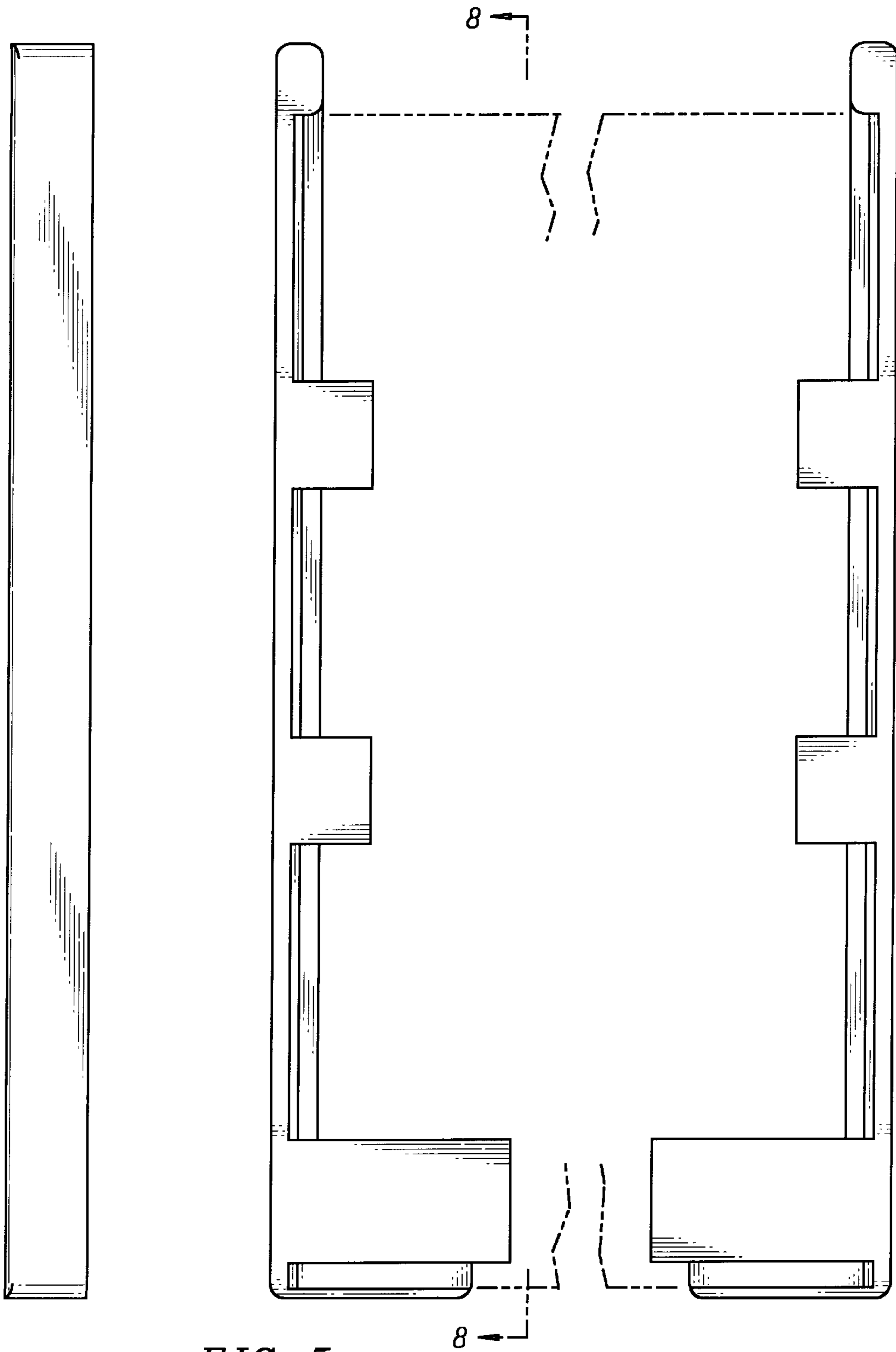

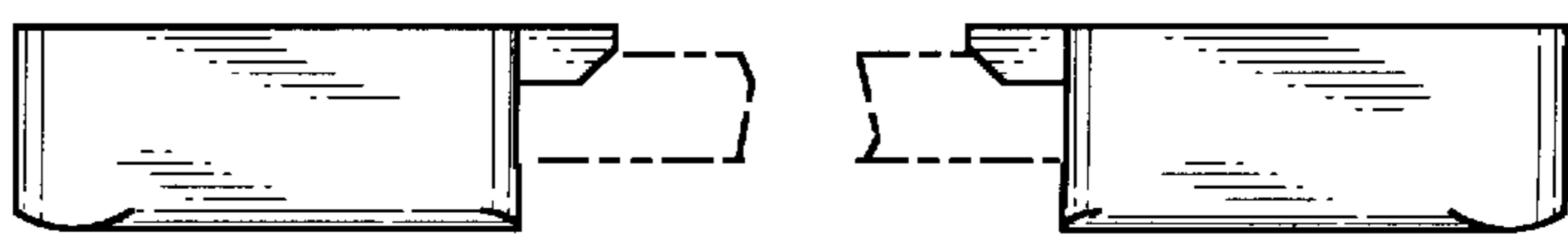

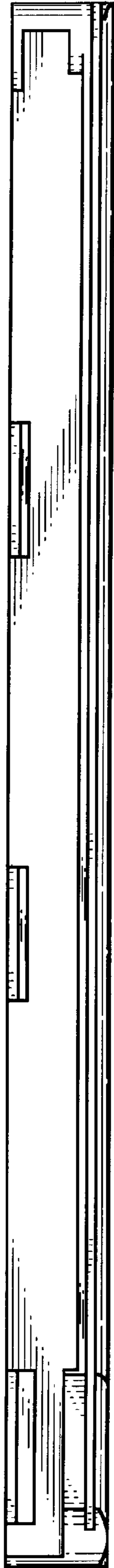

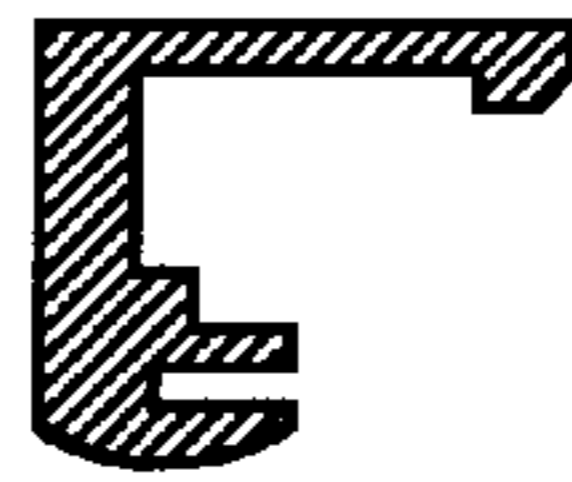
