[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shelf, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is as a wall mountable shelf primarily useful for storing various objects such as sports trophies.

FIG. 1 is a left, bottom, front perspective view of a shelf embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side shown;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left, bottom, front perspective view of a second embodiment;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side shown;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a left, bottom, front perspective view of a third embodiment;

FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 15 is a front elevational view thereof;

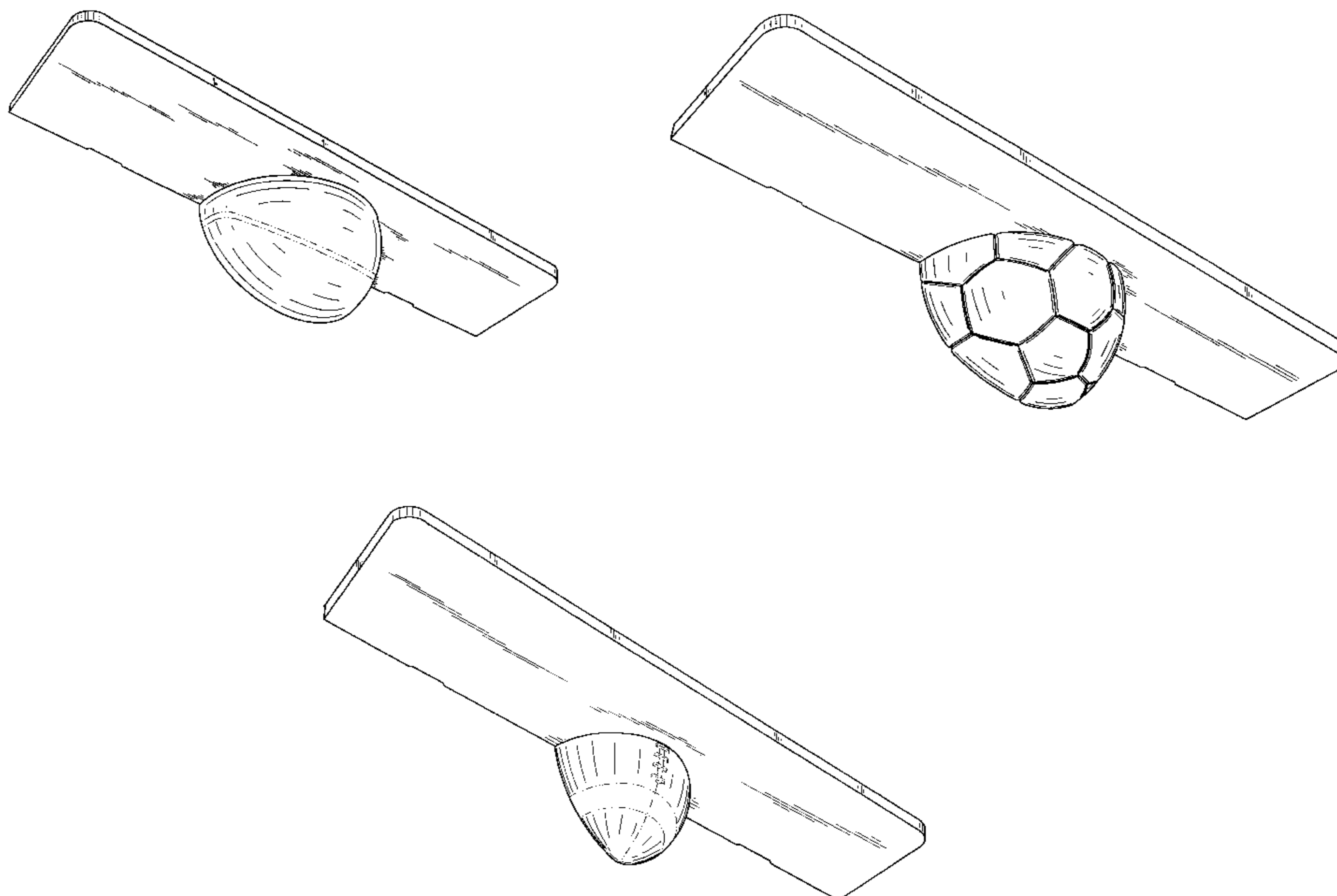
FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 17 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image of the left side shown; and,

FIG. 18 is a rear elevational view thereof.

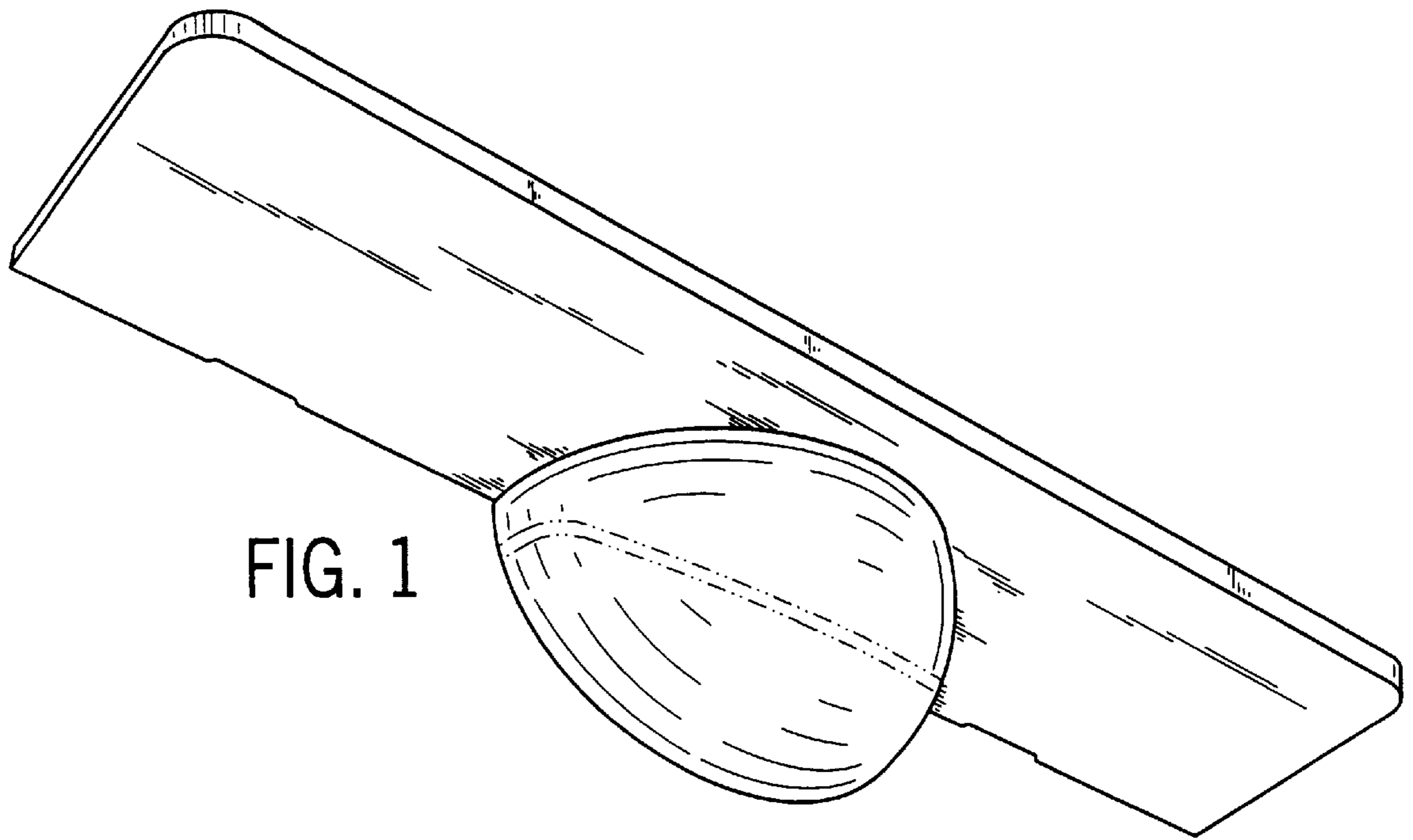

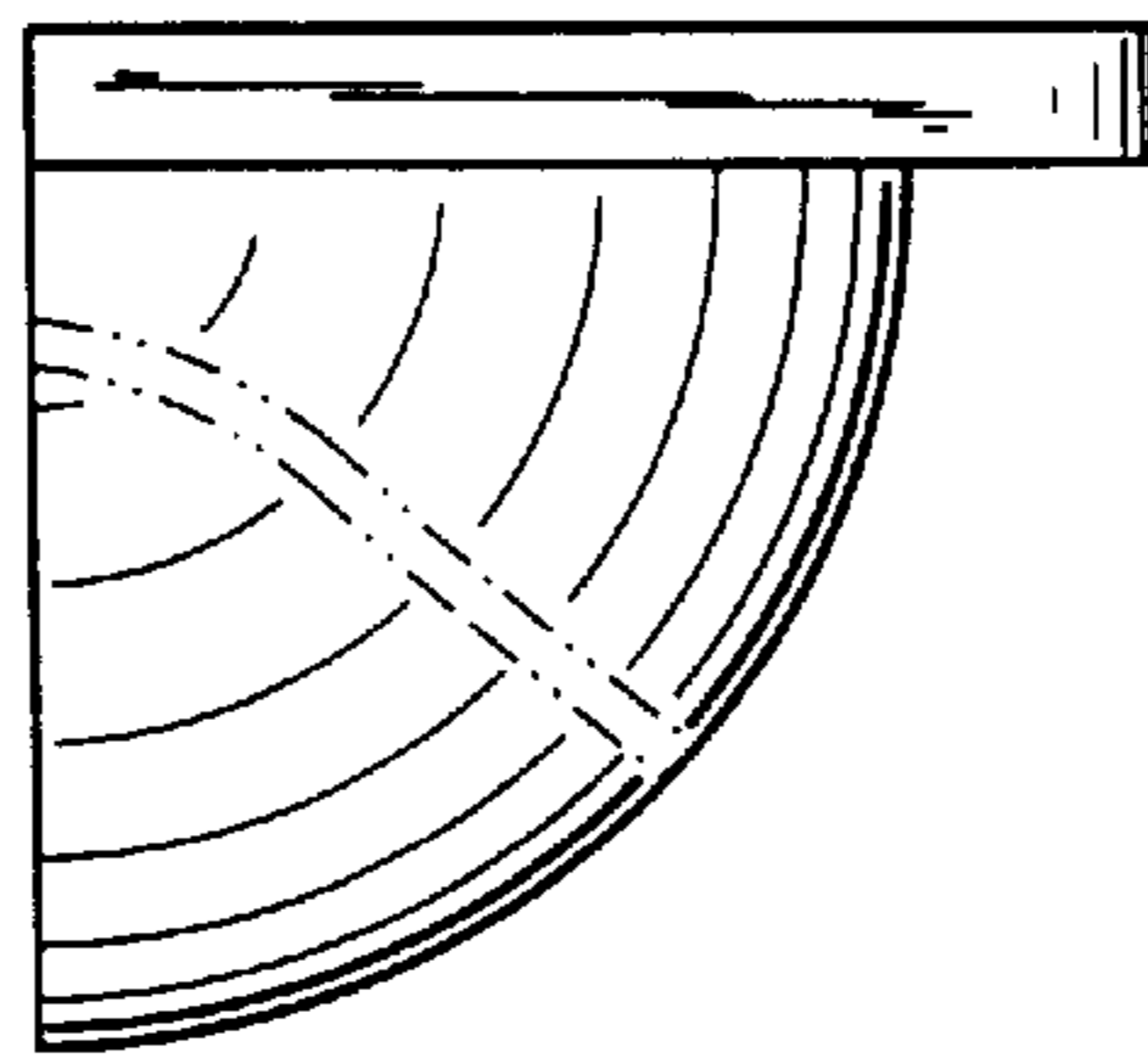

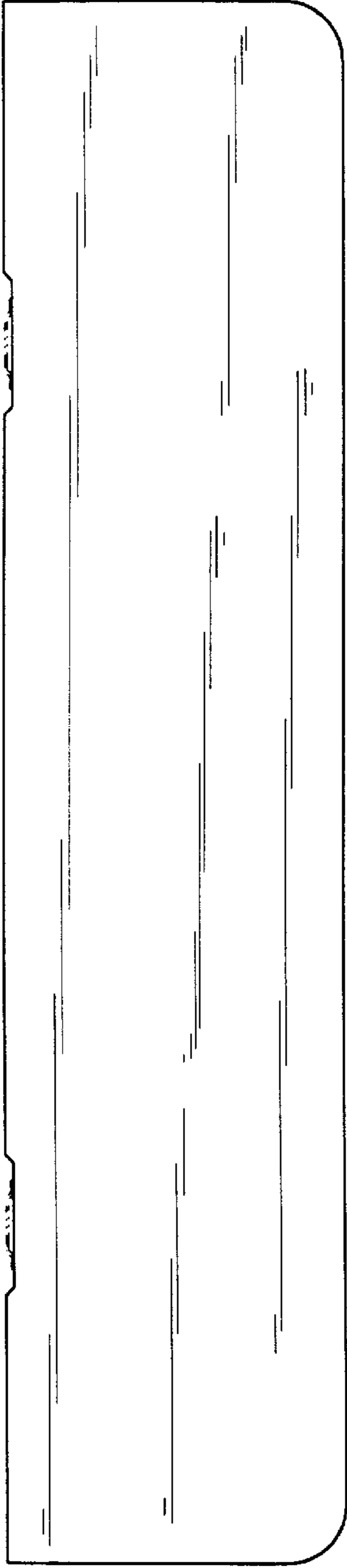

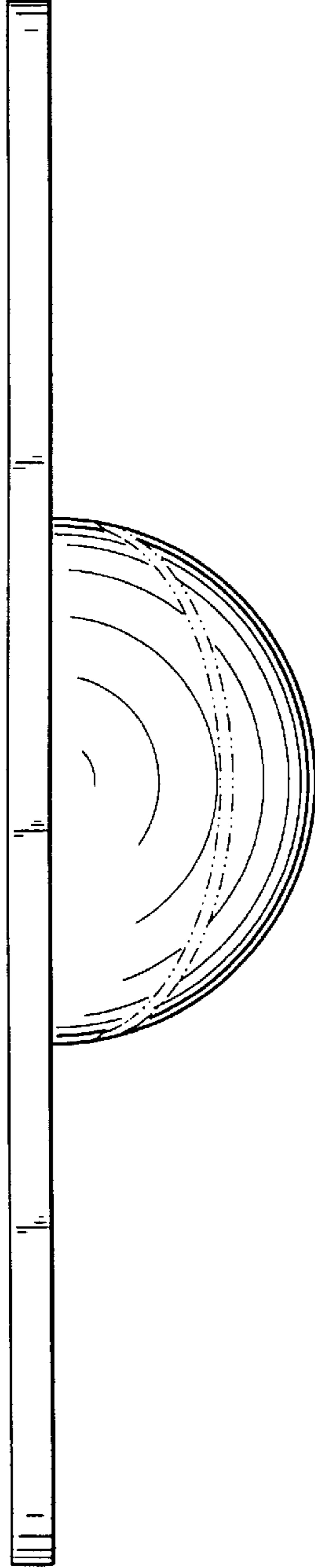

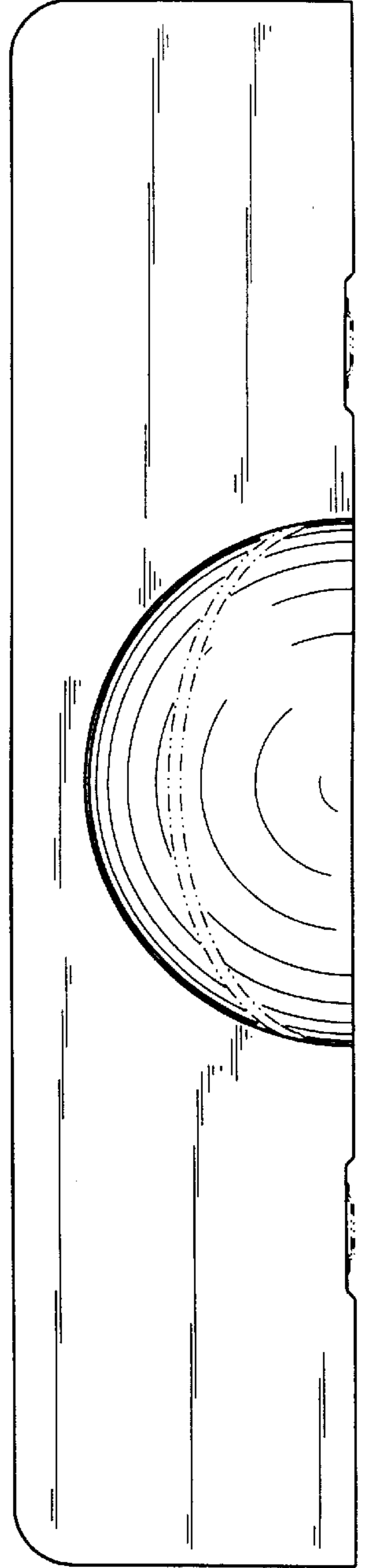
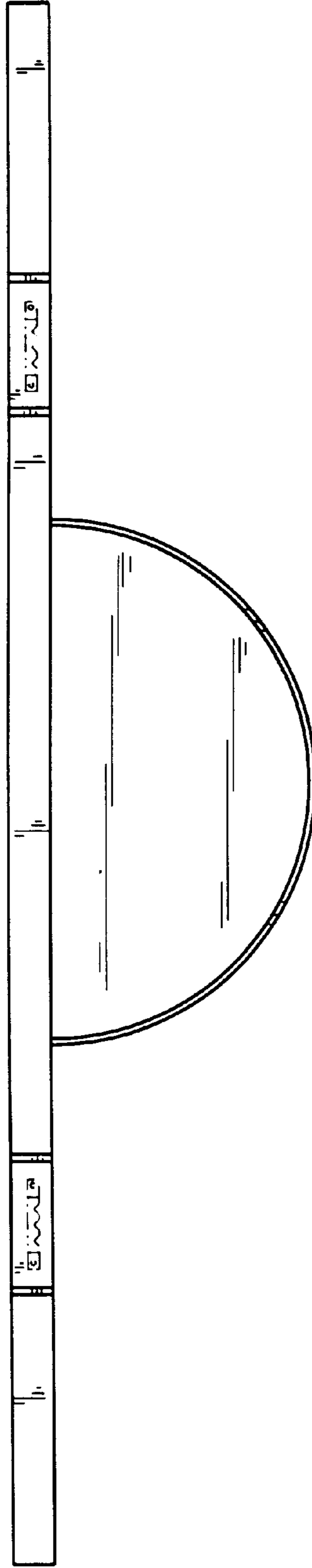

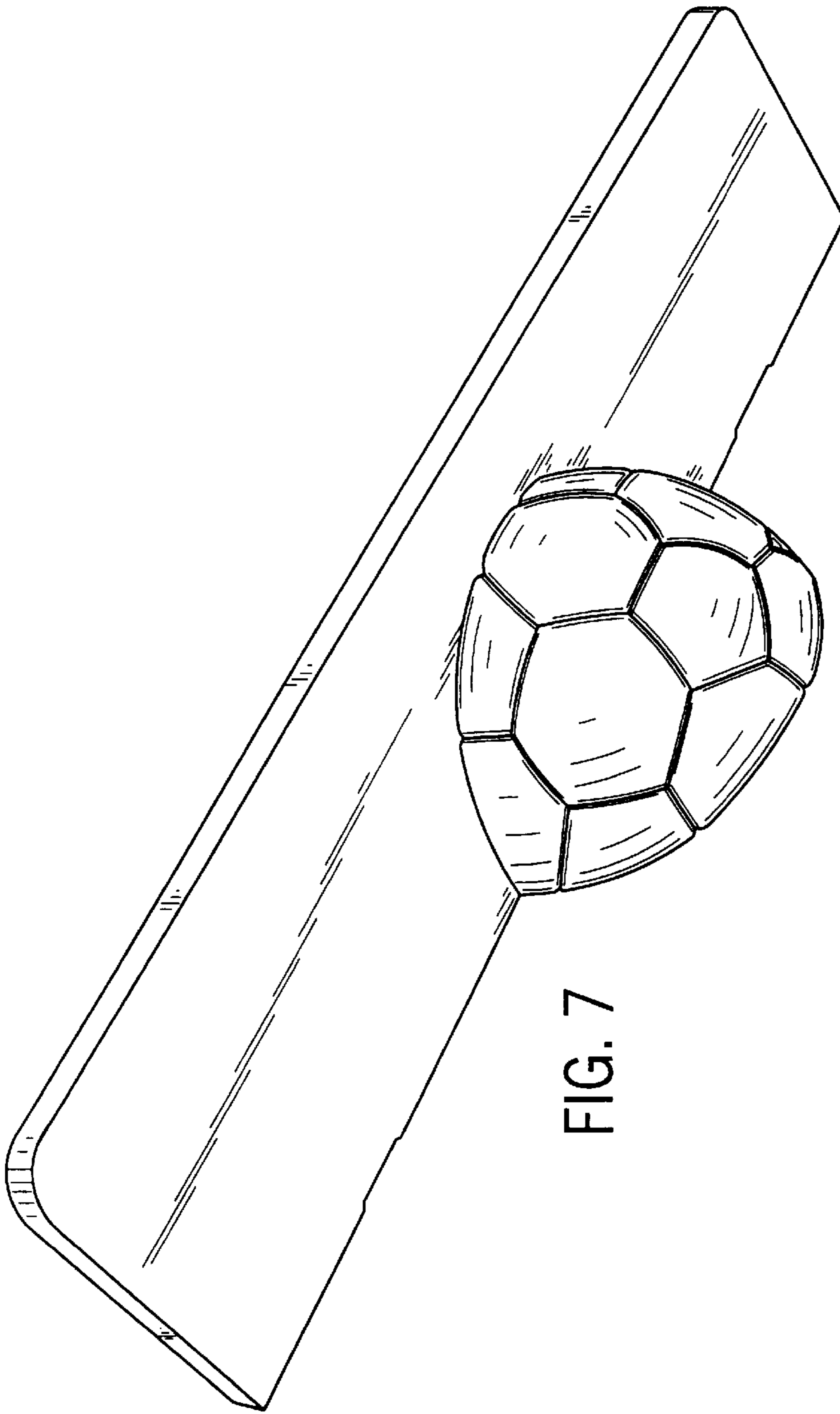

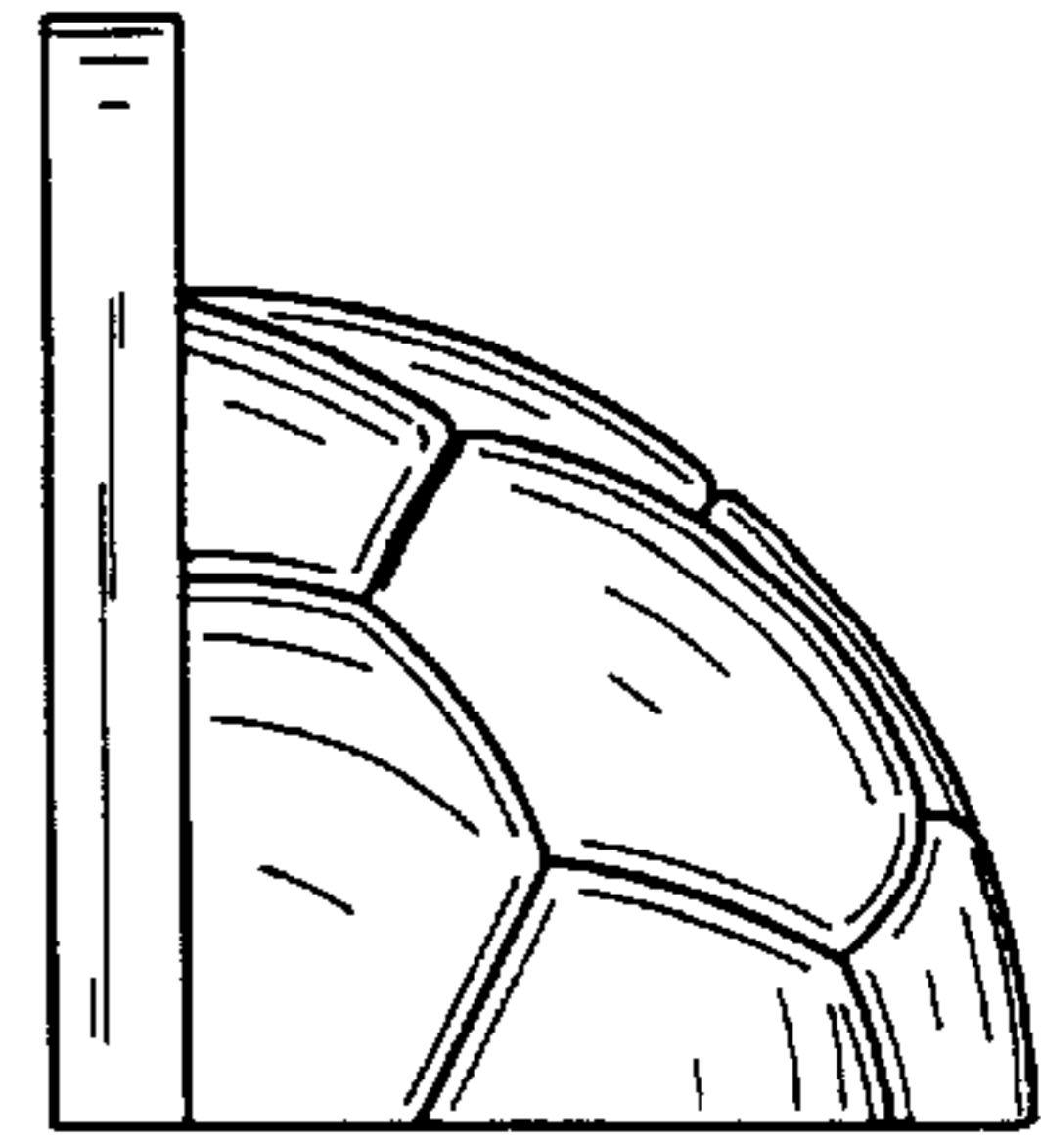

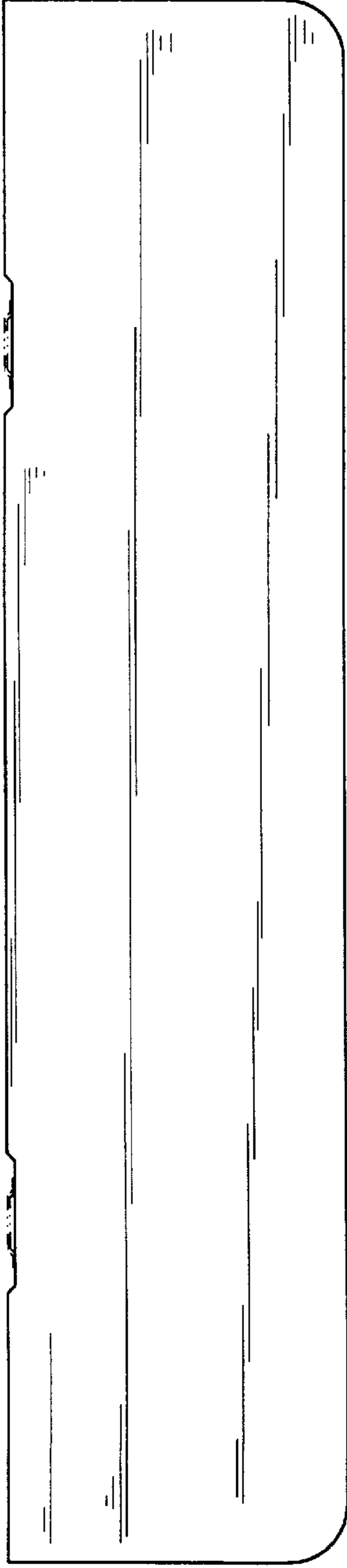

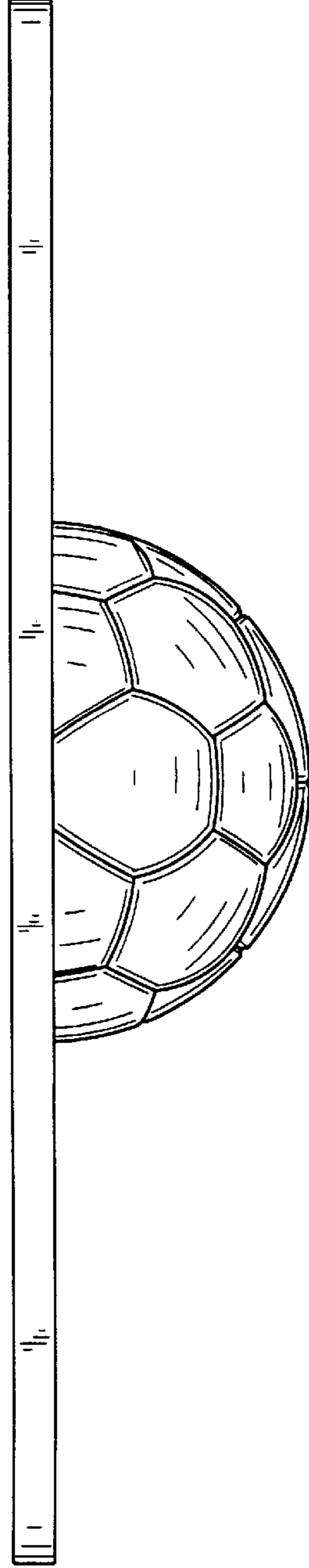

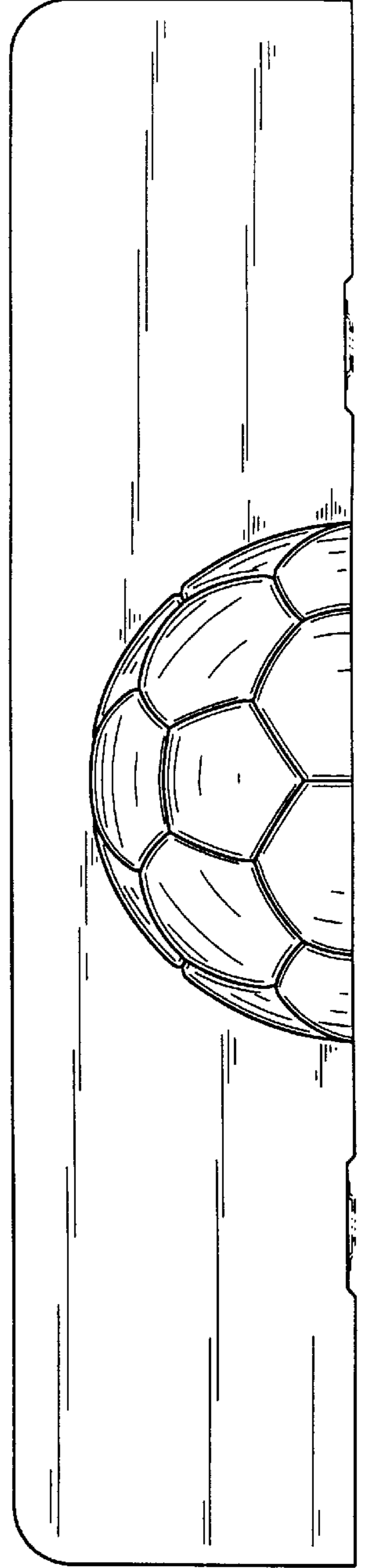
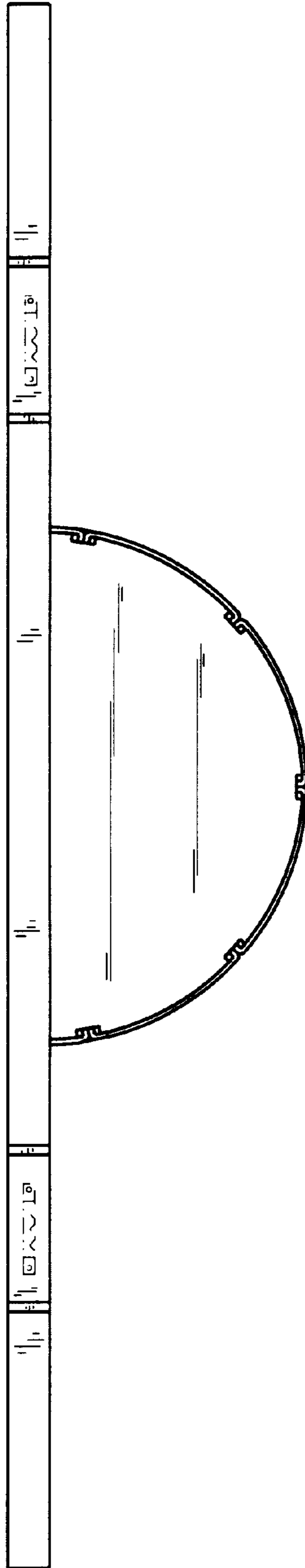

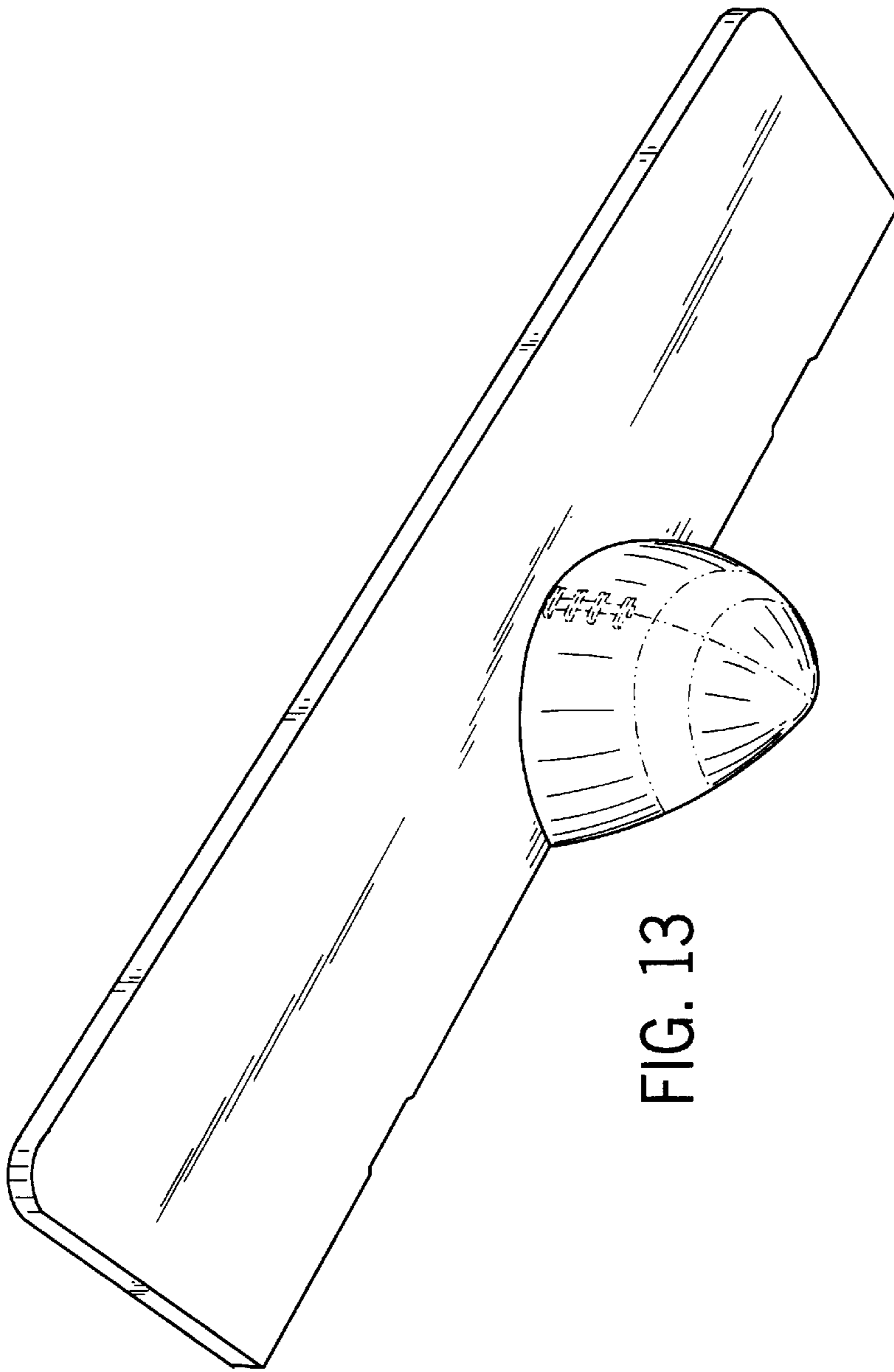

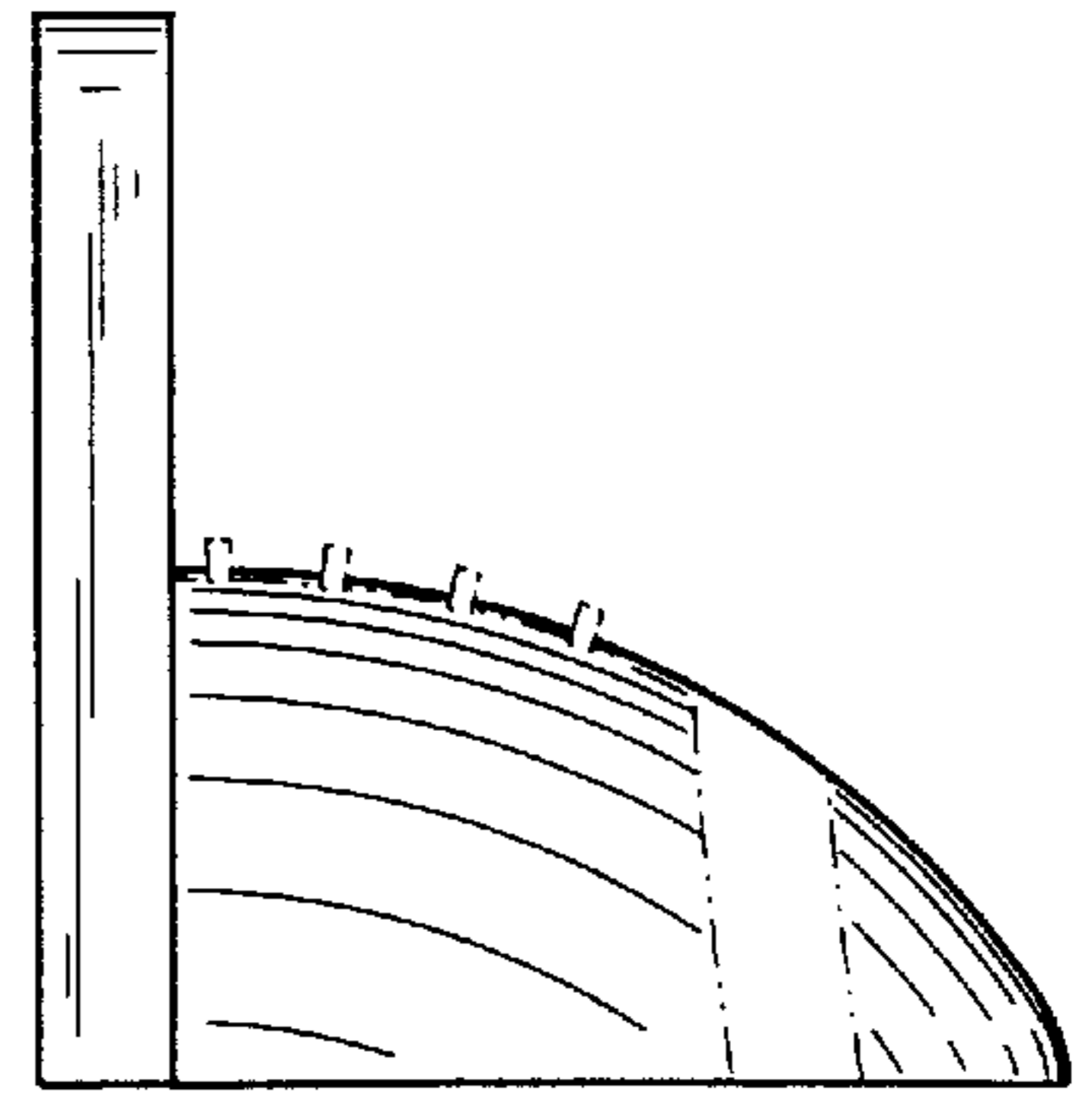

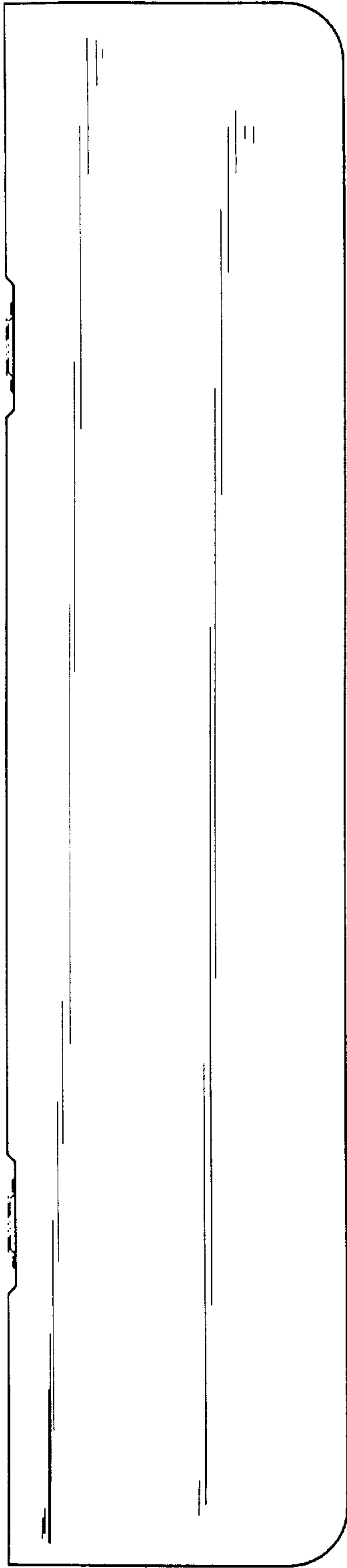

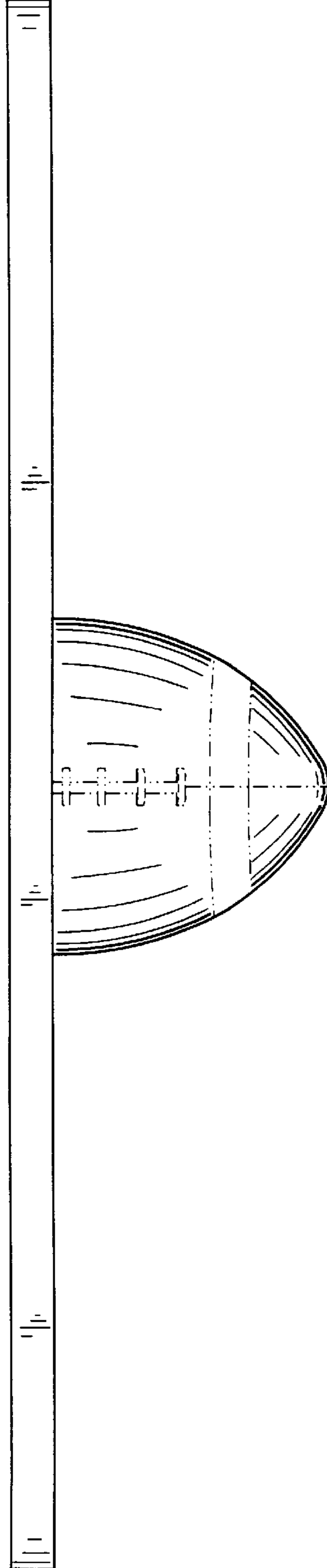

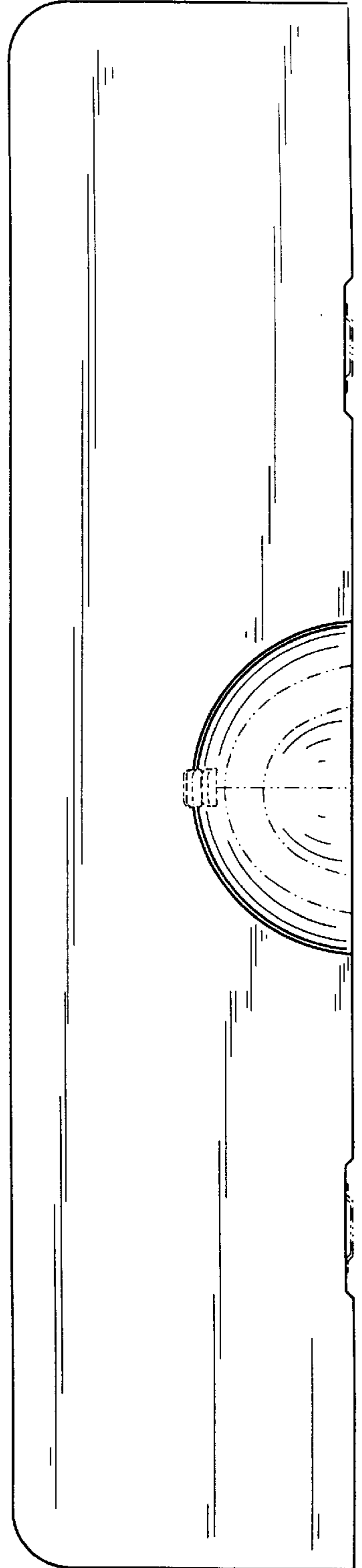
