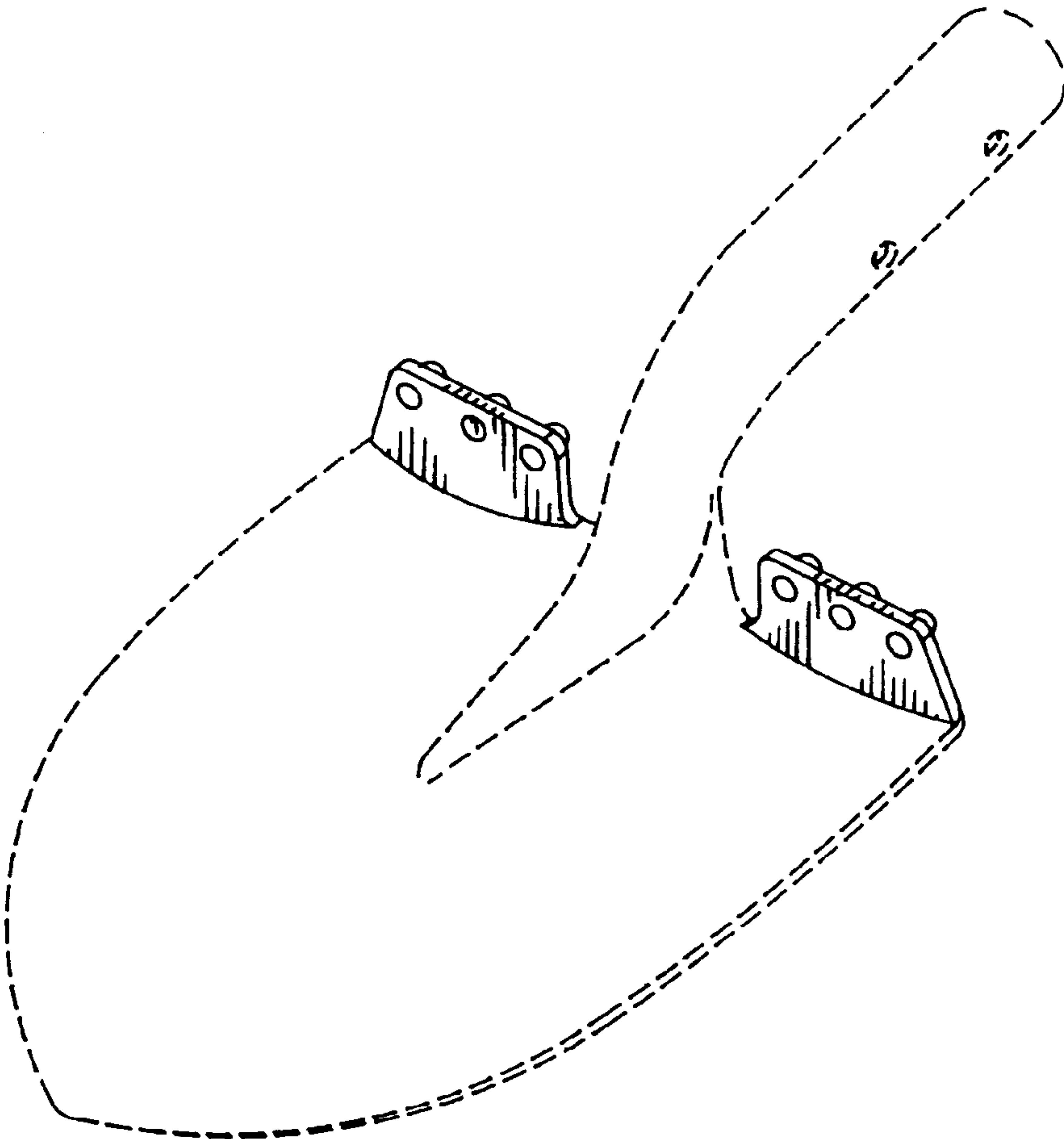
The ornamental design for a shovel element, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the shovel element according to a preferred embodiment of the invention;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top view of the shovel element;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the shovel element;
FIG. 4 is a front view of the shovel element;
FIG. 5 is a rear view of the shovel element;
FIG. 6 is a right side view of the shovel element; and,

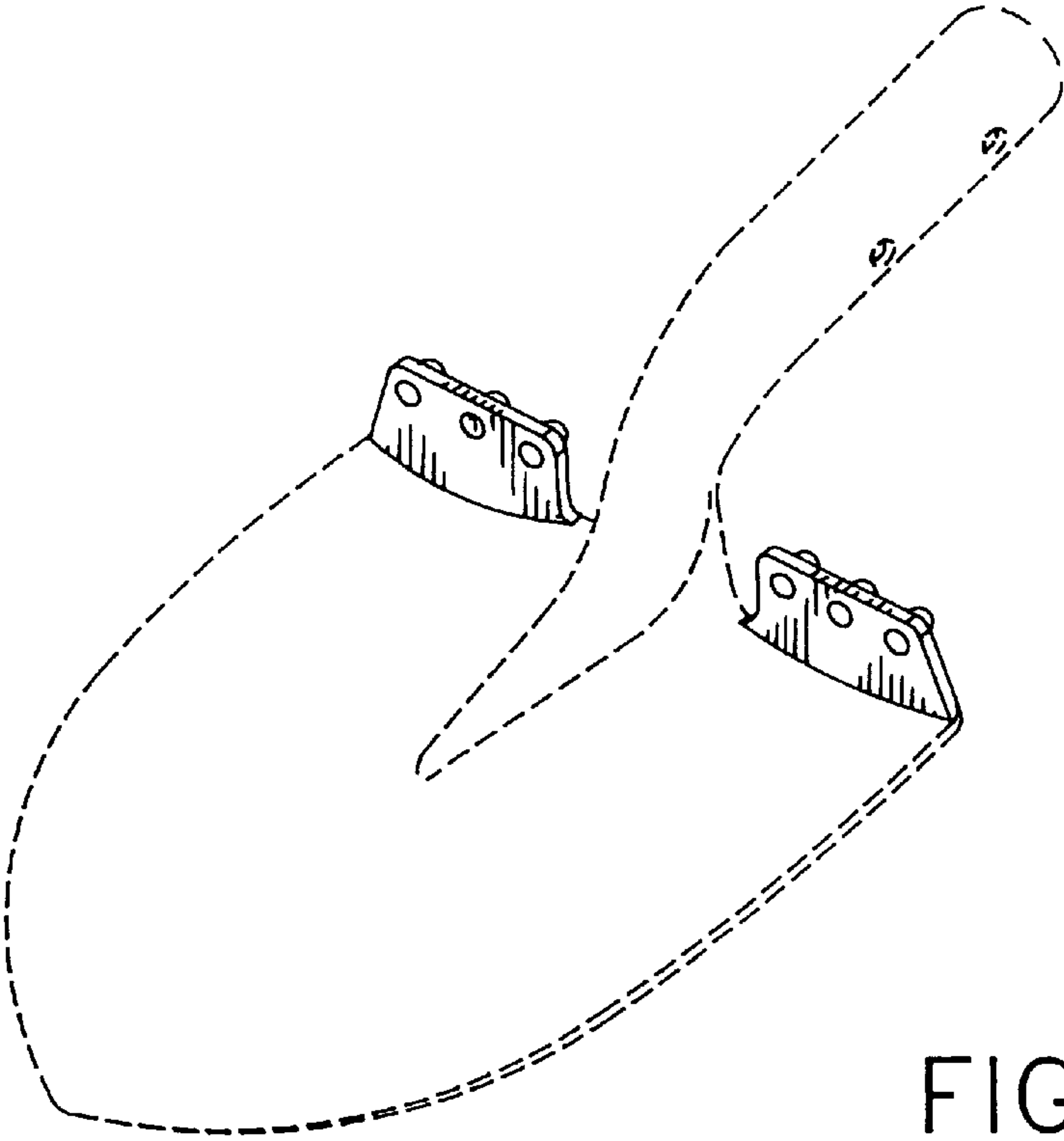

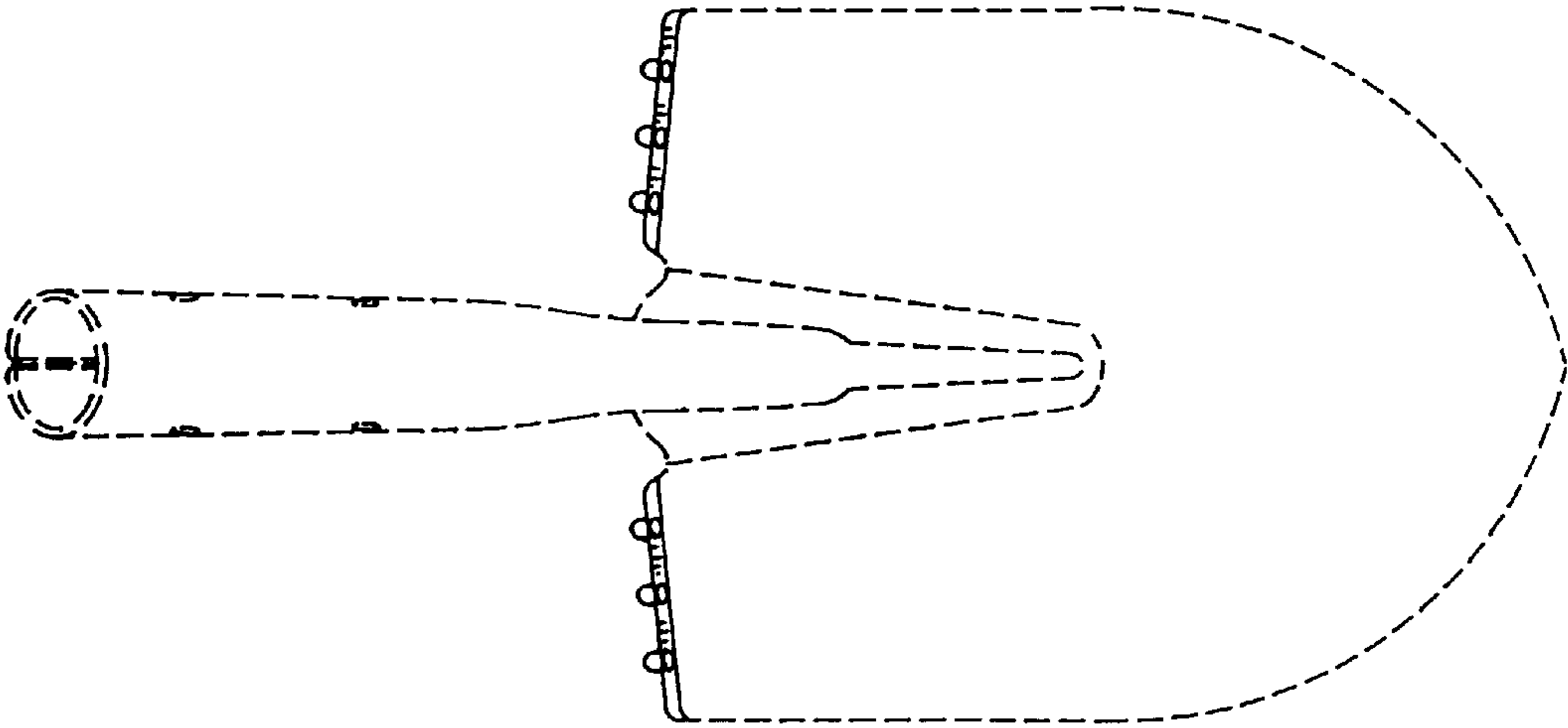

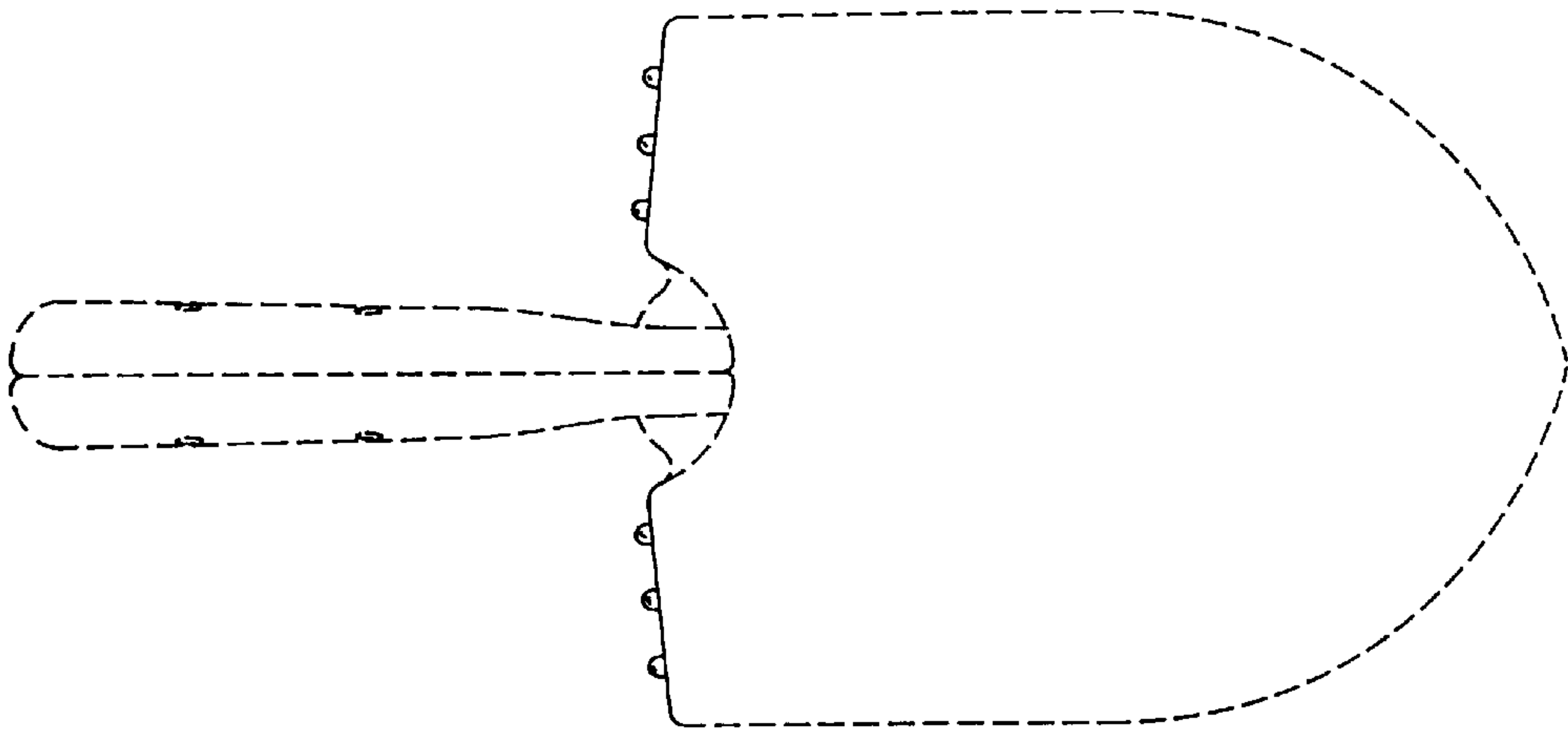

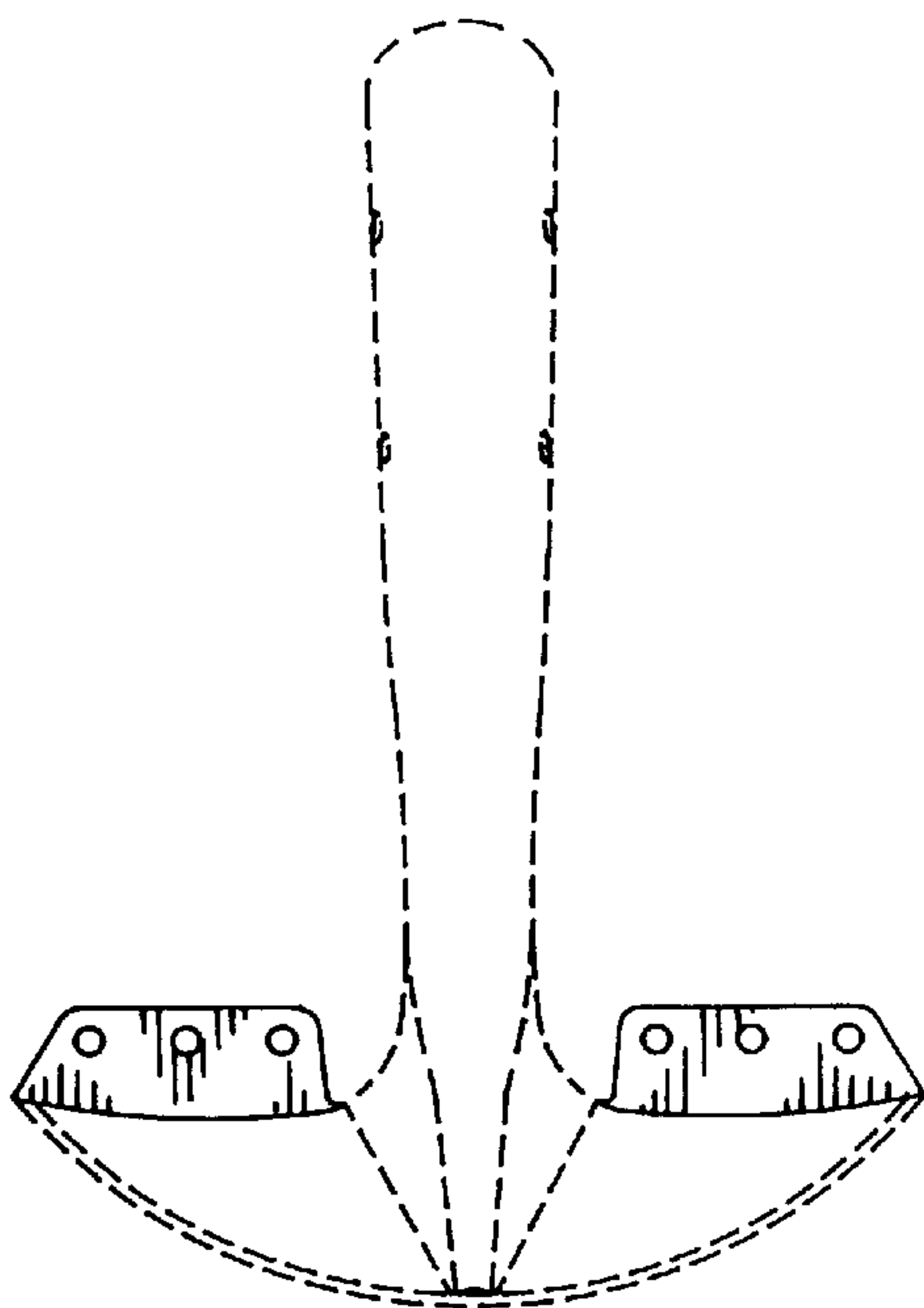

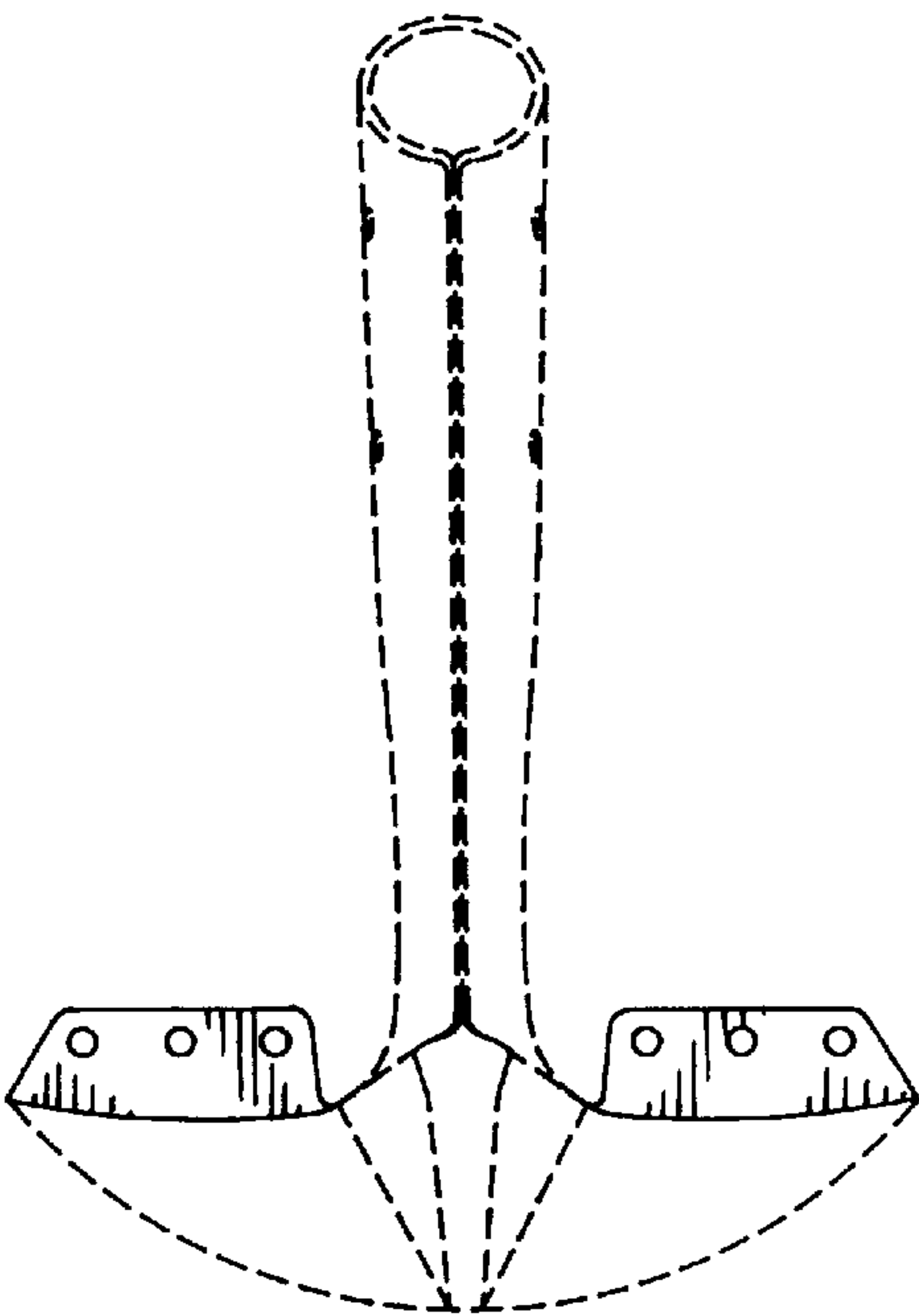

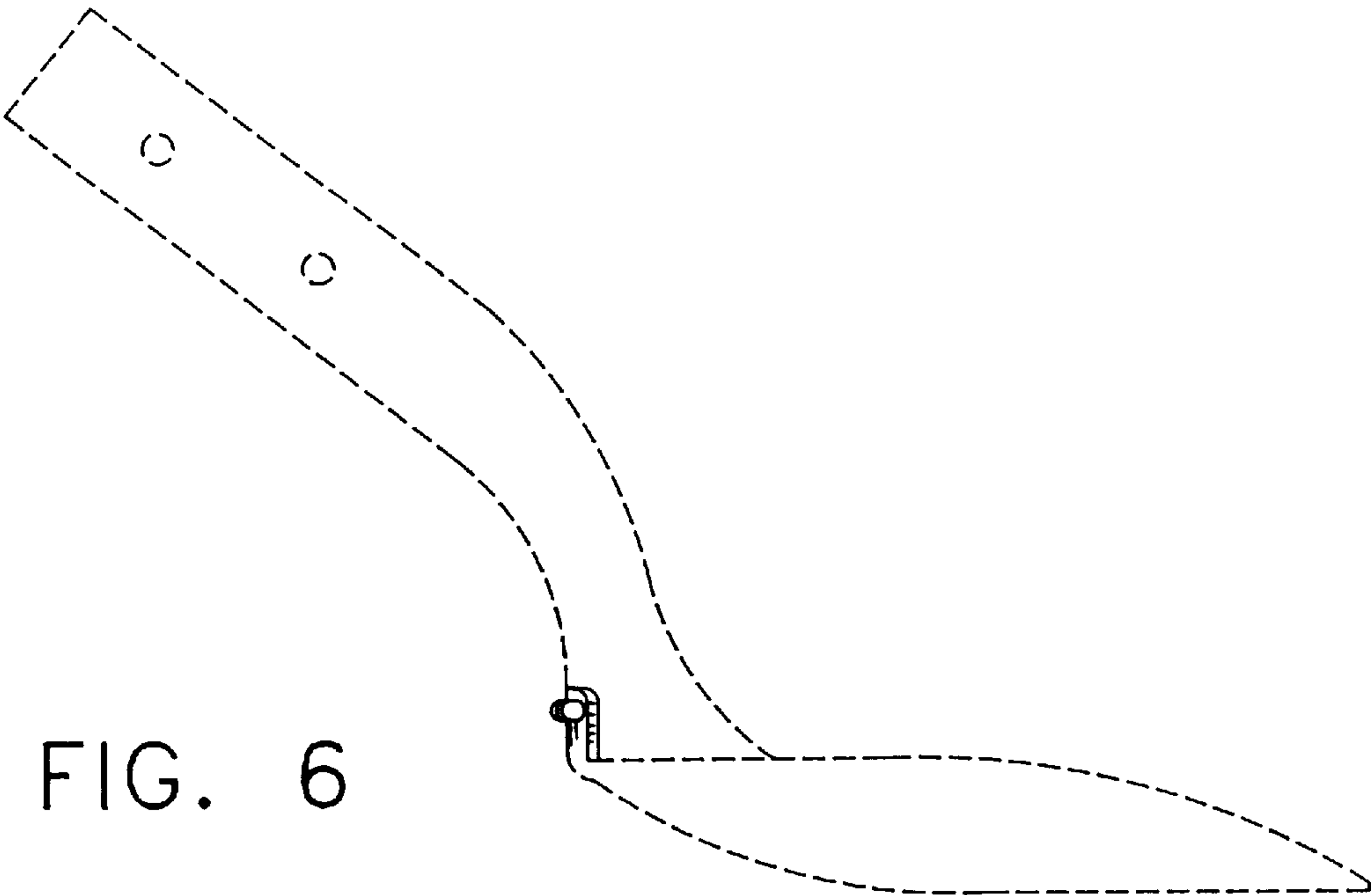

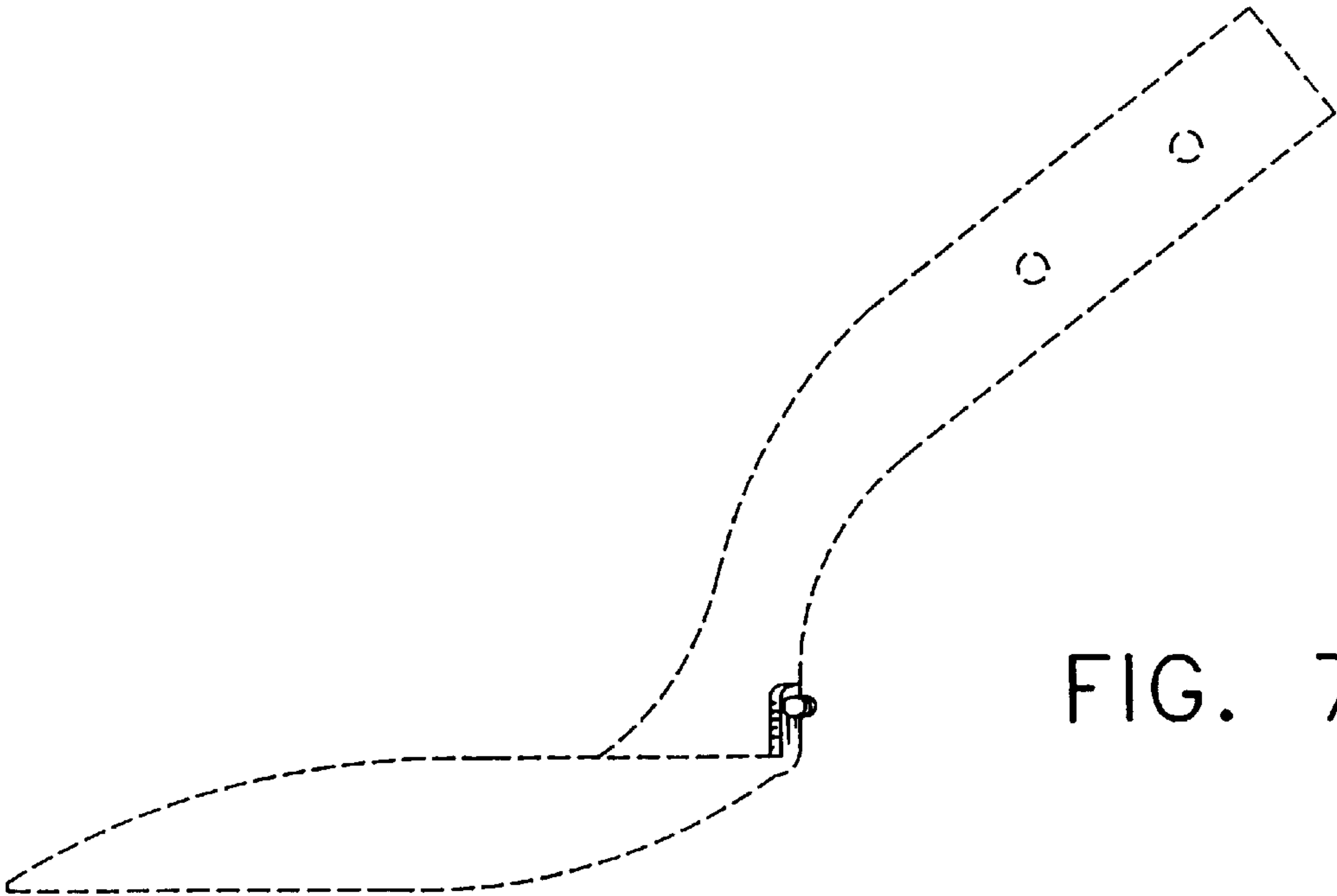
