DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a light attachment for a portable electronic or computing device;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the light attachment for a portable electronic or computing device, shown as used in a portable electronic device;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the light attachment for a portable electronic or computing device of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

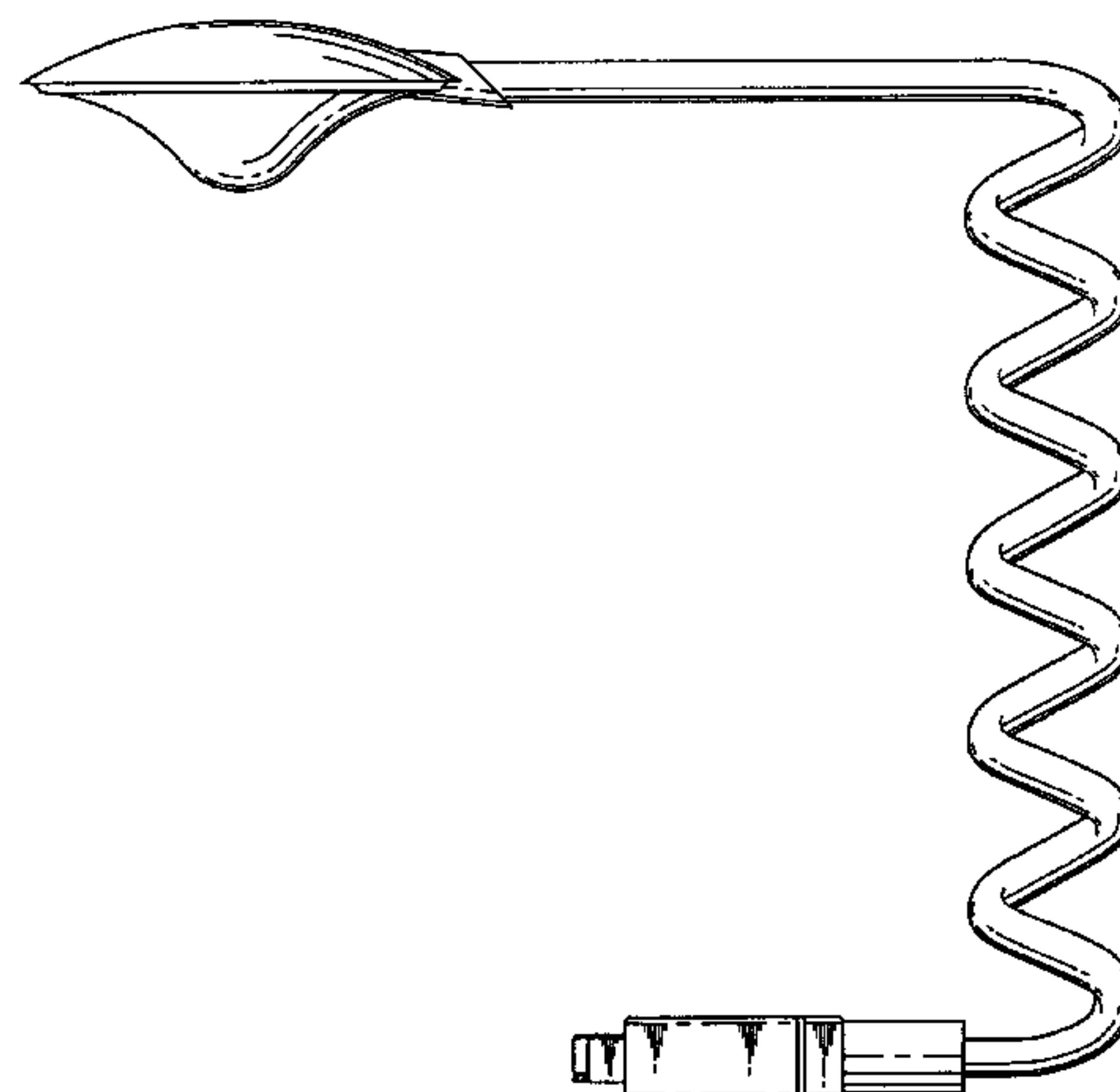
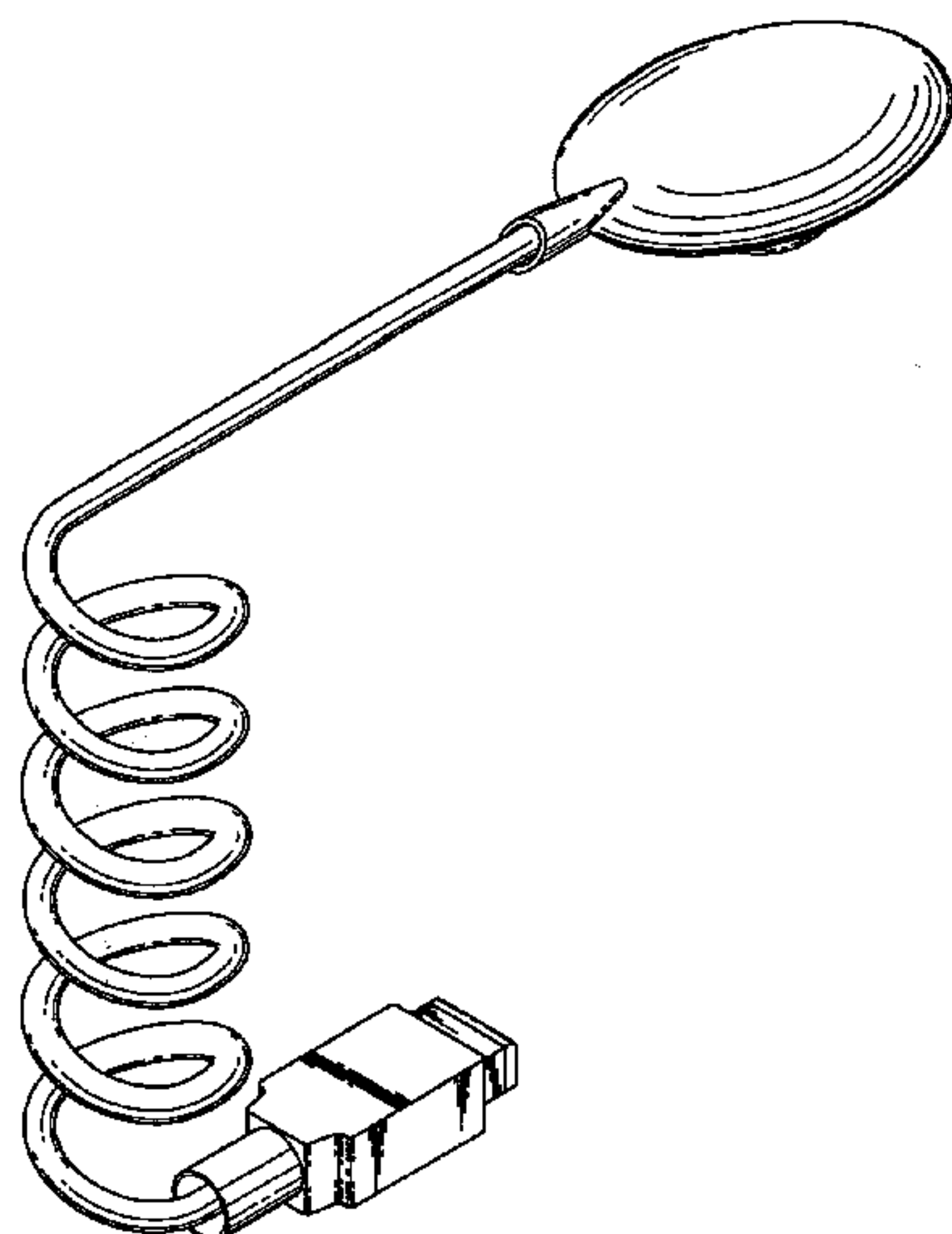
FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof;

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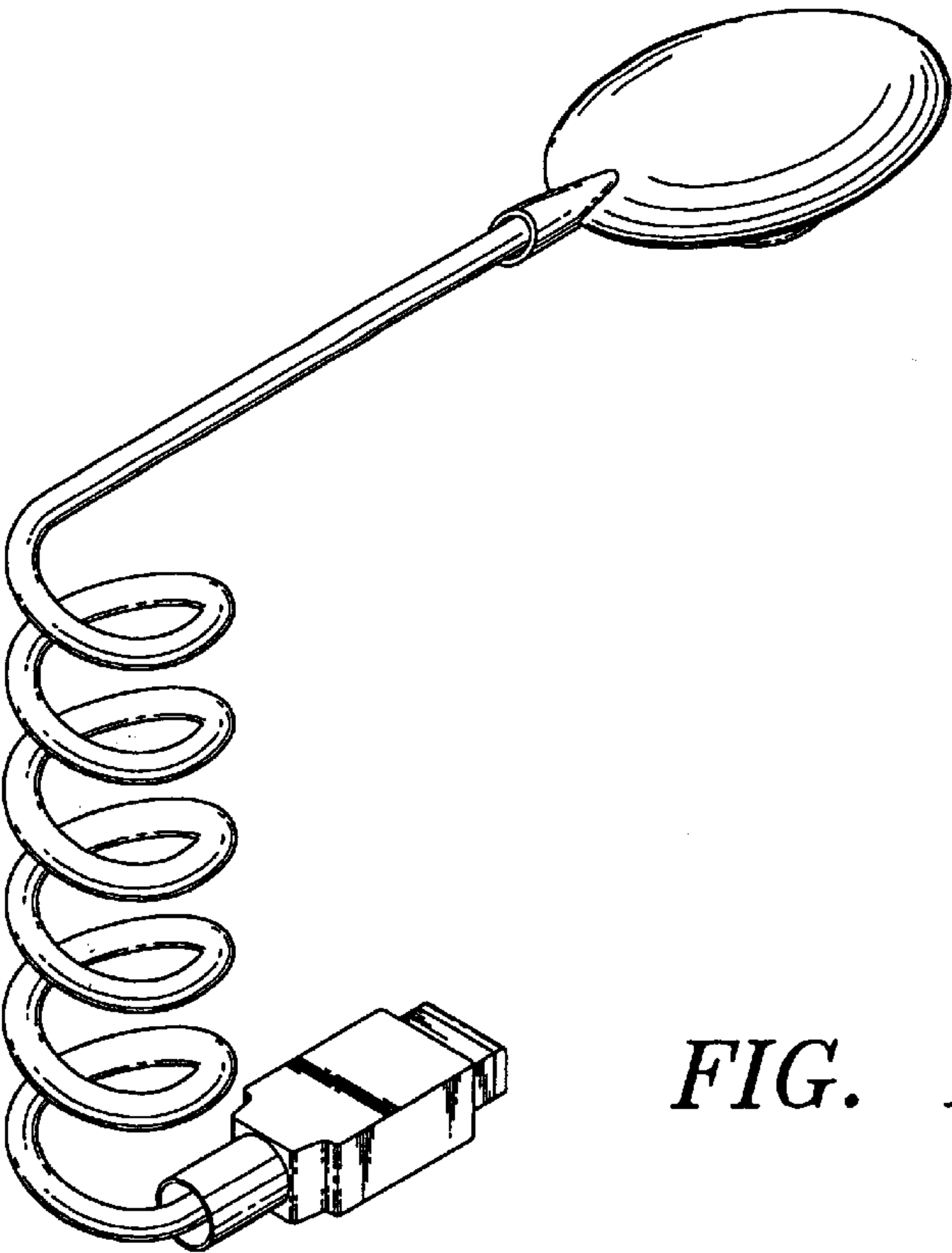

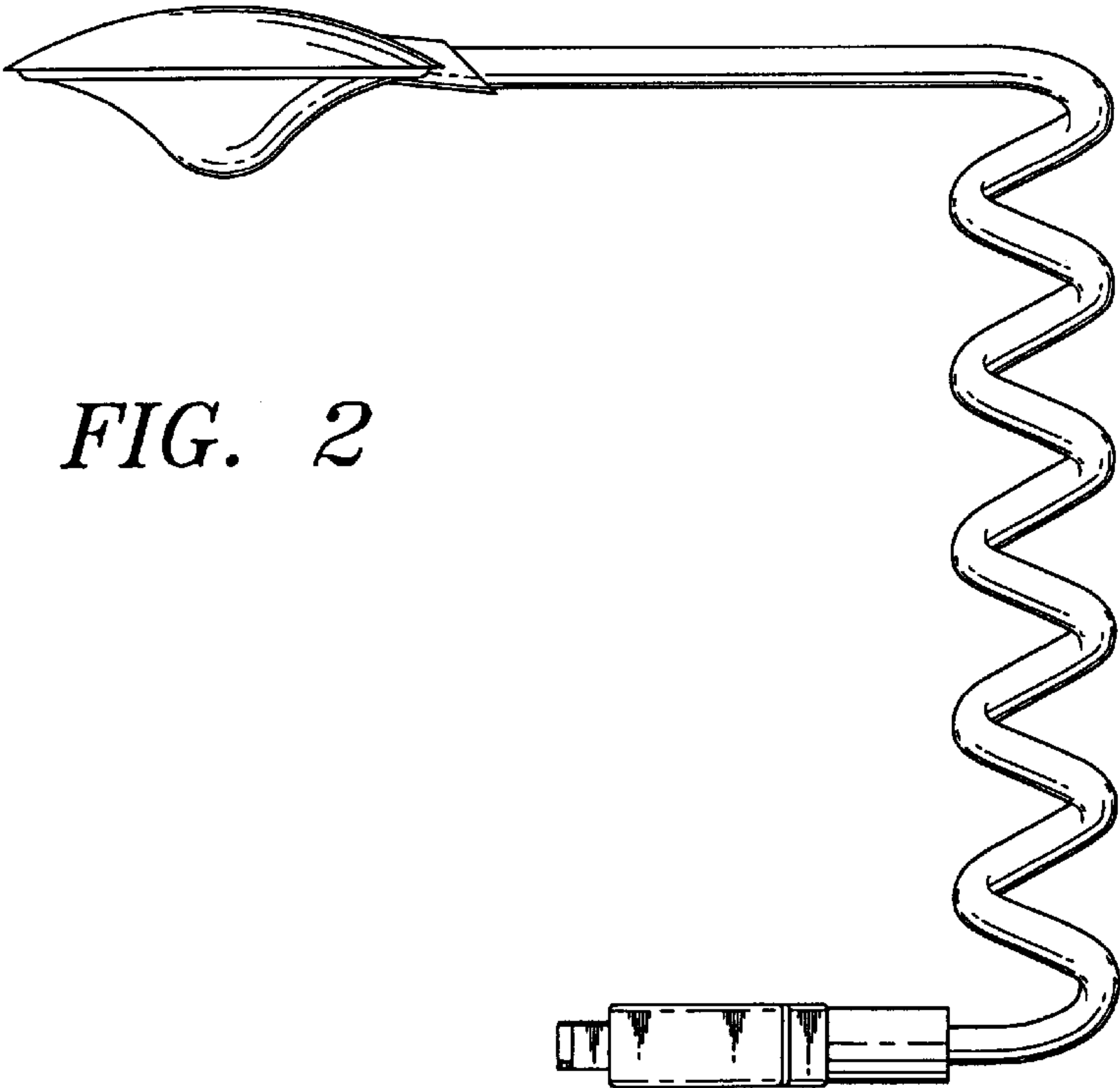

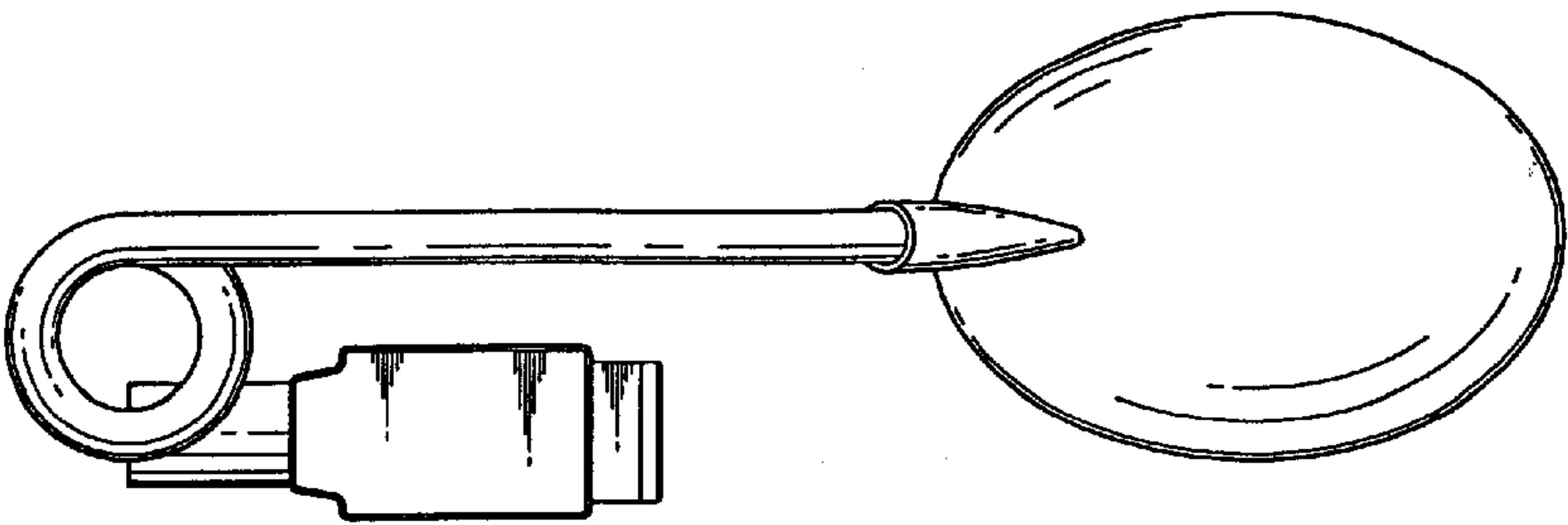

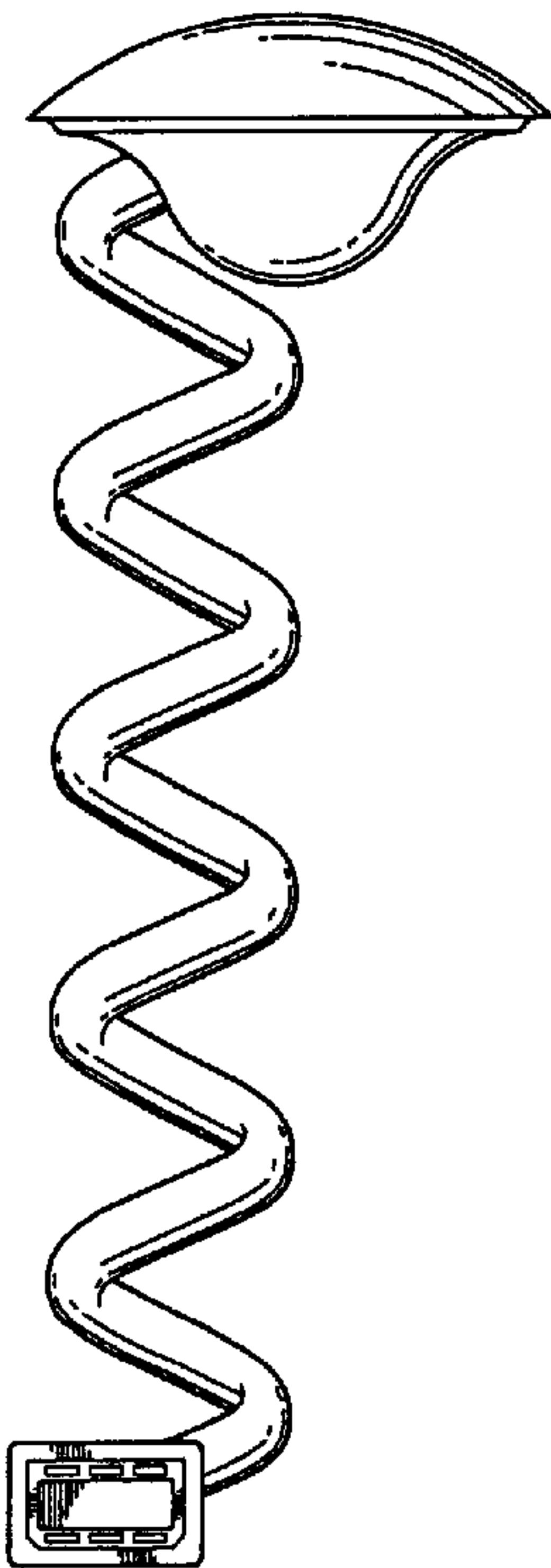

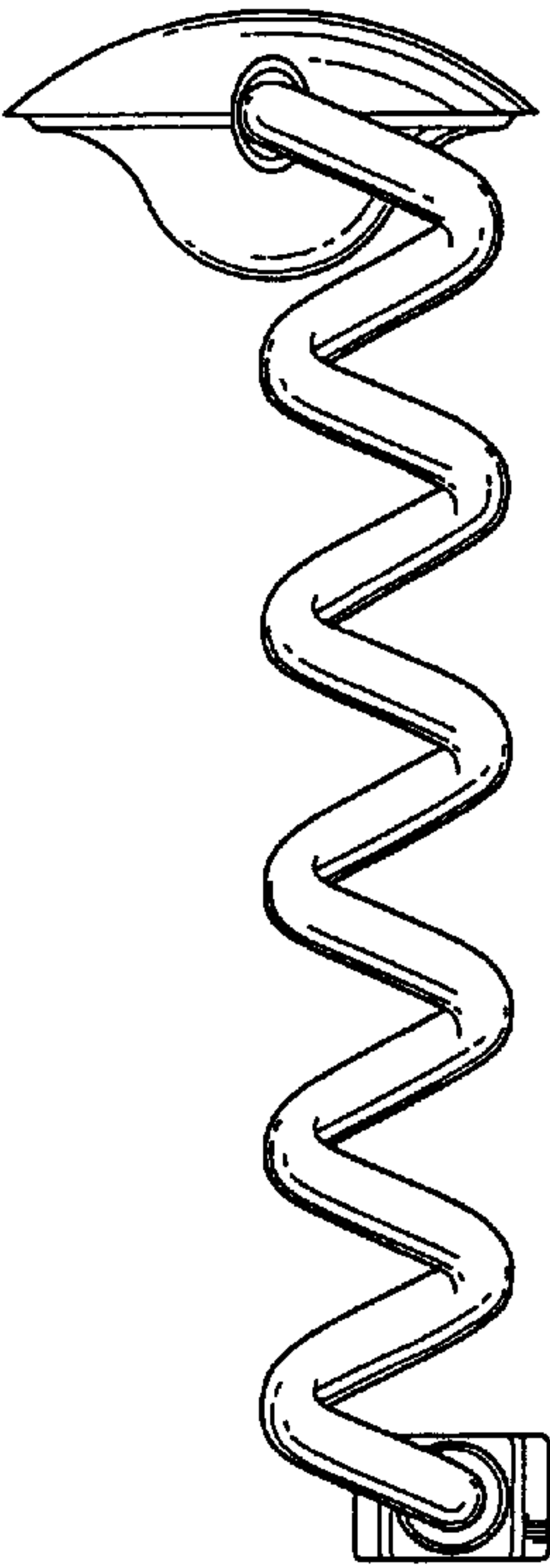

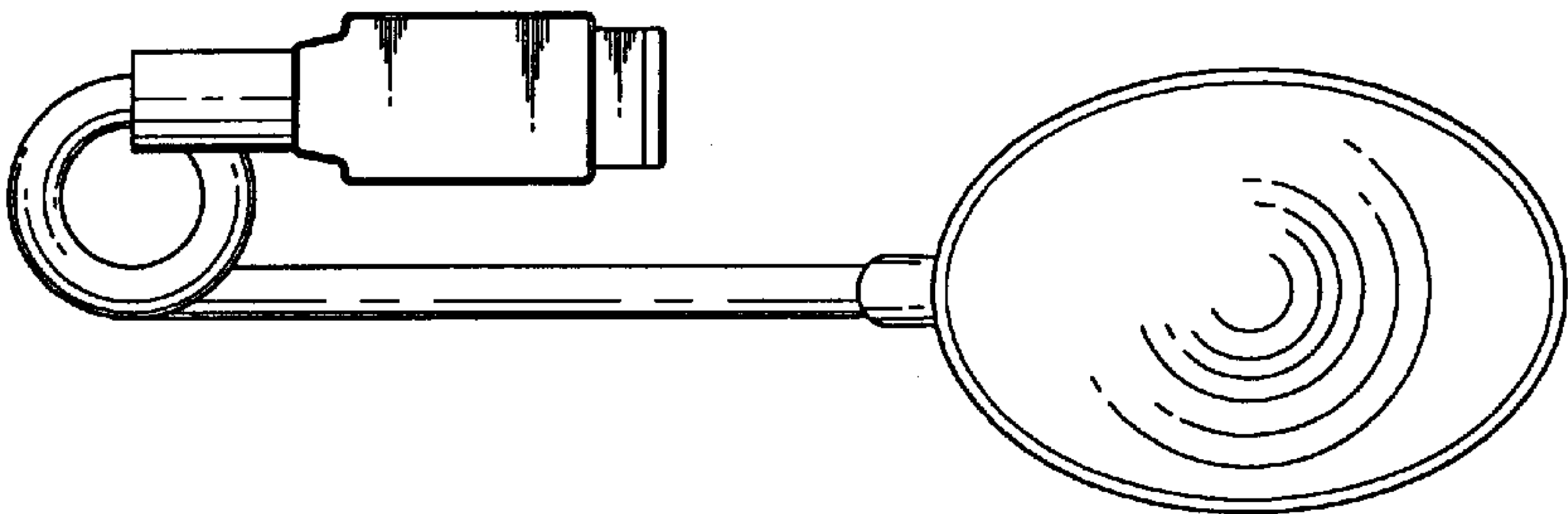

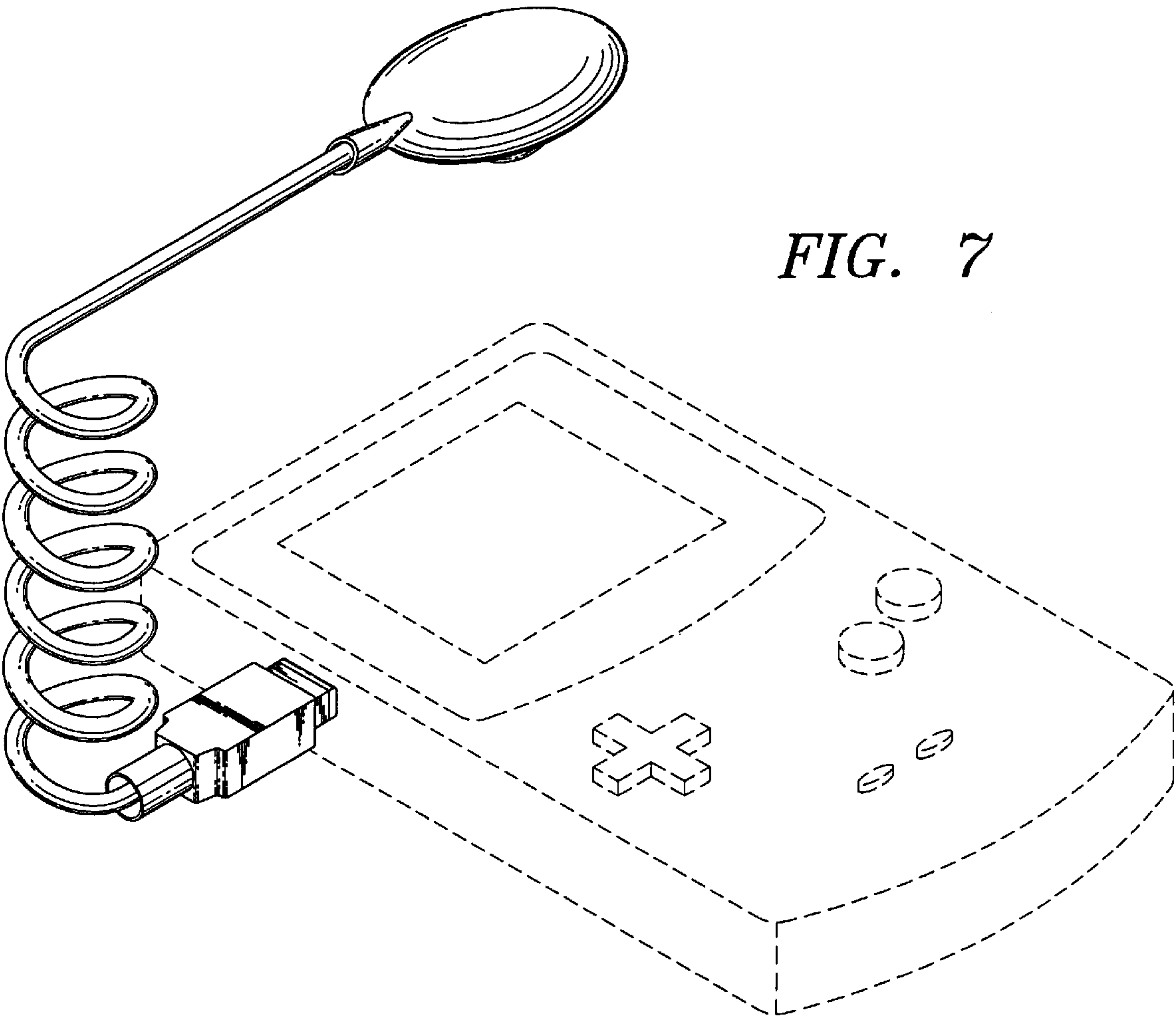

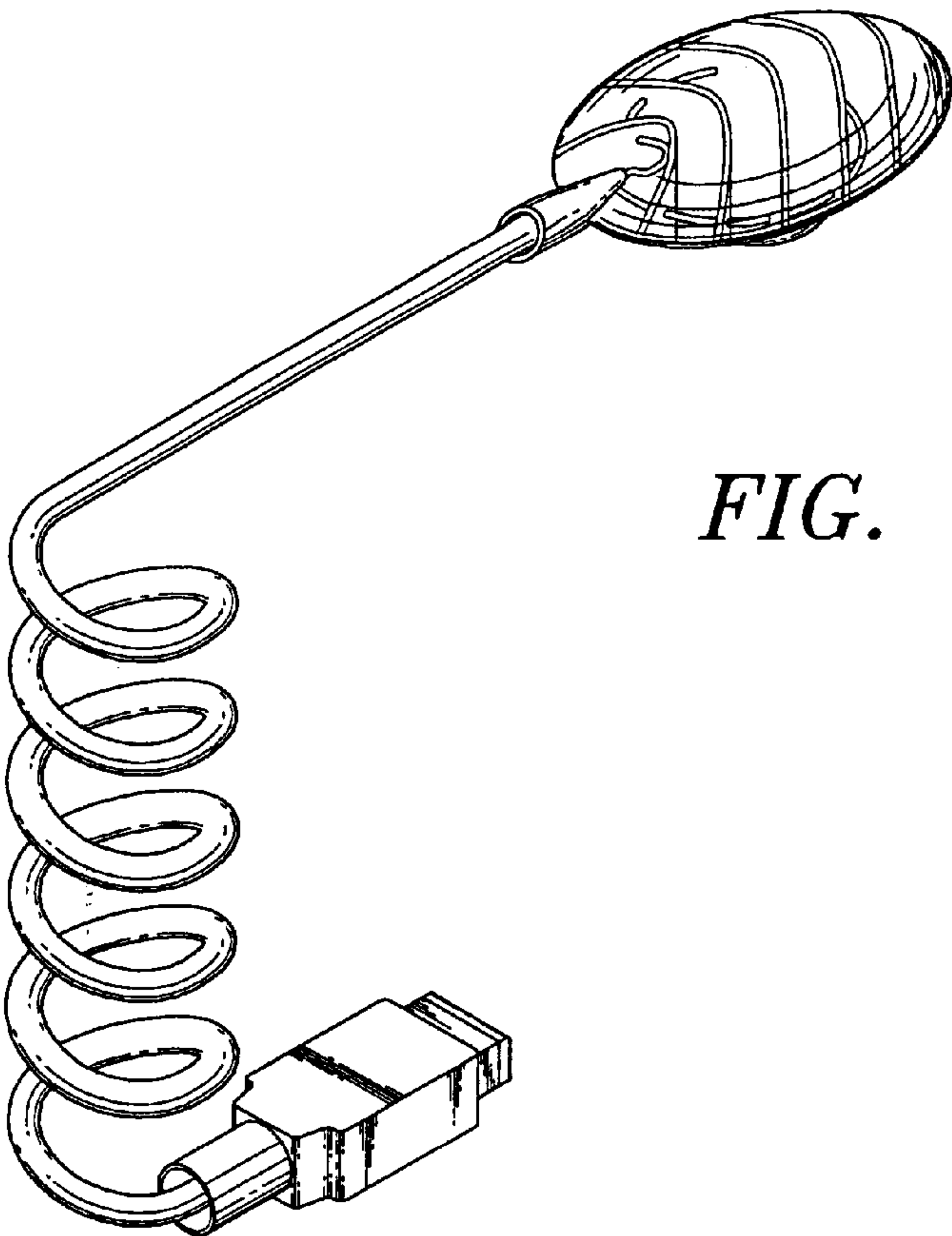

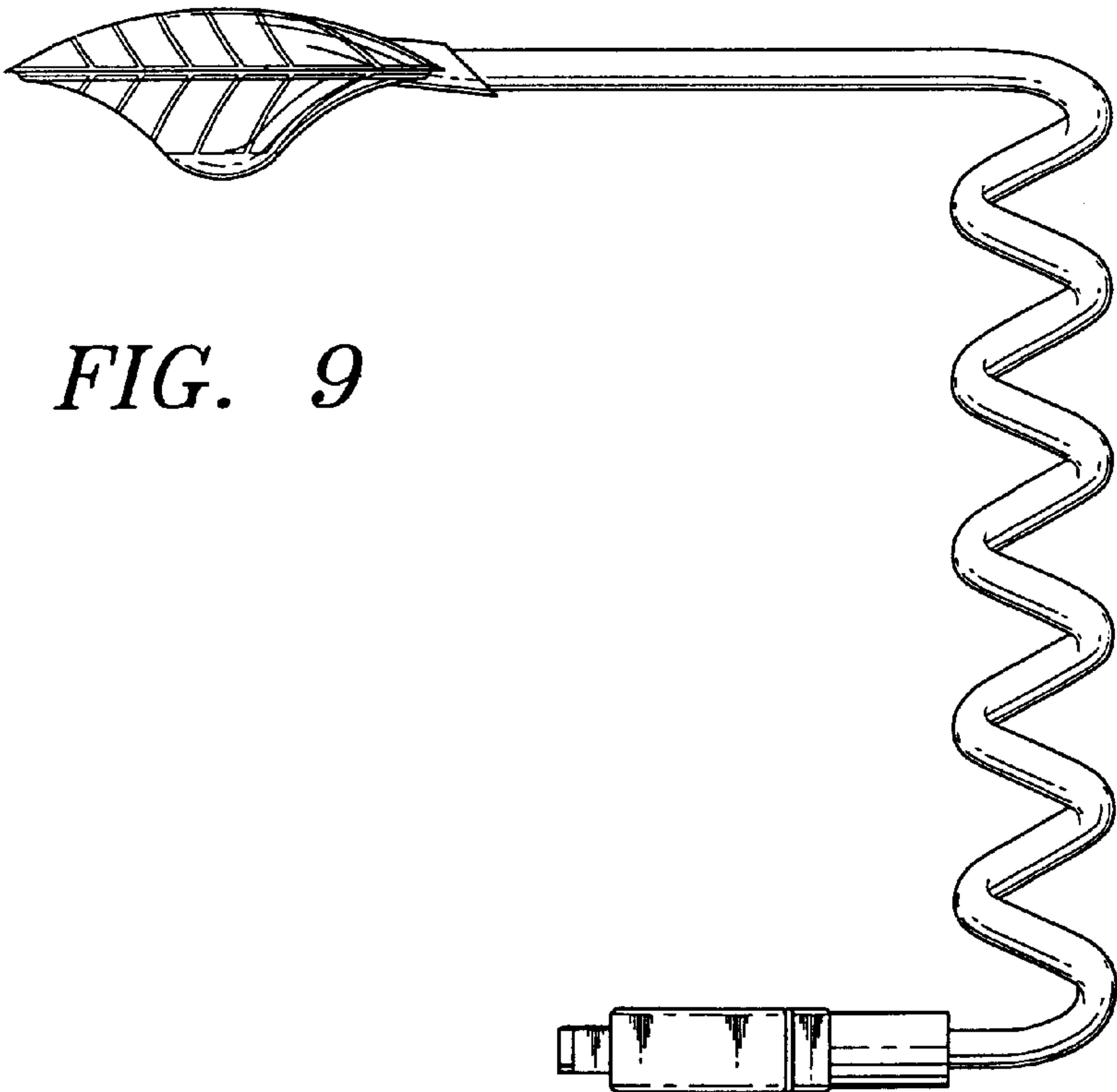

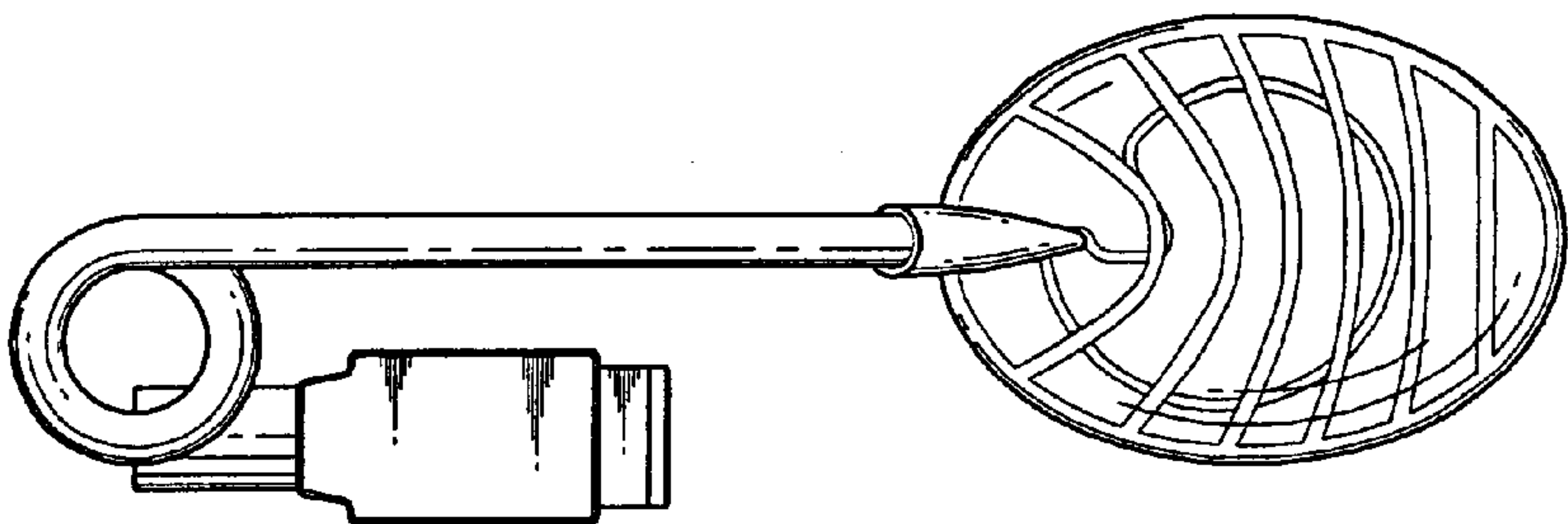

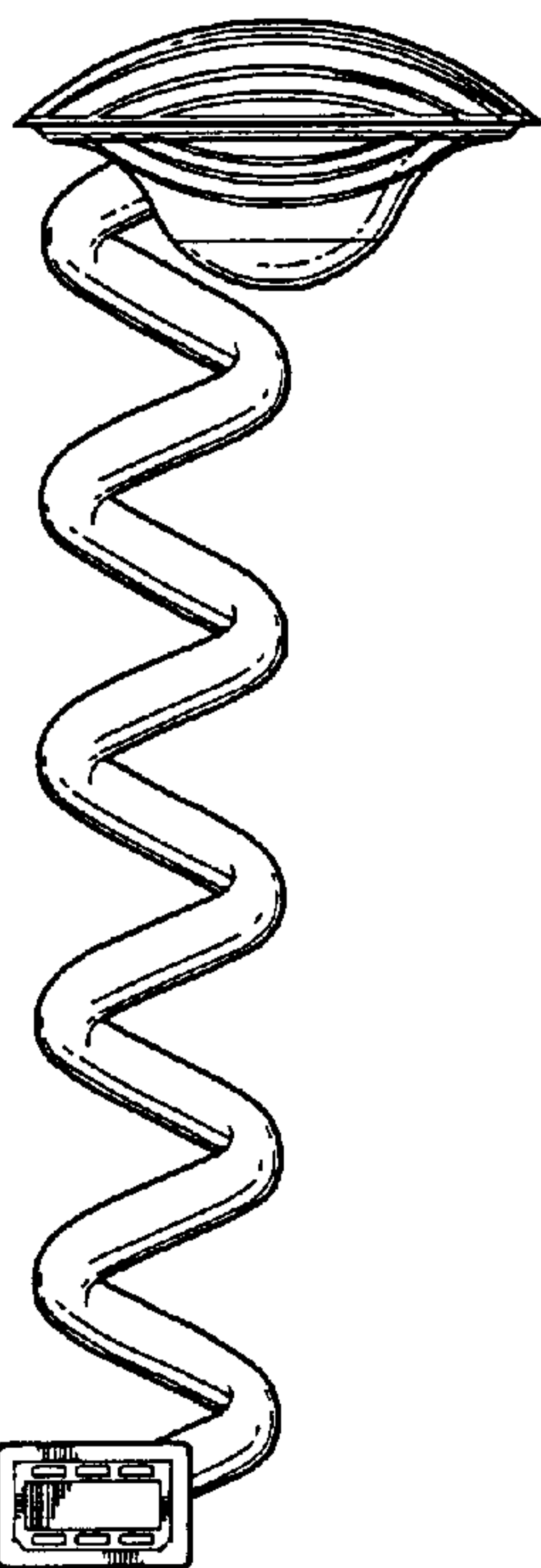

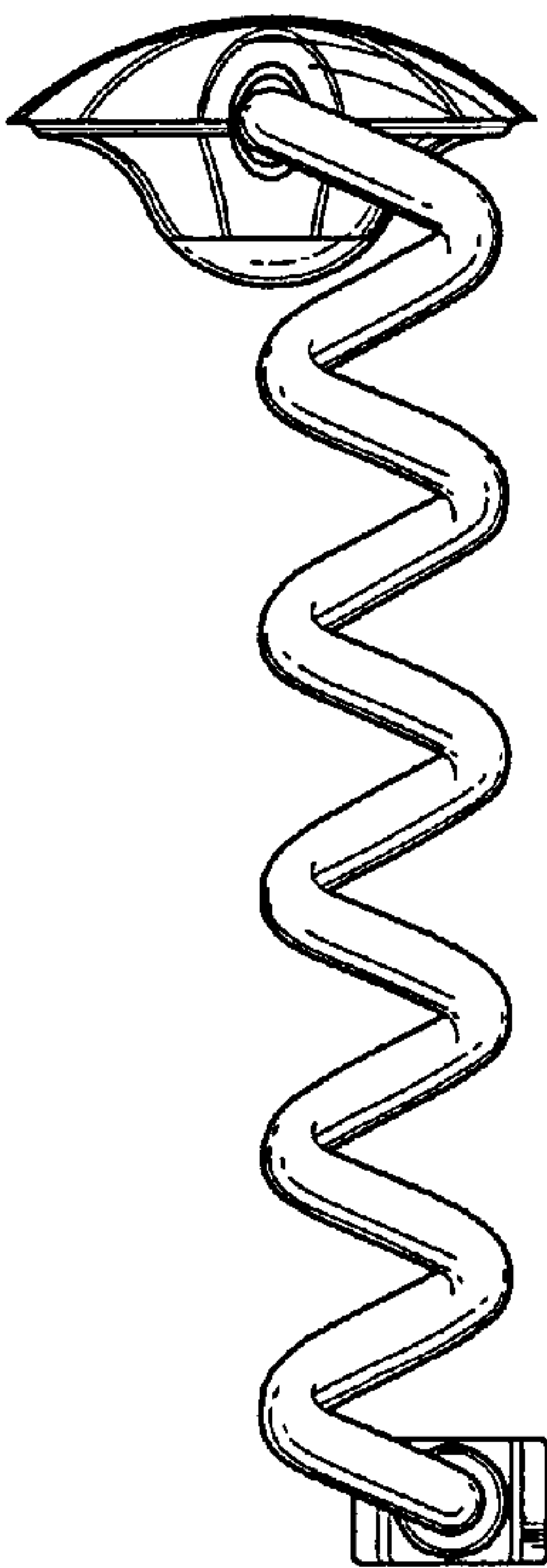

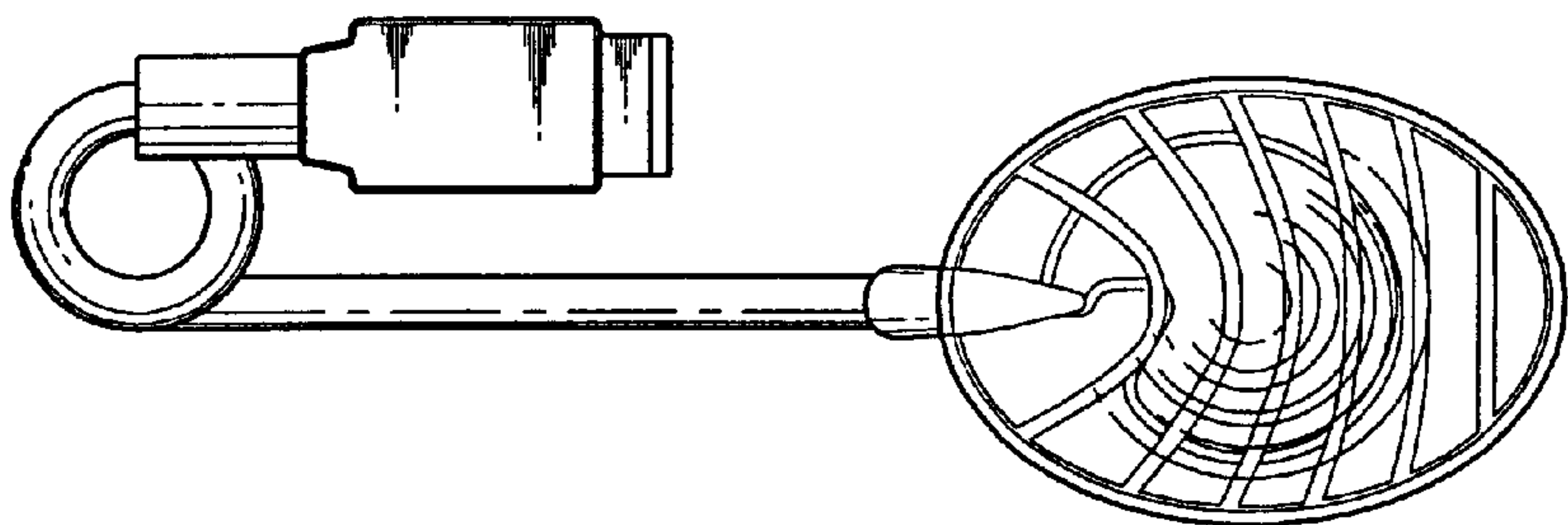
