(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a set of panels for window blinds,
awnings, and room dividers, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a set of panels for
window blinds, awnings, and room dividers, the rear being
identical, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a
mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a top plan view, the bottom view being identical
thereof.

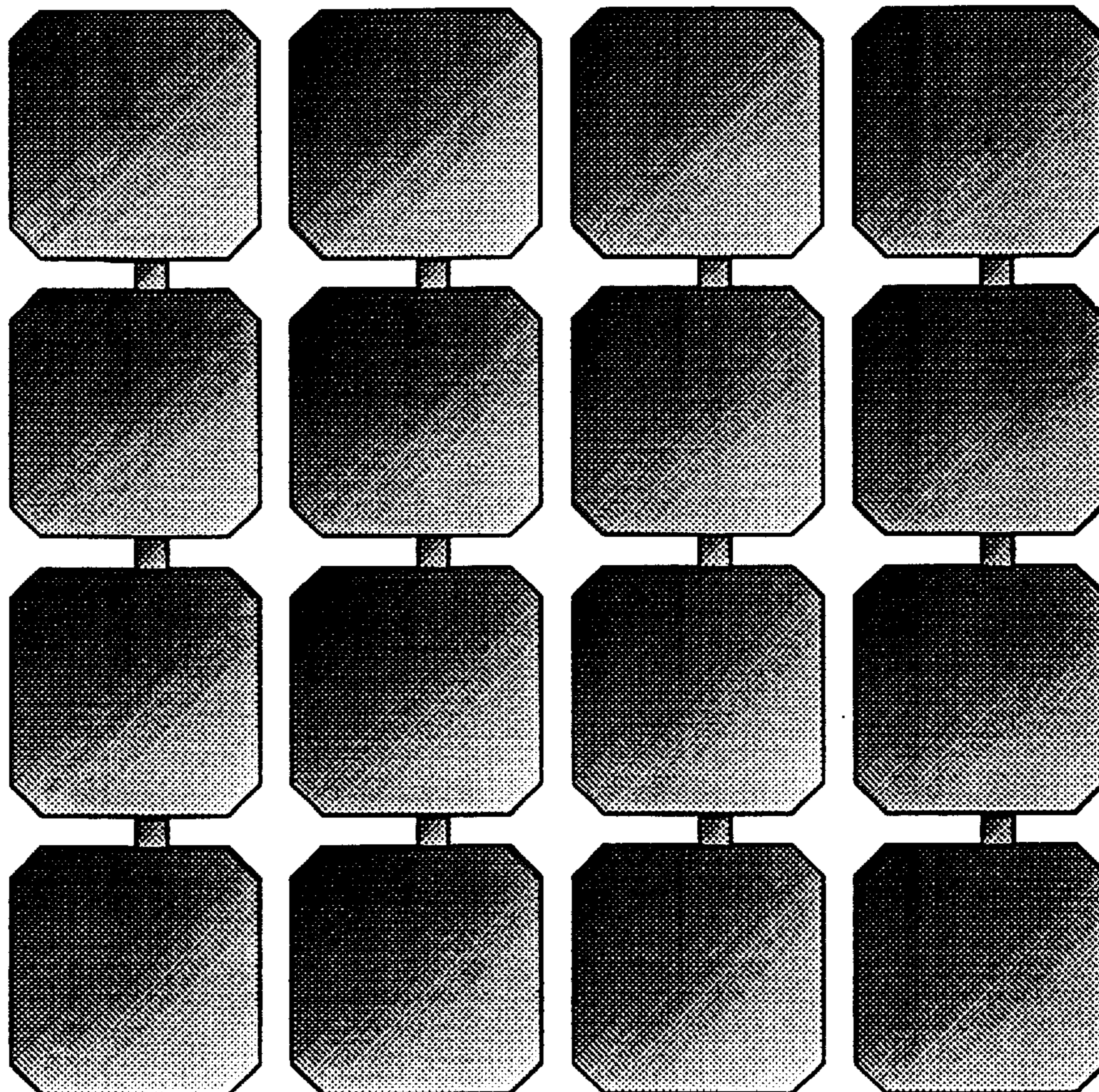

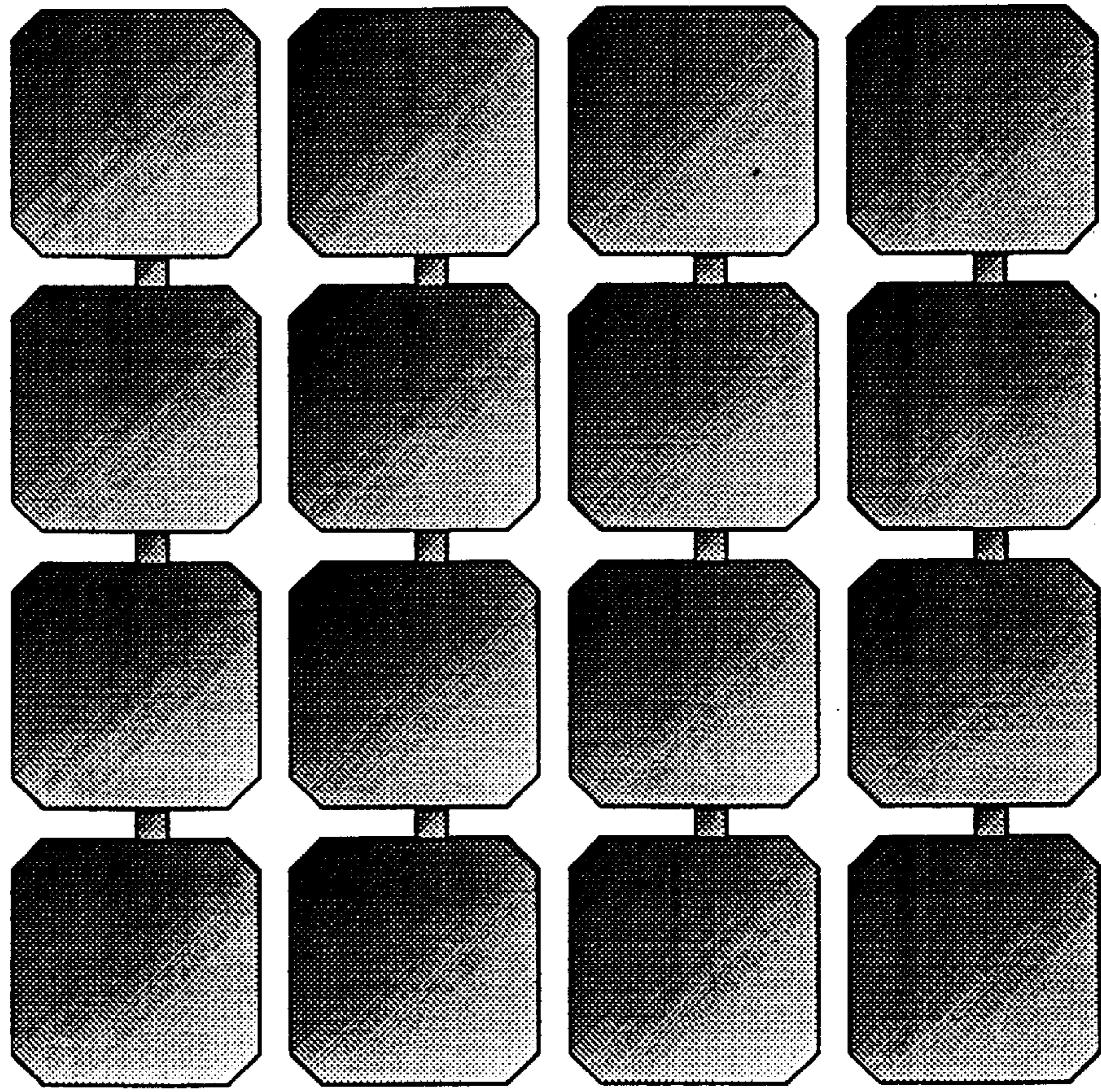
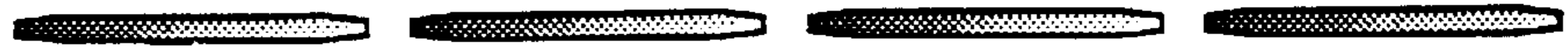
