FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.


FIG. 3 is a top view of the figurine.


FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.


FIG. 5 is a left side view, of which the right side is a mirror image thereof; and,


FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the cartoon-like figurine.


