DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a waiter's apron showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a reduced front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 2;

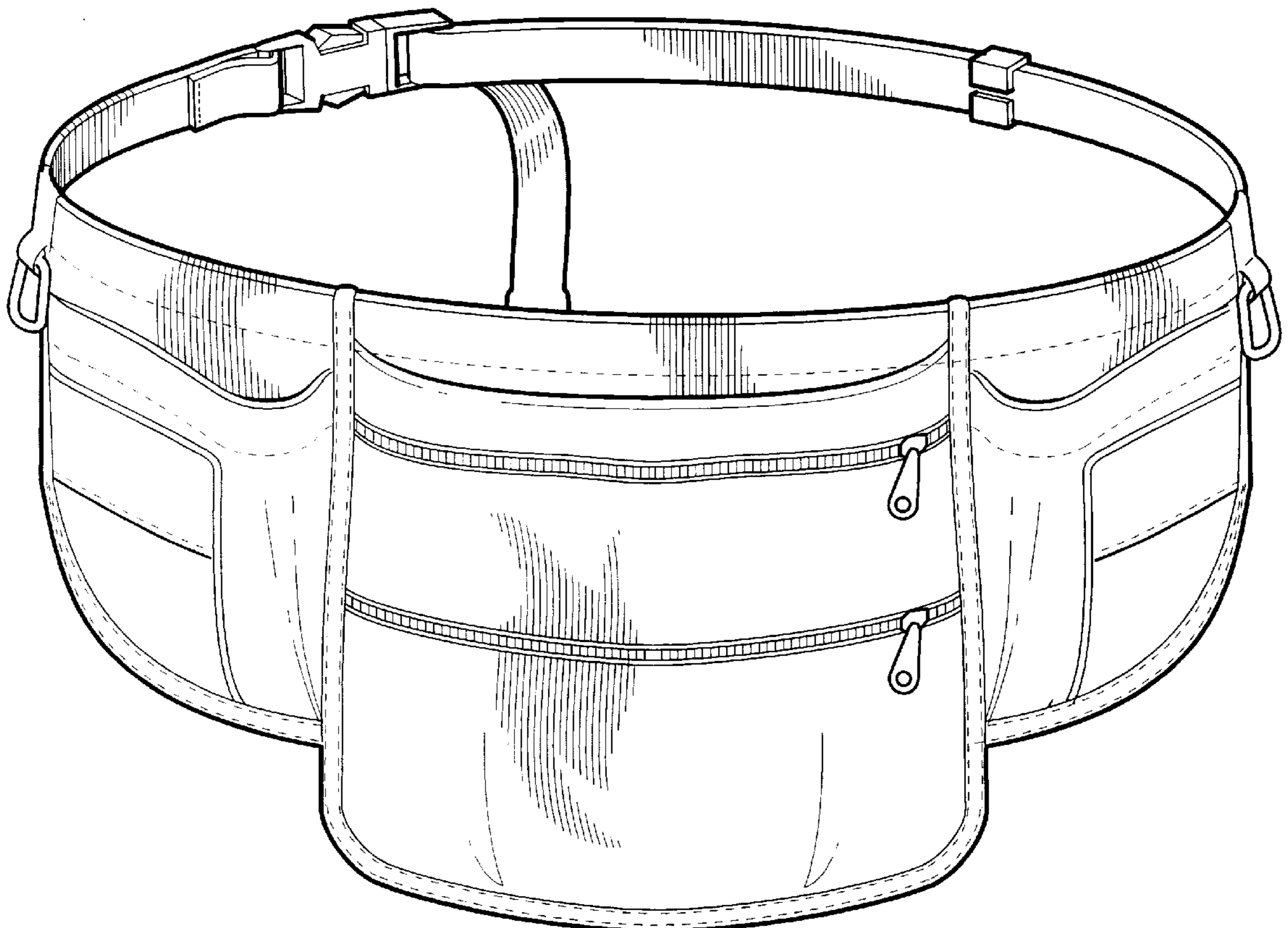
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 2;

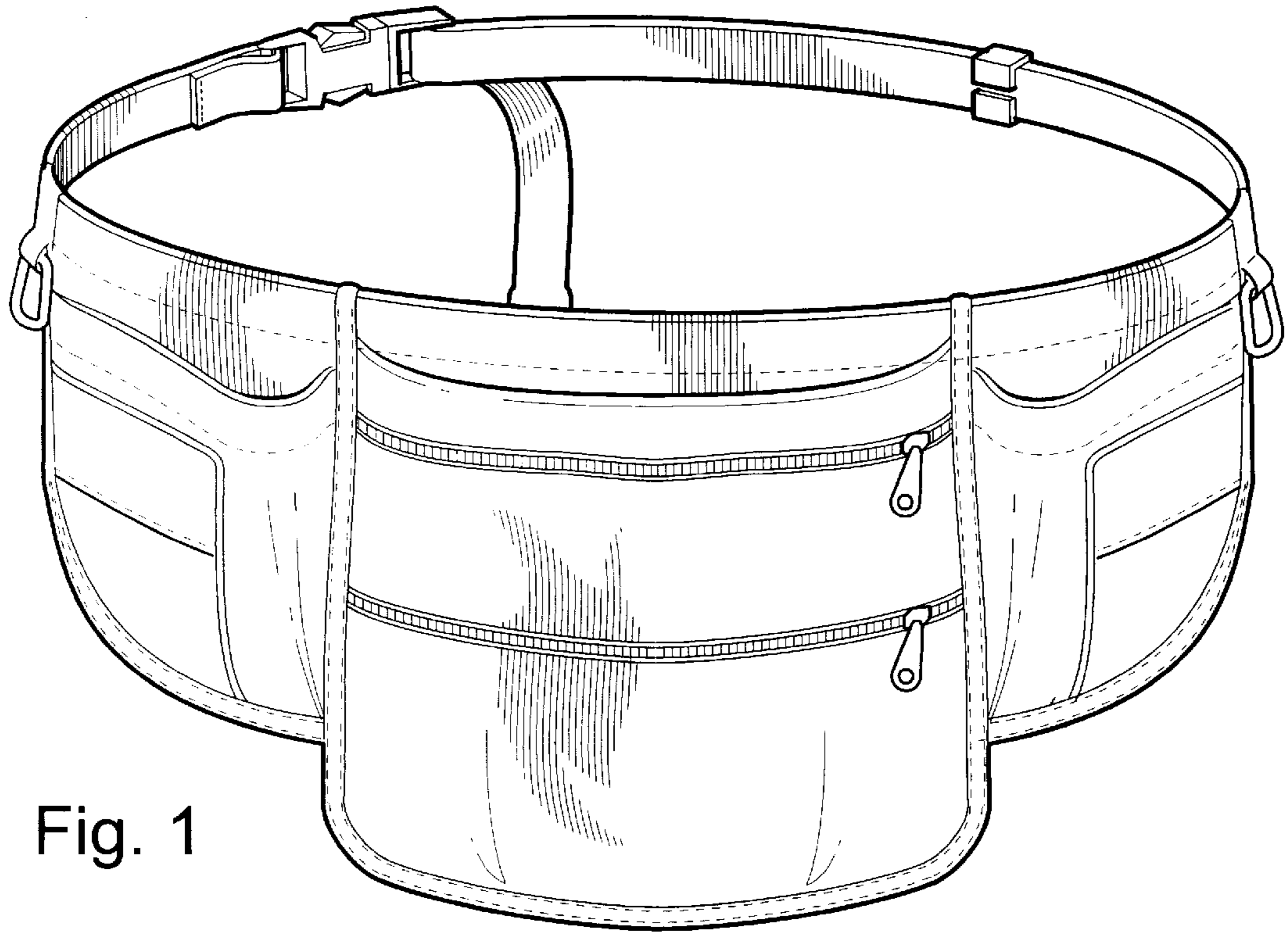

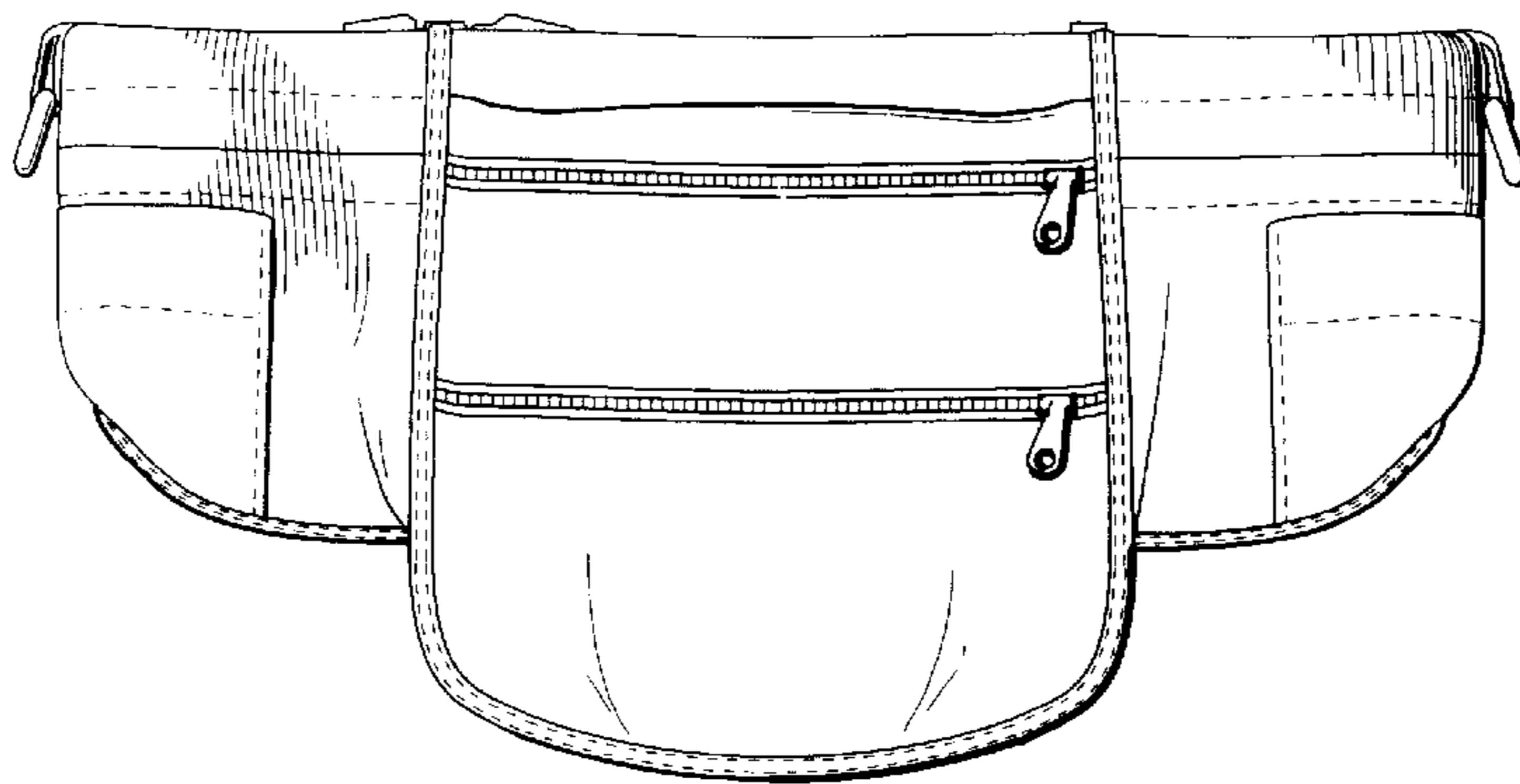

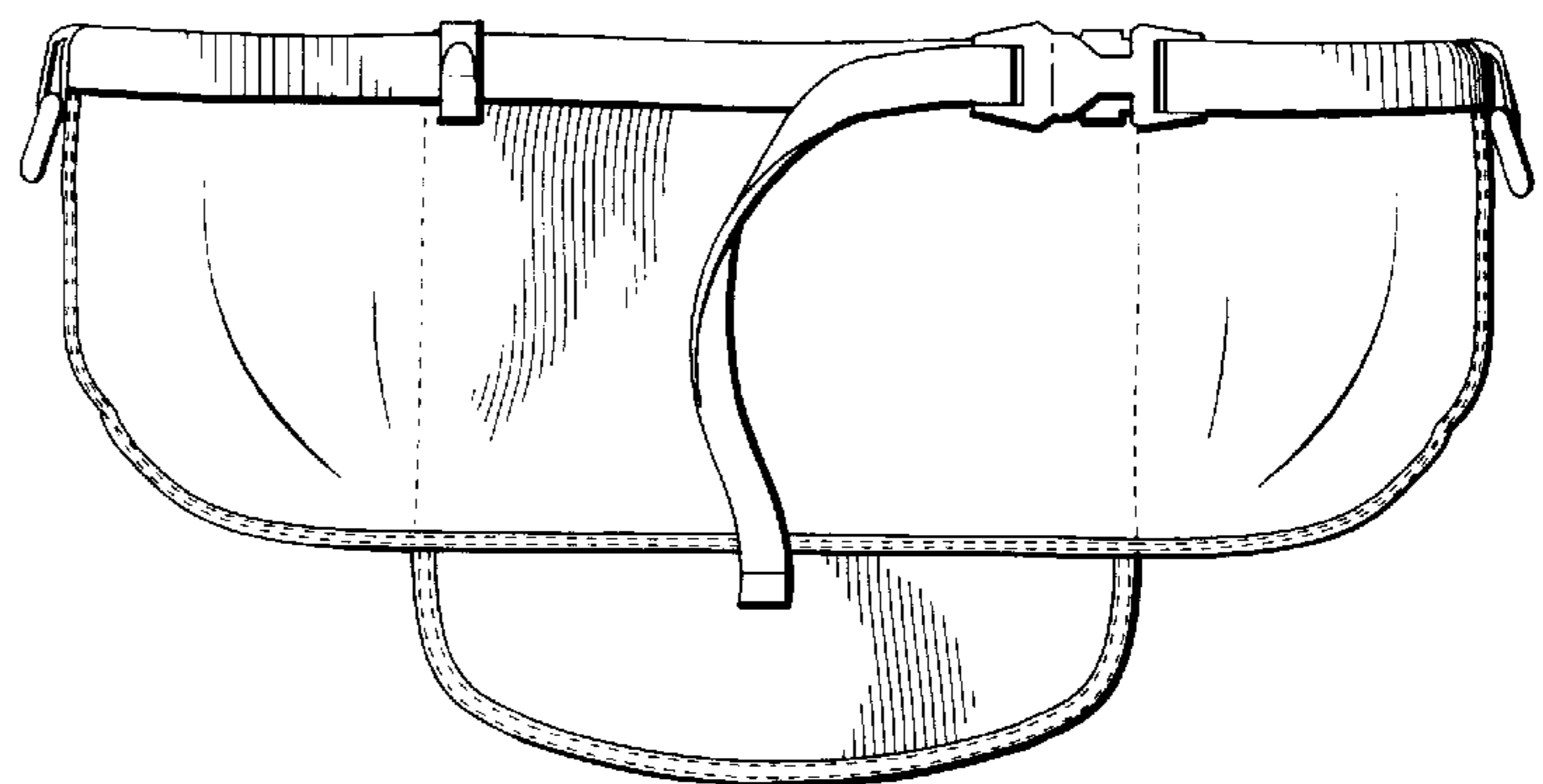

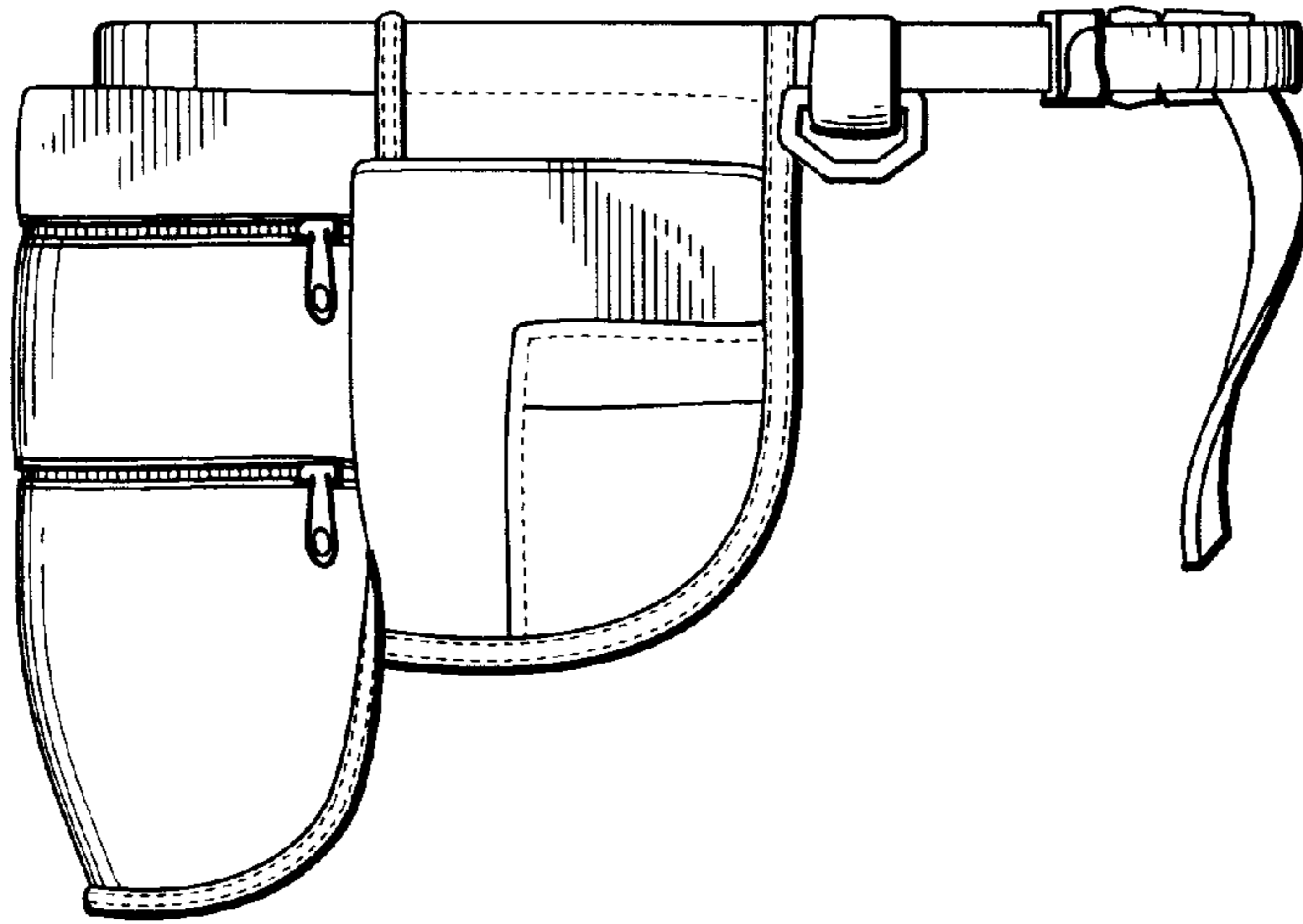

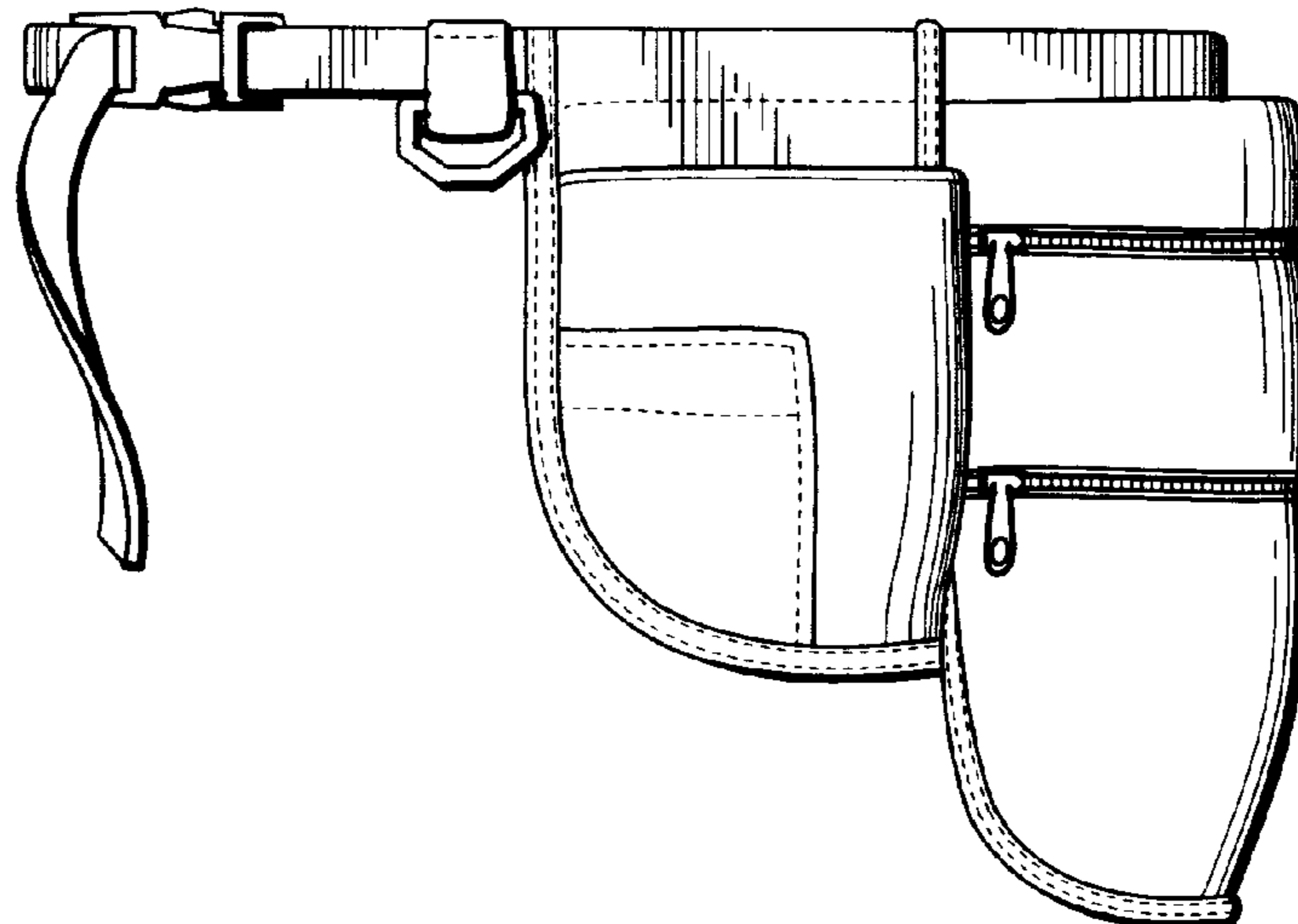

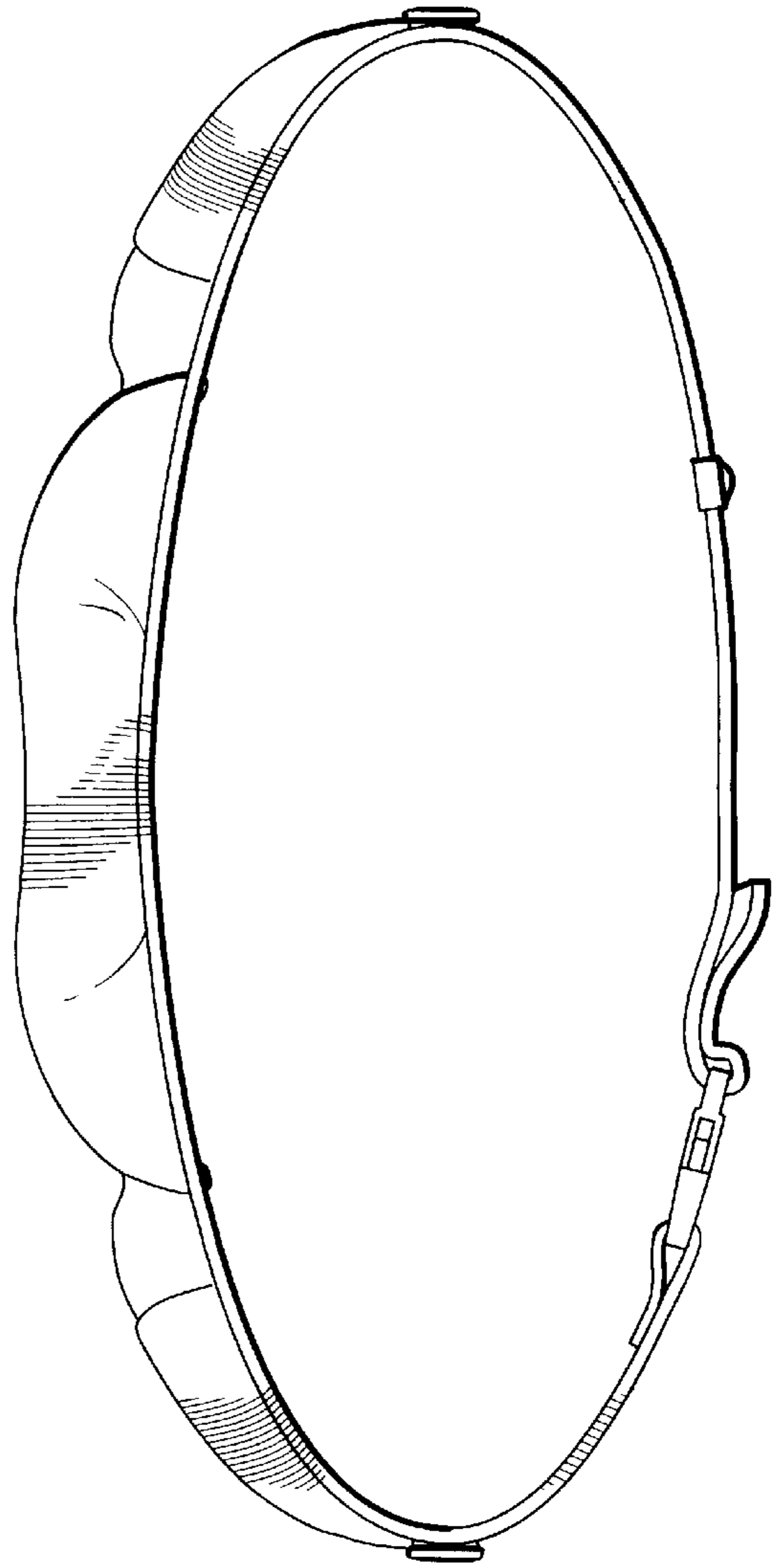
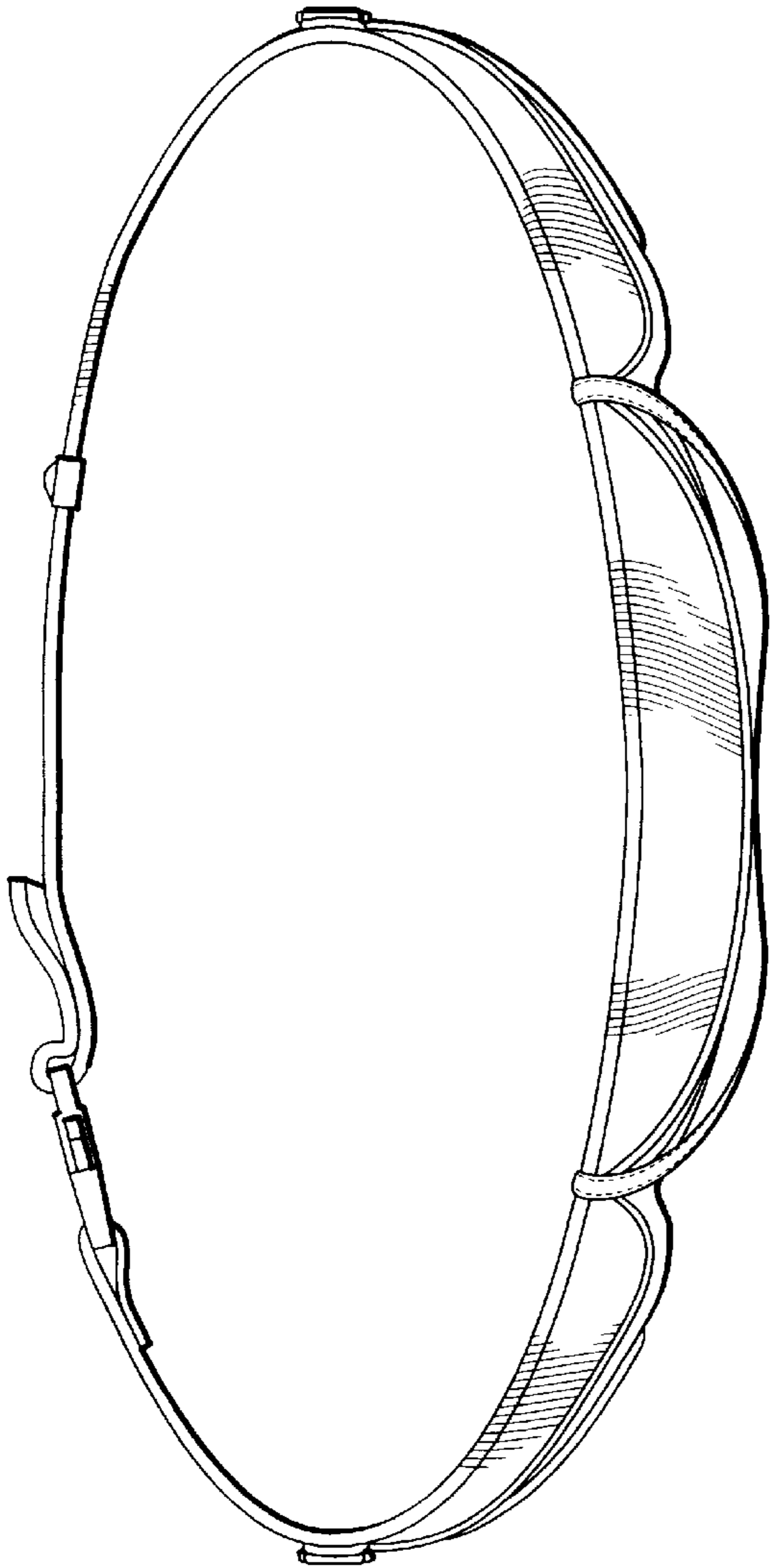
