The ornamental design for a faucet handle body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

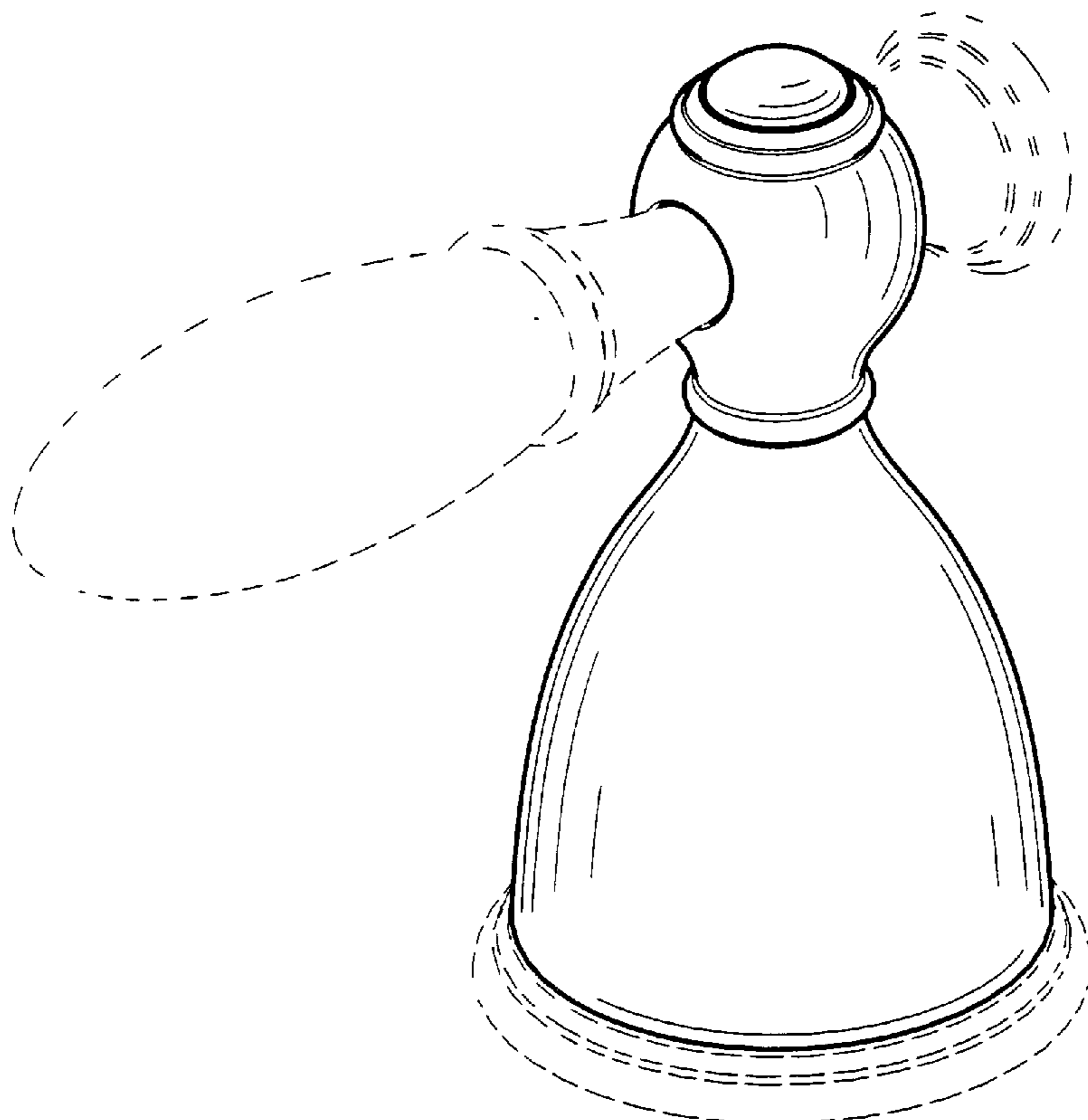
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the faucet handle body showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 The broken line showing of the tailpiece and handle blade and annular ribs at the base of the handle body in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.

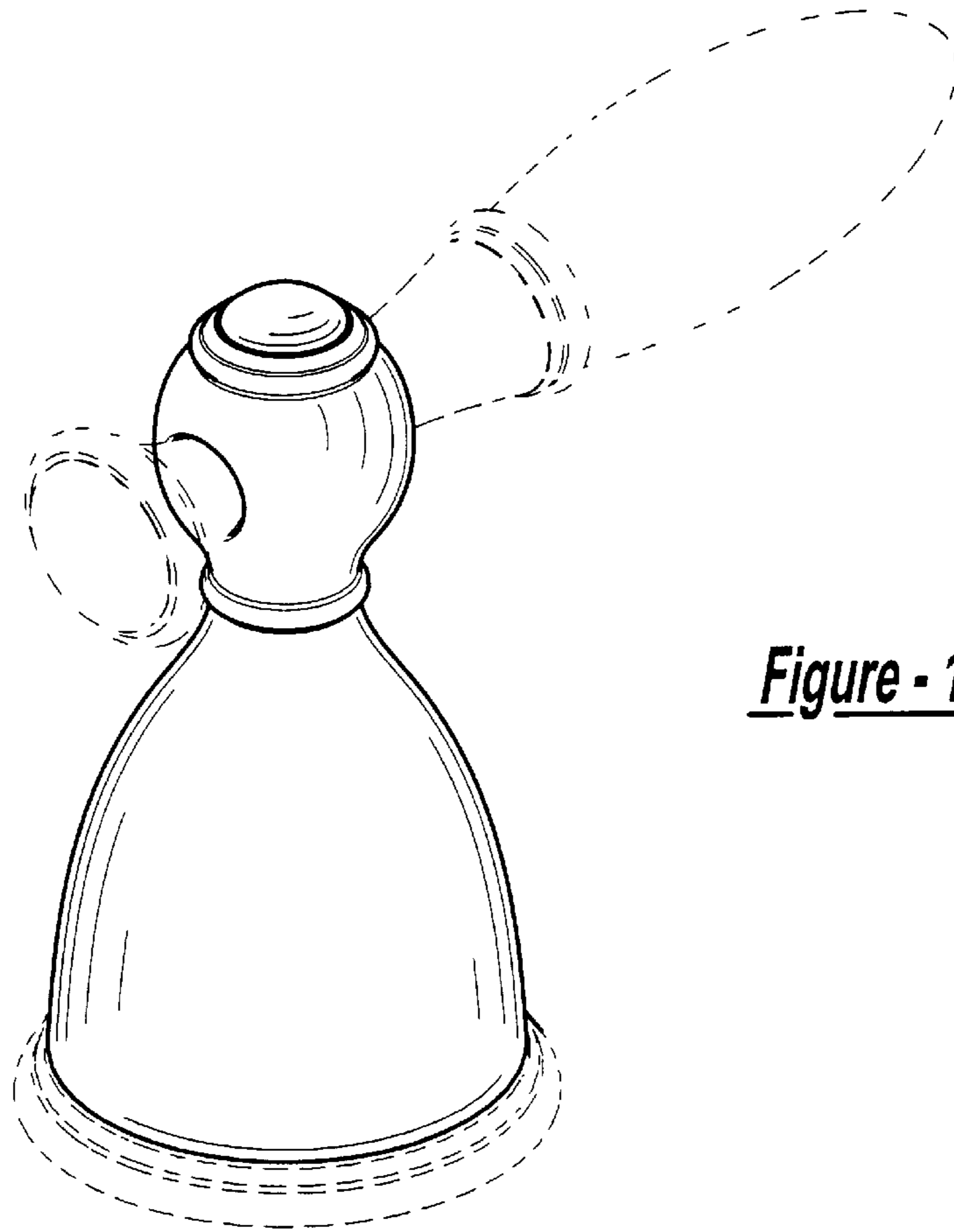

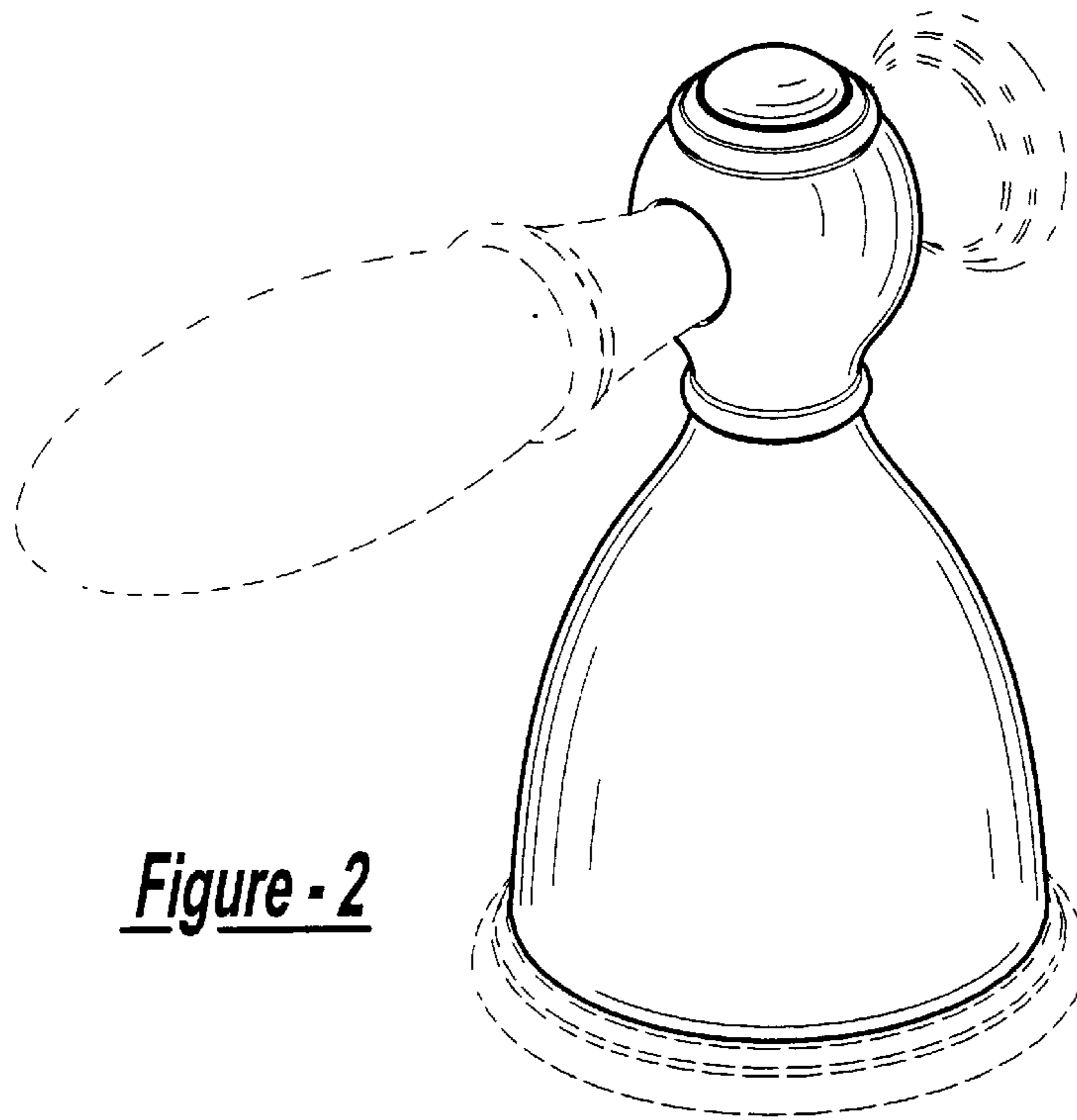

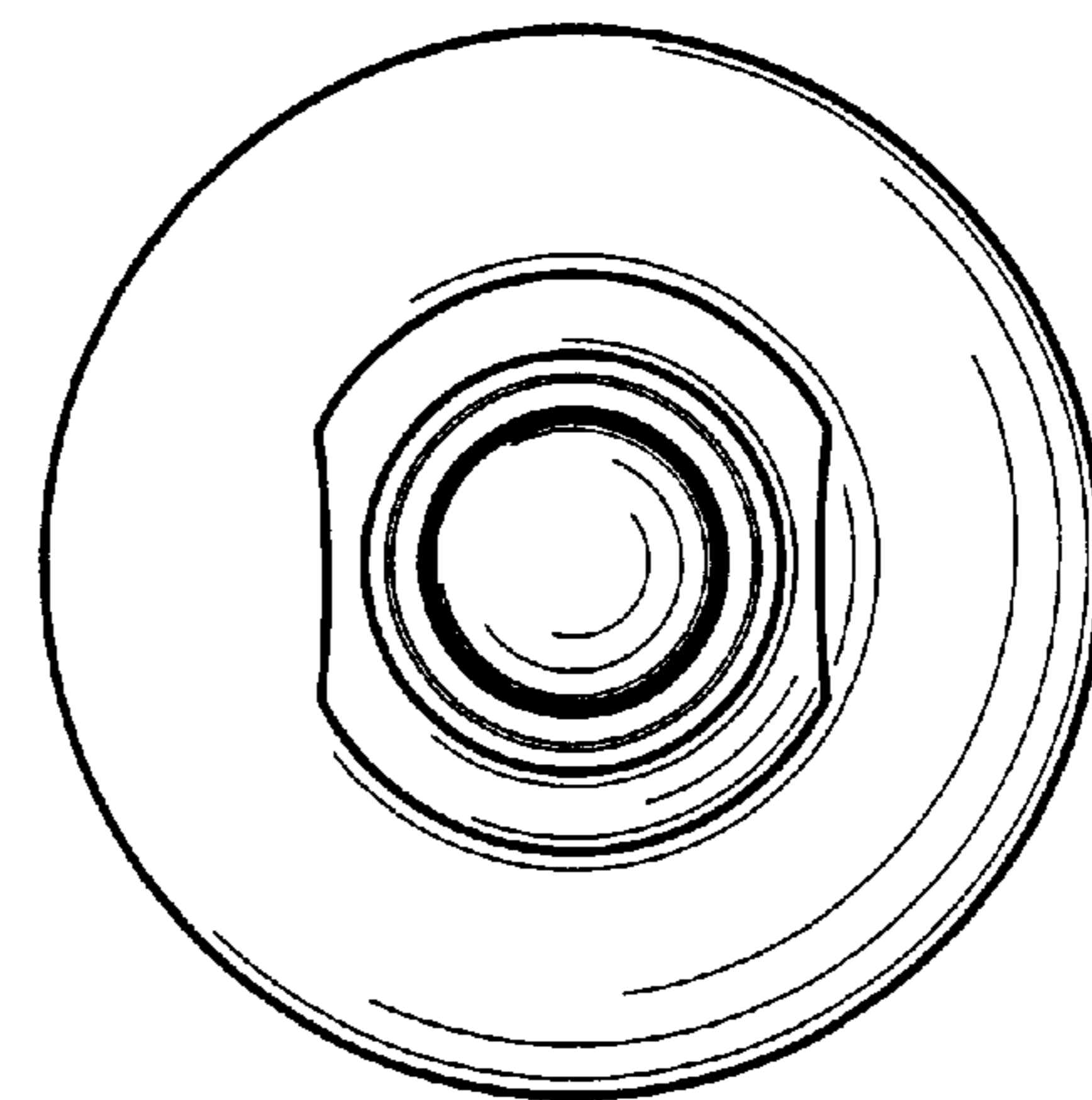
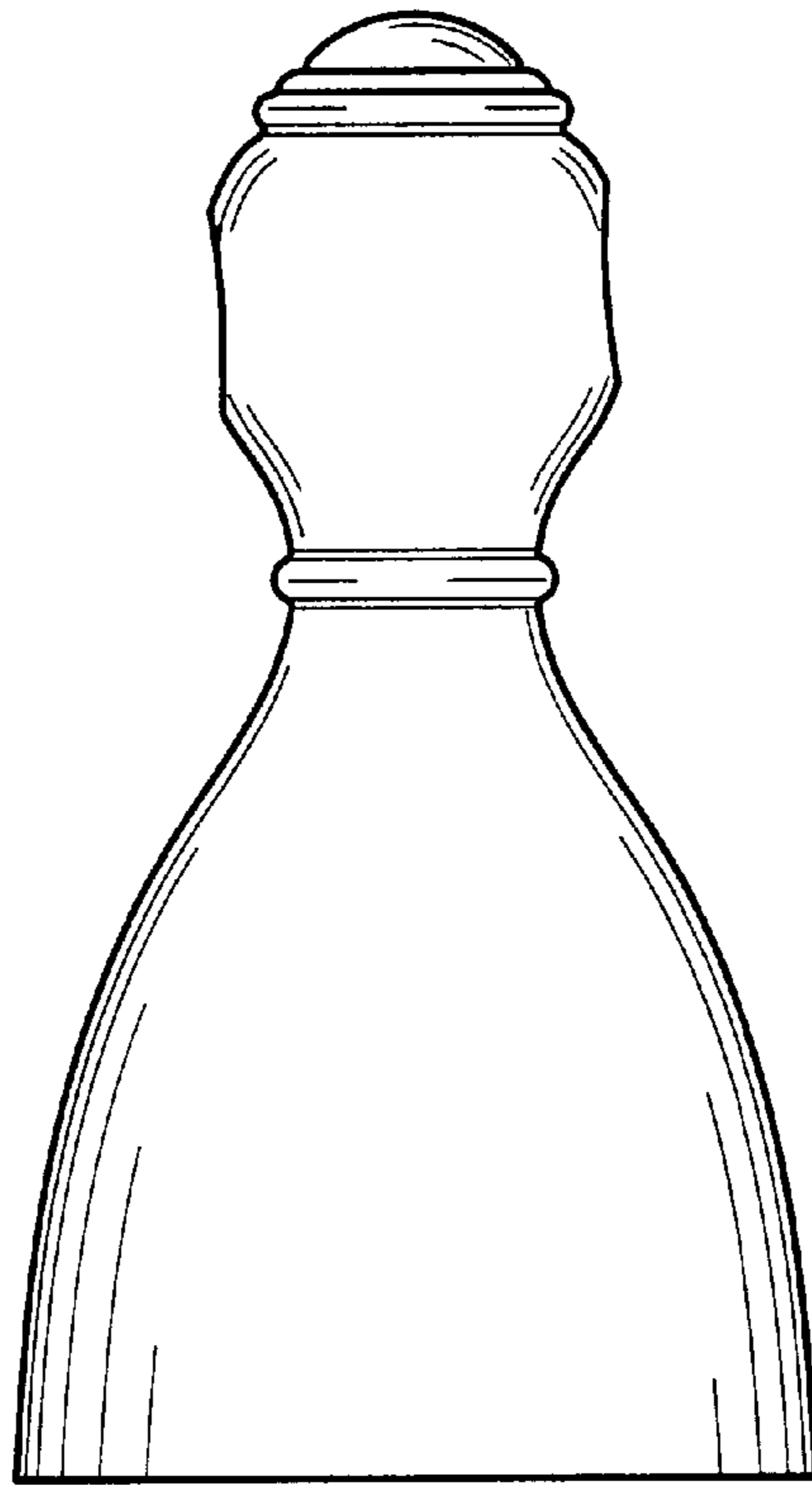

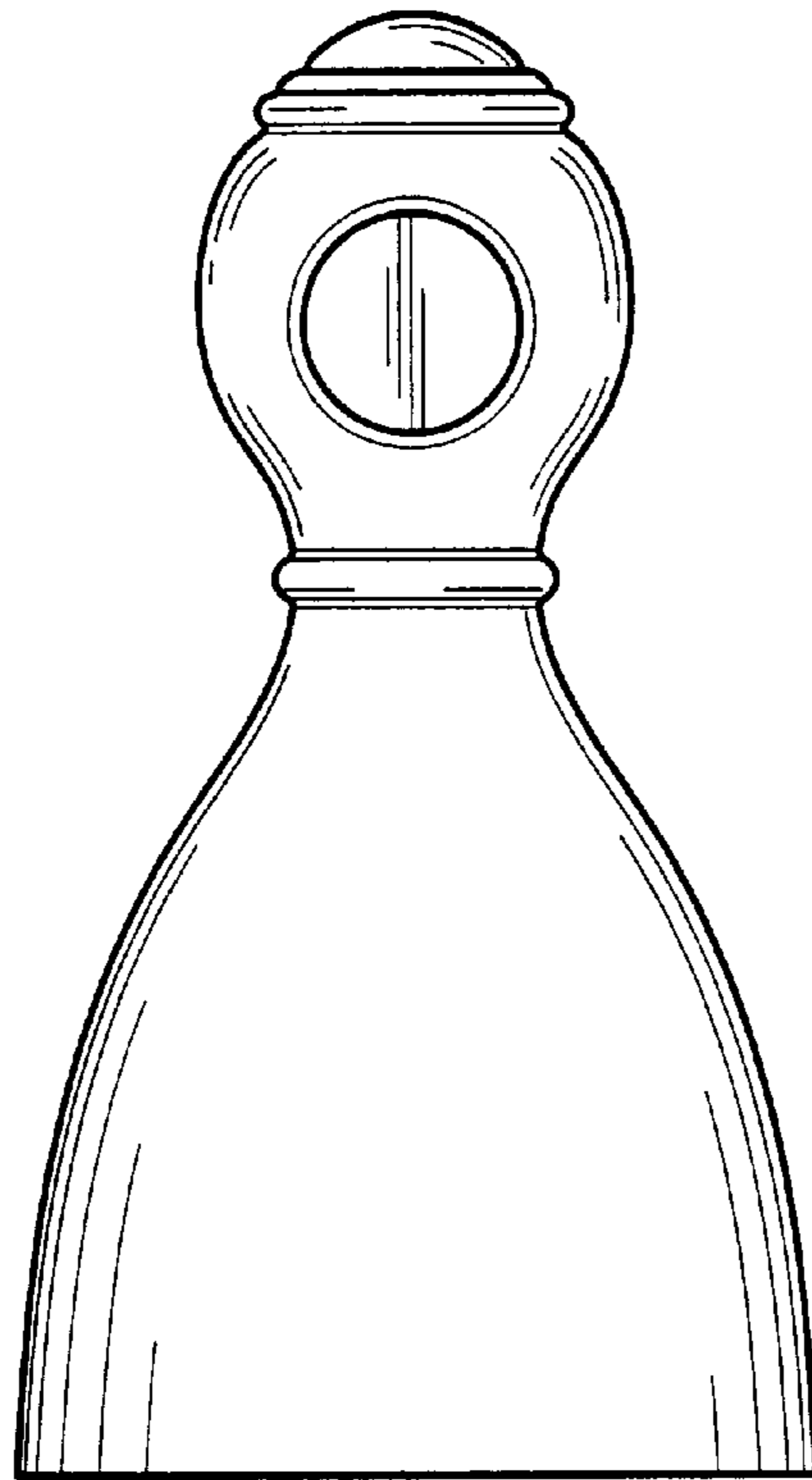

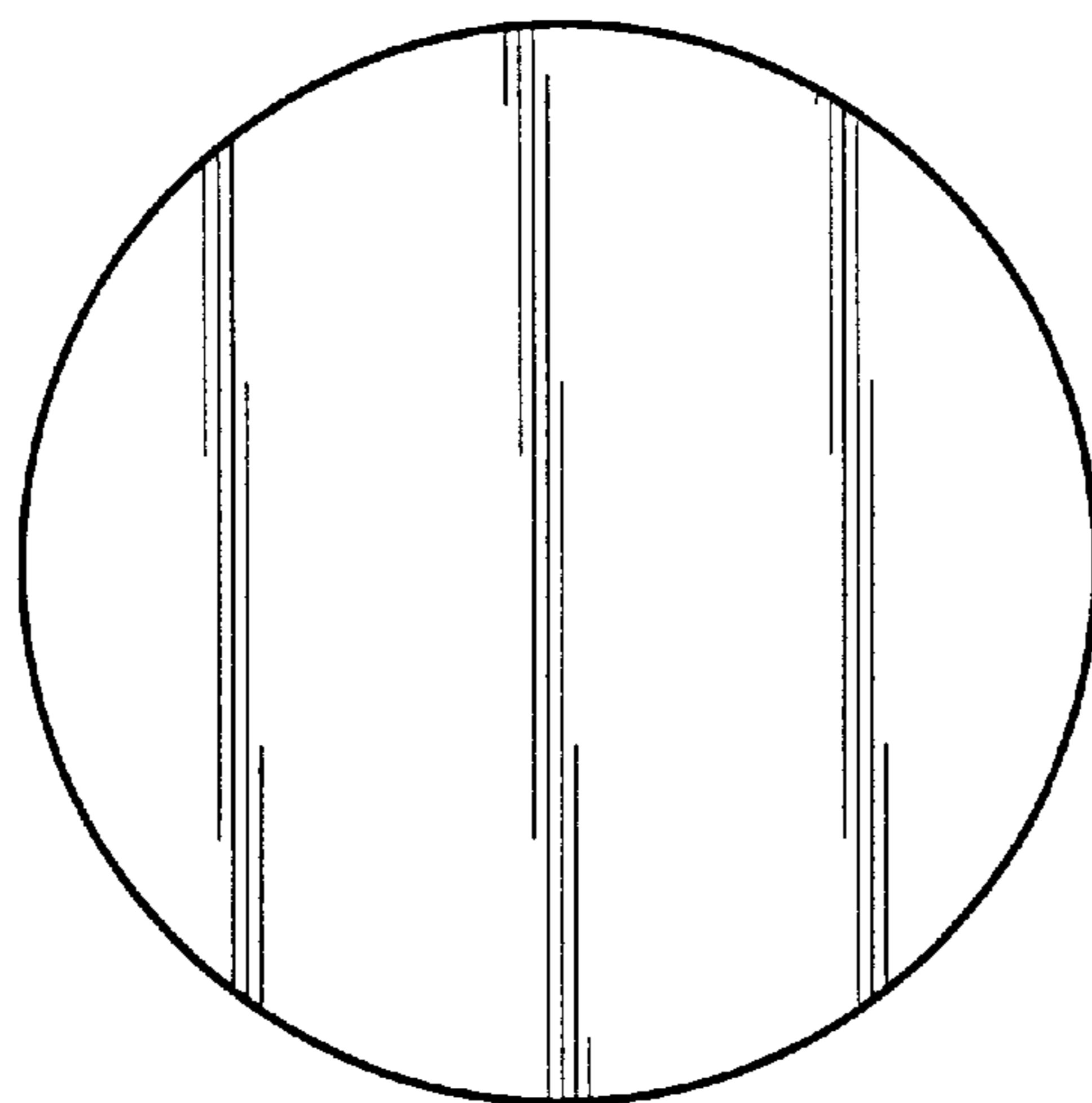
