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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for the combined wallet and money clip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear elevational view of a combined wallet and money clip showing my new design, the broken lines shown as part of the claimed invention in FIGS. 1, 2, 5, and 7-10 are understood to represent stitching;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an inside elevational view thereof shown in an open position;

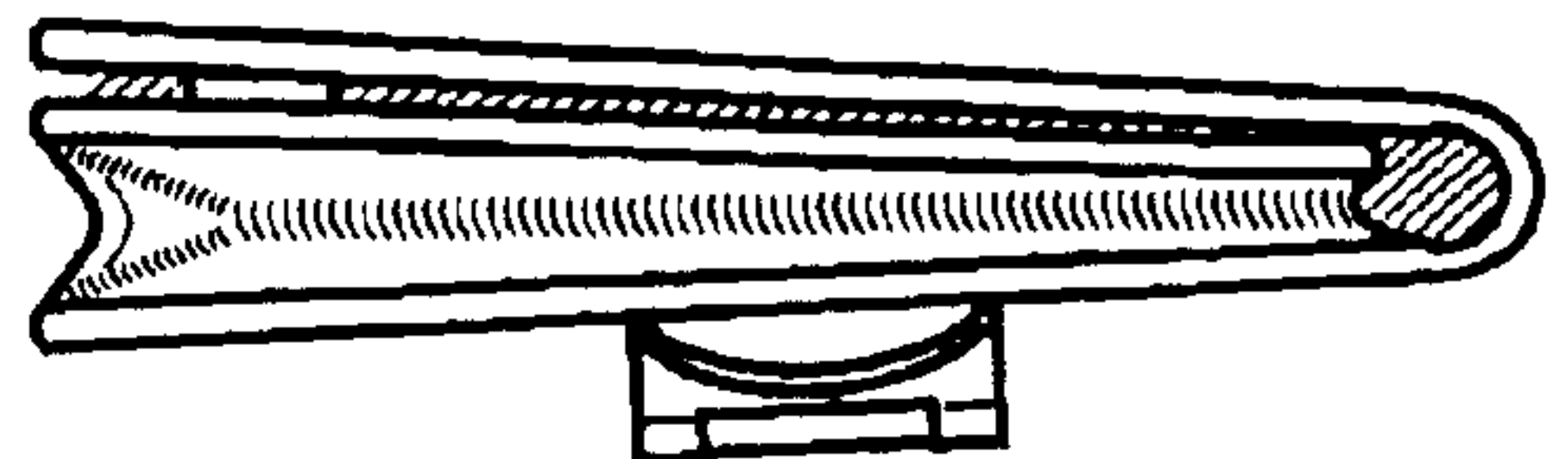
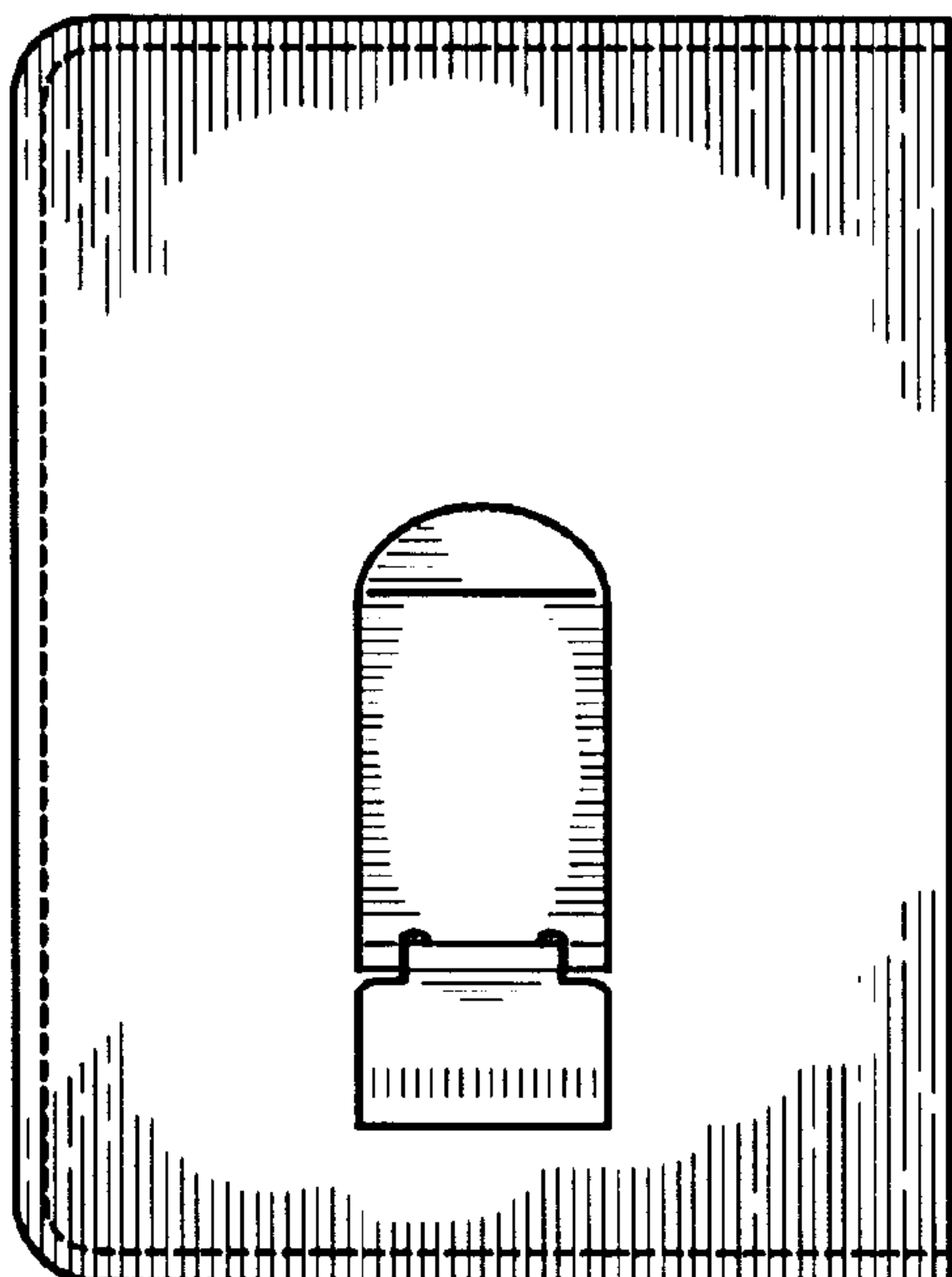
FIG. 8 is an outside elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a left rear perspective view of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 10 is a left rear perspective view of FIG. 1 shown with the money clip in an open position.

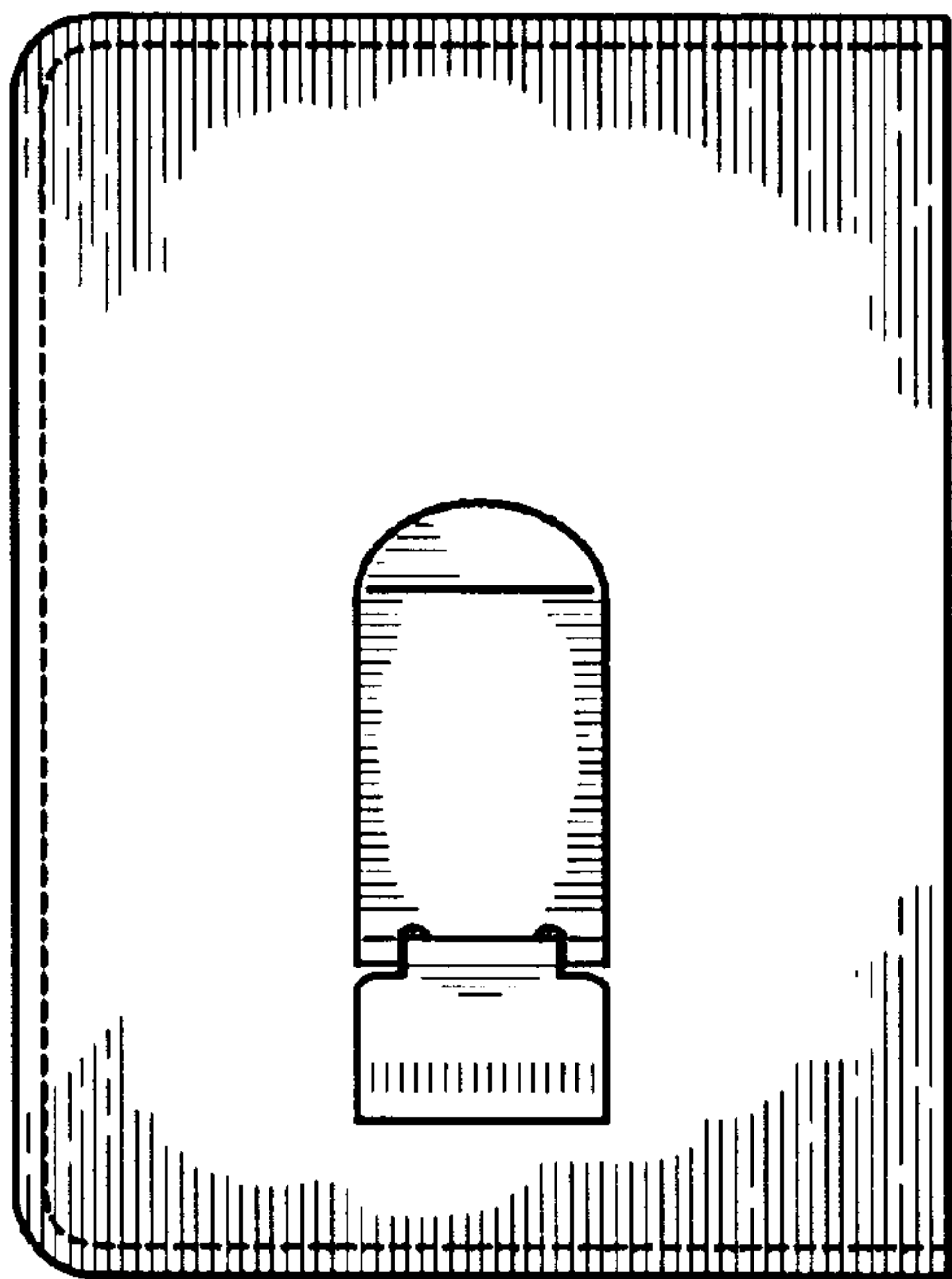

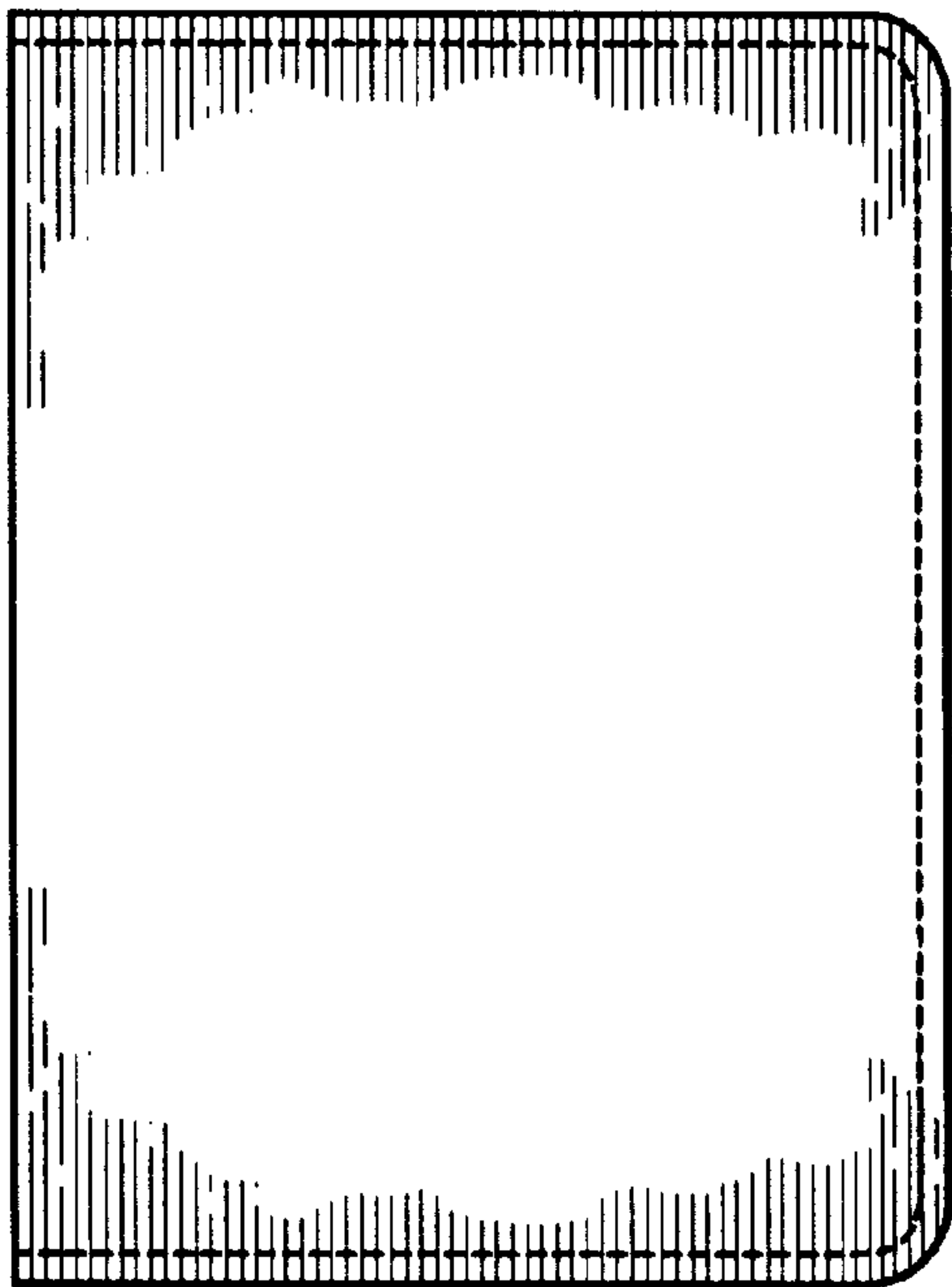

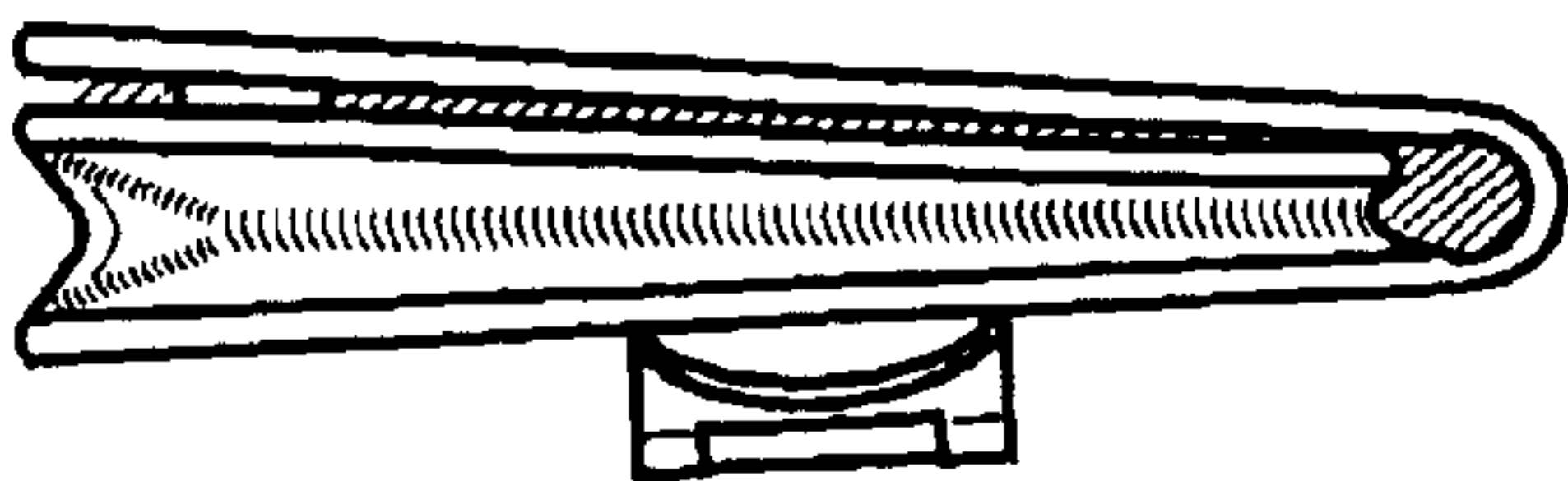

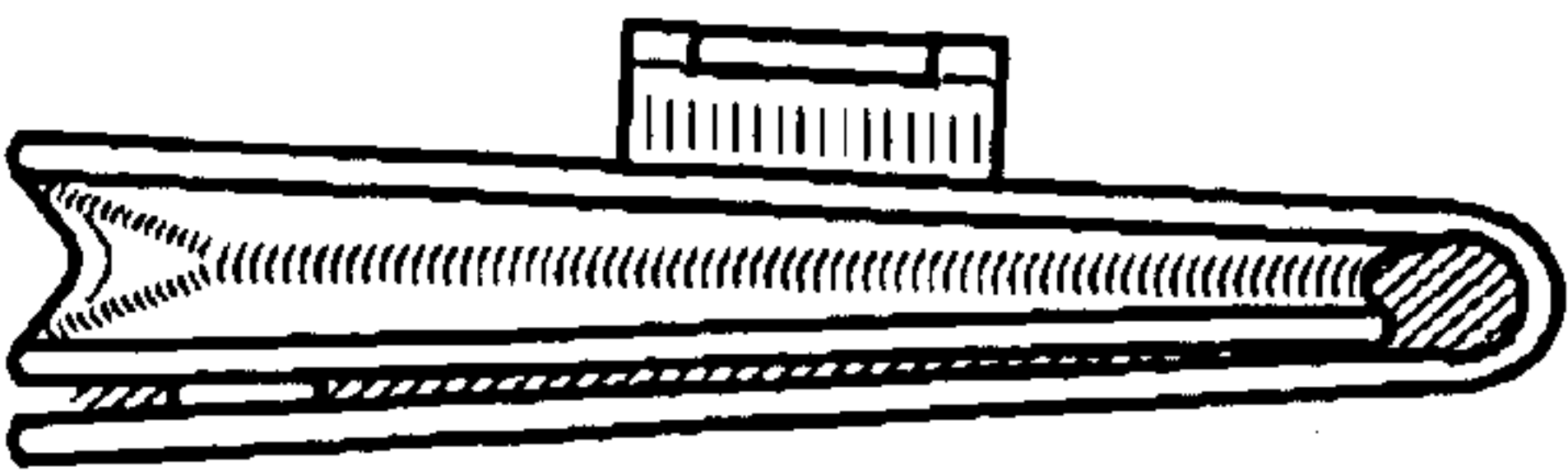

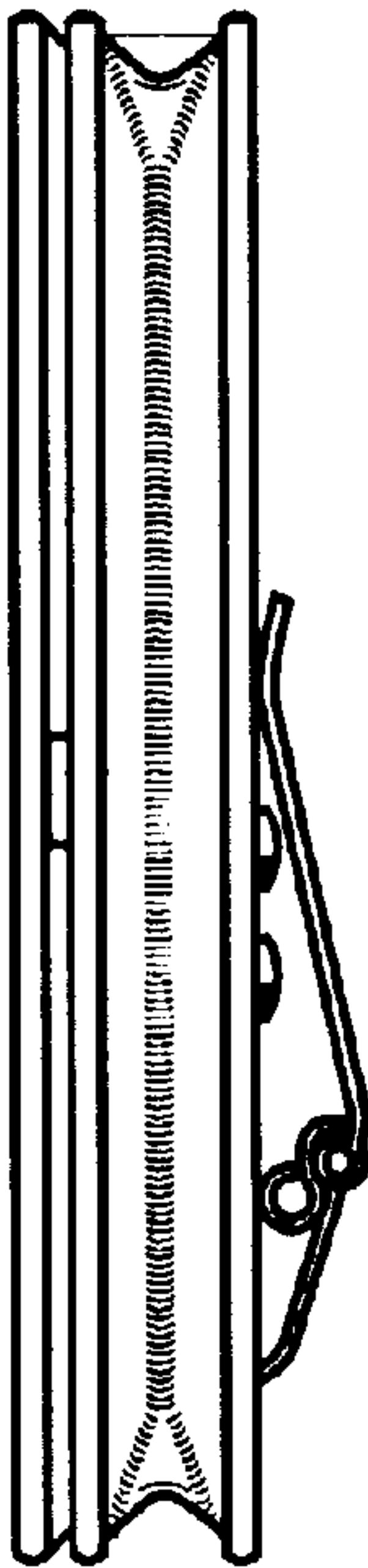

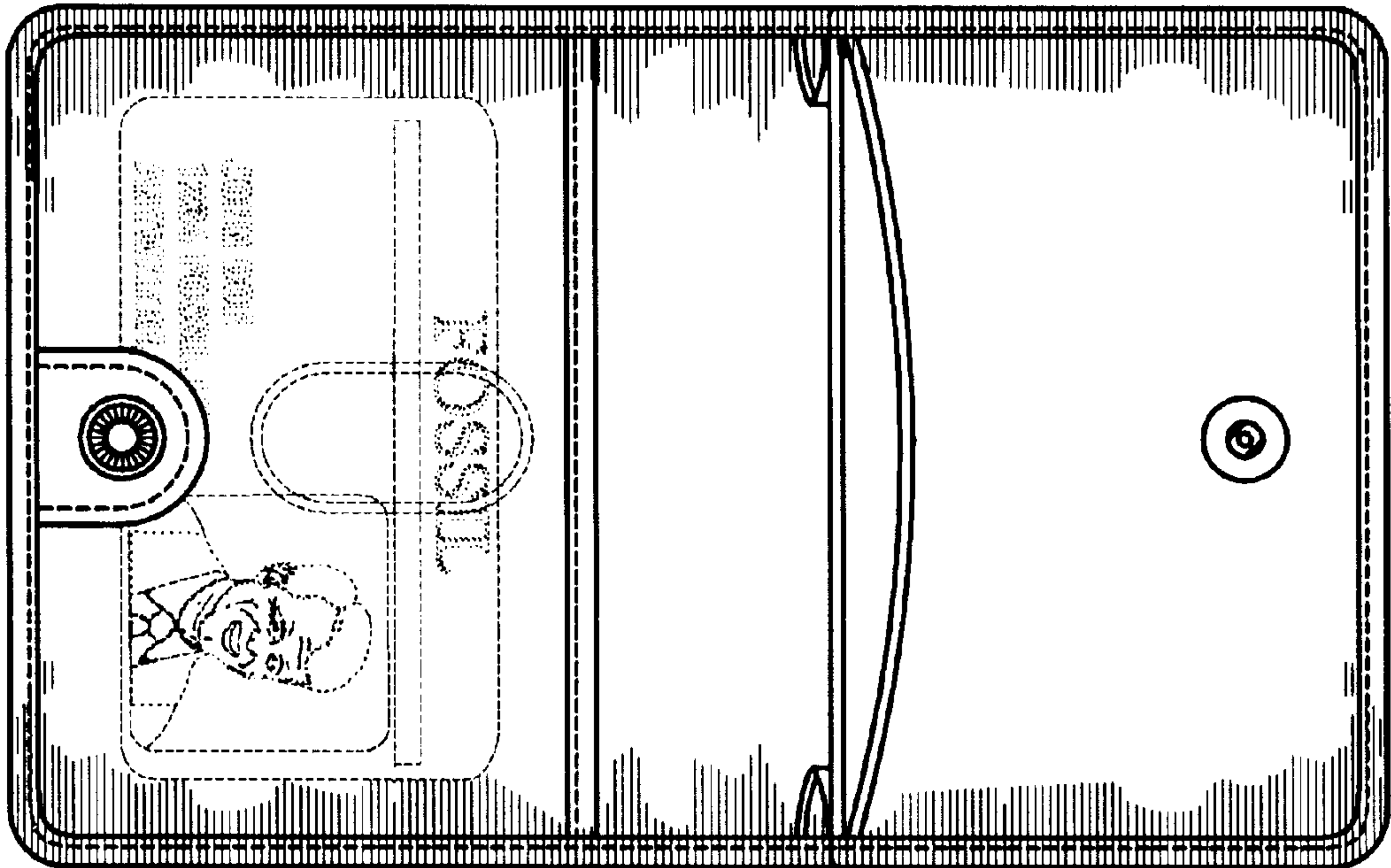

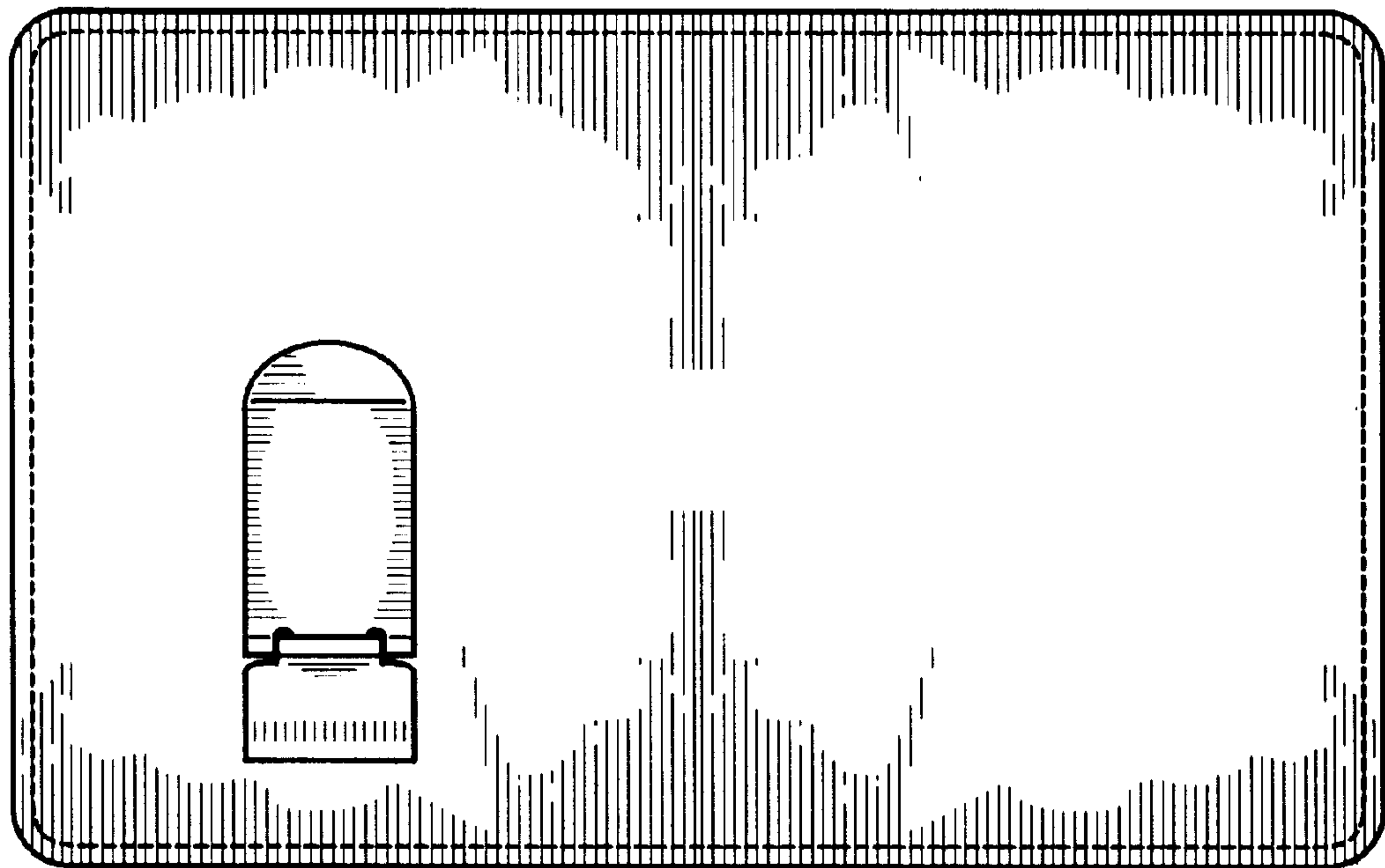

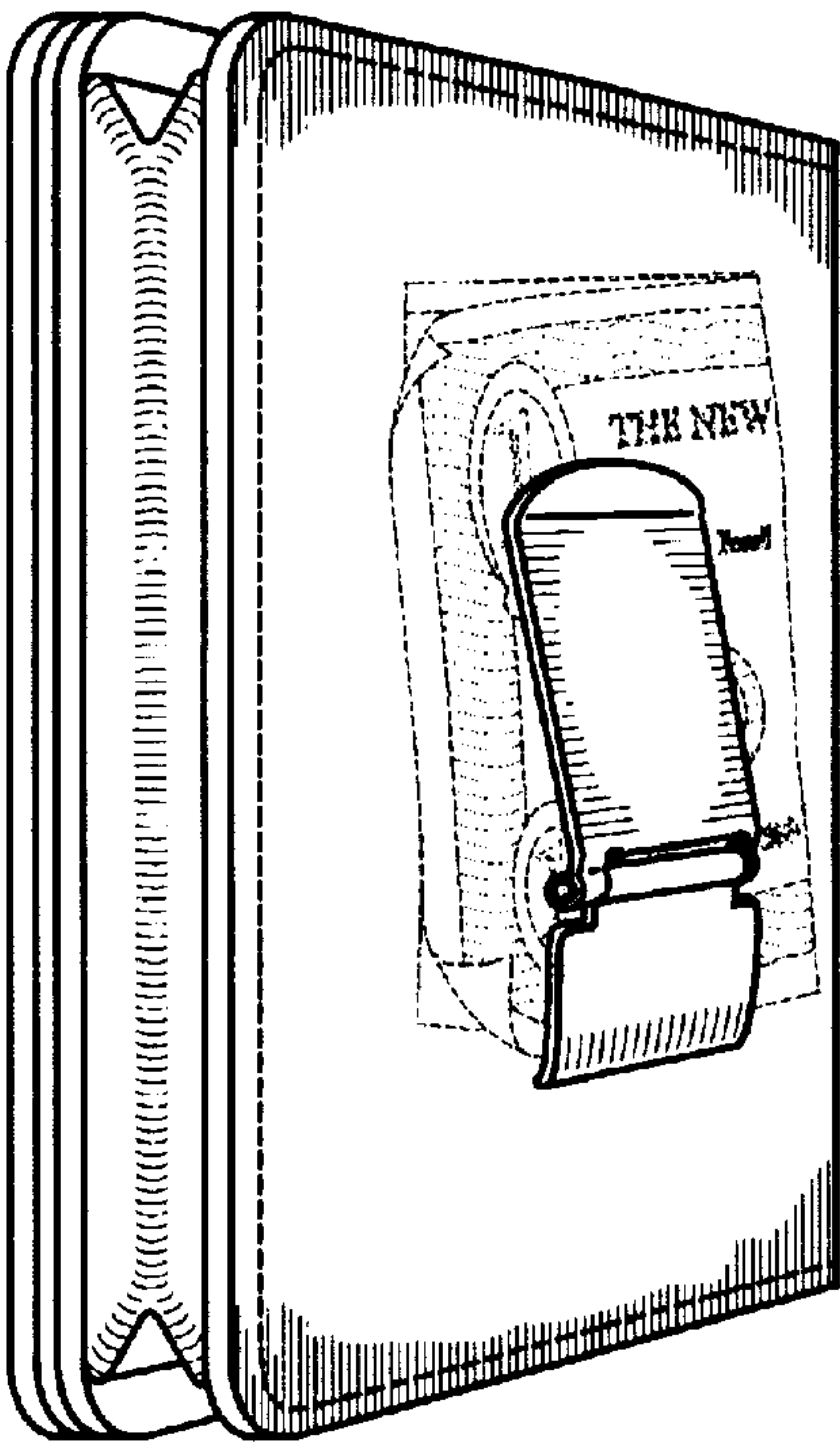

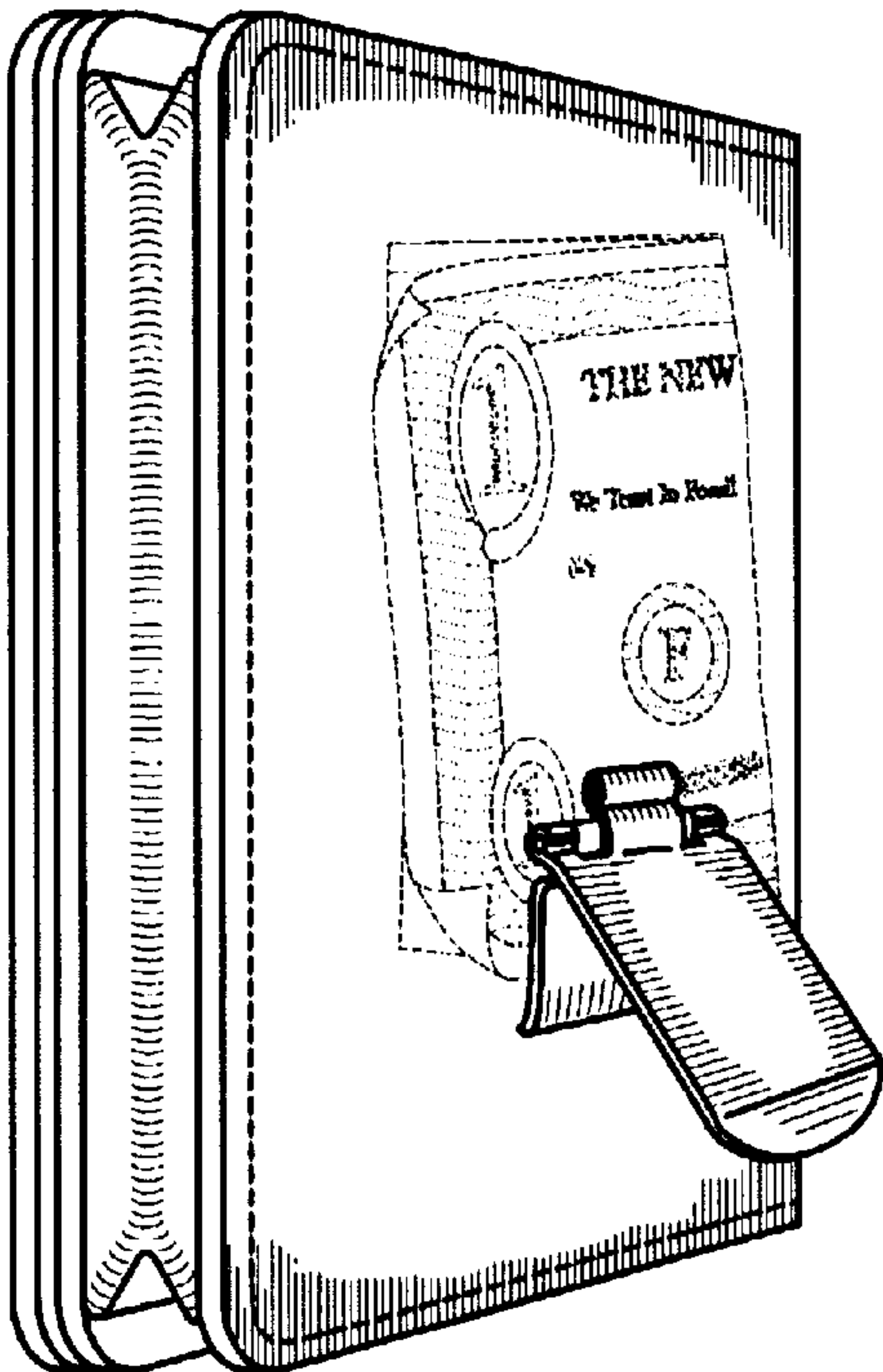
