(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof (with or without the handle shown in phantom).

FIG. 3 is a front view of the design.

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the design; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the design.

The broken line showing of the lever in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

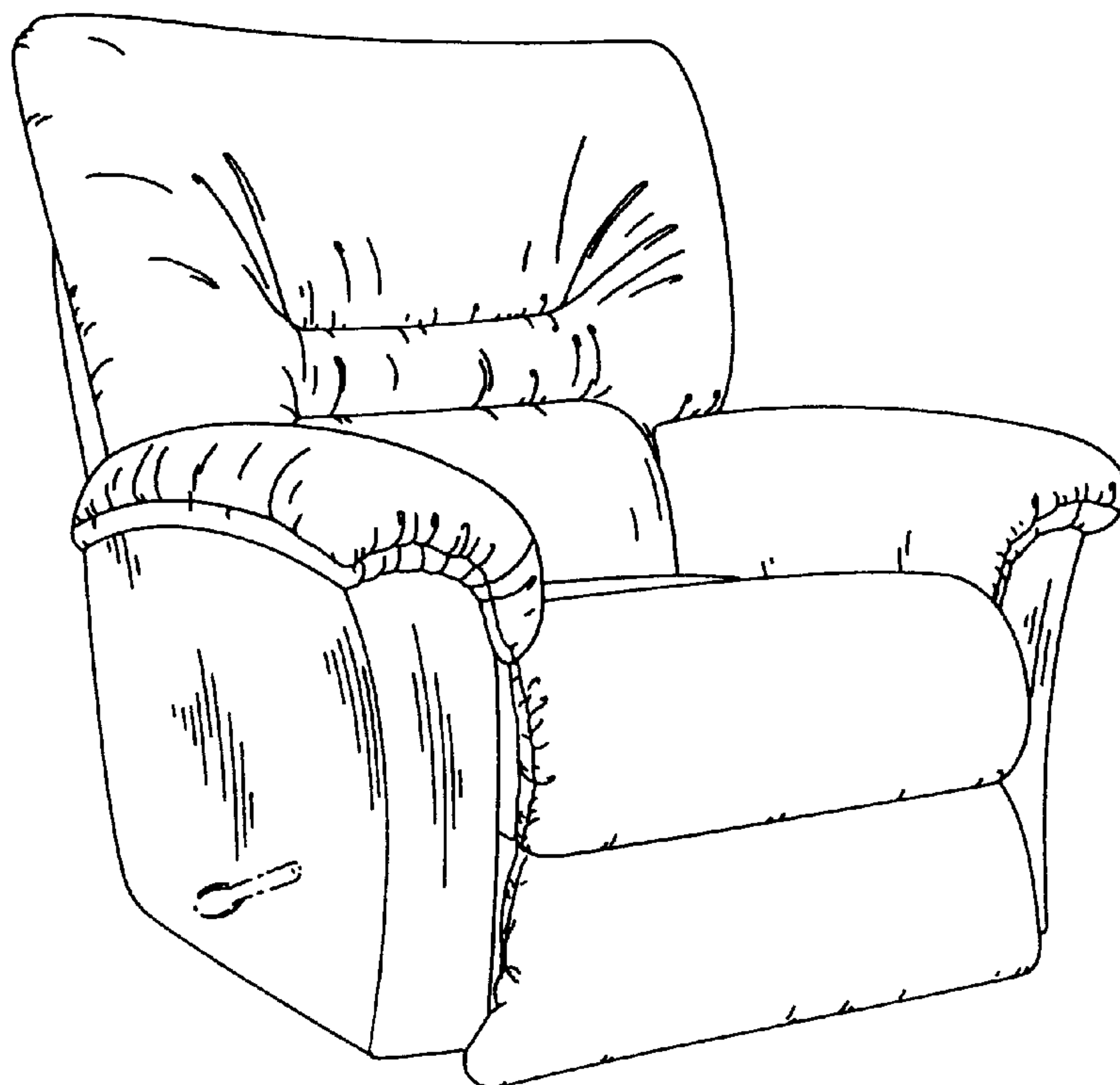

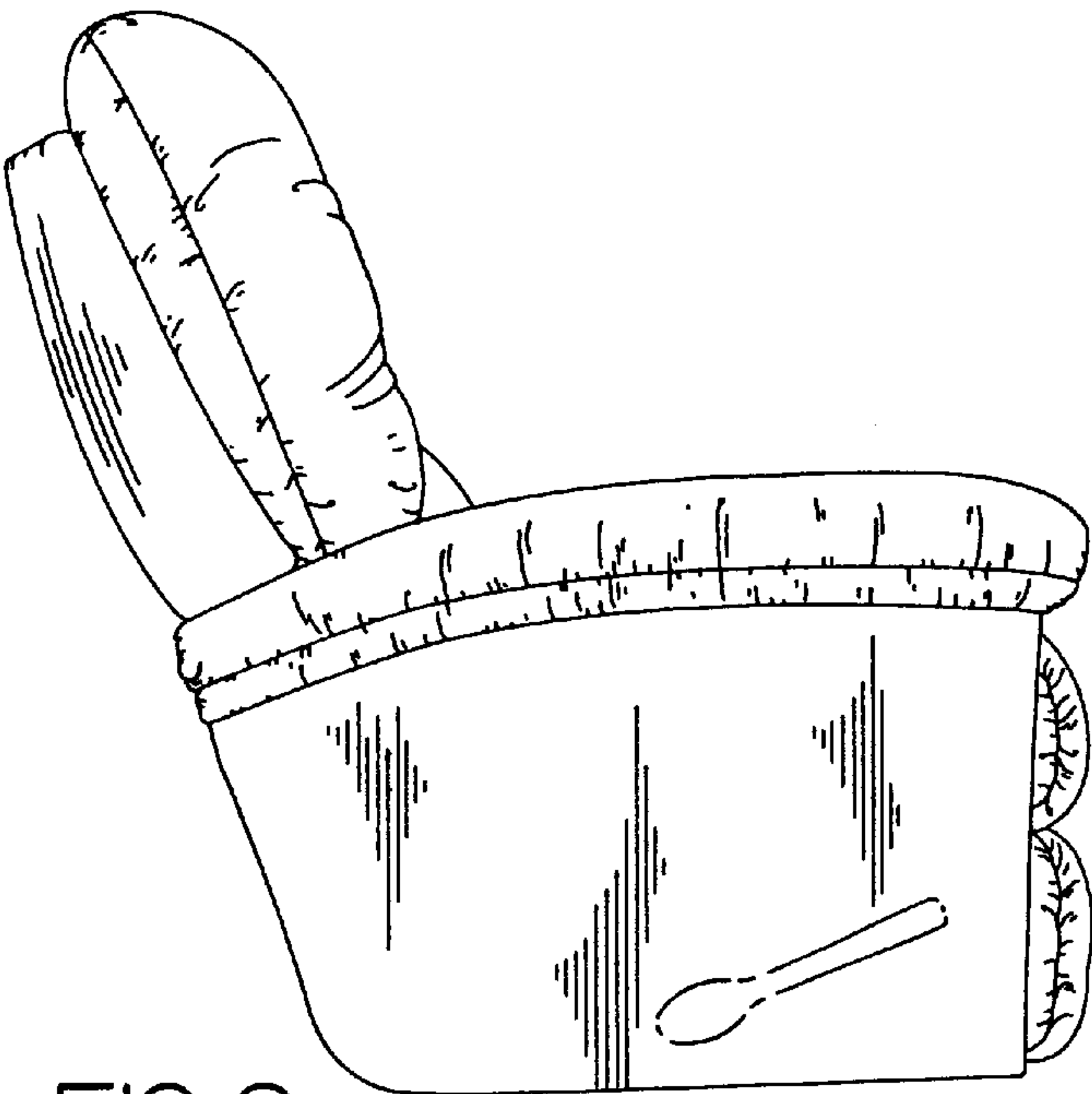
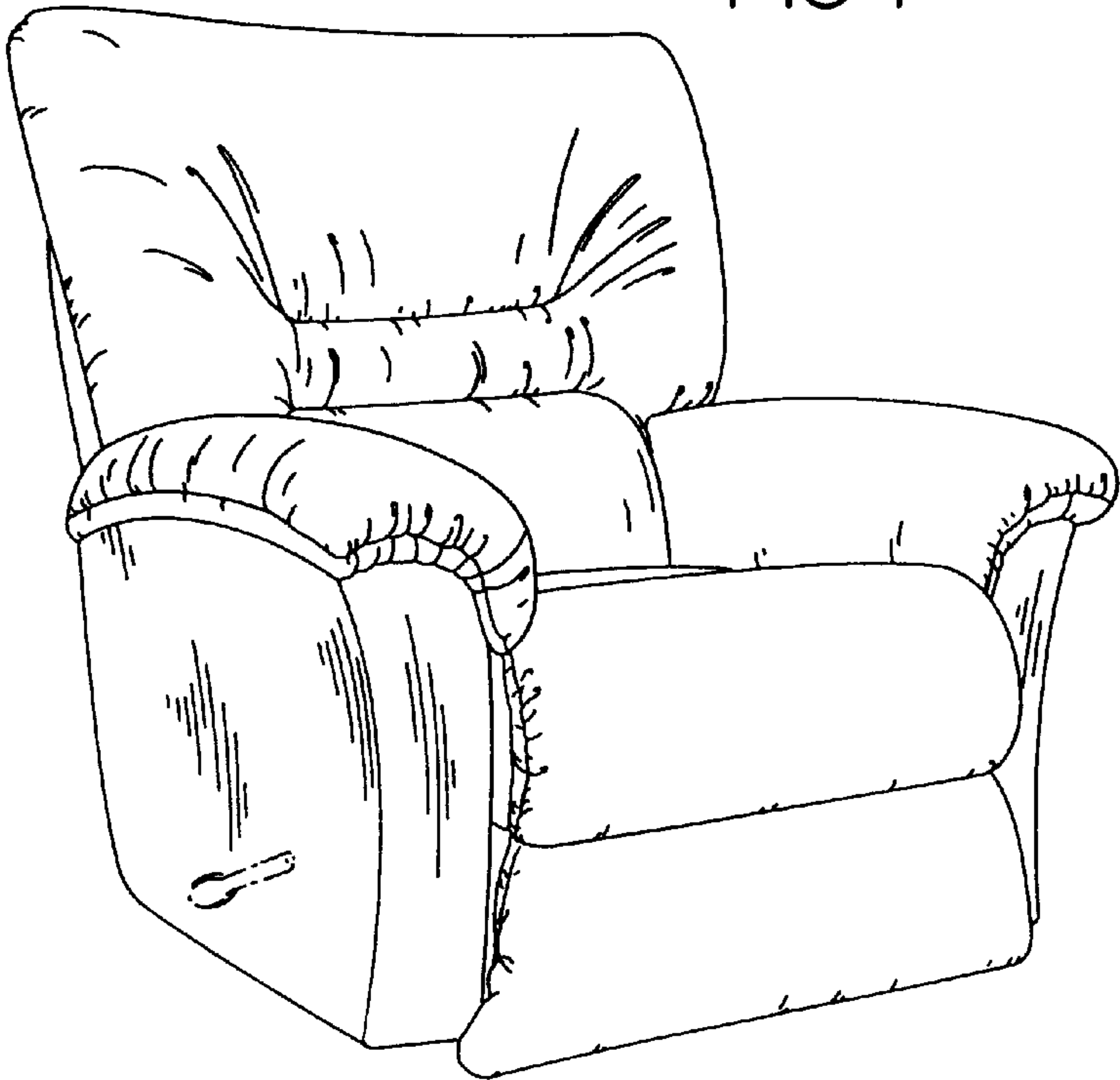

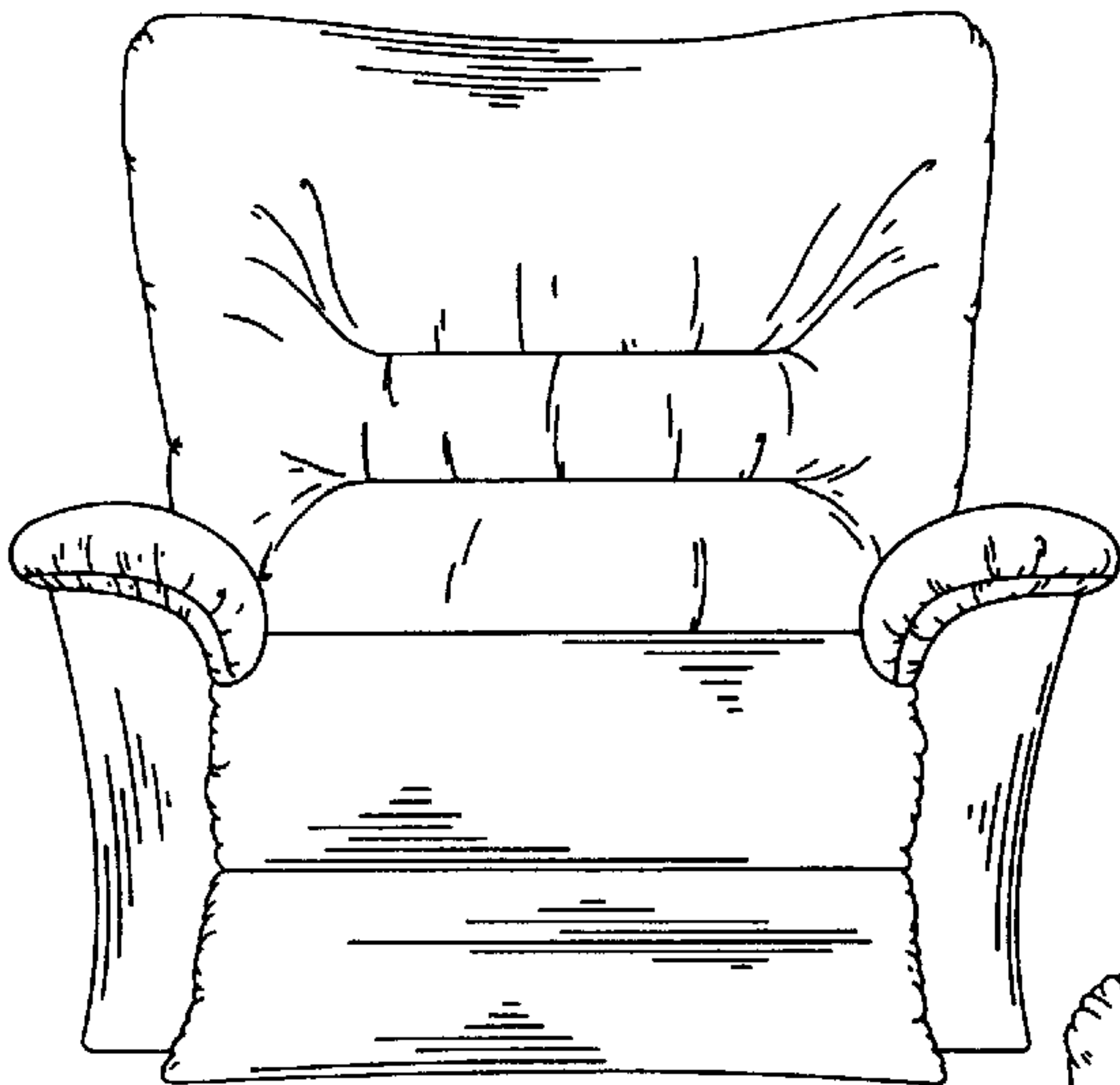

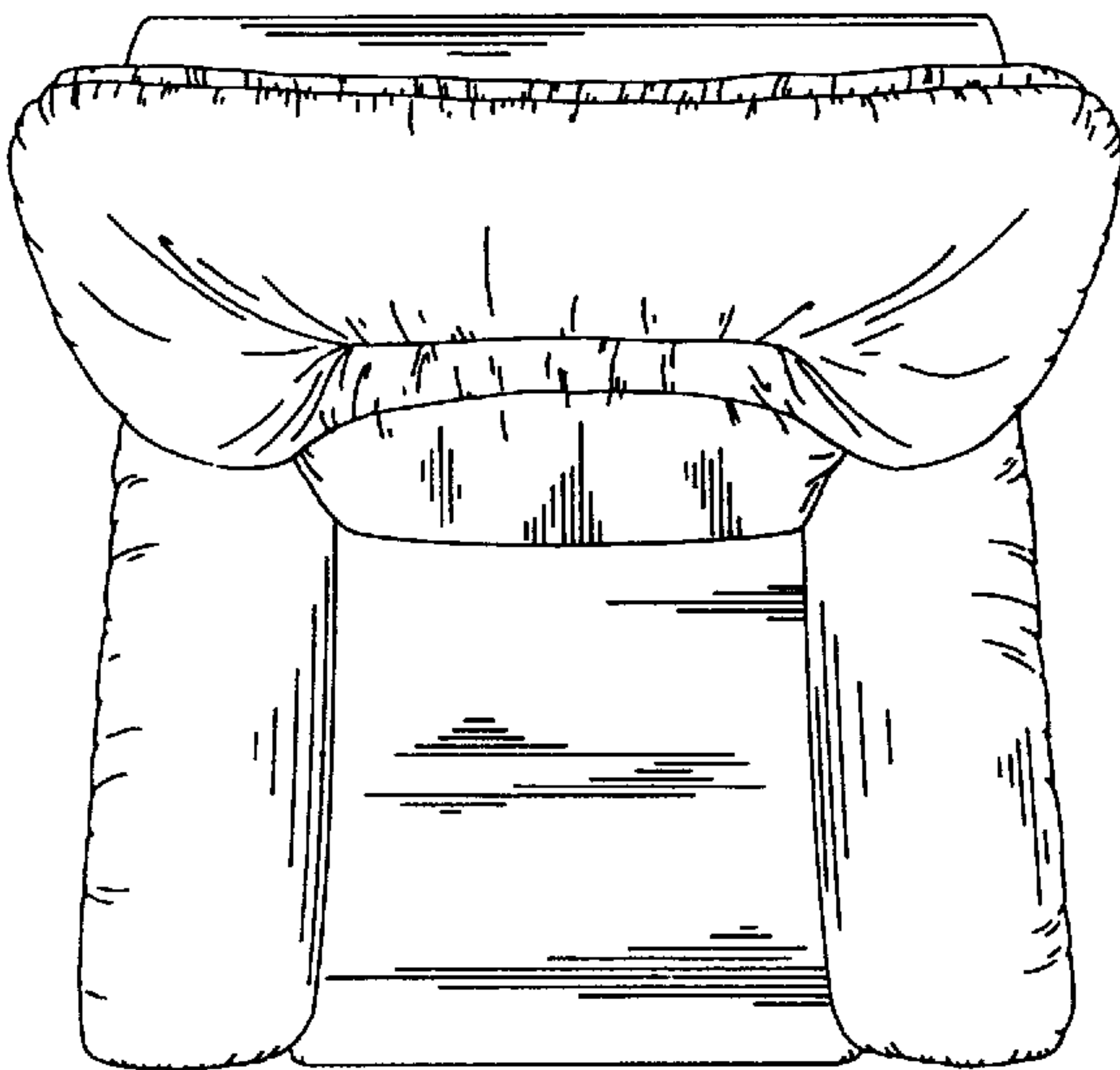
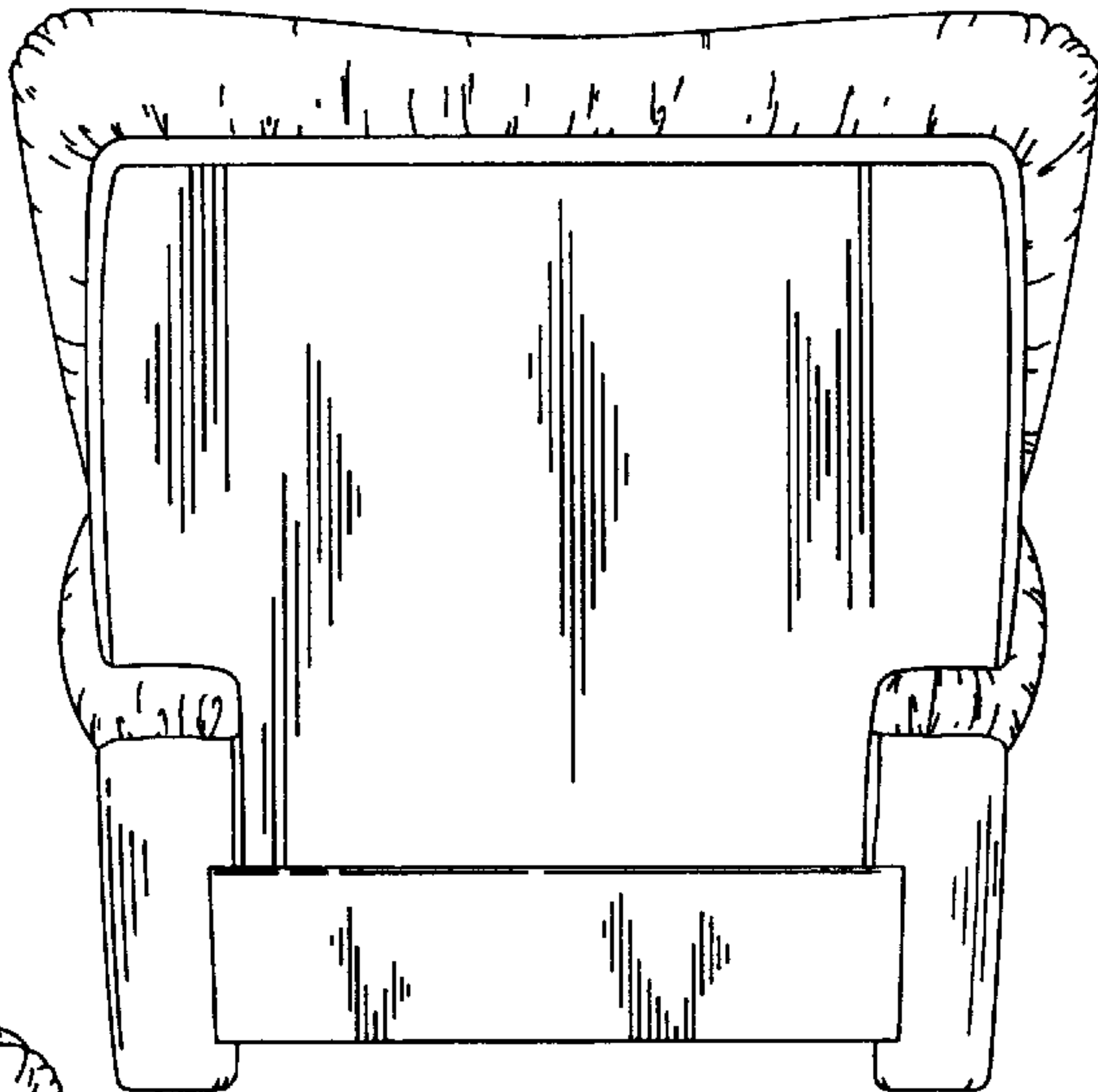
