DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a chair back comprising the new design;

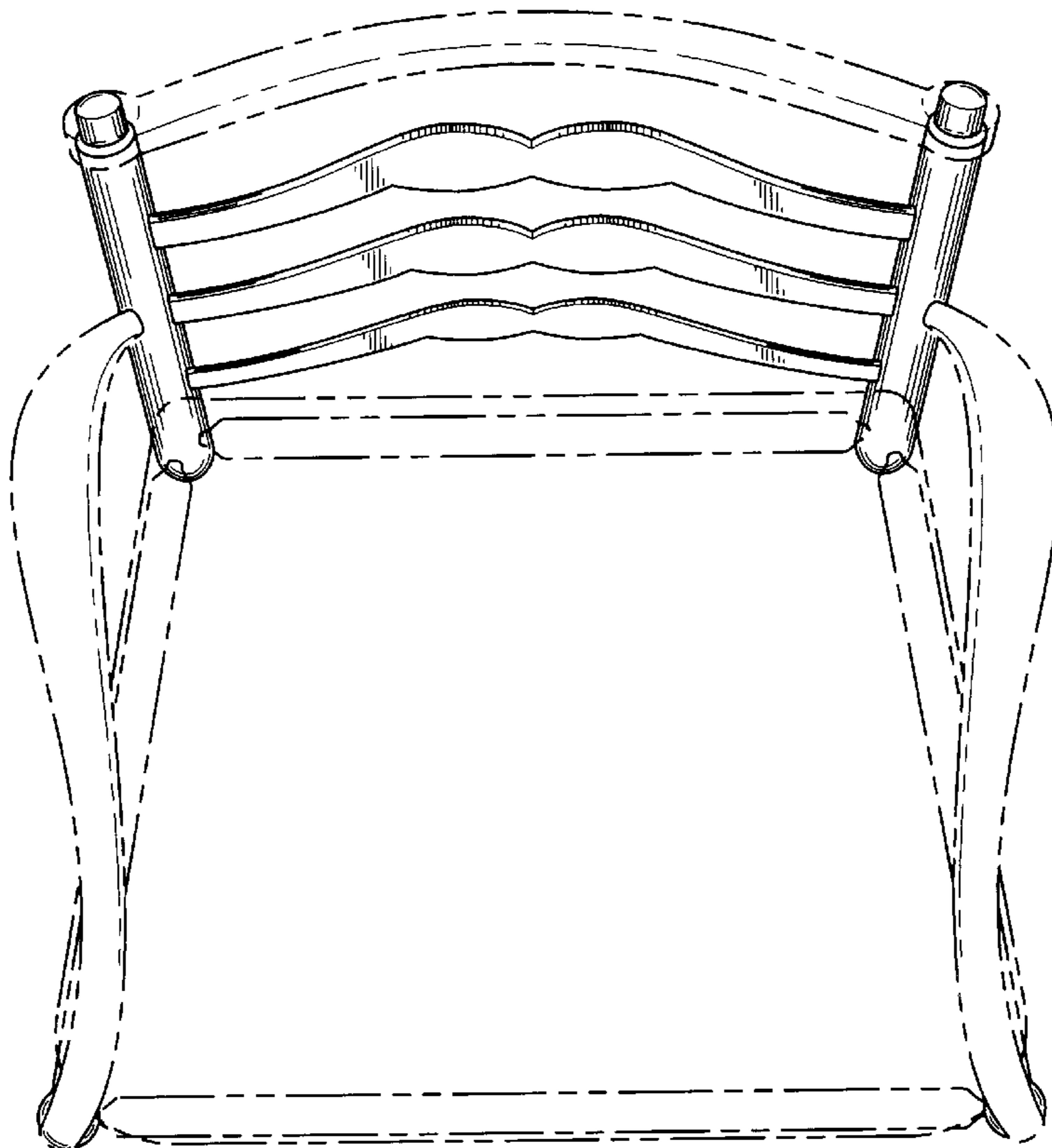
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

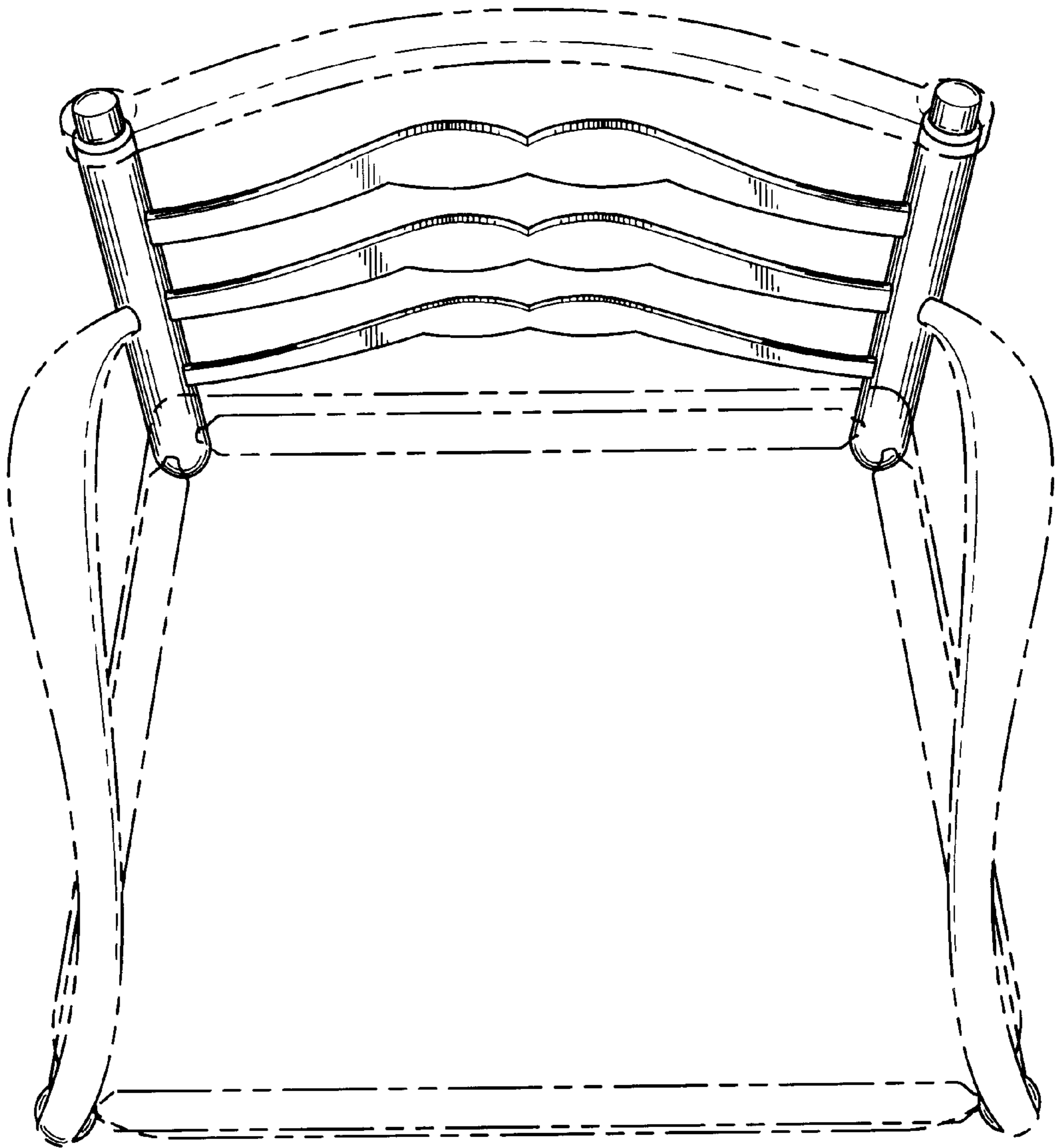

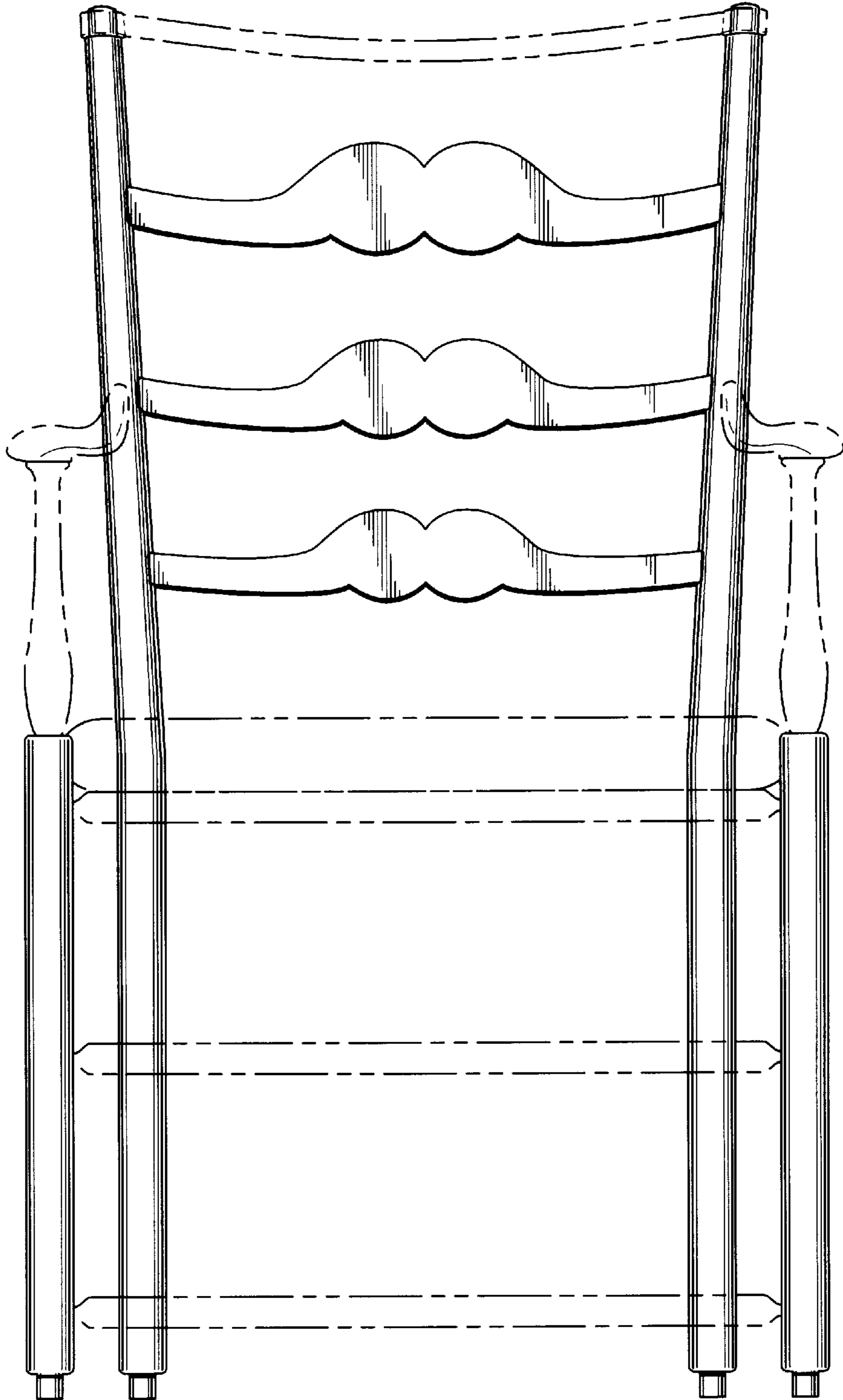

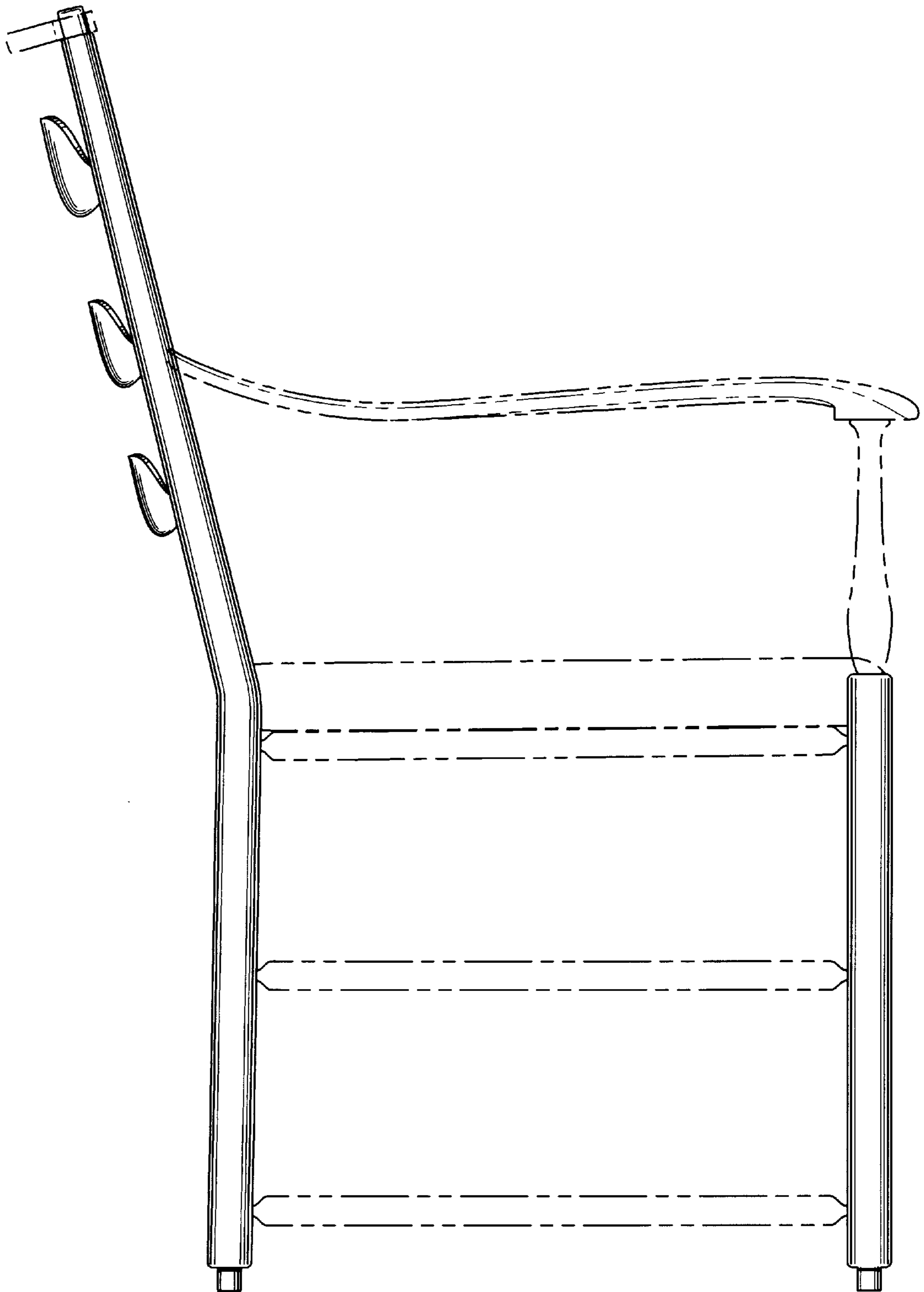

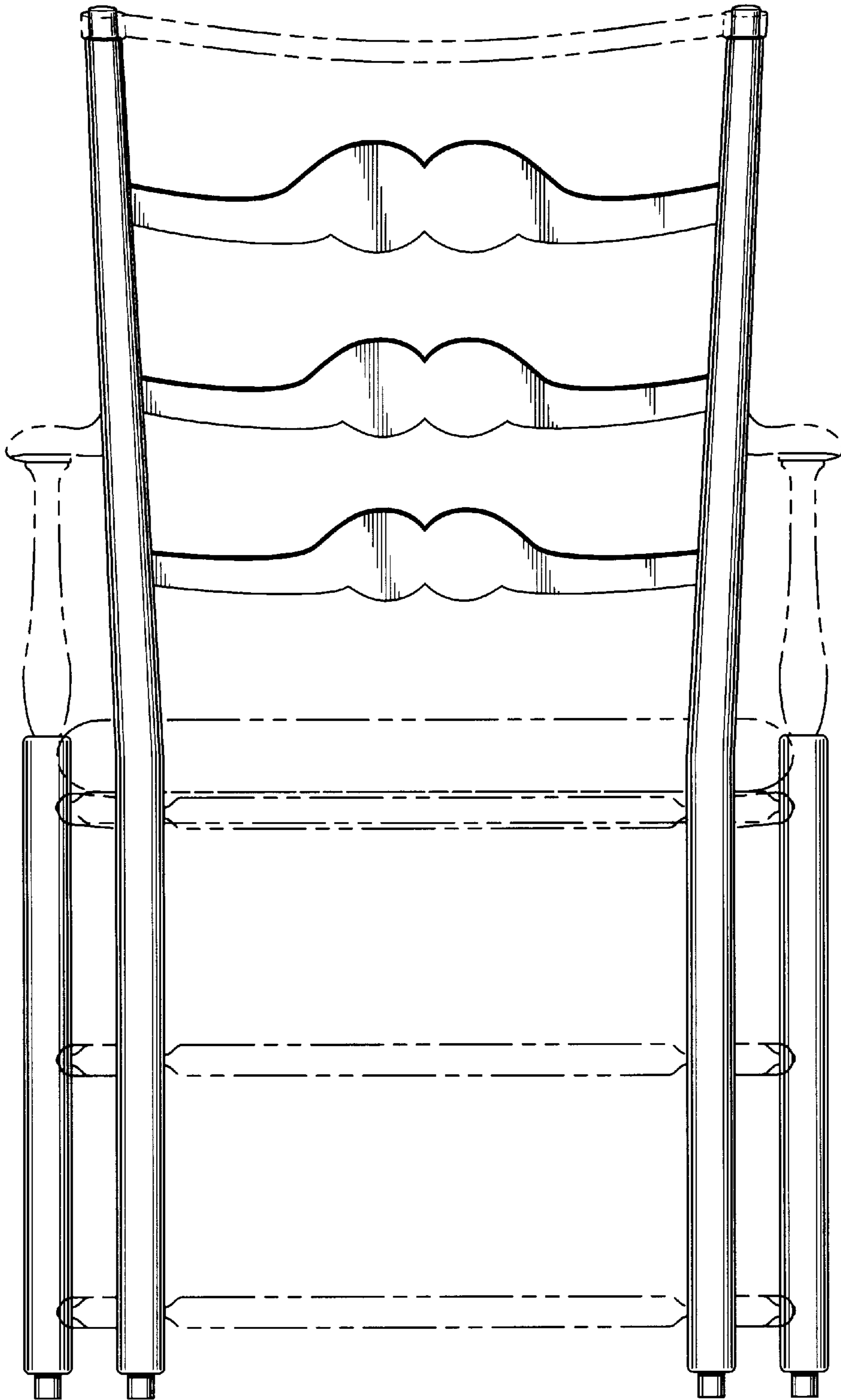
