FIG. 6 is a front-end view thereof; and,

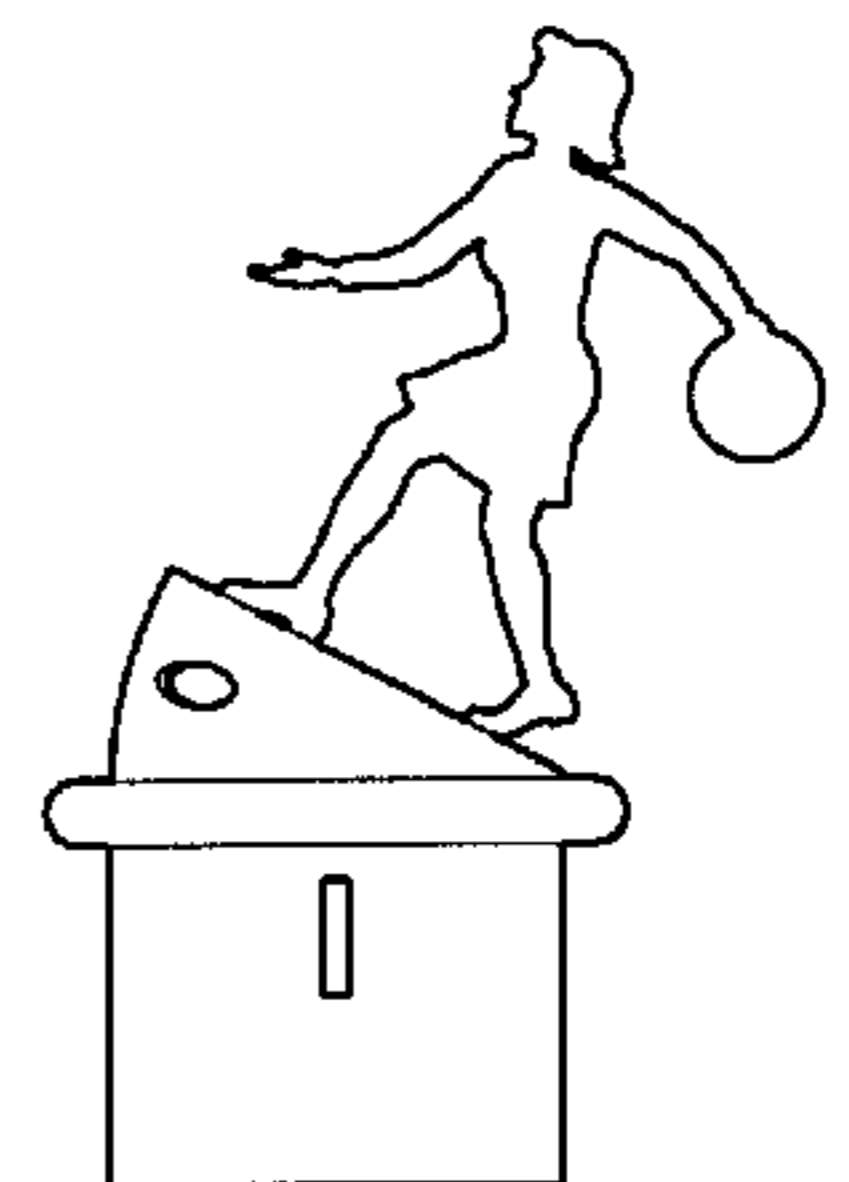
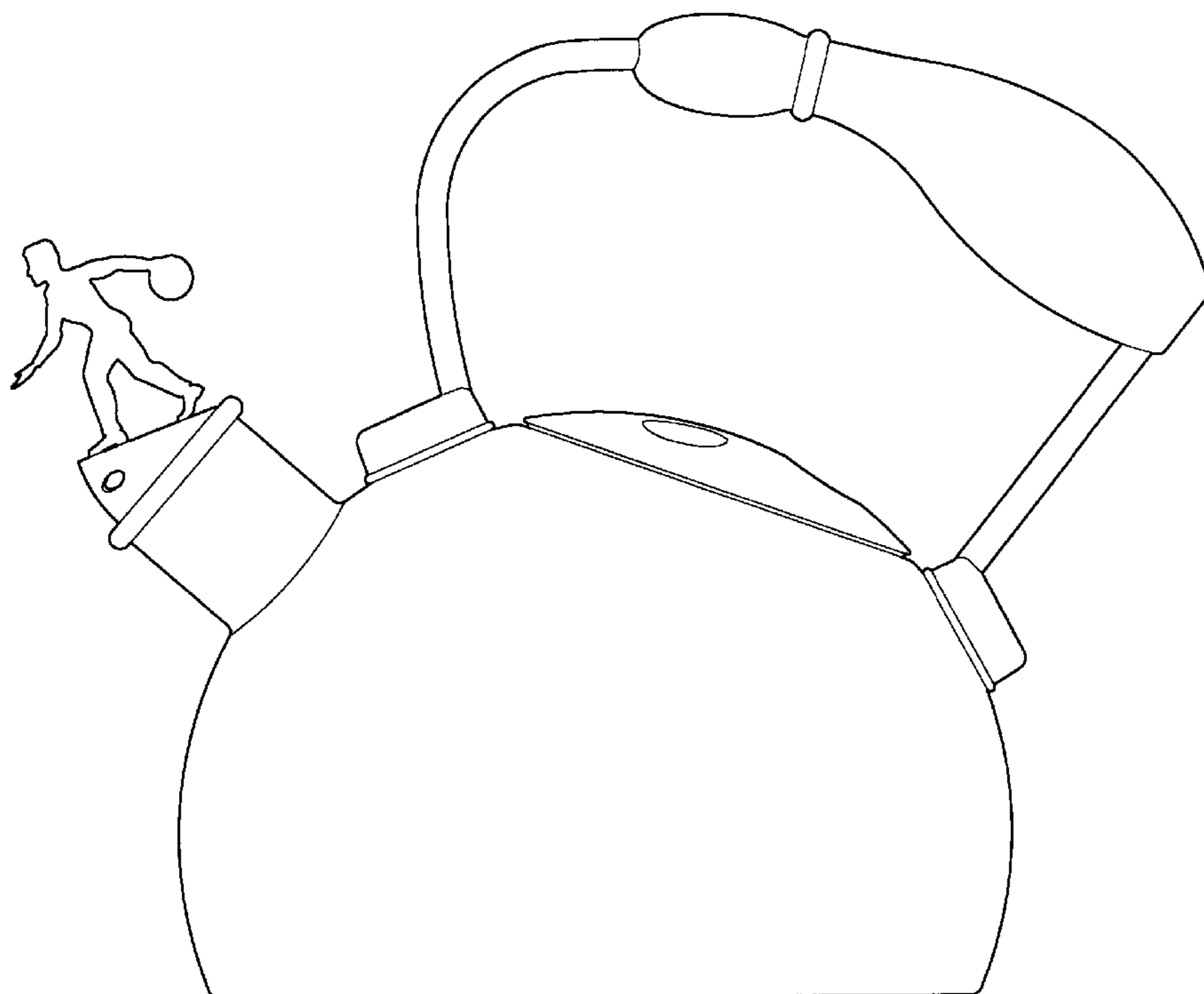
FIG. 7 is a back-end view thereof.

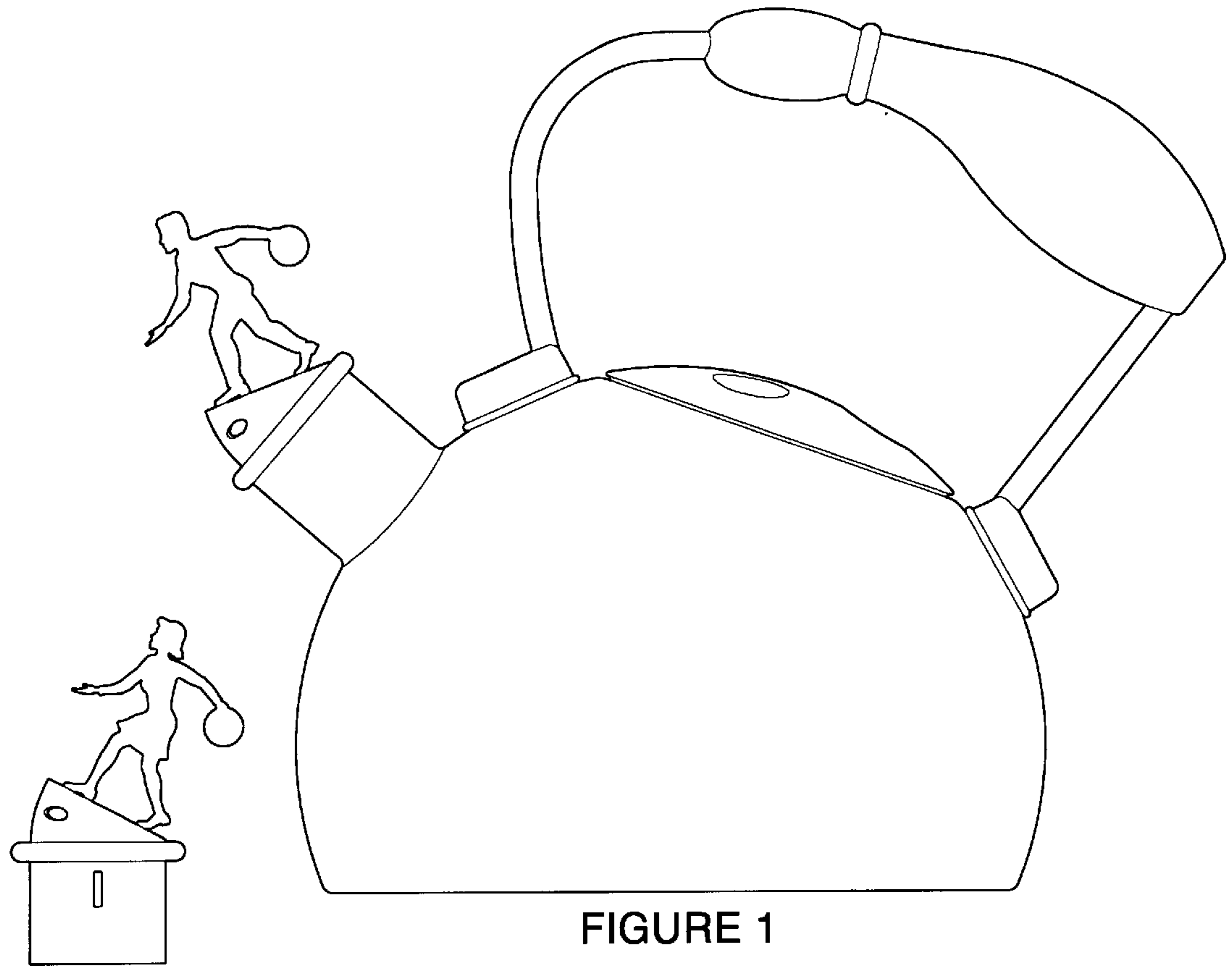
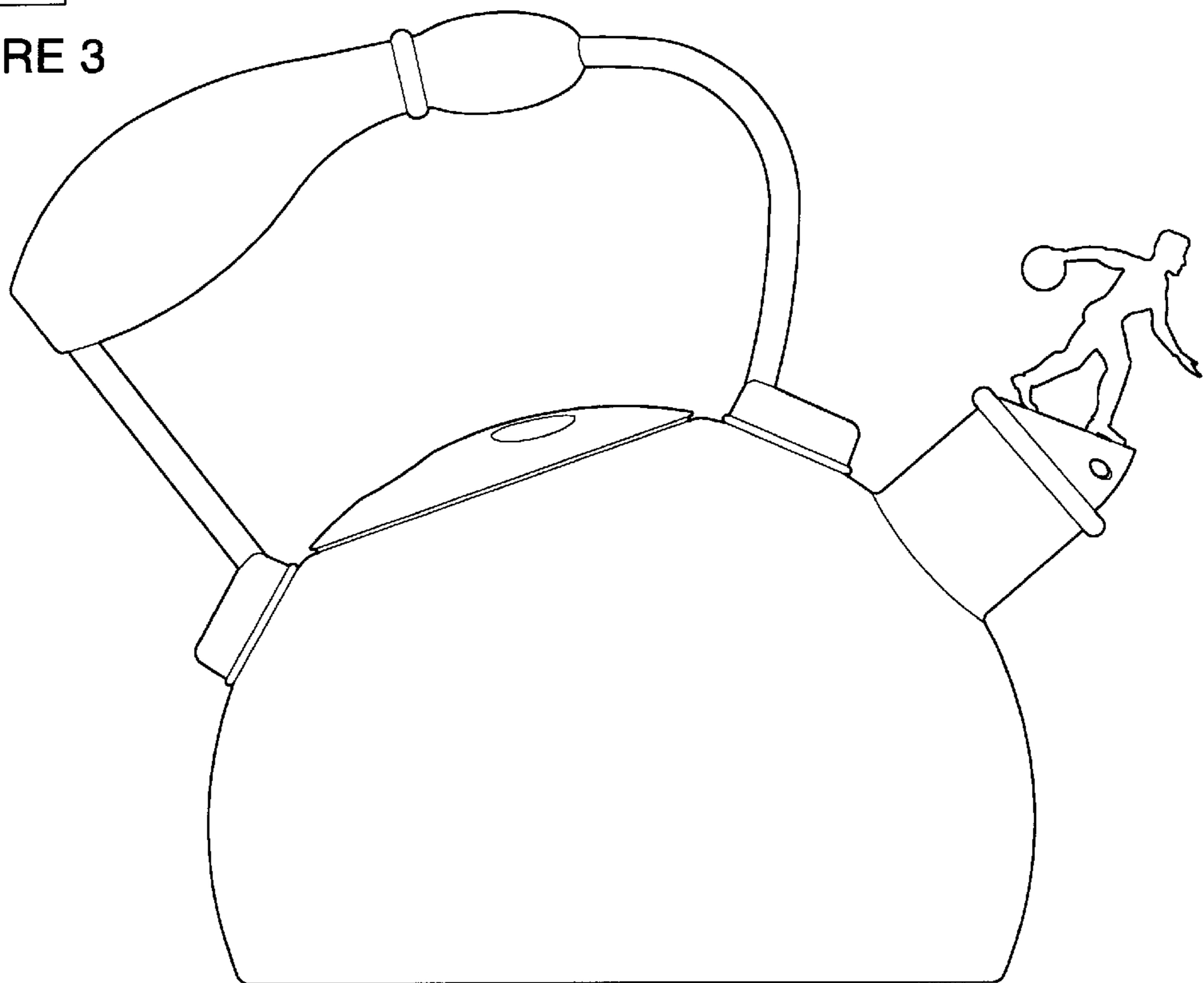

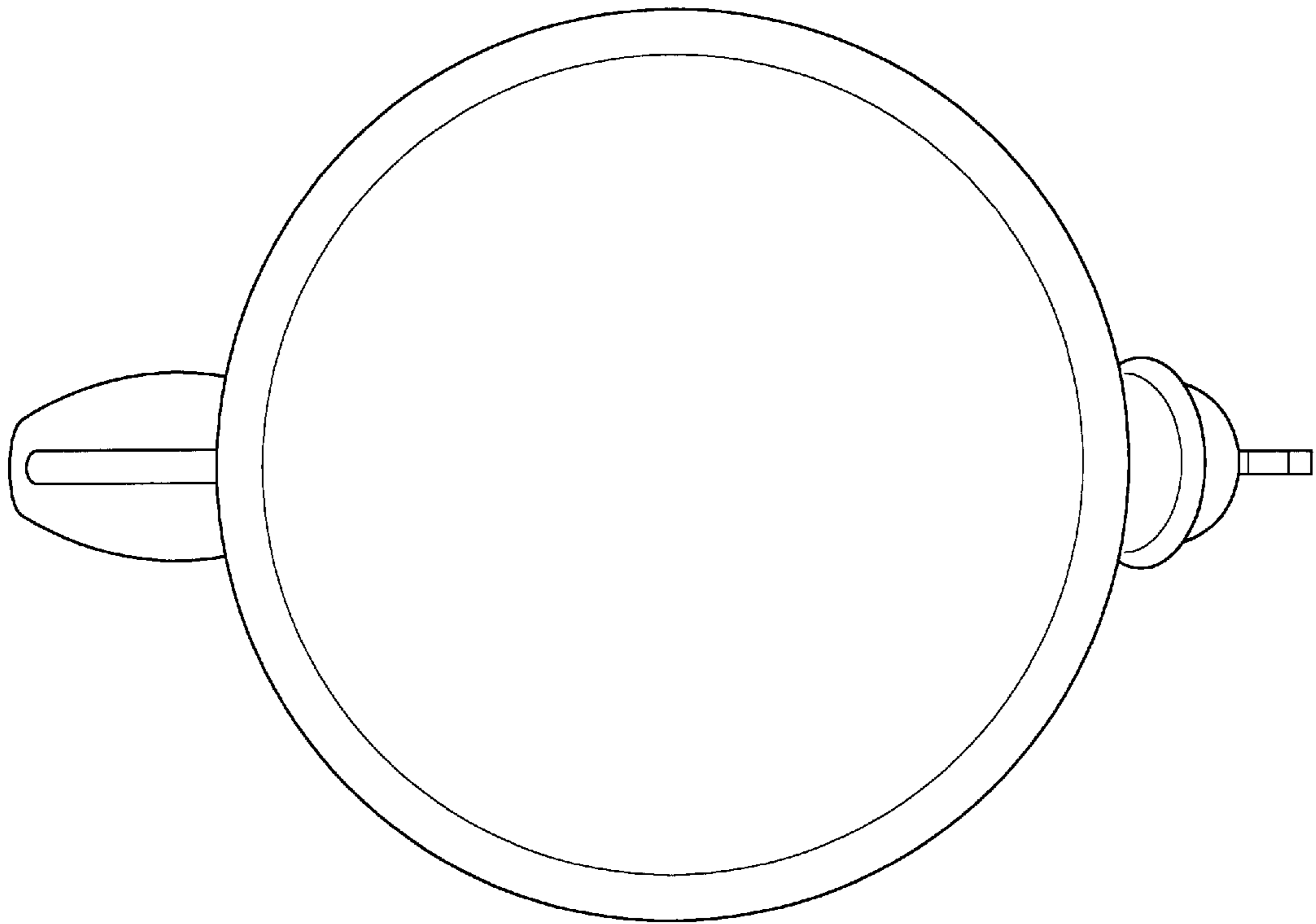

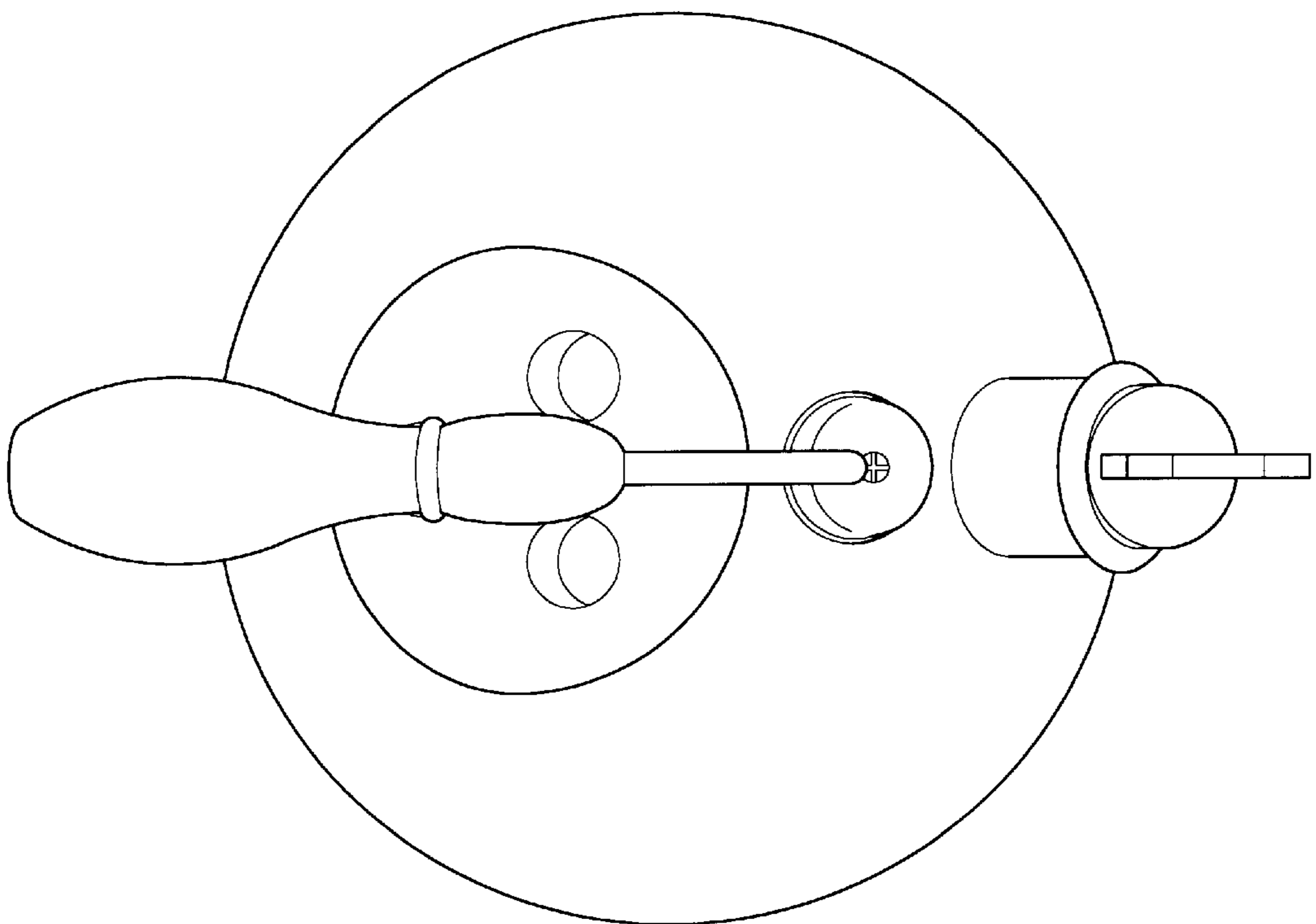

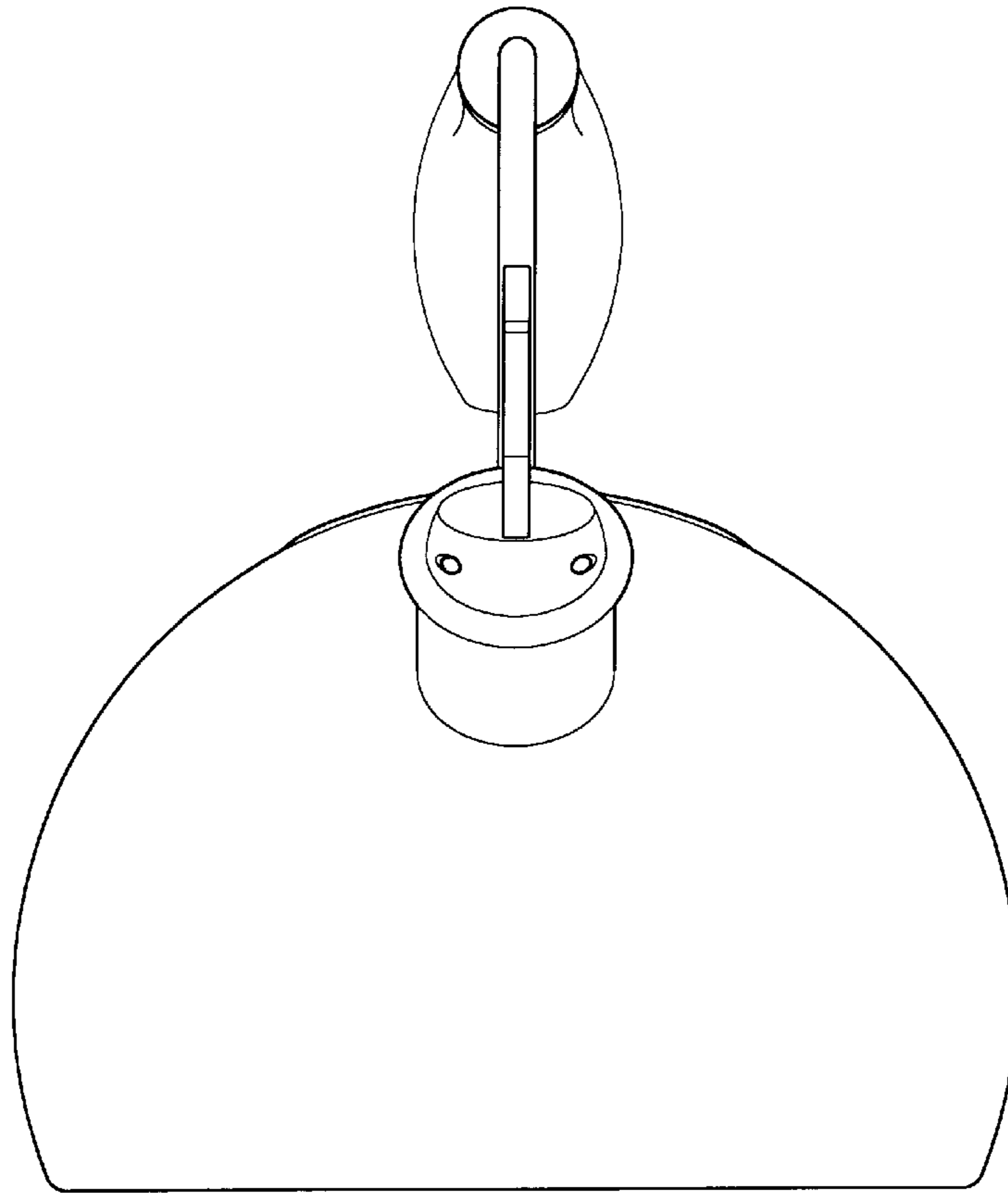

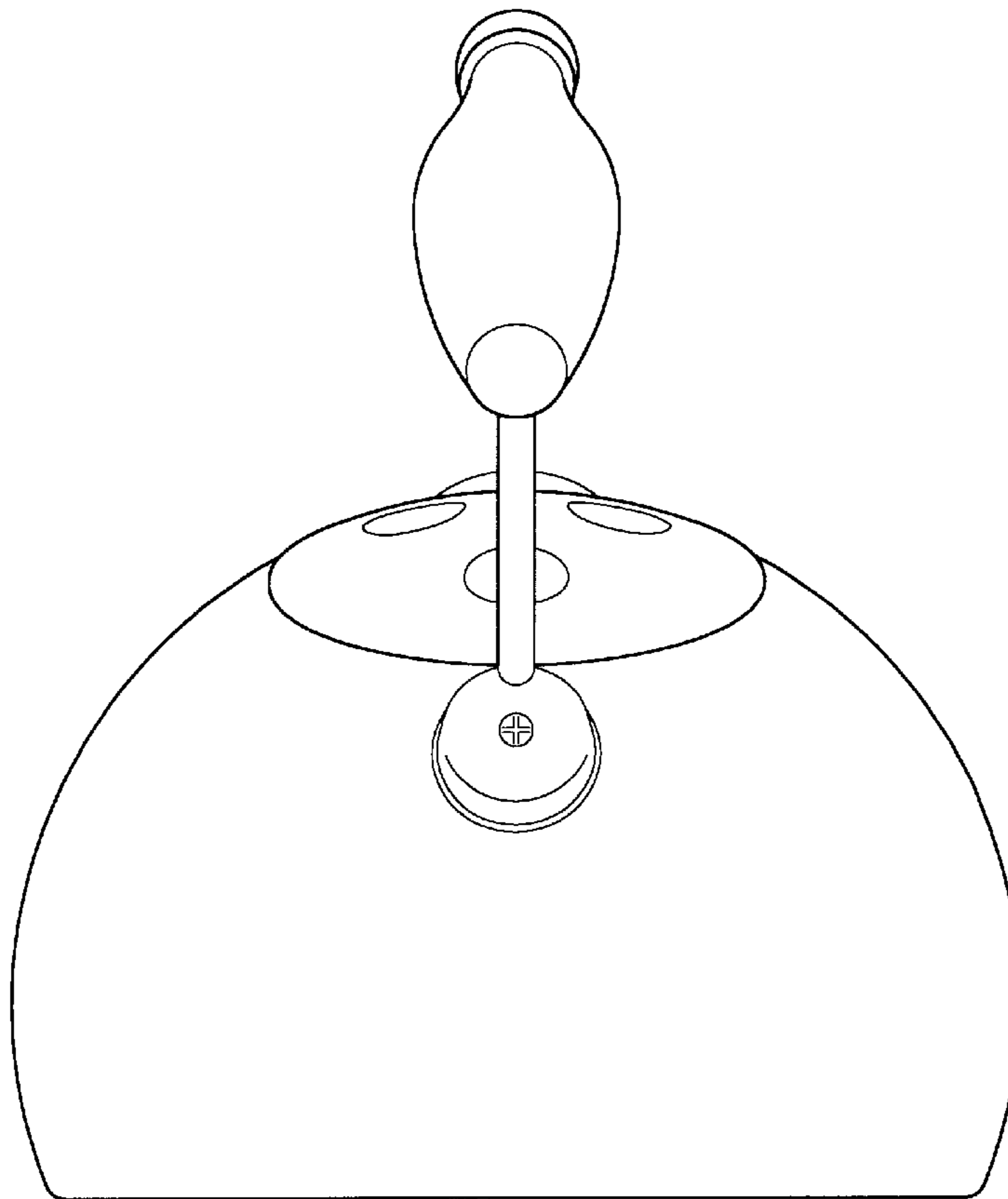
