(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bicycle display, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bicycle display showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 1–3;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 1–4;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 1–5;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 1–6;

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of a bicycle display in accordance with second embodiment of my new design that is basically a mirror image of the prior embodiment;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 8 and 9;

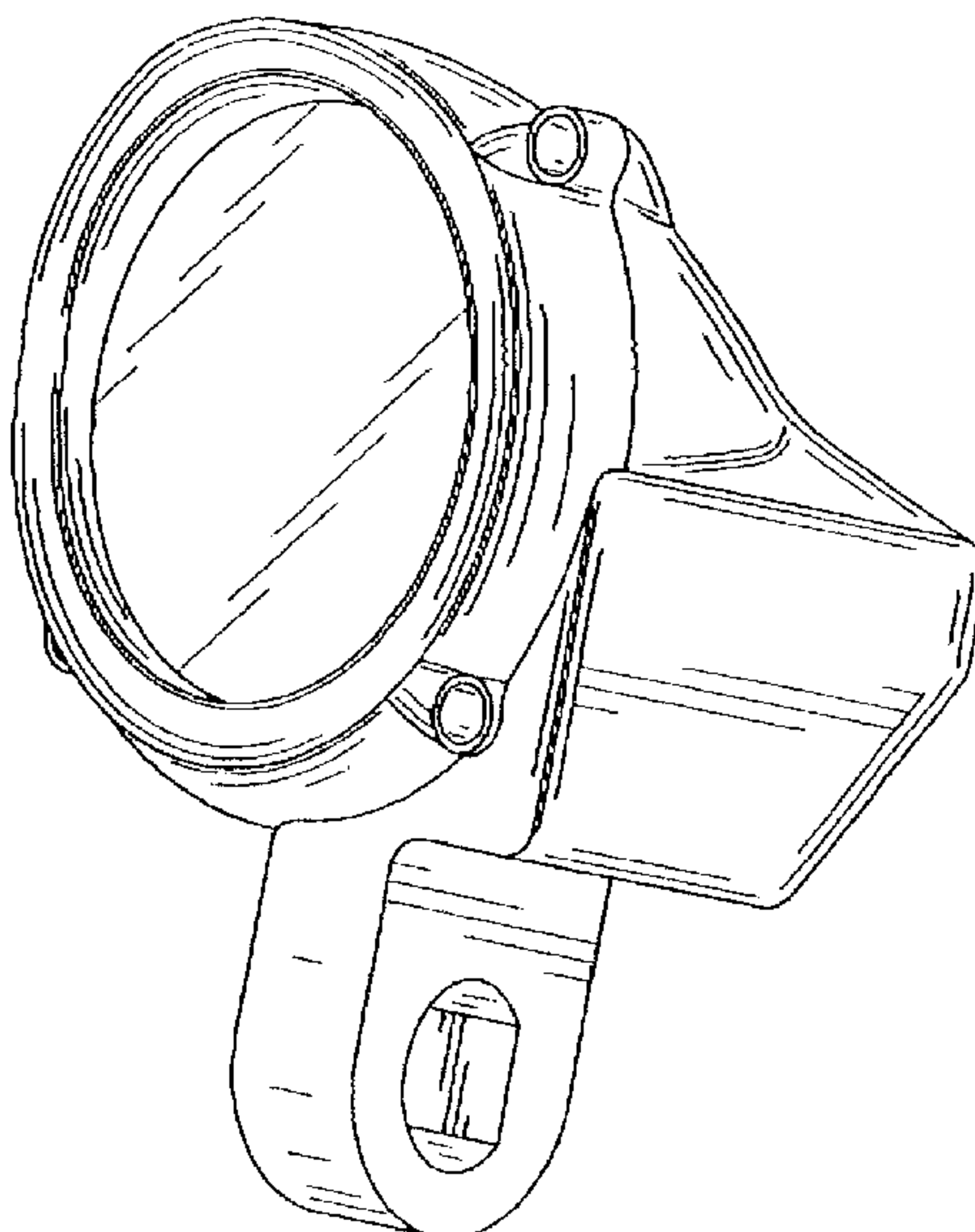
FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of the bicycle display illustrated in FIGS. 8–10;

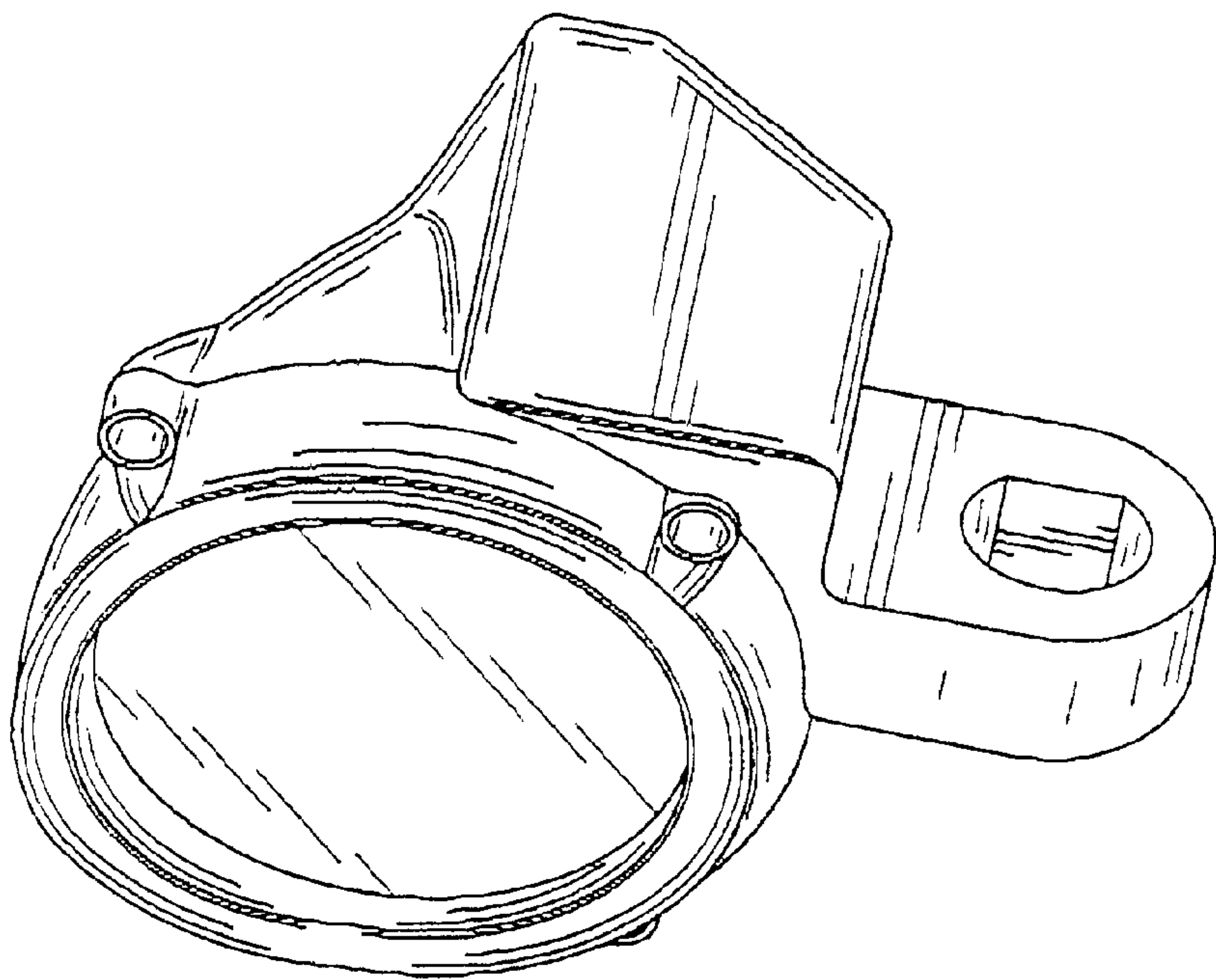

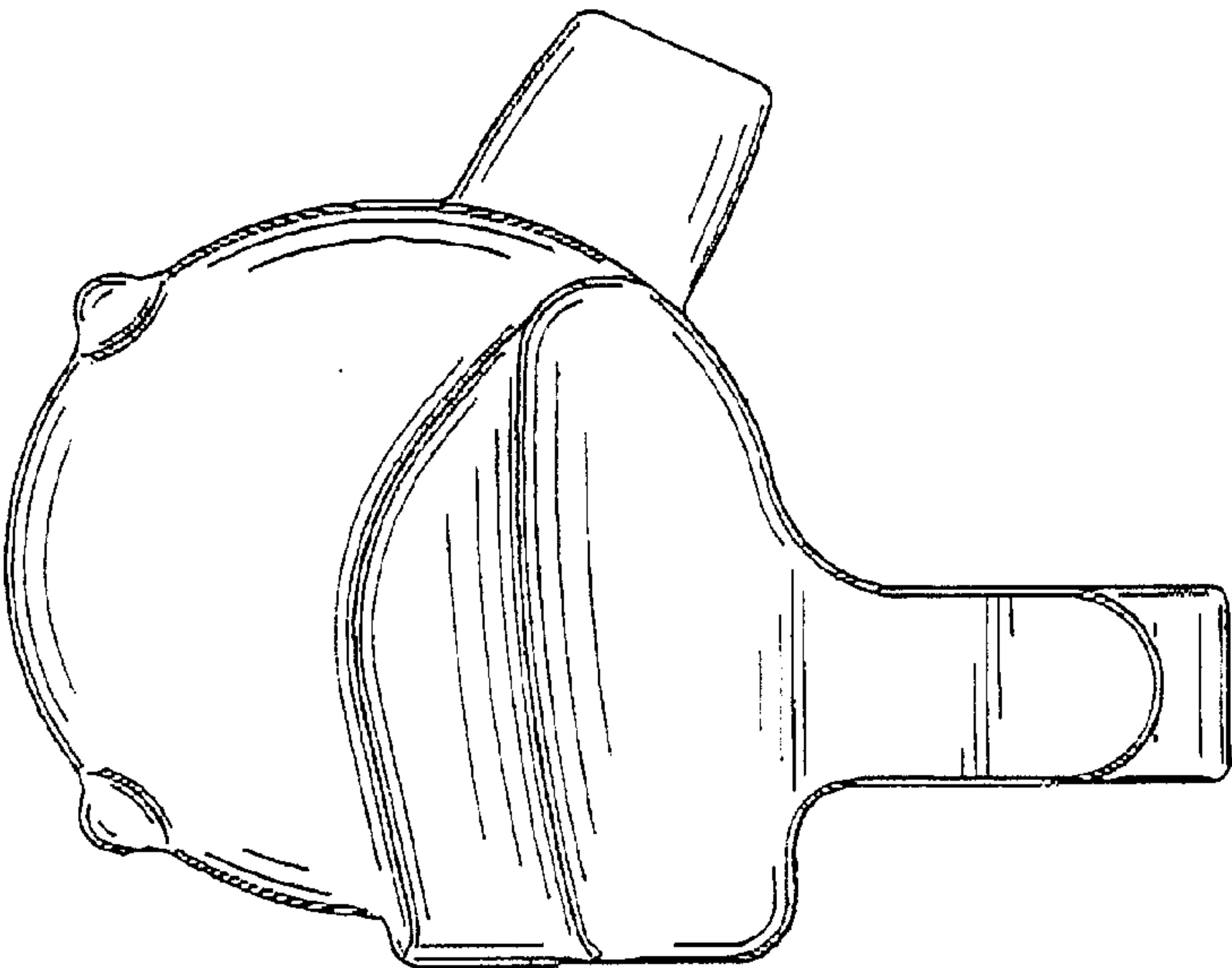

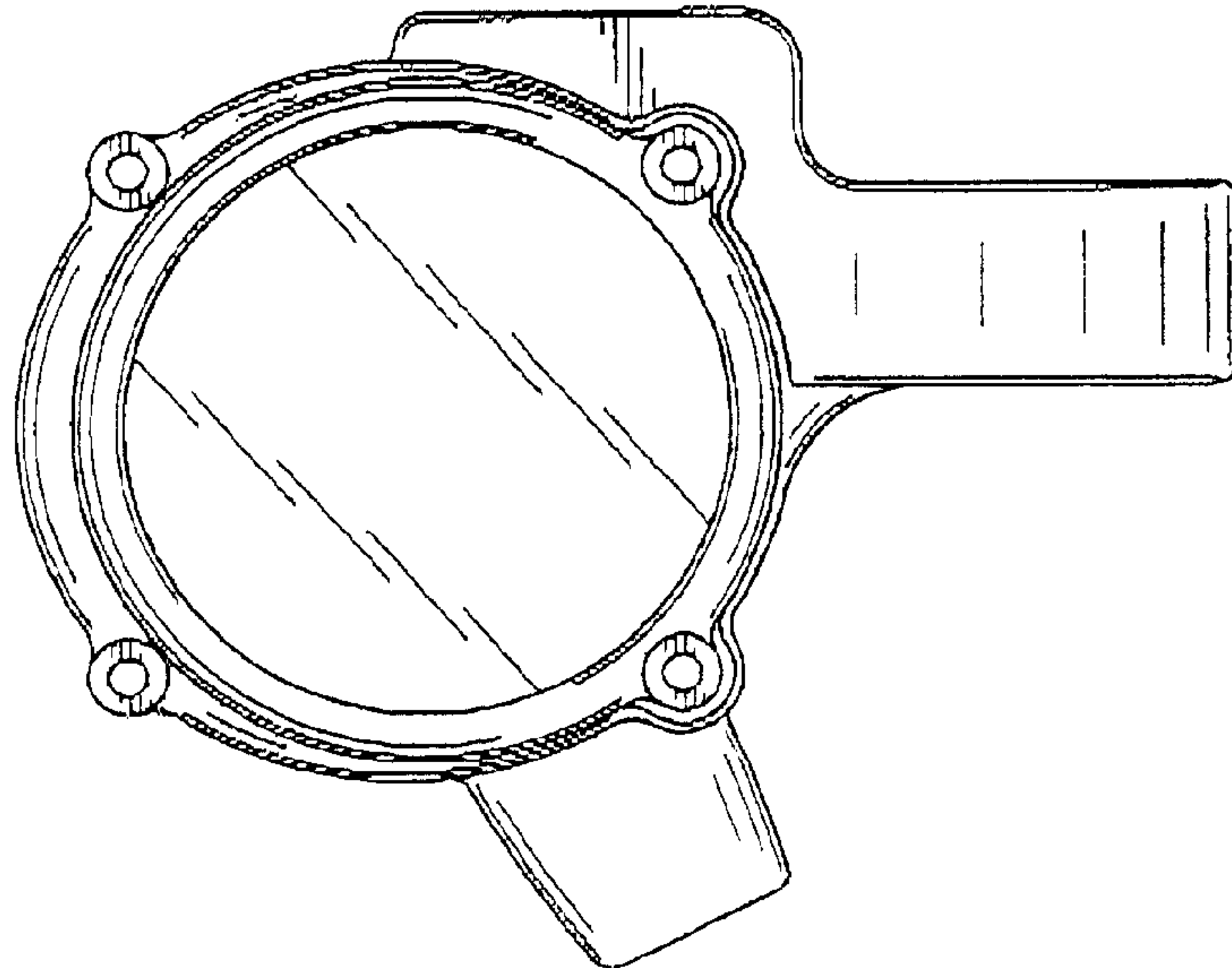

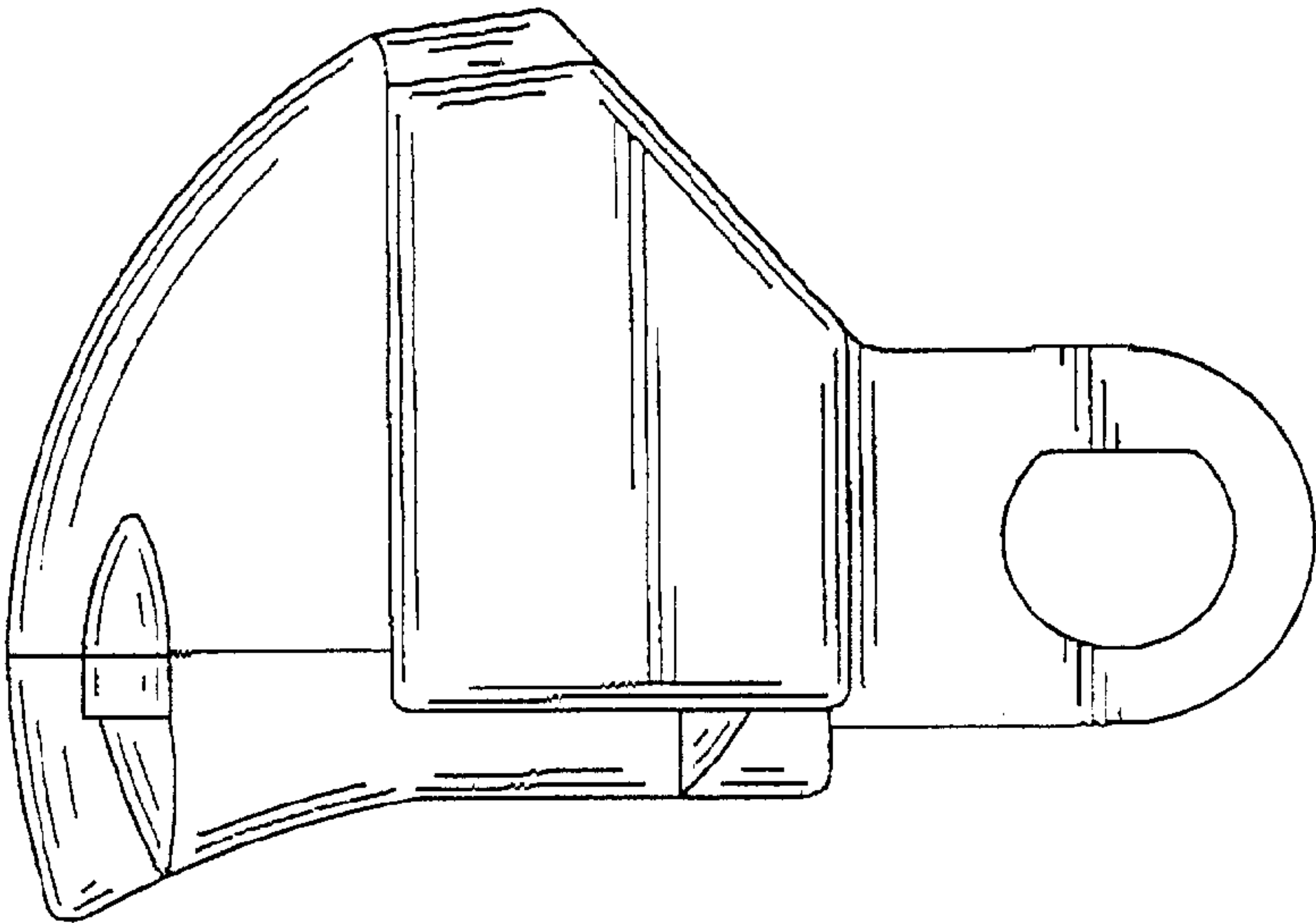

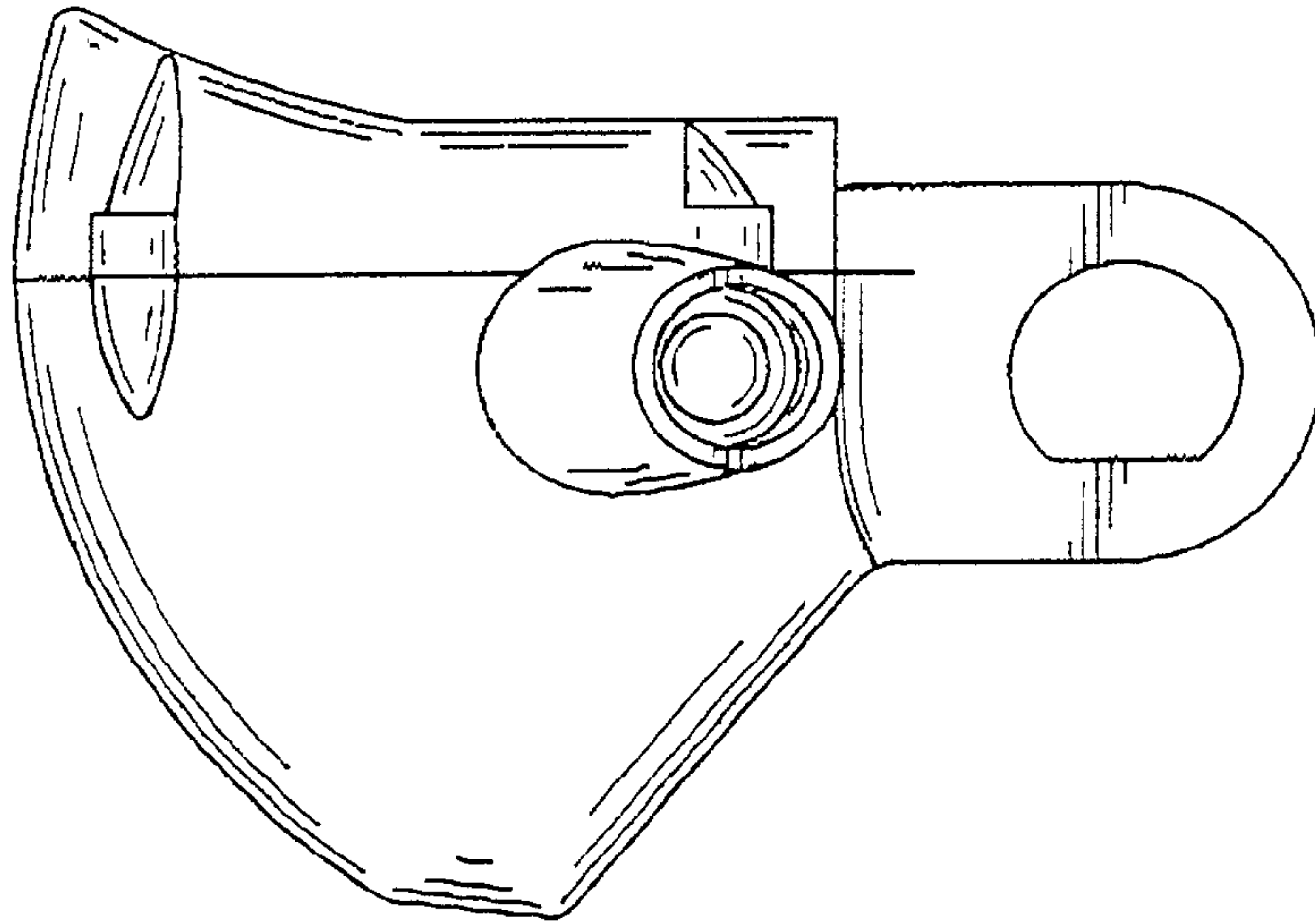

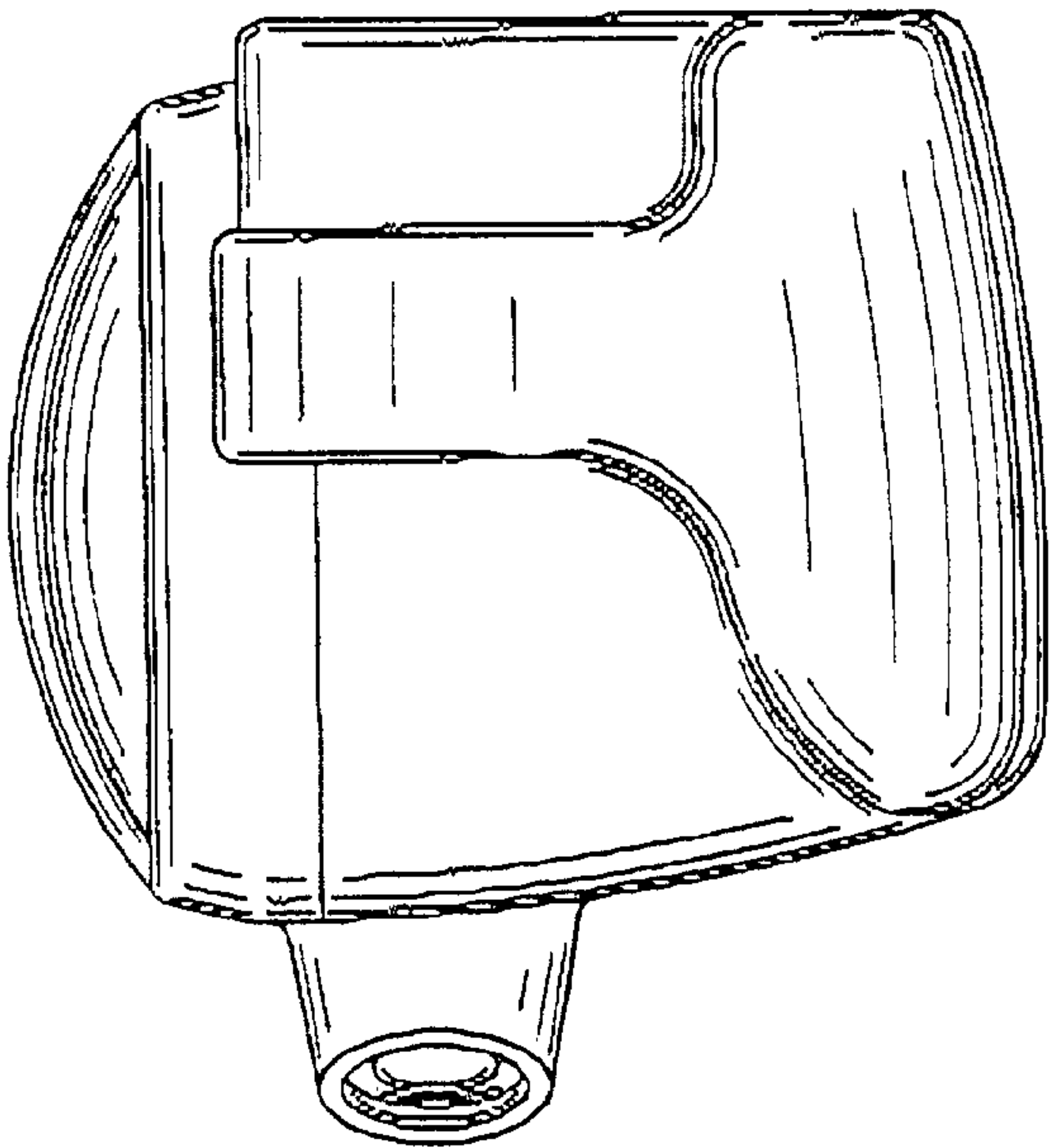

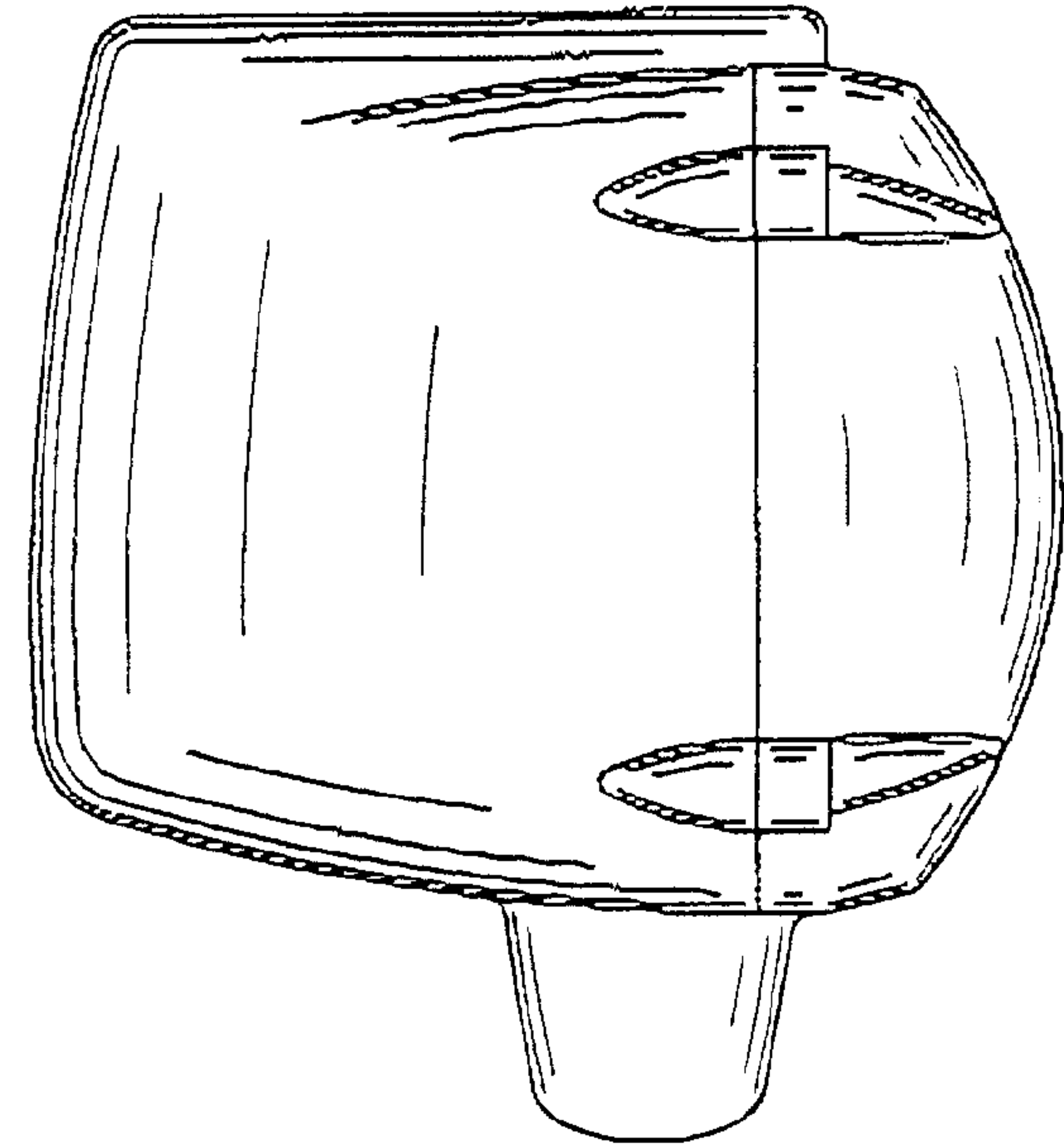

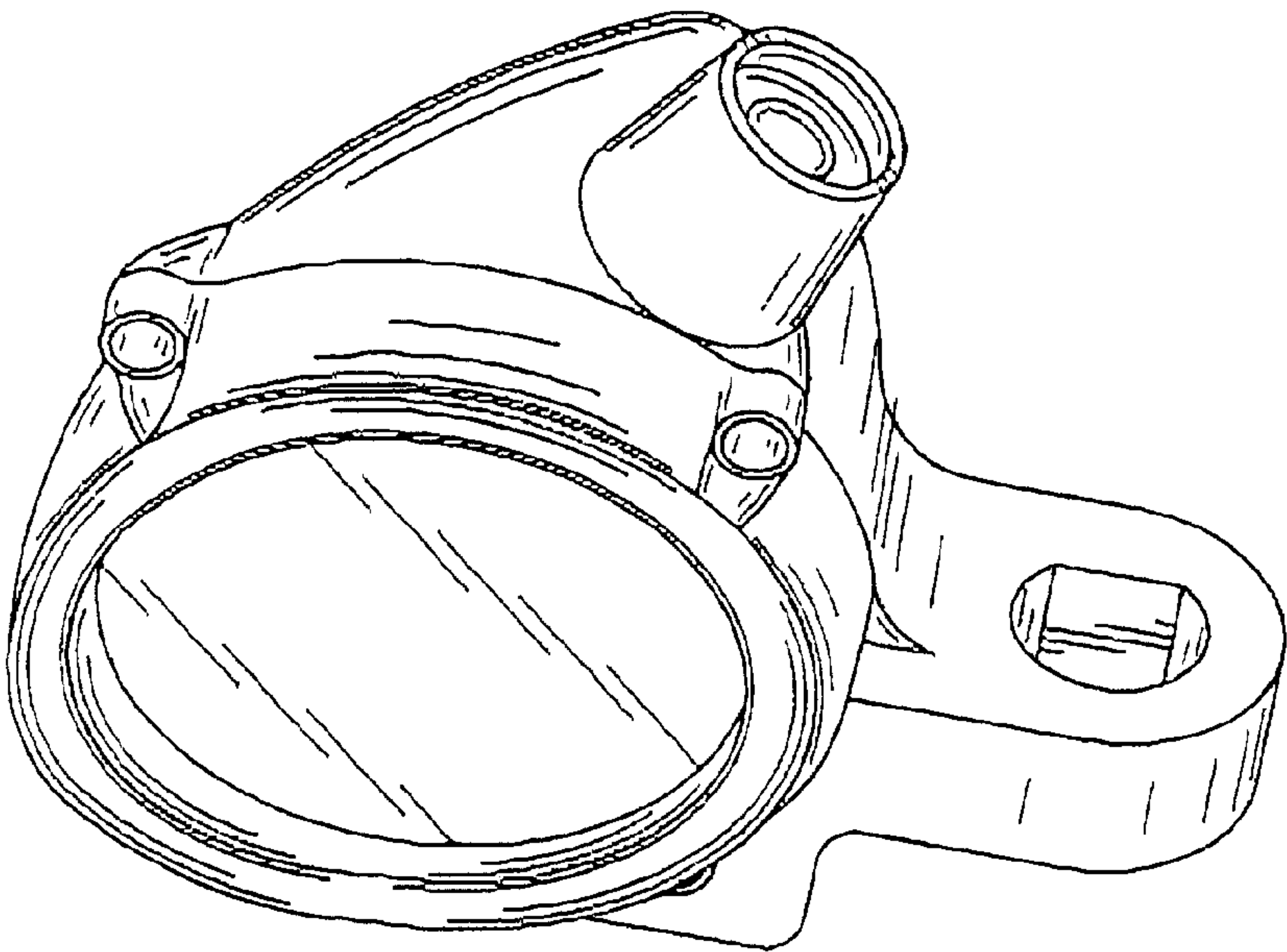

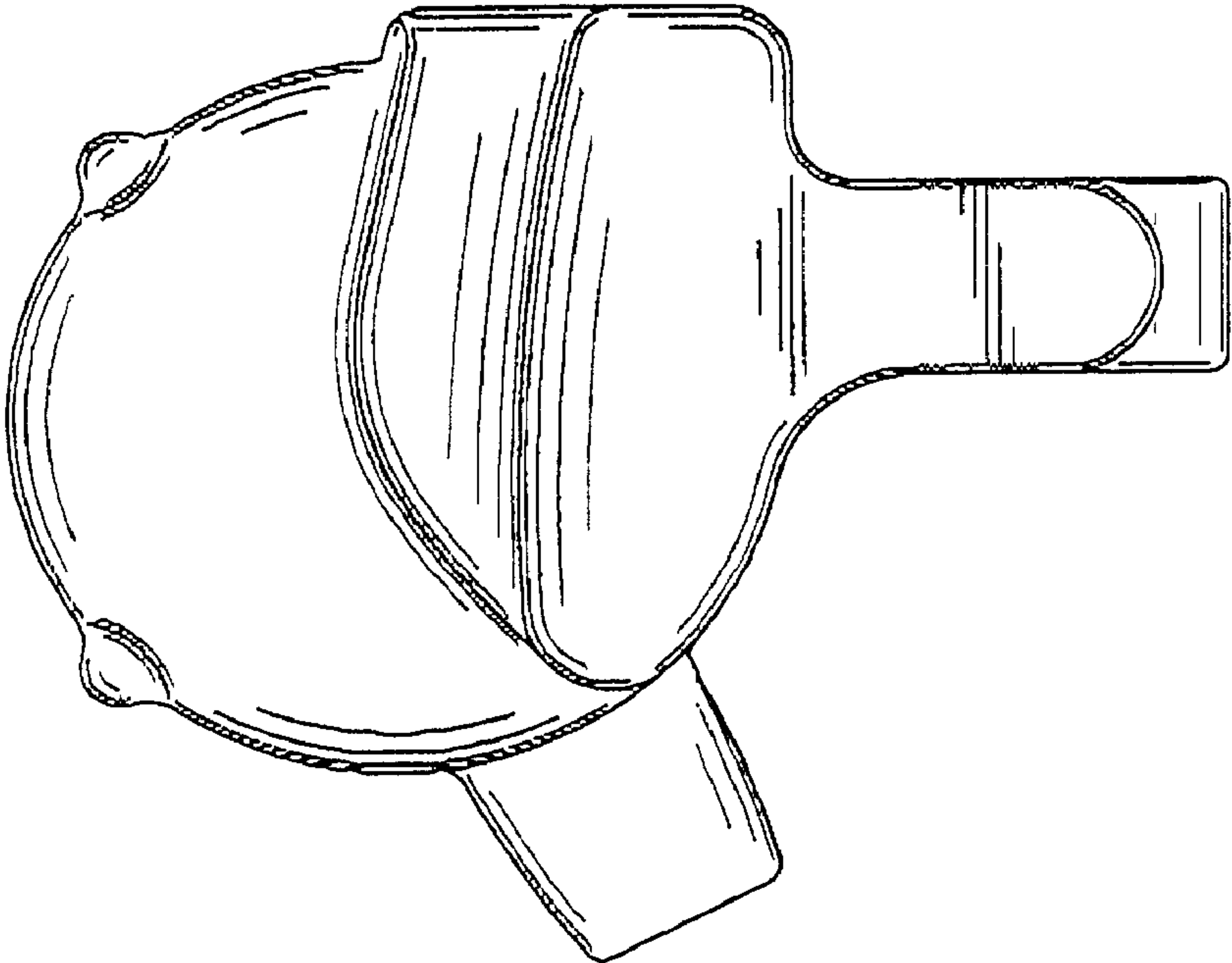

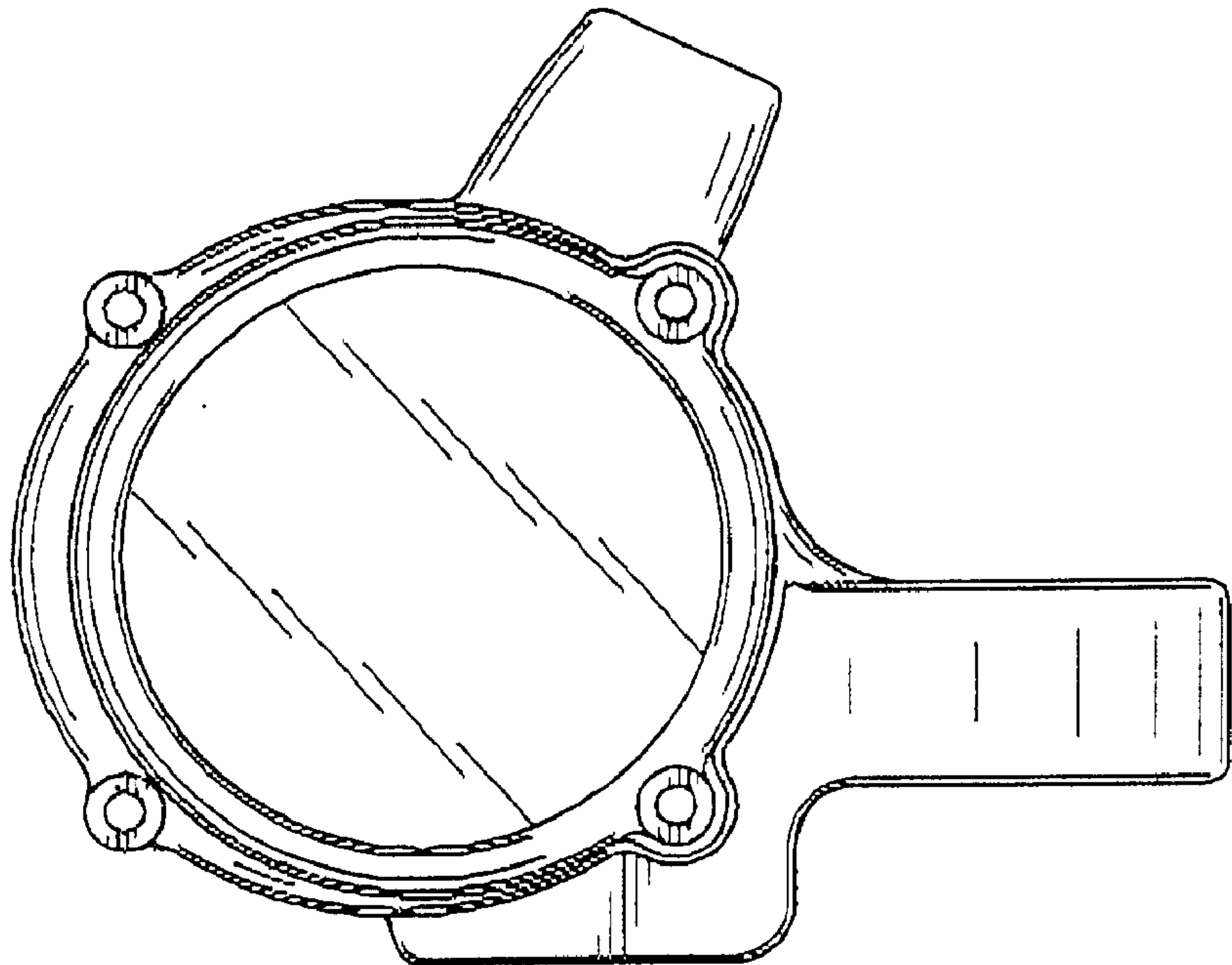

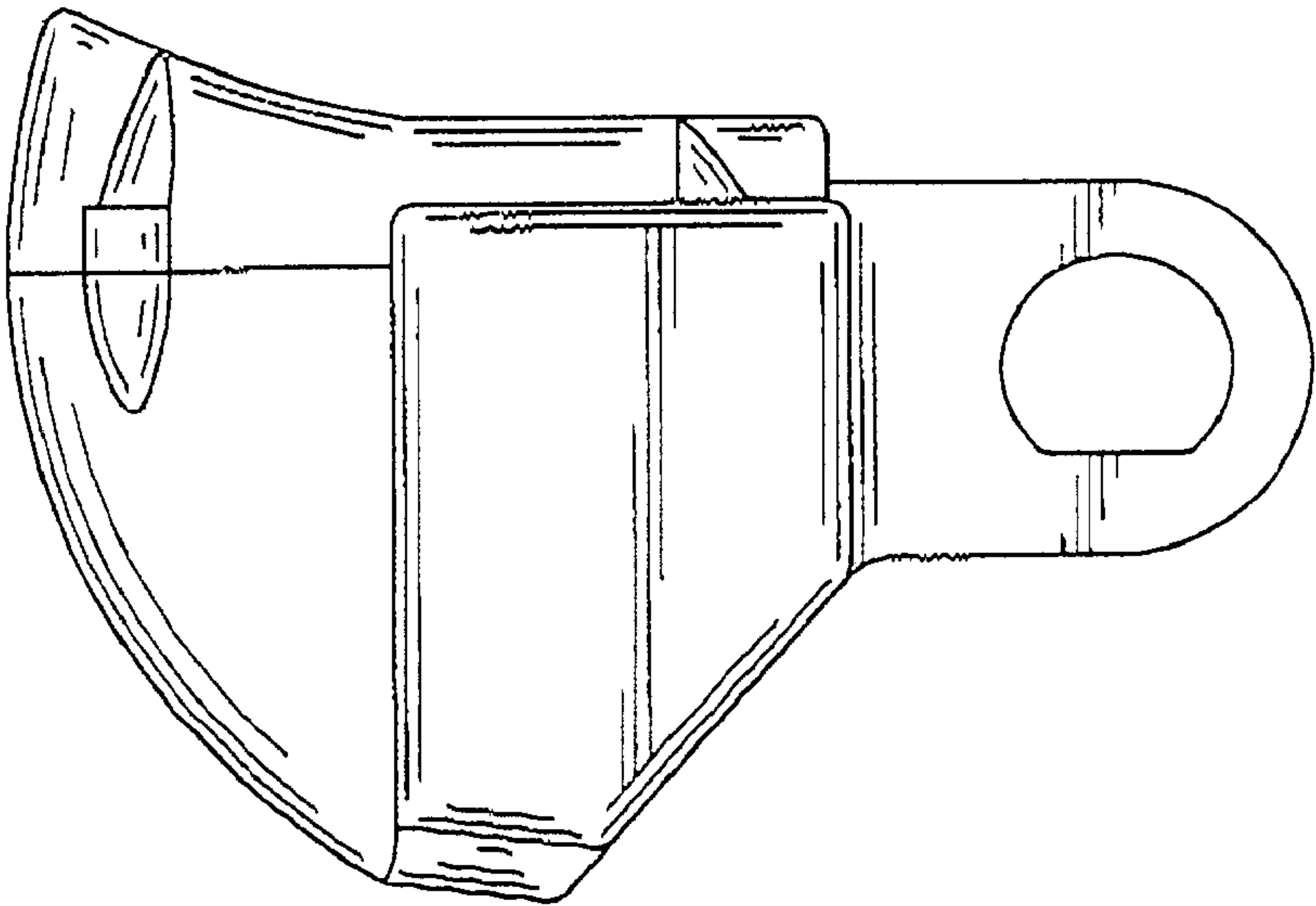

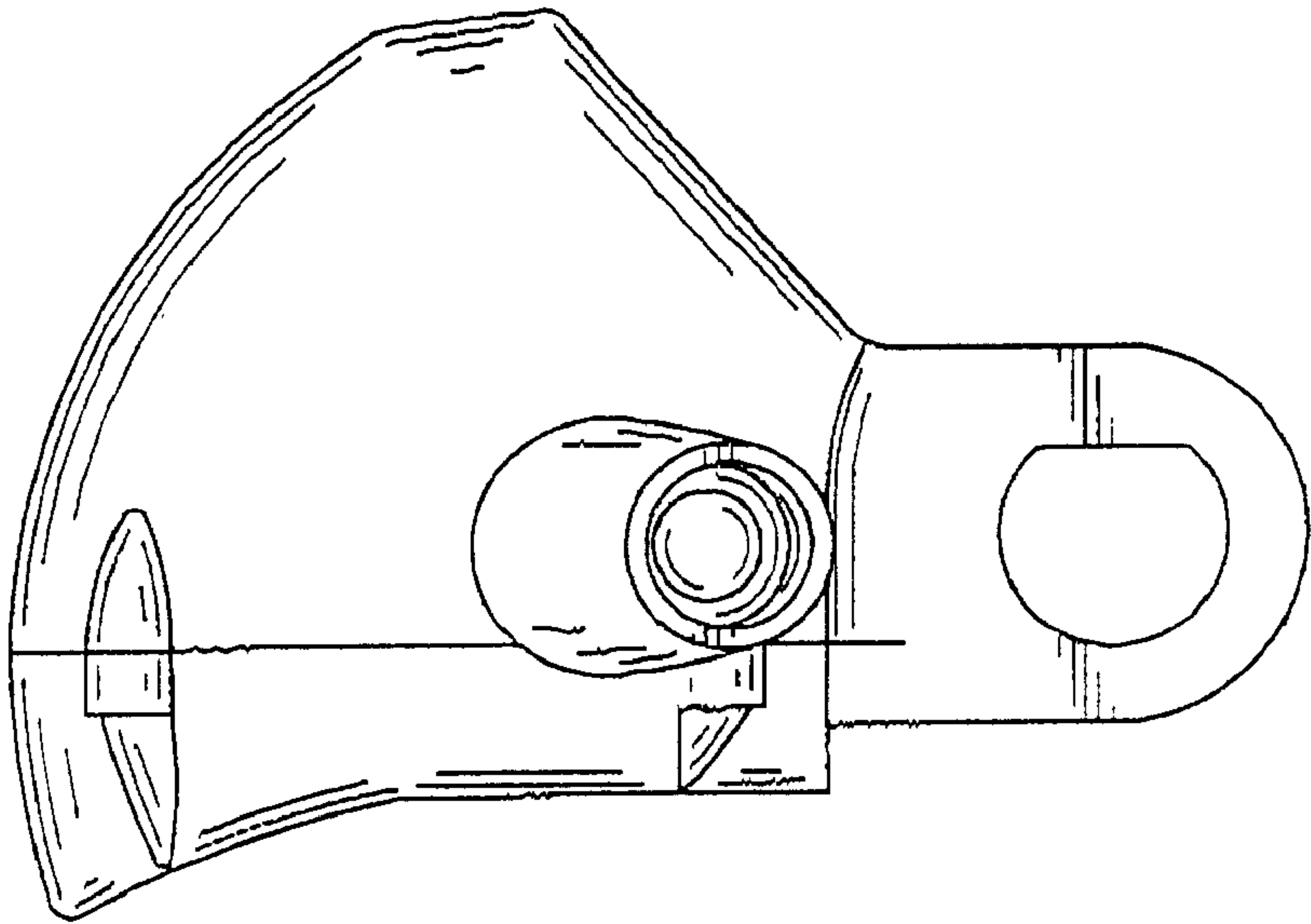

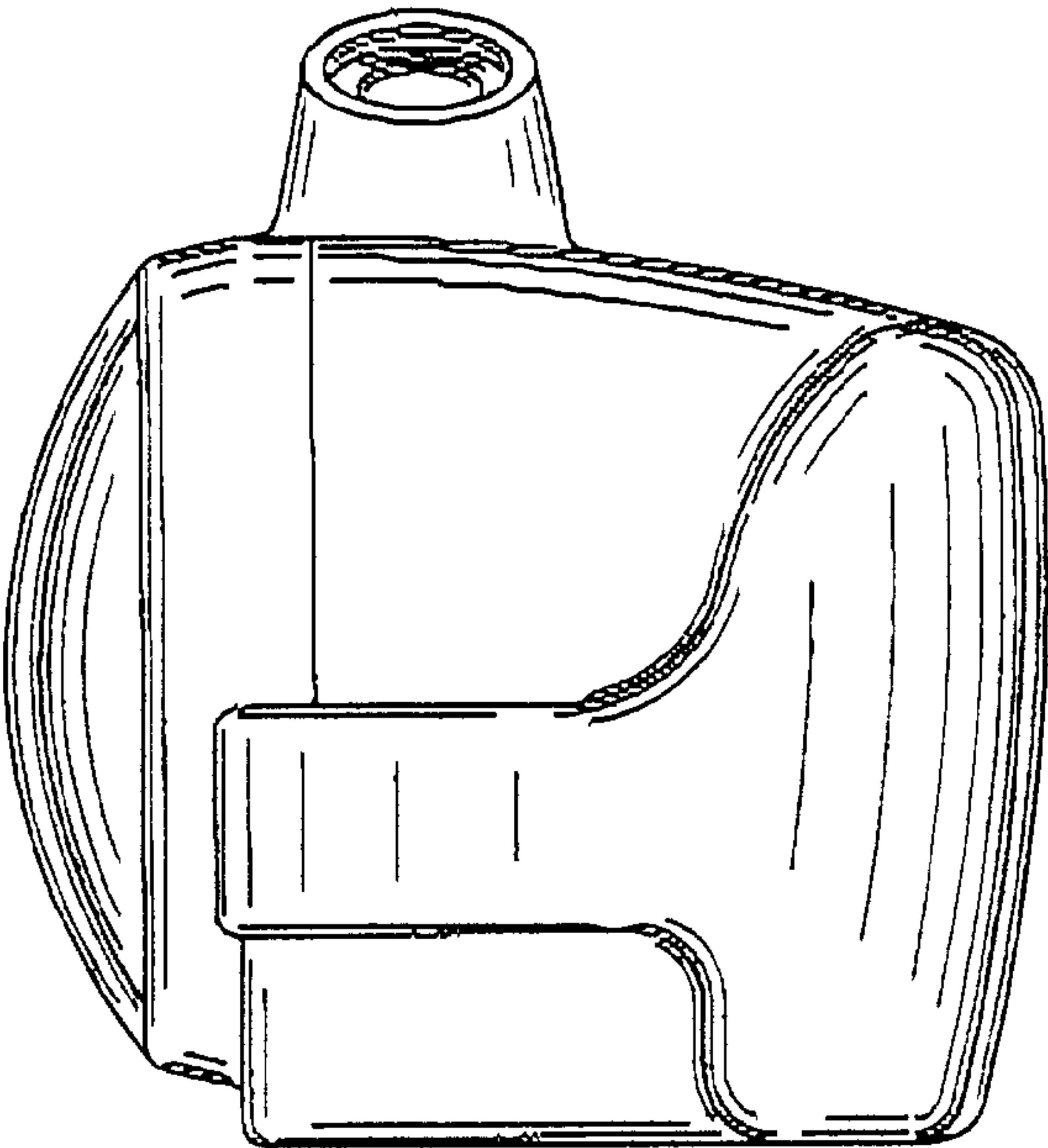

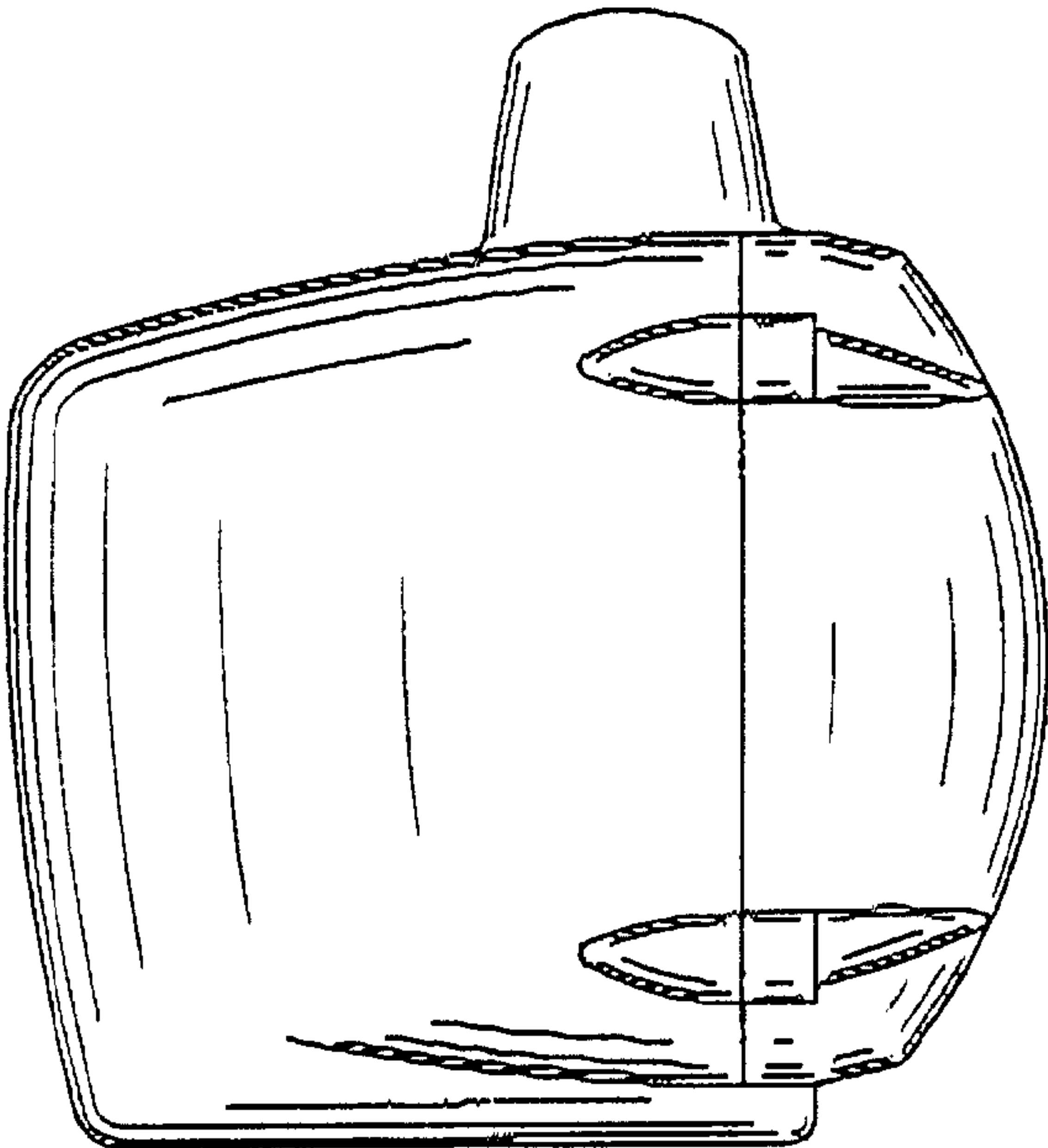
