DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of a power strip cable manager according to the present invention, with the body of the power strip, including the housing, outlets, power button, indicator lights, reset button, and bottom mounting elements, being shown in broken lines and thus not constituting a part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view of the power strip cable manager of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the power strip cable manager of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the power strip cable manager of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the power strip cable manager of FIG. 1.

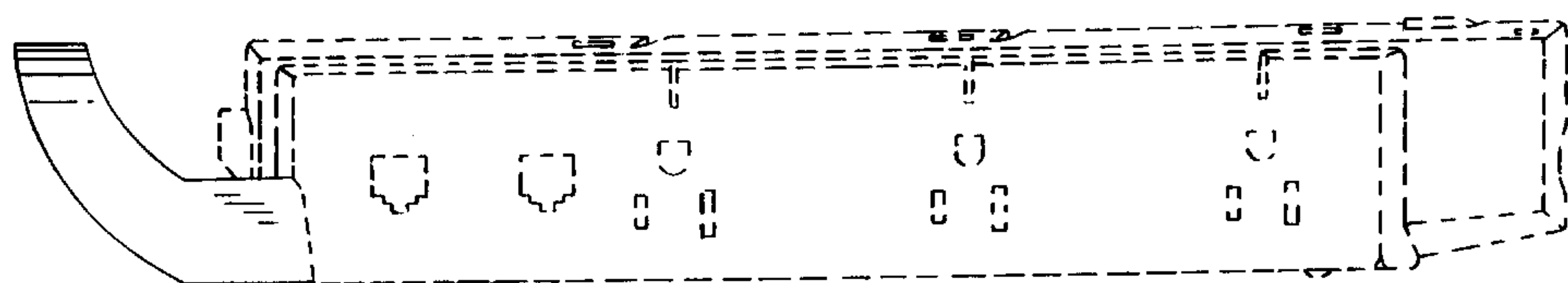
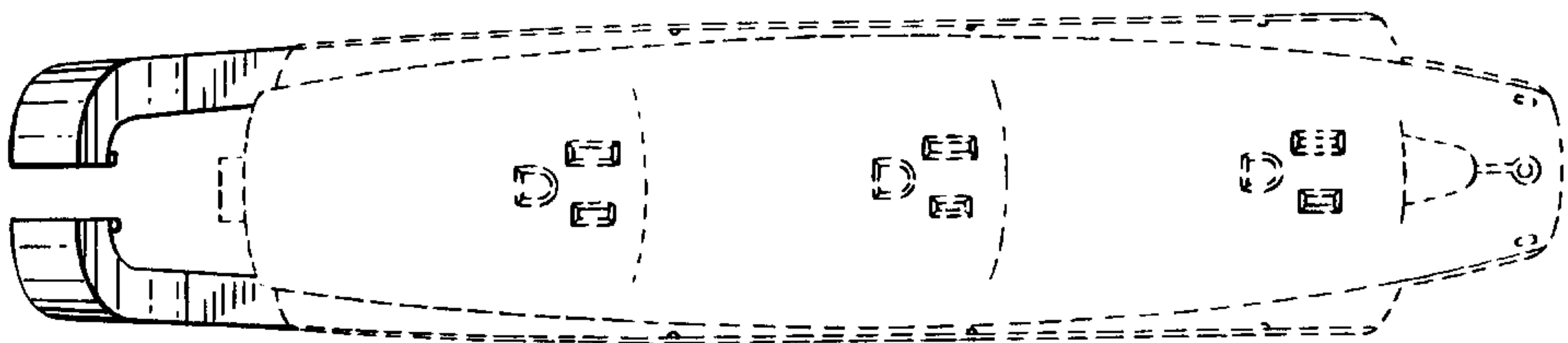

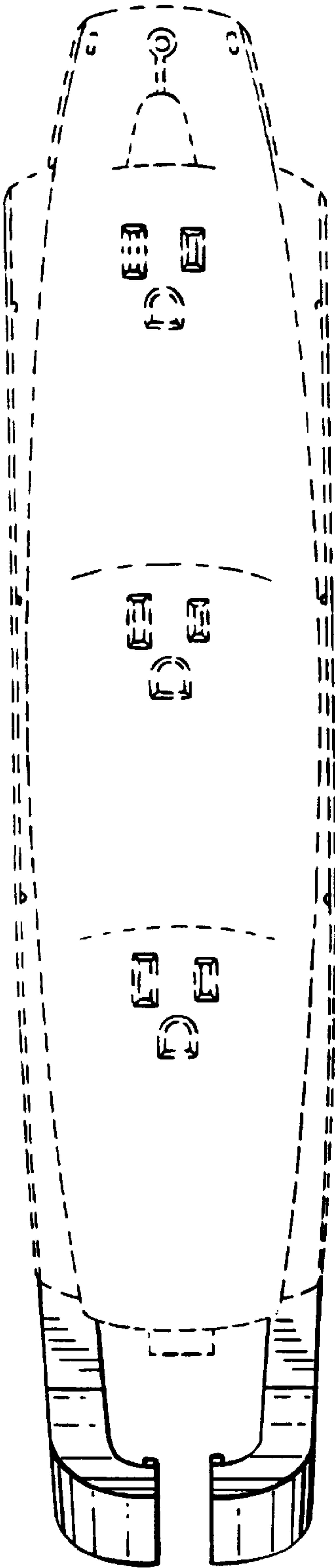

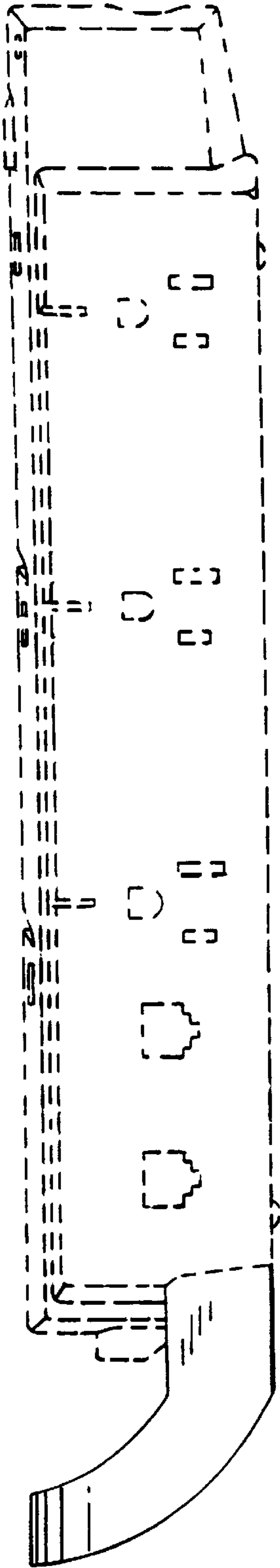

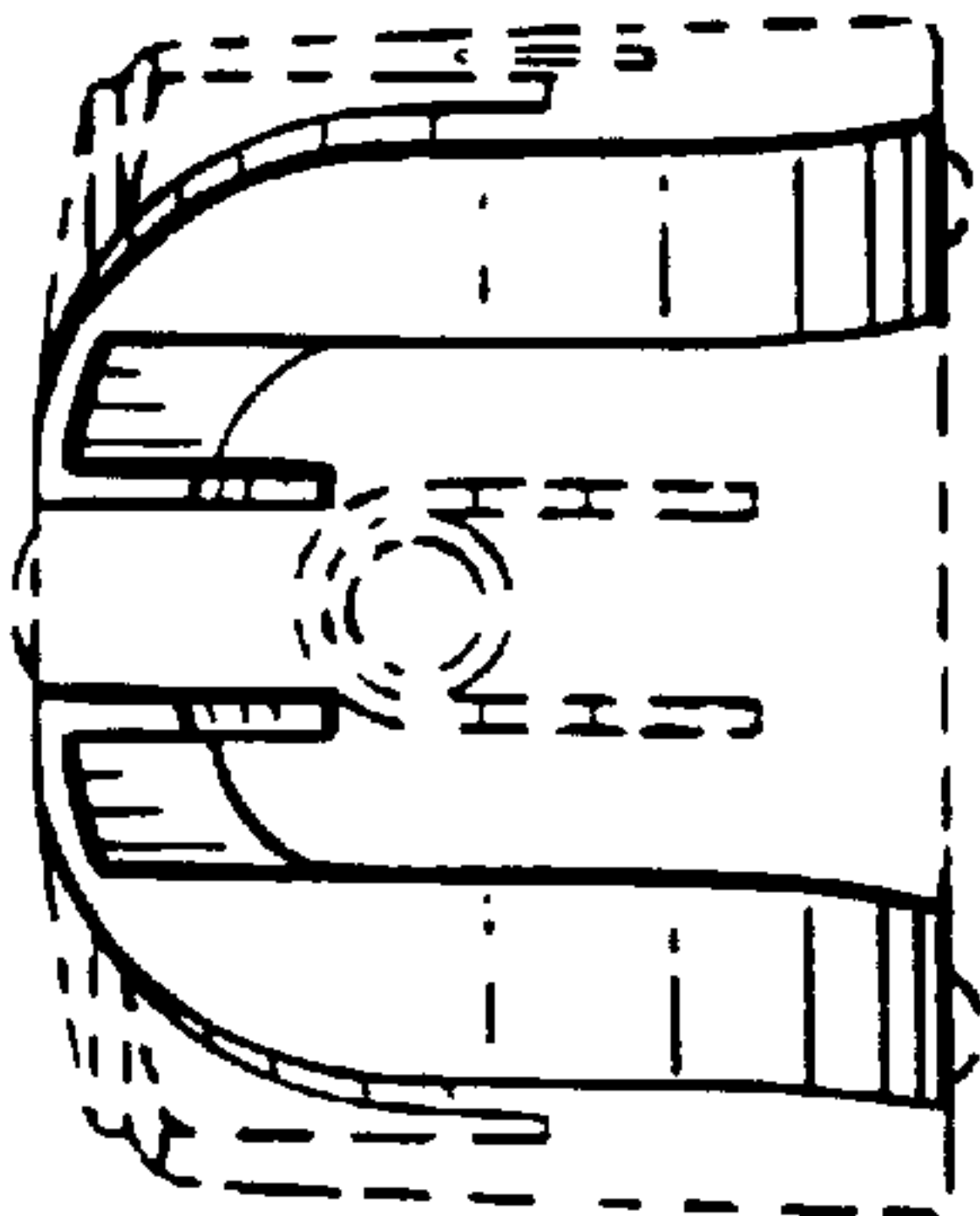

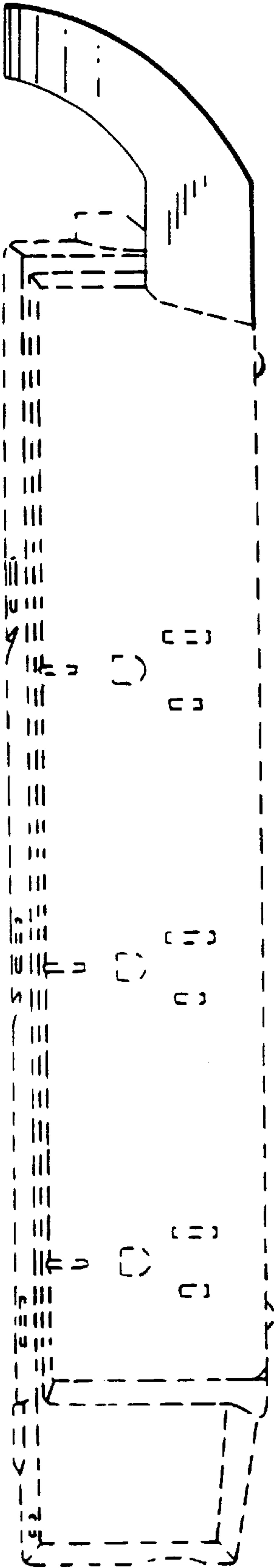
