FIG. 3 is a view of an inside side of the tennis shoe shown in FIGS. 1-2;

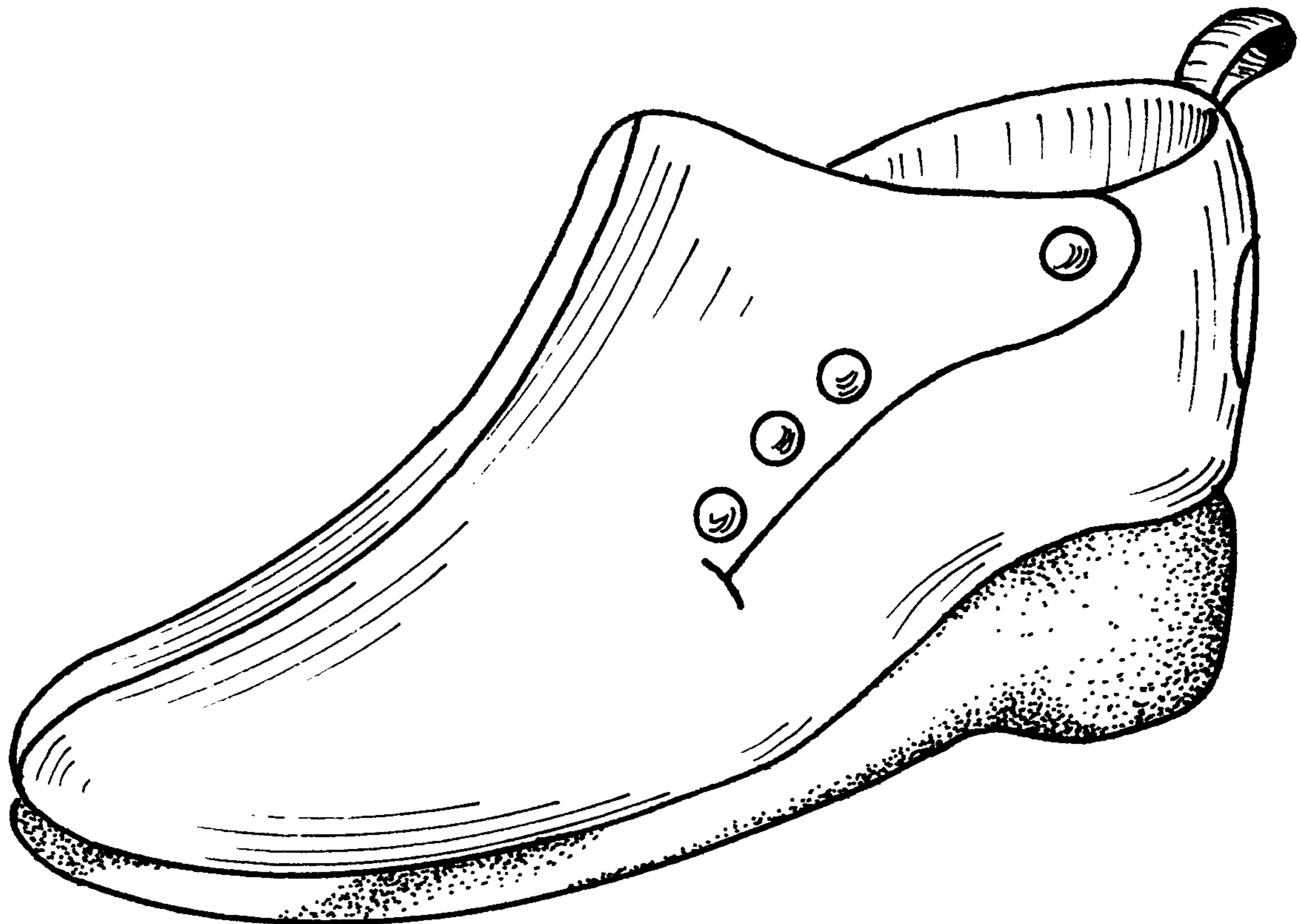
FIG. 4 is a view of an outside view of the tennis shoe shown in FIGS. 1-3;

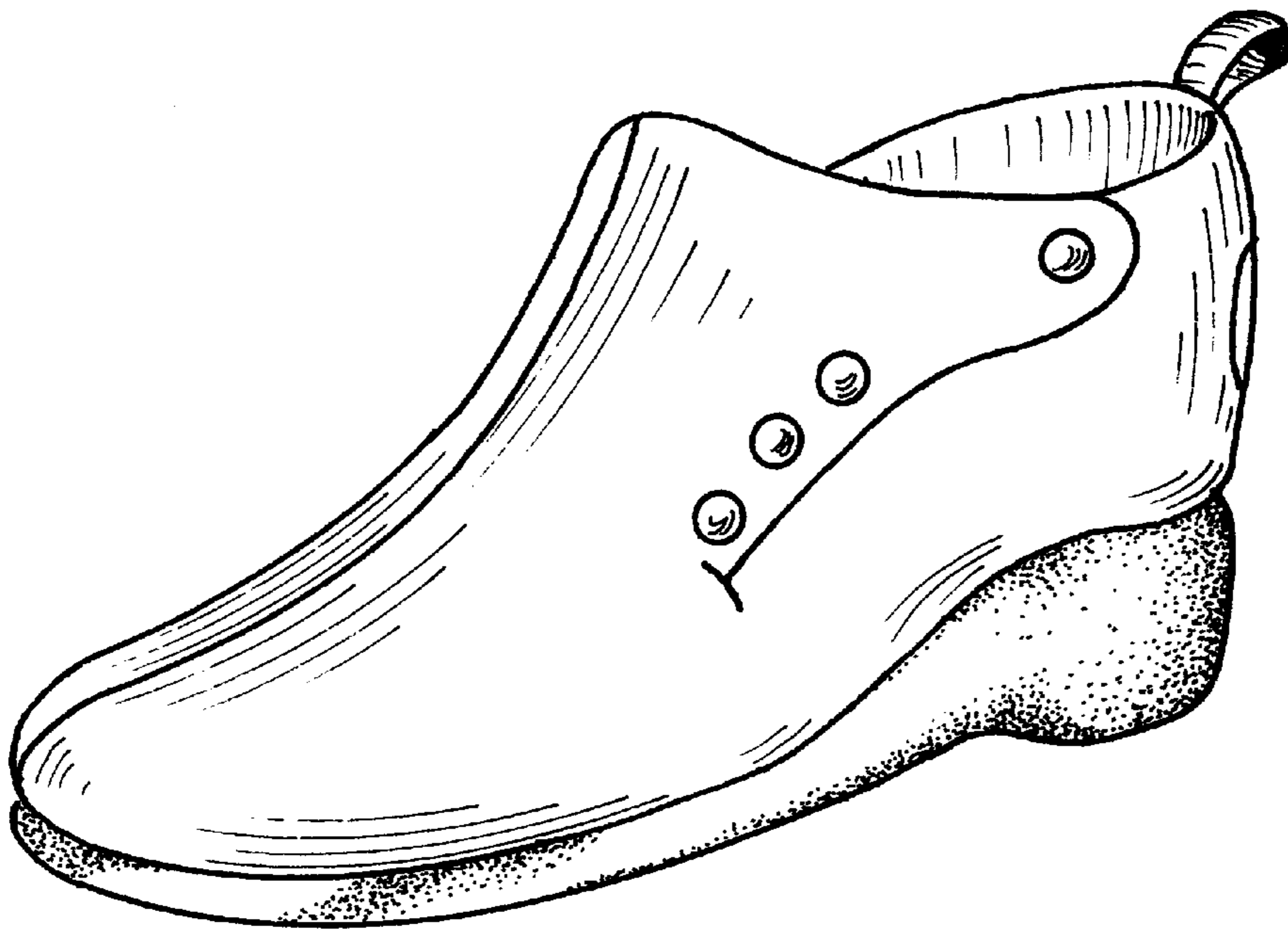
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the tennis shoe shown in FIGS. 1-4;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the tennis shoe shown in FIGS. 1-5; and,

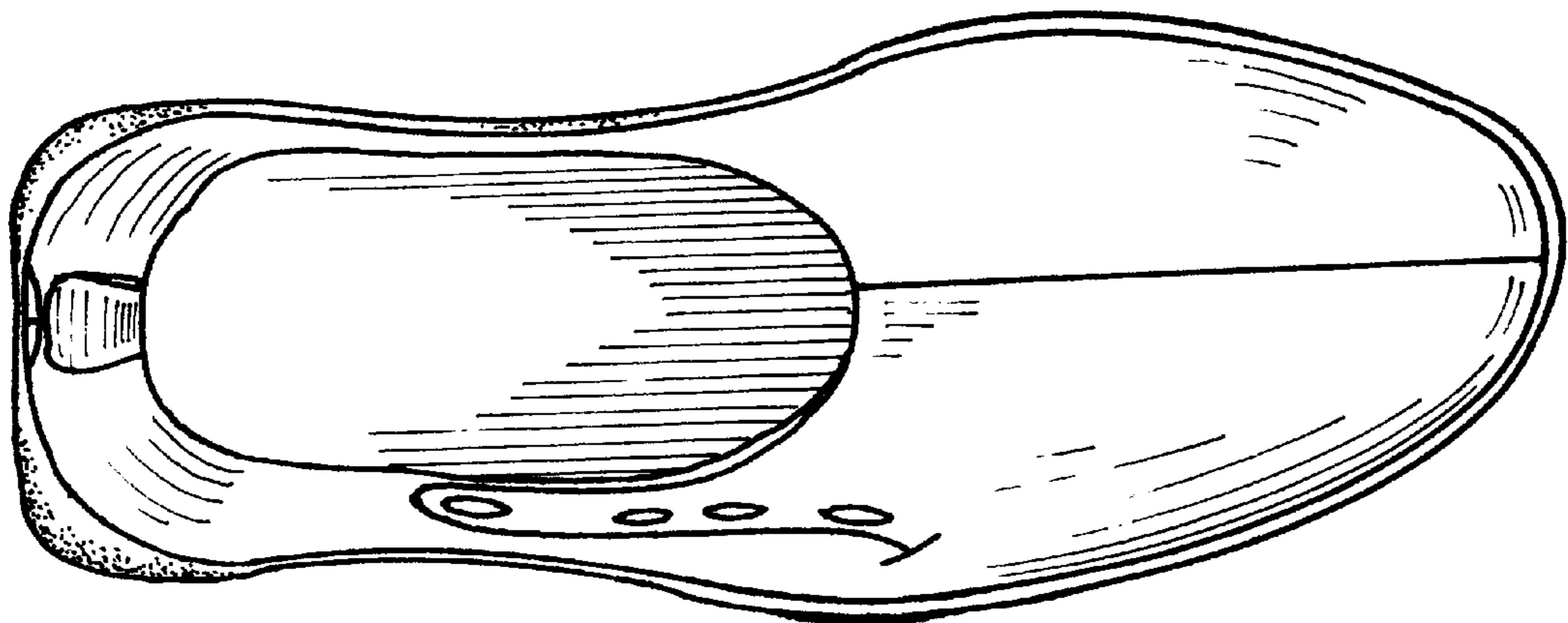
FIG. 7 is a back view of the tennis shoe shown in FIGS. 1-6.

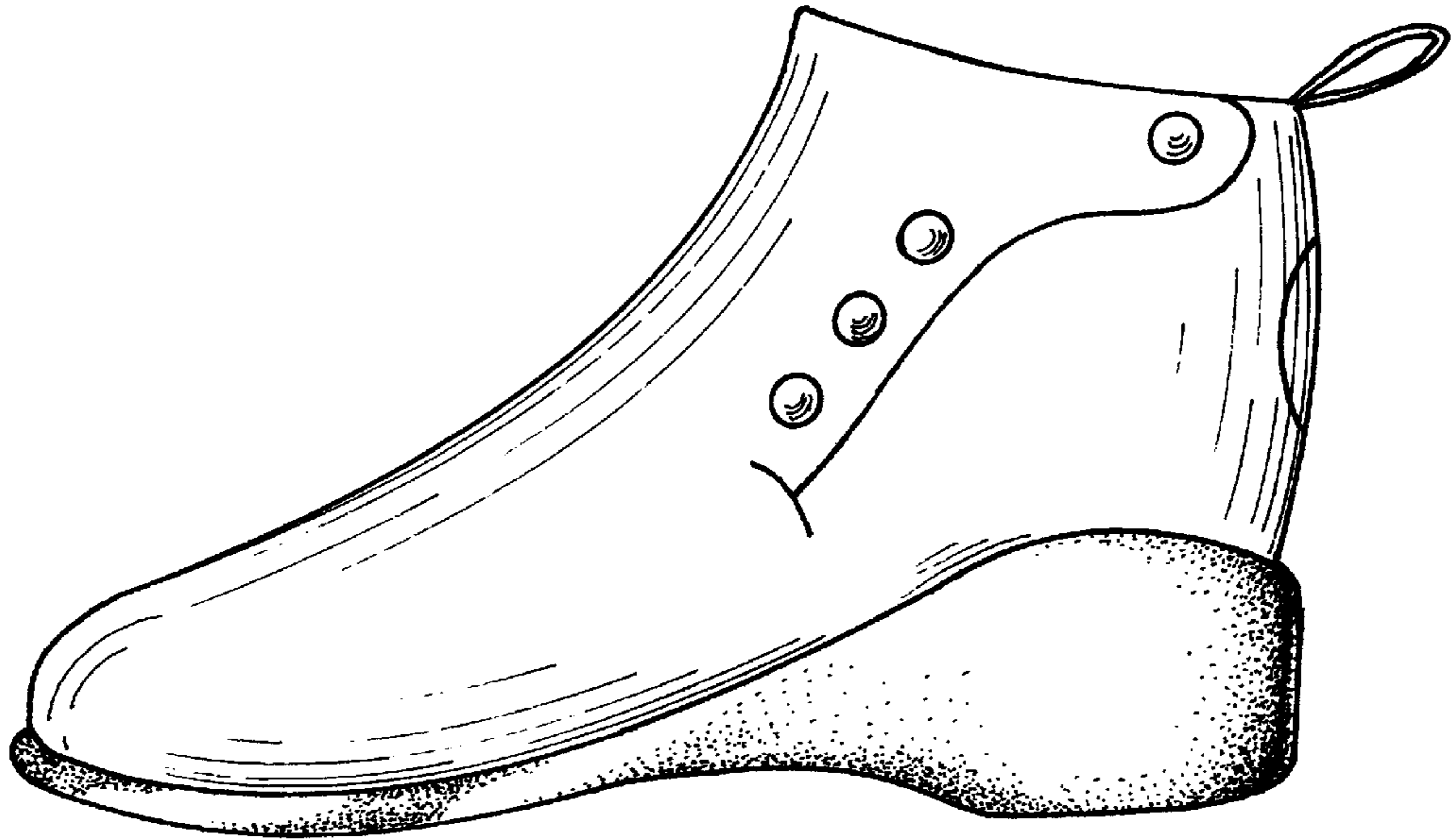

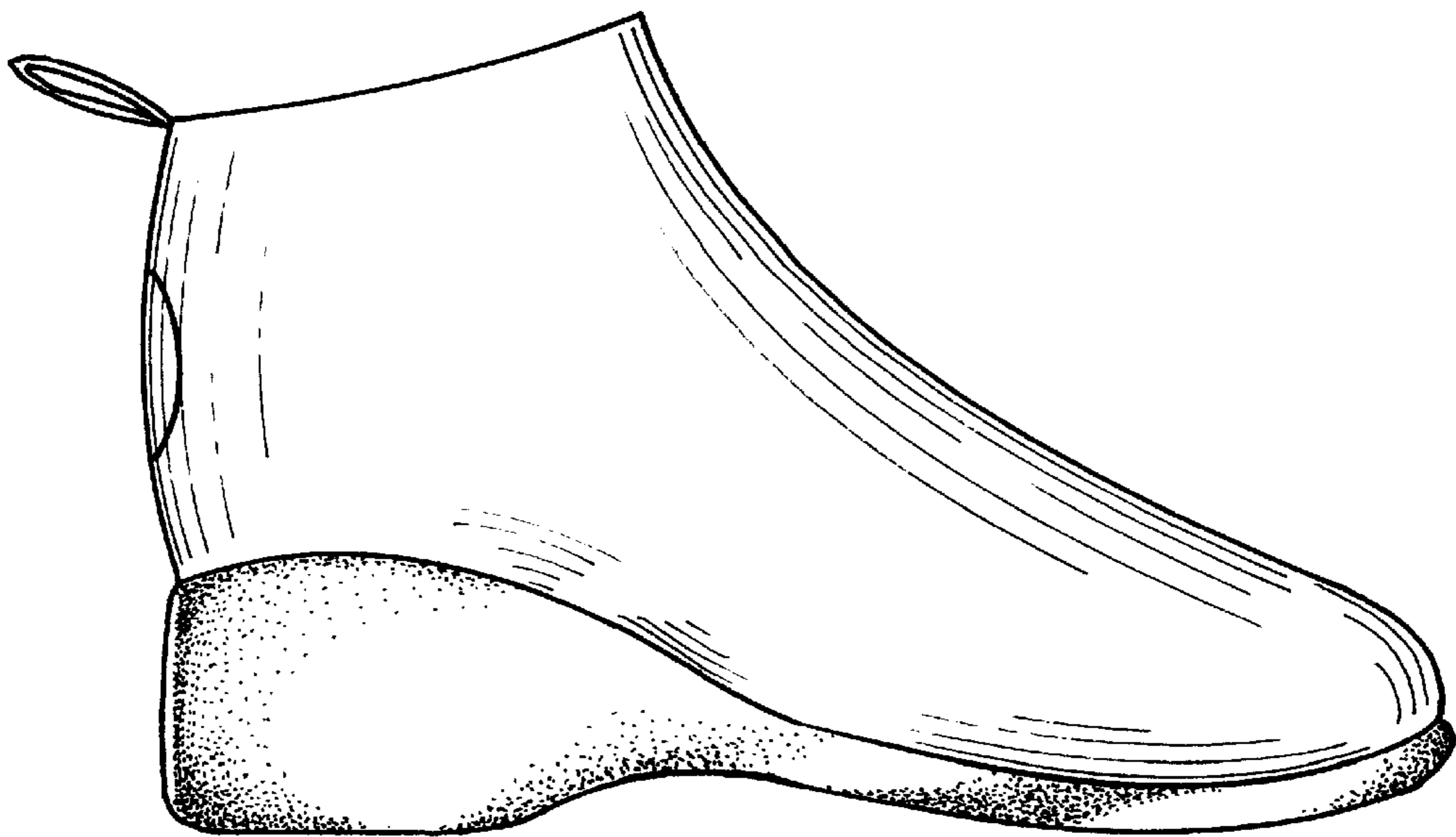

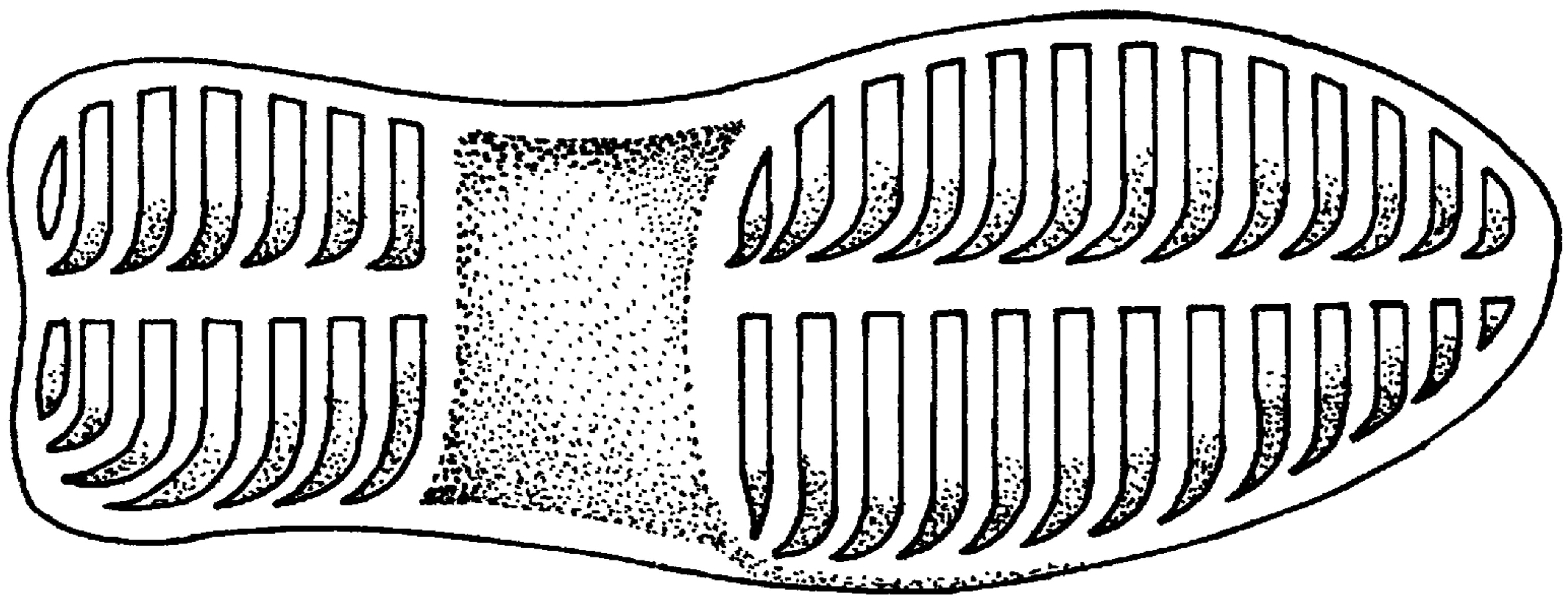

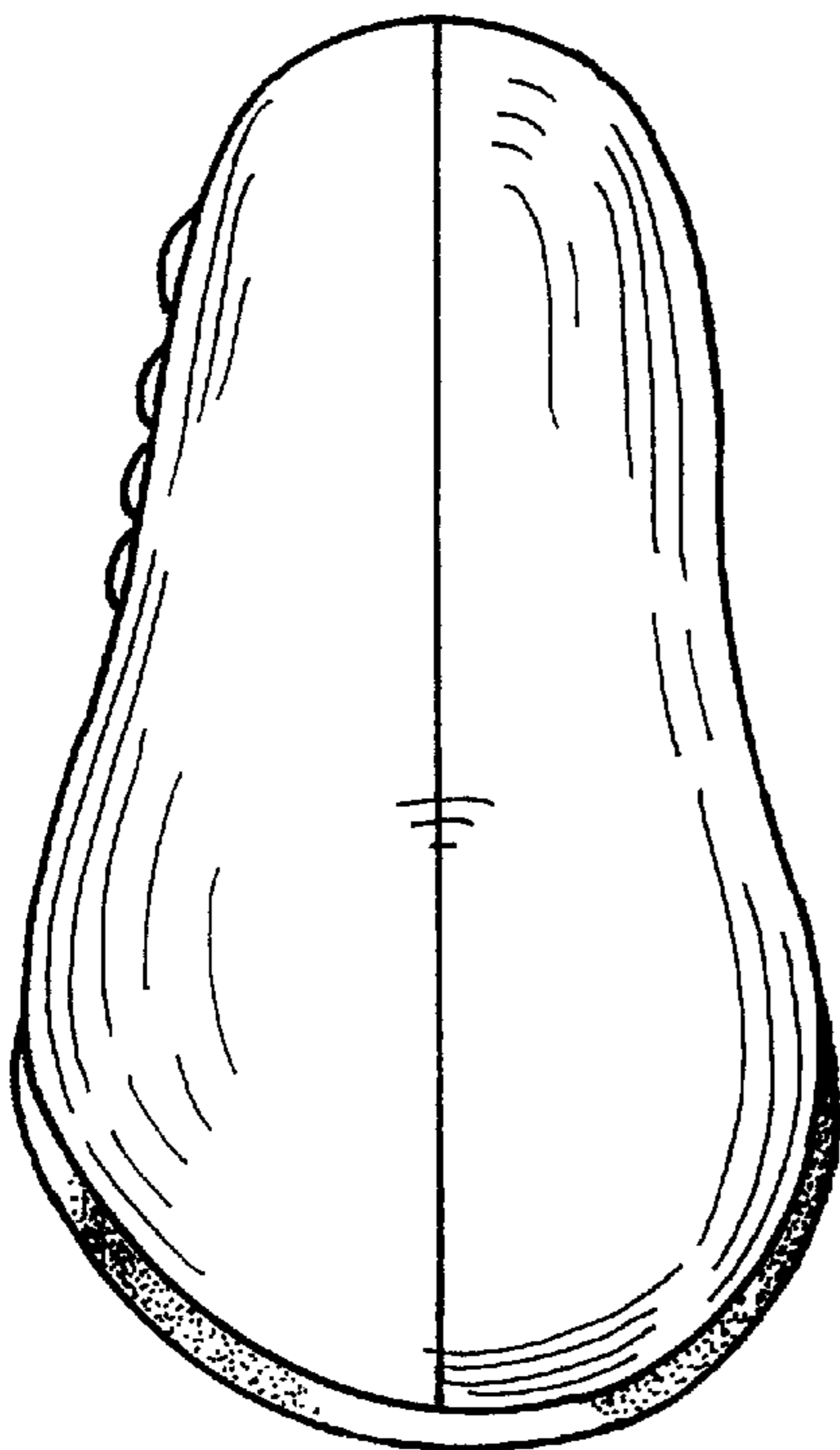

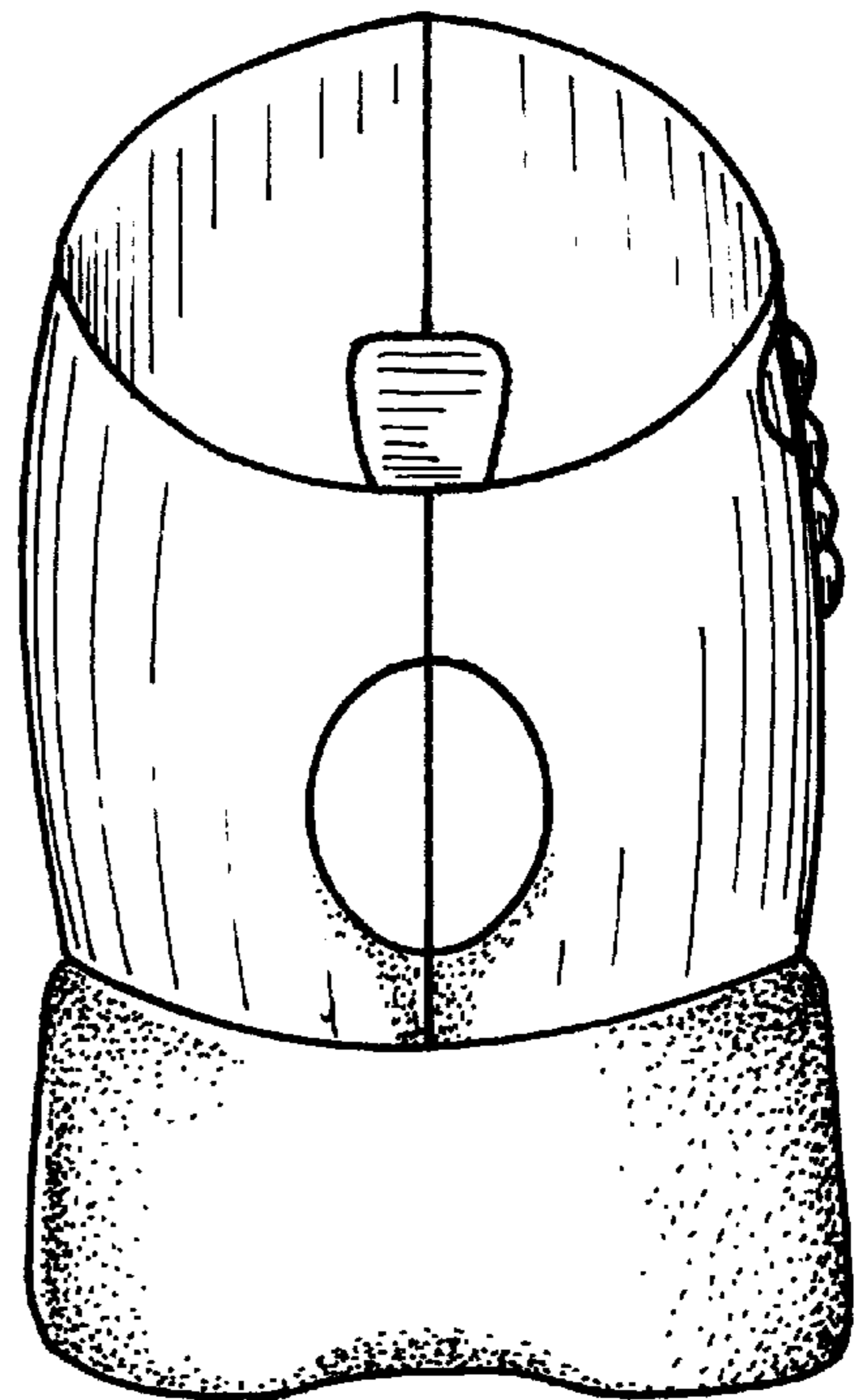
