FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, it being understood that the right side is a mirror image of the side shown except for the absence of the lever depicted in broken lines.

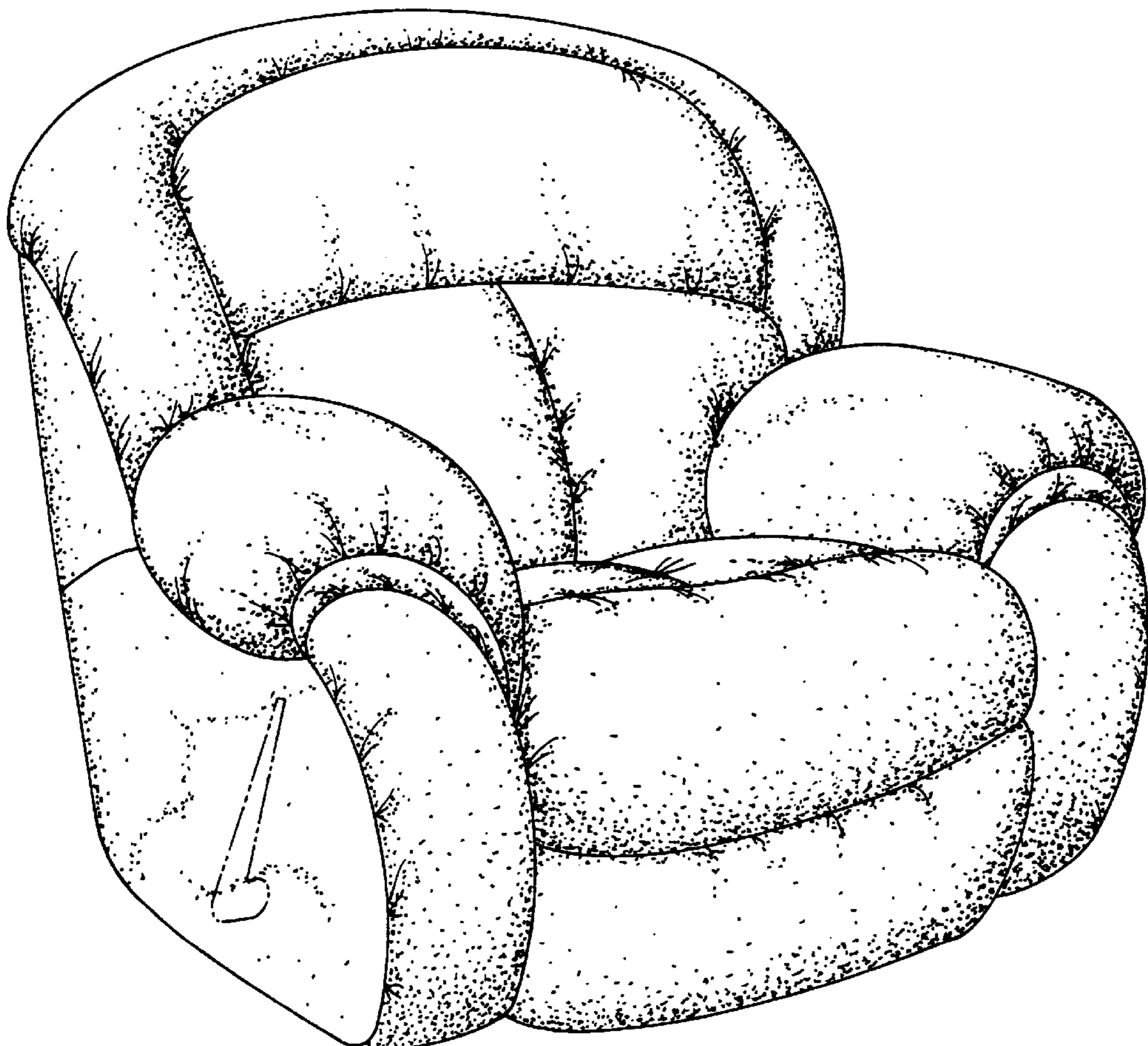

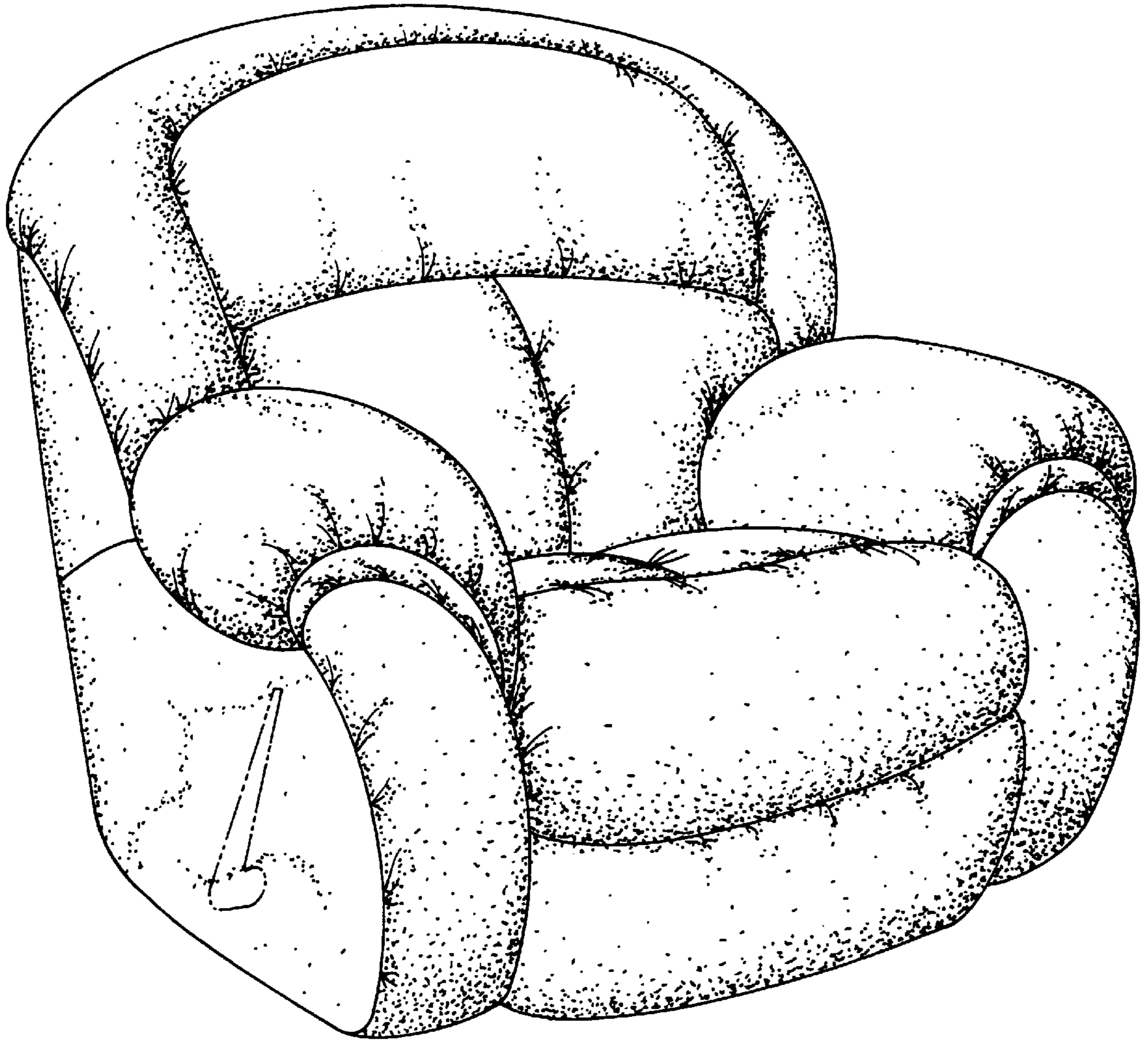

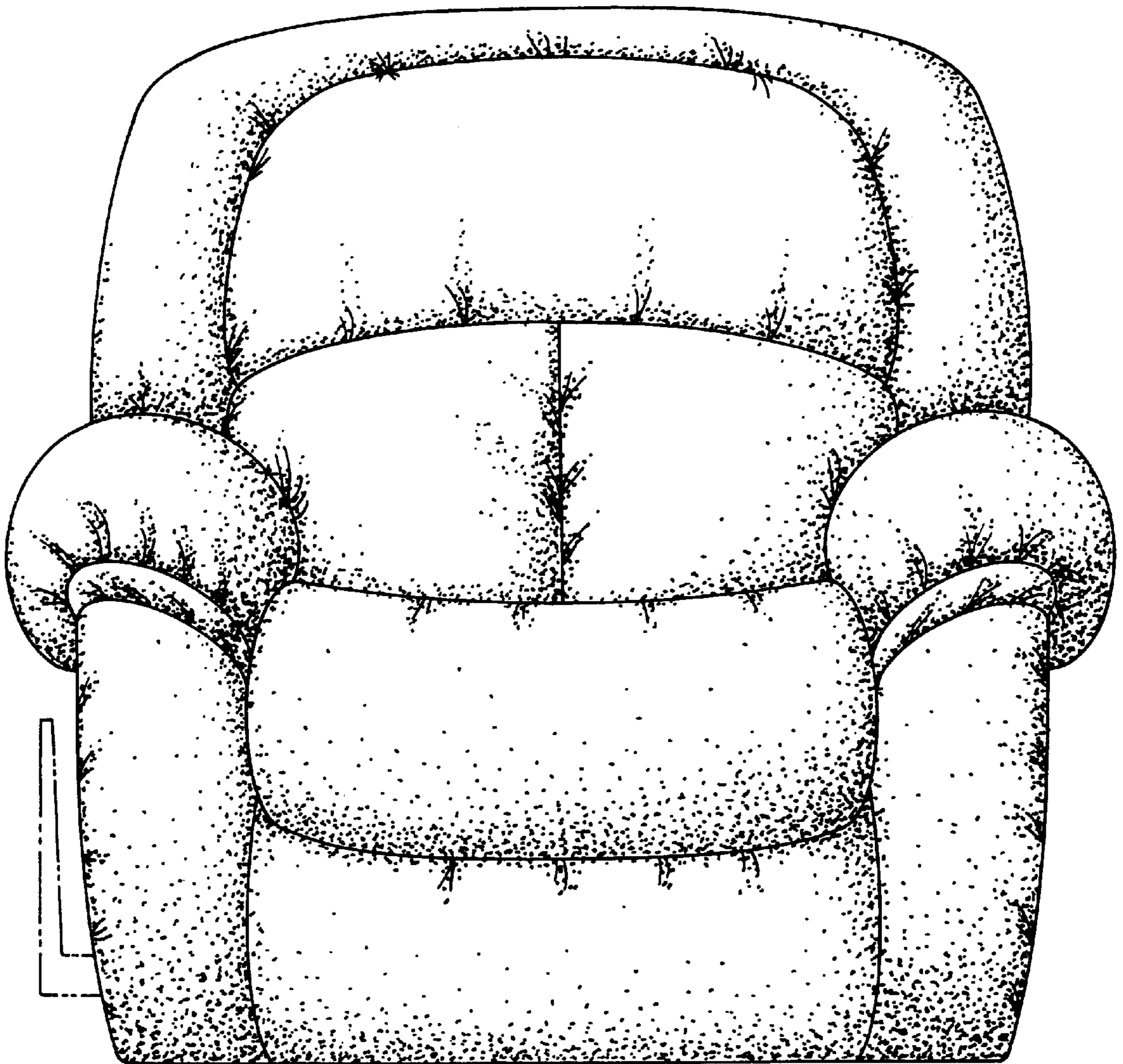

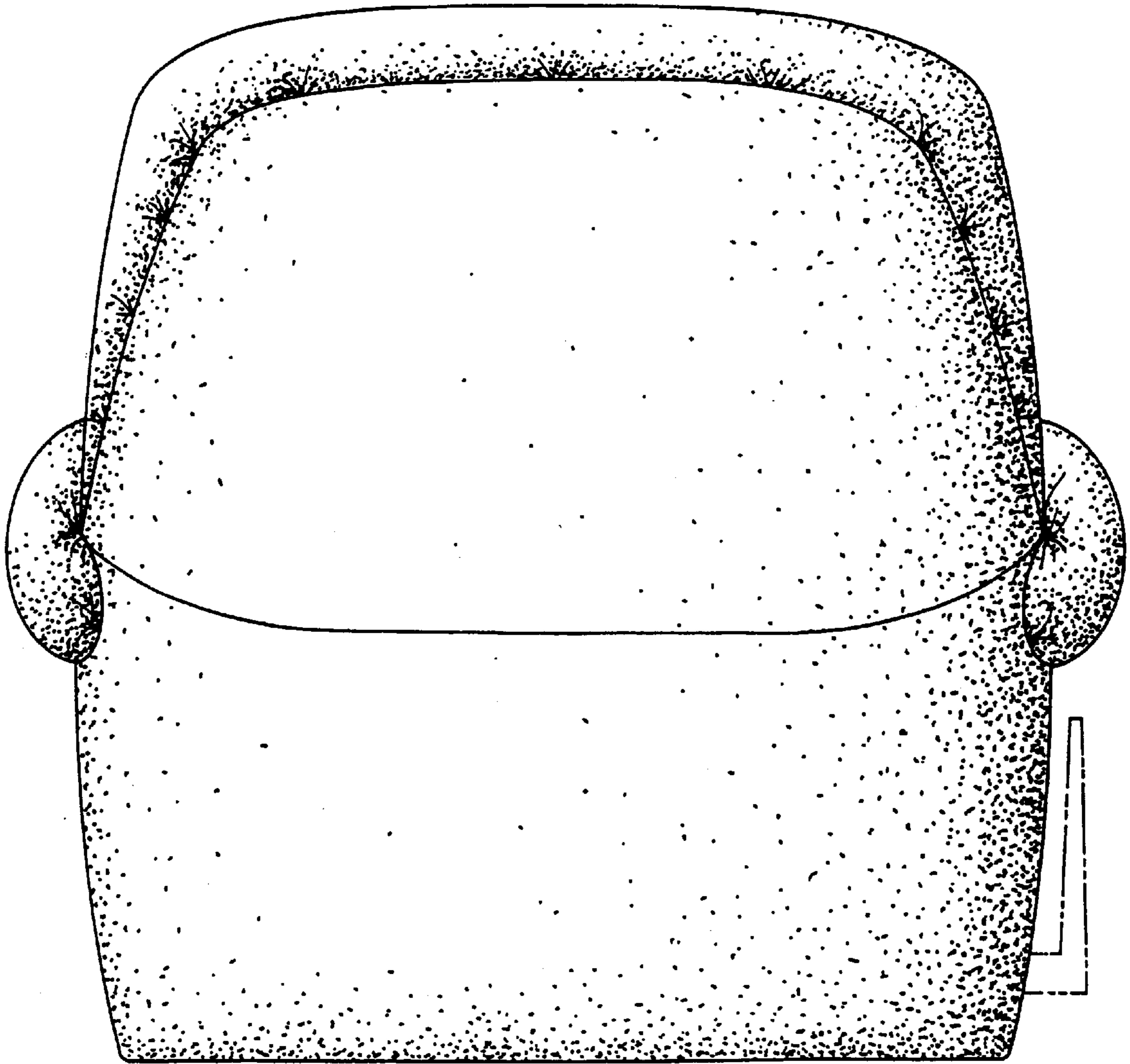

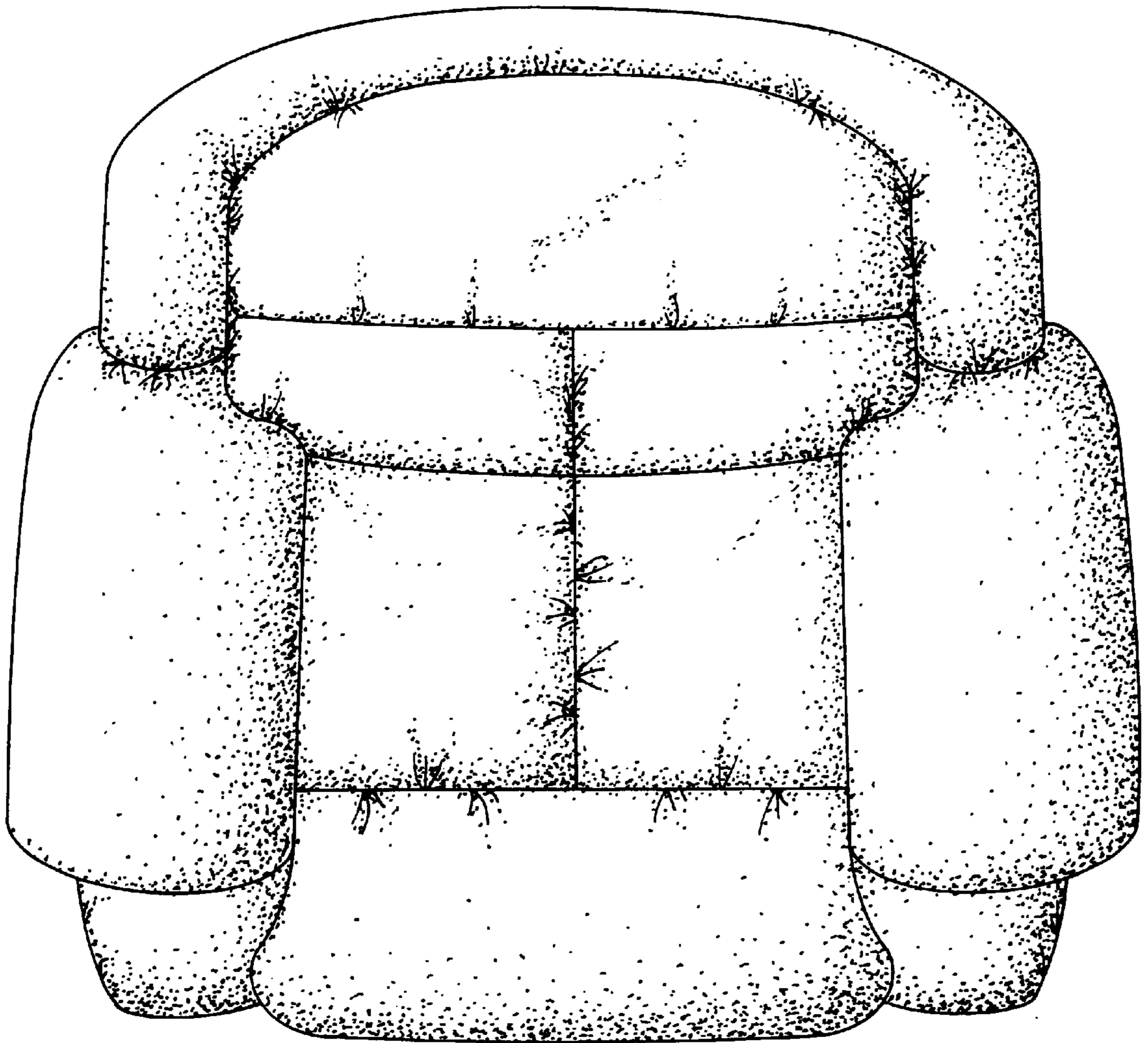

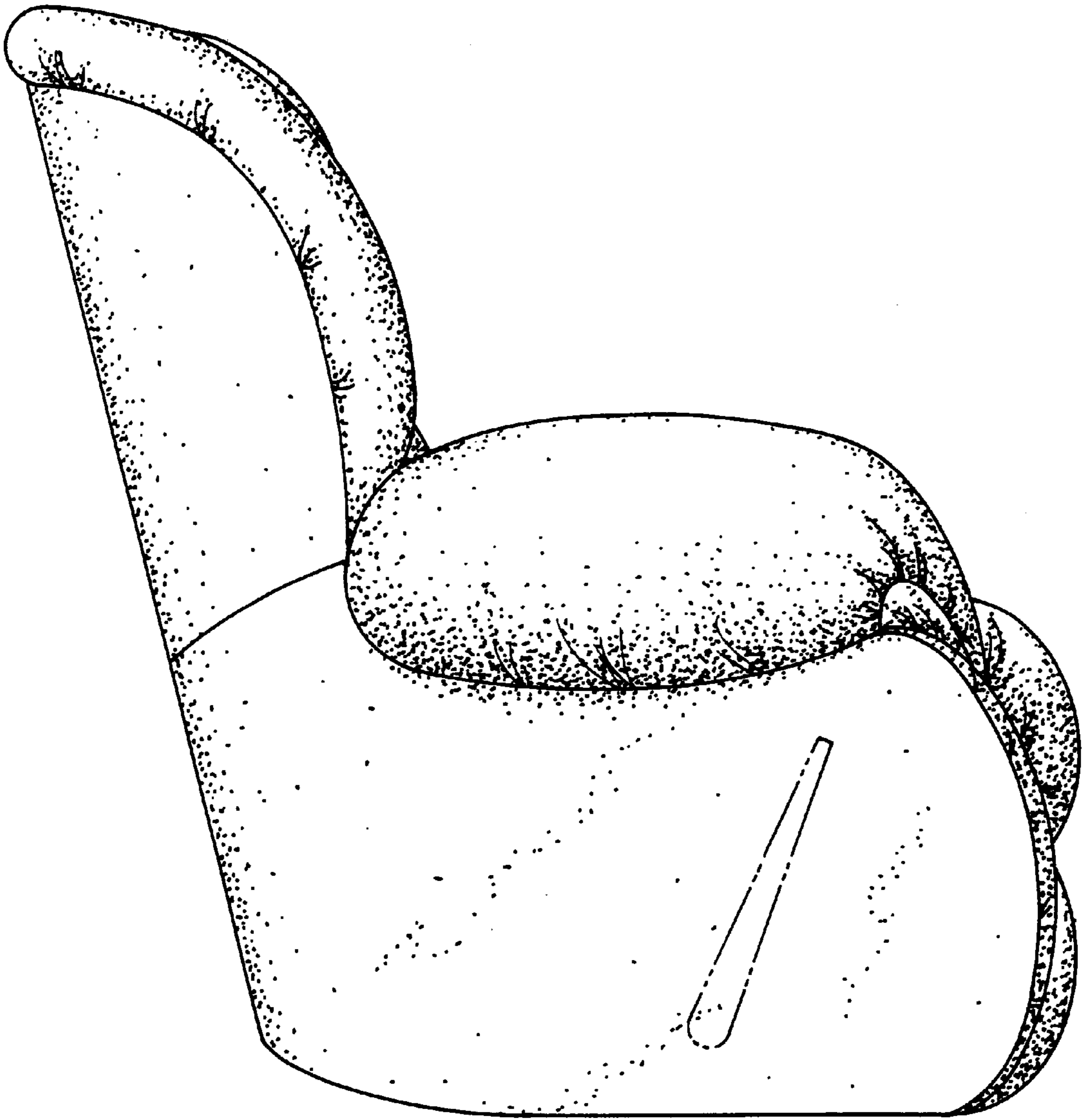
