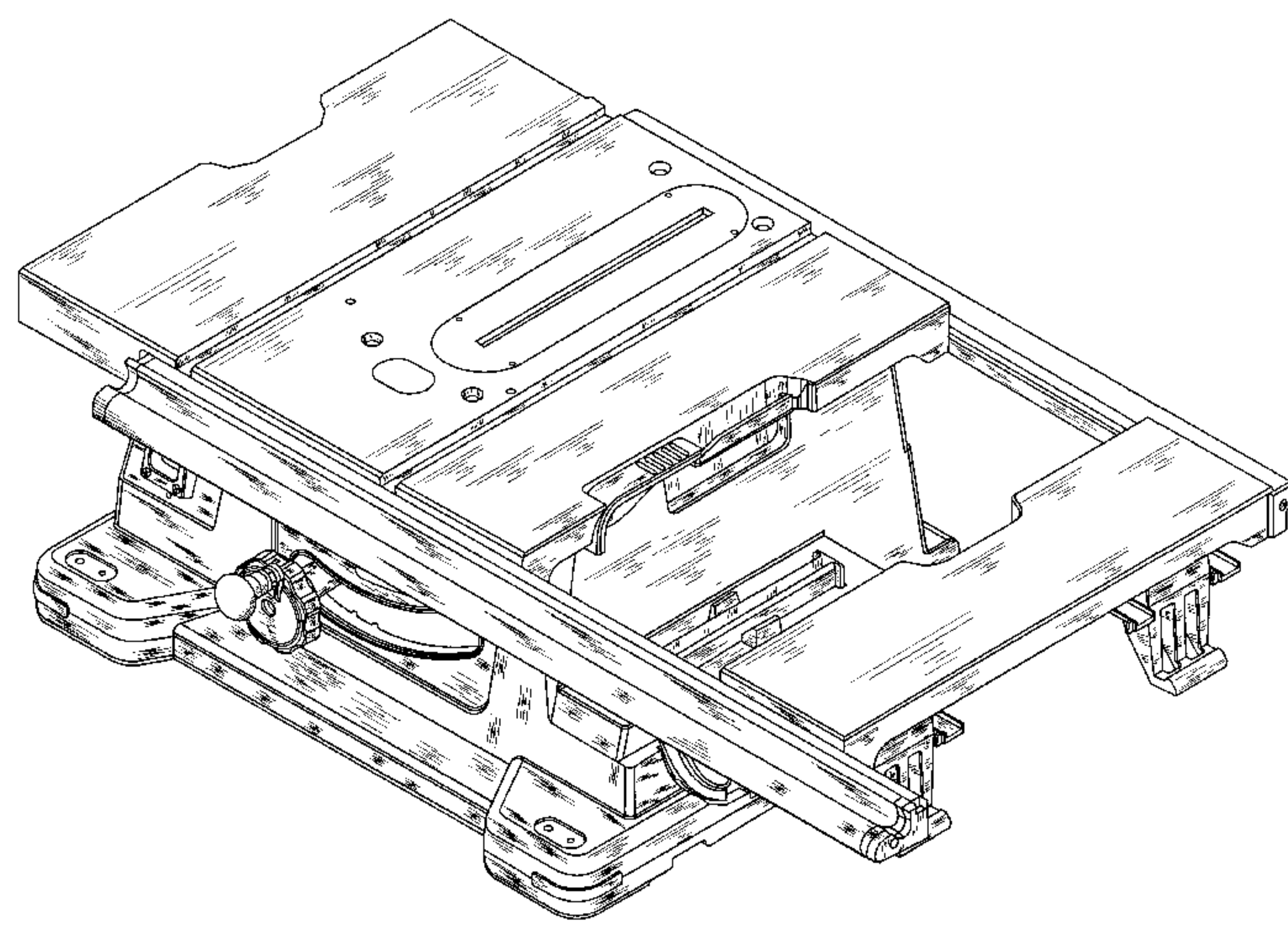
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the jobsite table saw, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view;

FIG. 5 is a left side view;
FIG. 6 is a front view; and,
FIG. 7 is a rear view.
The surface shading on the illustrative jobsite table saw is intended only to show the character and contour of the surfaces and not surface indicia.

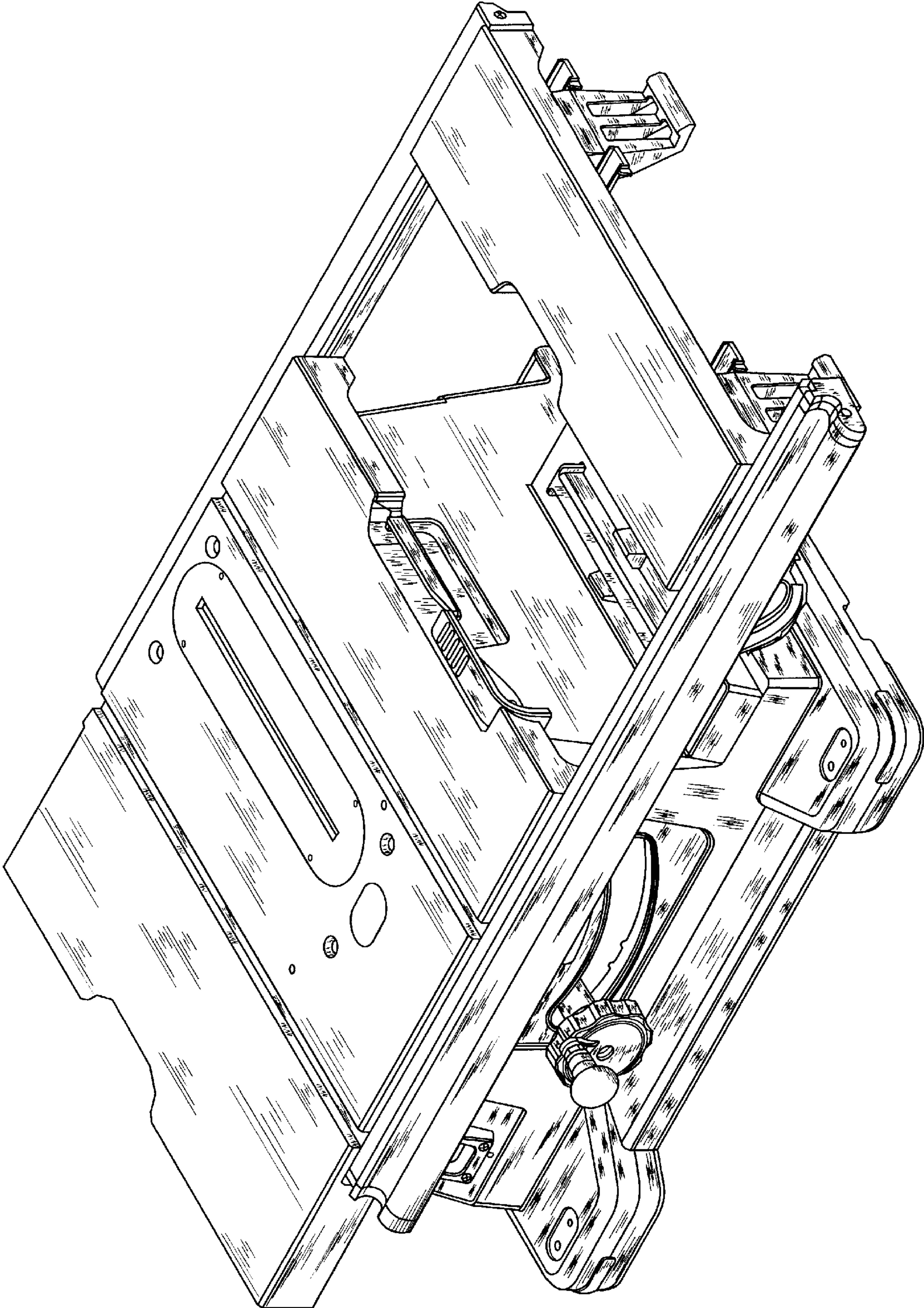

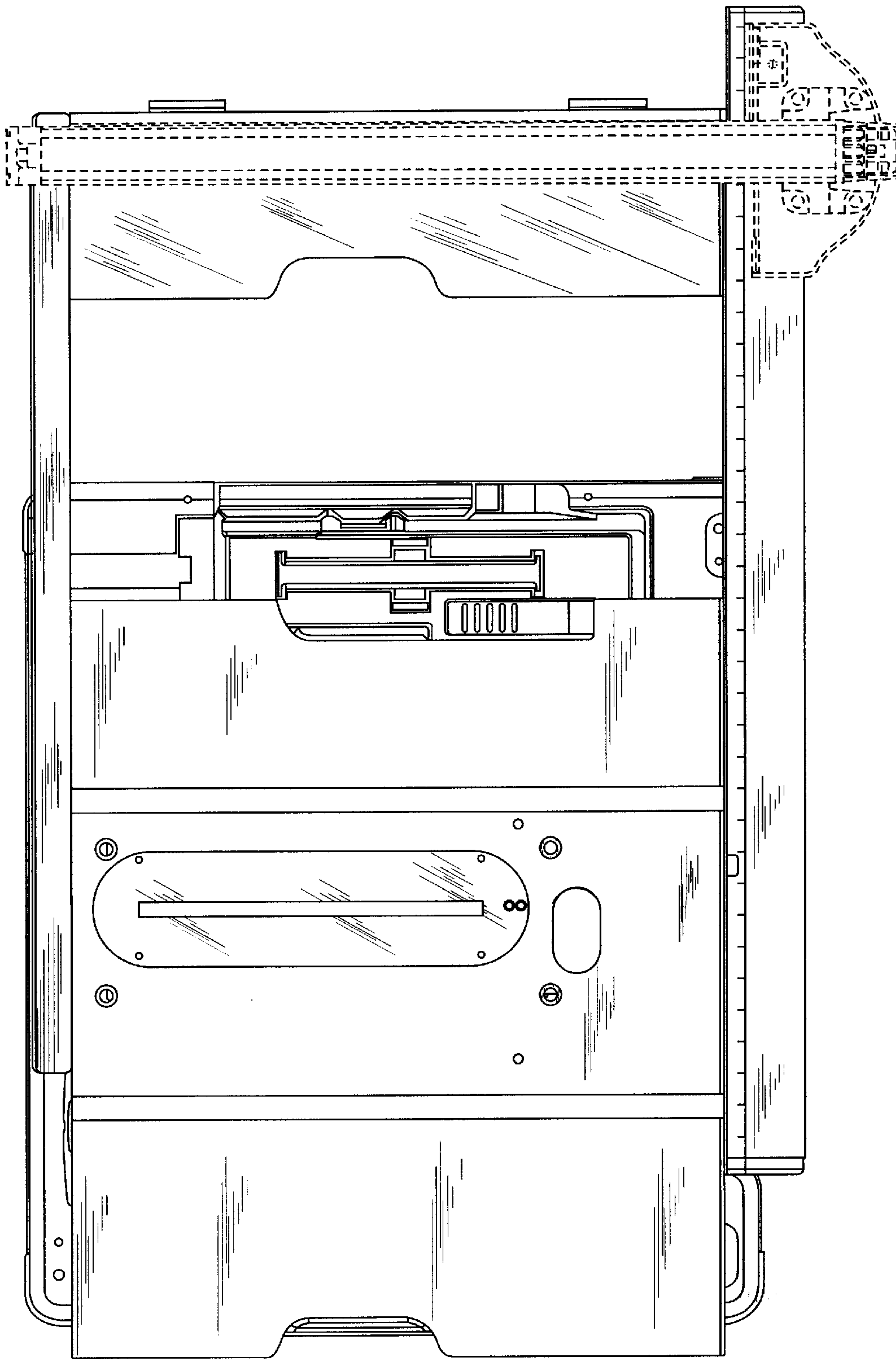

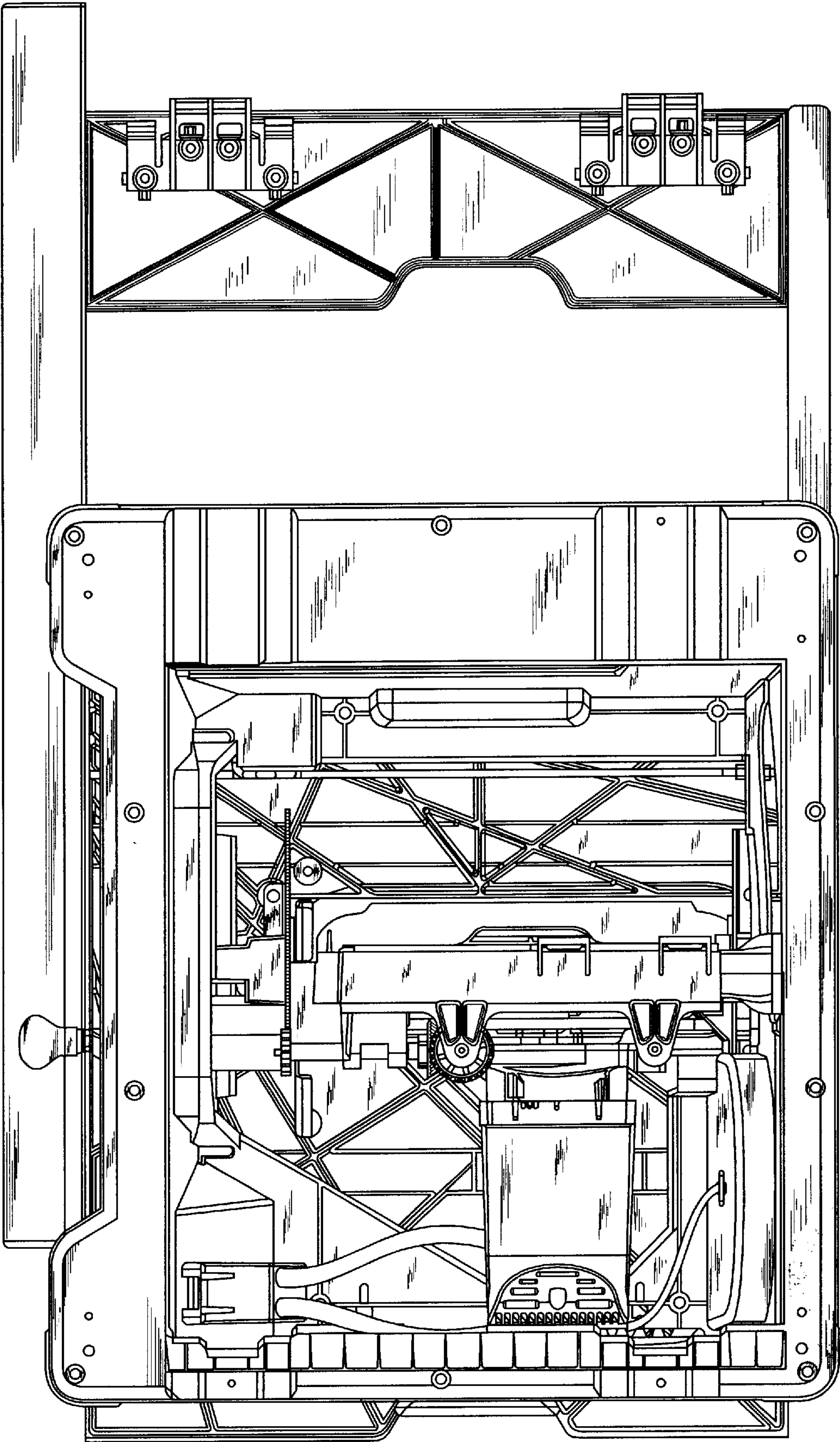

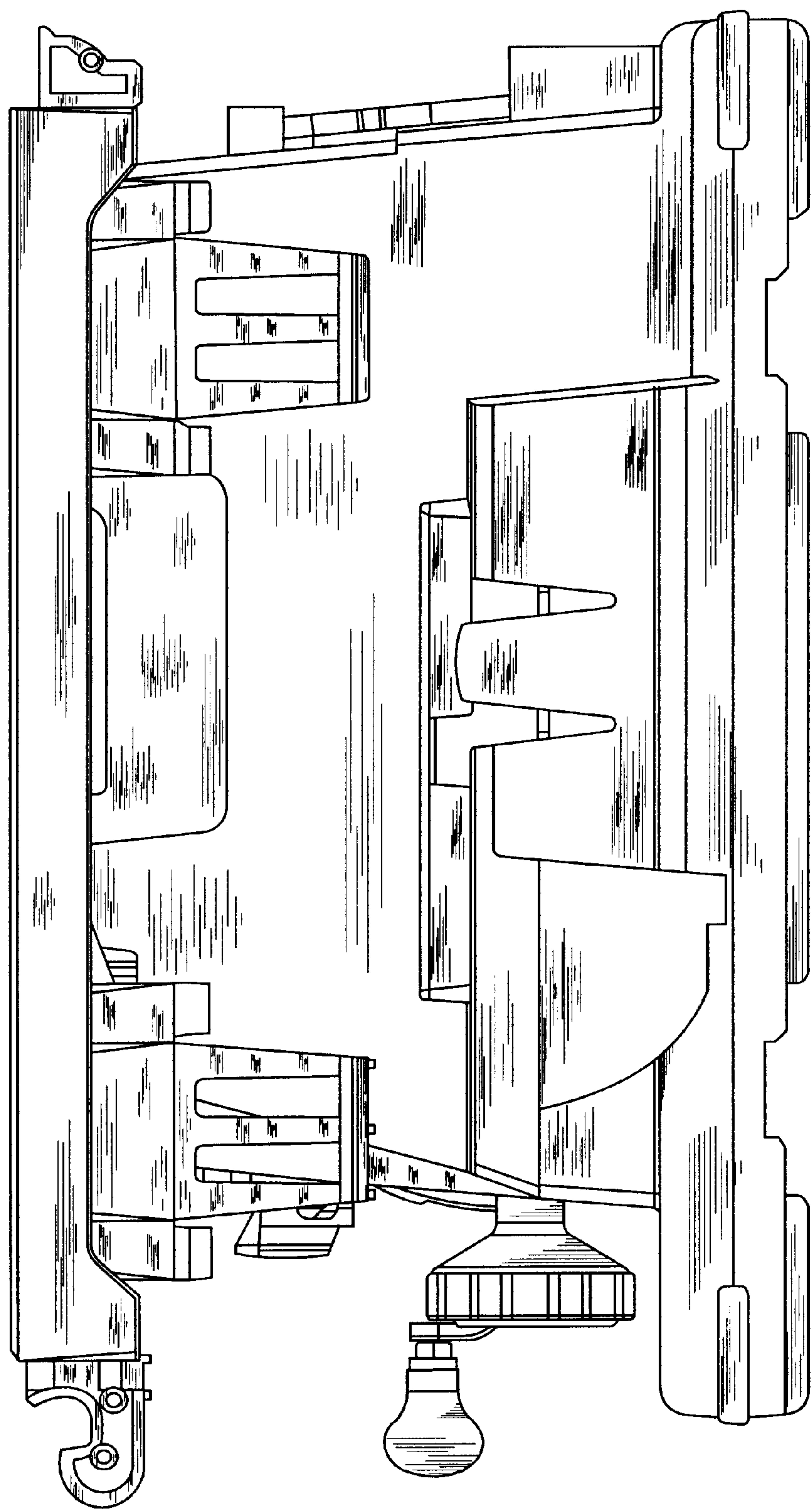

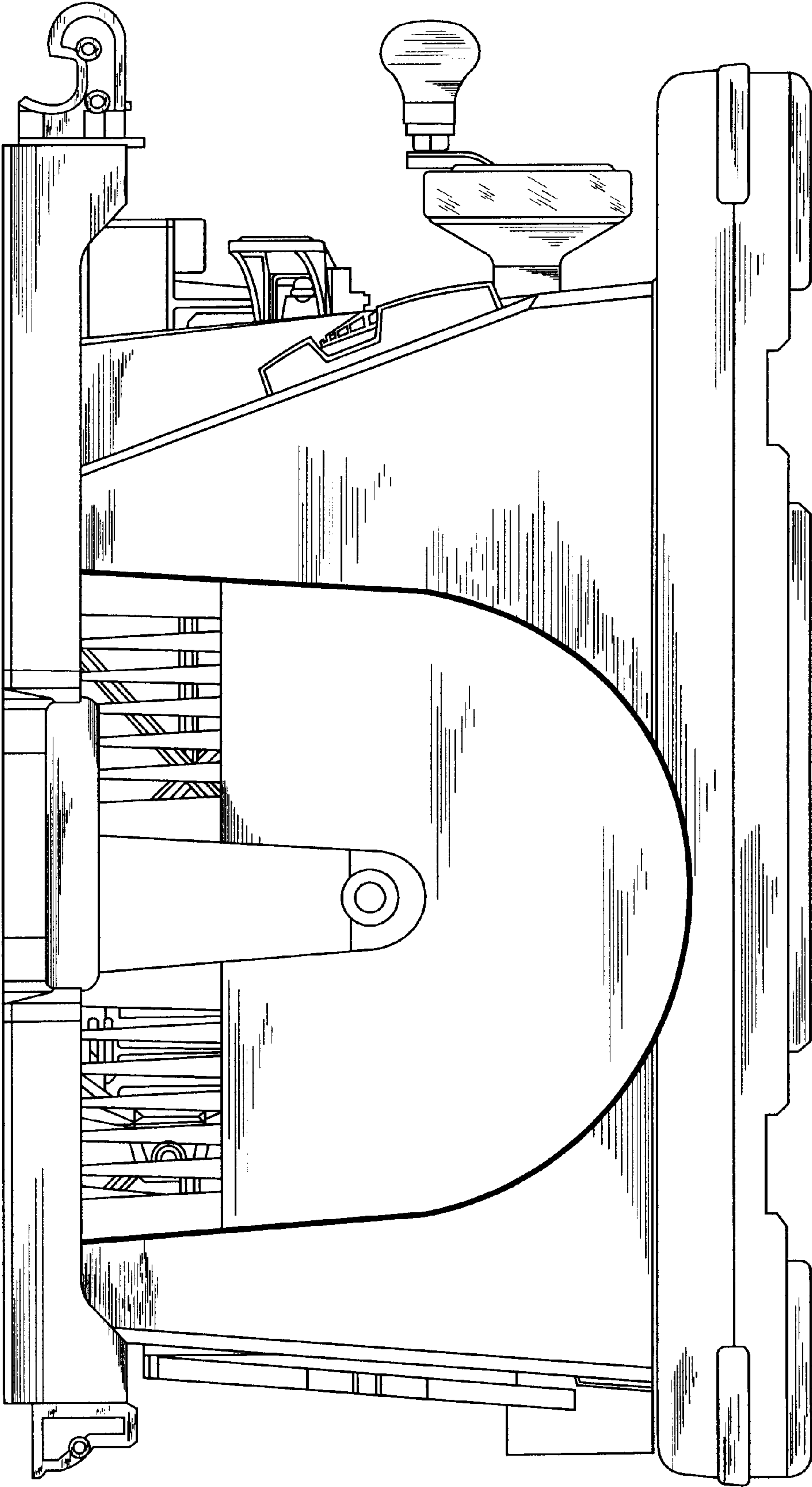

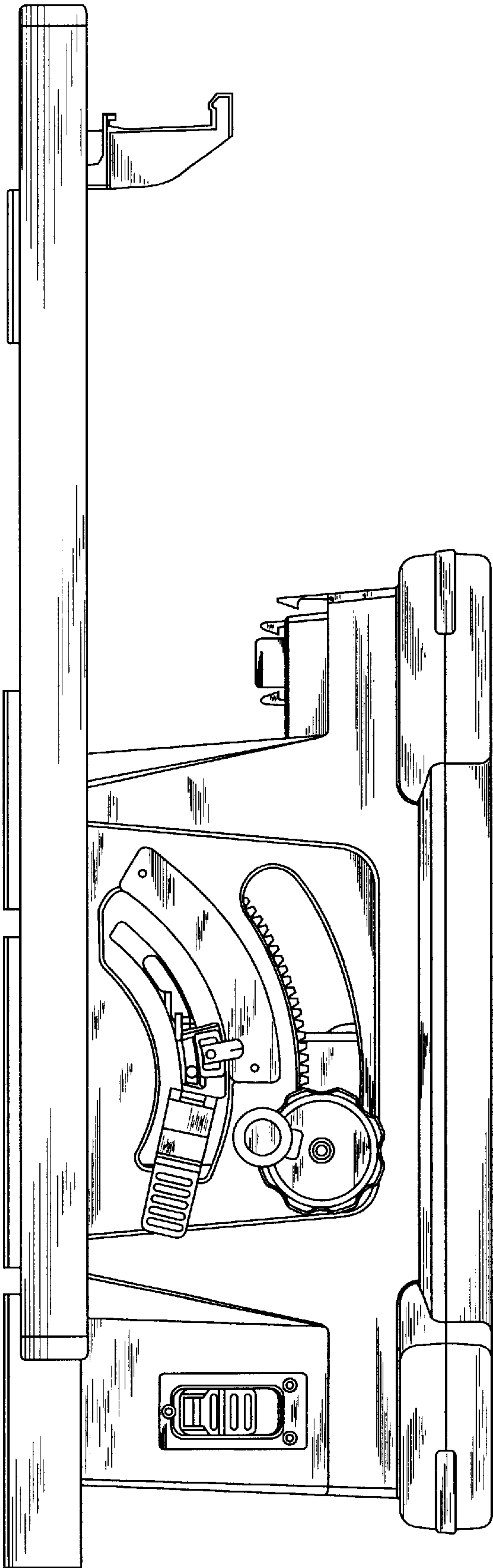

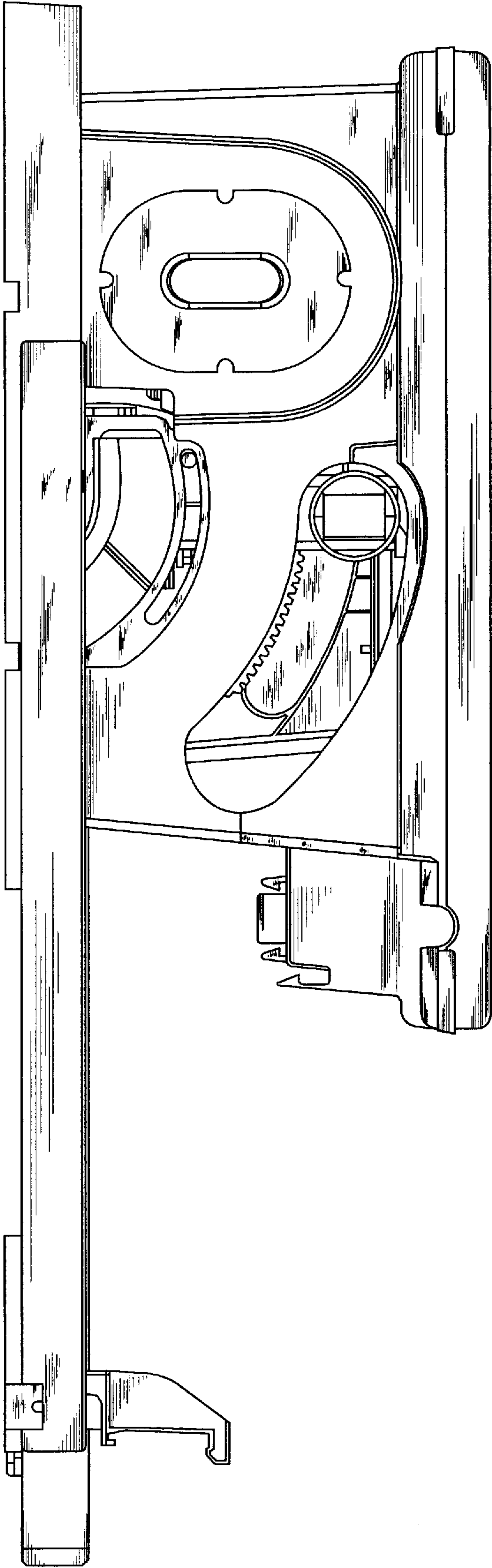
