FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the embodiment of the octagonal
toy building element shown in FIG. 6.

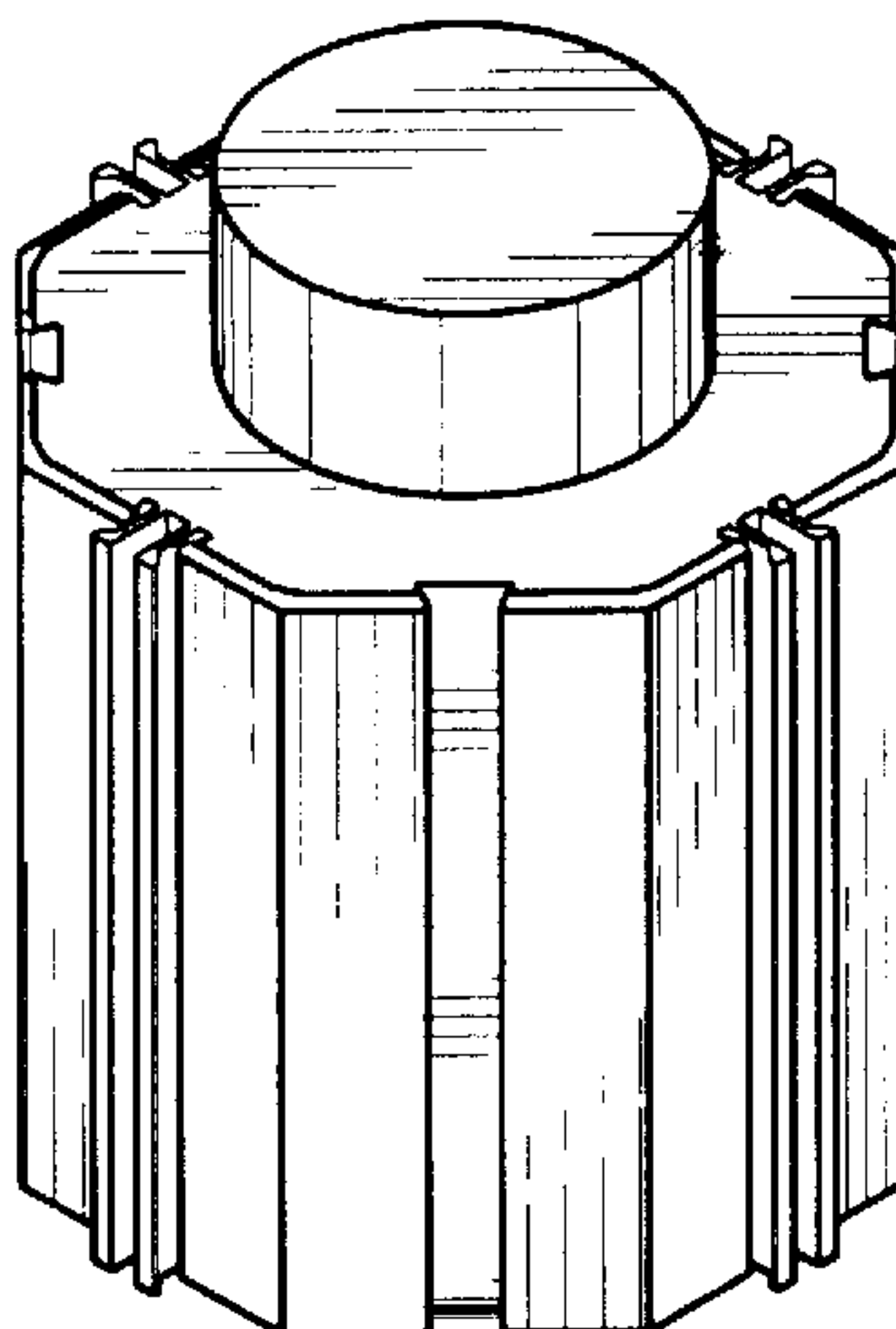

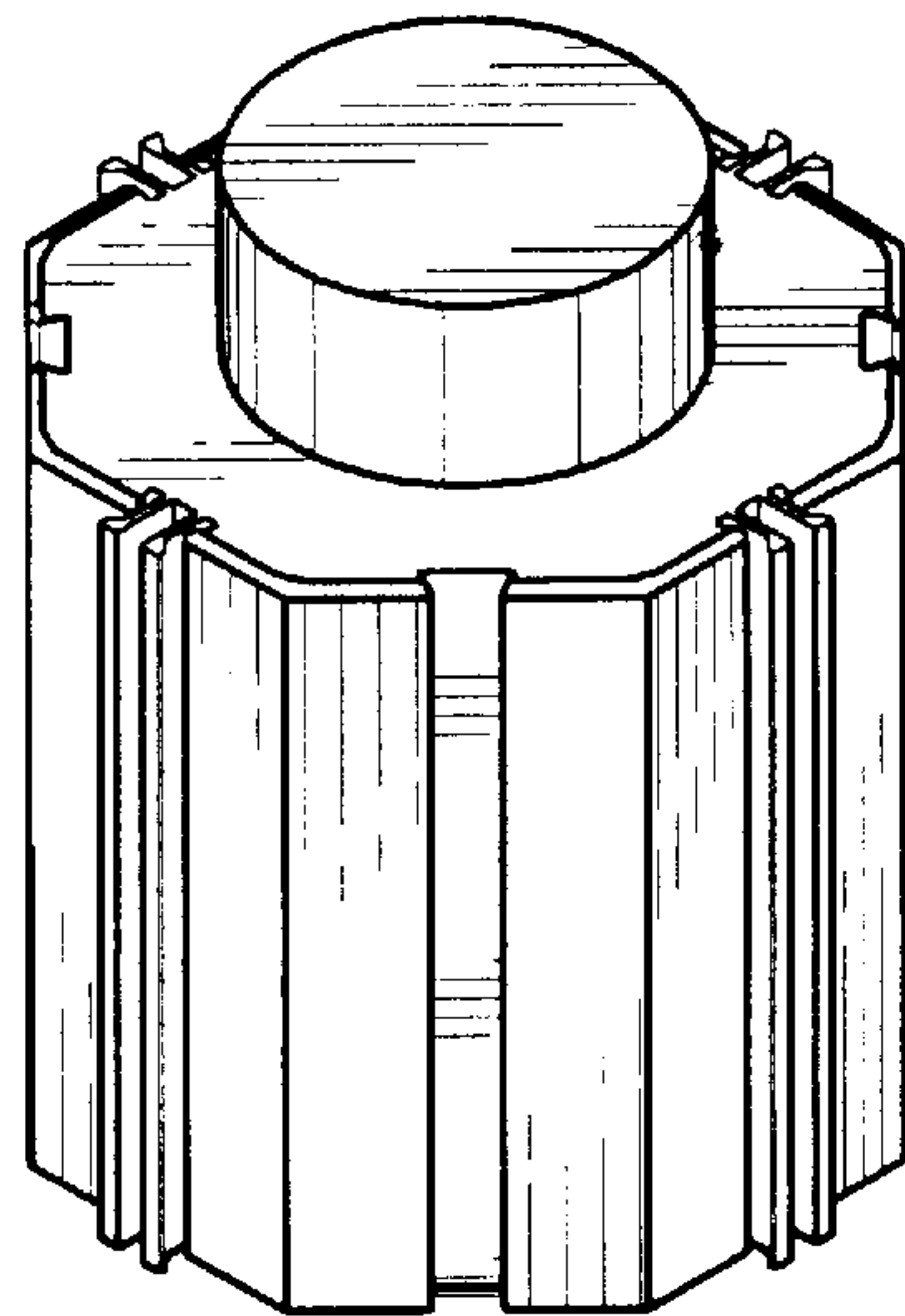

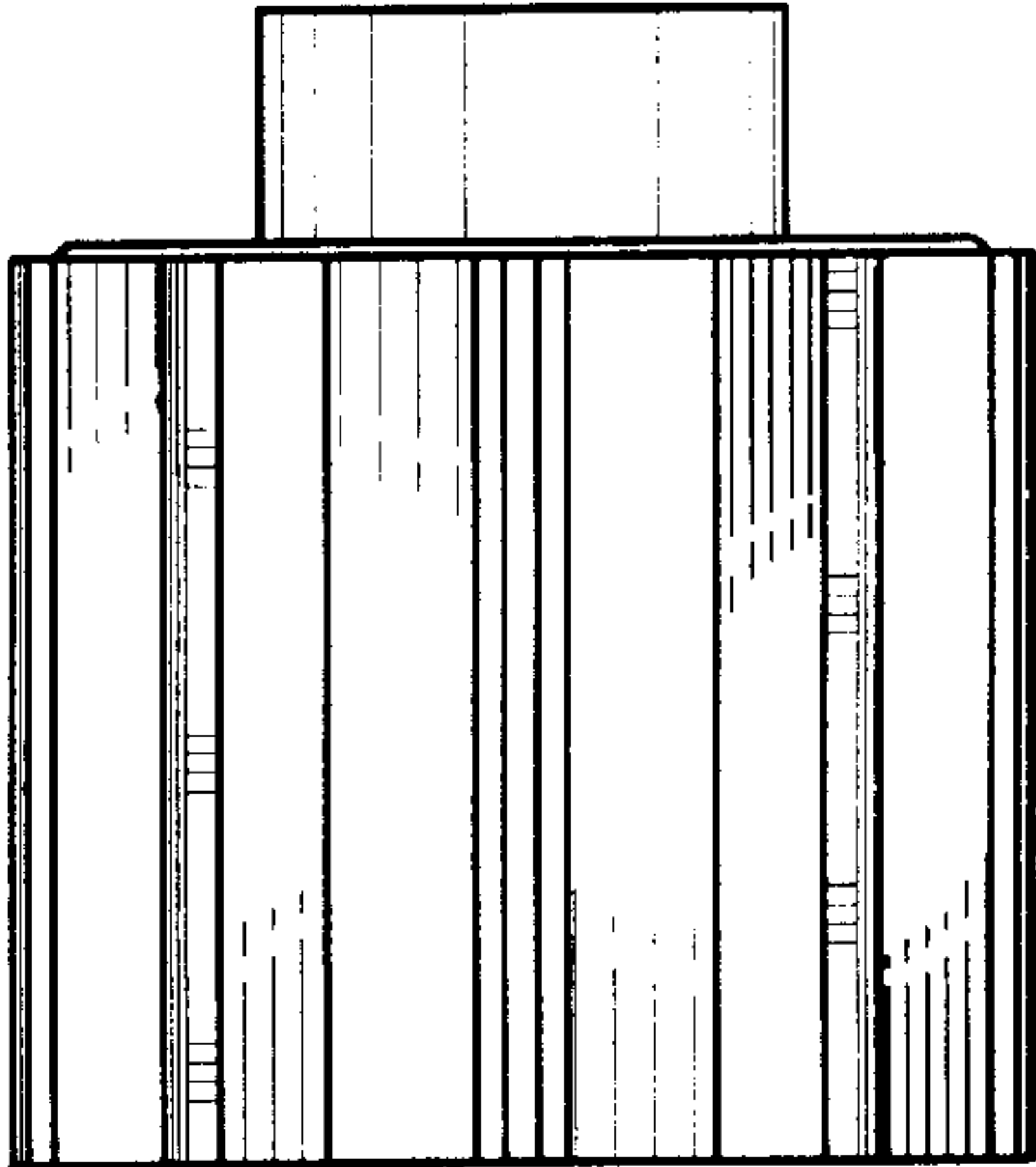
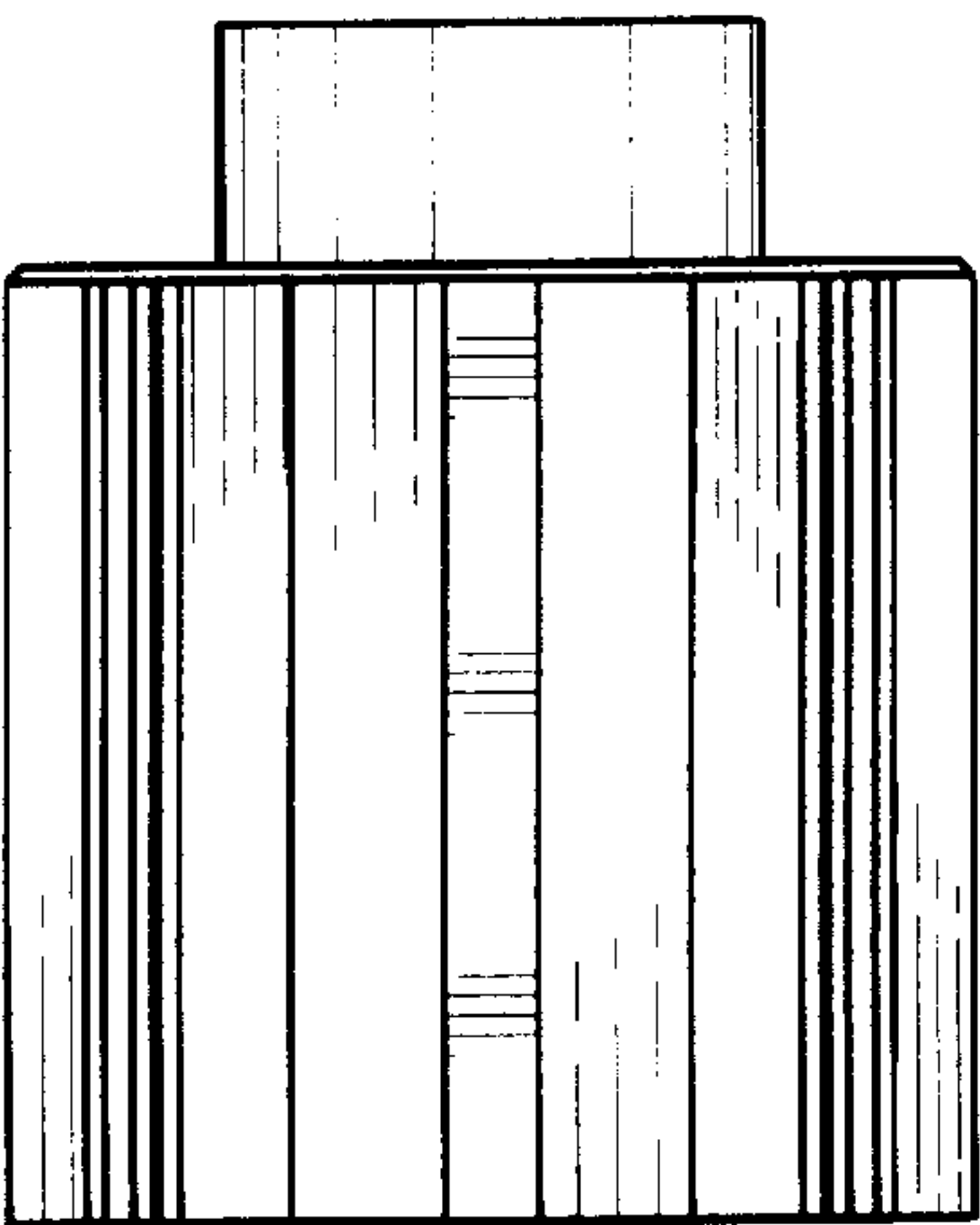
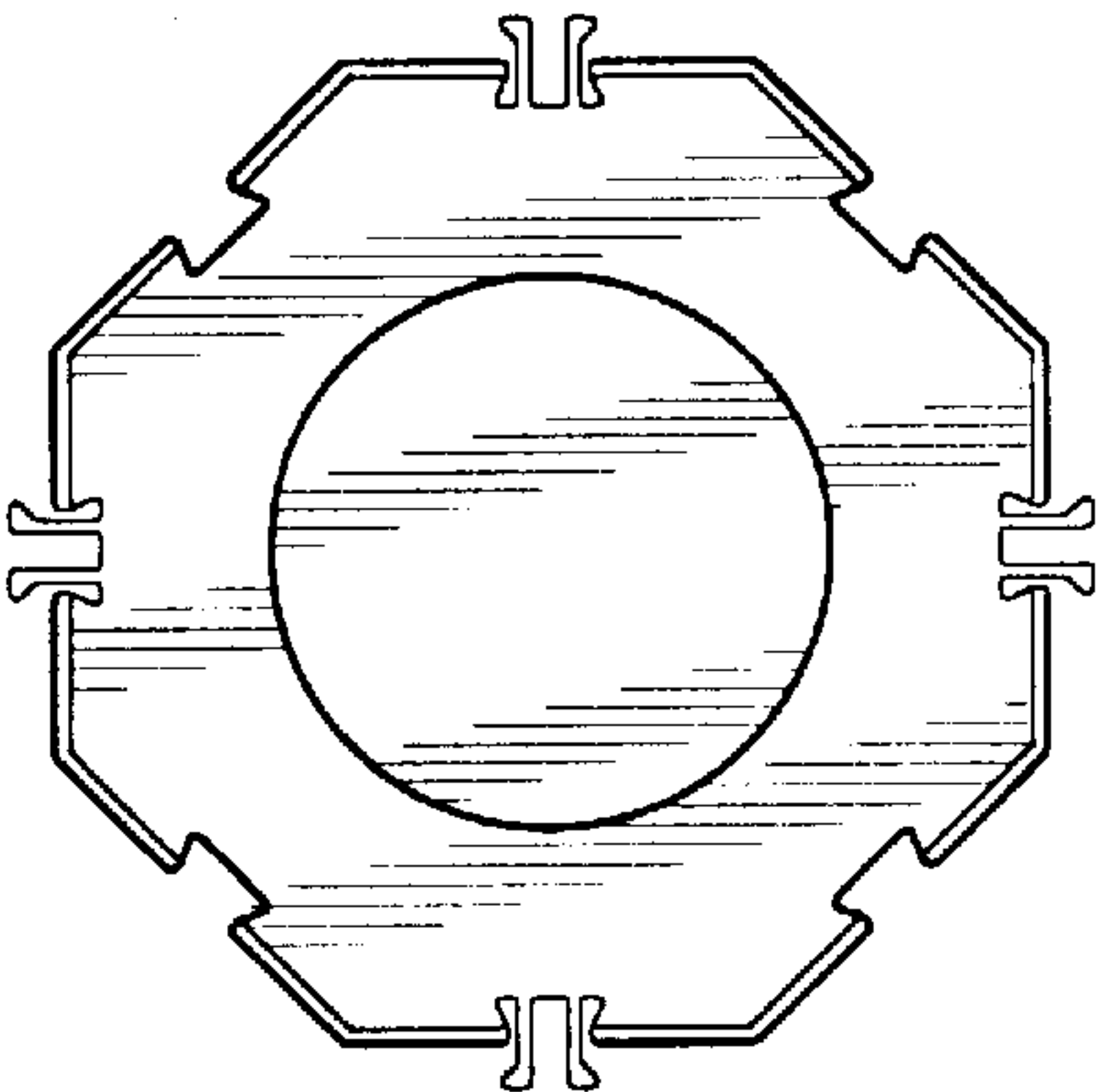

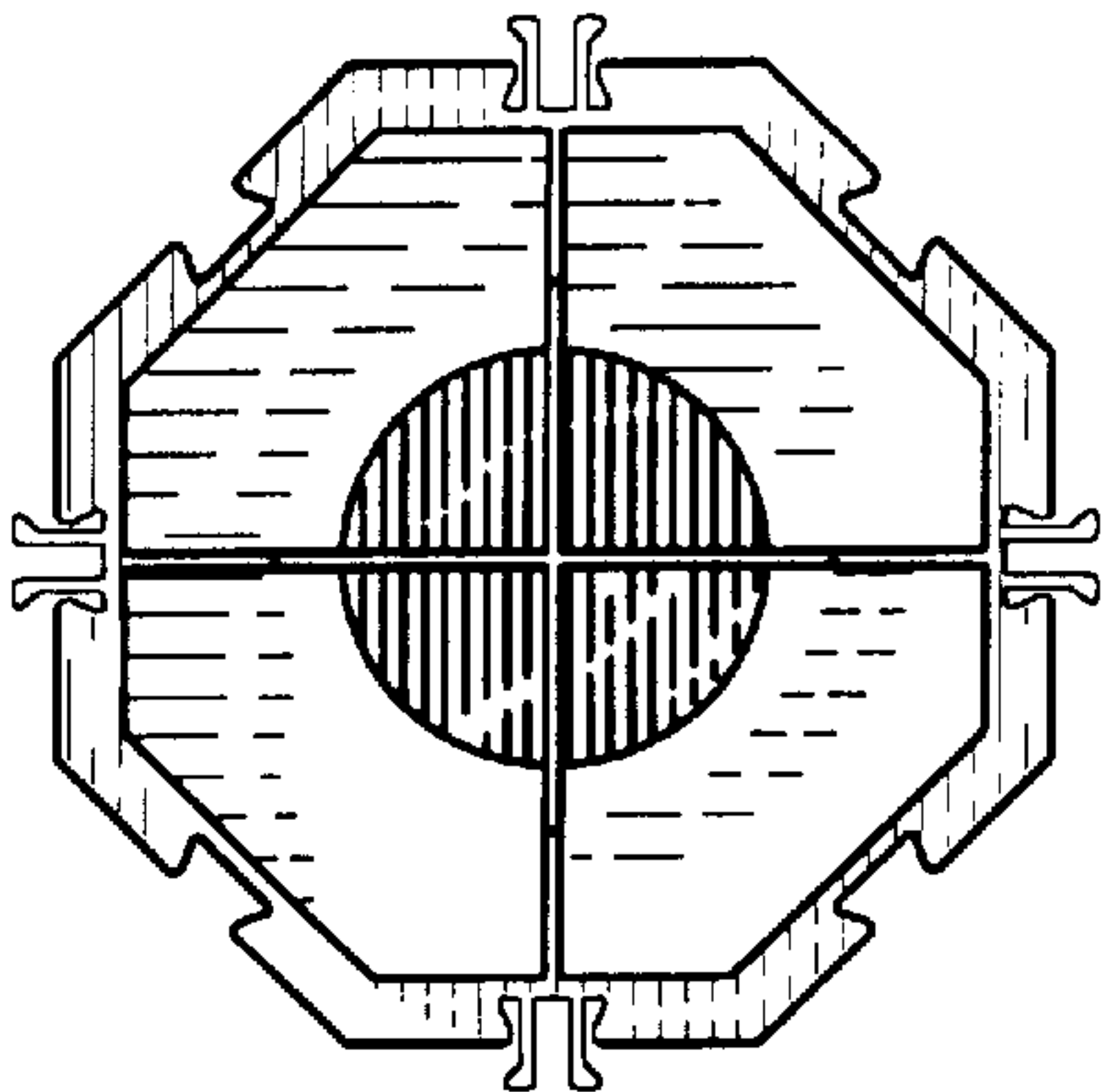

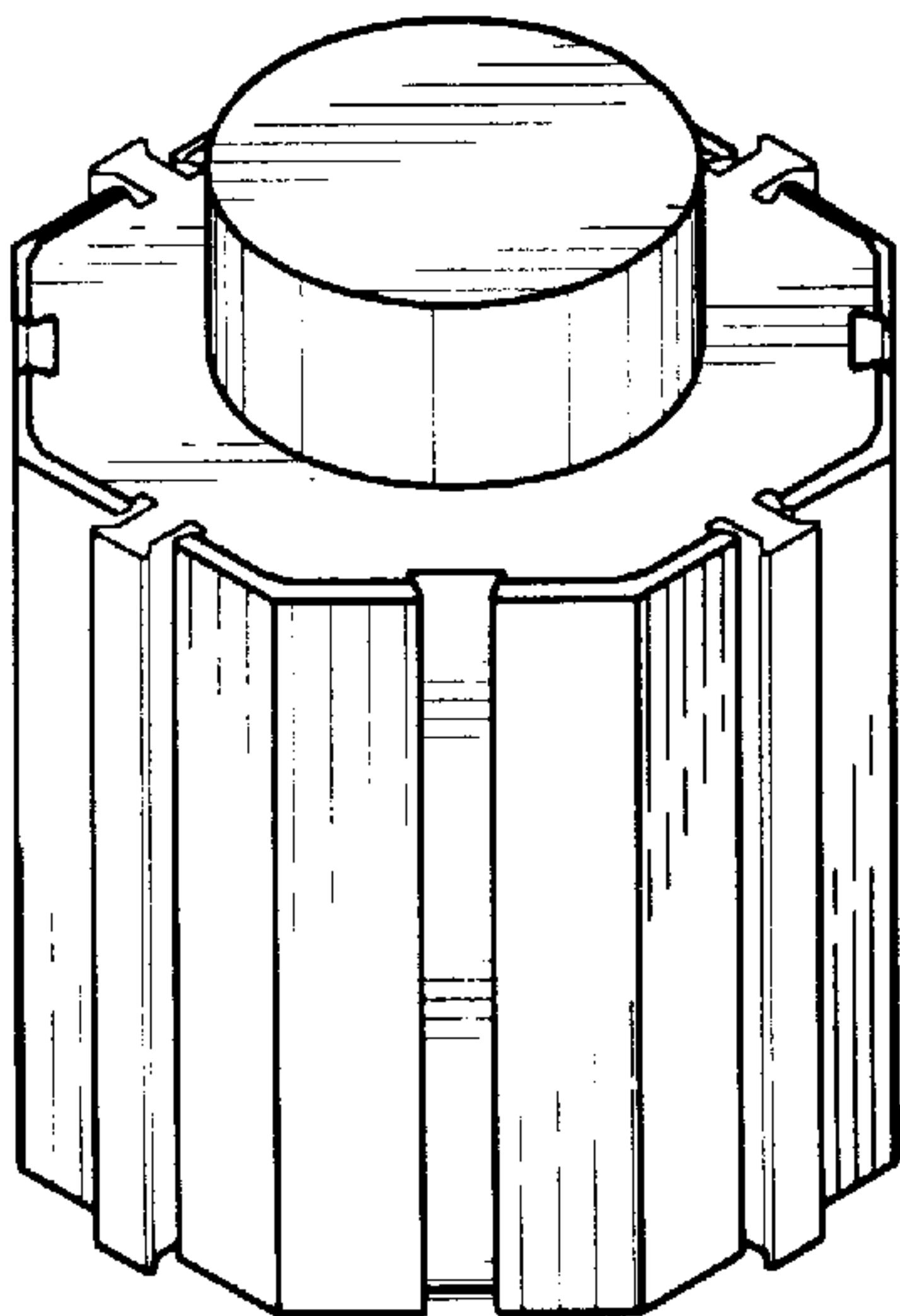

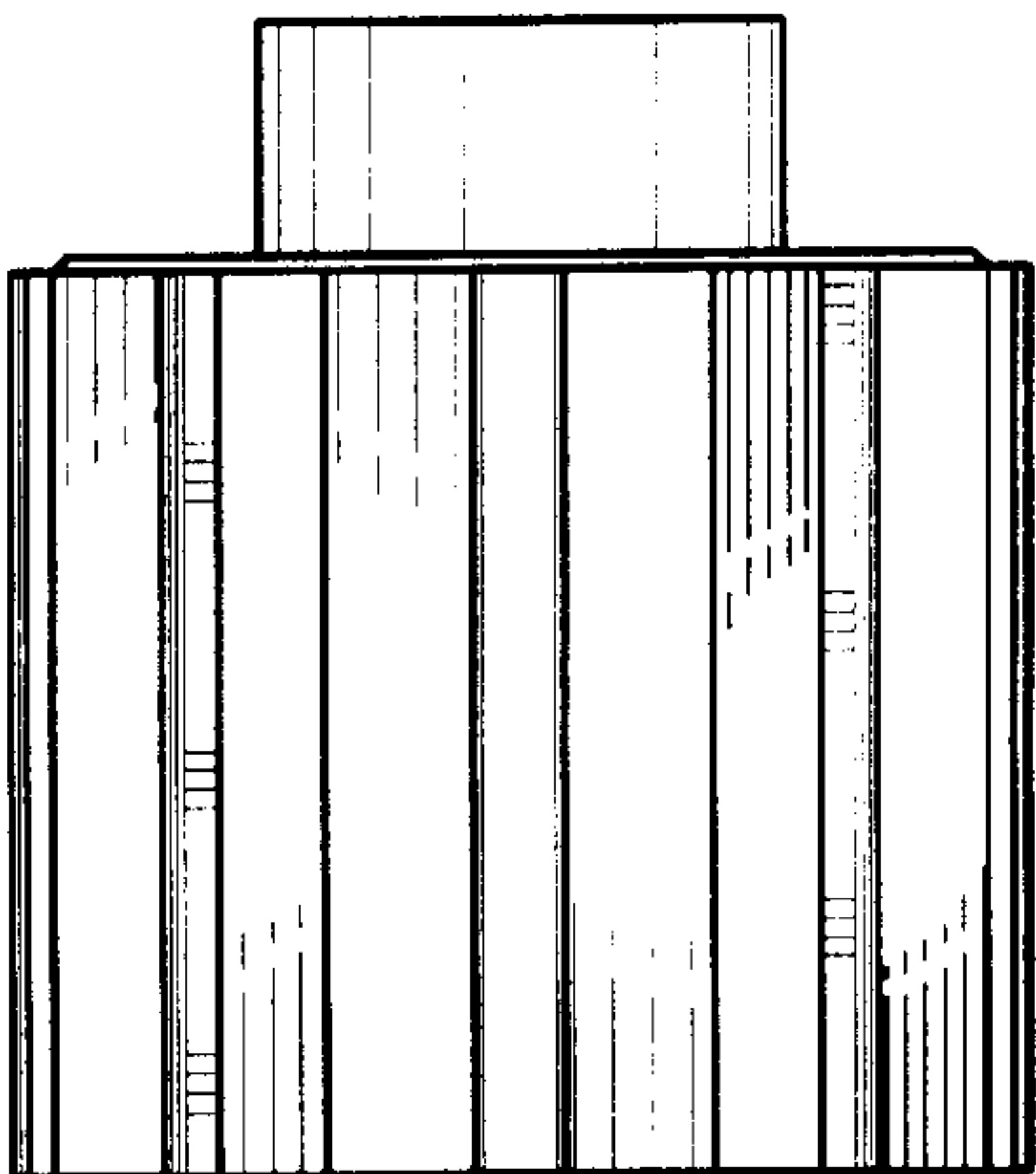
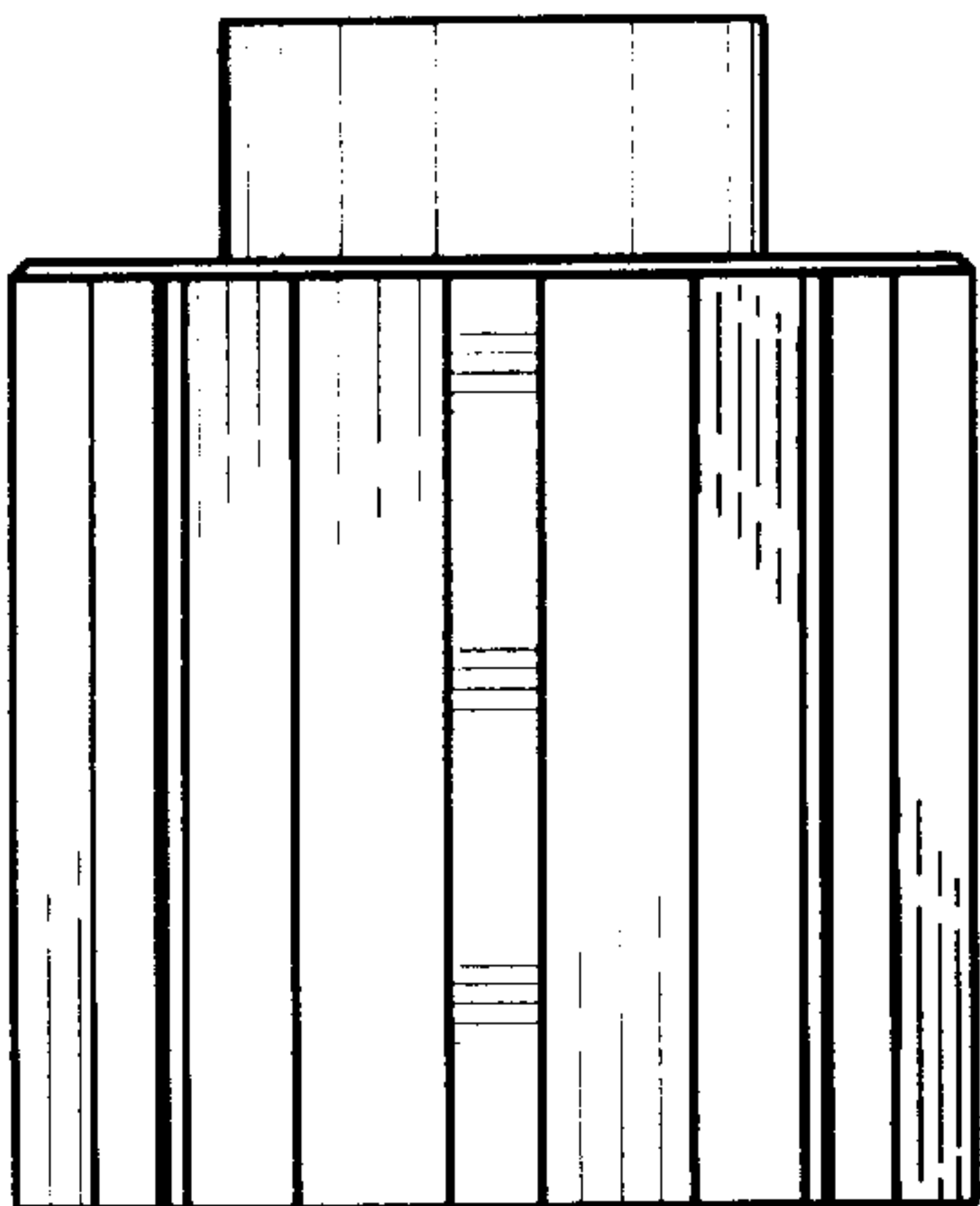
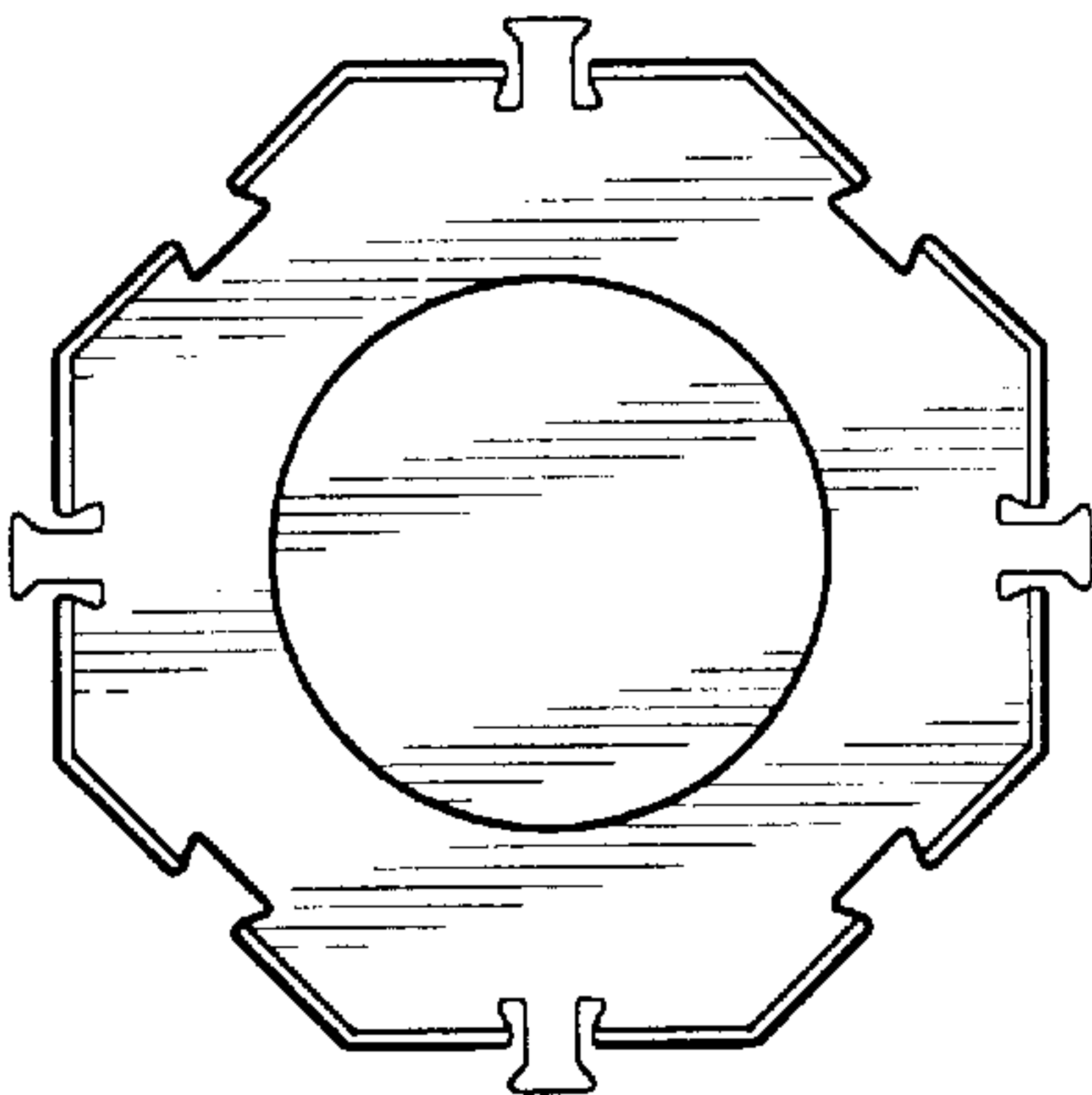
