FIG. 6 is a rear, right perspective view of the surface configuration of a vehicle body and/or toy according to my novel design;


FIG. 7 is a front view of the surface configuration of a vehicle body and/or toy according to my novel design;

FIG. 8 is a rear view of the surface configuration of a vehicle body and/or toy according to my novel design; and,


FIG. 9 is a top view of the surface configuration of a vehicle body and/or toy according to my novel design.















