DESCRIPTION

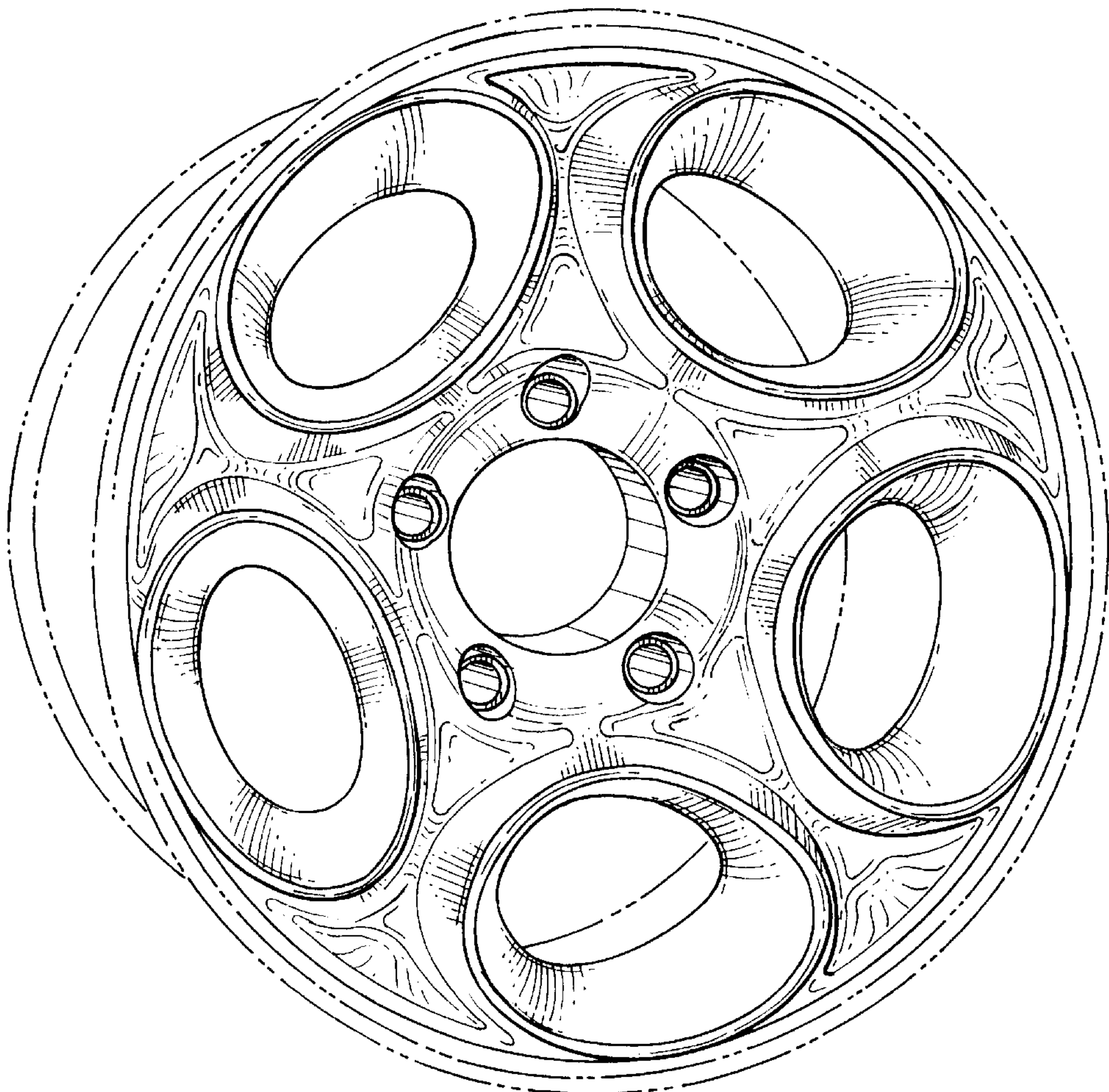
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wheel showing my new design;

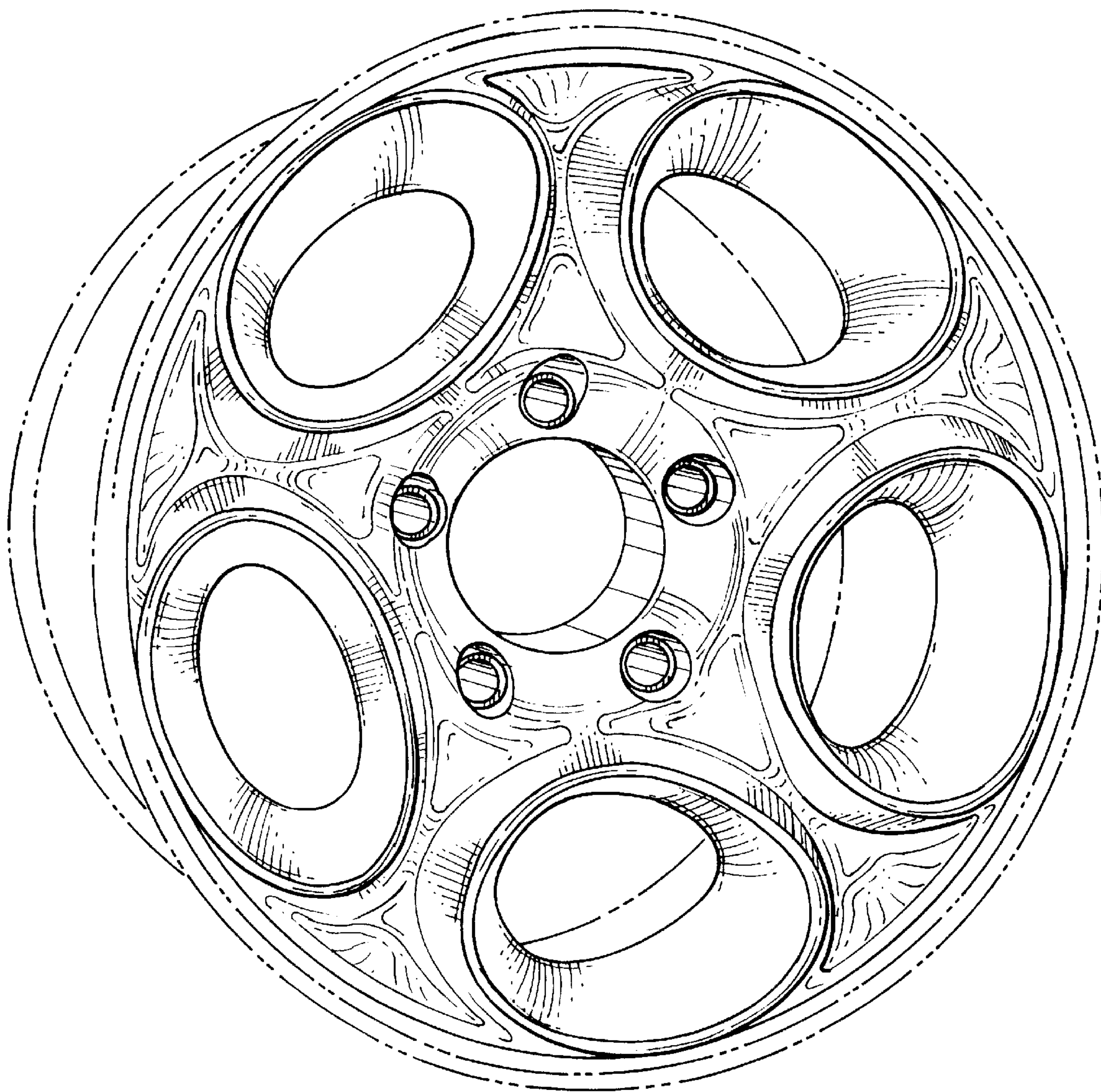

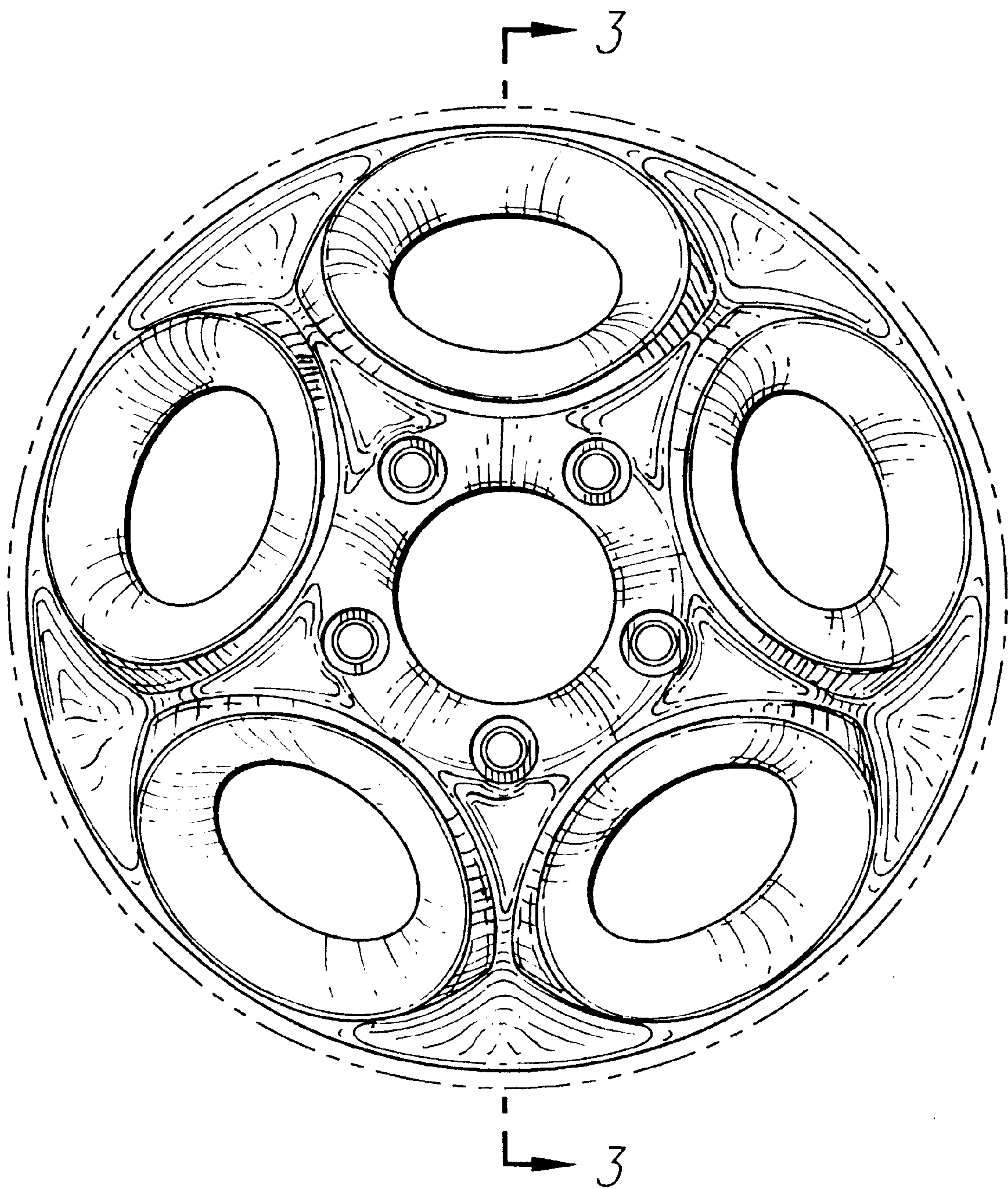

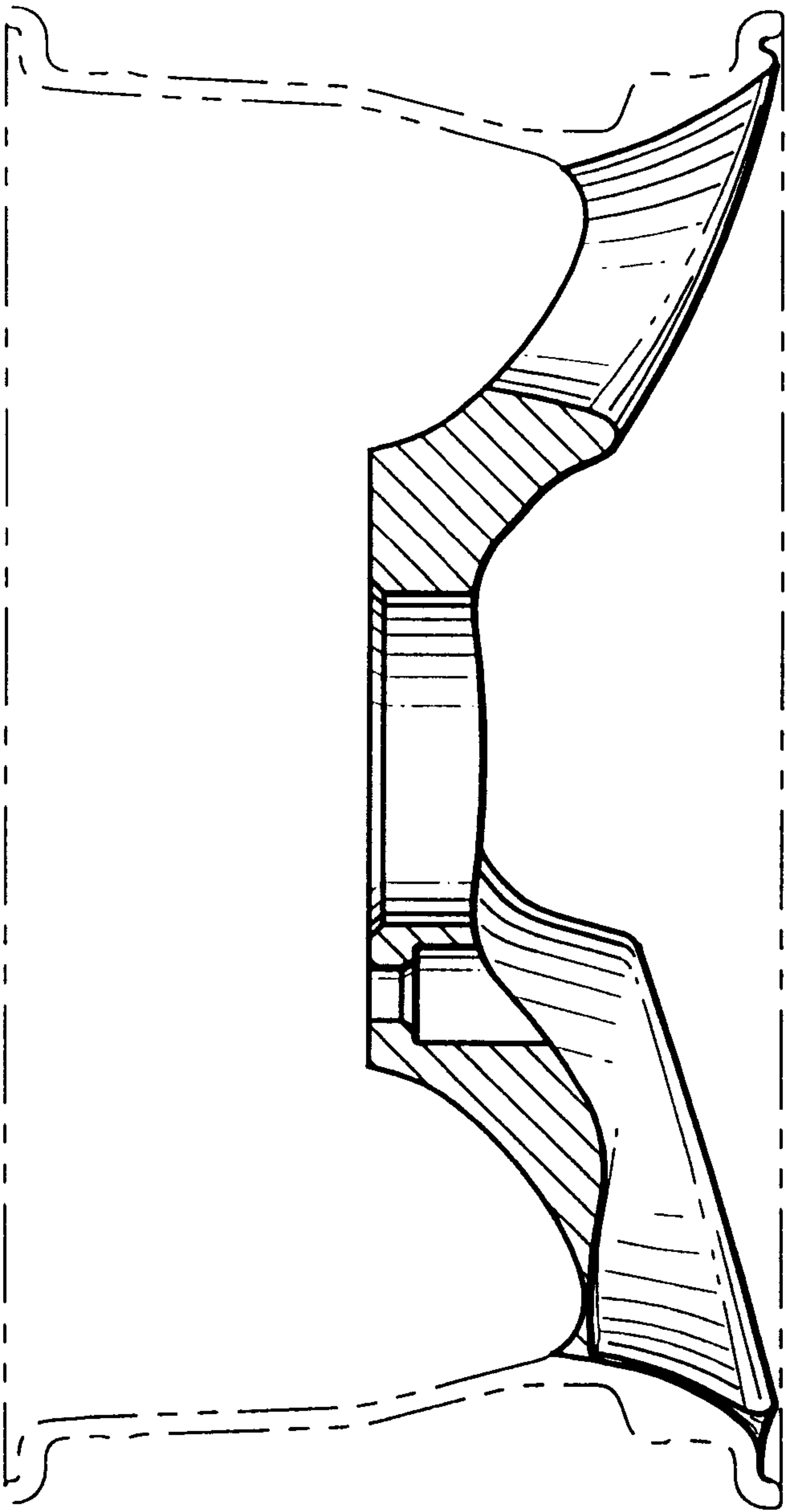
