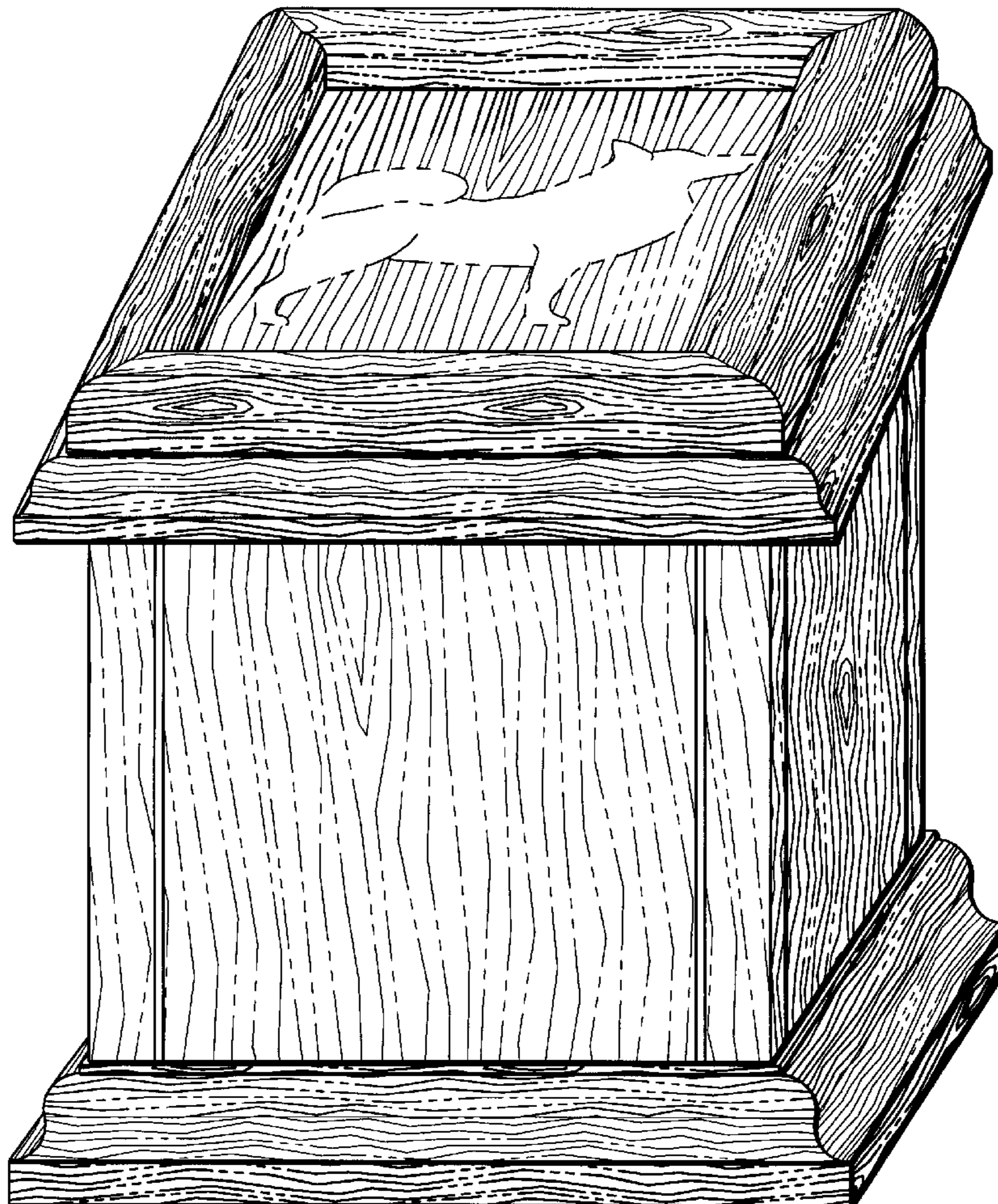
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the urn;

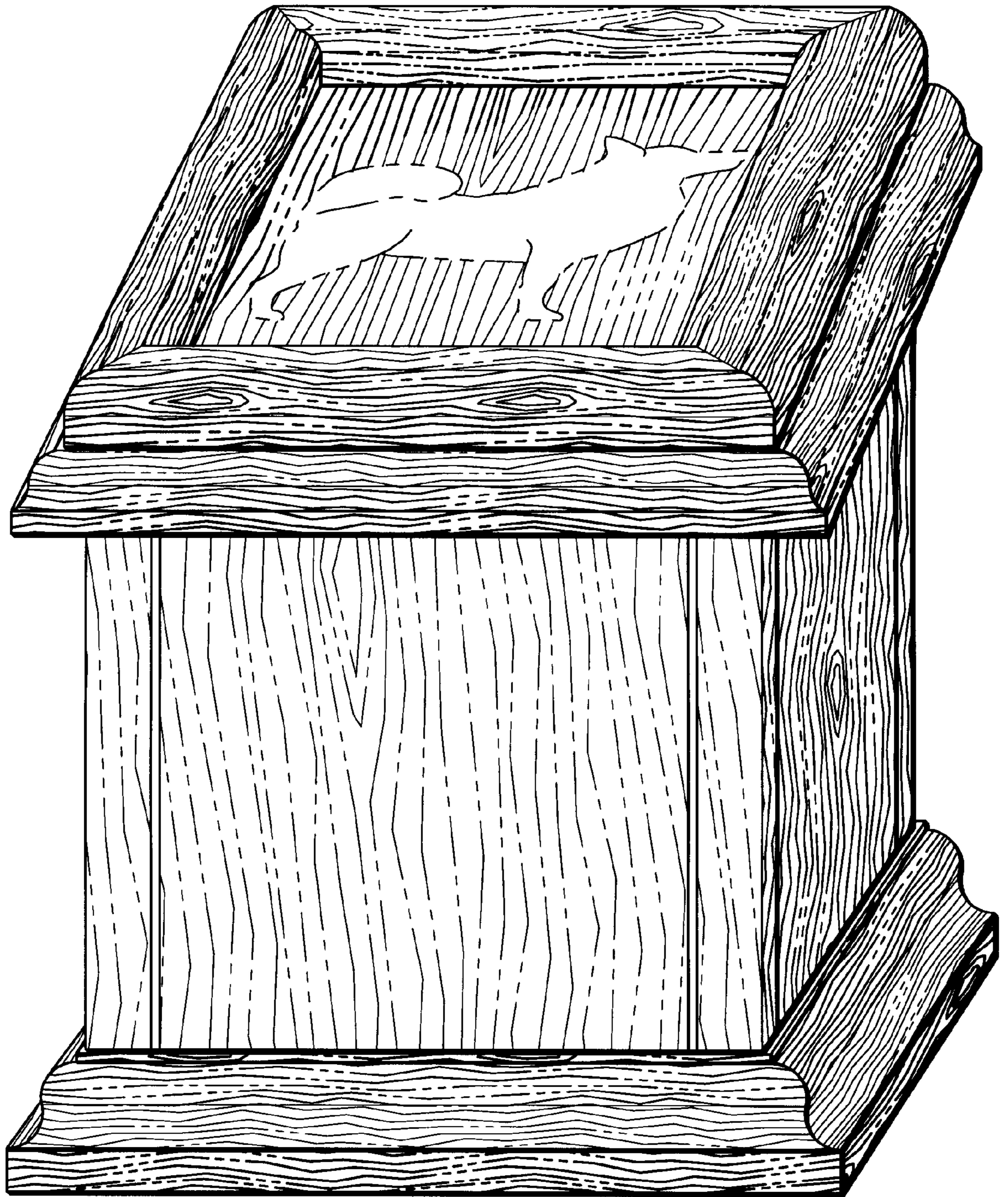

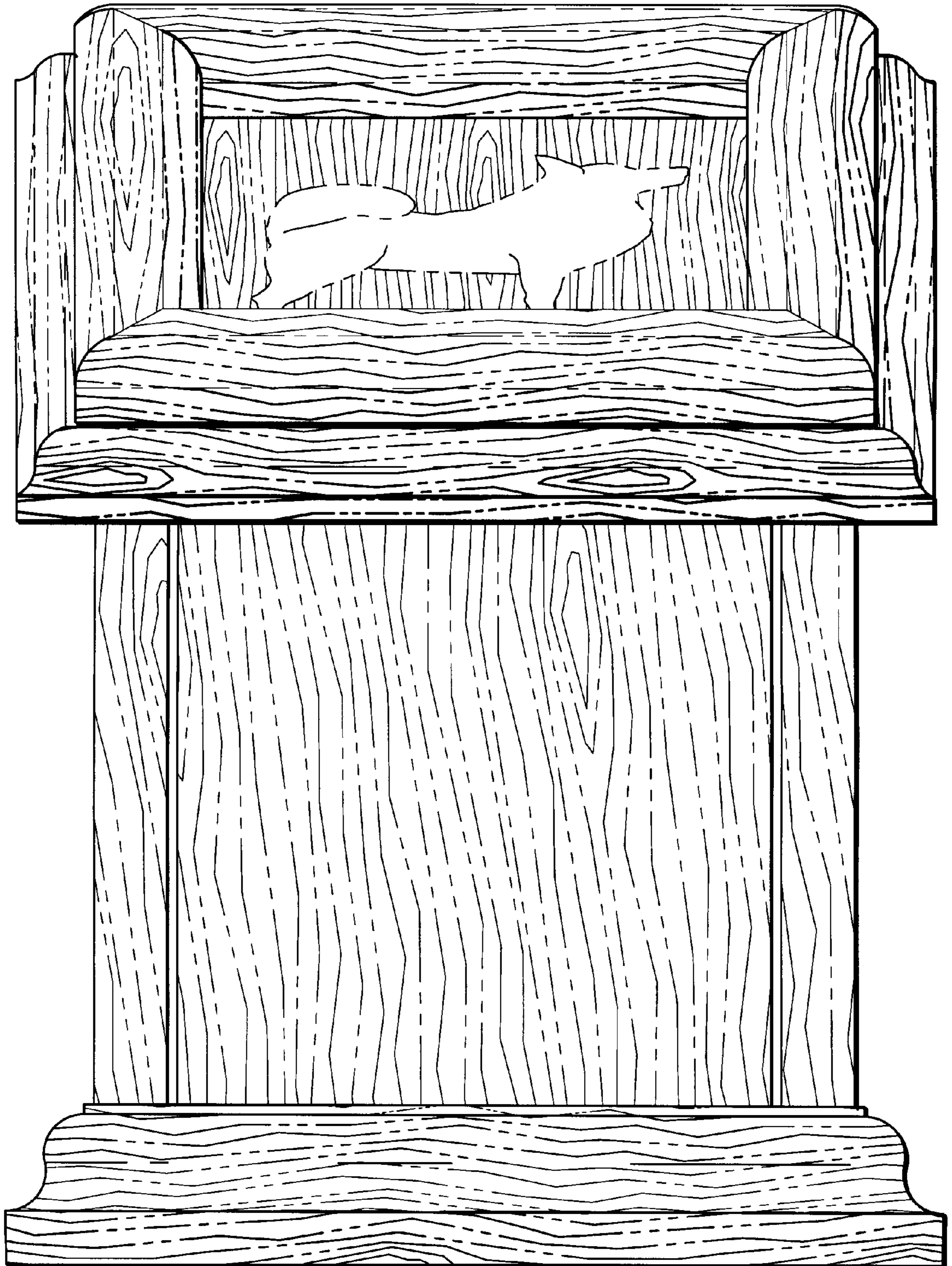

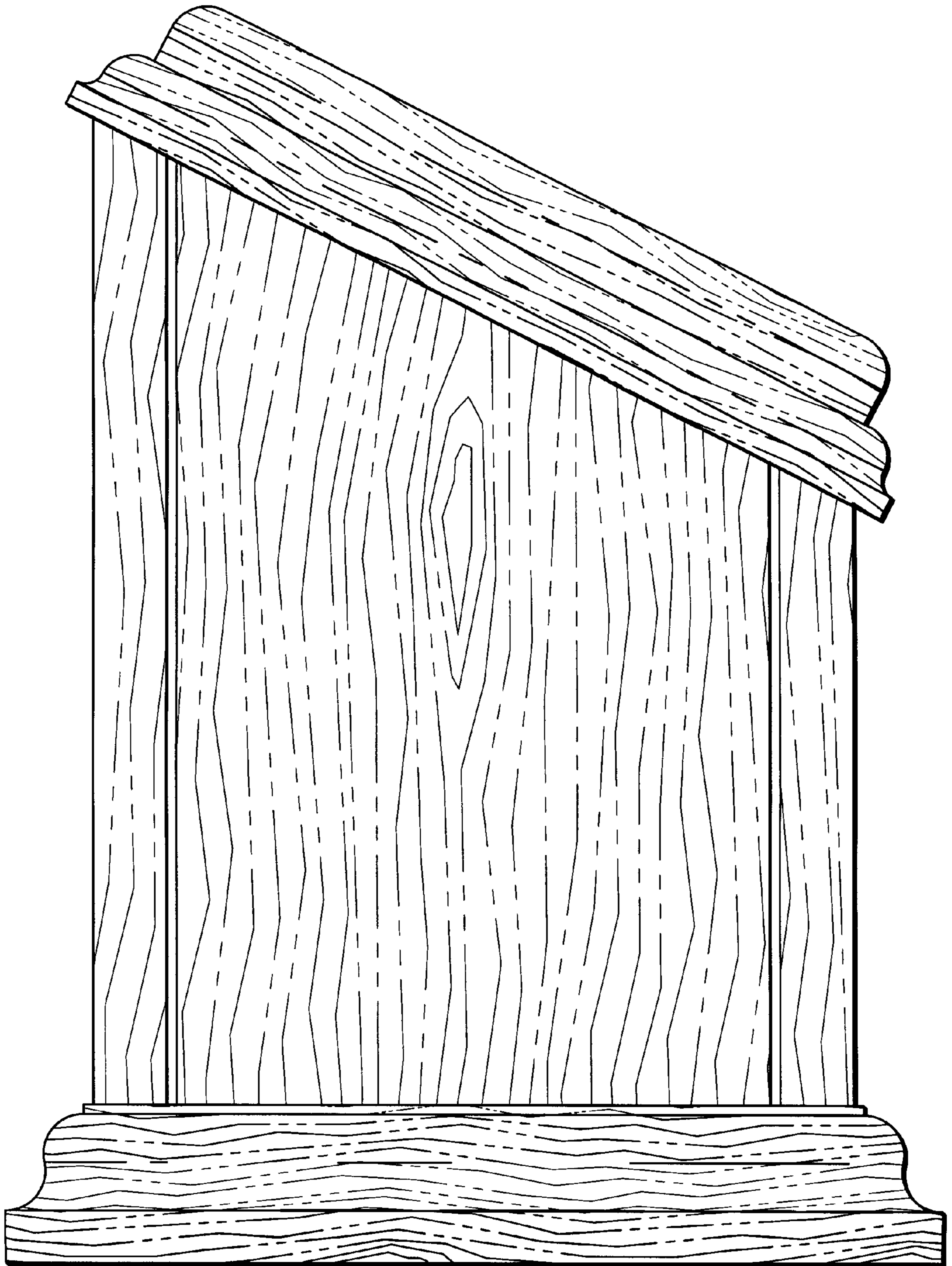

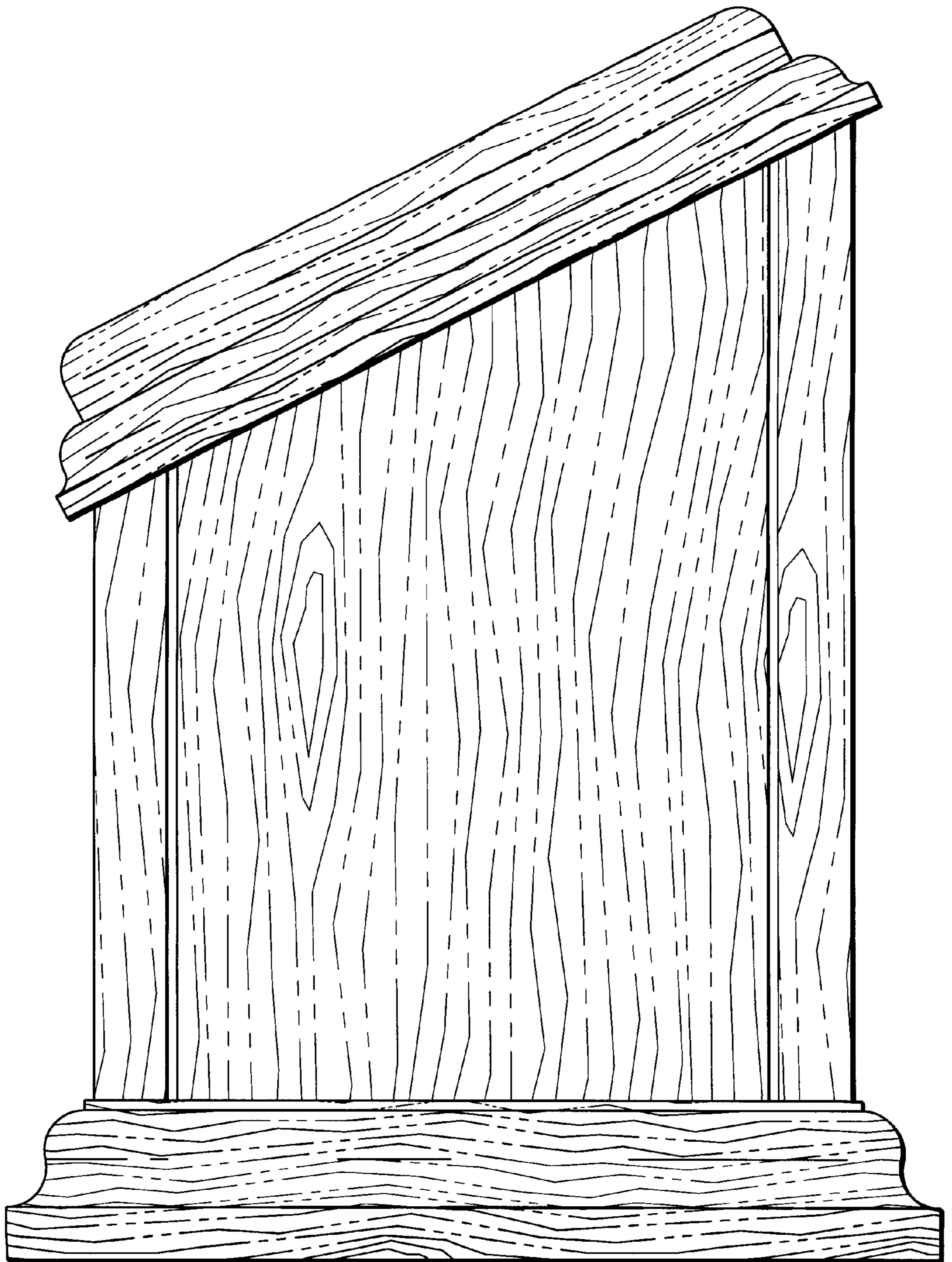

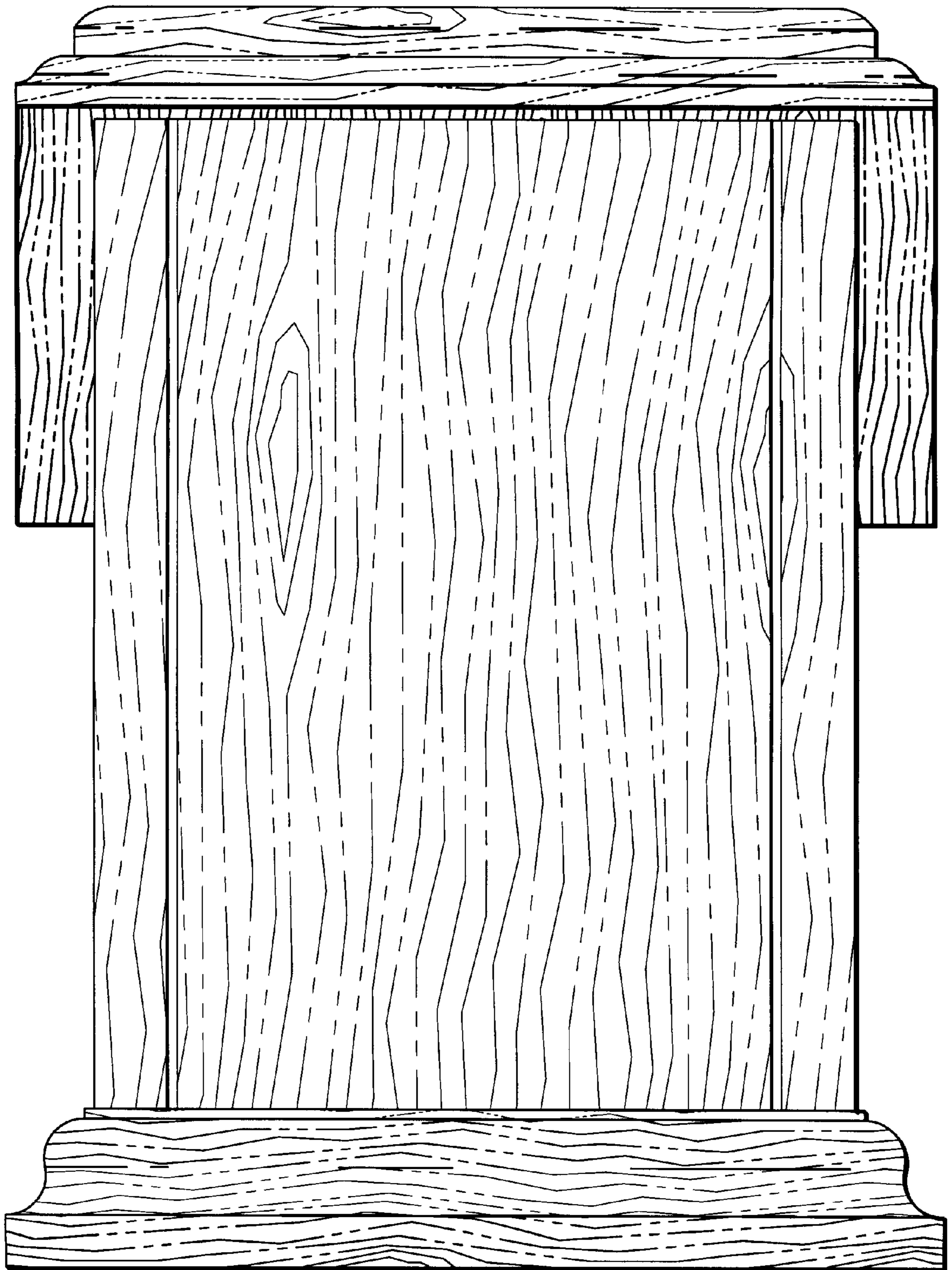

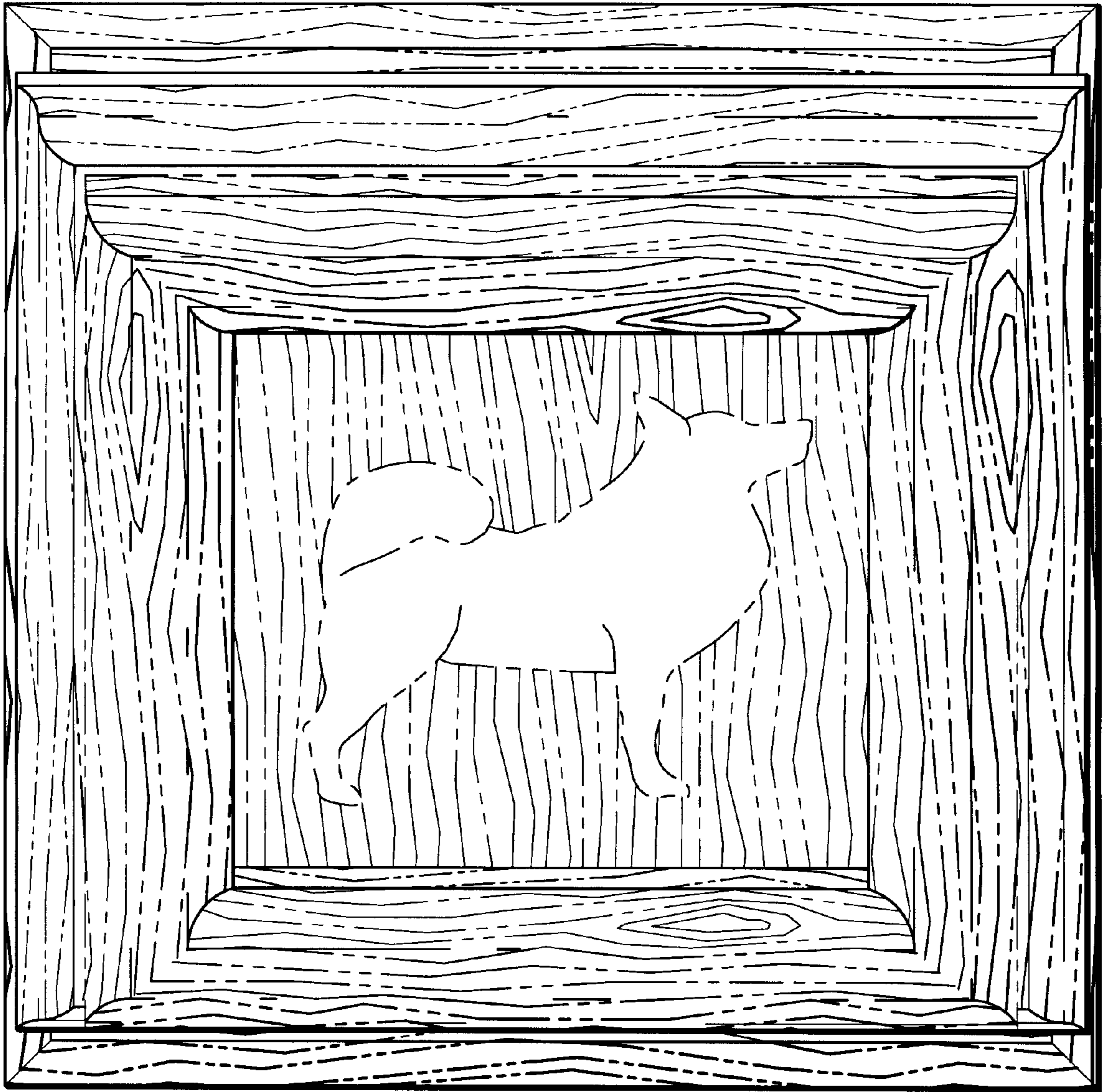

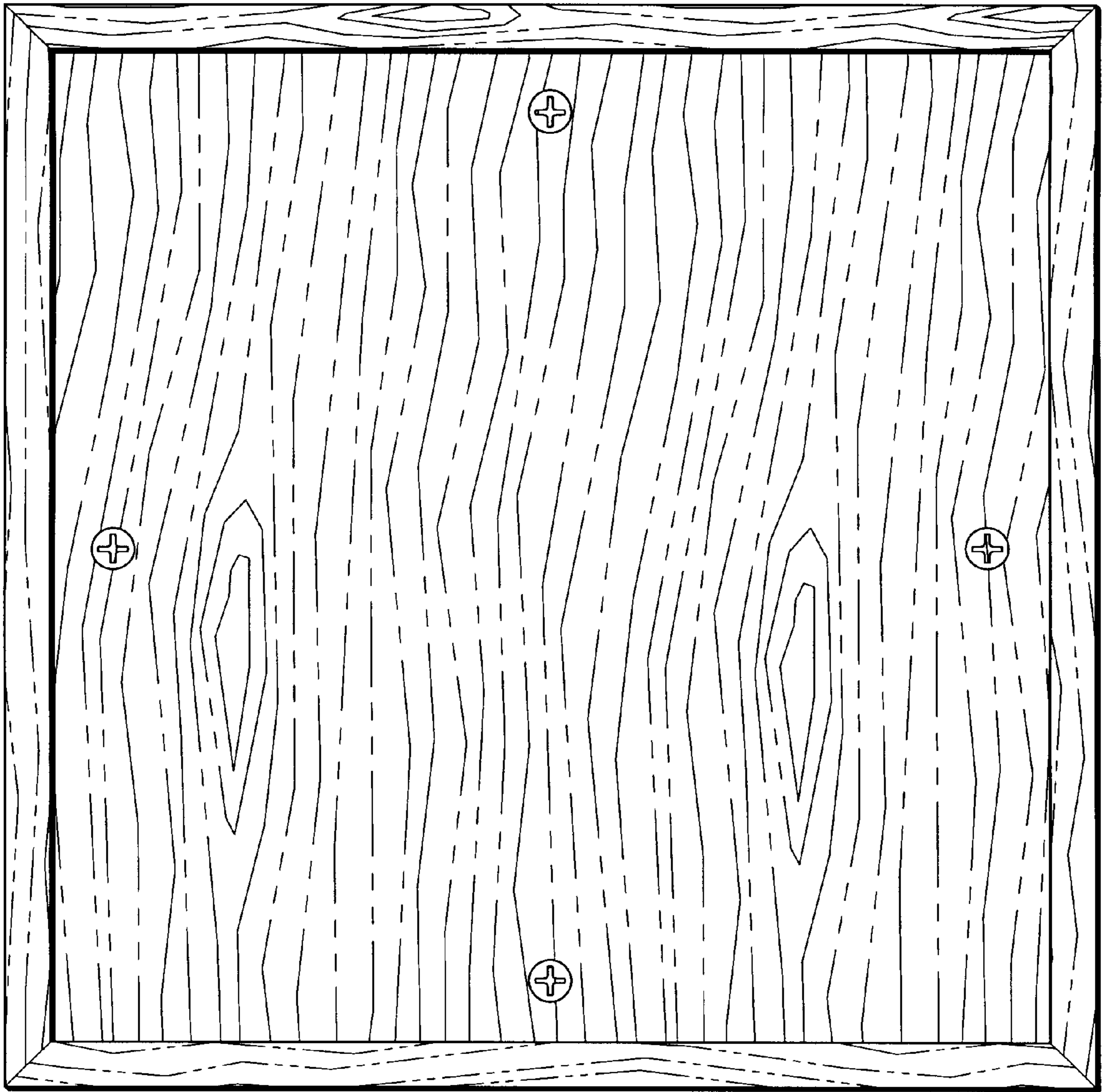
