DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sleeve for a height adjustable arm rest unit incorporating the design of the present invention.

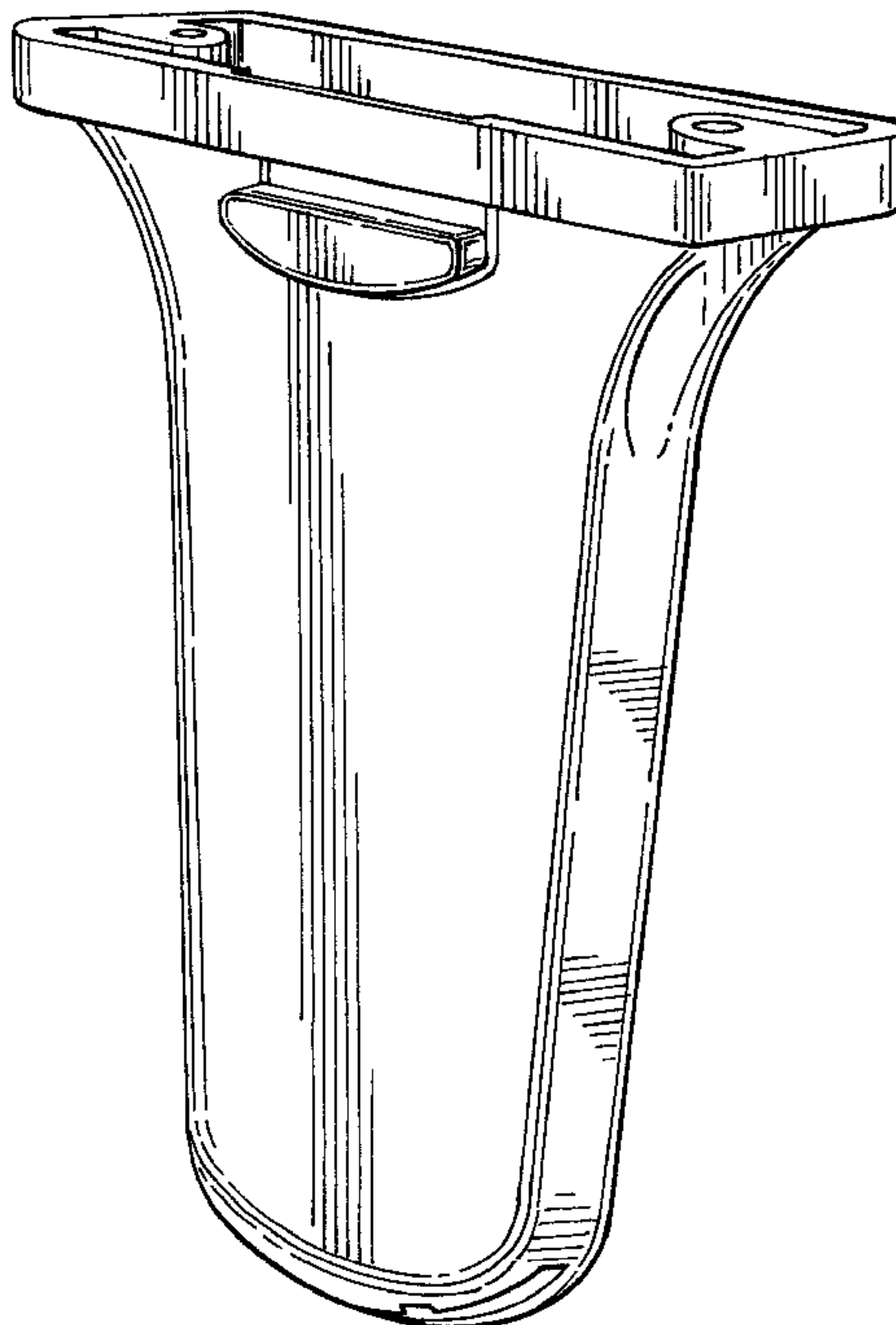

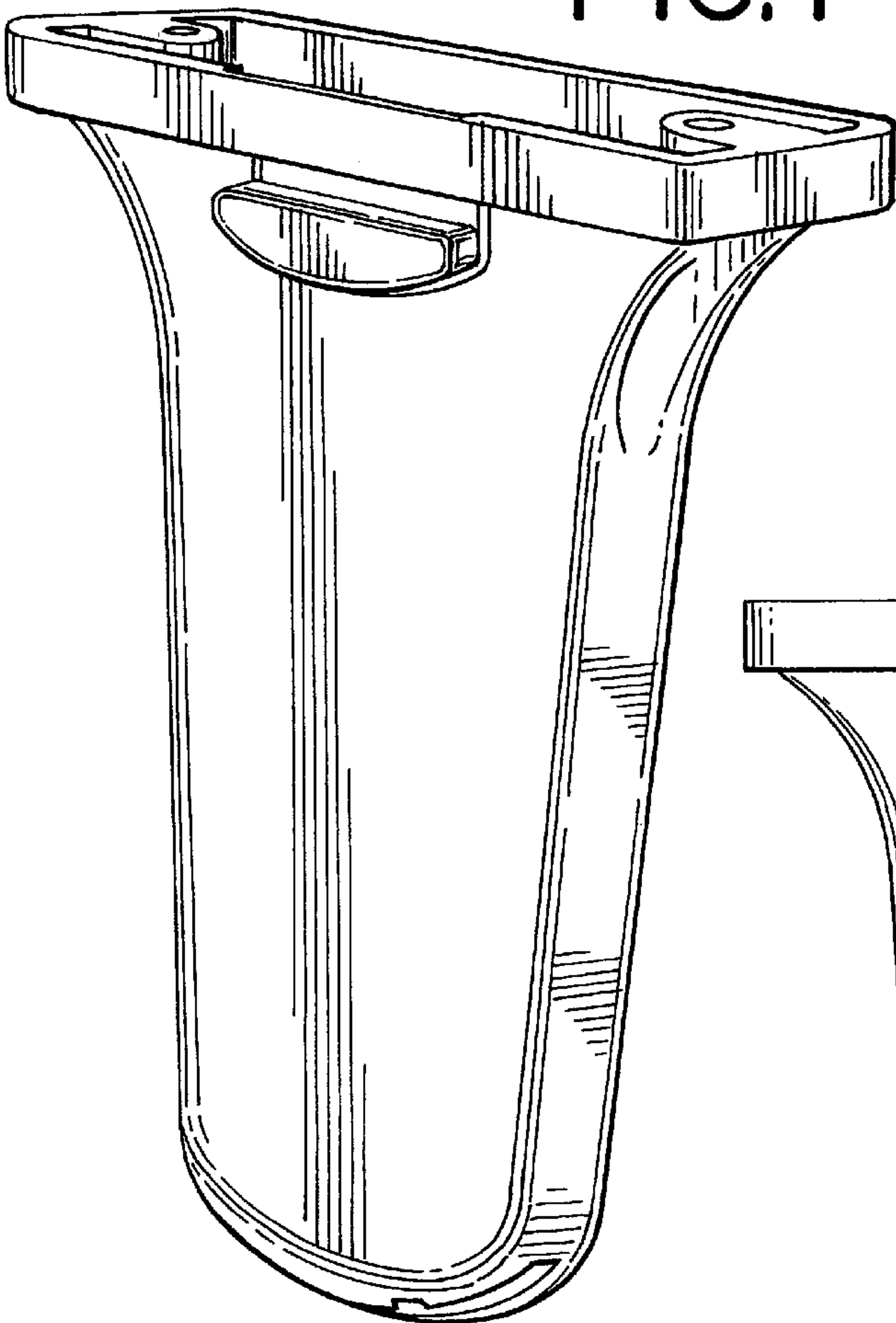
