(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a kitchen utensil spoon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the kitchen utensil spoon showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

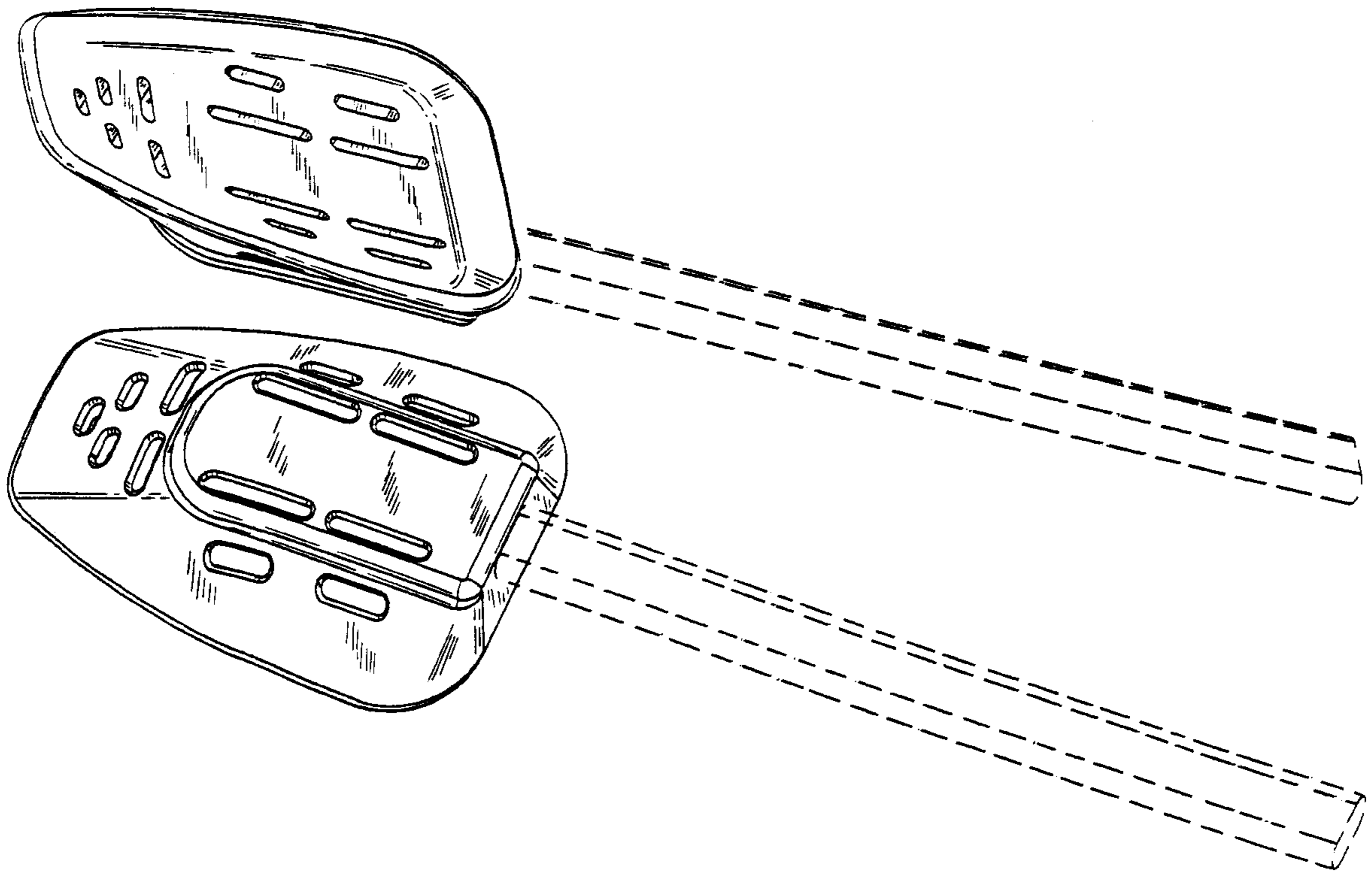
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of this right side view;

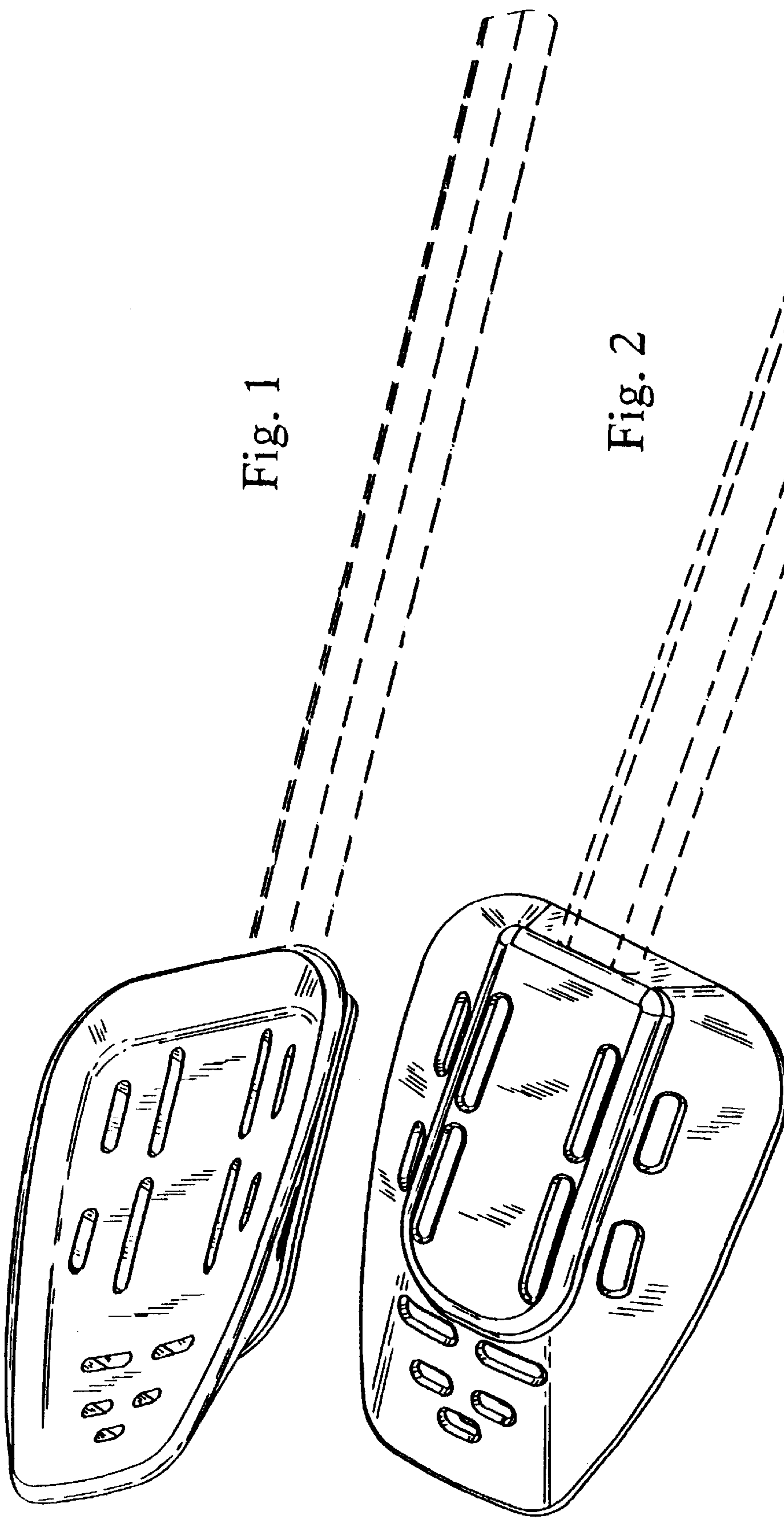

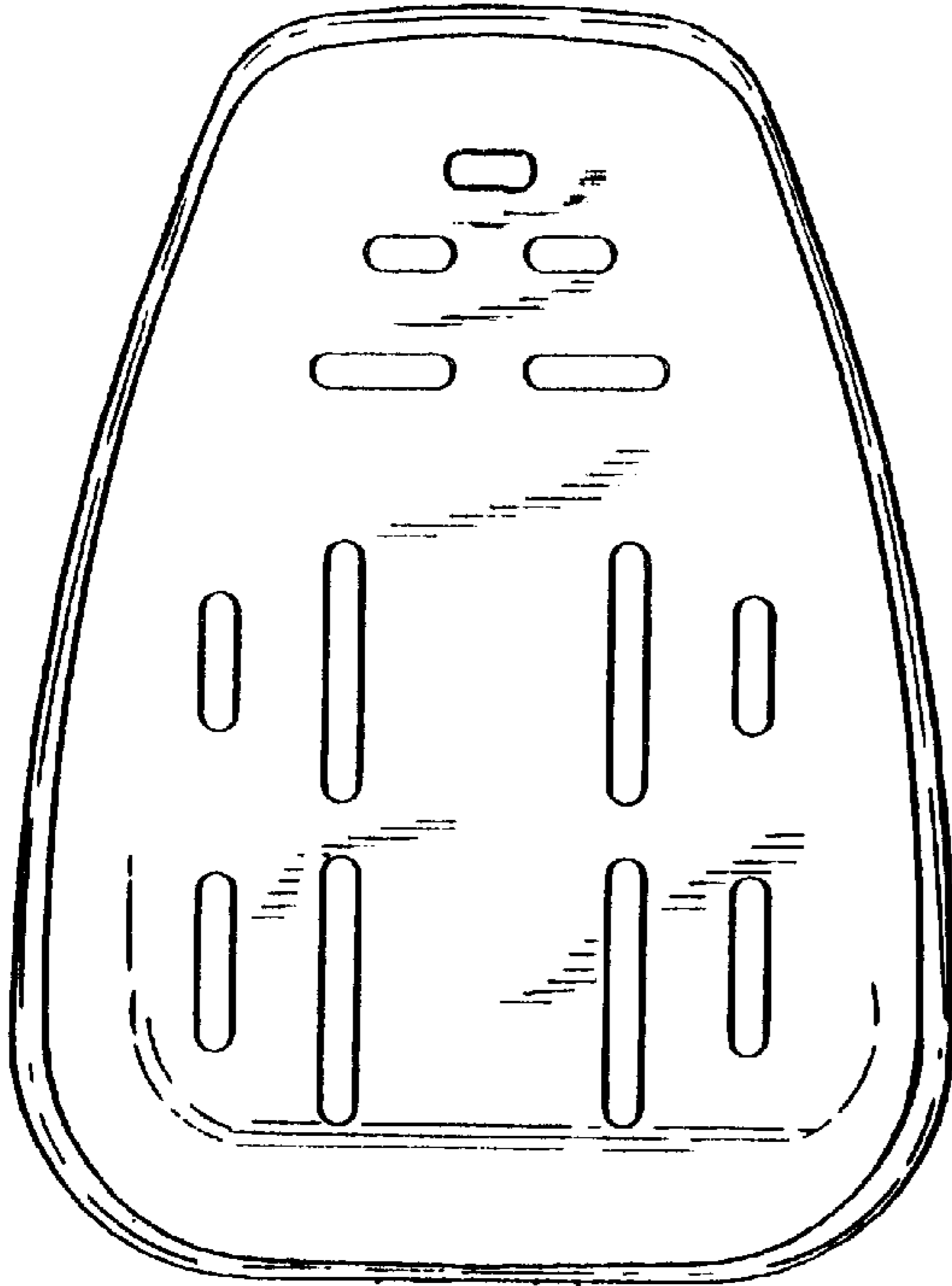

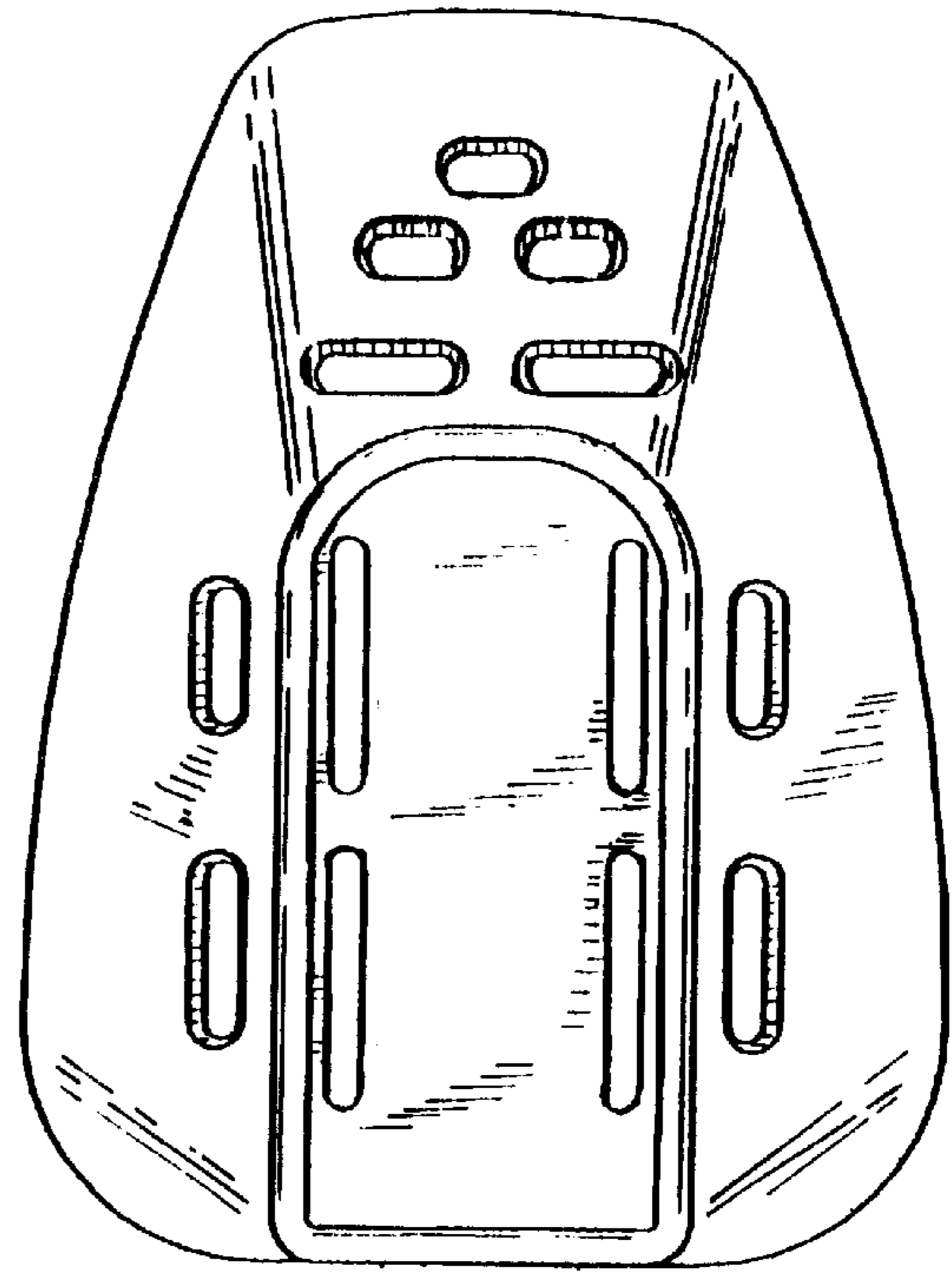

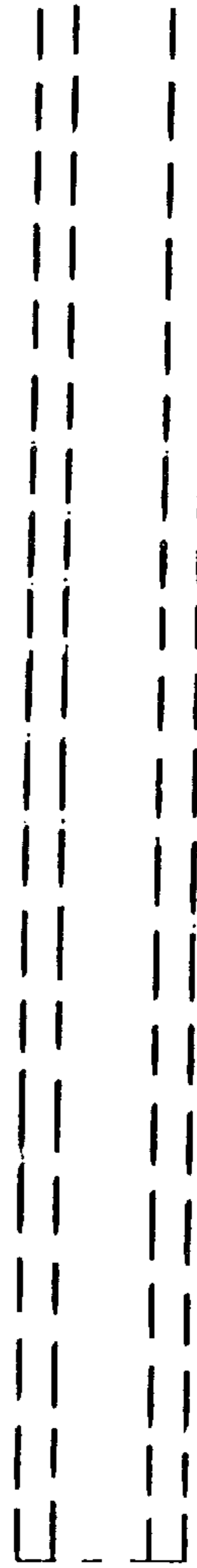
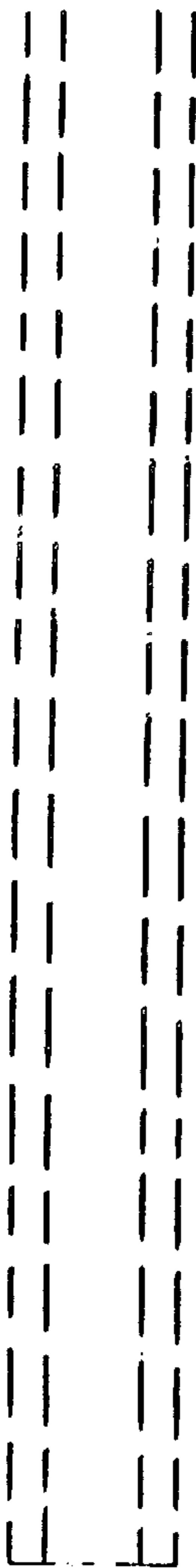

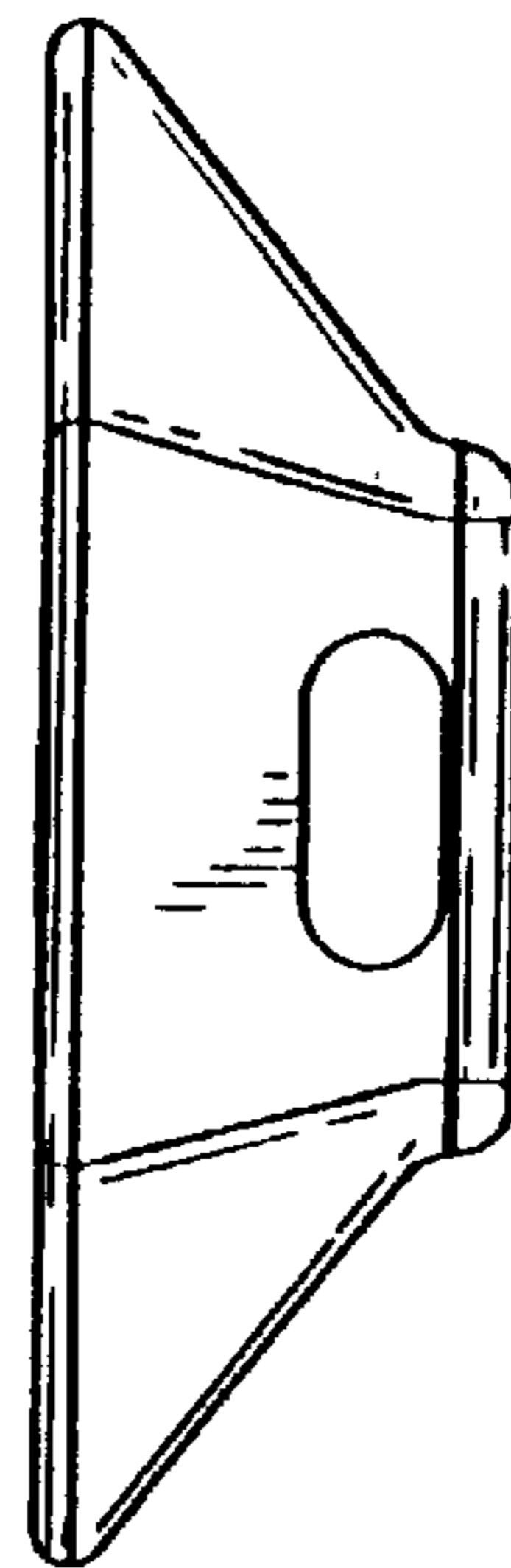
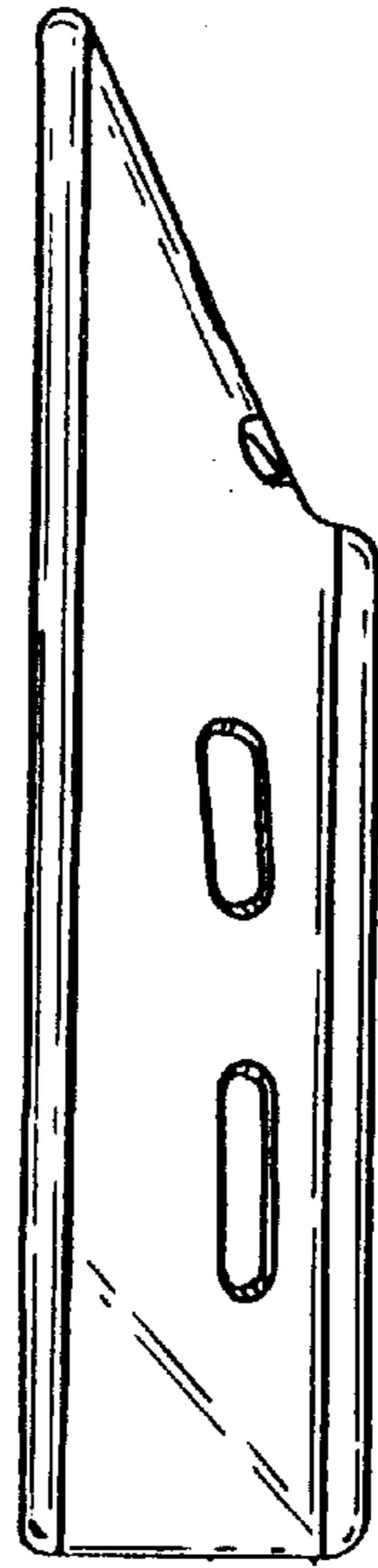

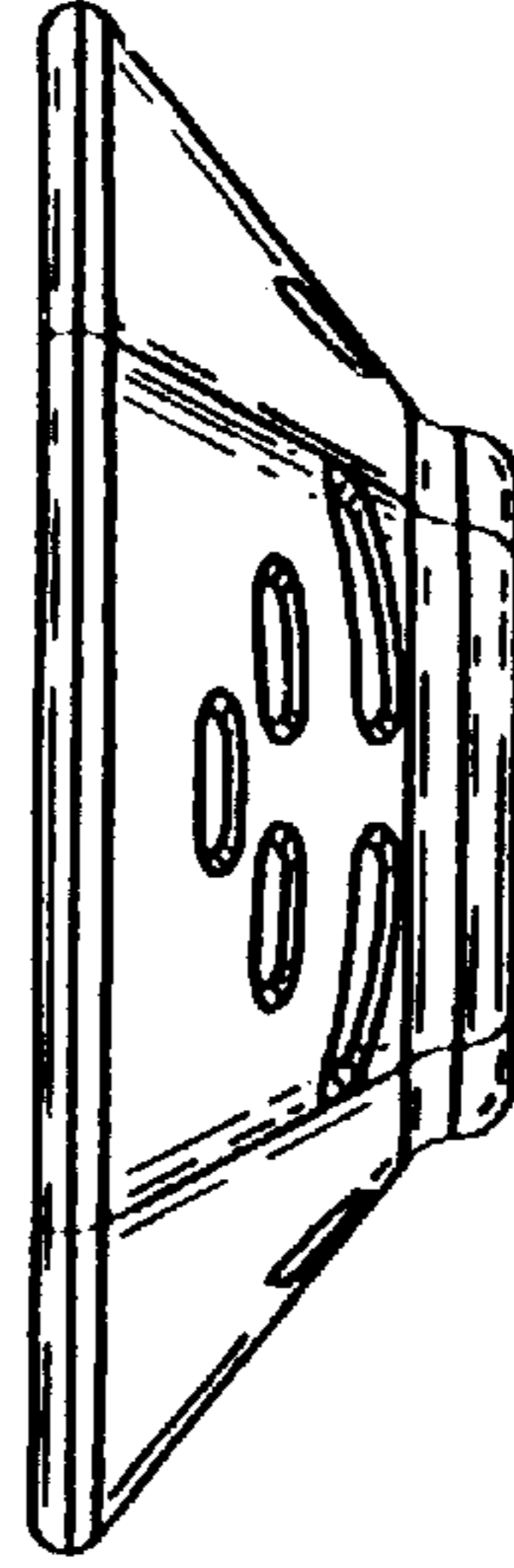
