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DESCRIPTION

is a front elevational view of a splash guard attachable to a roll bar, showing my new design mounted on a motorcycle driven by a driver shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2; and,

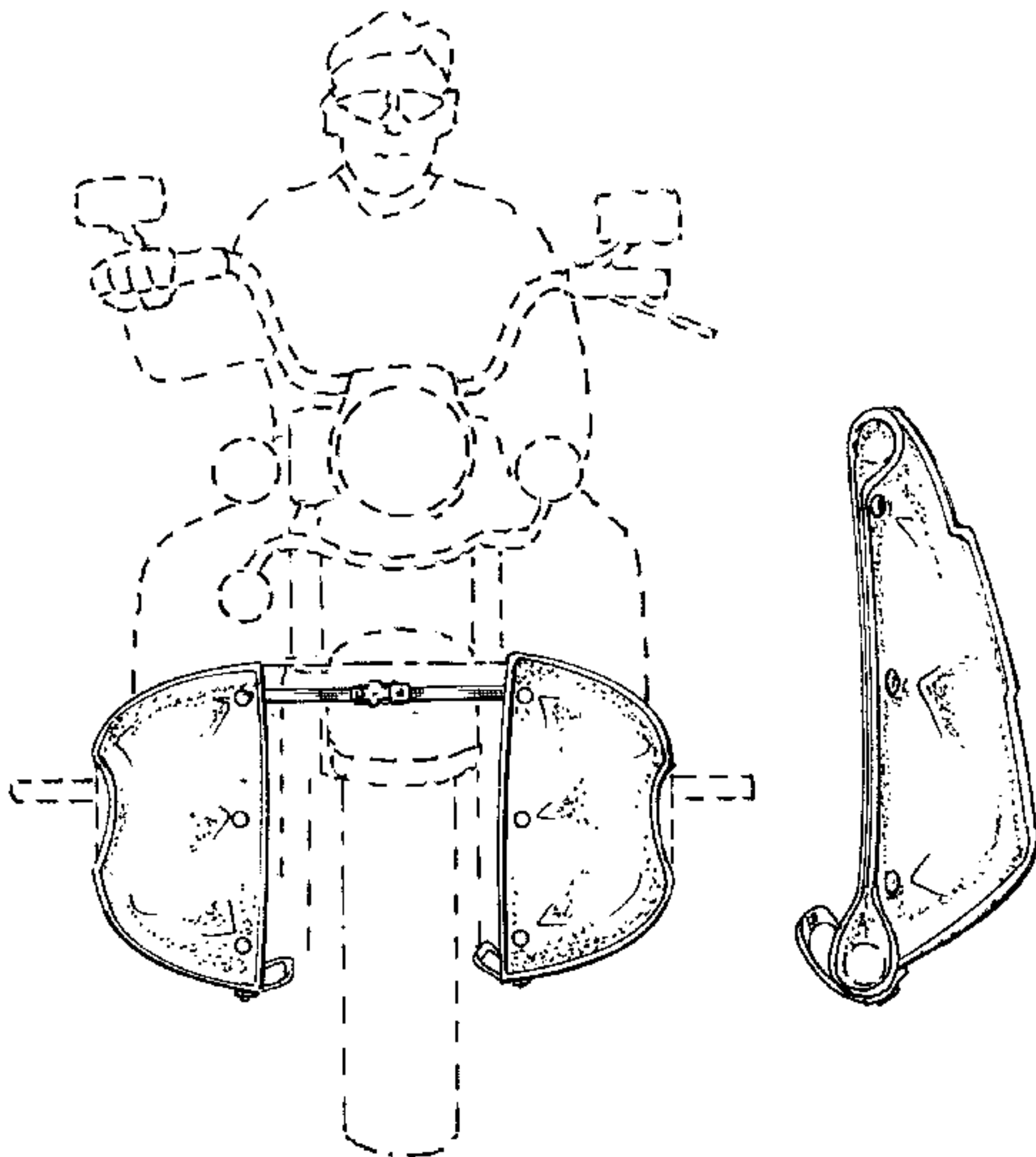
FIG. 8

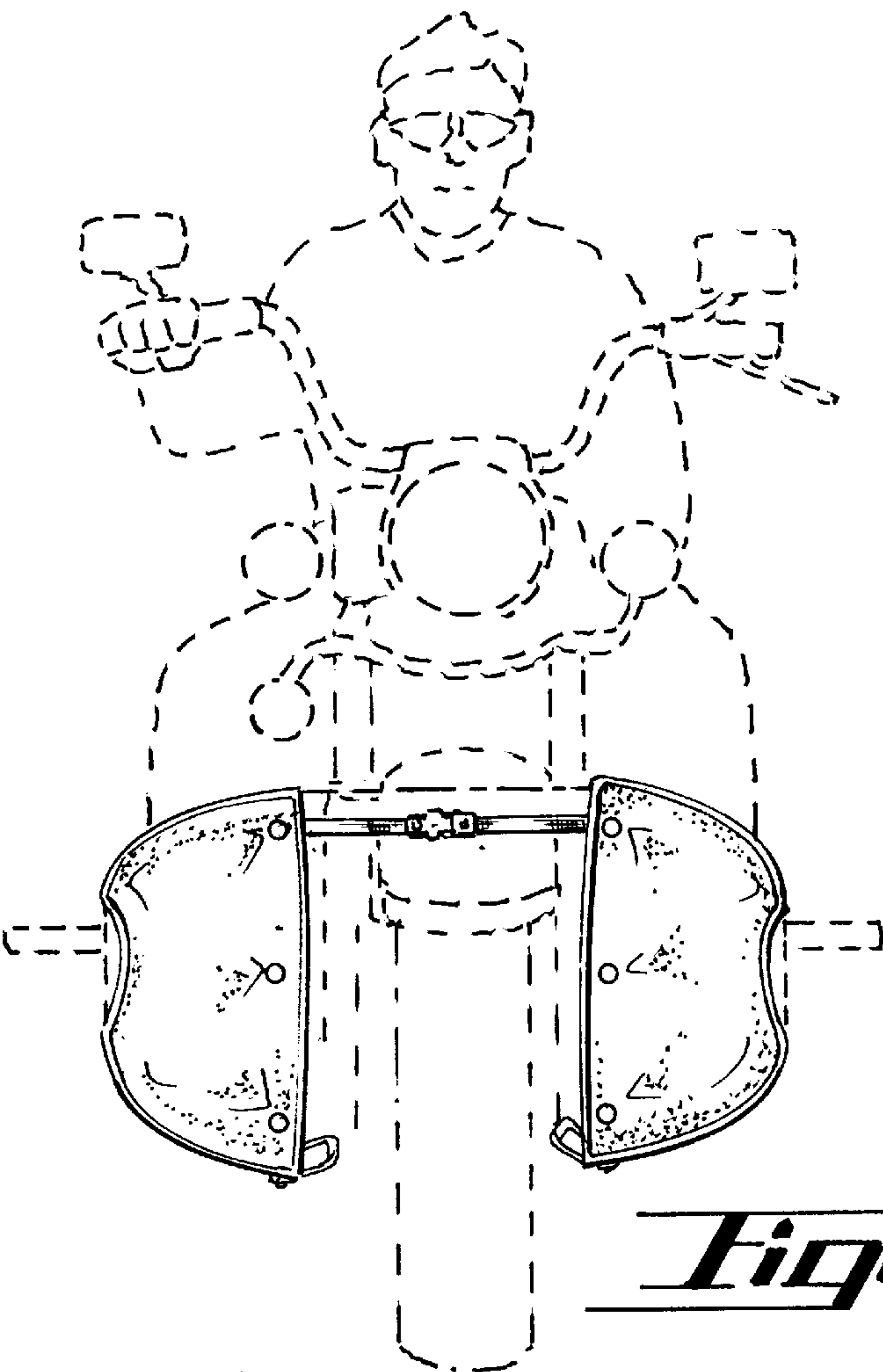

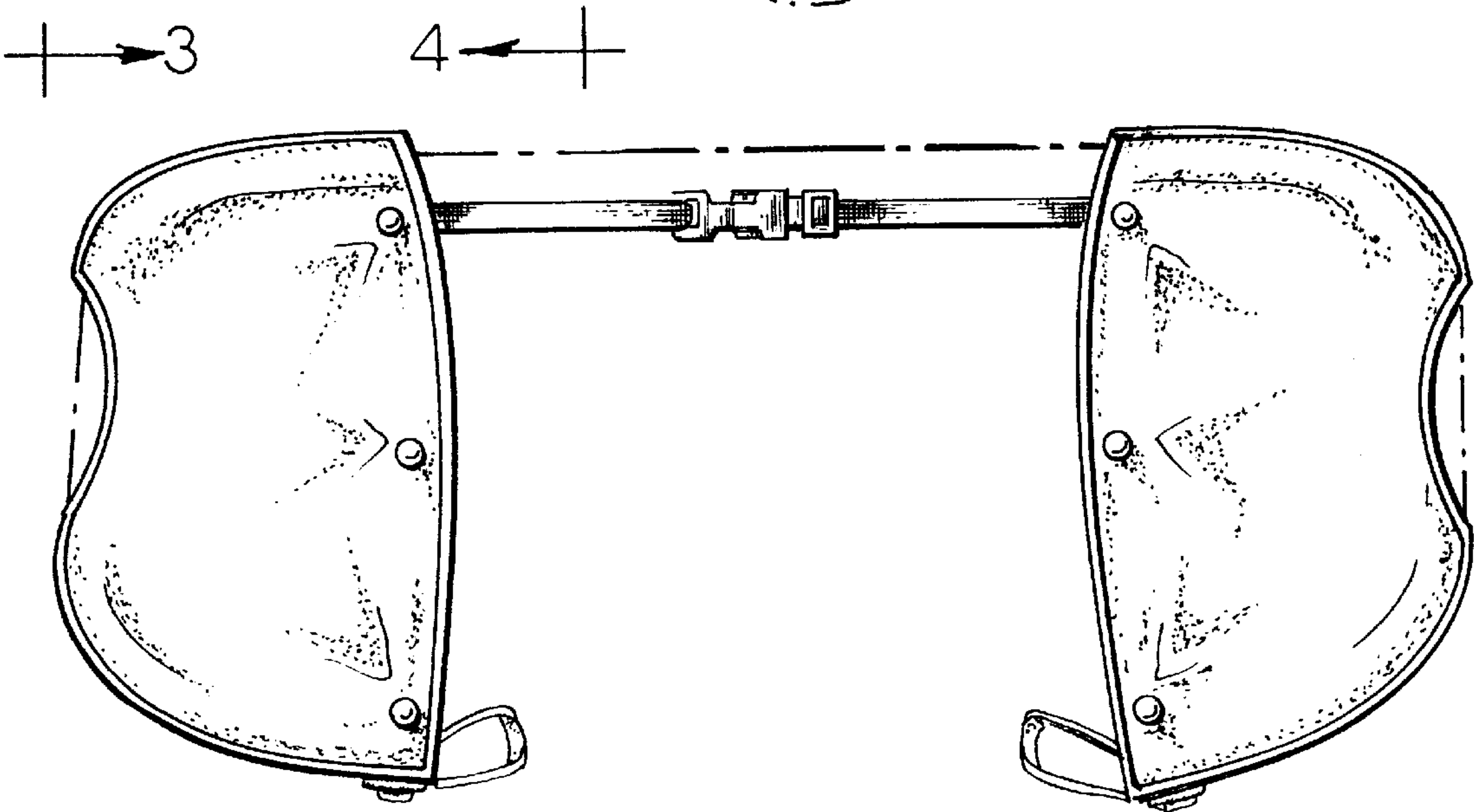

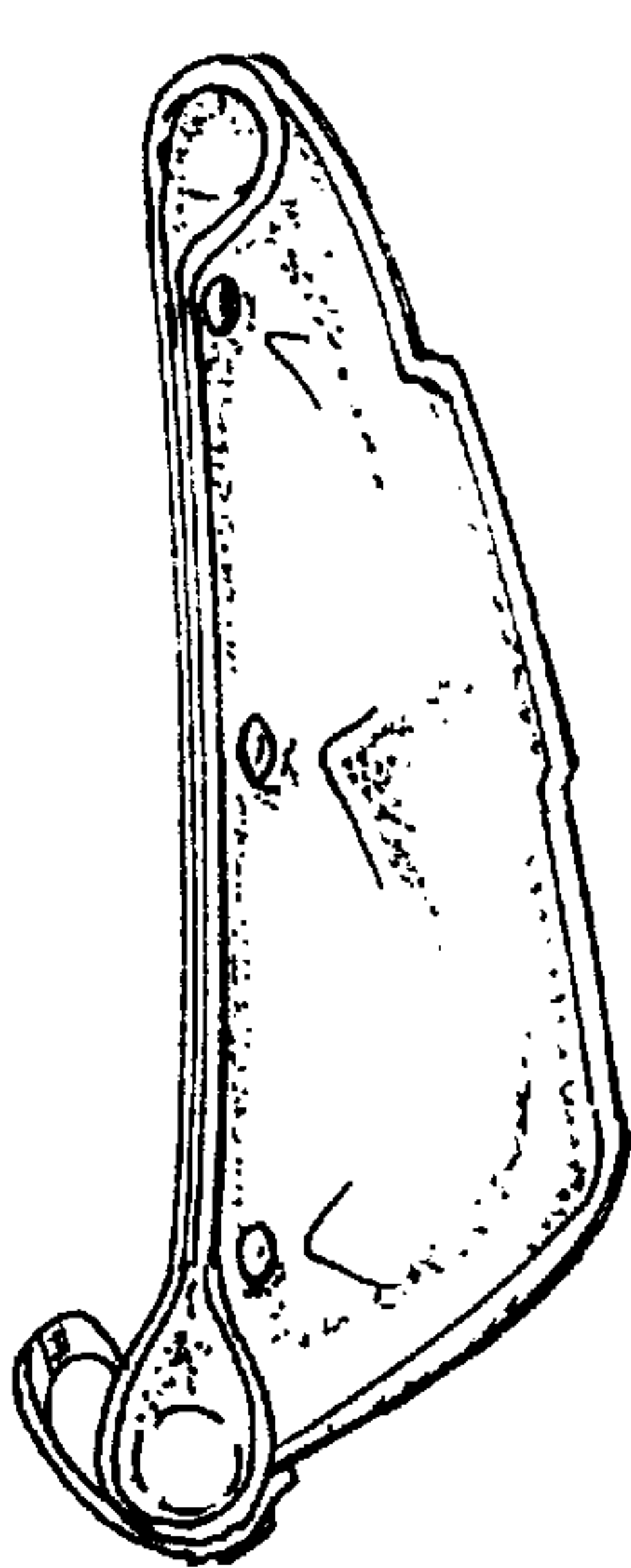

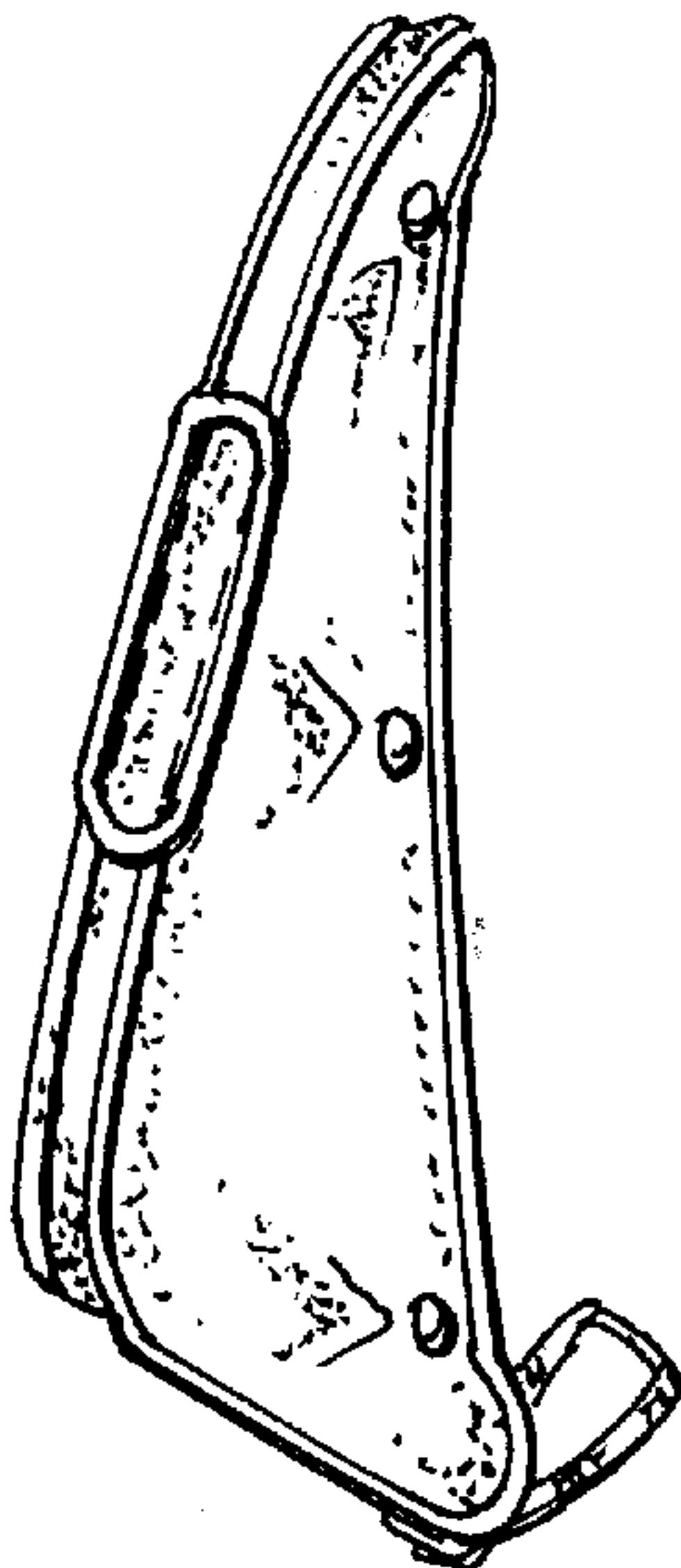

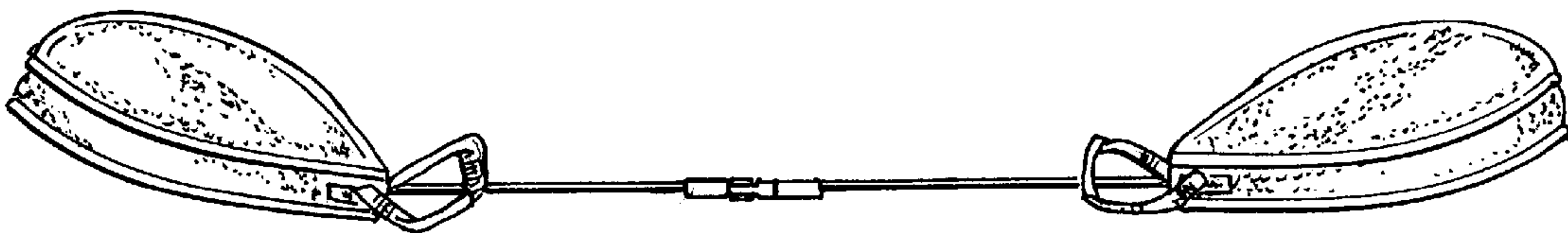

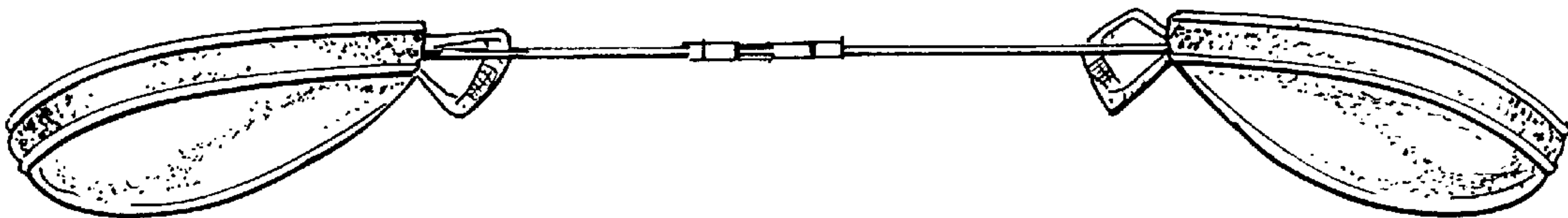

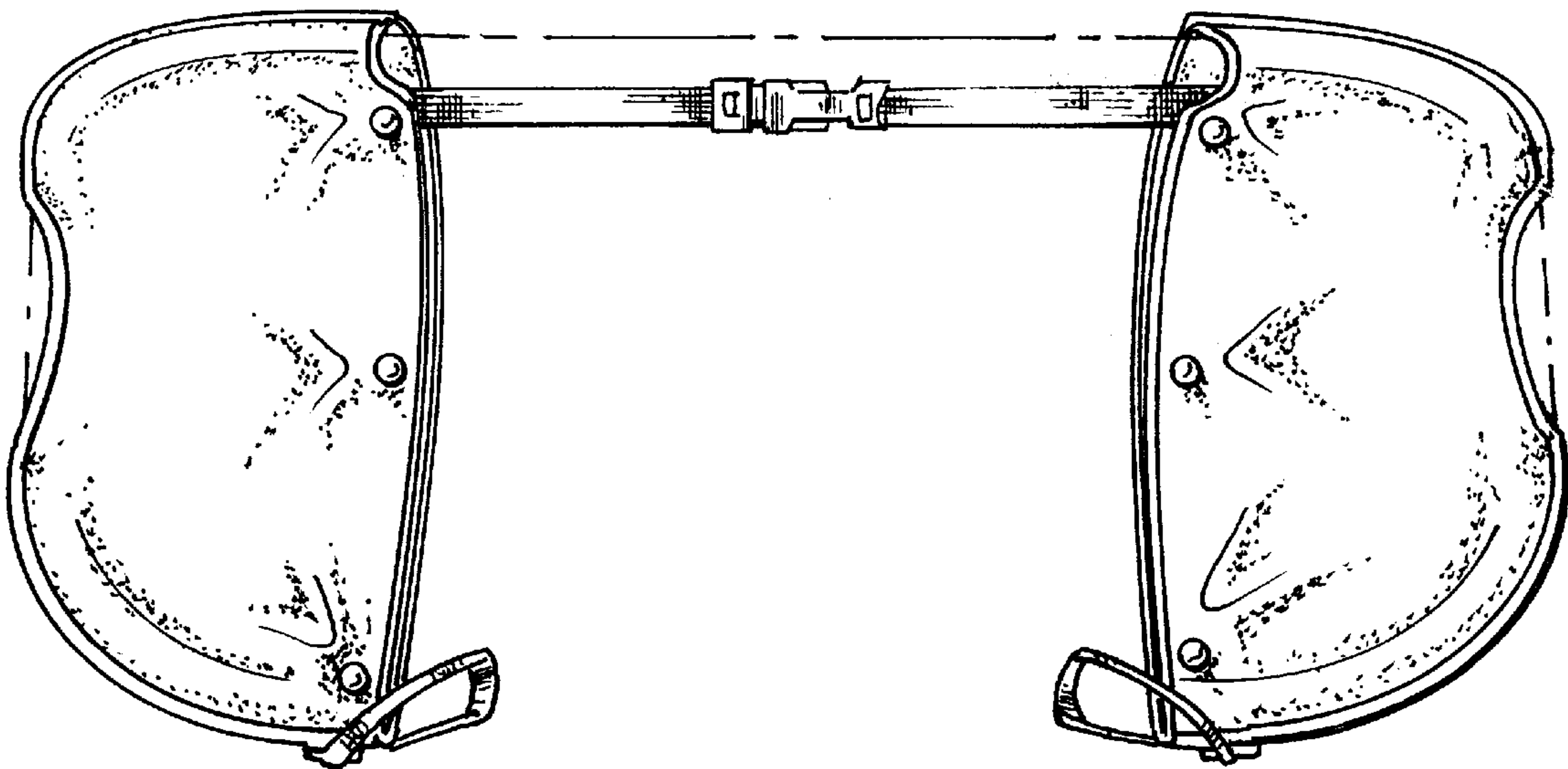

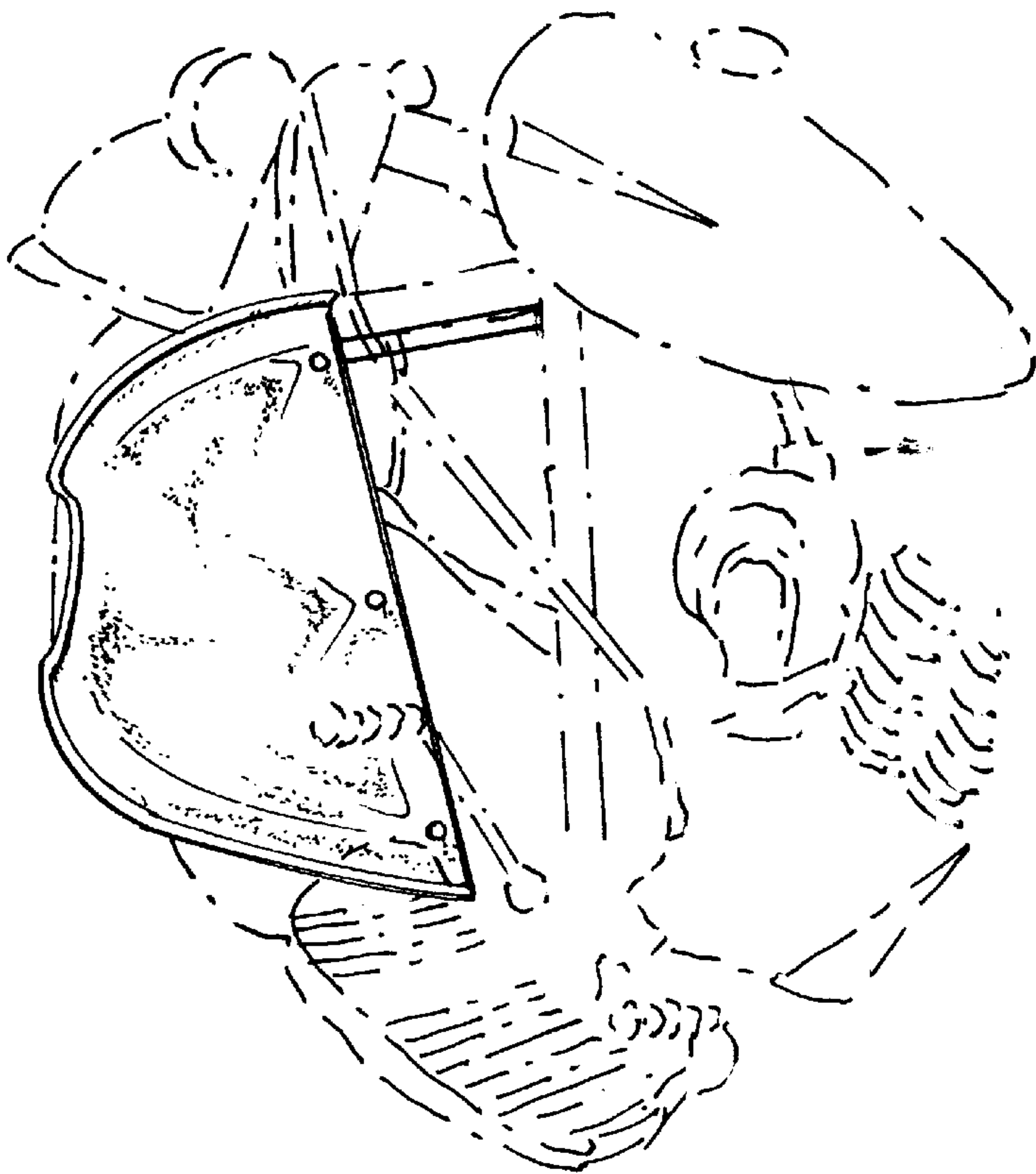
