(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tape dispenser with a cutter, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view from the right front of a tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention; FIG. 2 is a perspective view taken from the left front side of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention;


FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the rear of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the right side of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention; FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the front of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention; FIG. 7 is an elevational view of the left side of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention; FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention;


FIG. 9 is an inside view of the left part forming the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention; and,


FIG. 10 is an inside view of the right part coacting with the left part to form the tape dispenser with a cutter according to the present invention.









