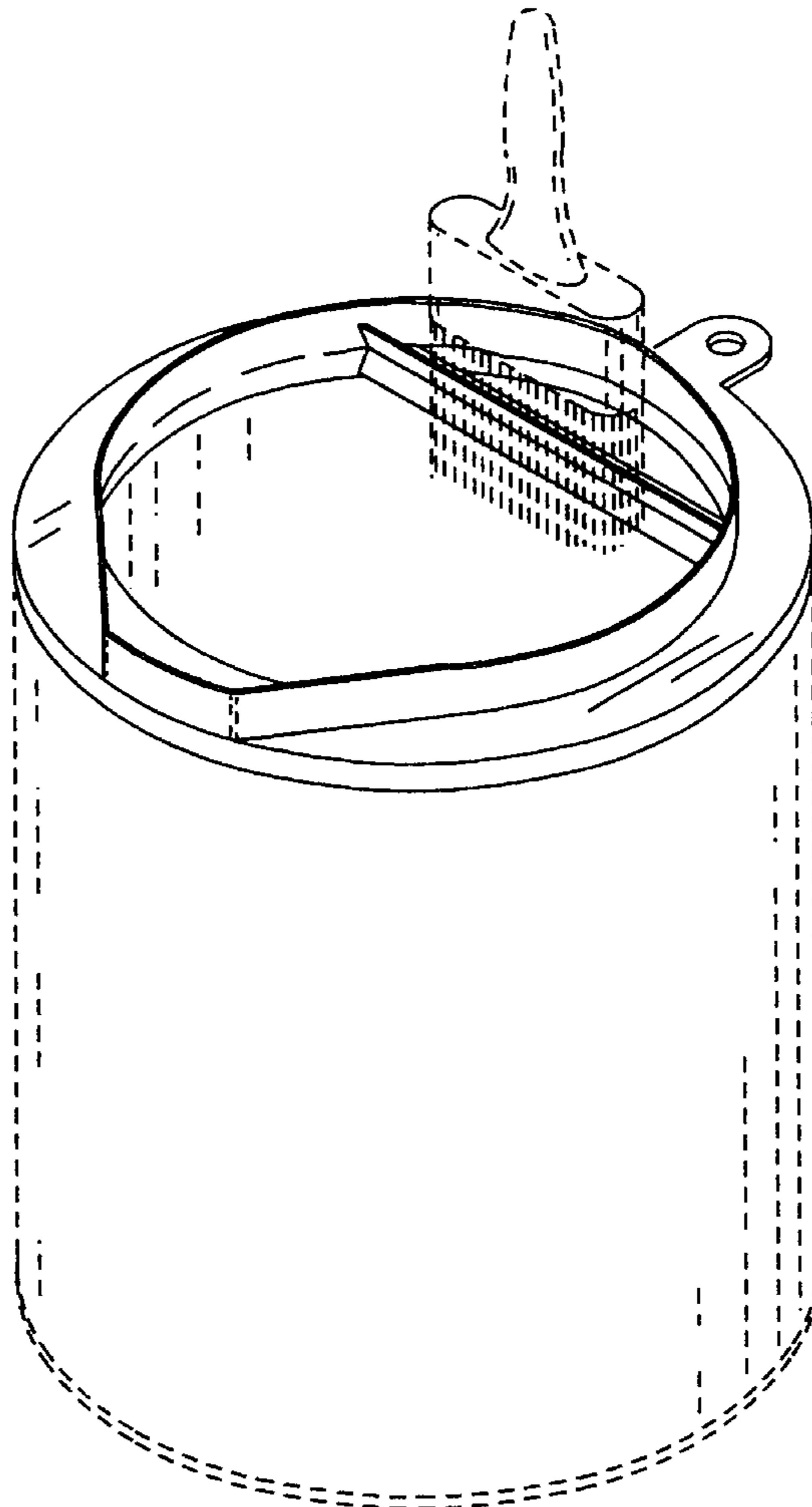
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the present invention.

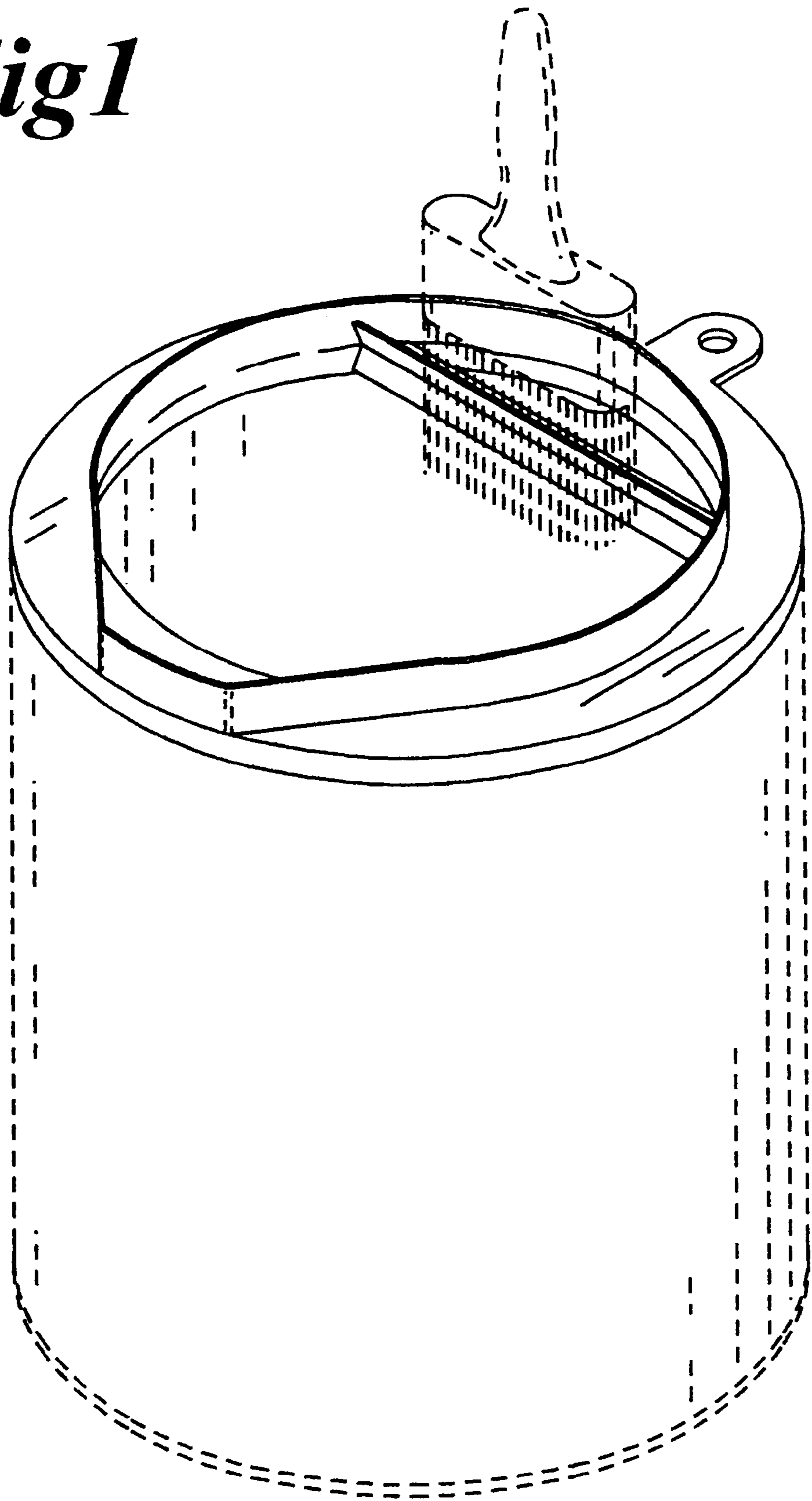

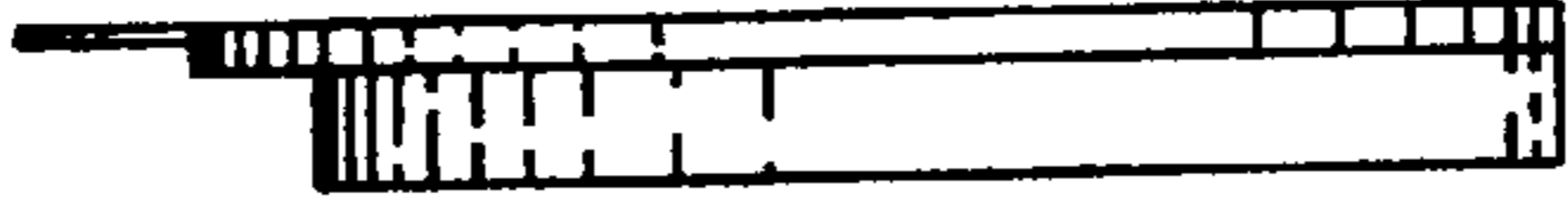

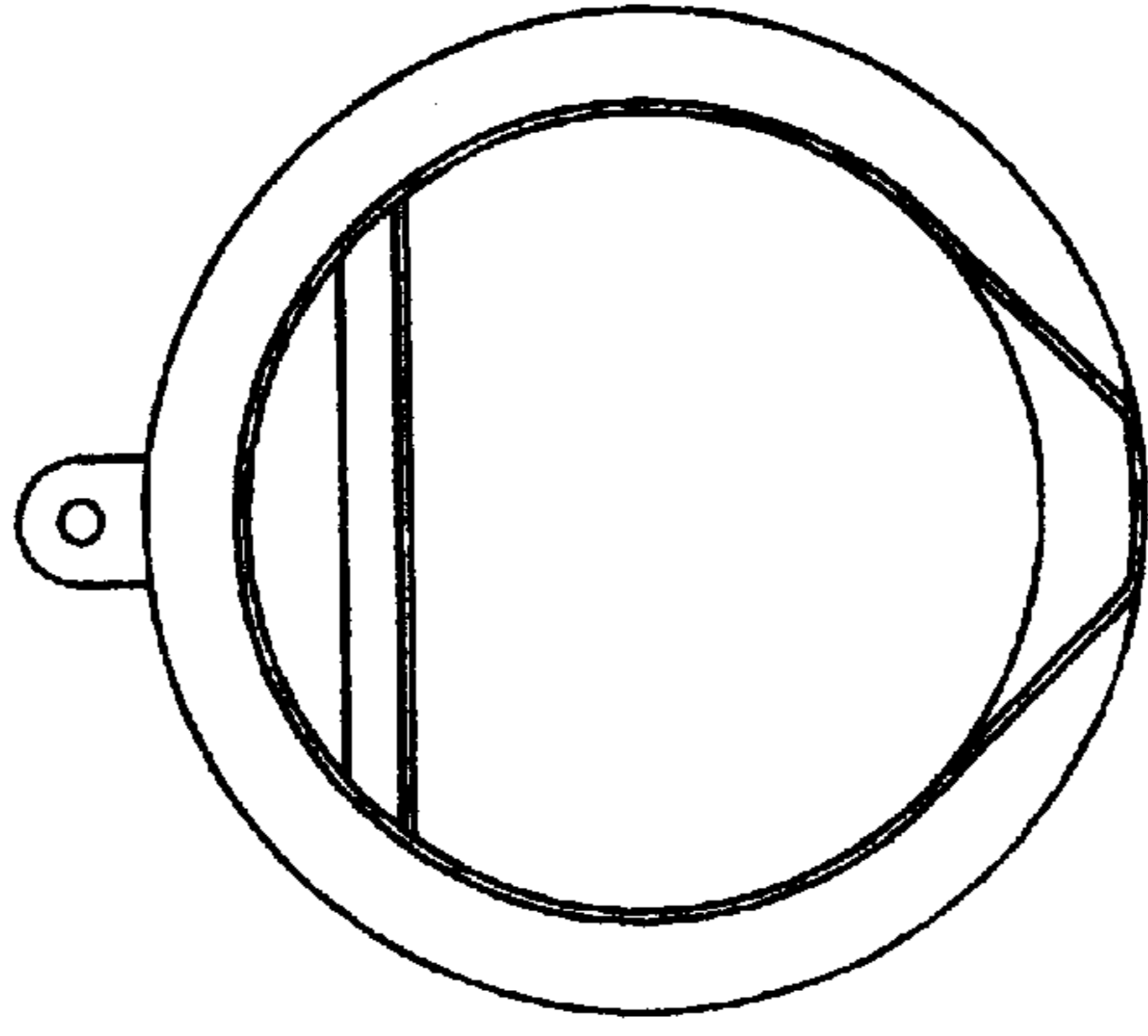




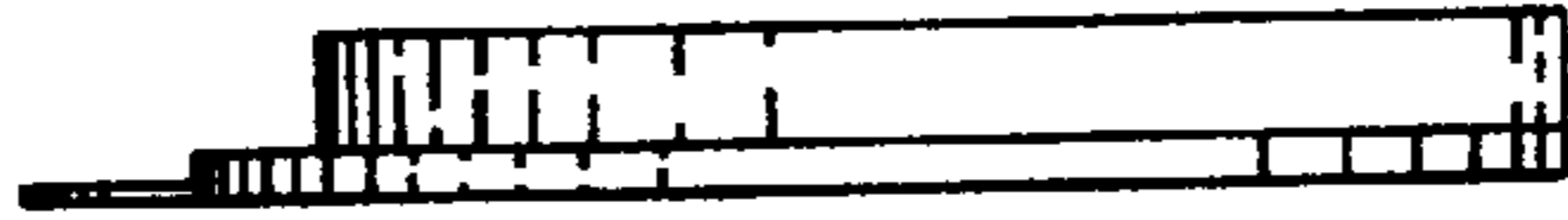

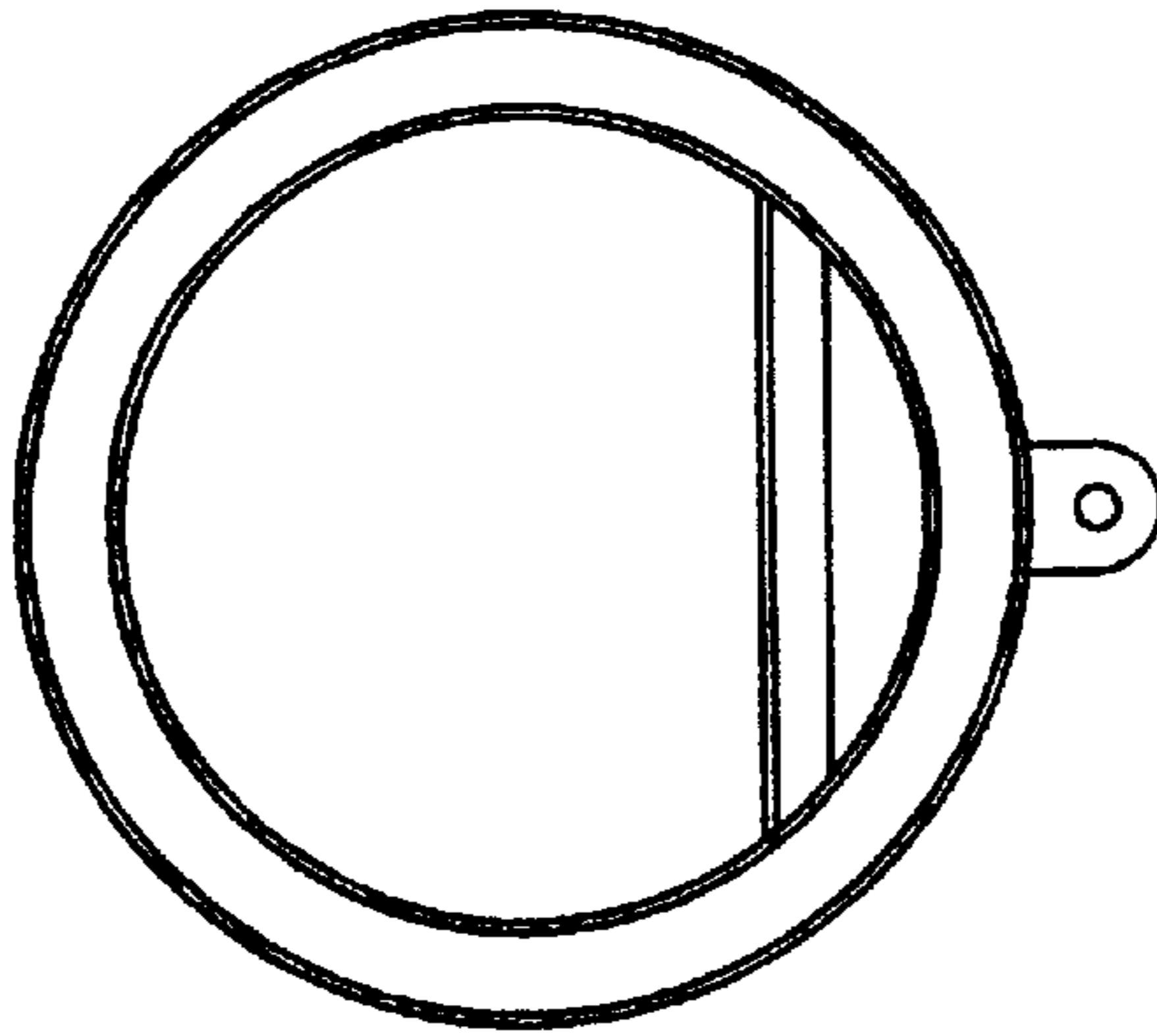

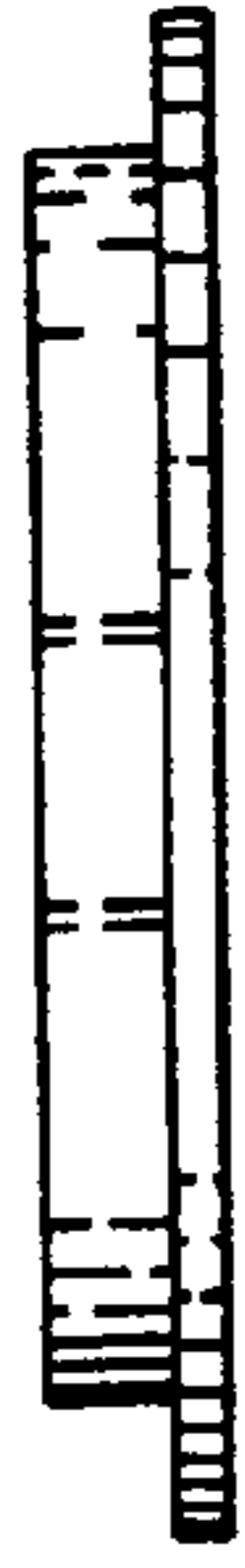
